(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a batter's helmet, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a batter's helmet in accordance with the design of the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the batter's helmet of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view of the batter's helmet of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a right-side elevational view of the batter's helmet of FIG. 1;

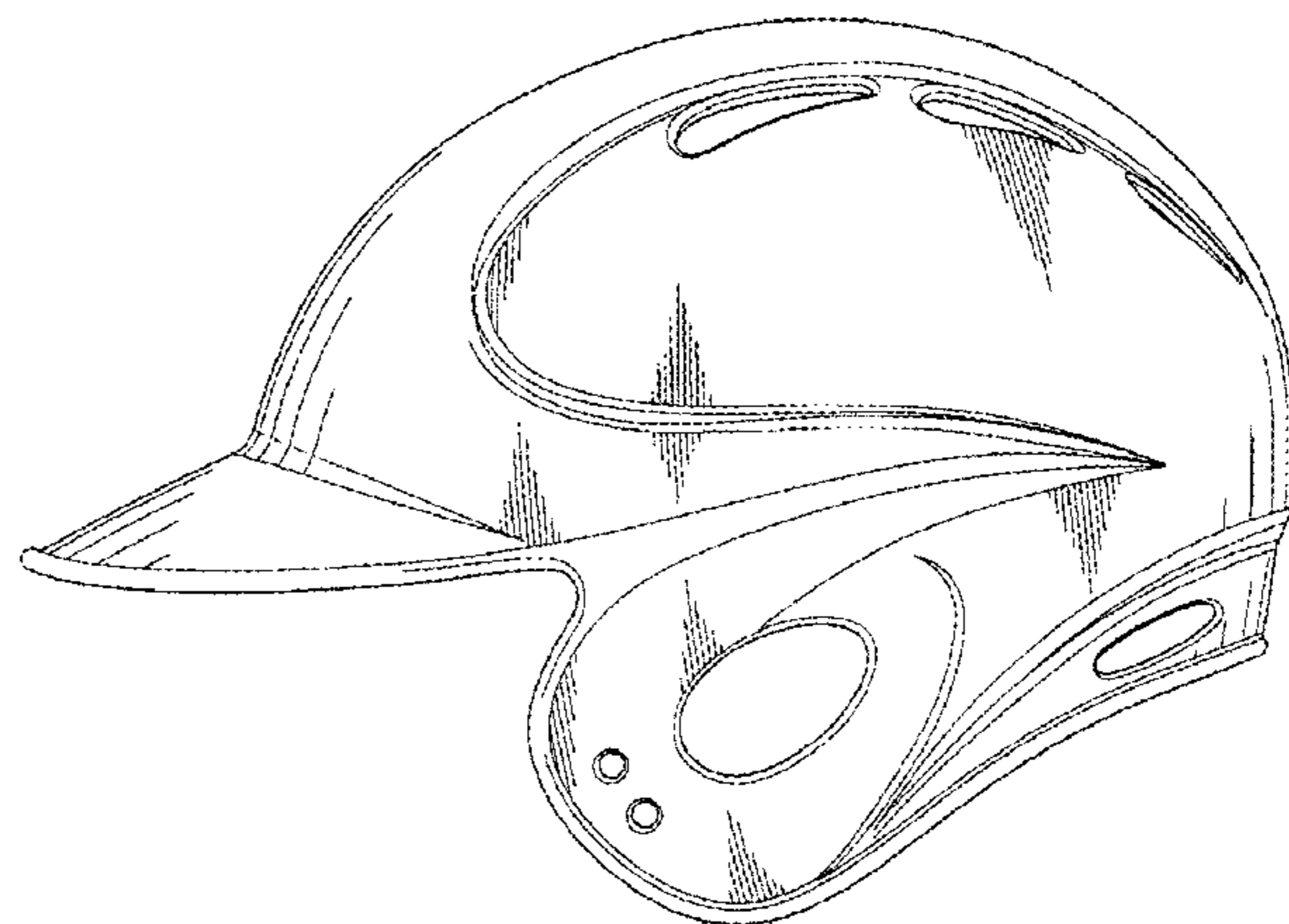
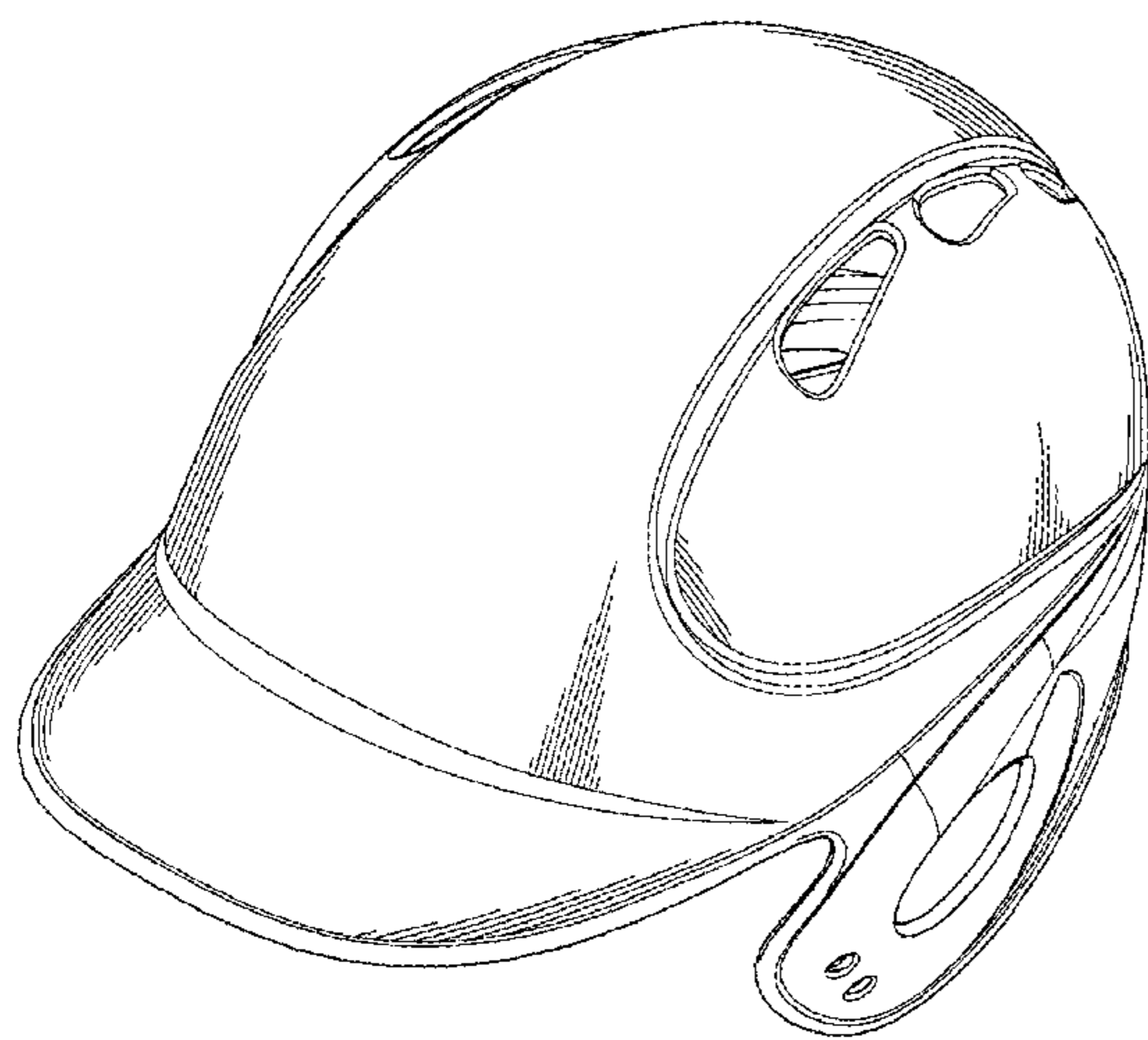
FIG. 5 is a left-side