FIG. 4 is a left side view.

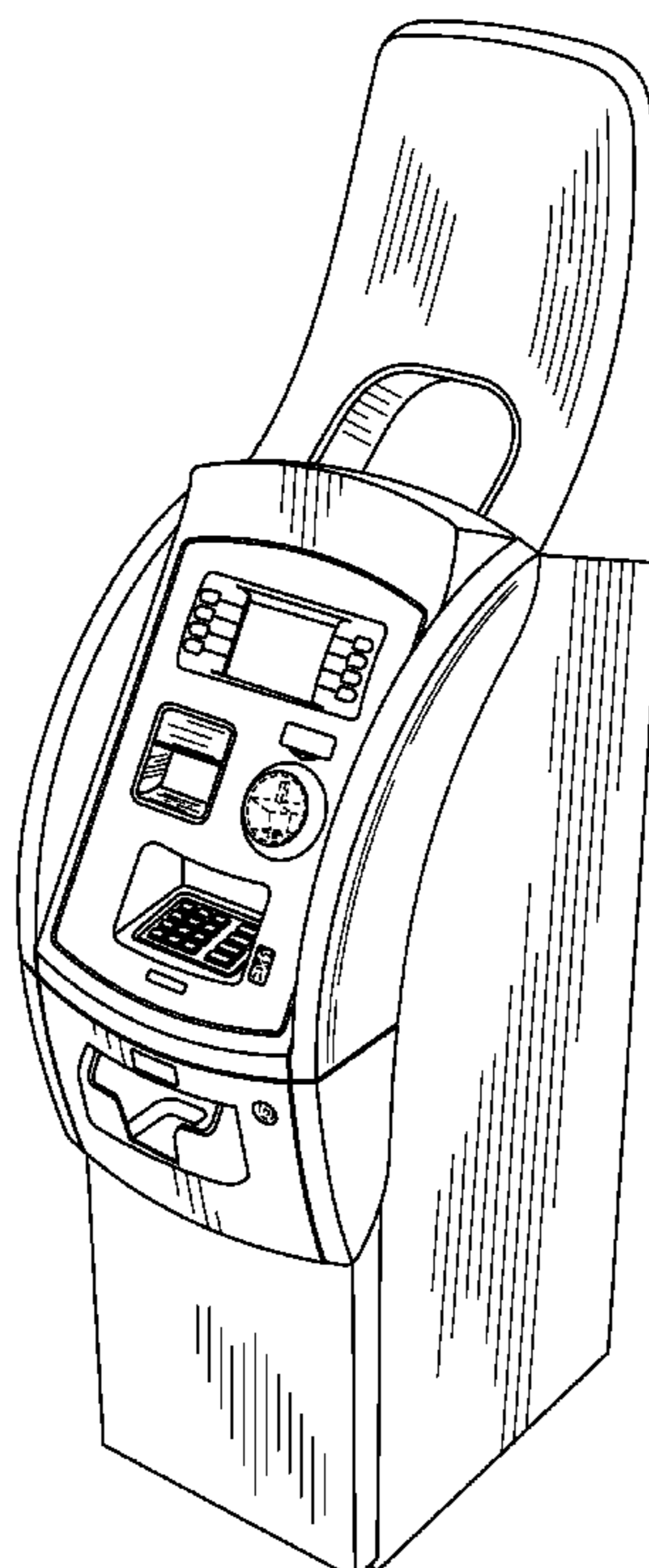
FIG. 5 is a right side view.

