FIG. 5 is a right side, elevational view thereof;

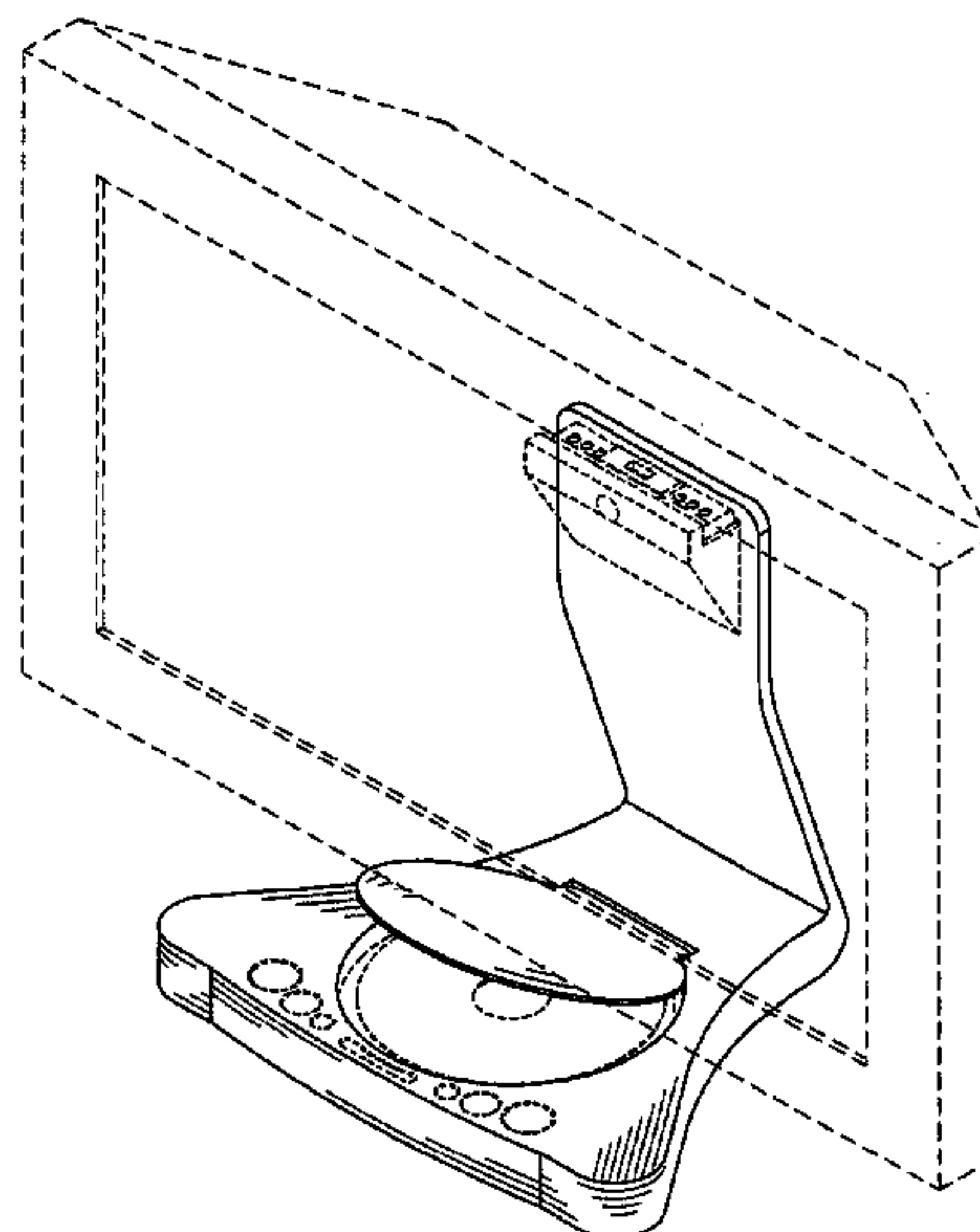
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