(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design of a linoleum cutter, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a linoleum cutter, the back view being a mirror image thereof, the right side view having the same appearance, and the left side view having the same appearance;

FIG. 2 is a top view of the linoleum cutter of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a bottom view of the linoleum cutter of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a front view of a handle of the linoleum cutter of FIG. 1 without an end cap, the back view being a mirror image thereof, the right side view having the same appearance, and the left side view having the same appearance;

FIG. 5 is a front view of the threaded end cap of the linoleum cutter of FIG. 1 unscrewed from the handle of the linoleum cutter of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a top view of the handle of FIG. 4 showing the hollow interior of the handle;

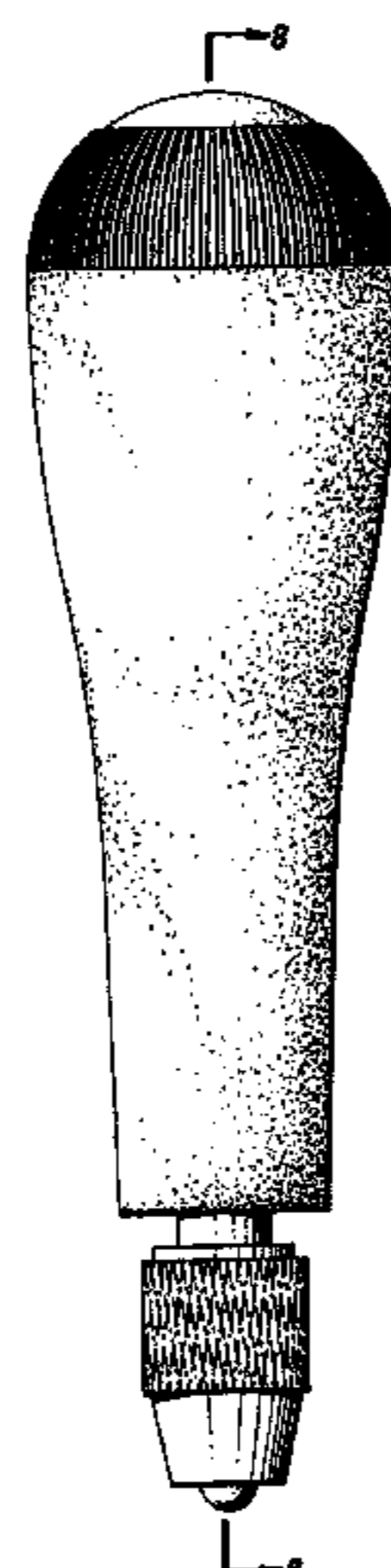
FIG. 7 is a top view of the end cap of FIG. 5;

FIG. 8 is a cross-sectional view of the linoleum cutter of FIG. 1 along view 8—8; and,

FIG. 9 is a rear view of the threaded end cap of the linoleum cutter of FIG. 1 unscrewed from the handle of the linoleum cutter of FIG. 1.

