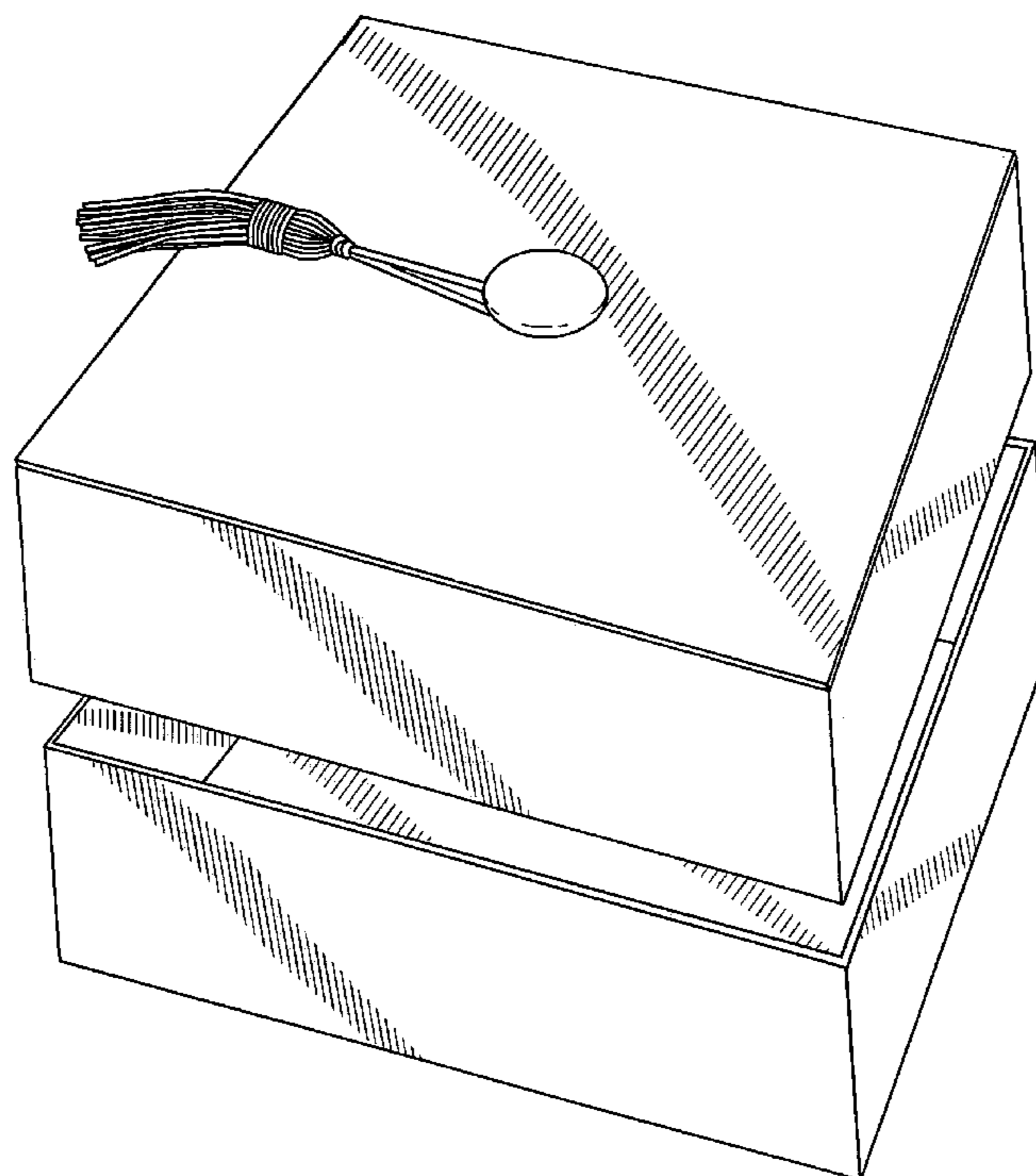
FIG. 5 is a lateral view of a second side of the embodiment of FIG. 1.