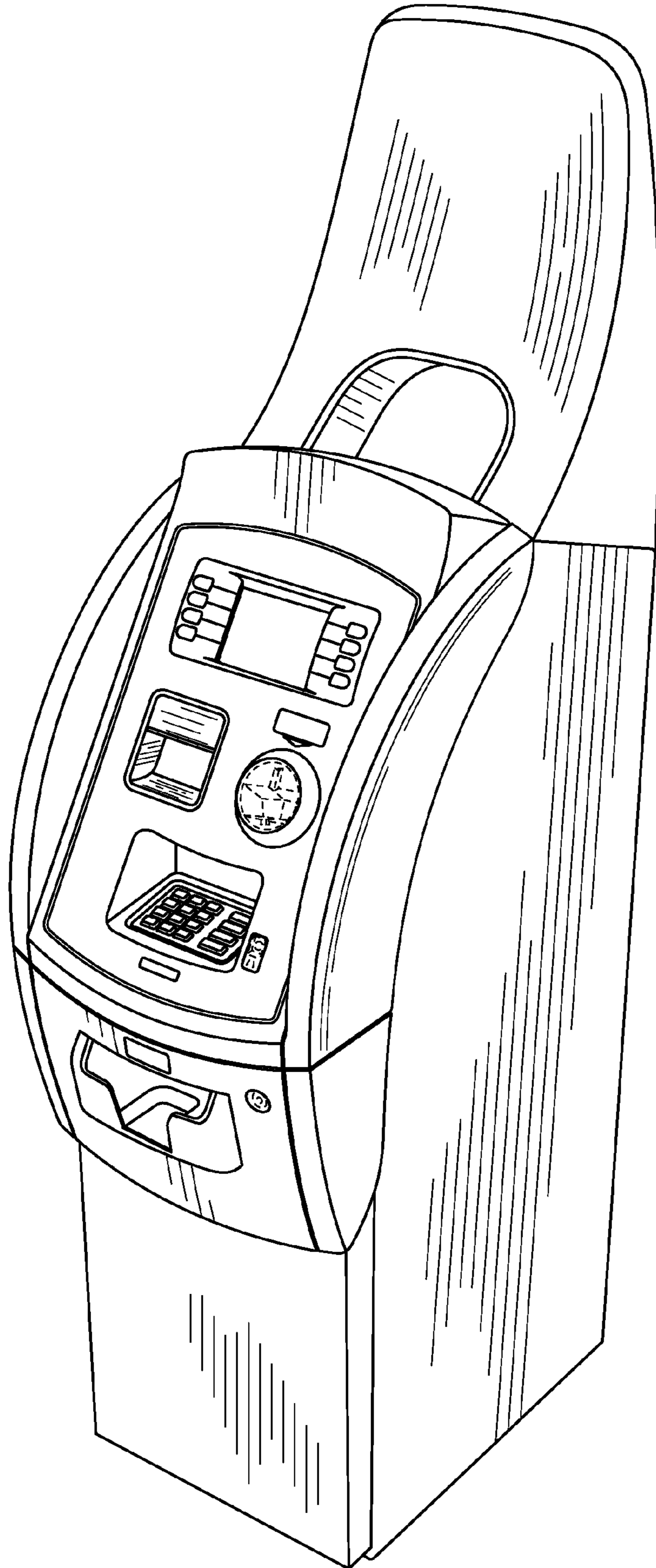

