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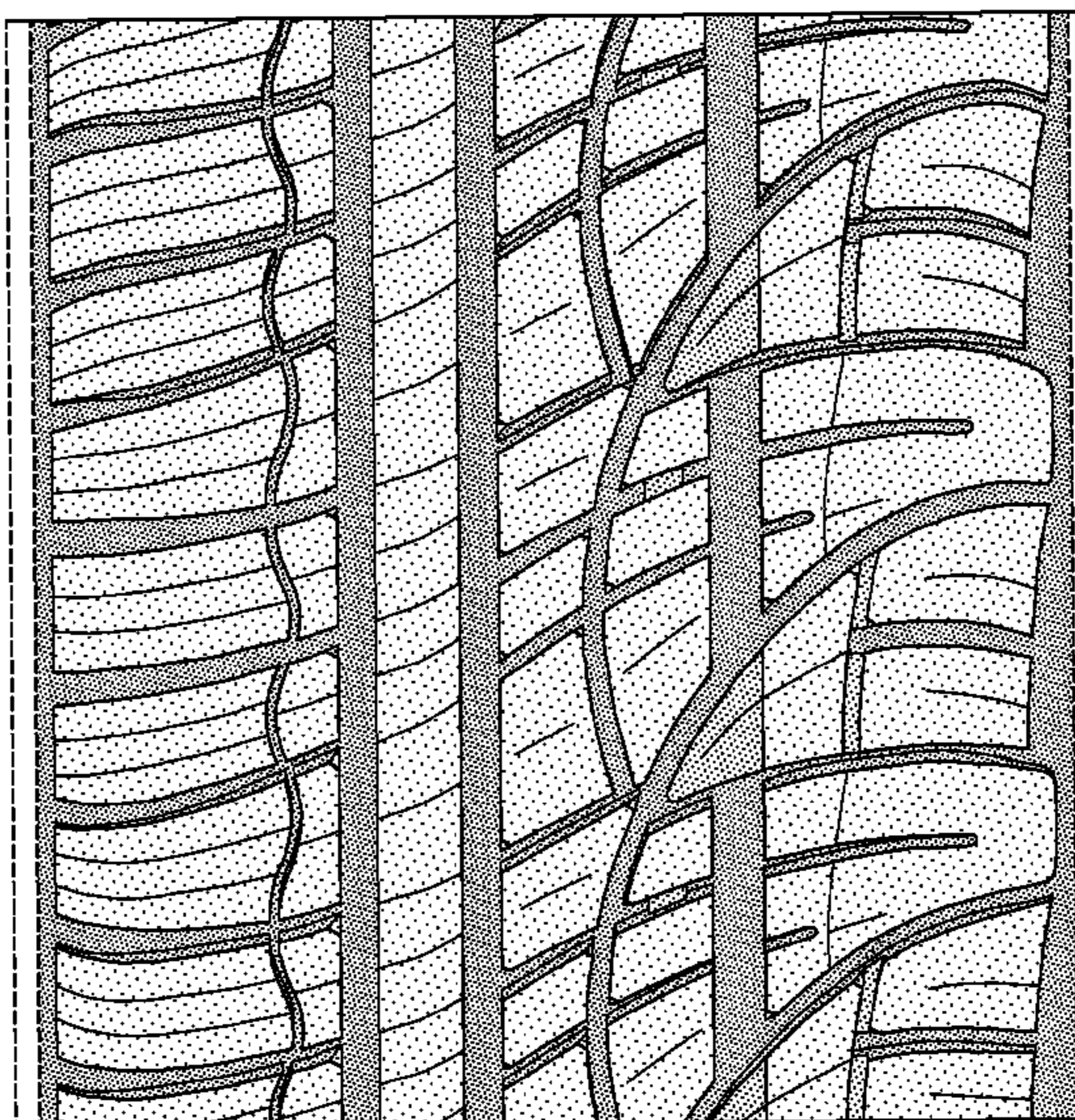
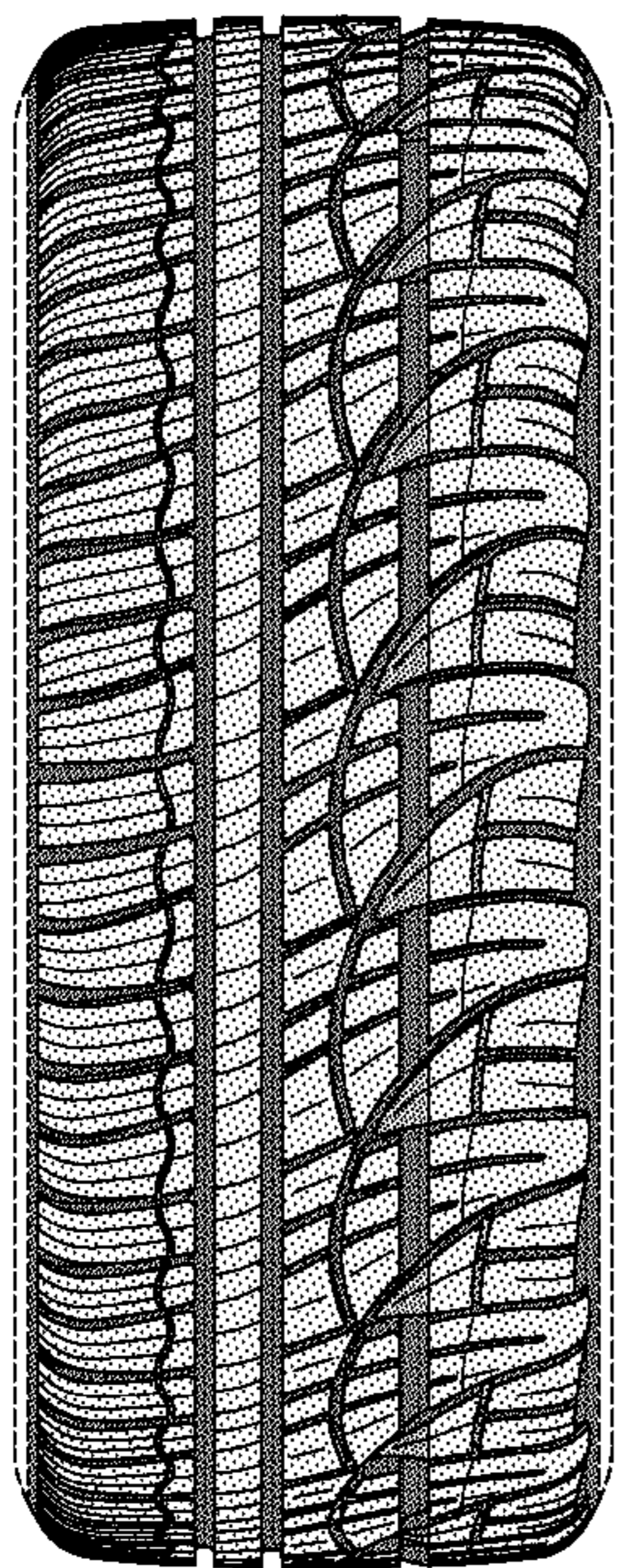