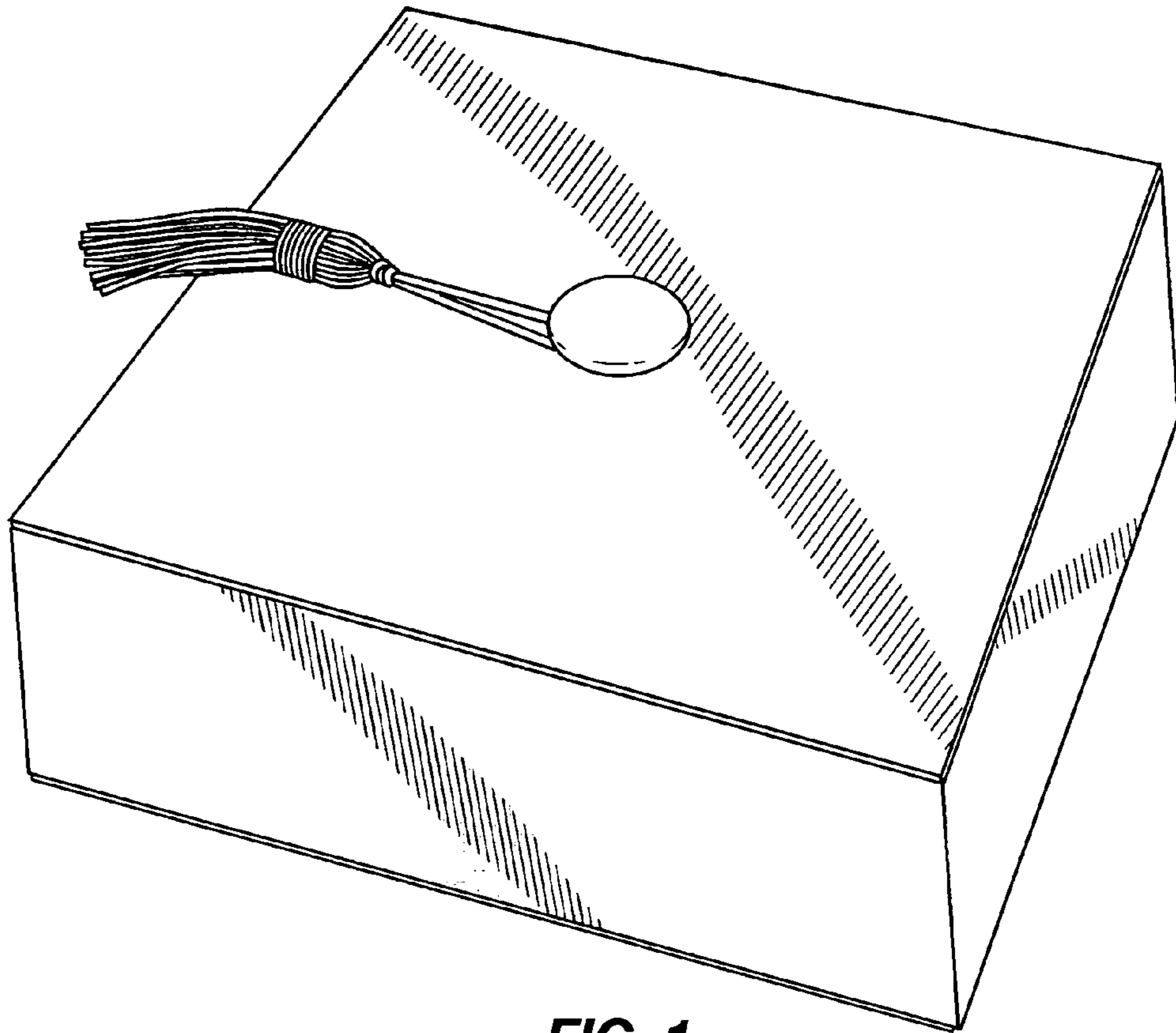
FIG. 6 is a lateral view of a third side of the embodiment of FIG. 1.

