(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a shoe outsole, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom perspective view of a shoe outsole in accordance with my new design;

FIG. 2 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side view thereof;

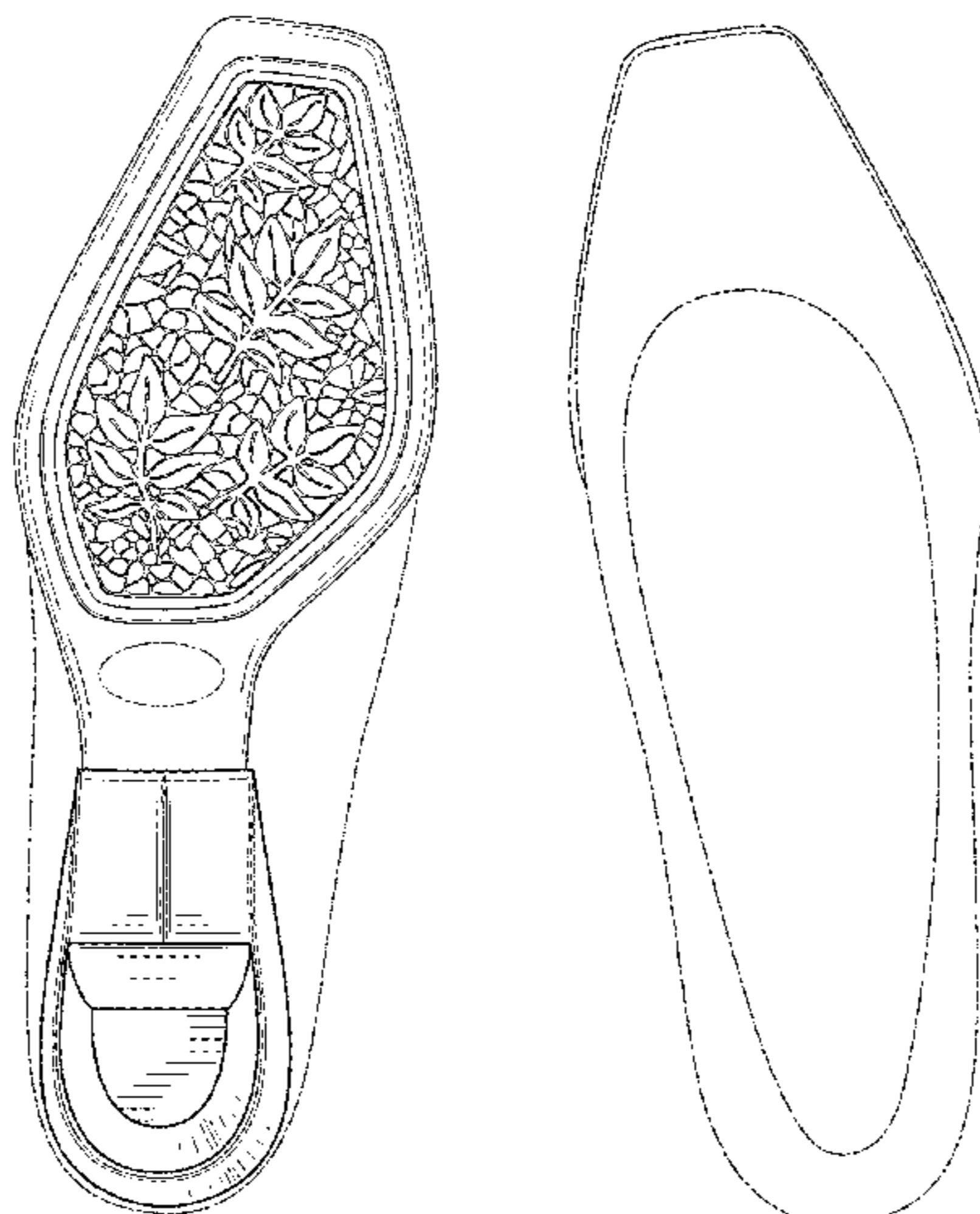
FIG. 6 is a front view thereof;

