FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof.

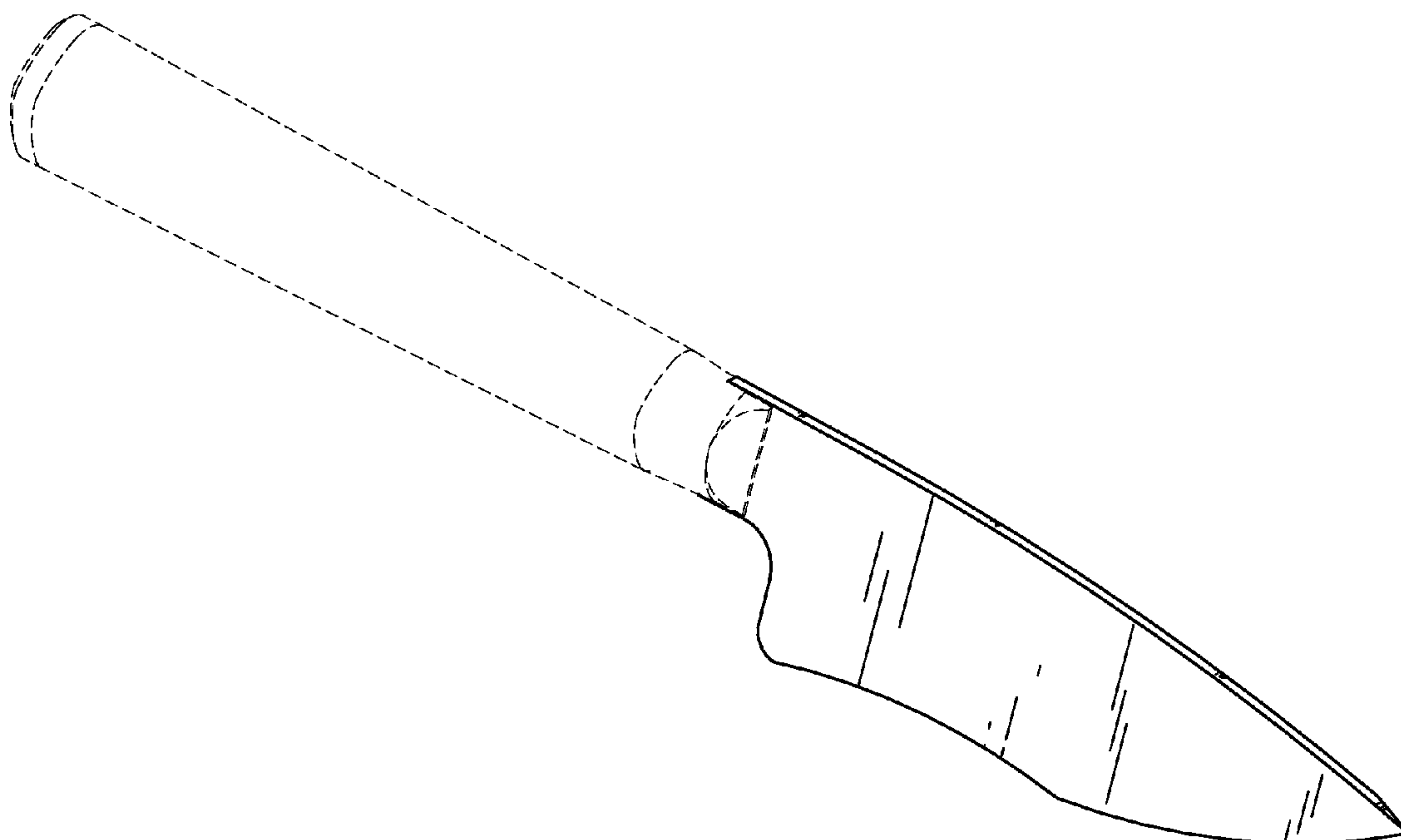
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof.

