the appliance handle;

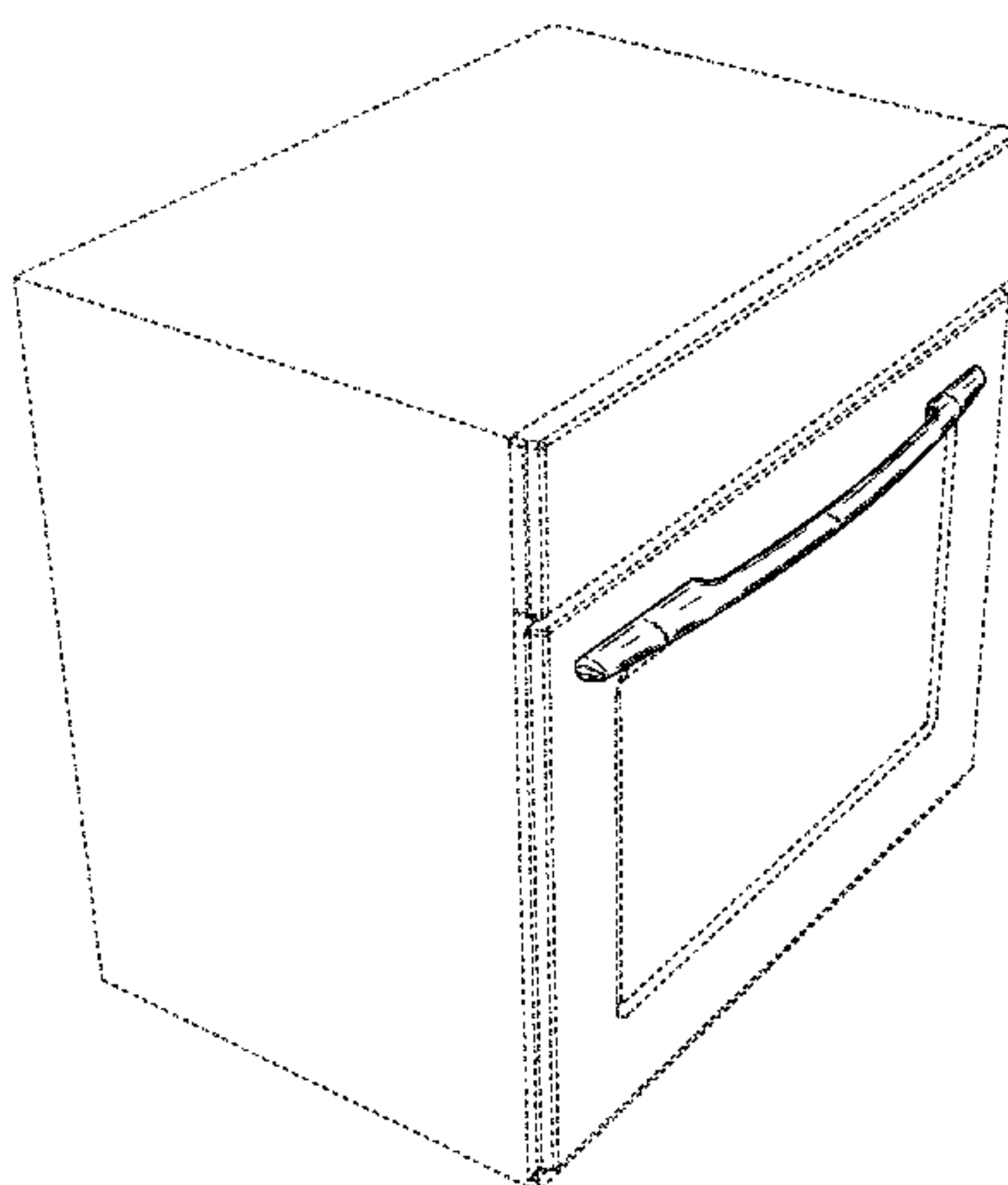
FIG. 14 is a front elevational view thereof;