elevational view of the batter's helmet of FIG. 1;

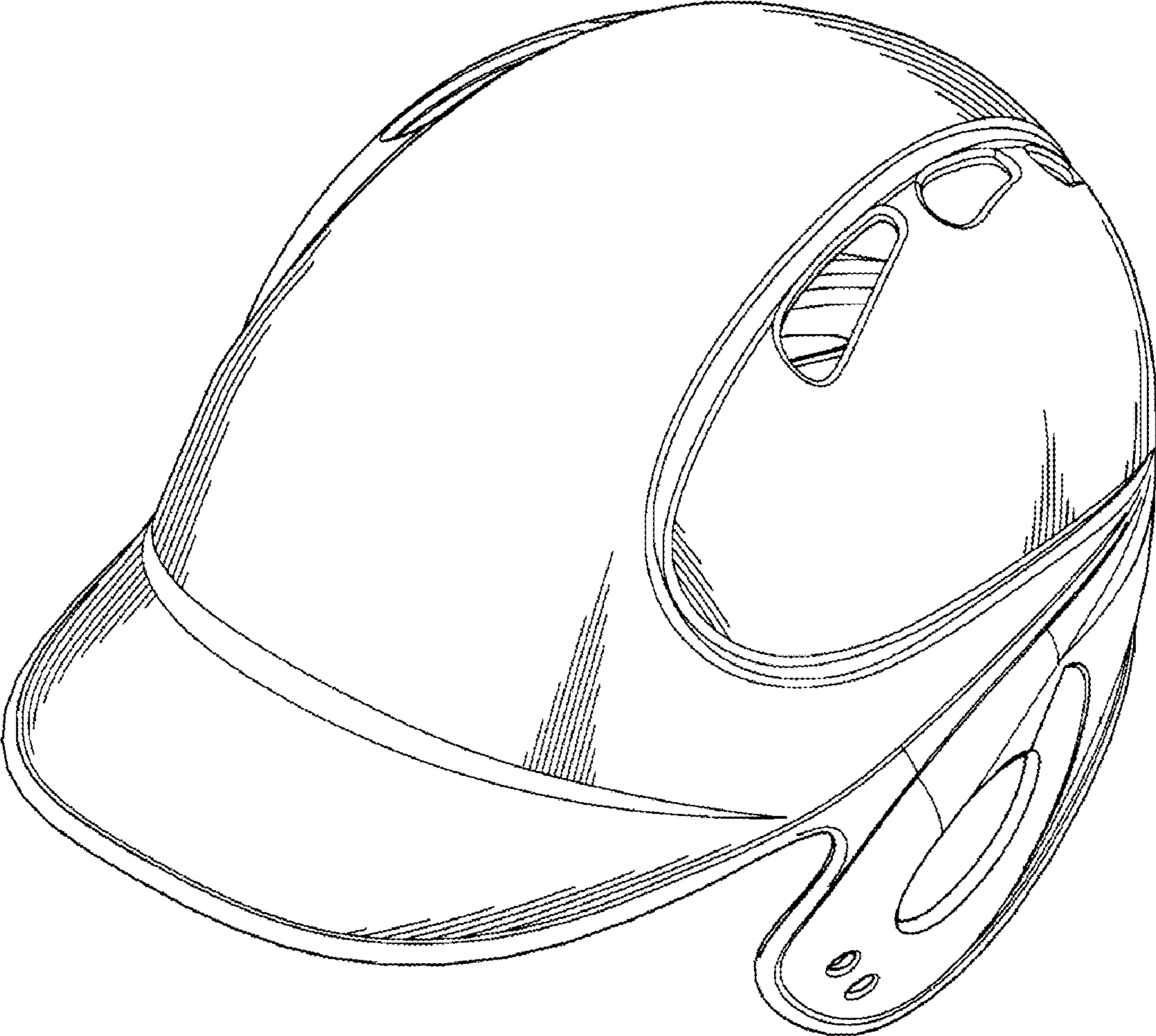

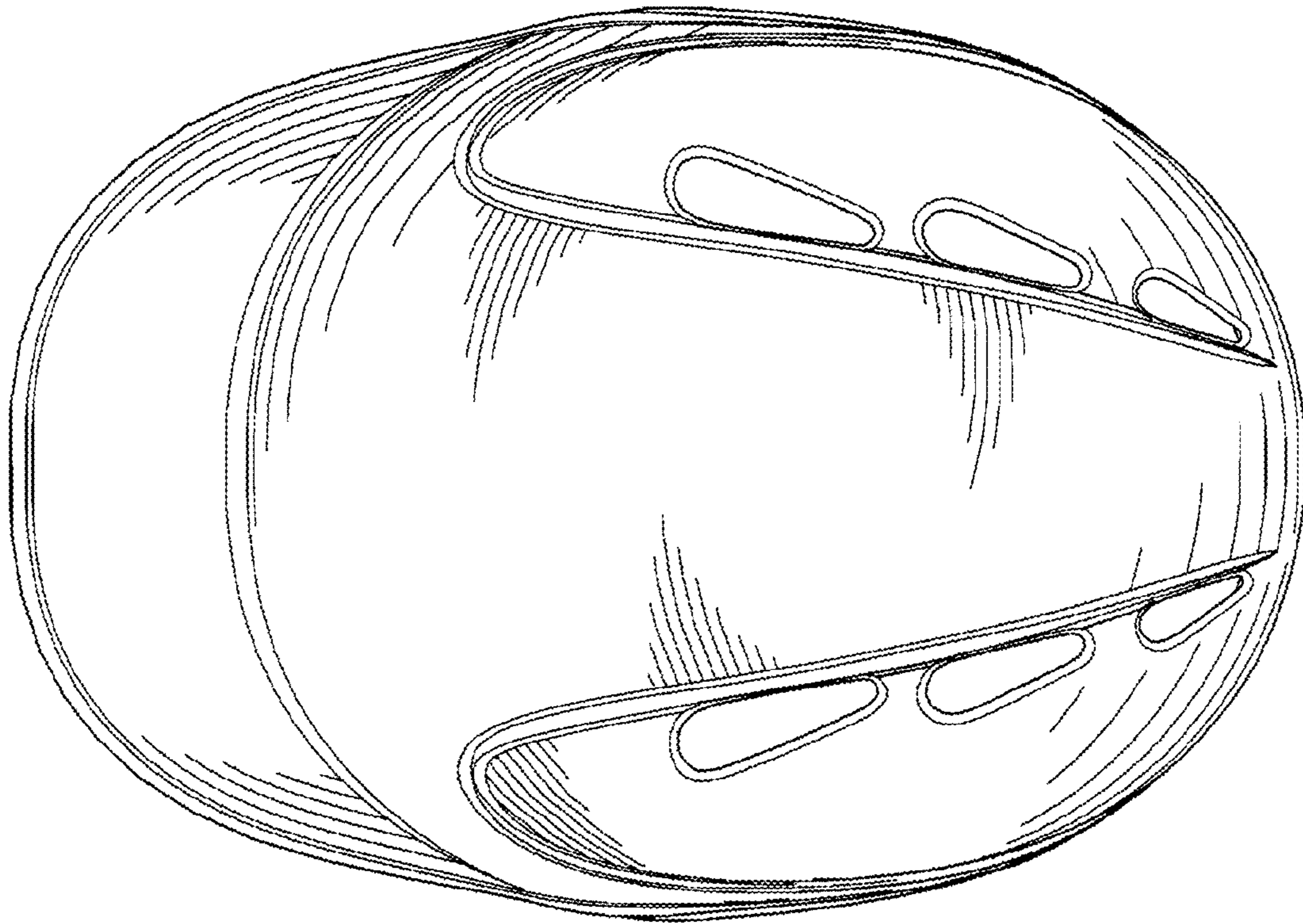