FIG. 7 is a lateral view of a fourth side of the embodiment of FIG. 1; and,

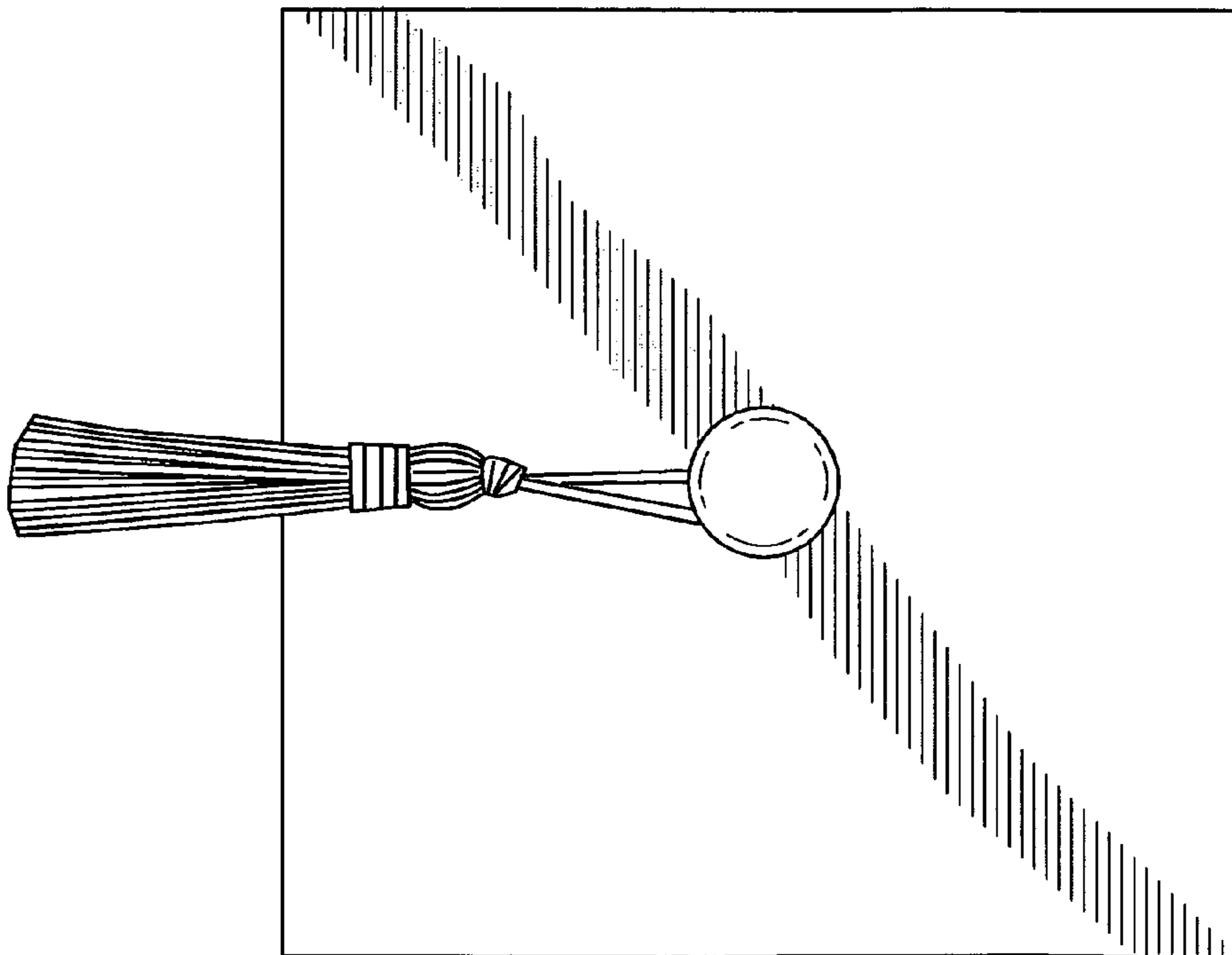
FIG. 8 is a perspective view of the embodiment of FIG. 1 with the graduation memorabilia box open.