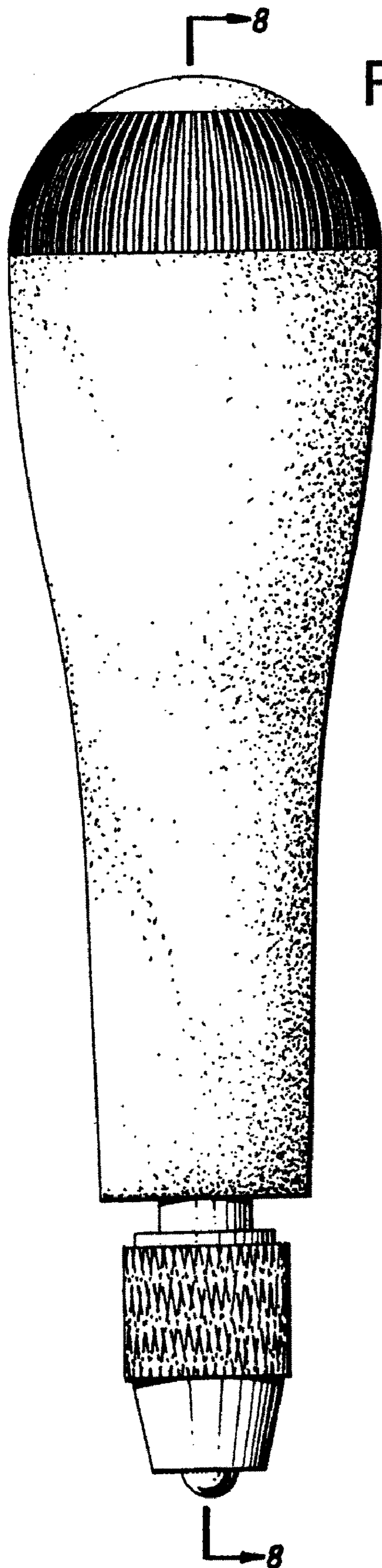