and

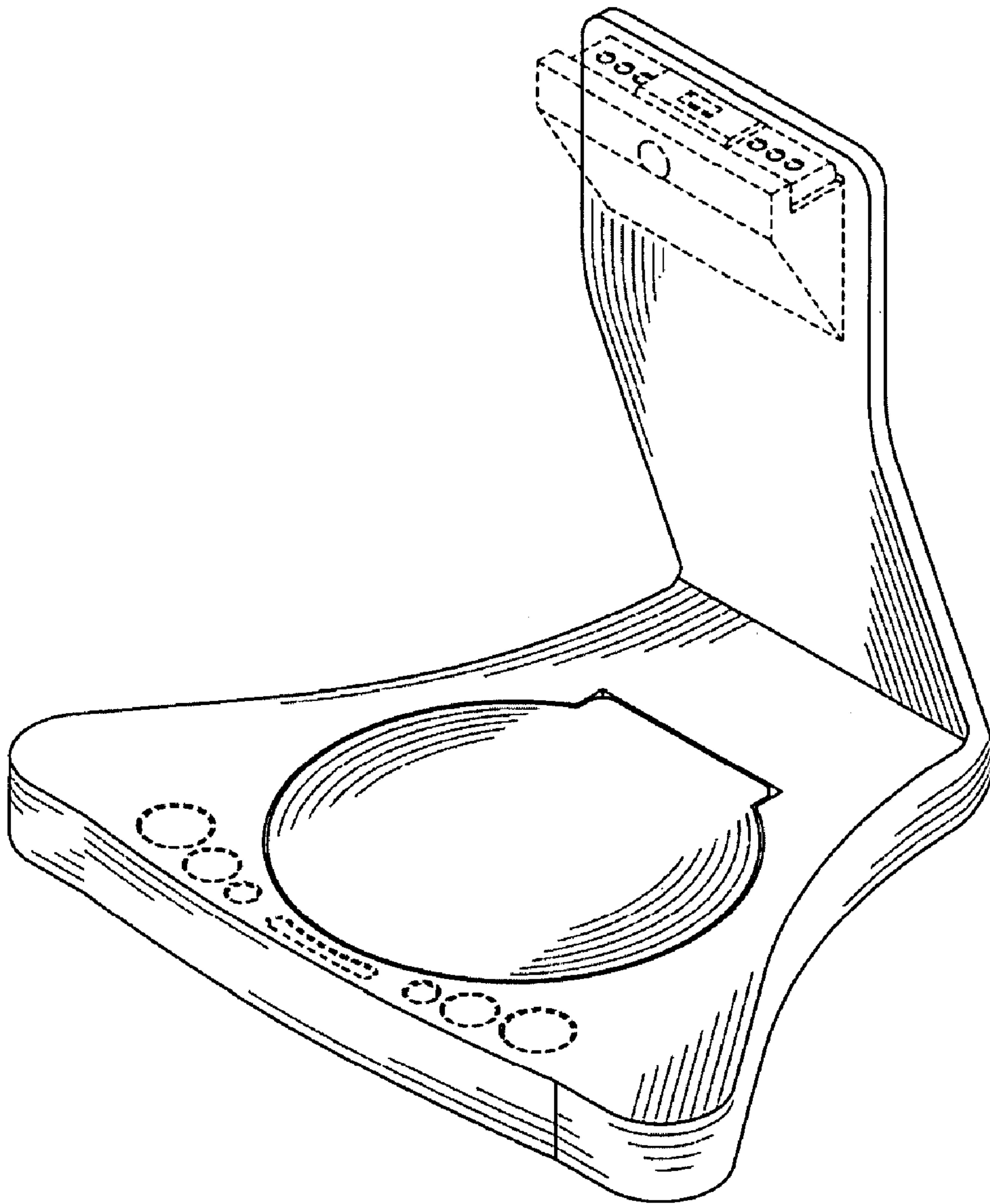

