FIG. 2 is a side elevation view of the applicator device shown in FIG. 1;

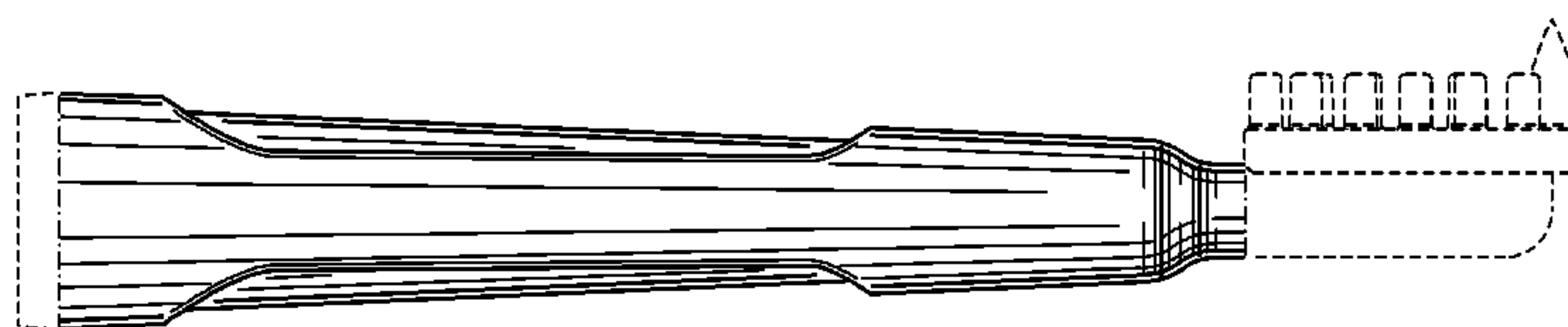
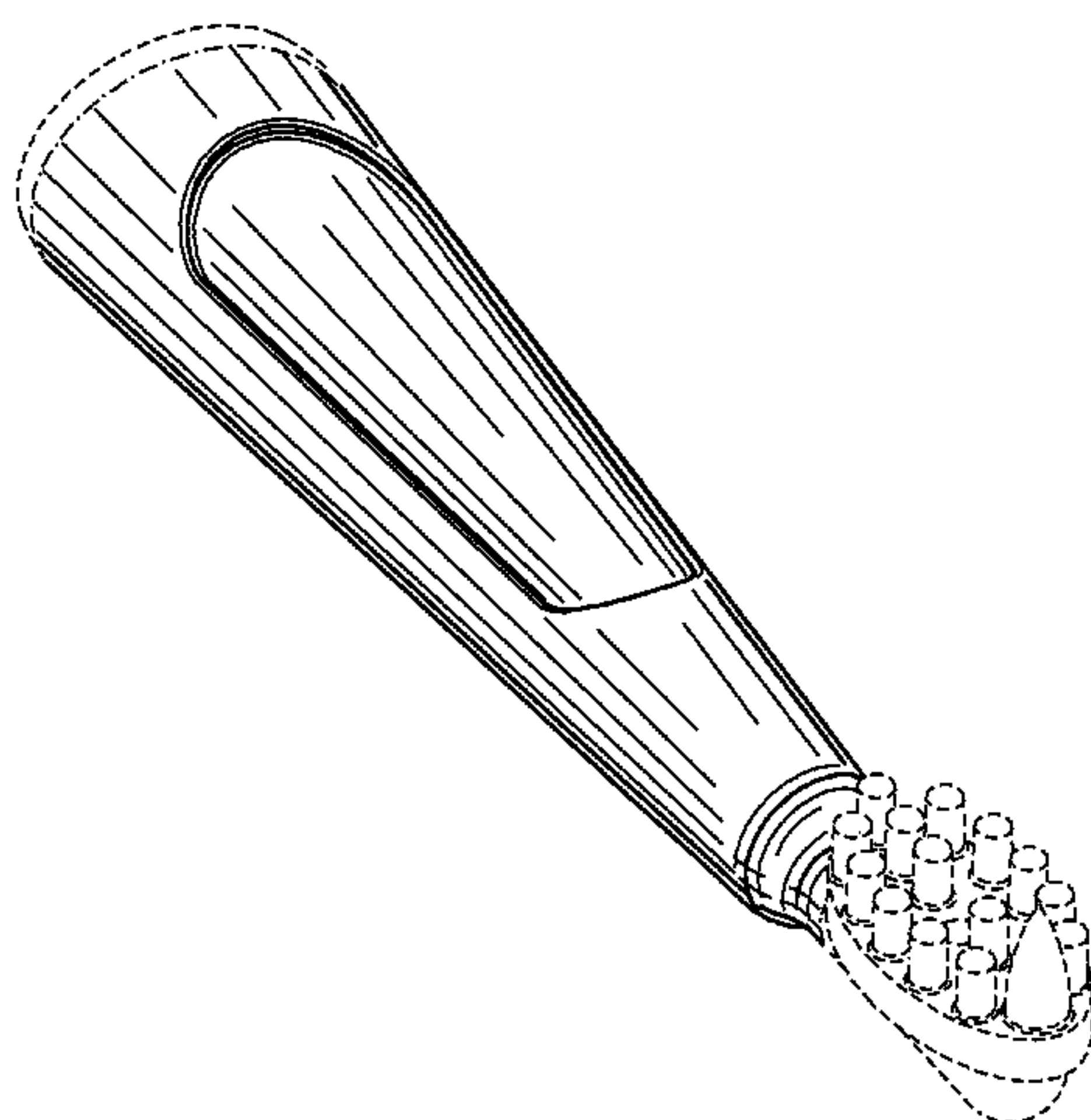