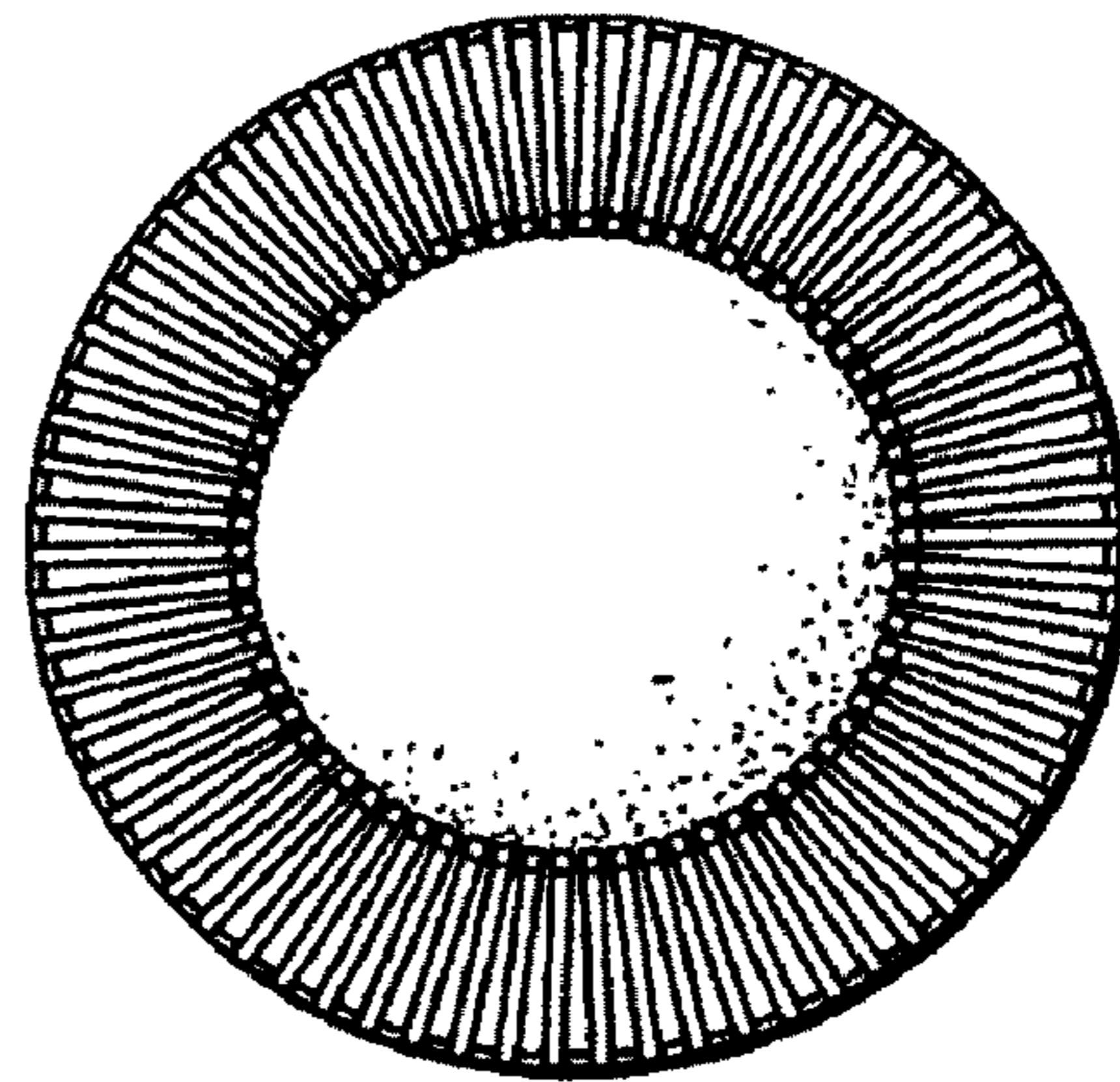
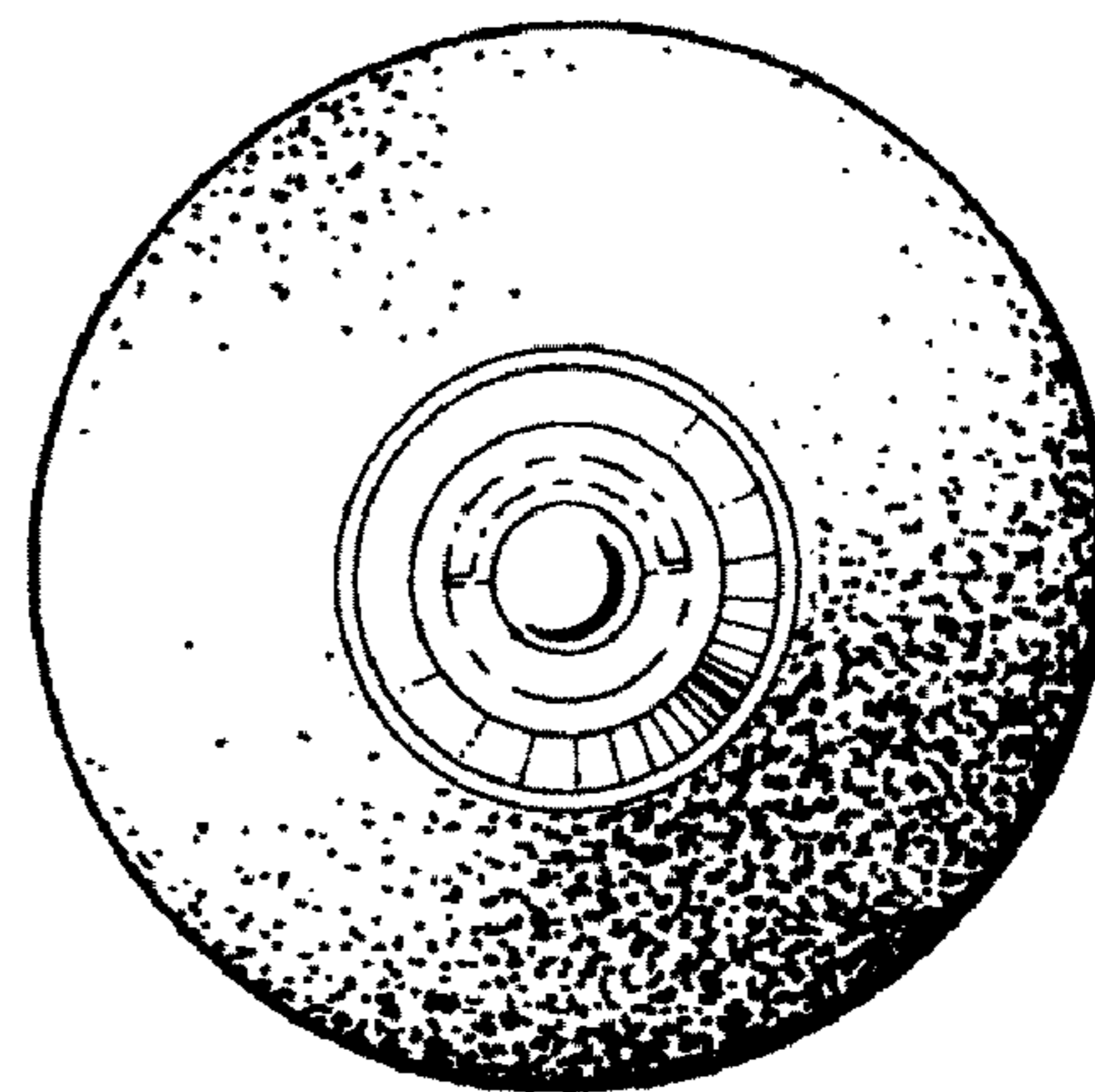