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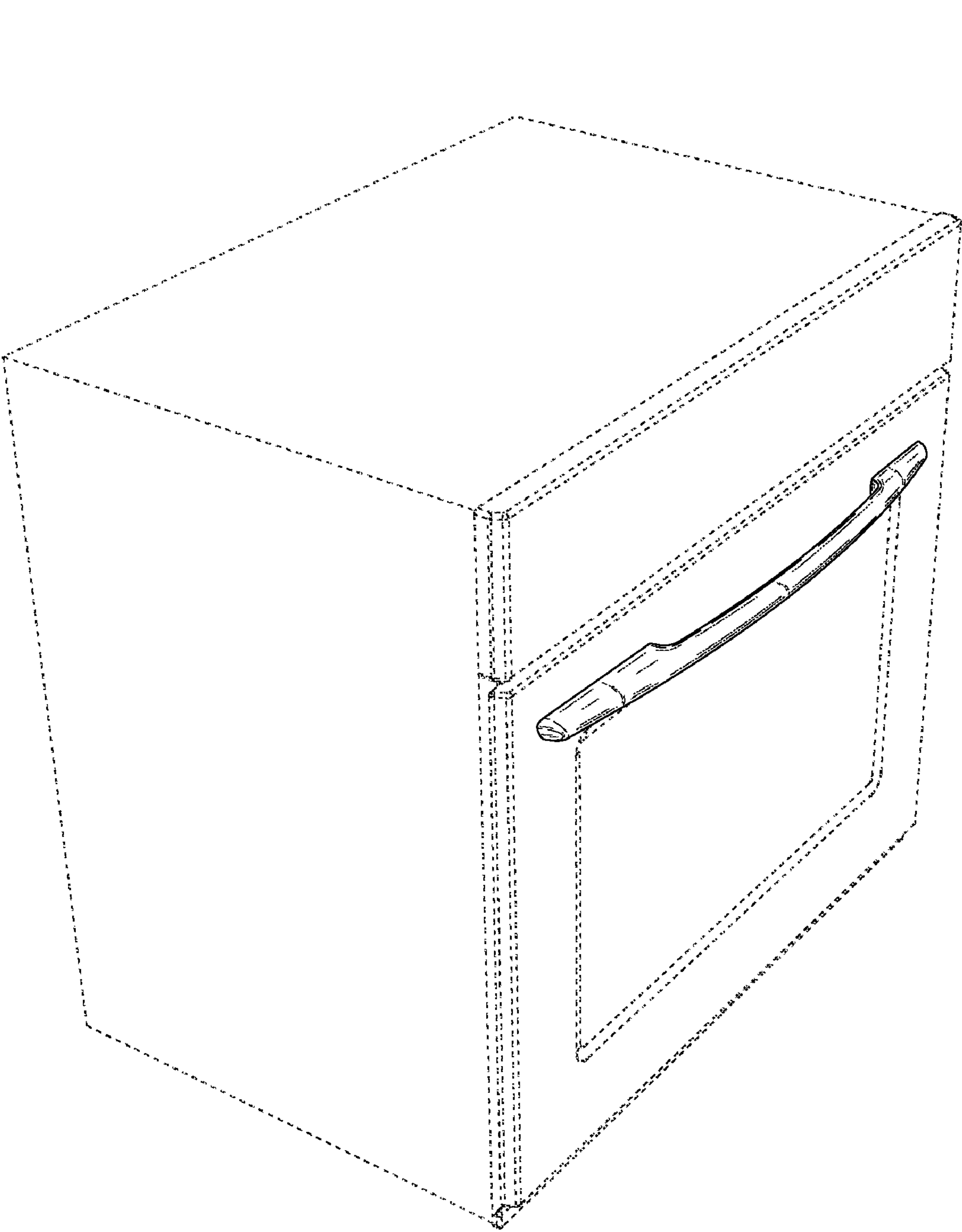

