FIG. 1 is a top view of a pole bracket showing the design;

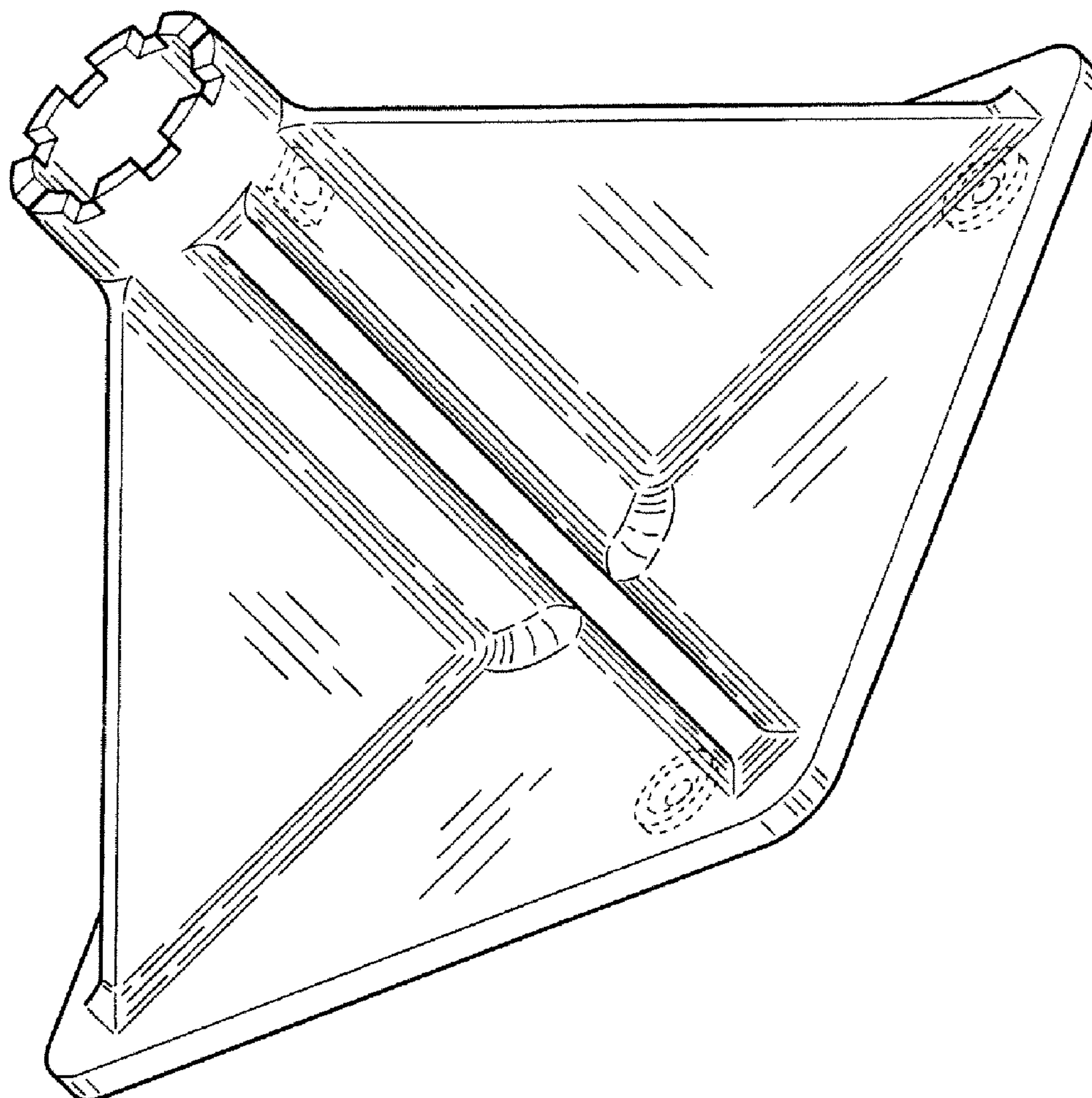
FIG. 2 is a side view of the