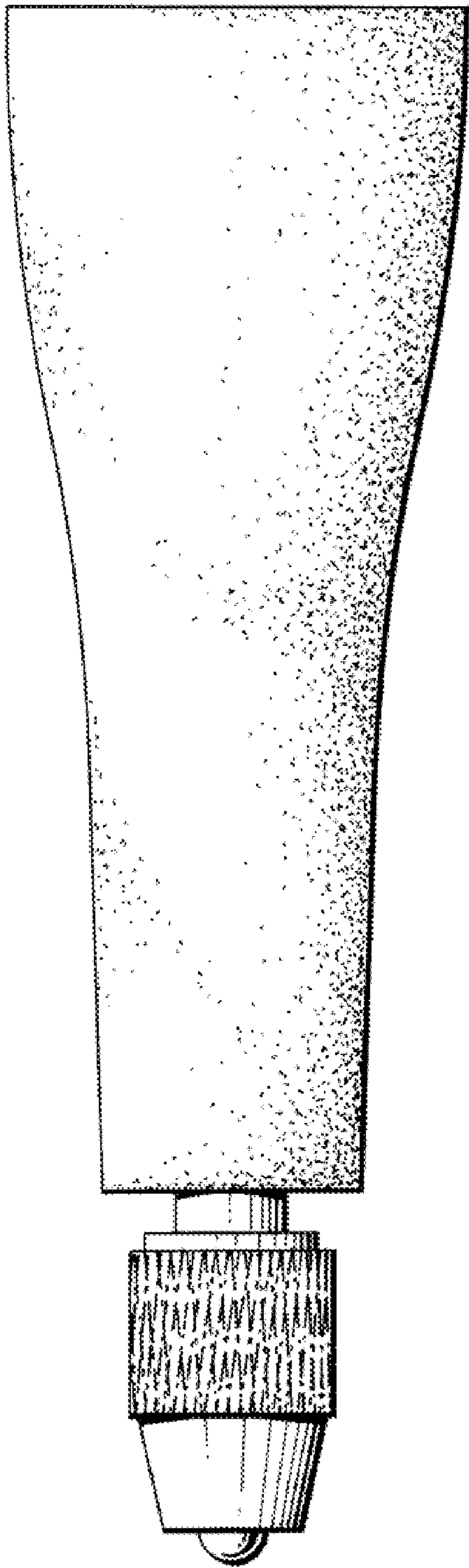