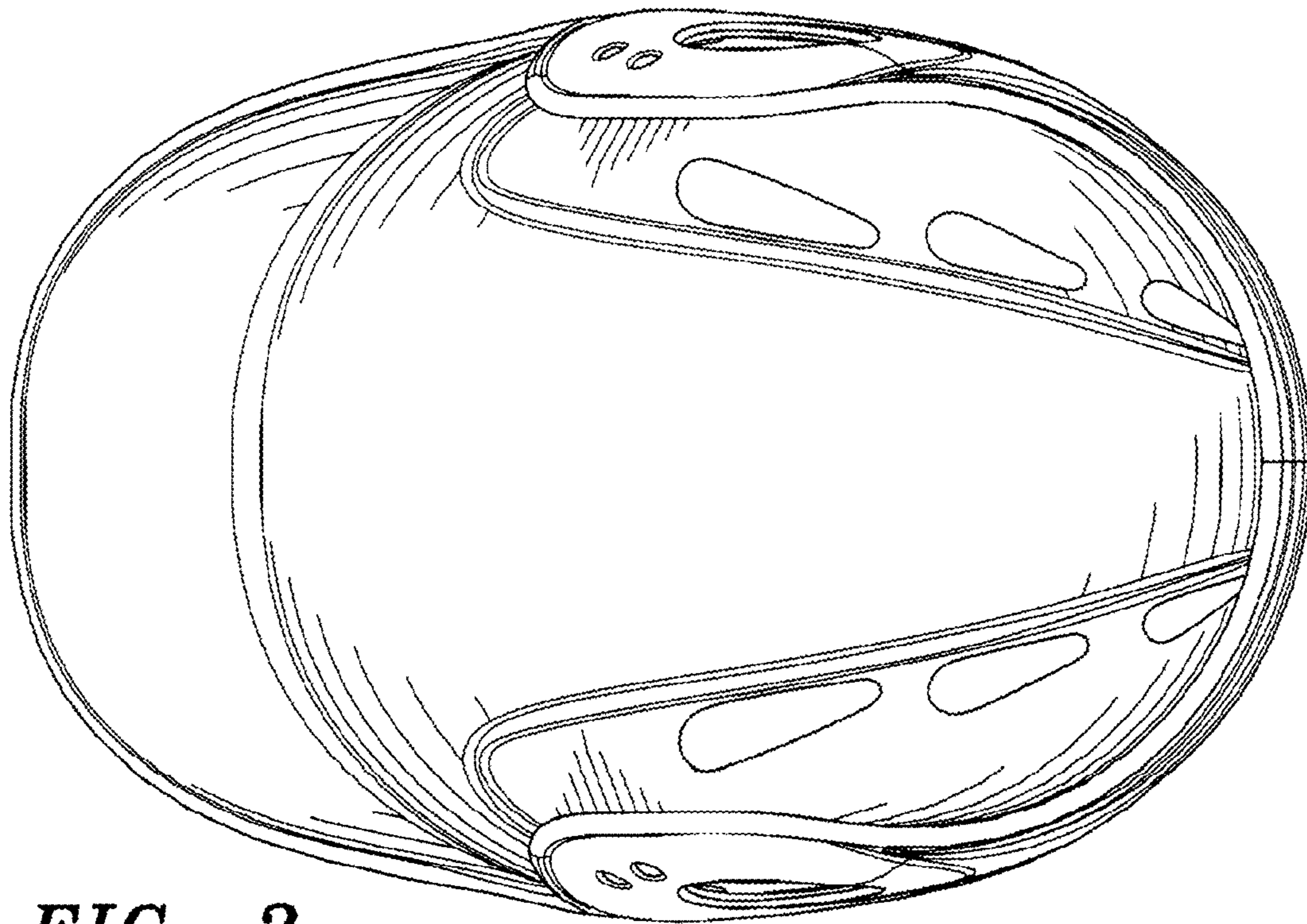

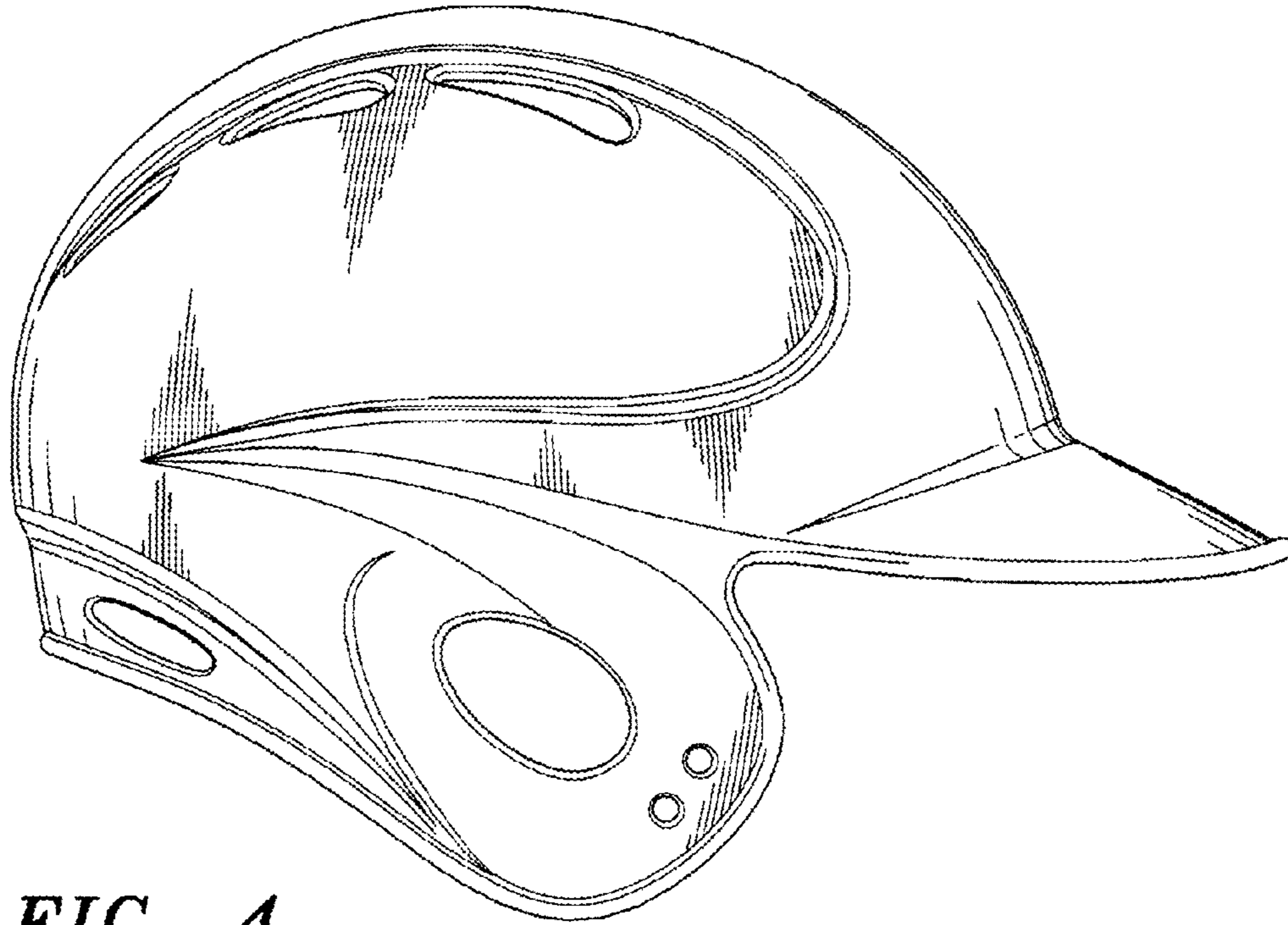