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FIG. 6 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of a tire

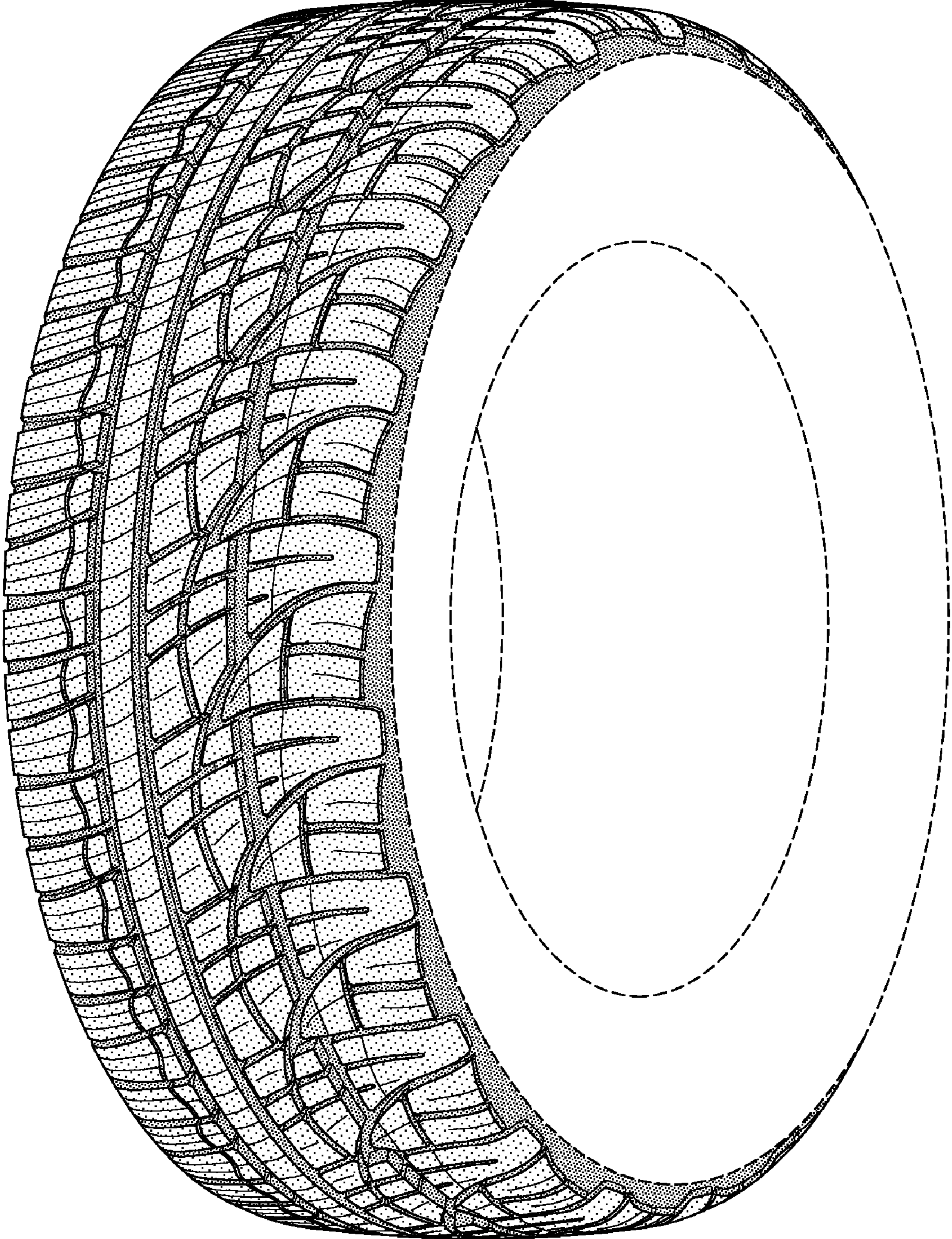

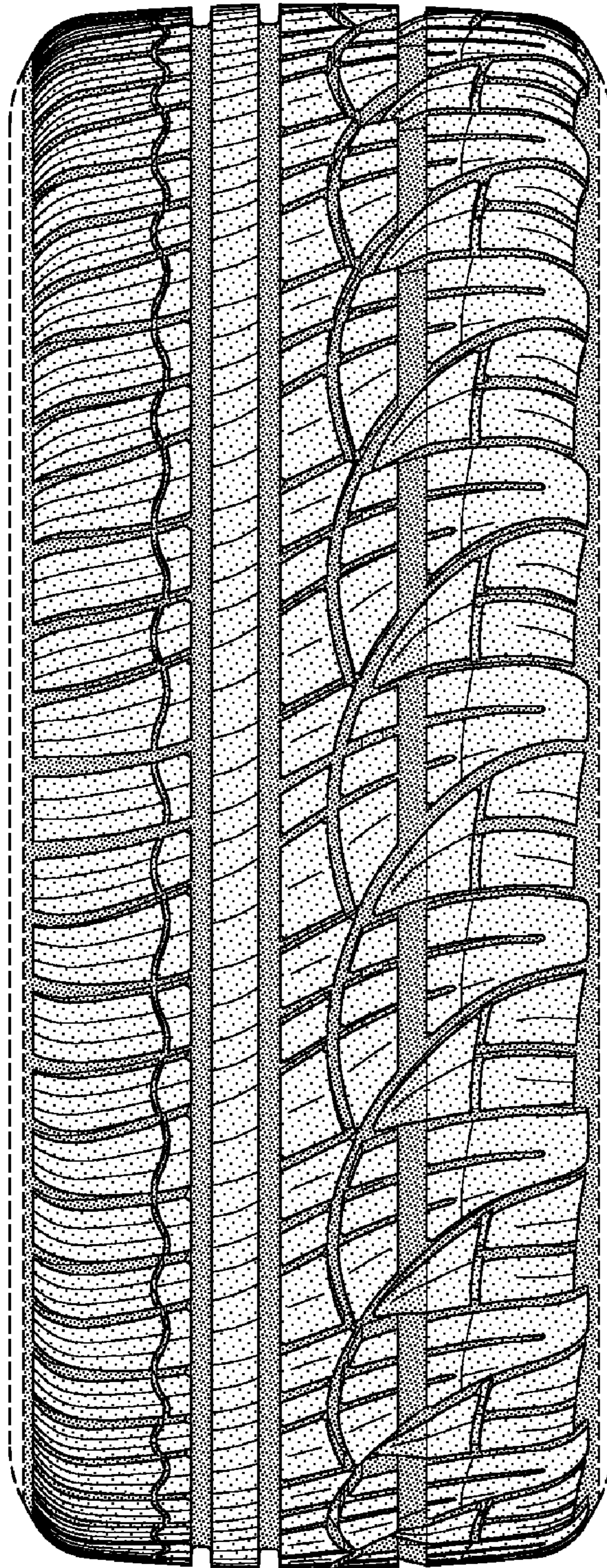