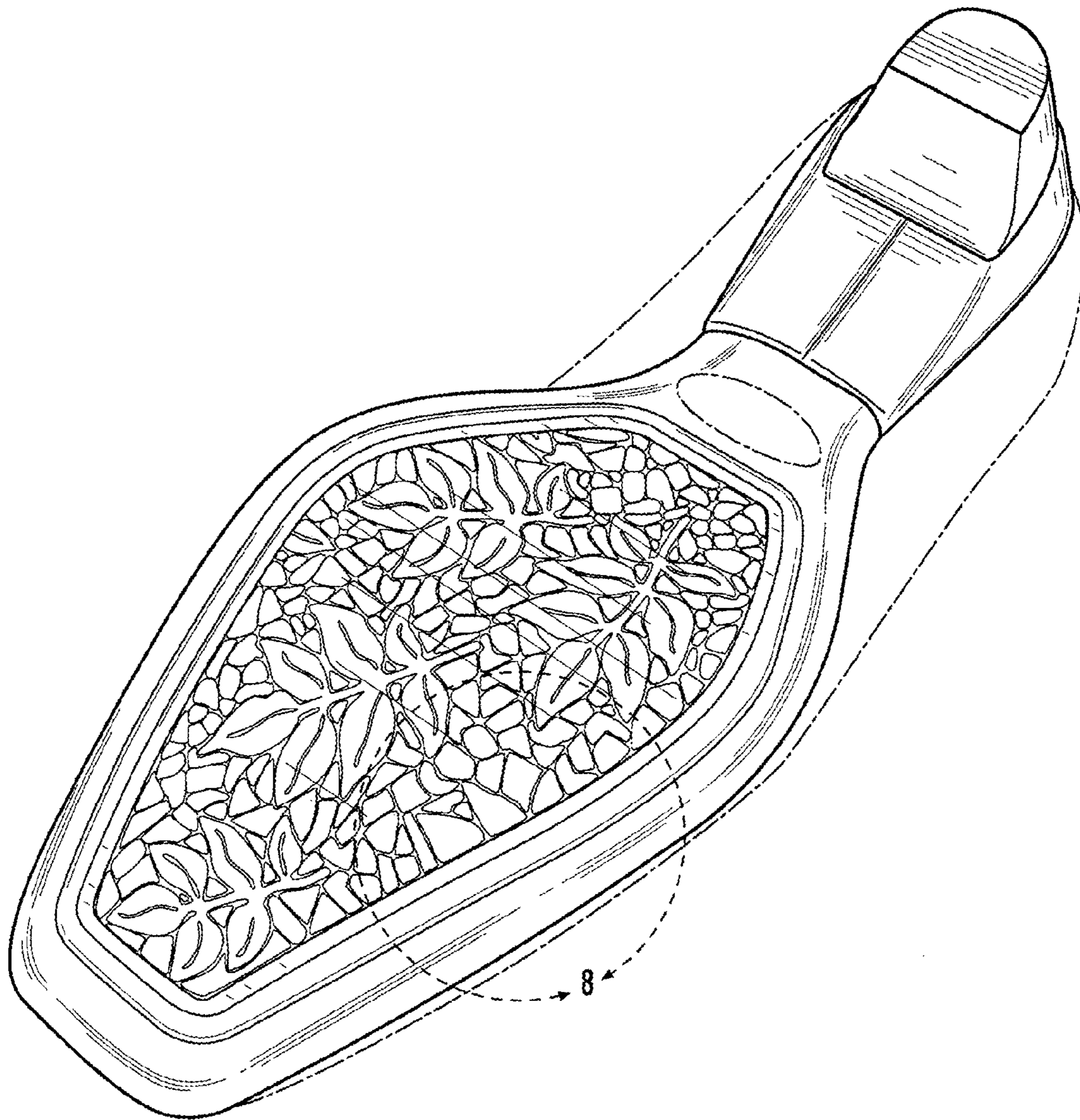

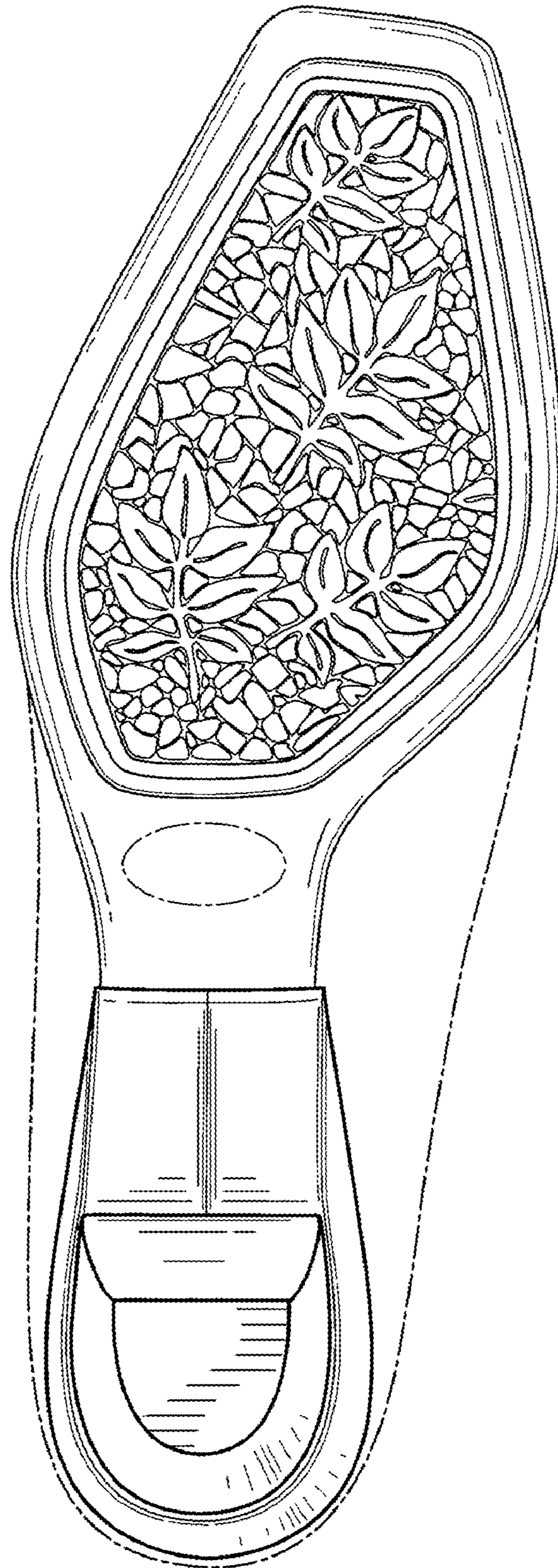