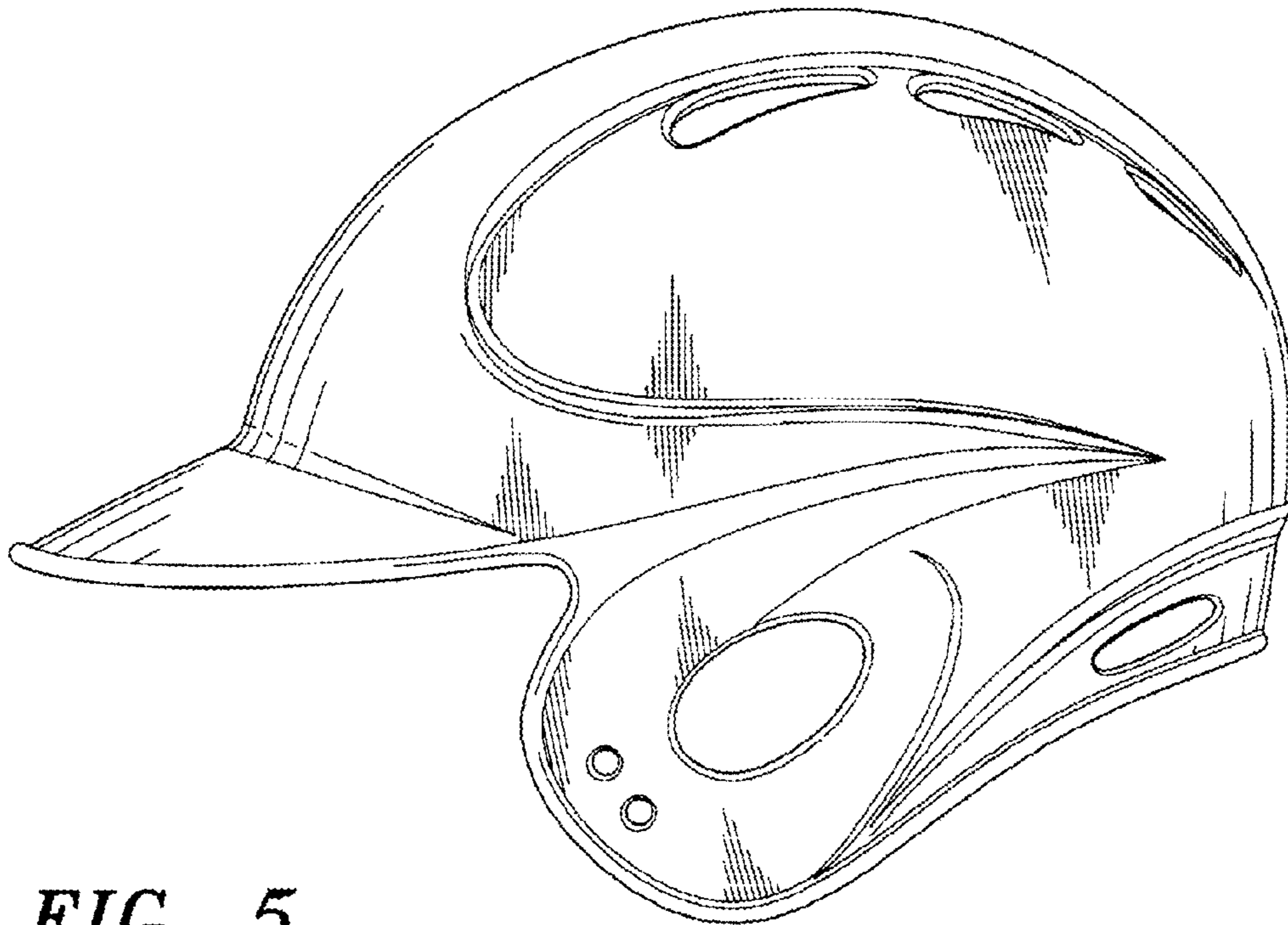

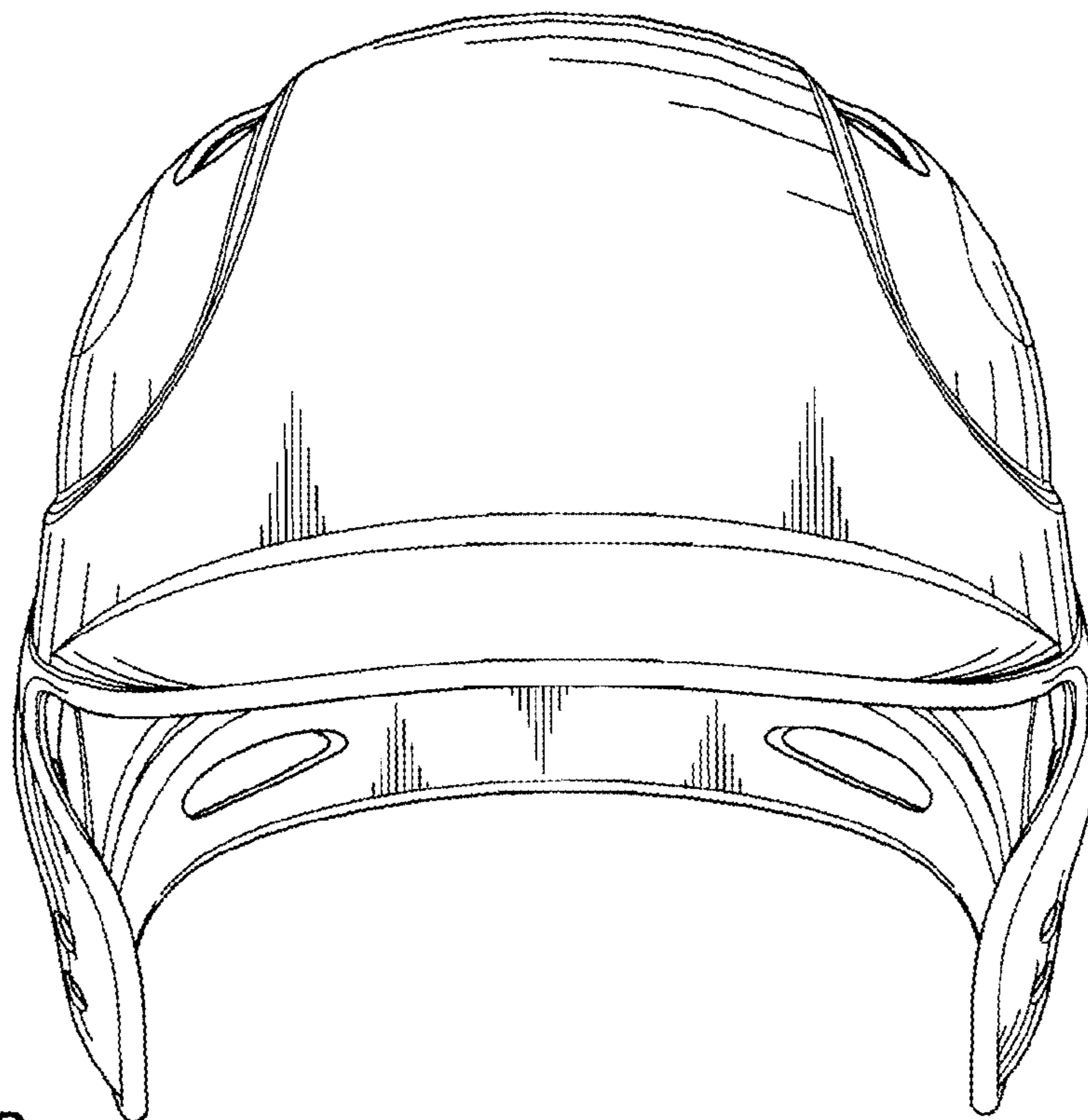

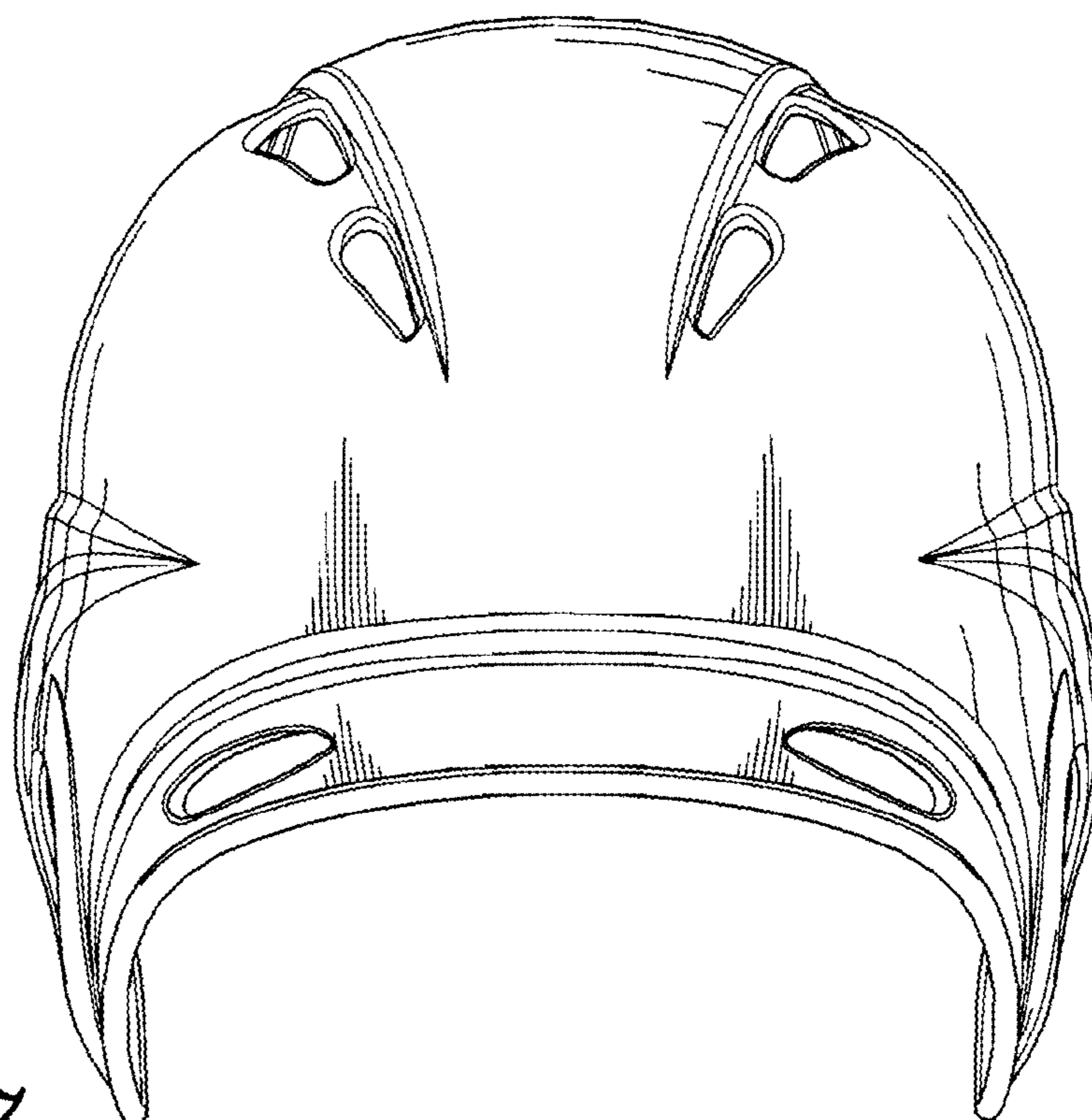