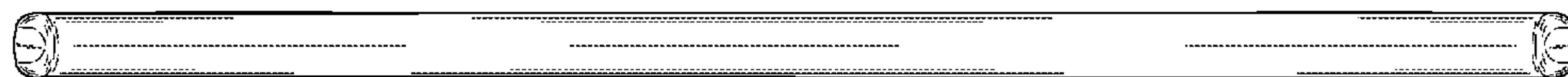

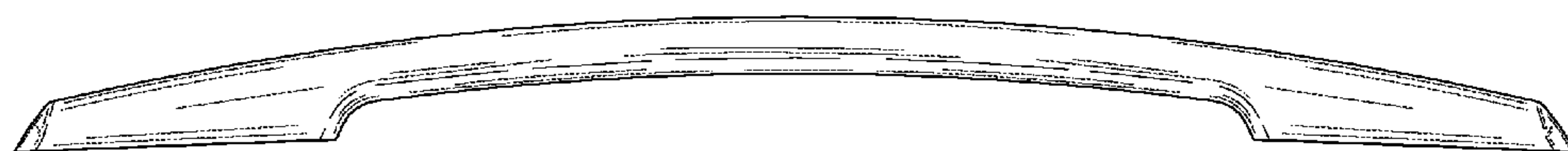

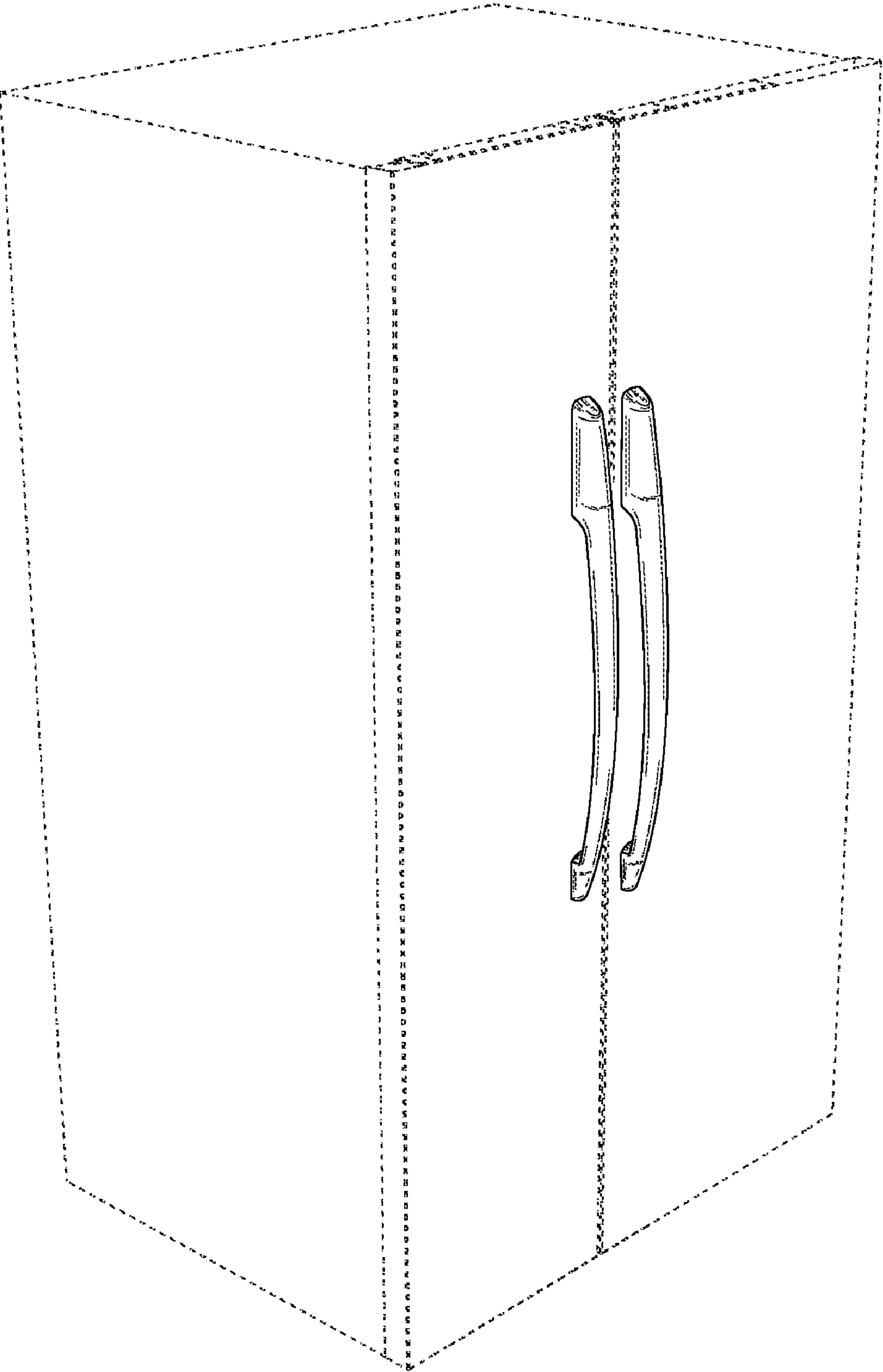