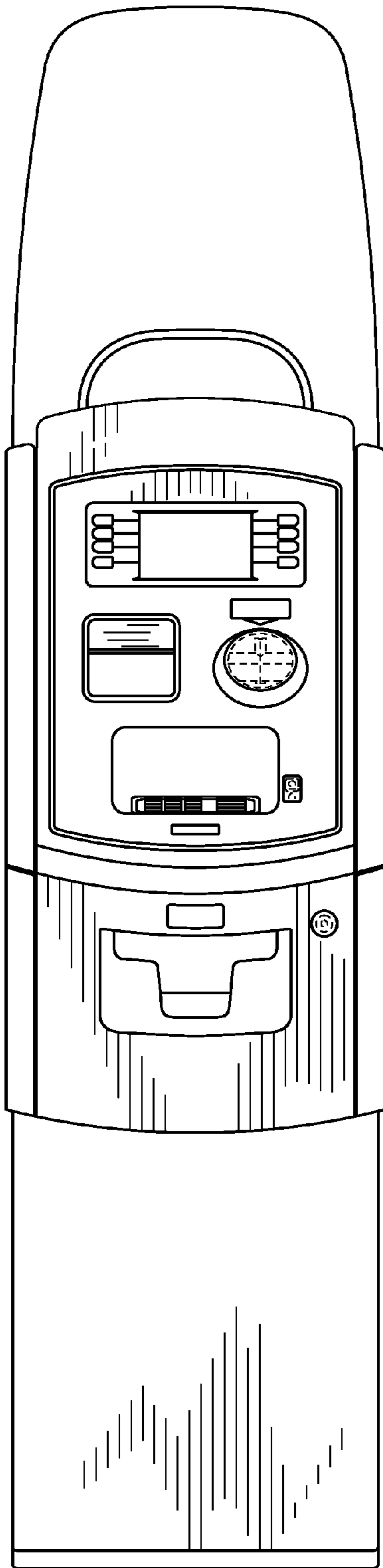

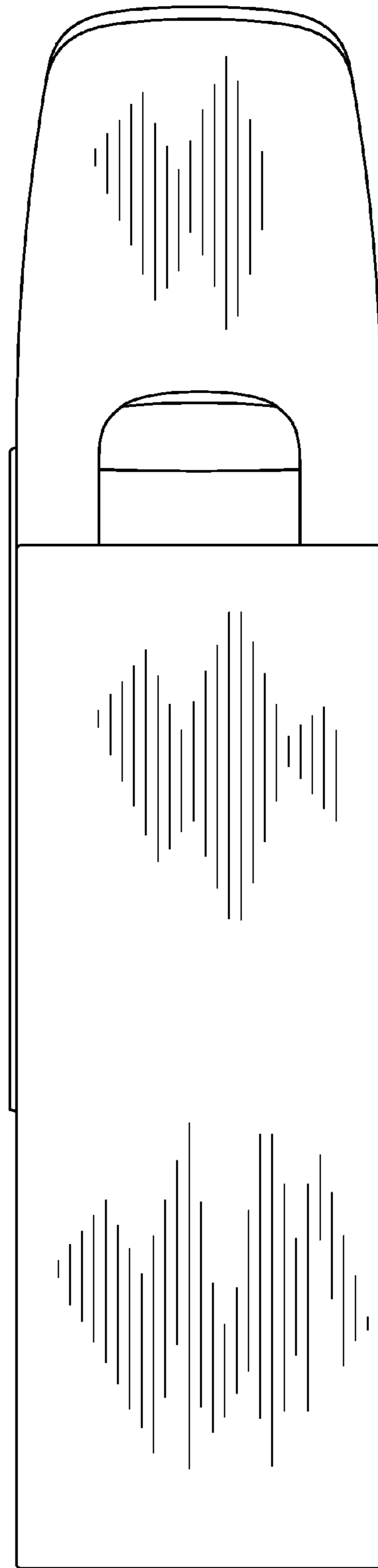