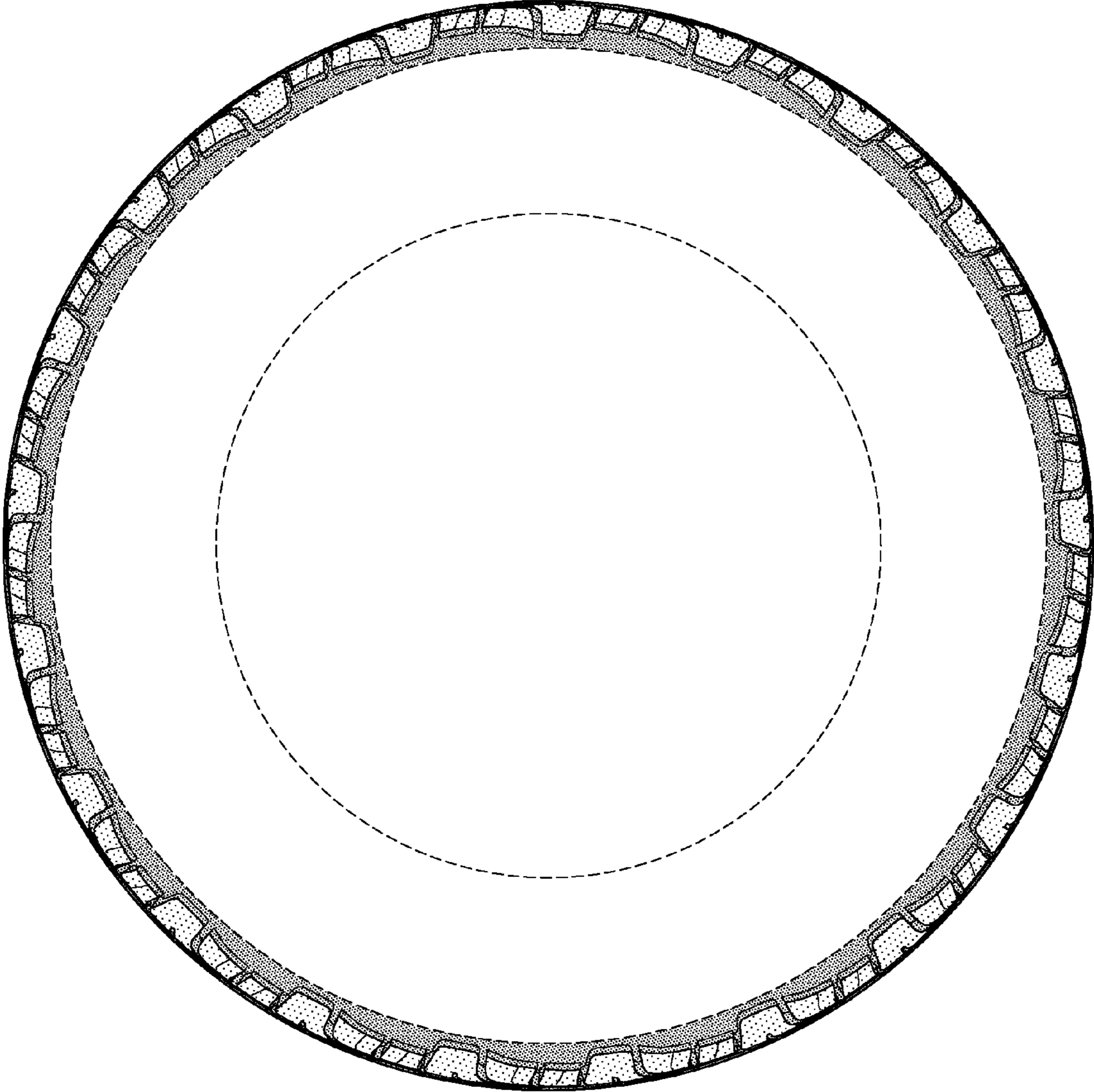

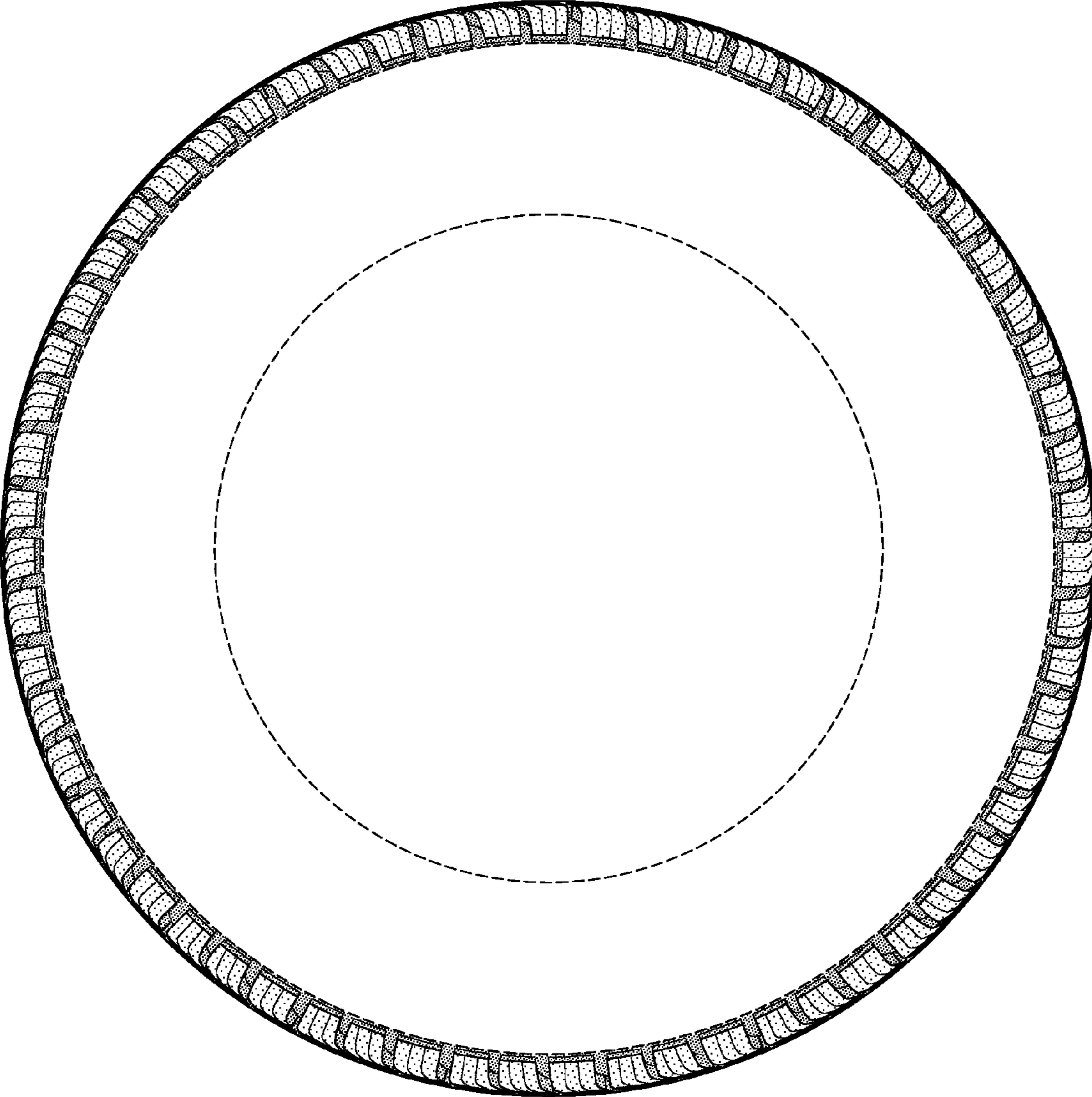