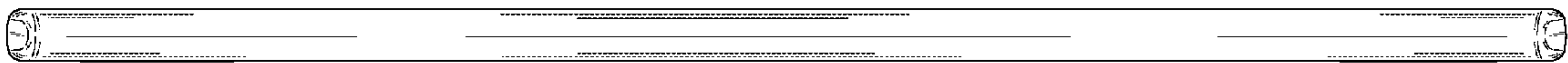

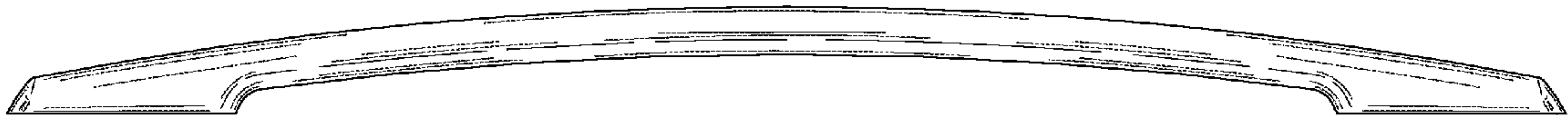

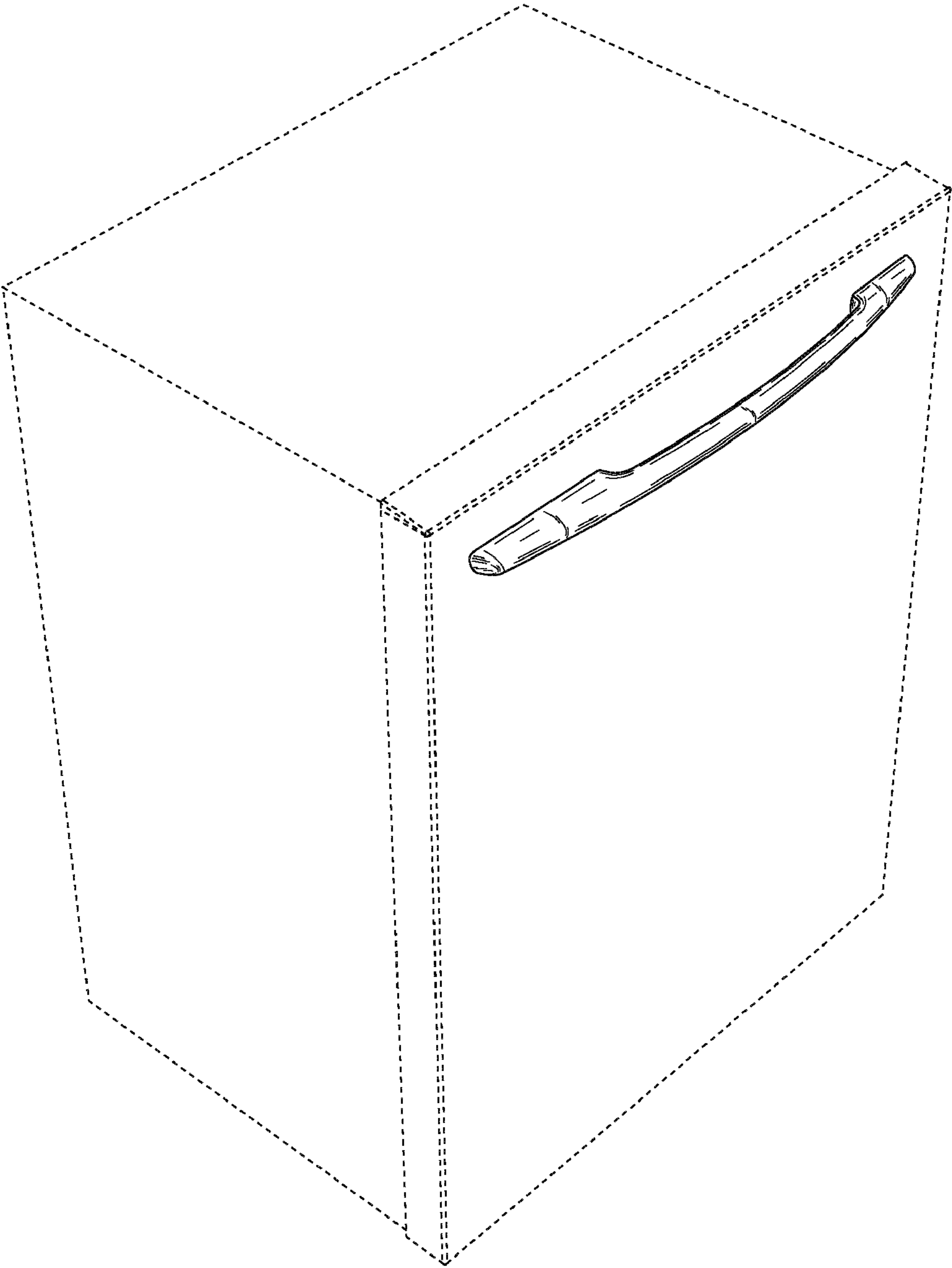

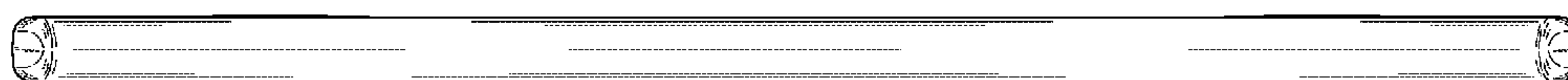

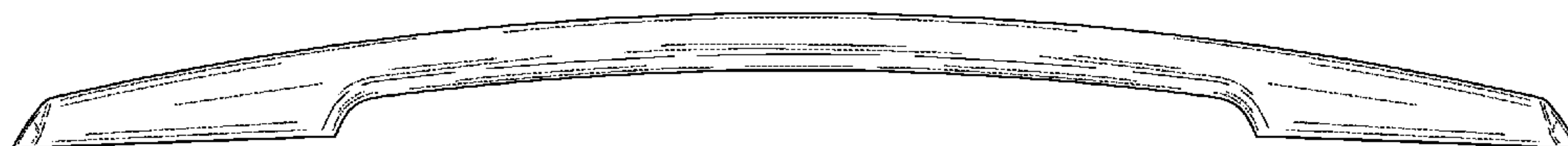