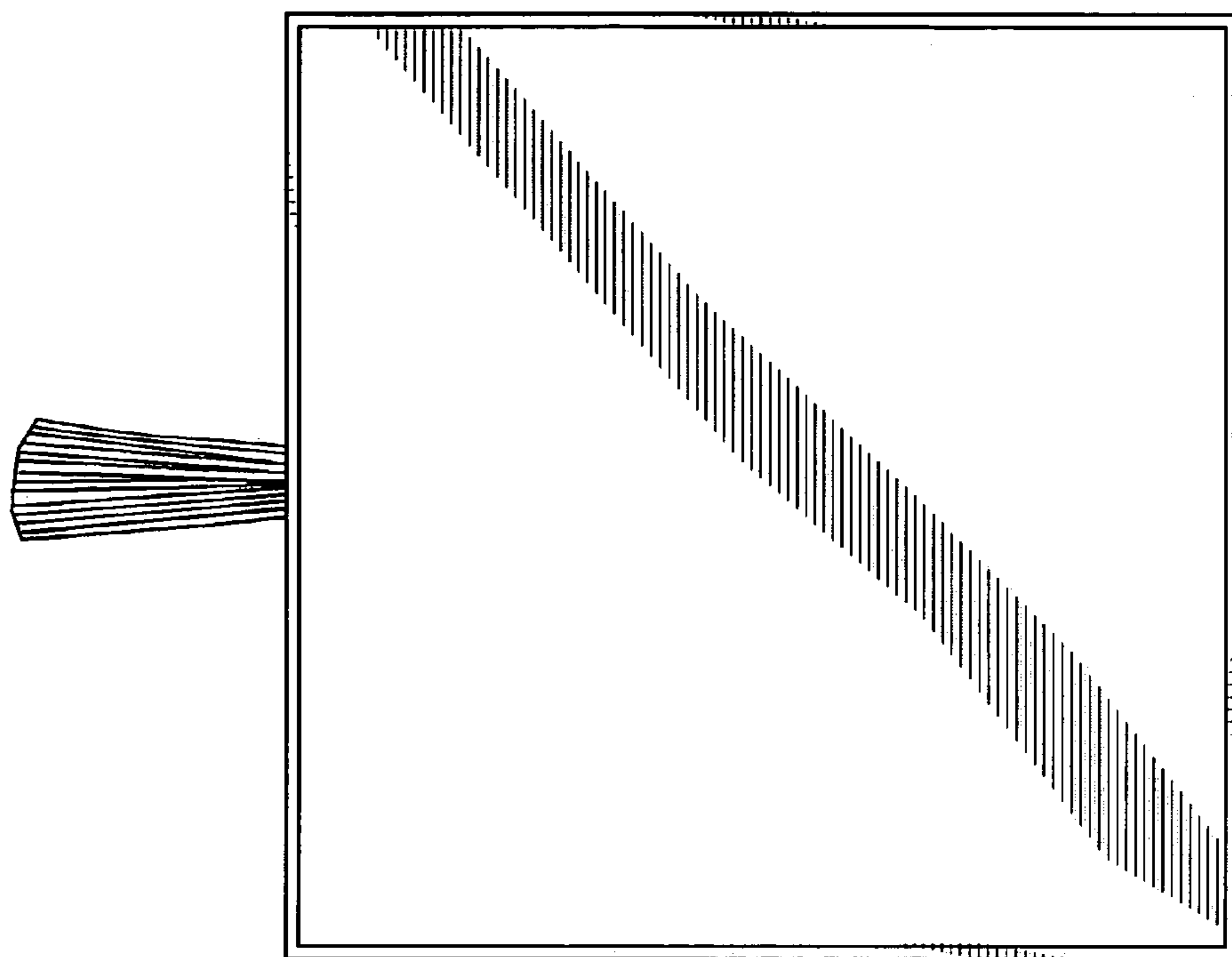