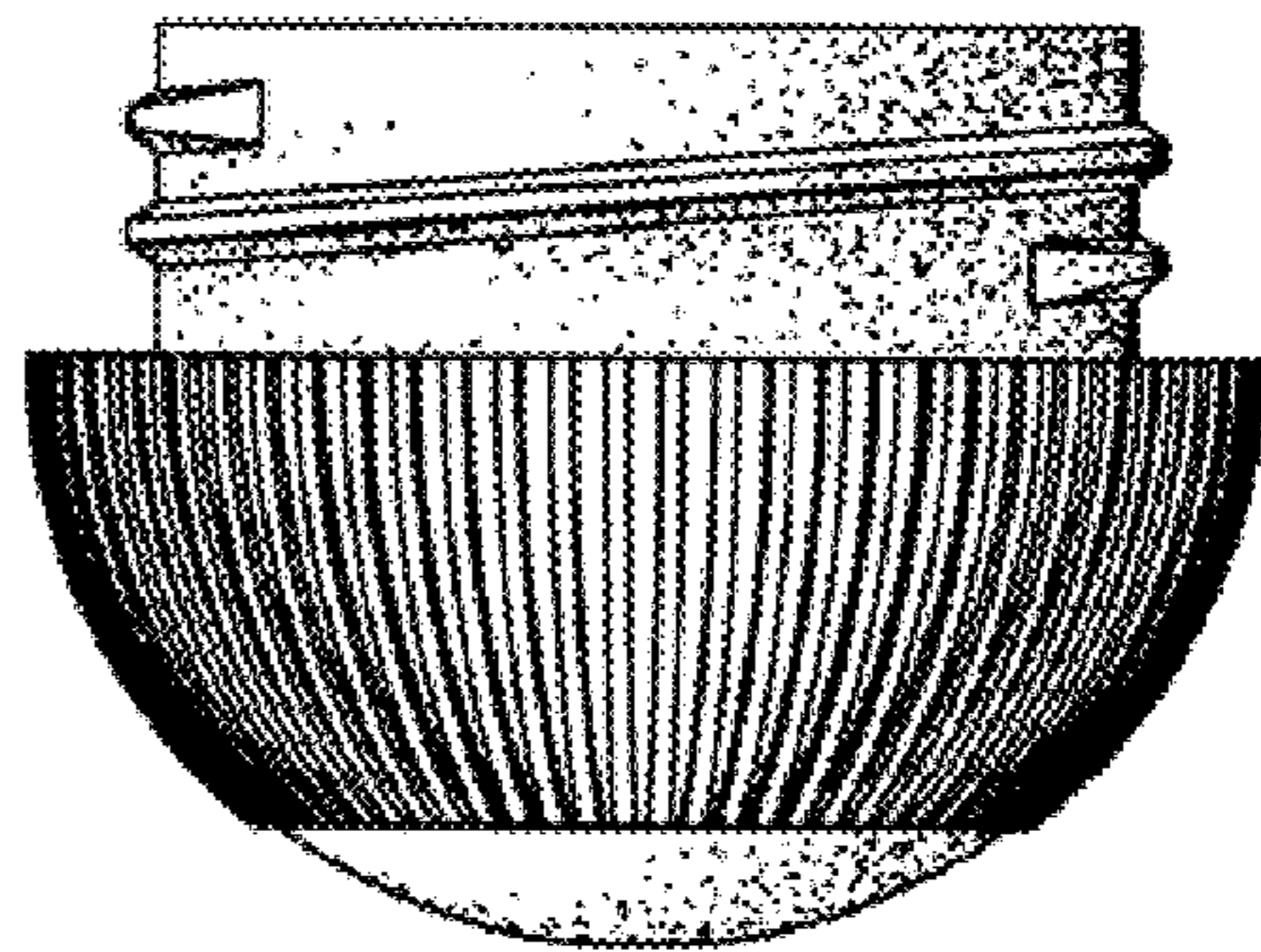