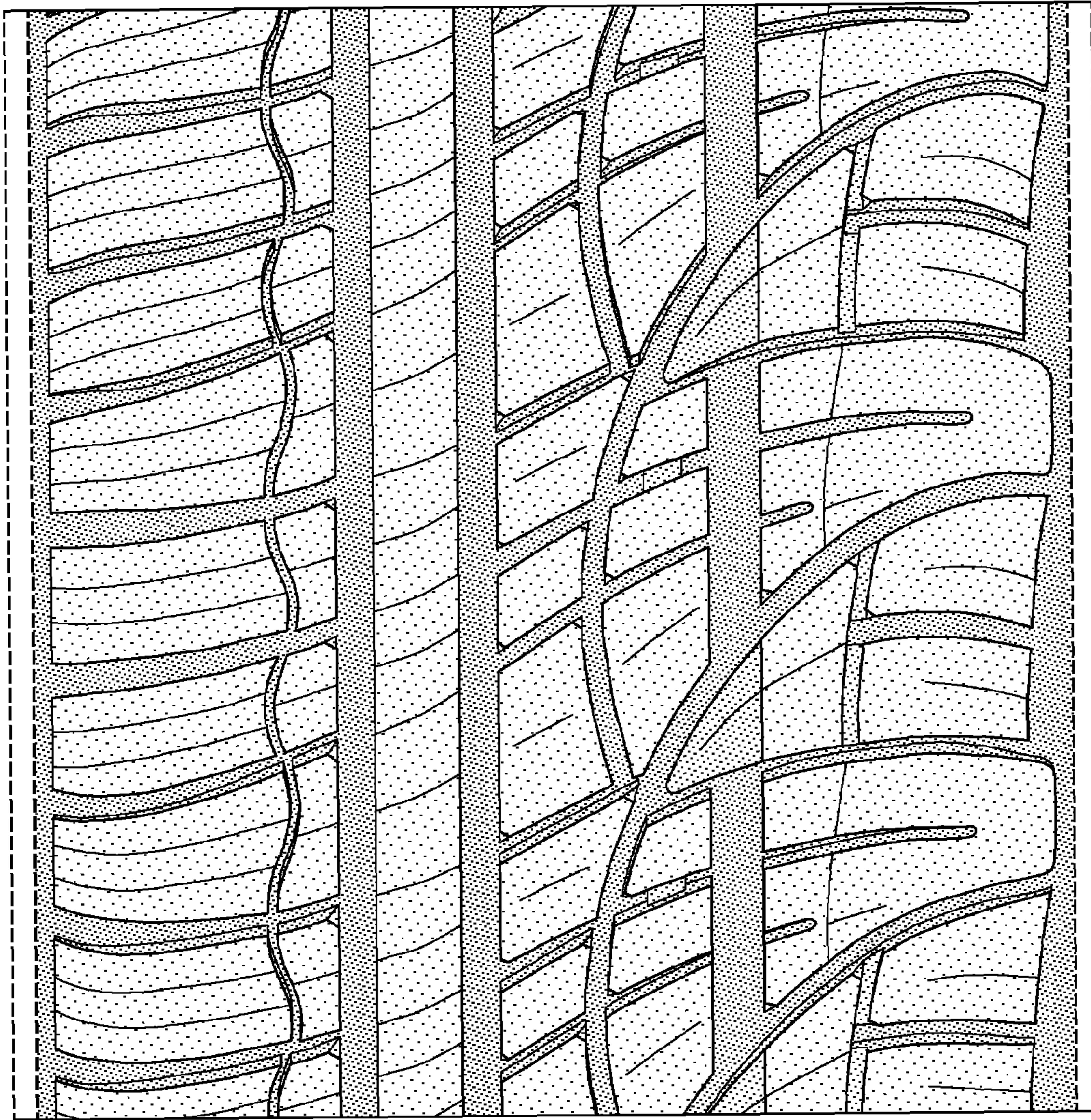