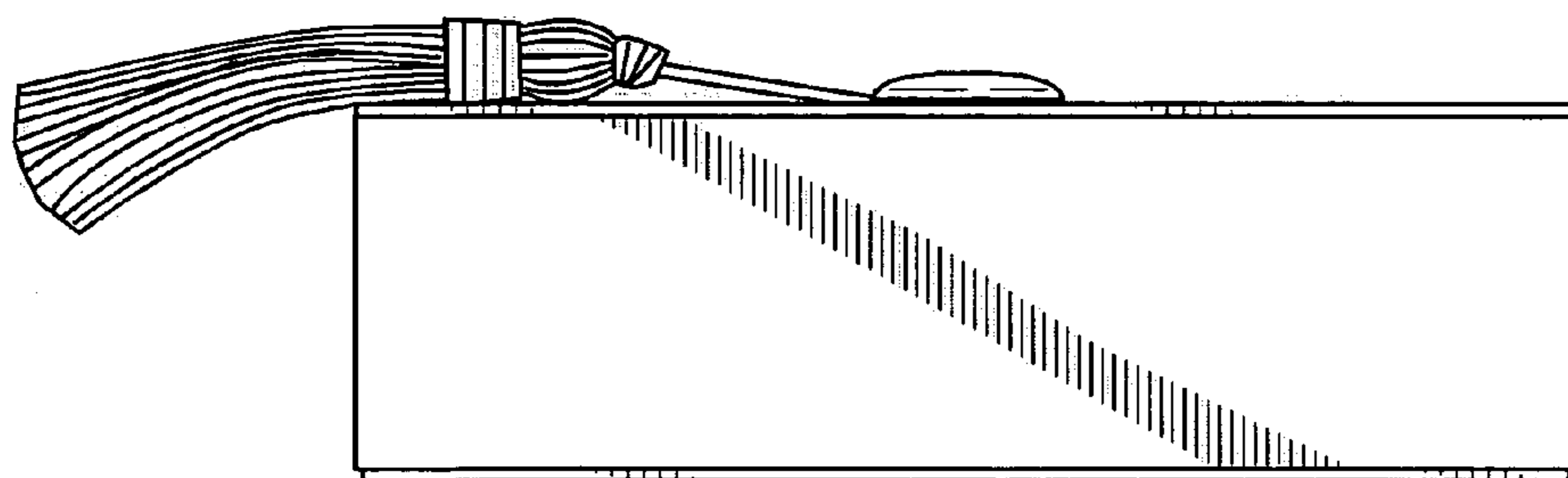

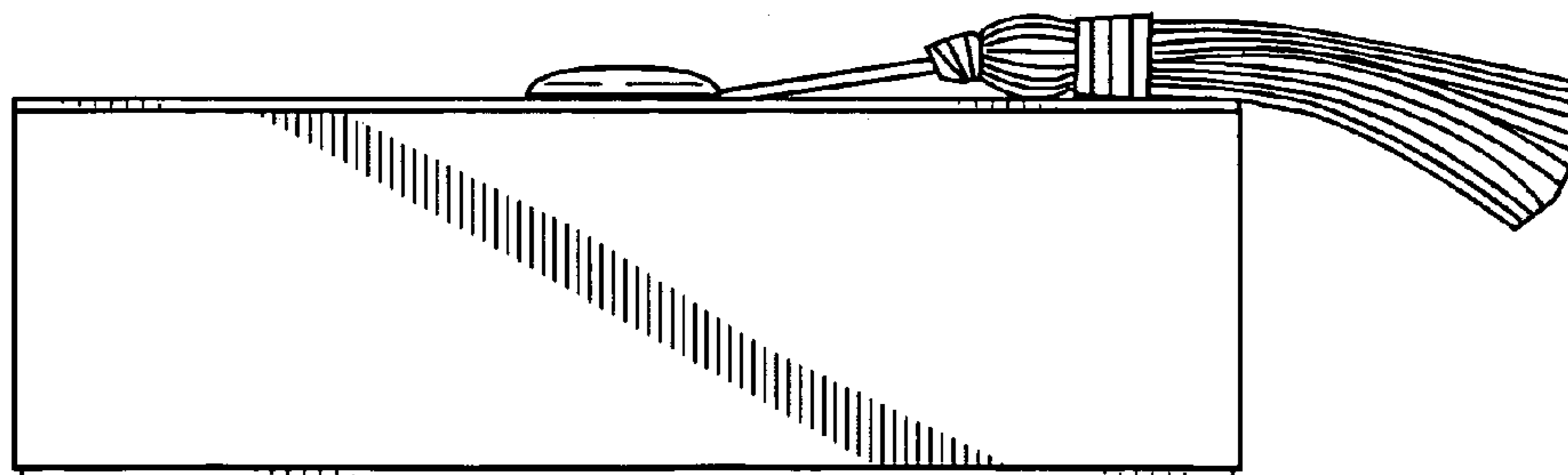