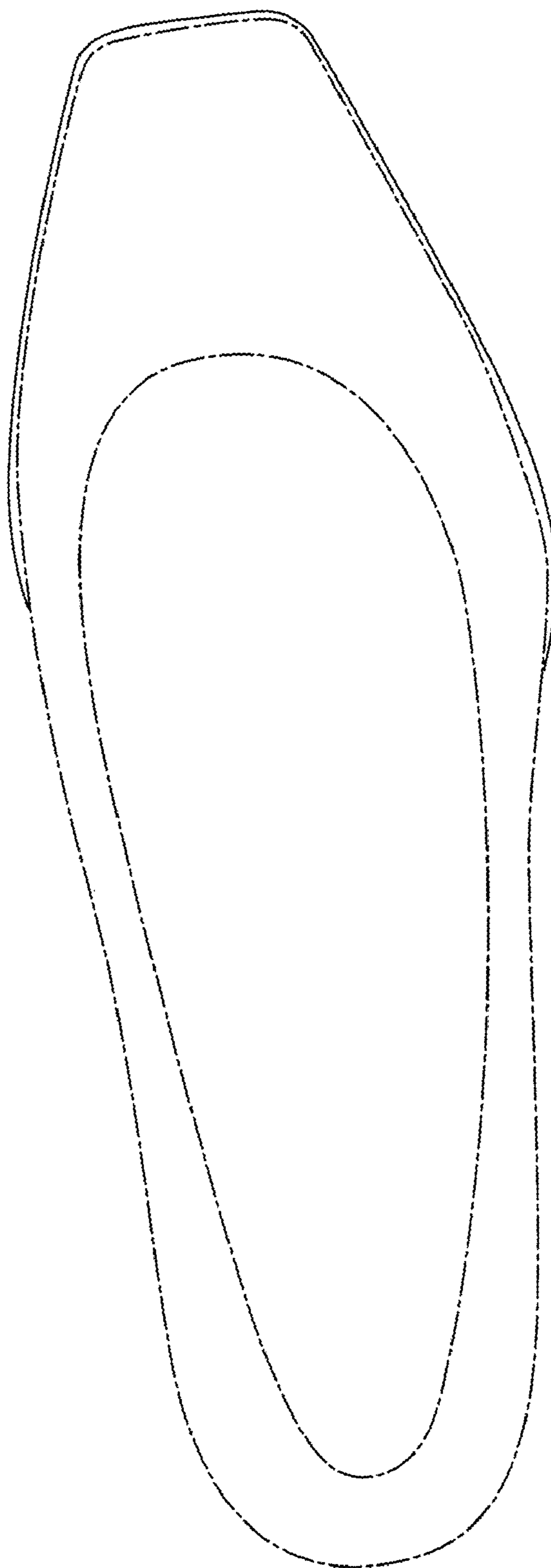

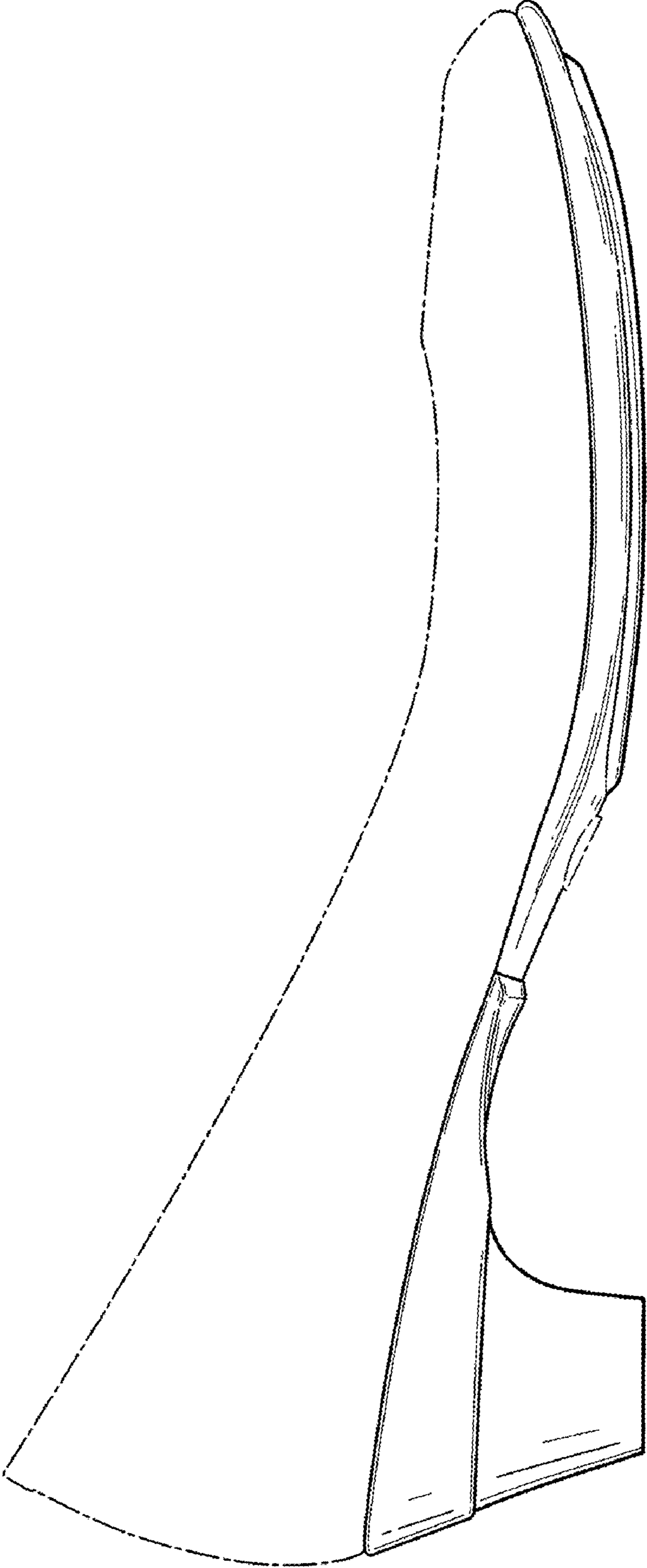