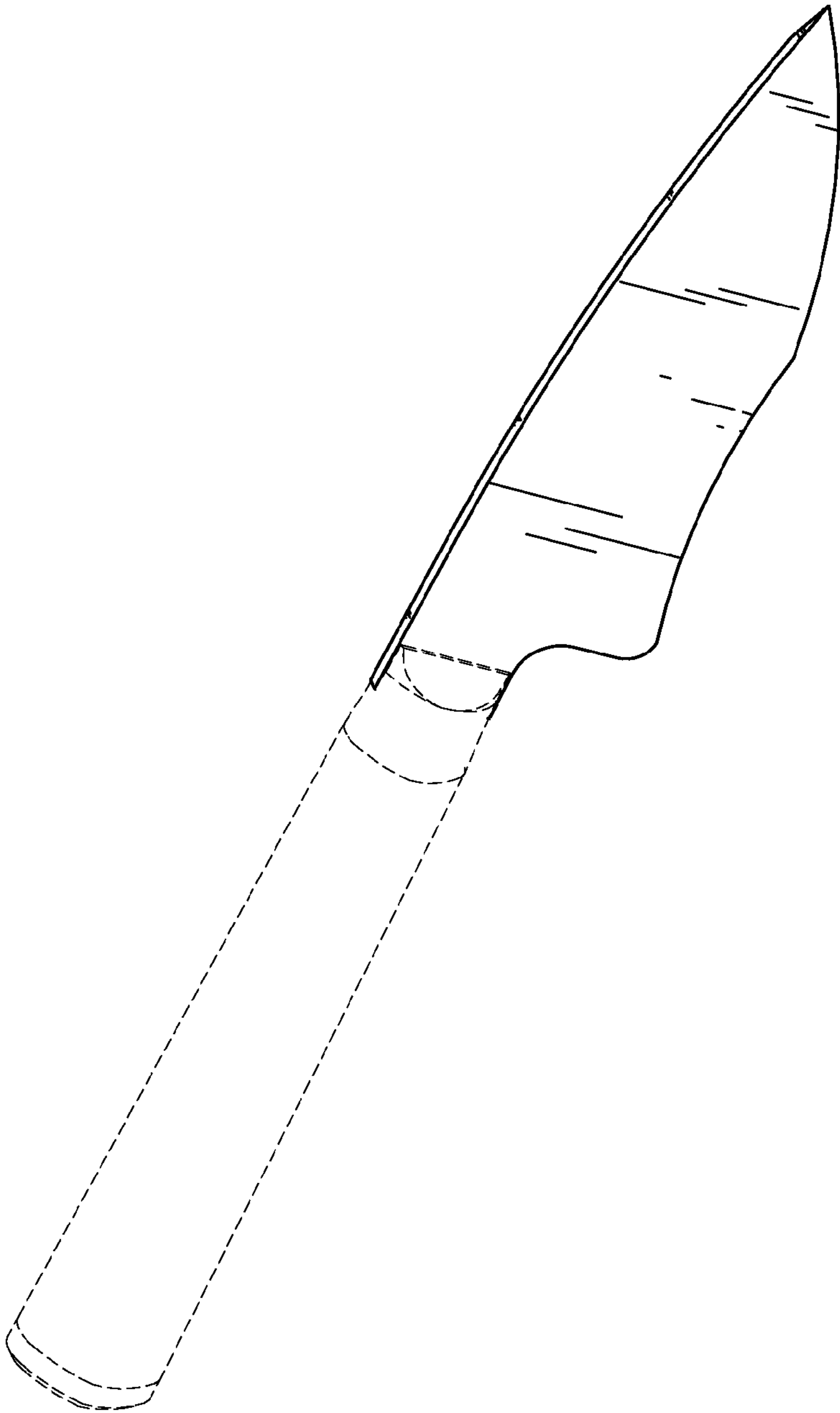

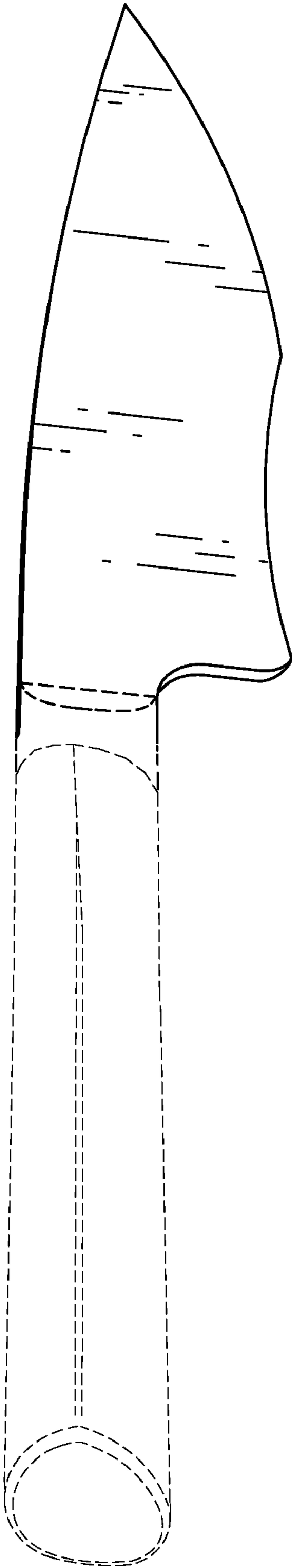