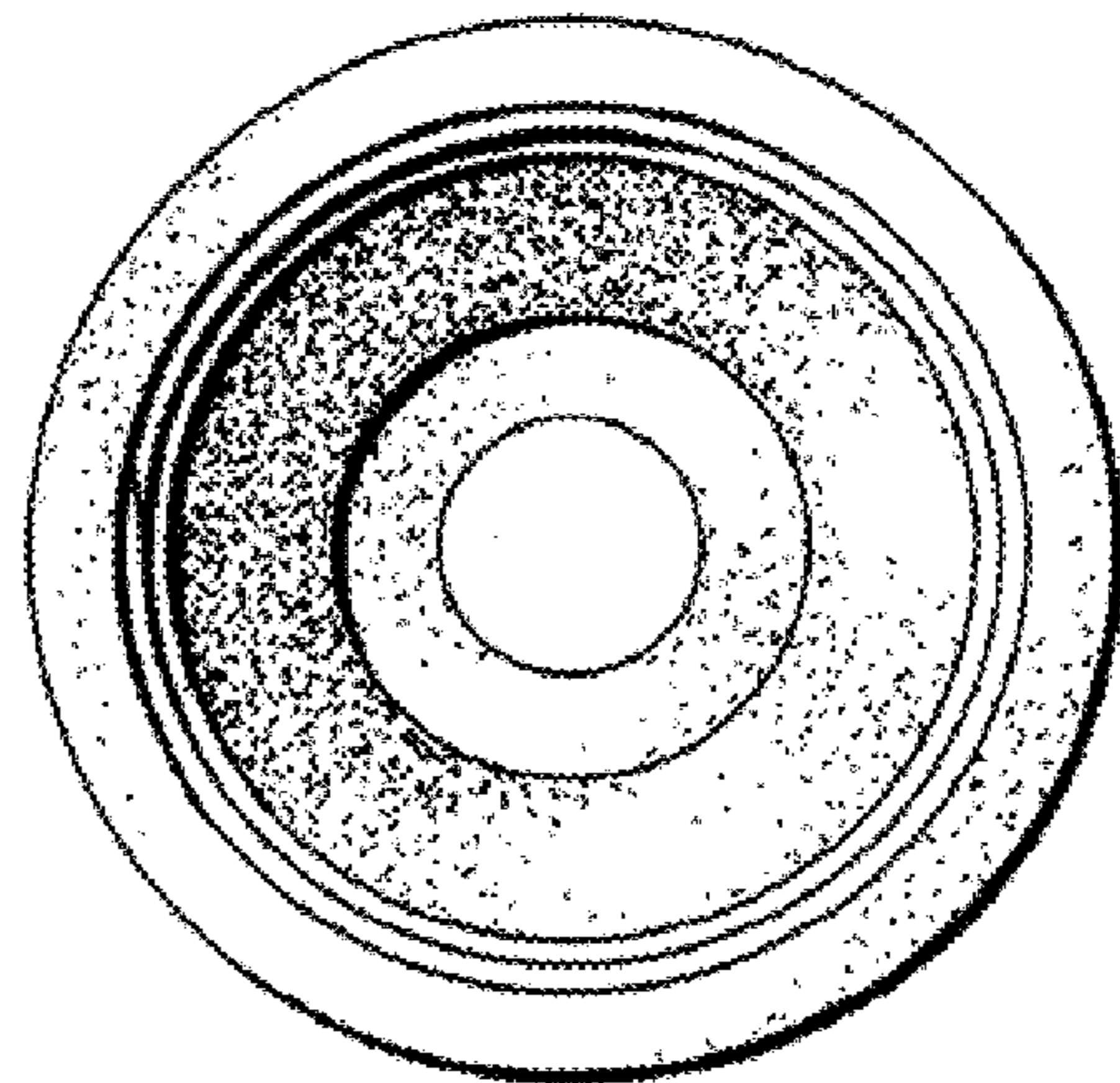