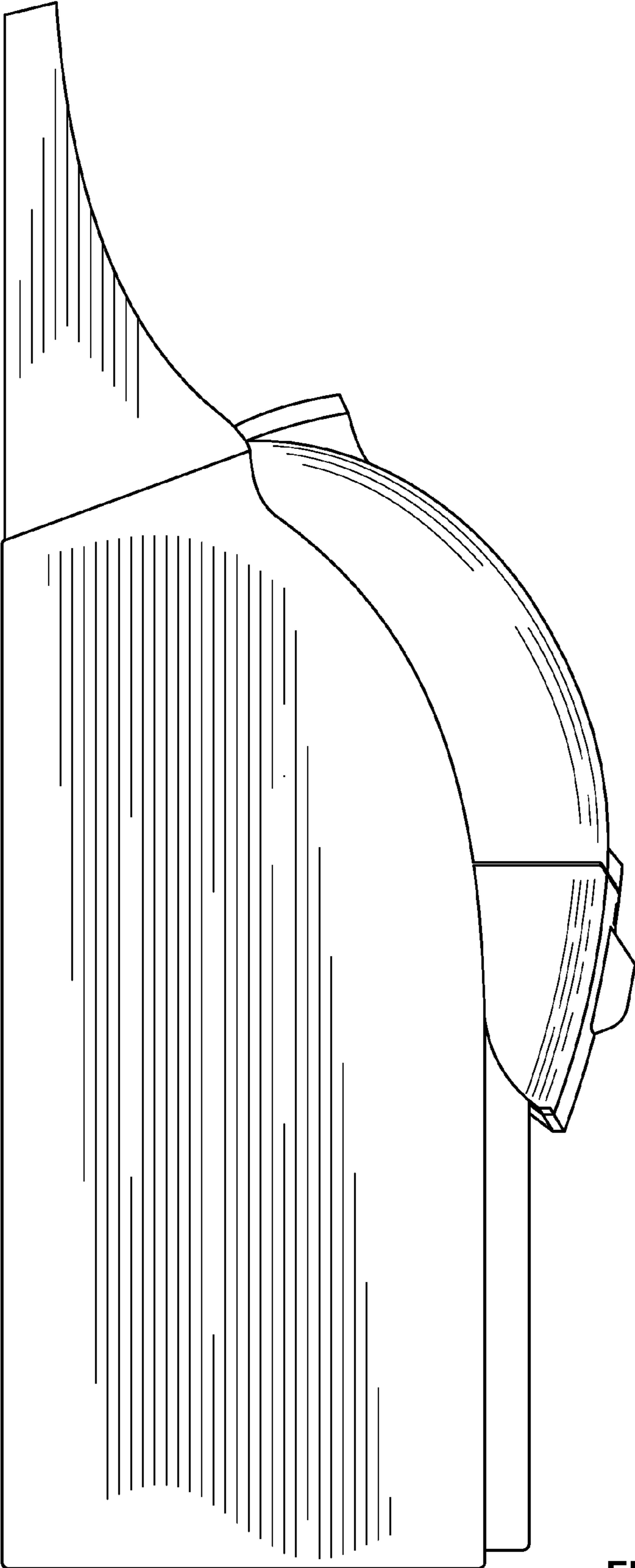