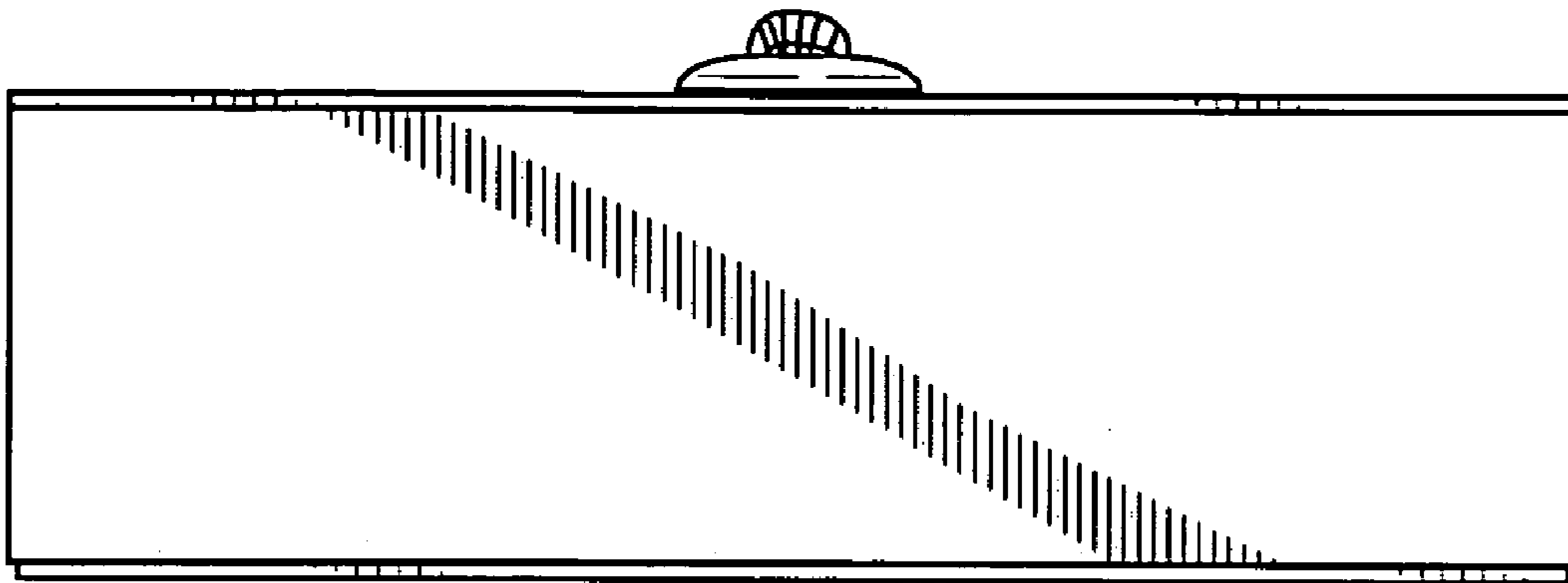