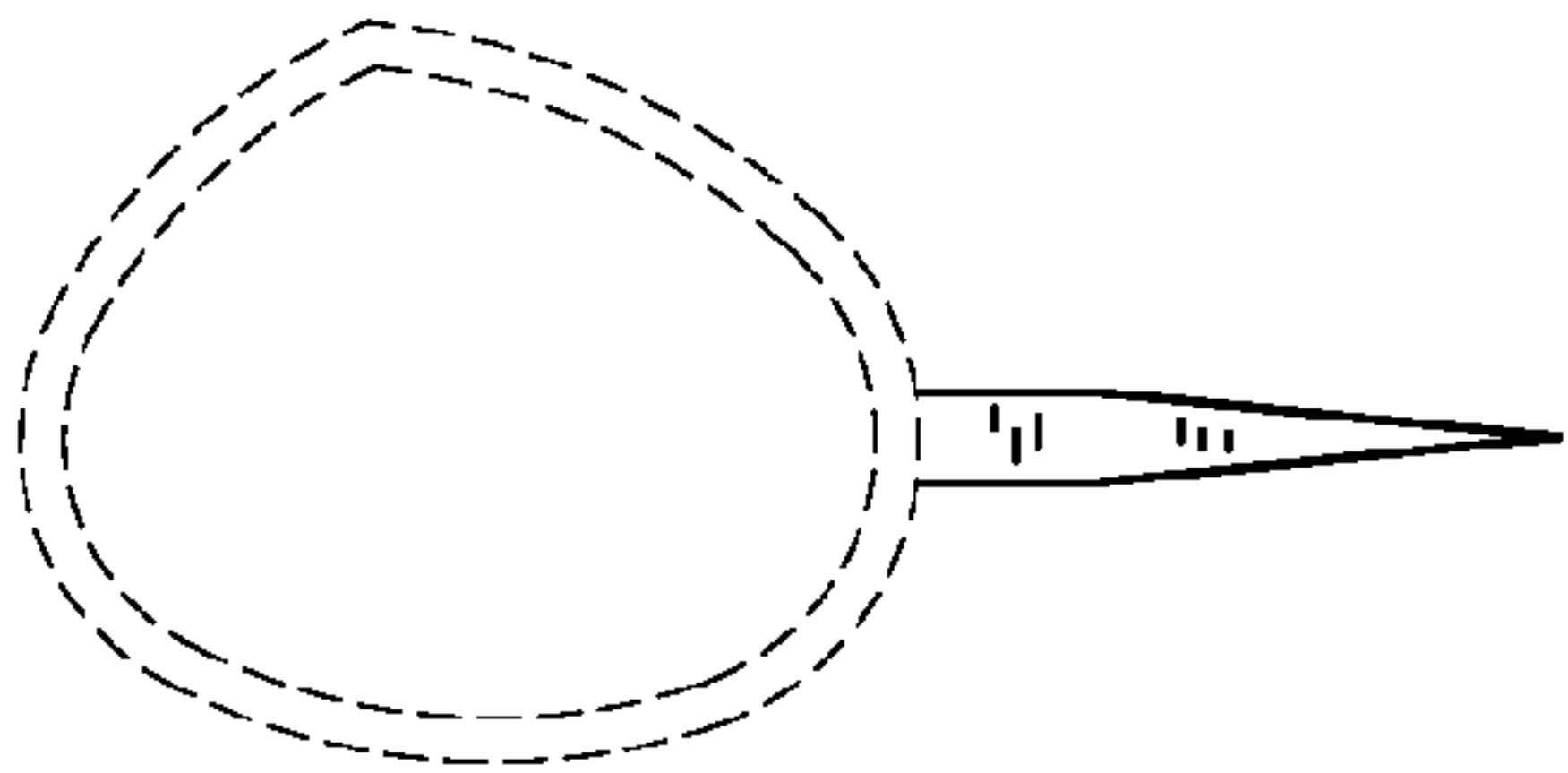

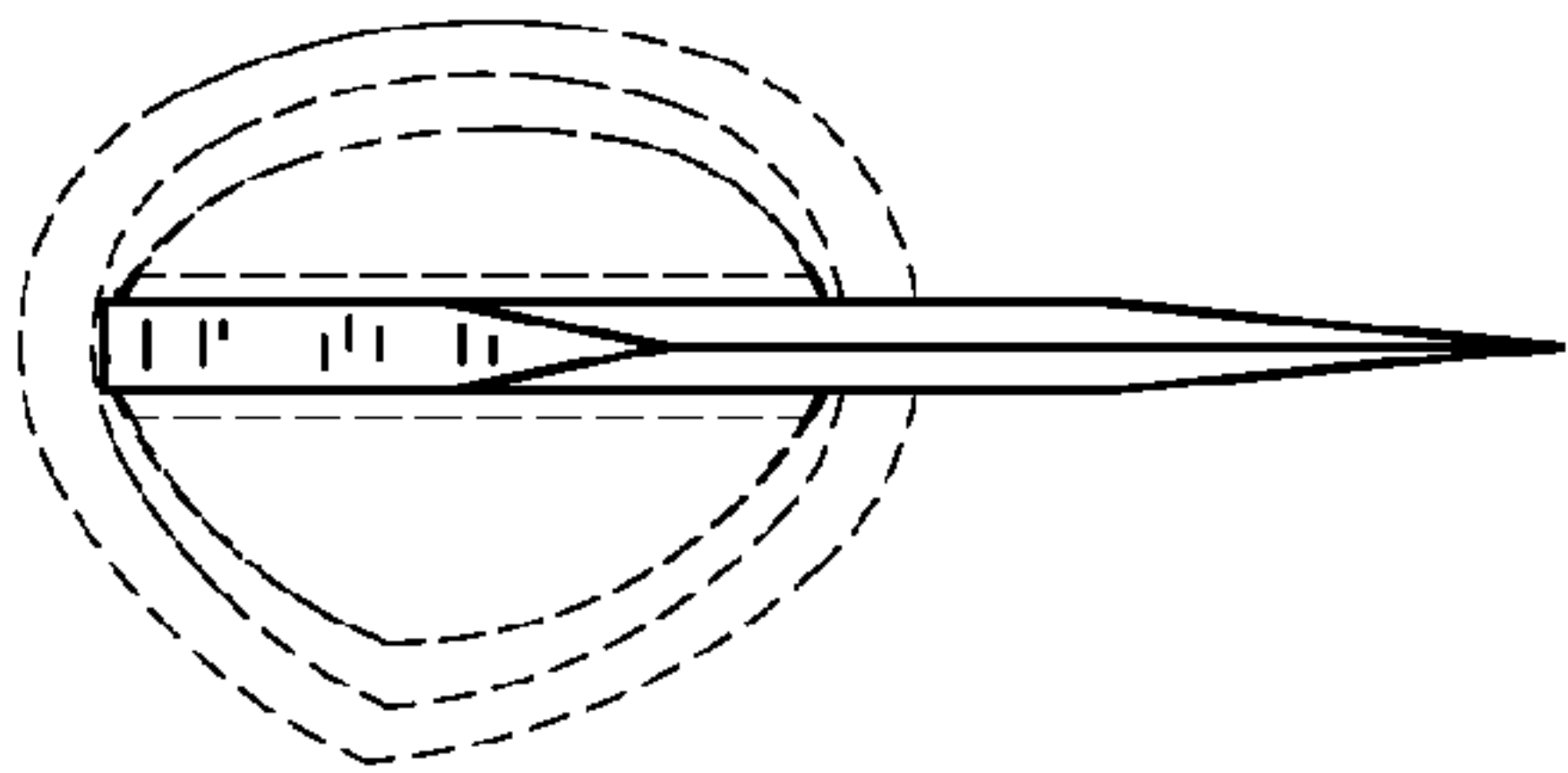