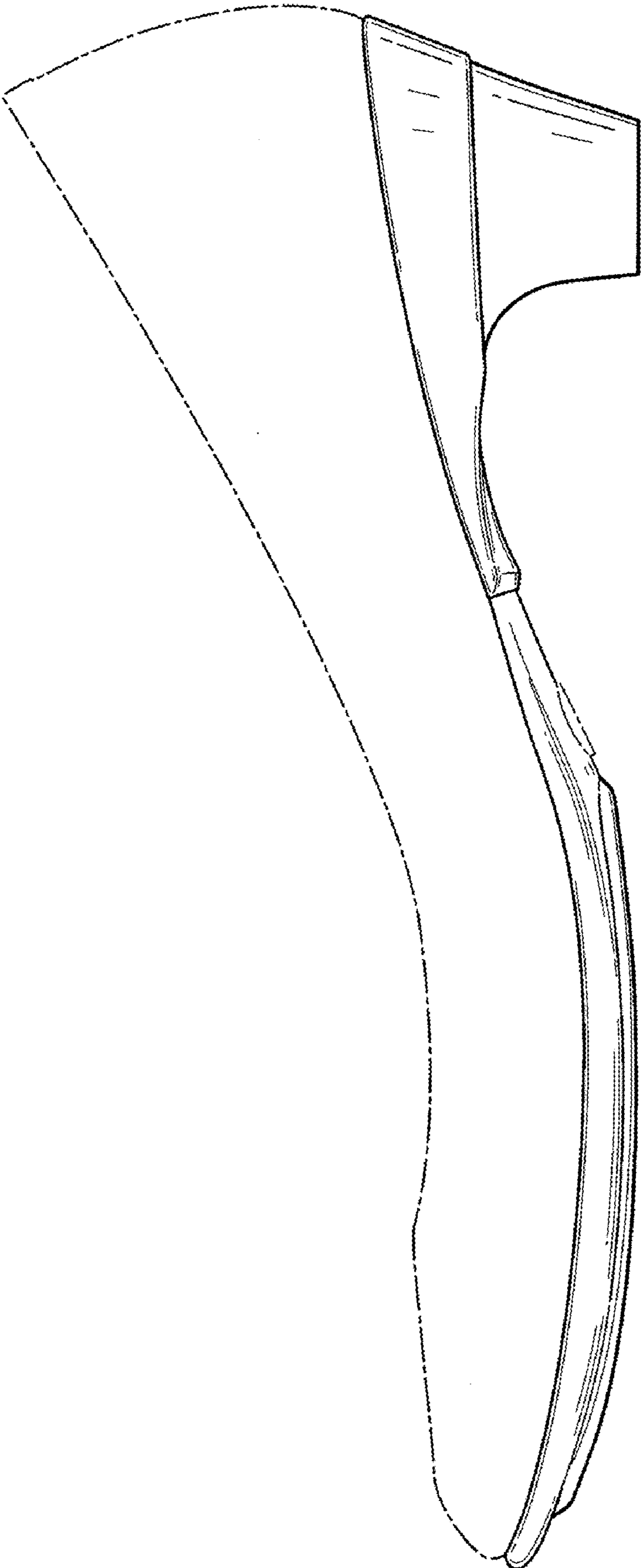

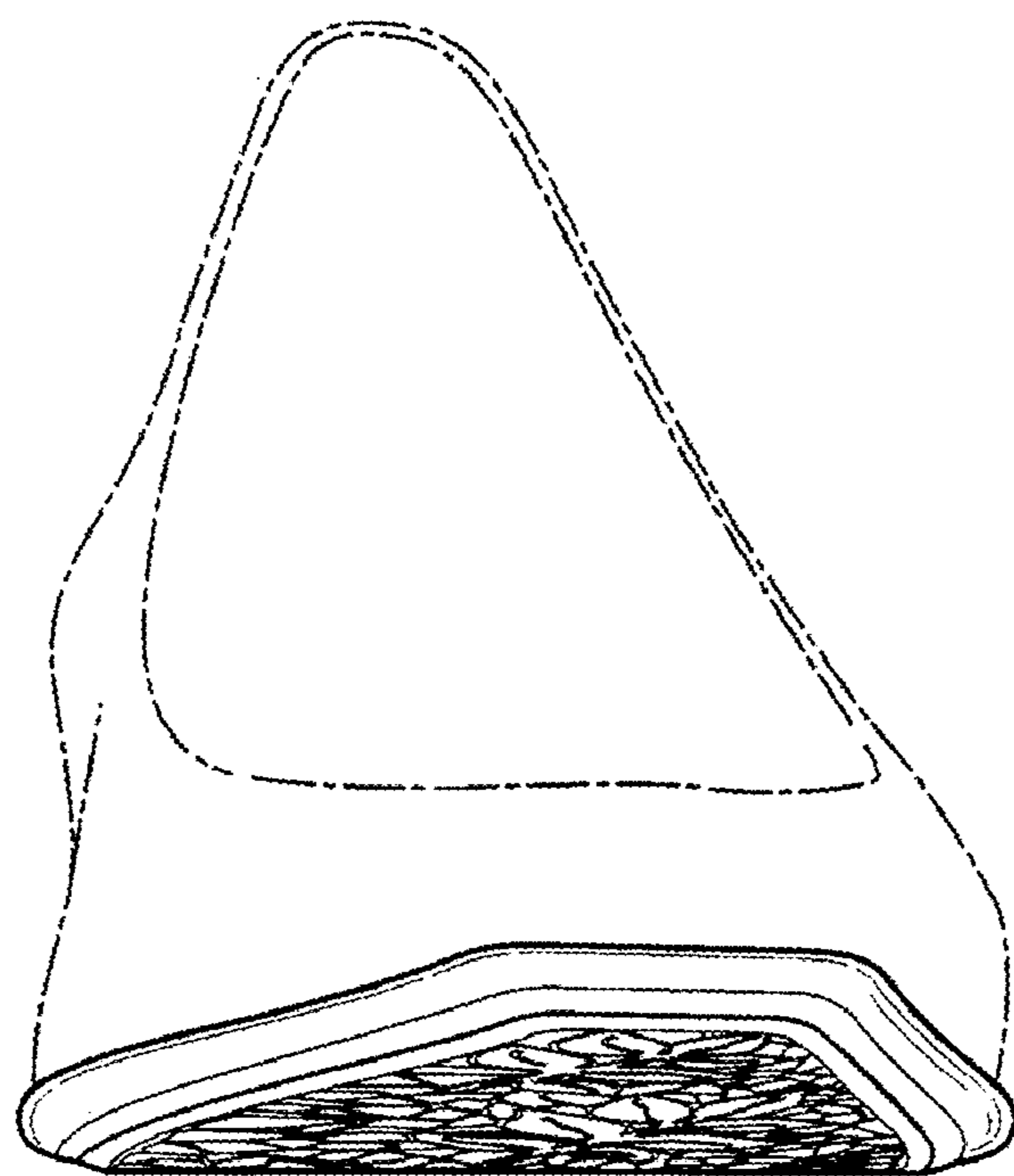