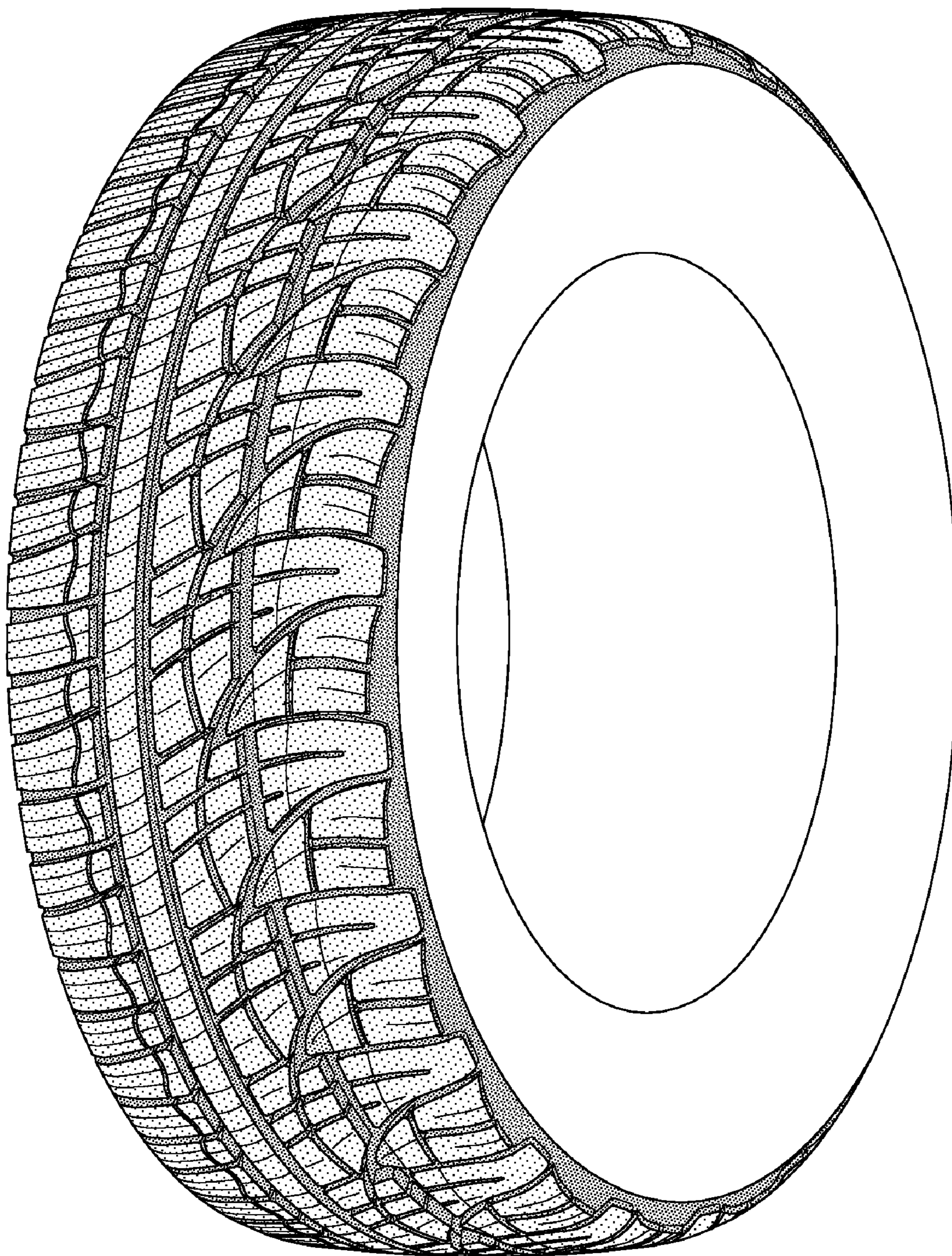

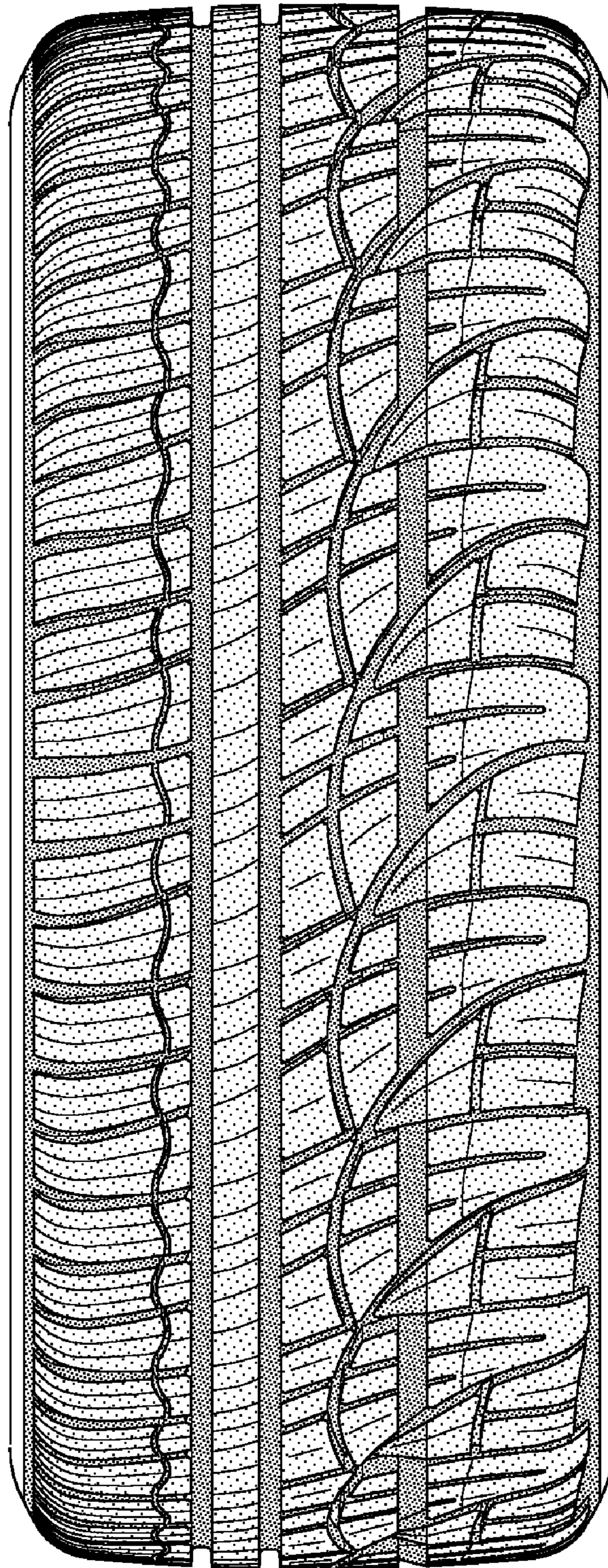