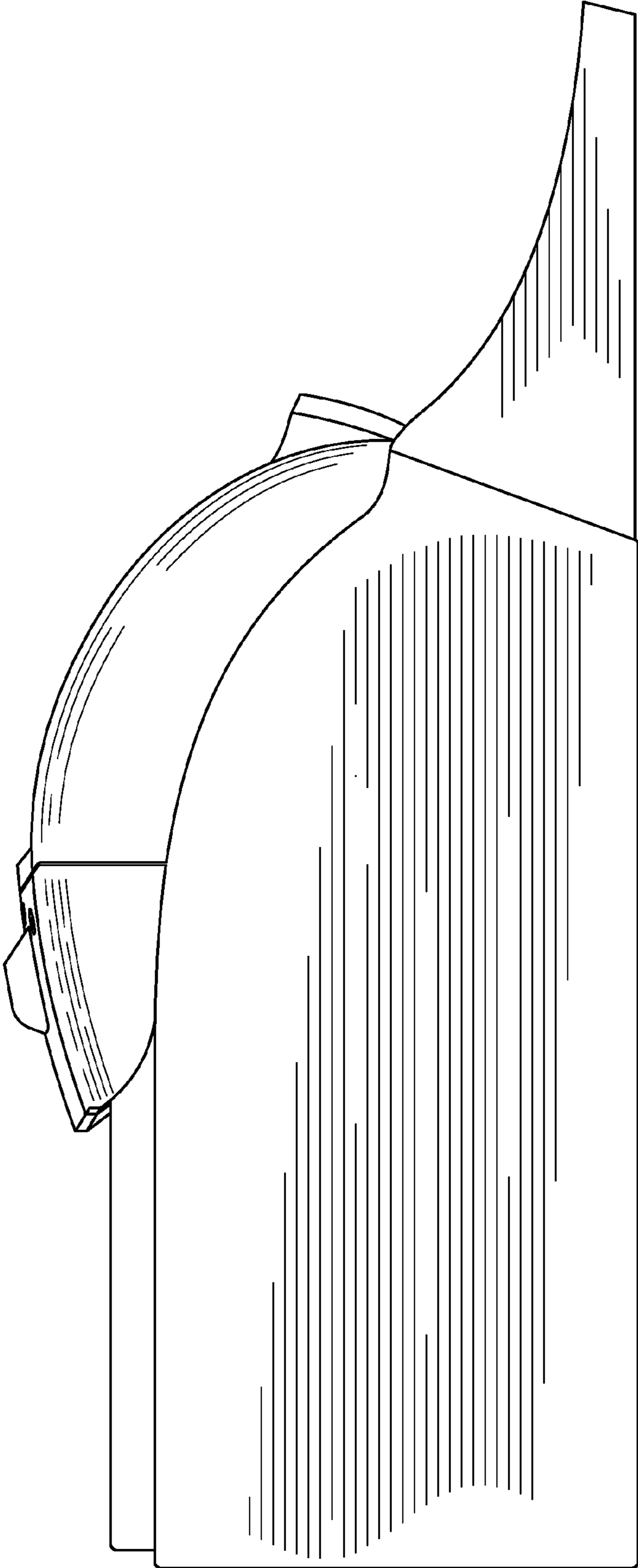

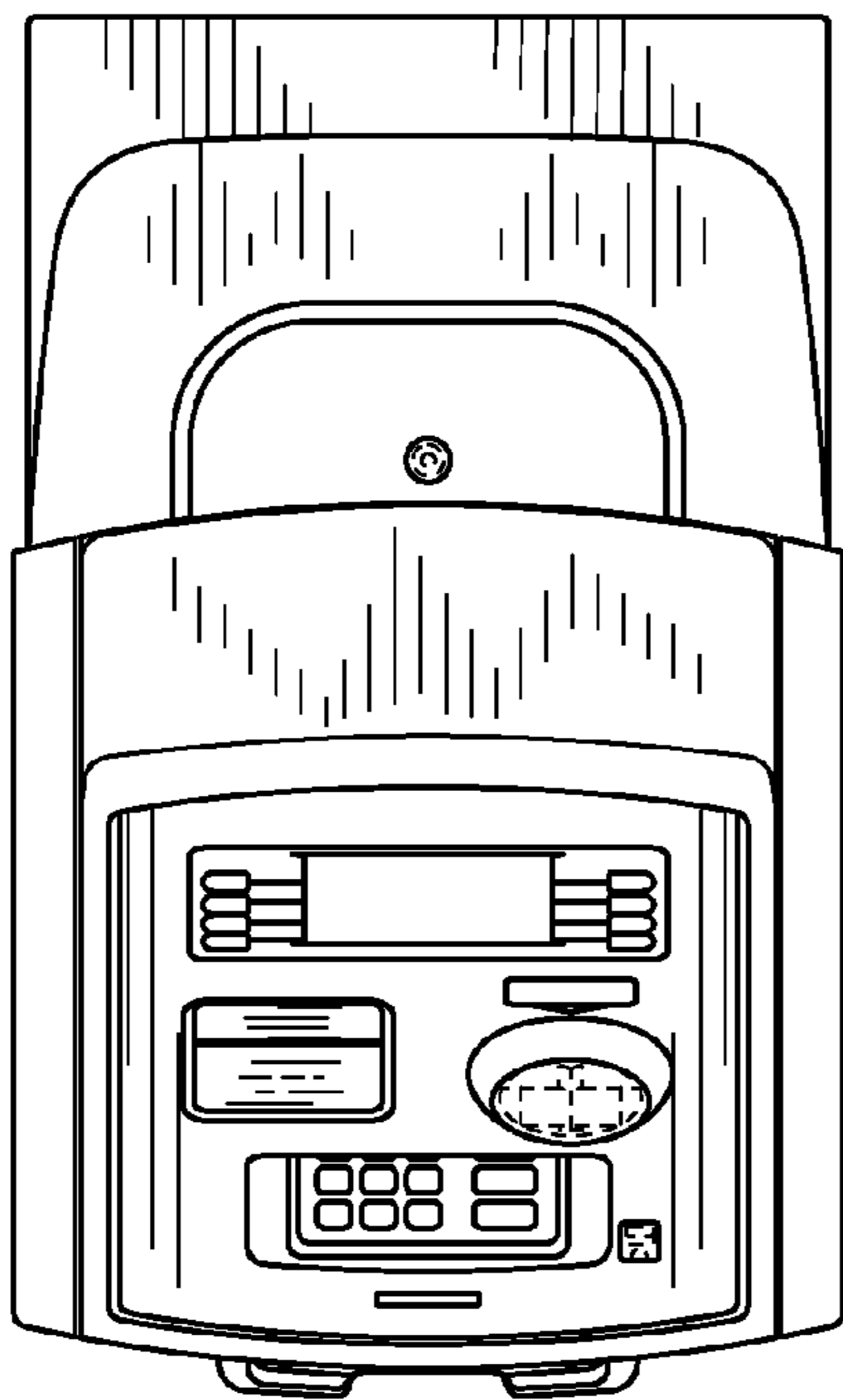