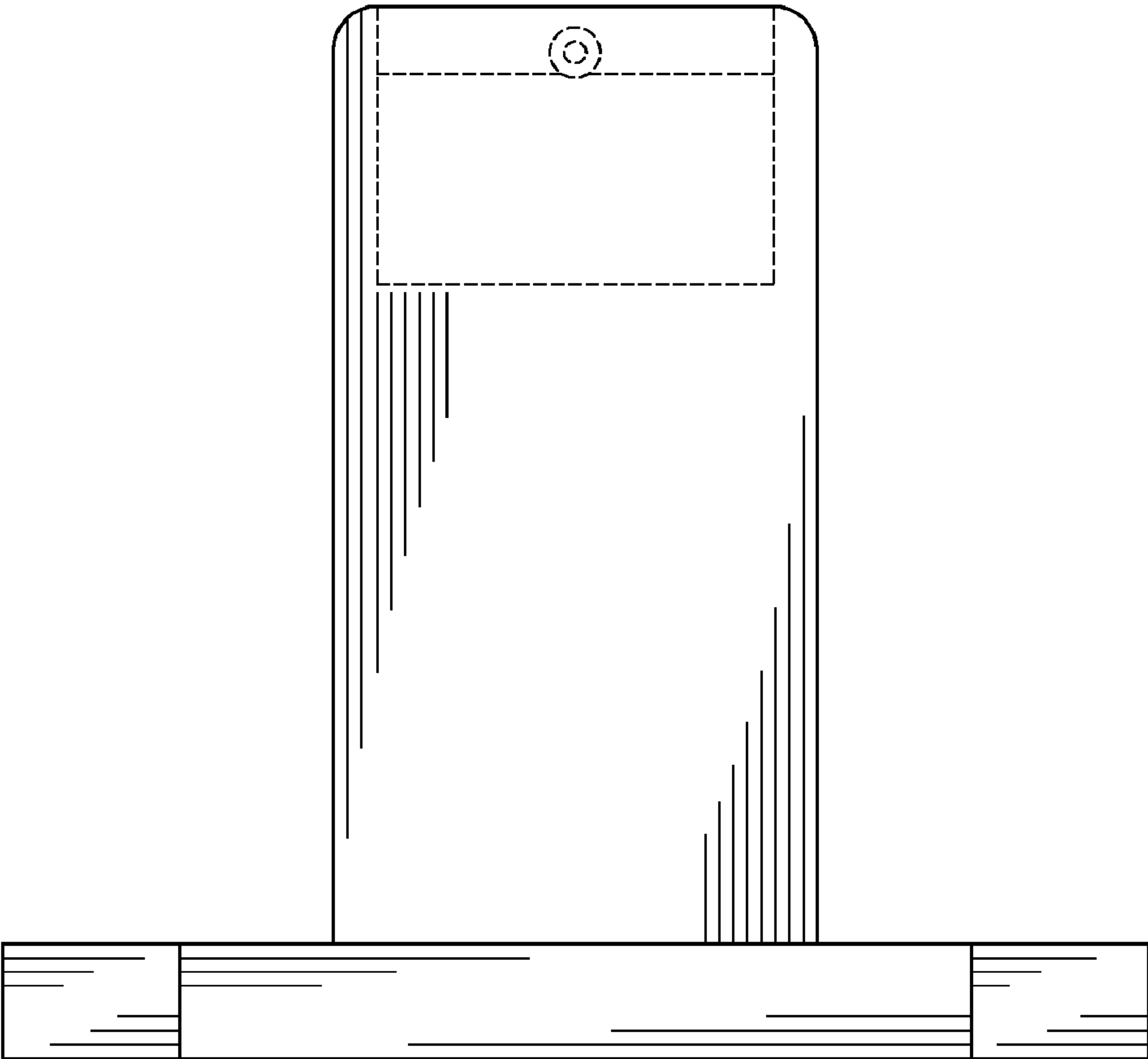