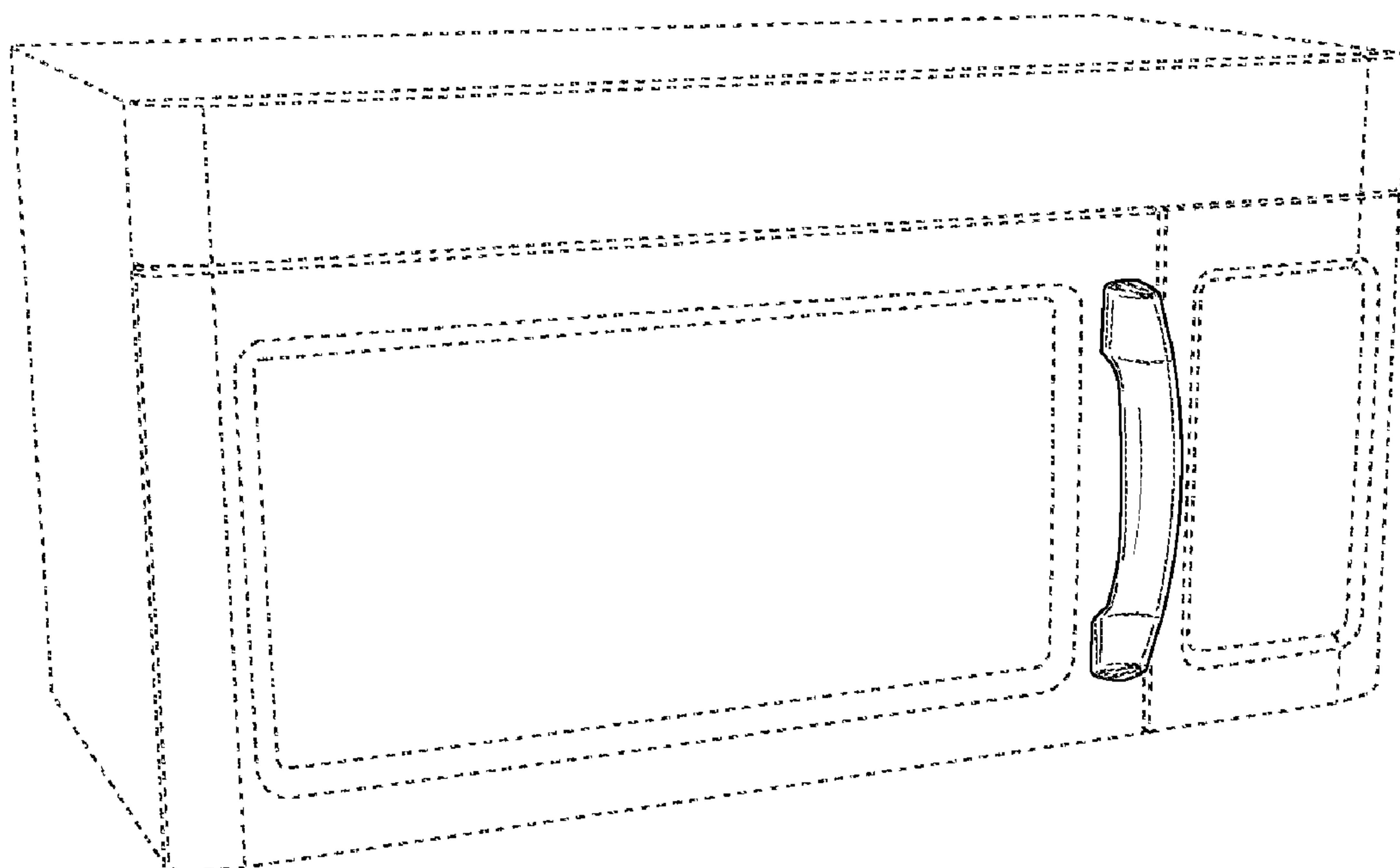

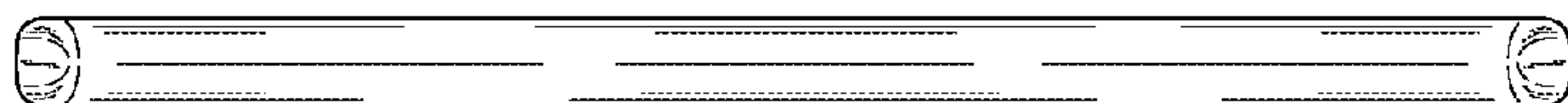

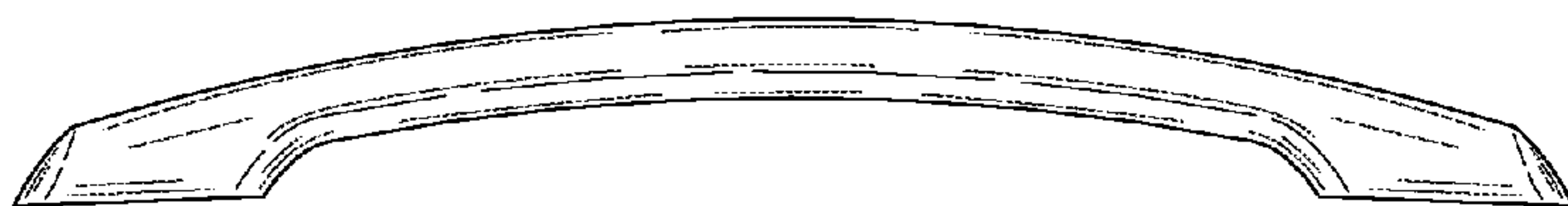