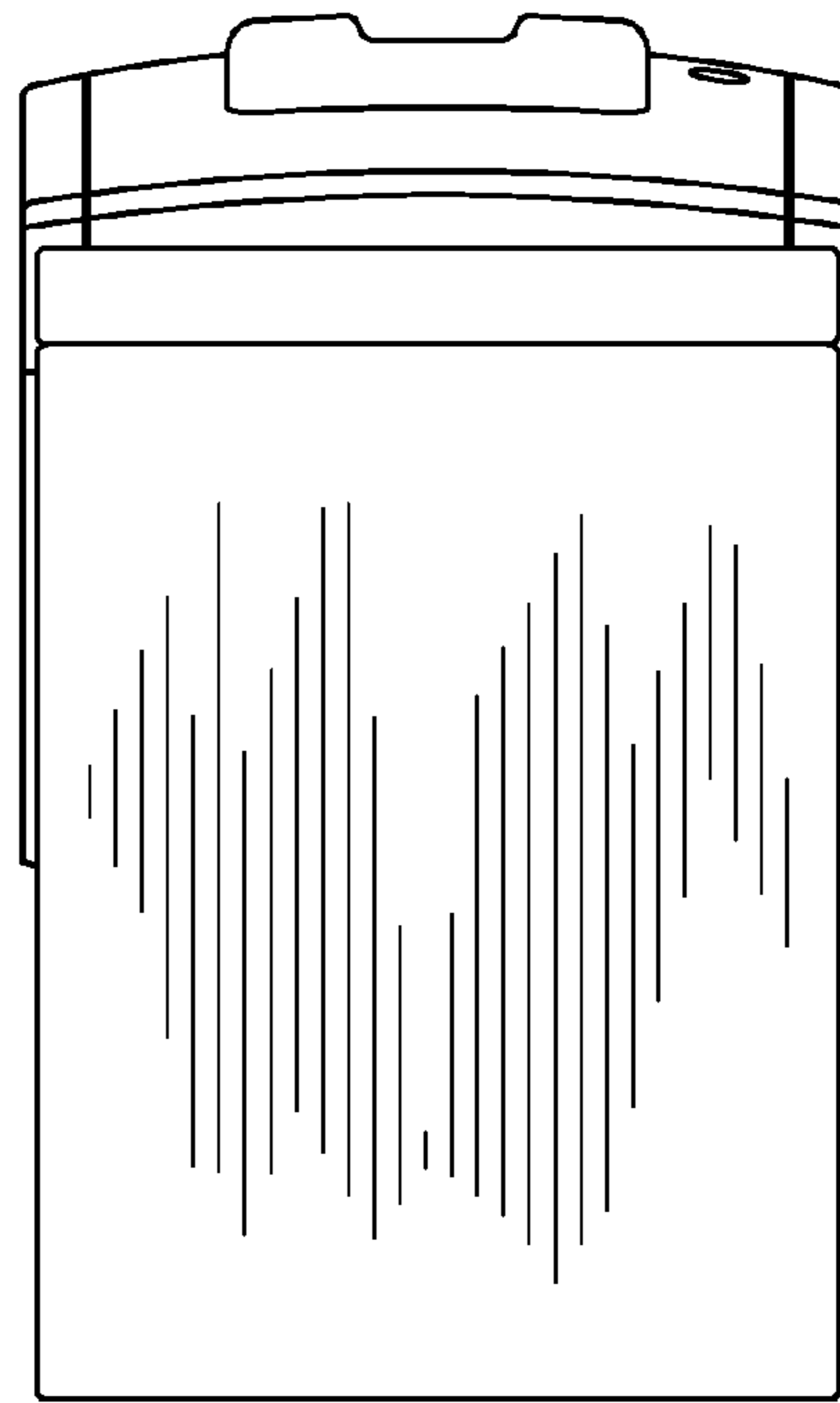