pole bracket of FIG. 1;

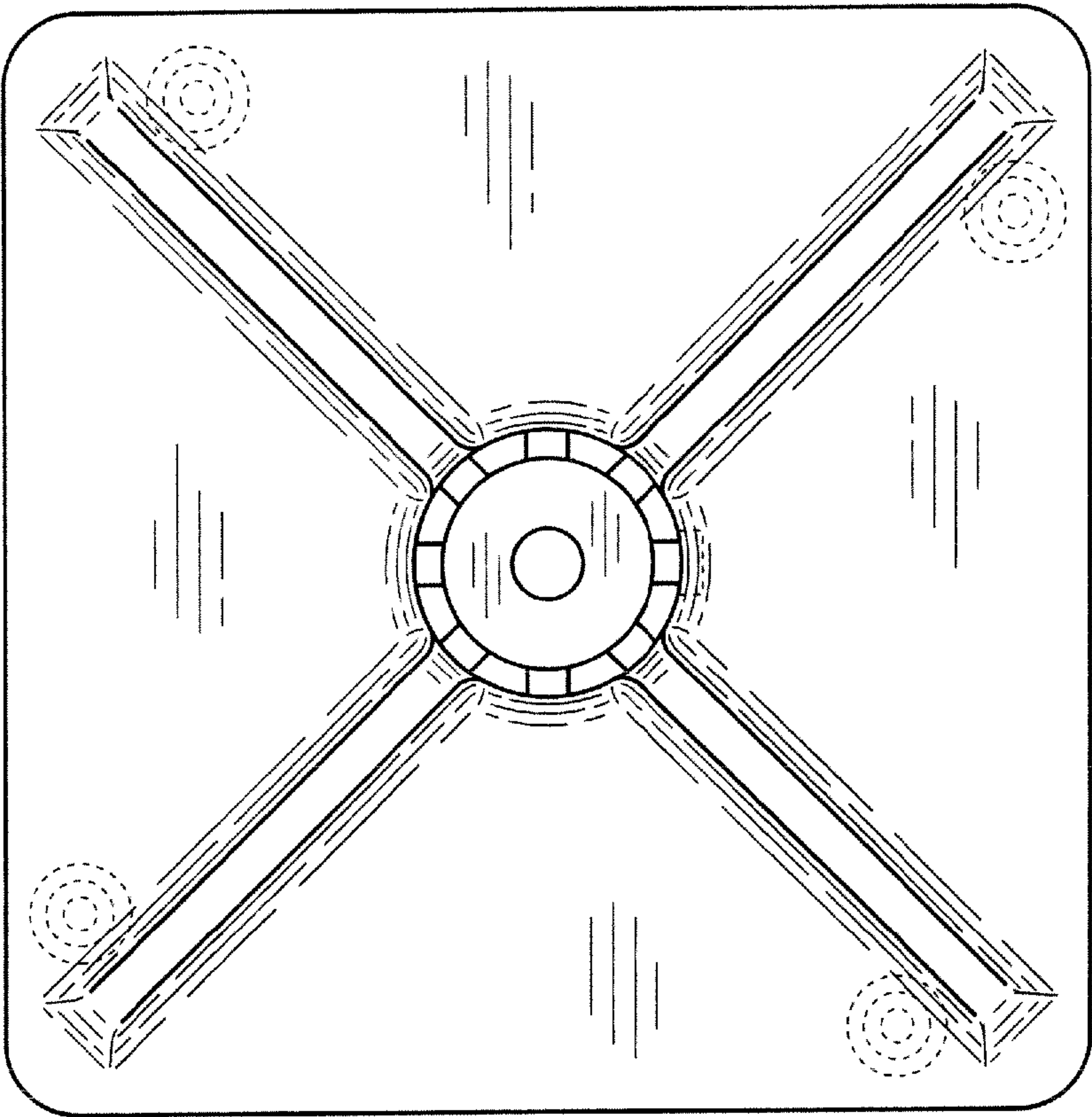