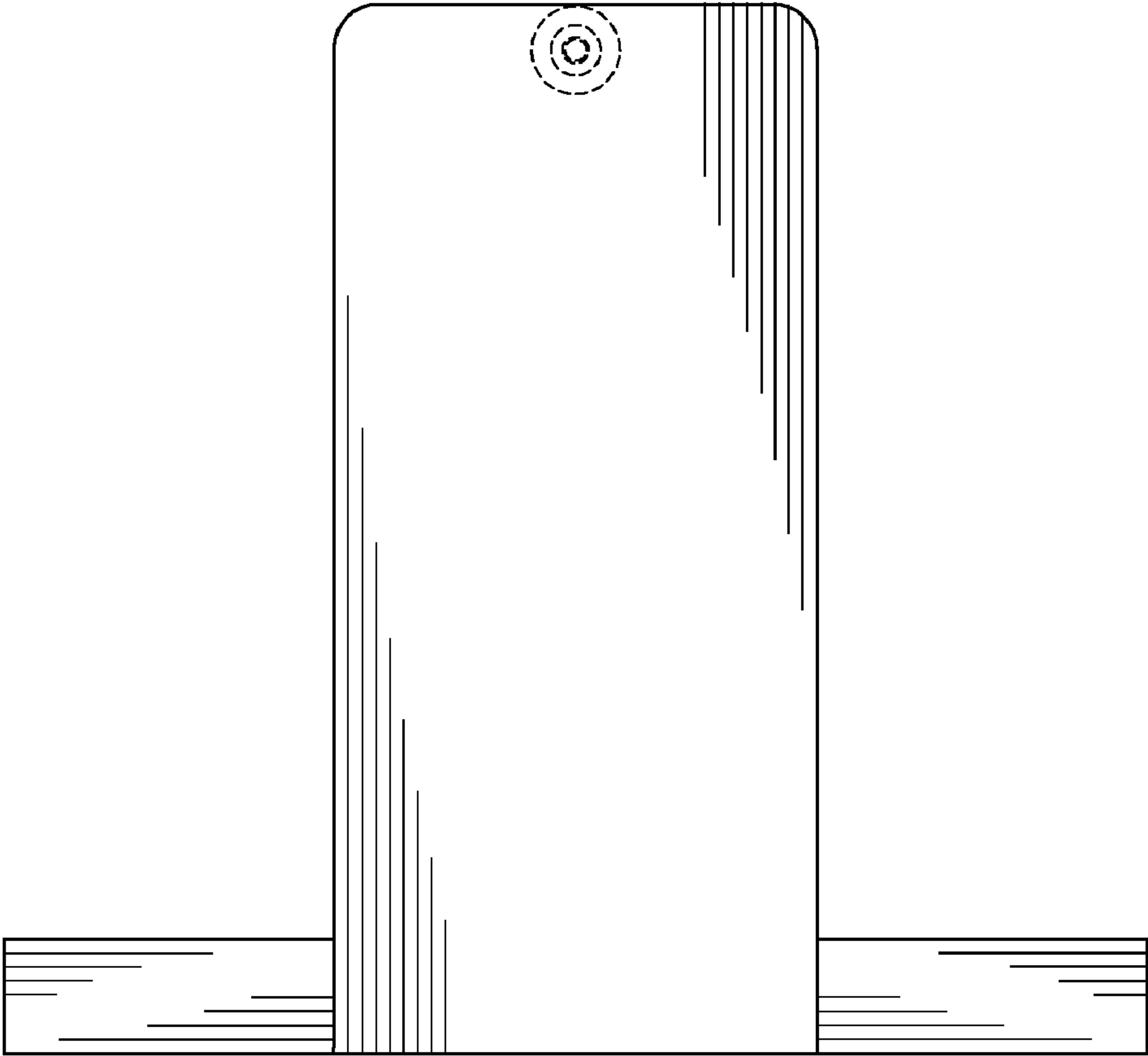

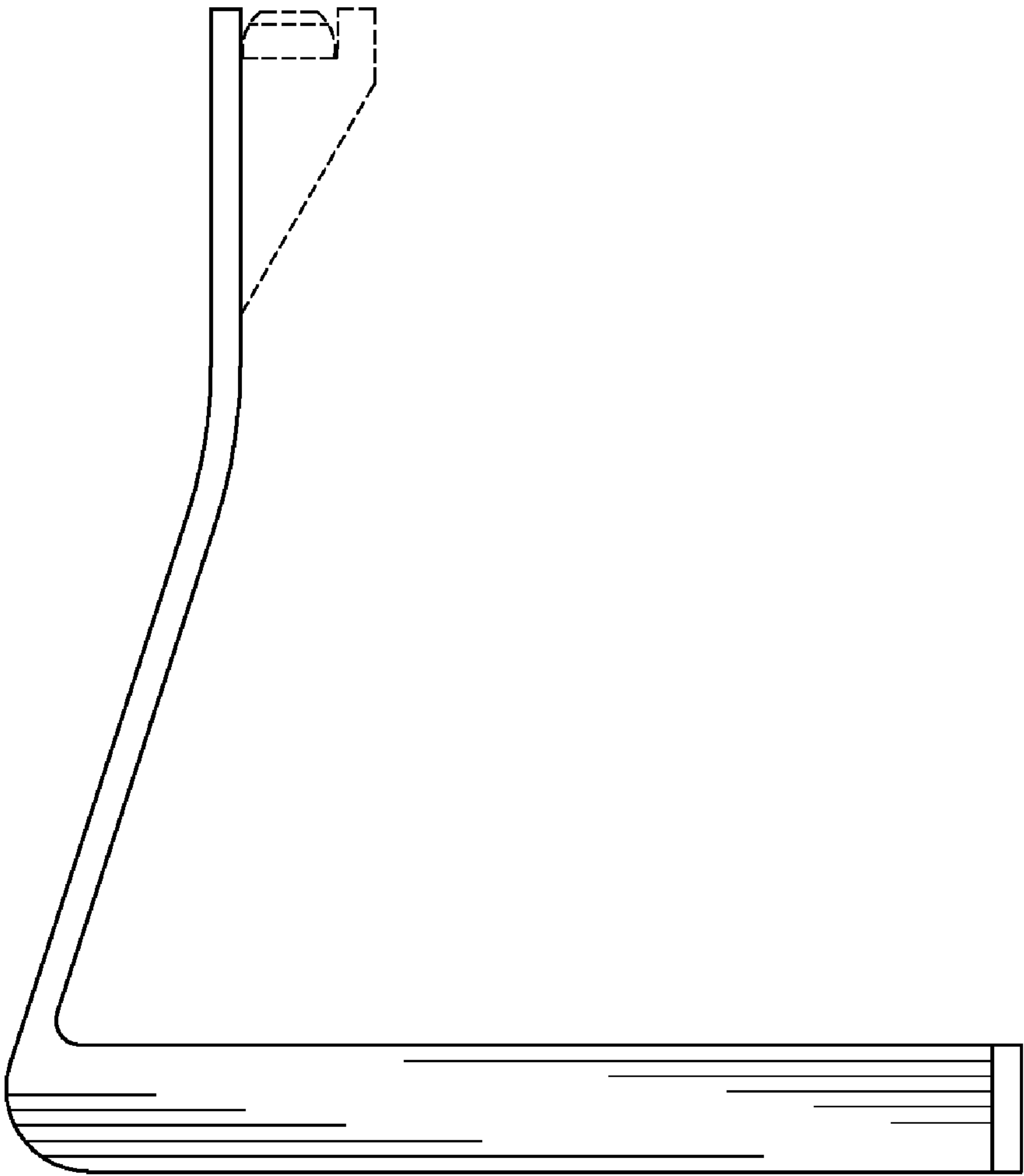