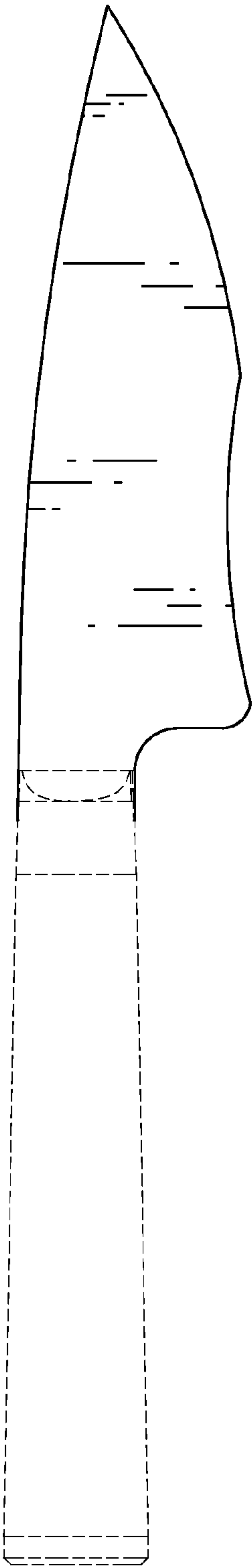

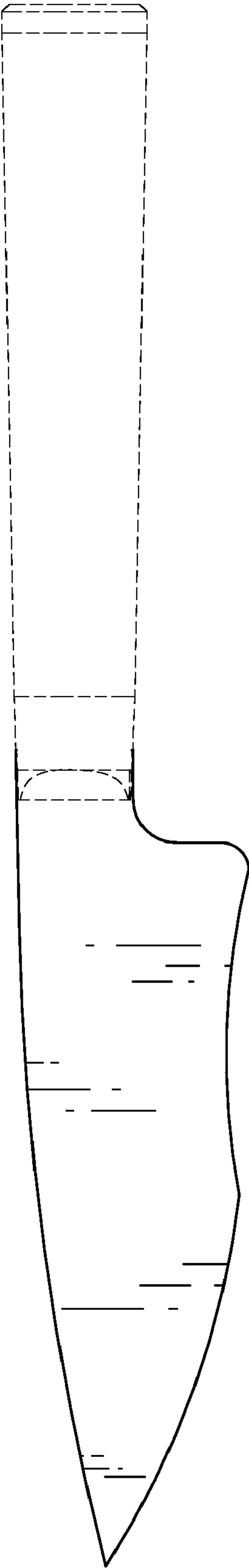