FIG. 3 is a front elevation view of the applicator device shown in FIG. 1;

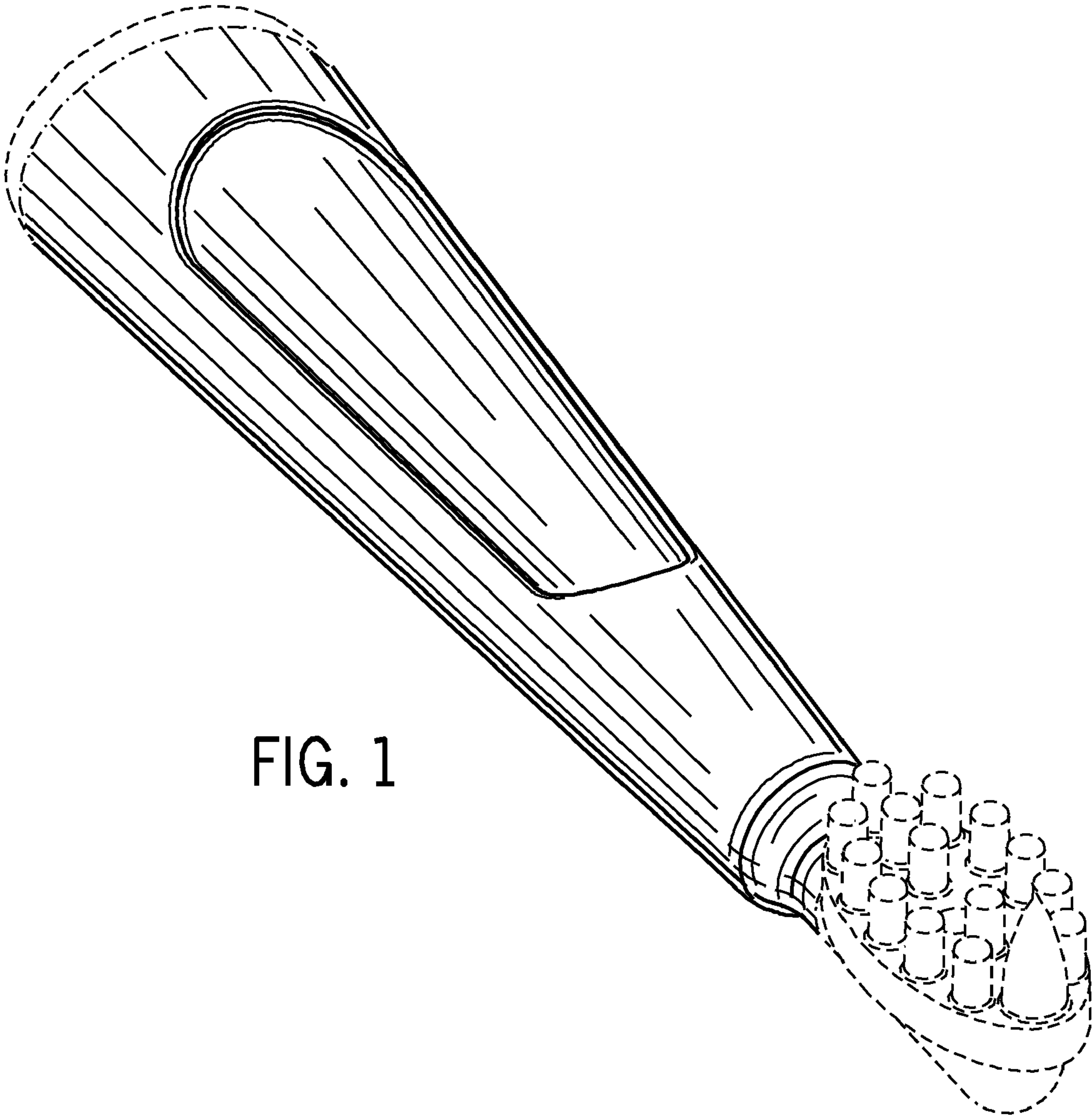
FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view of the applicator device shown in FIG. 1; and,

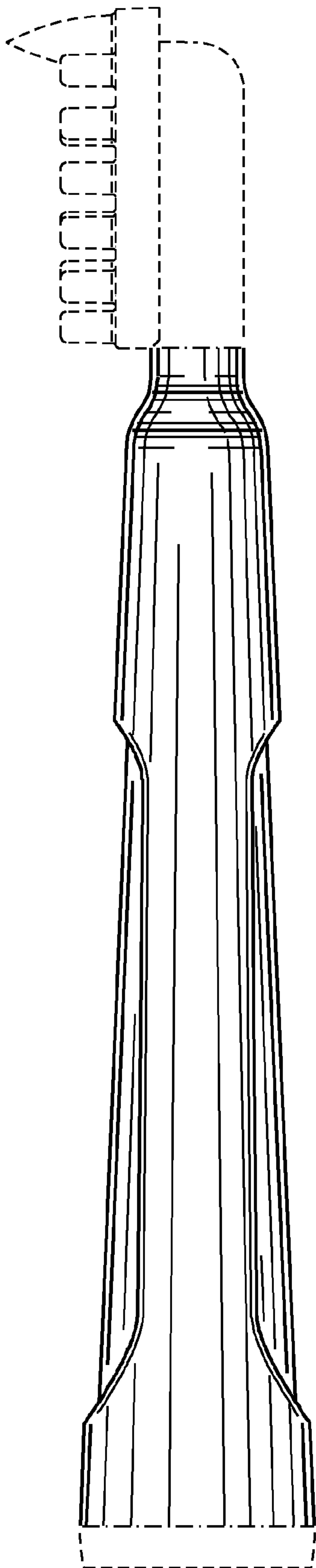