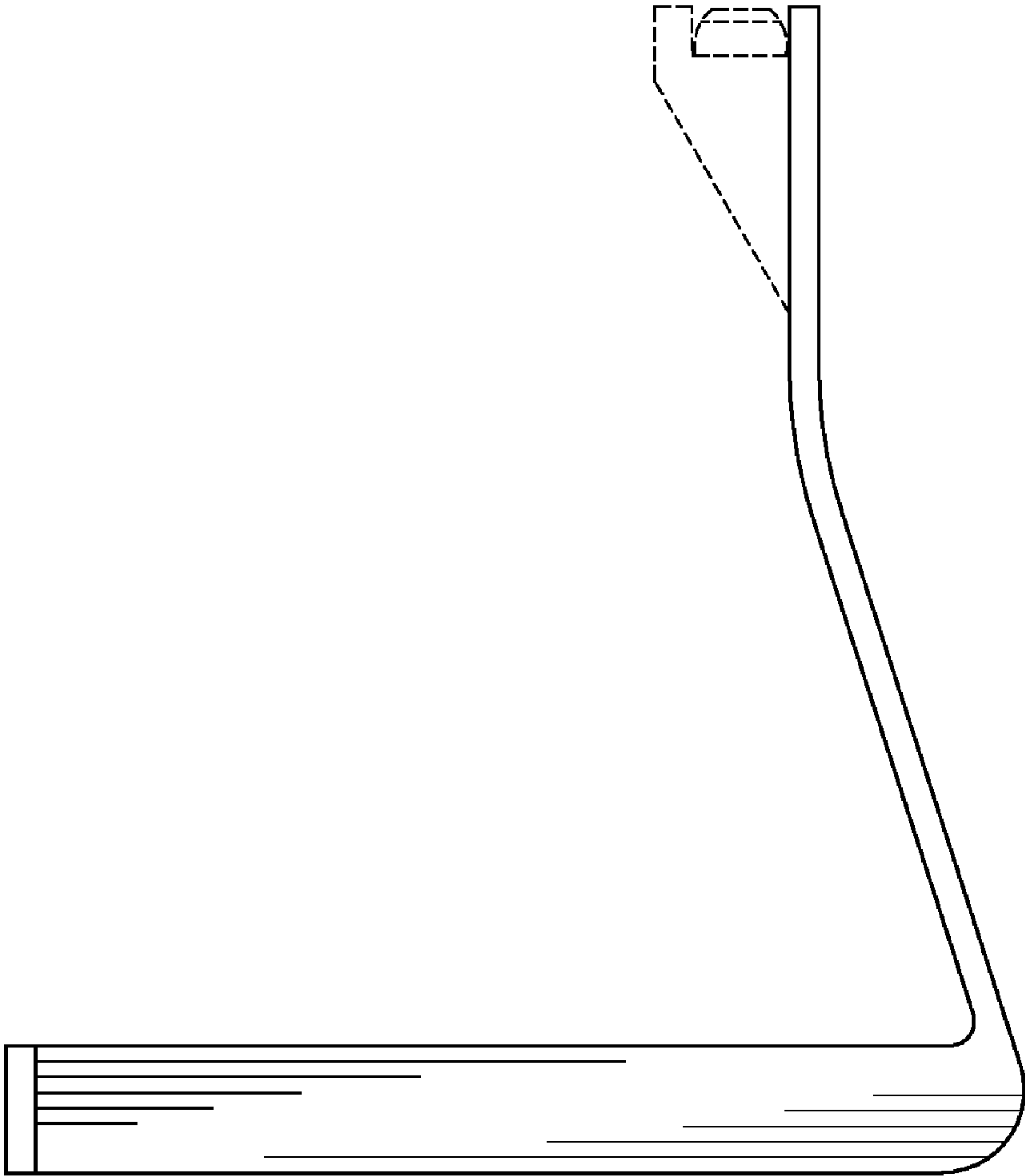