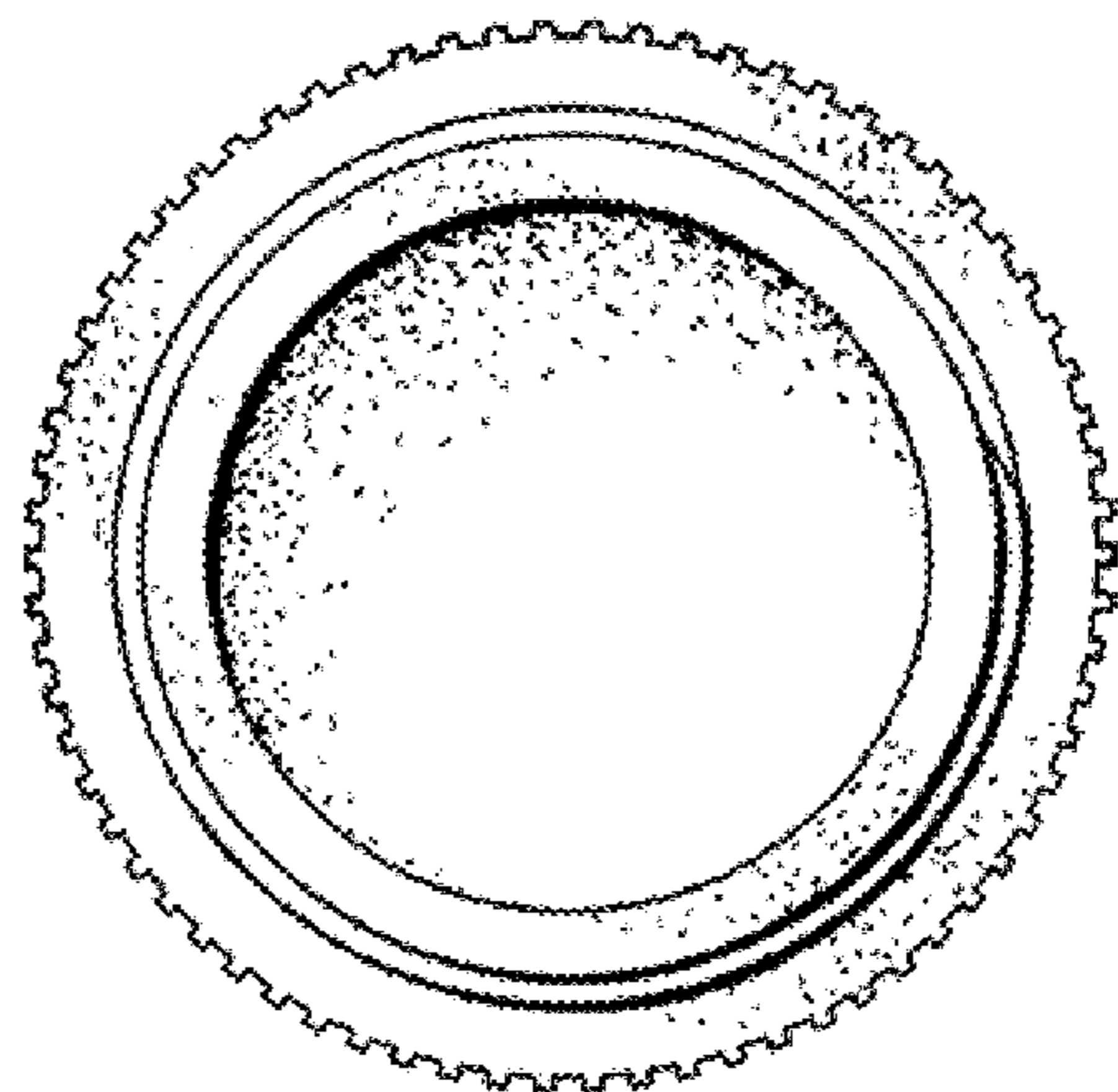

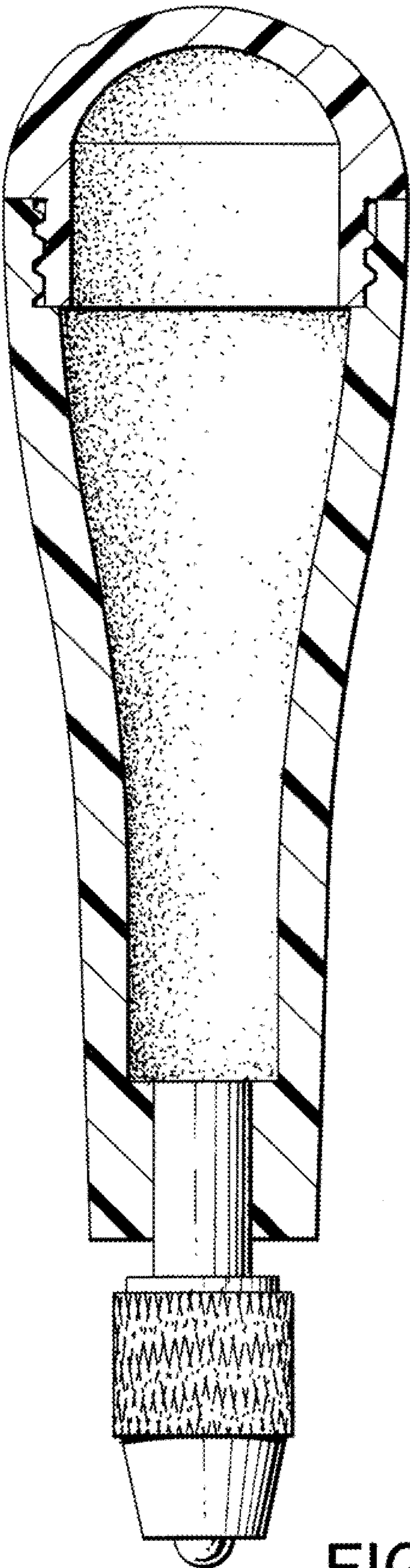