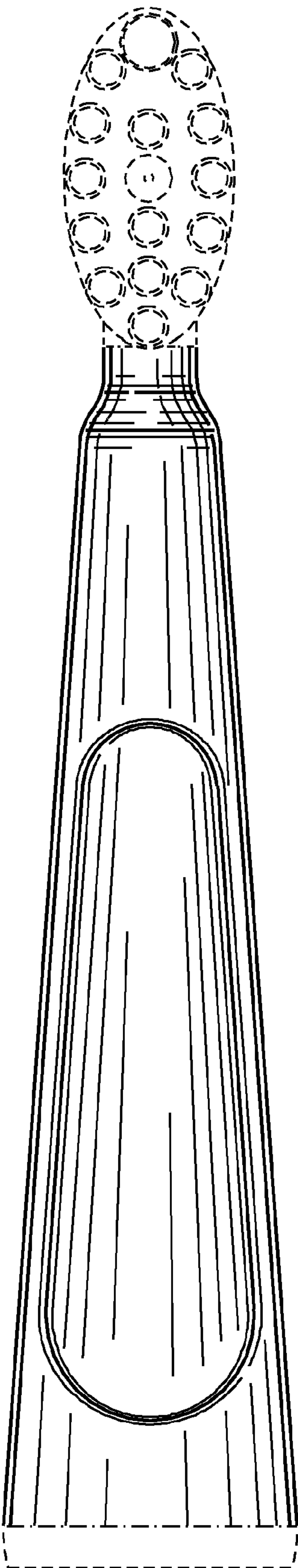

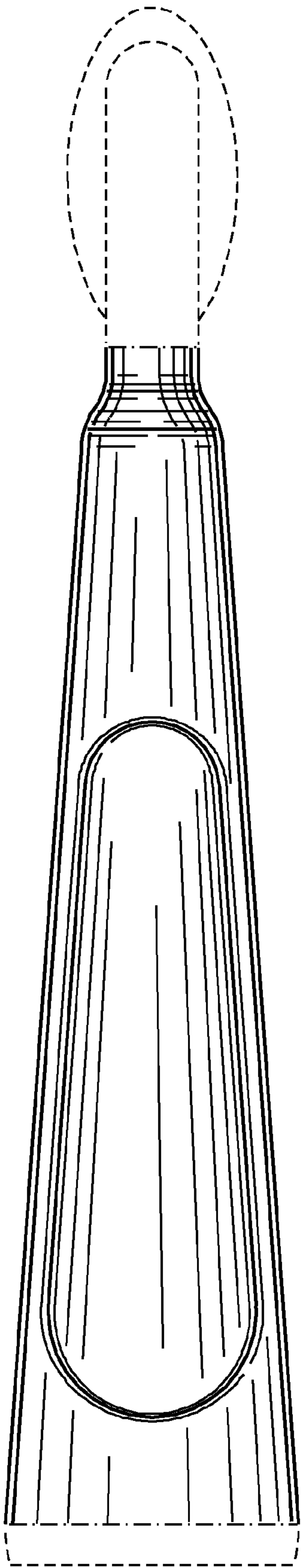

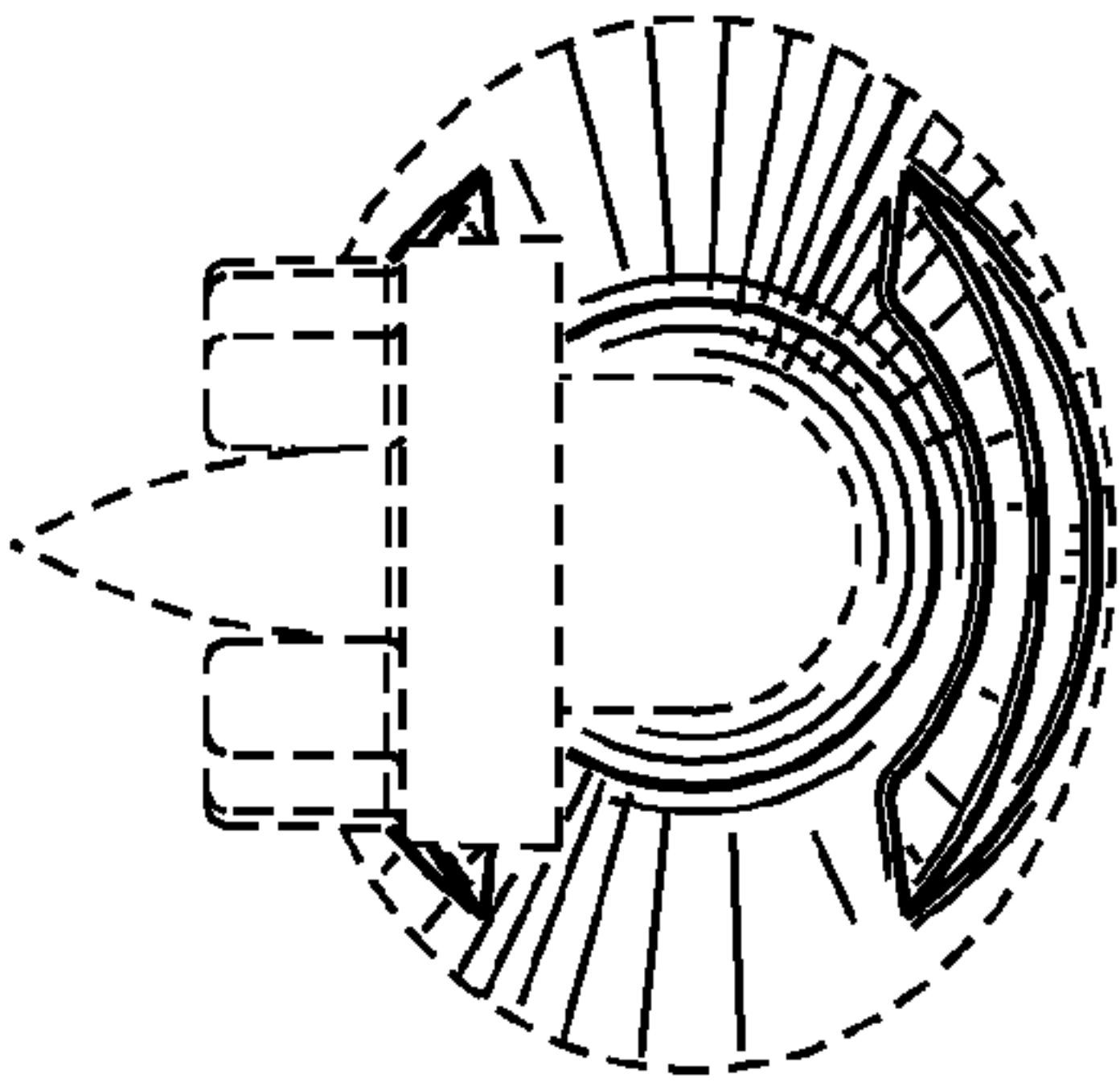