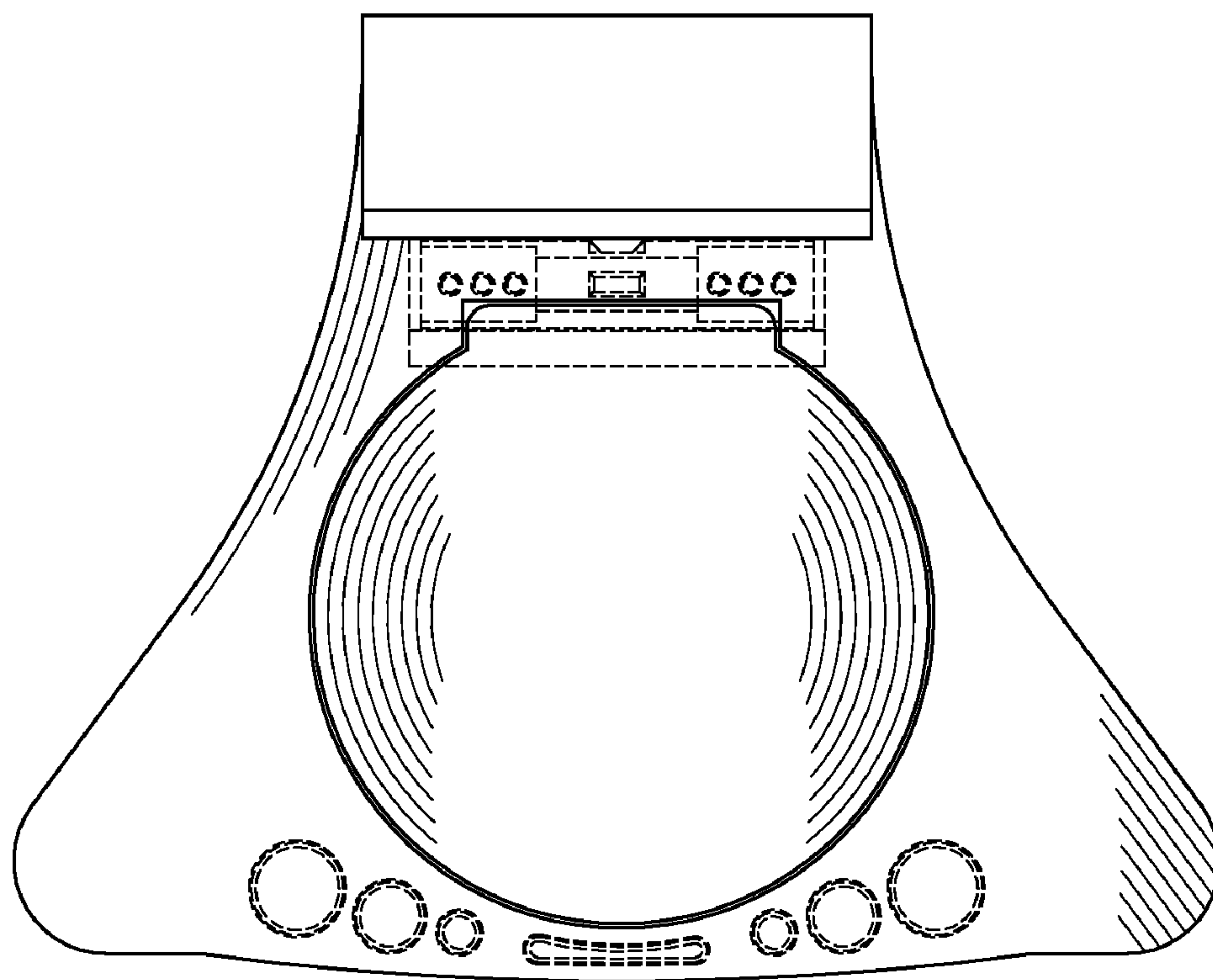

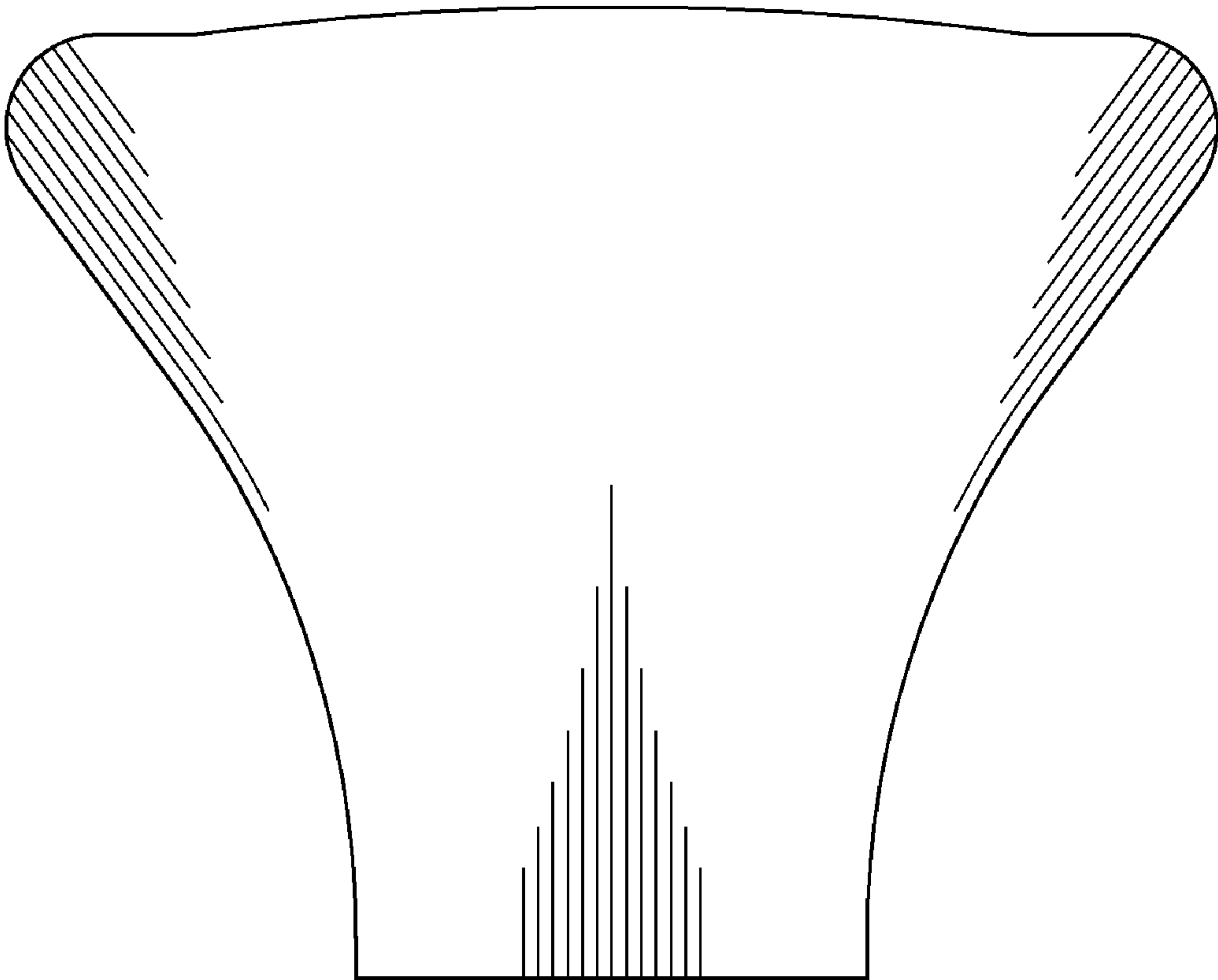