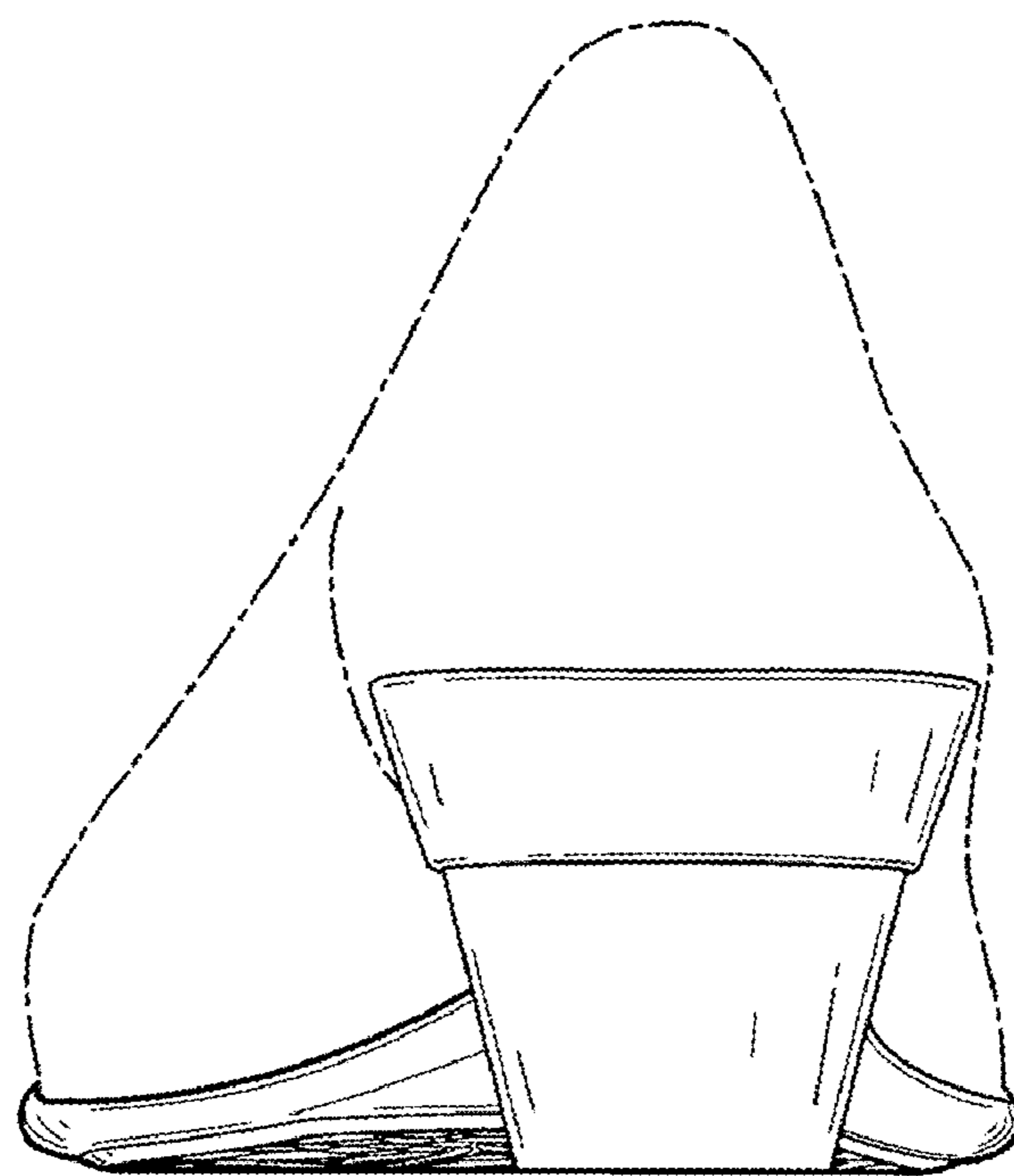

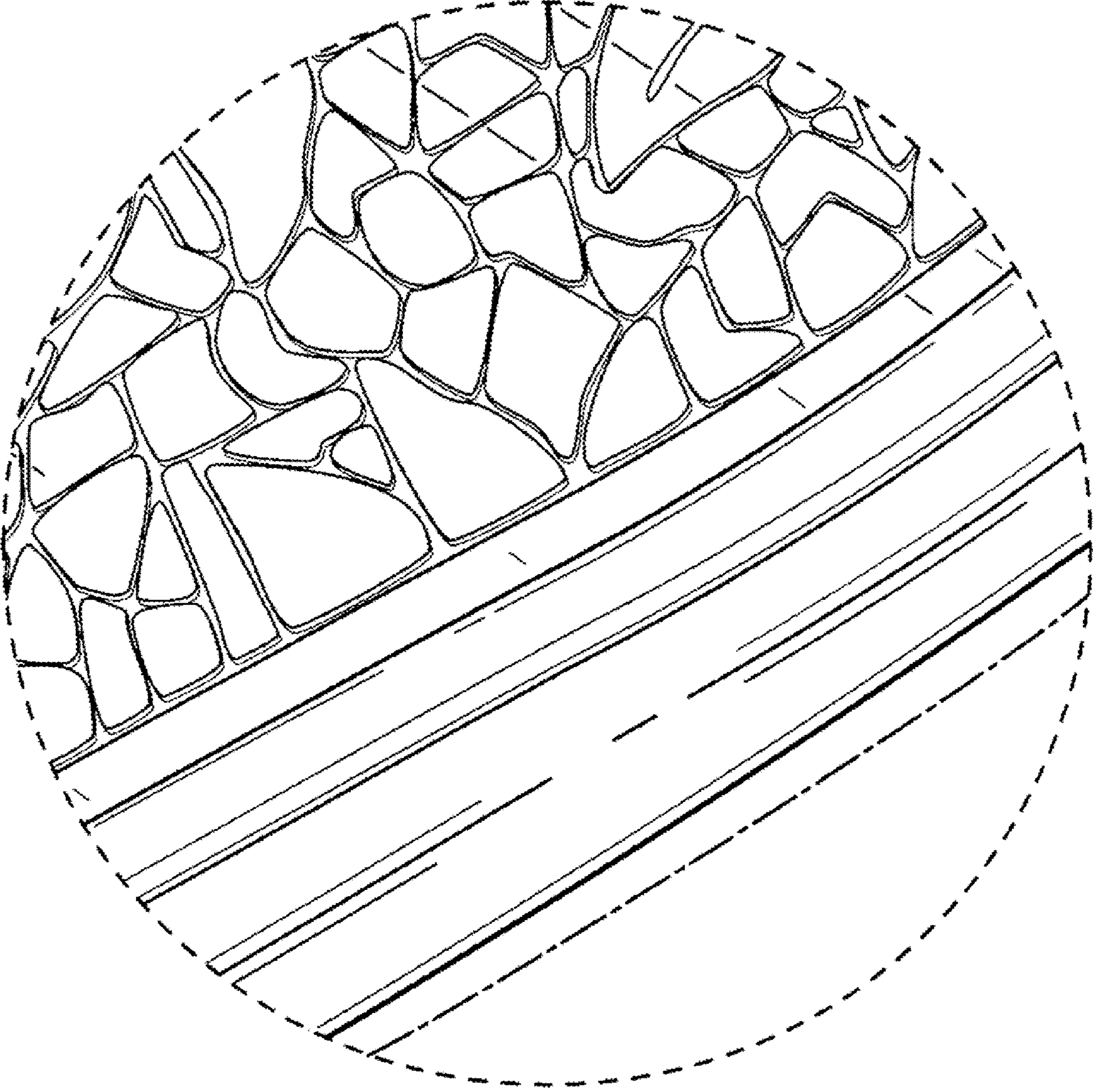