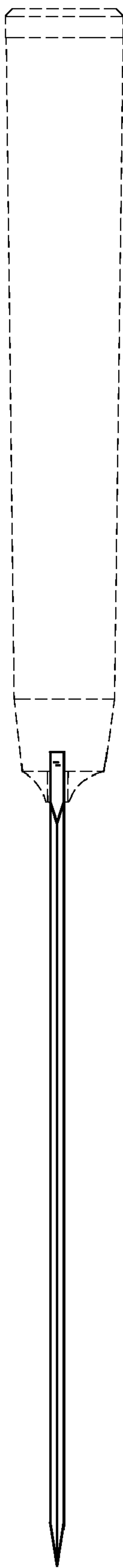

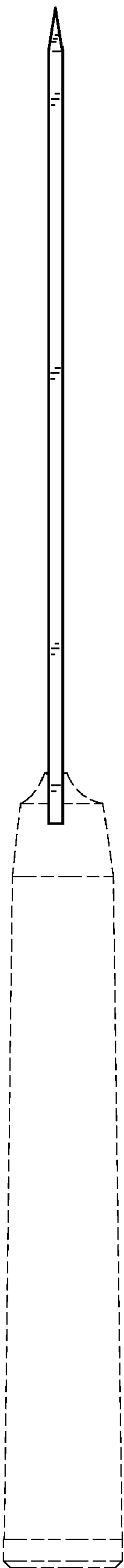