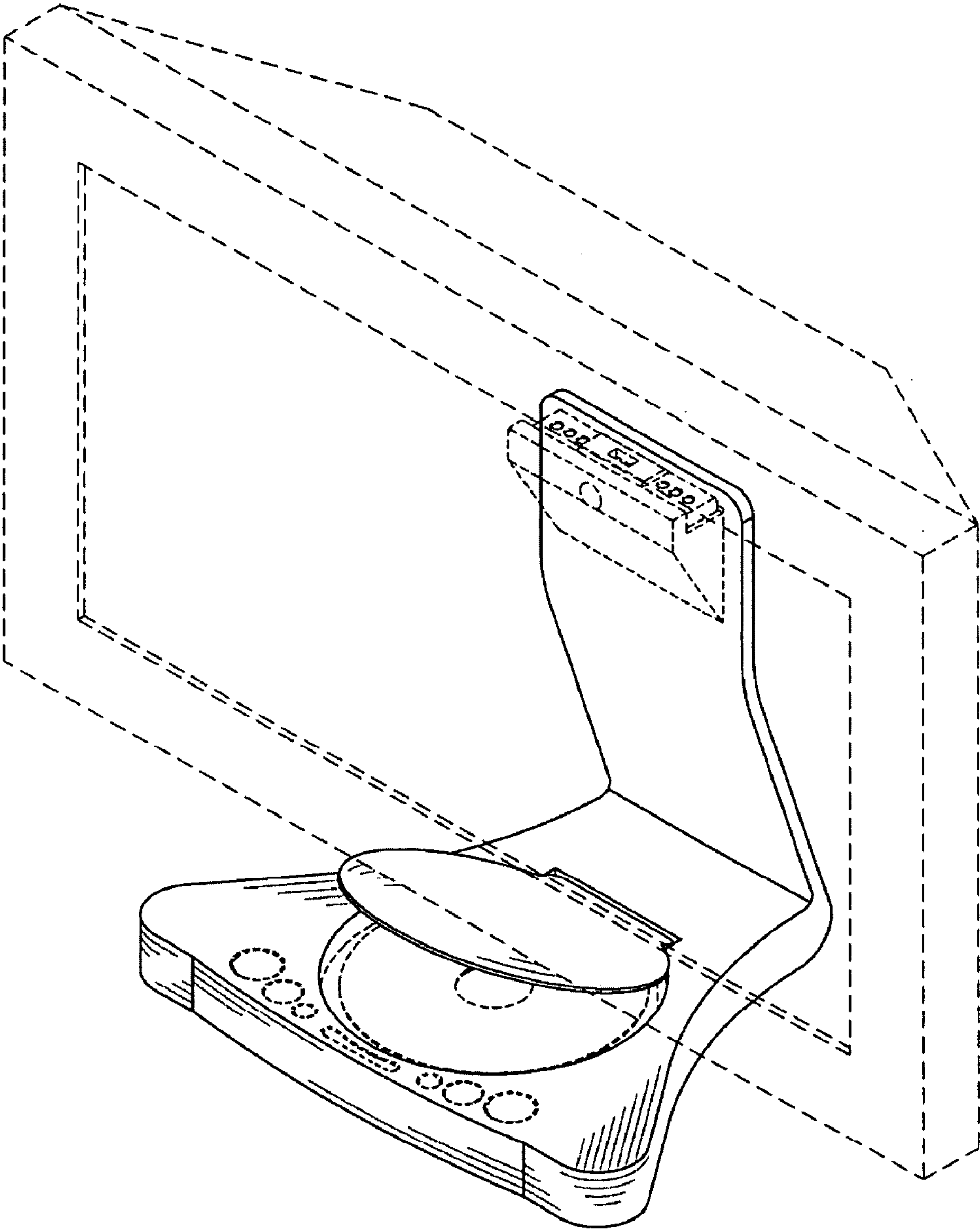