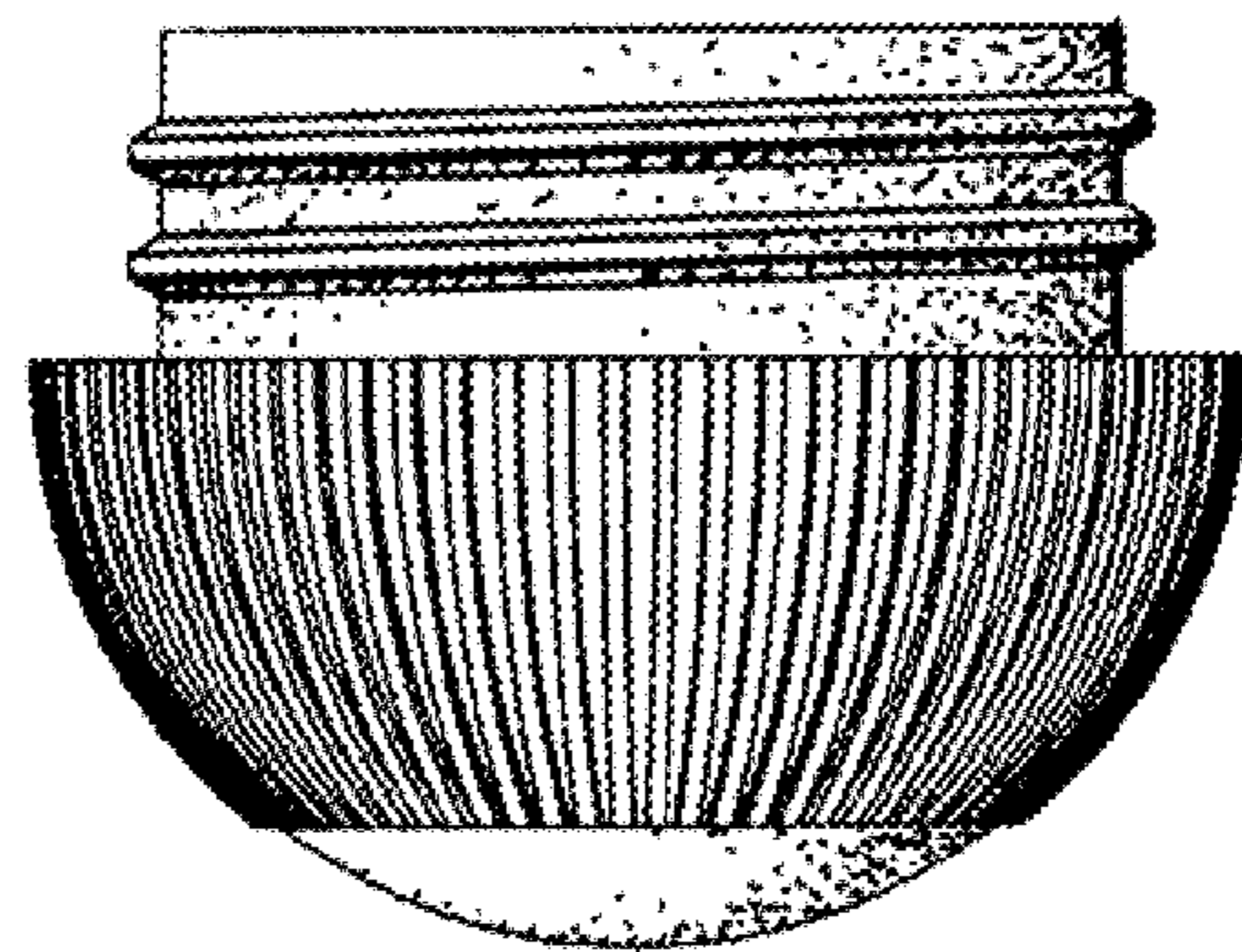