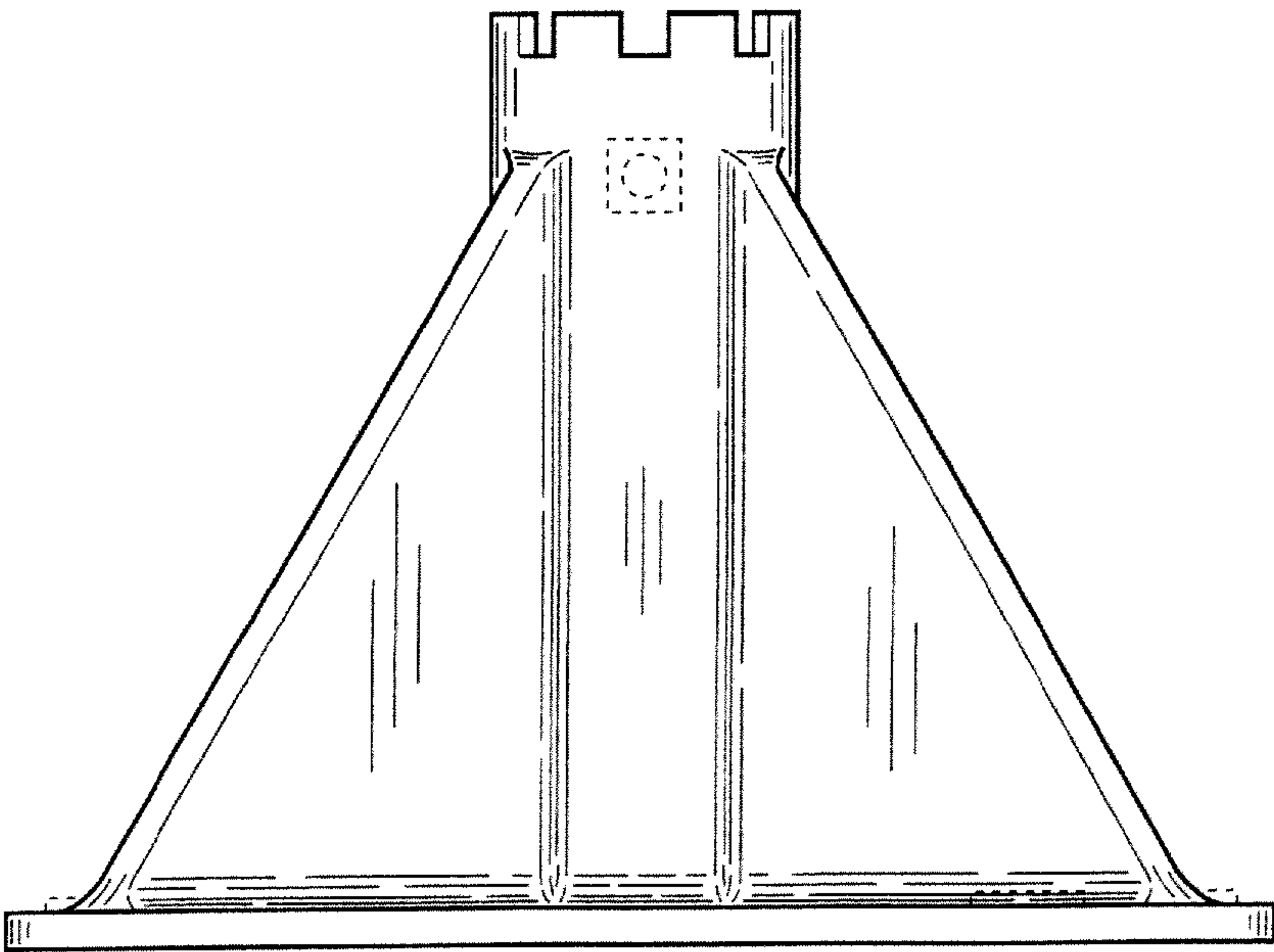