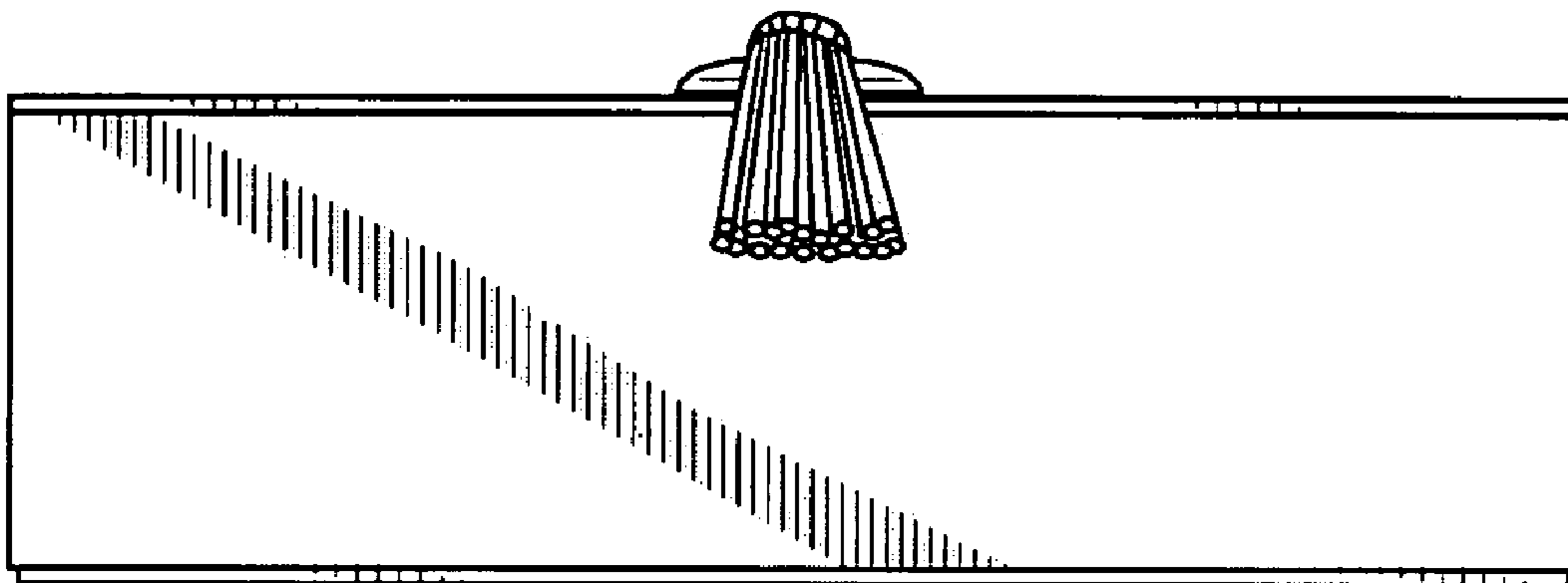

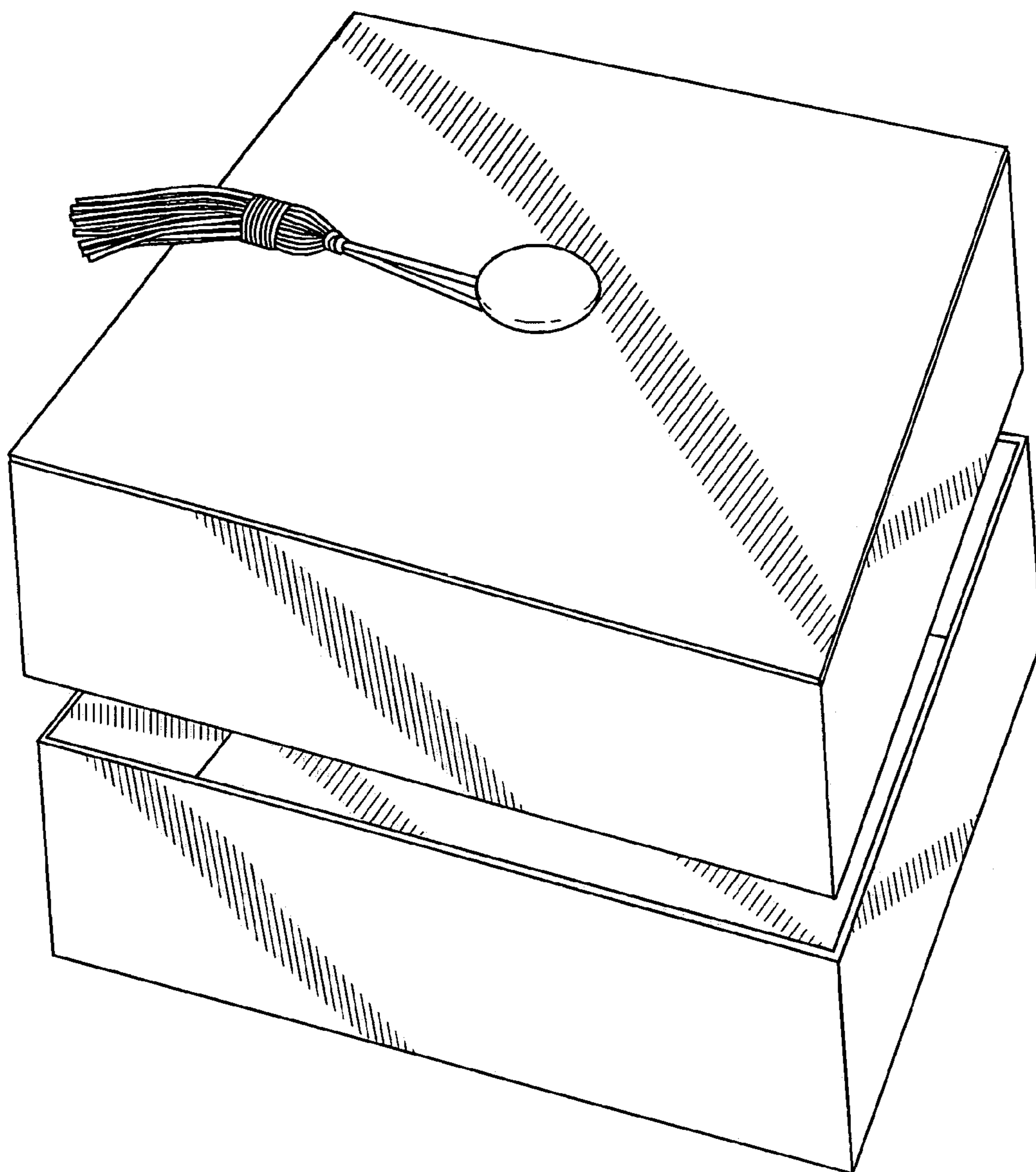