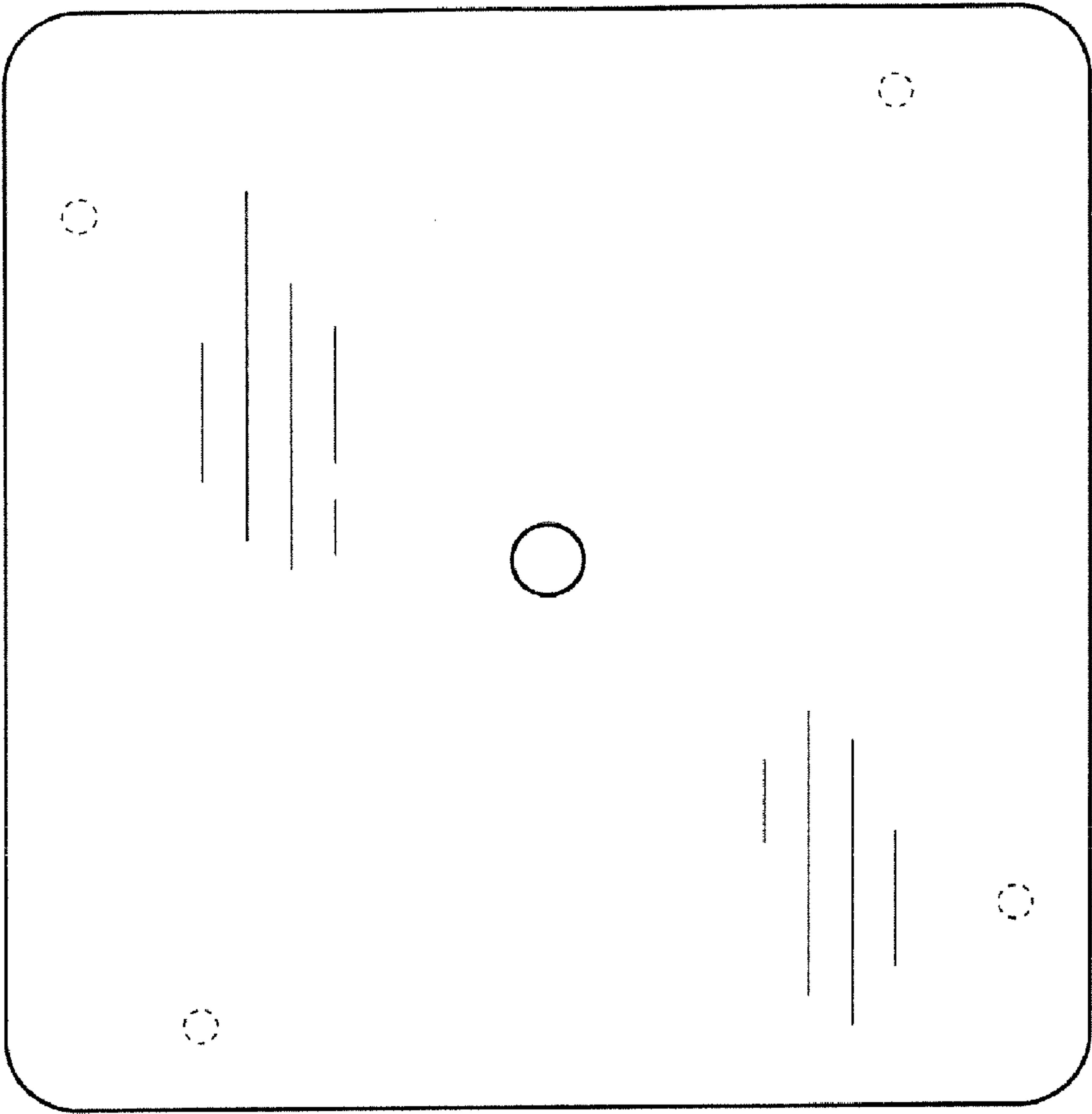

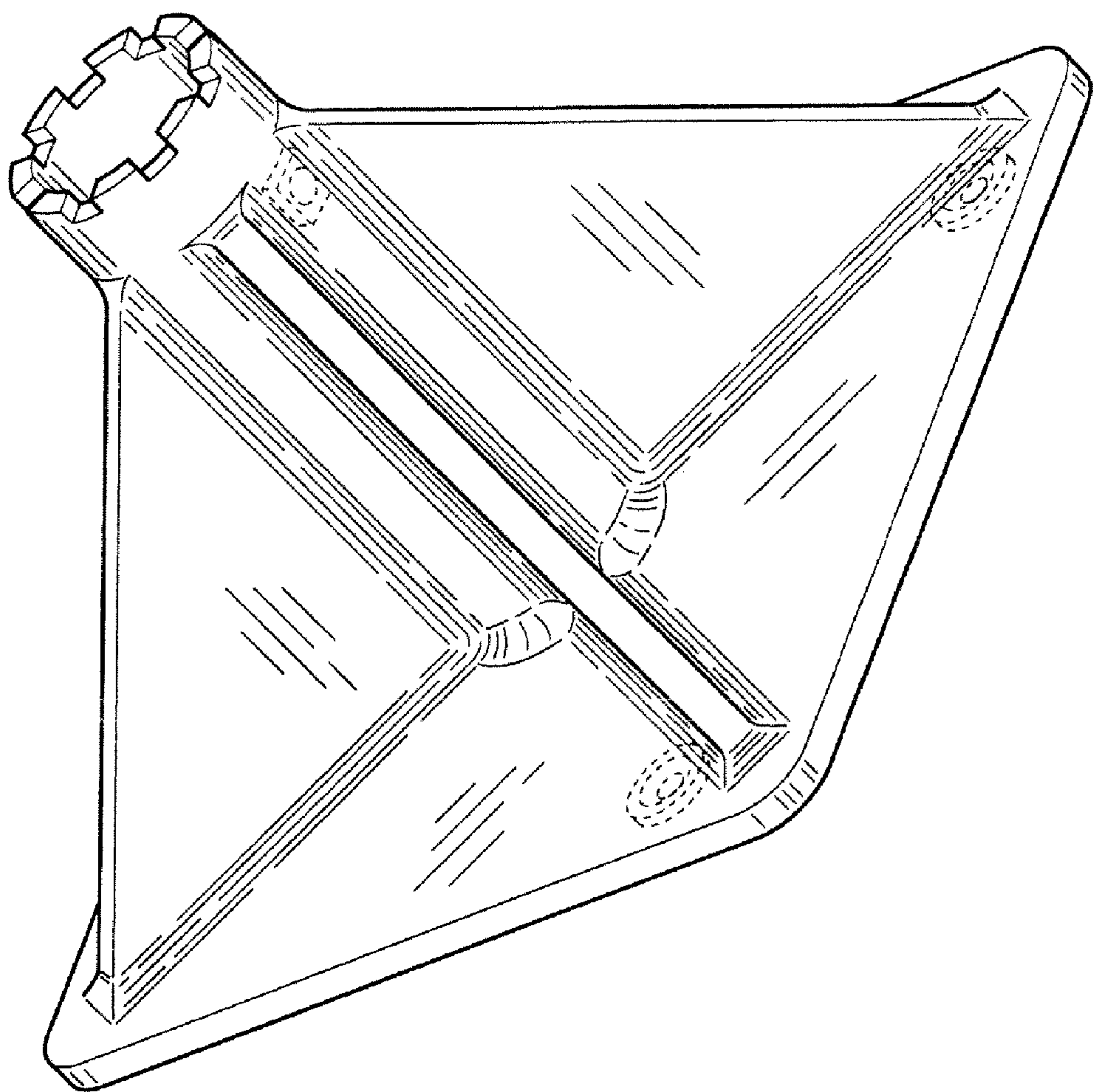
