FIG. 11 is a bottom view of the display board of FIG. 8.

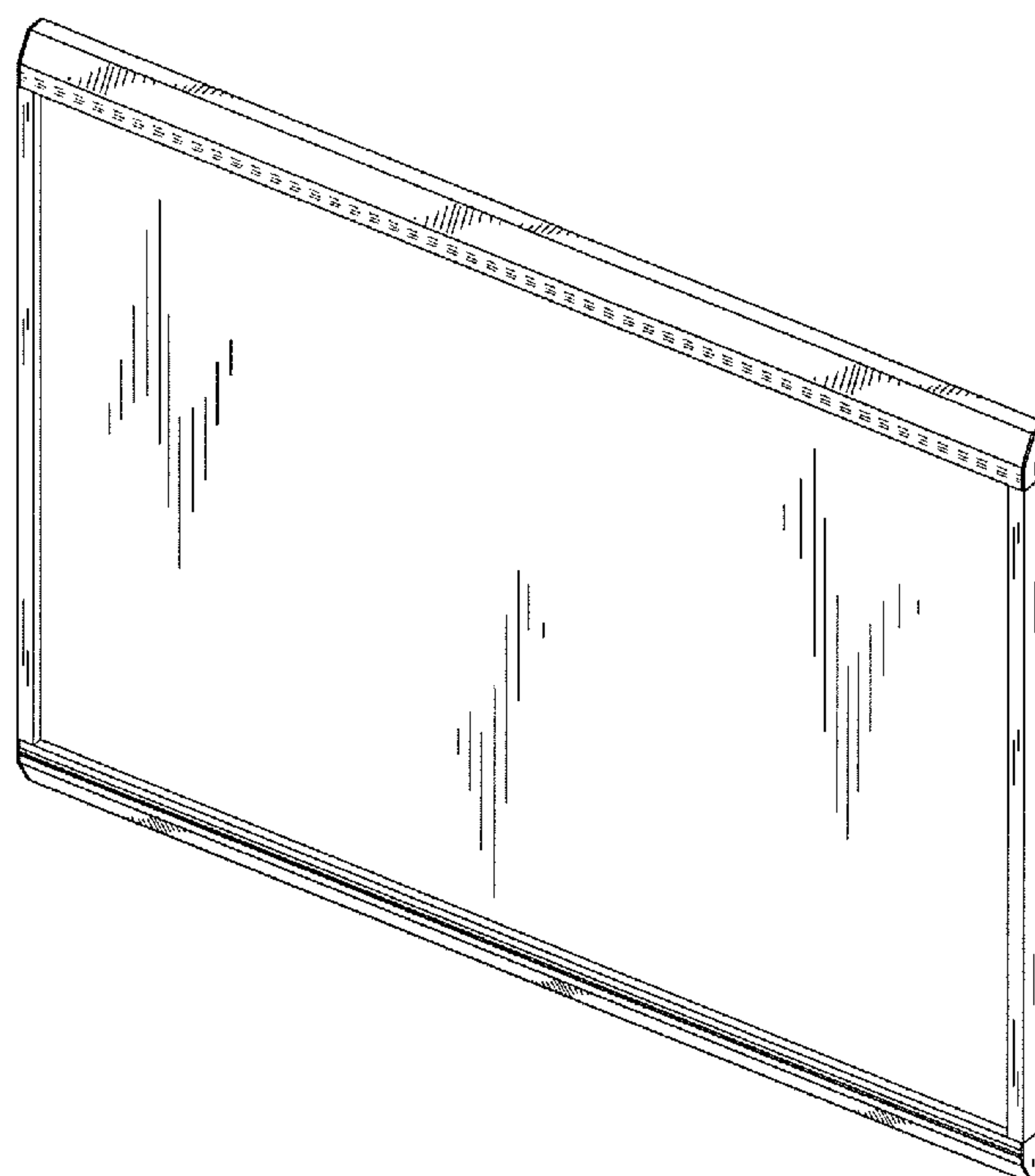
FIG. 12 is a right-side view of the display board of FIG. 8.

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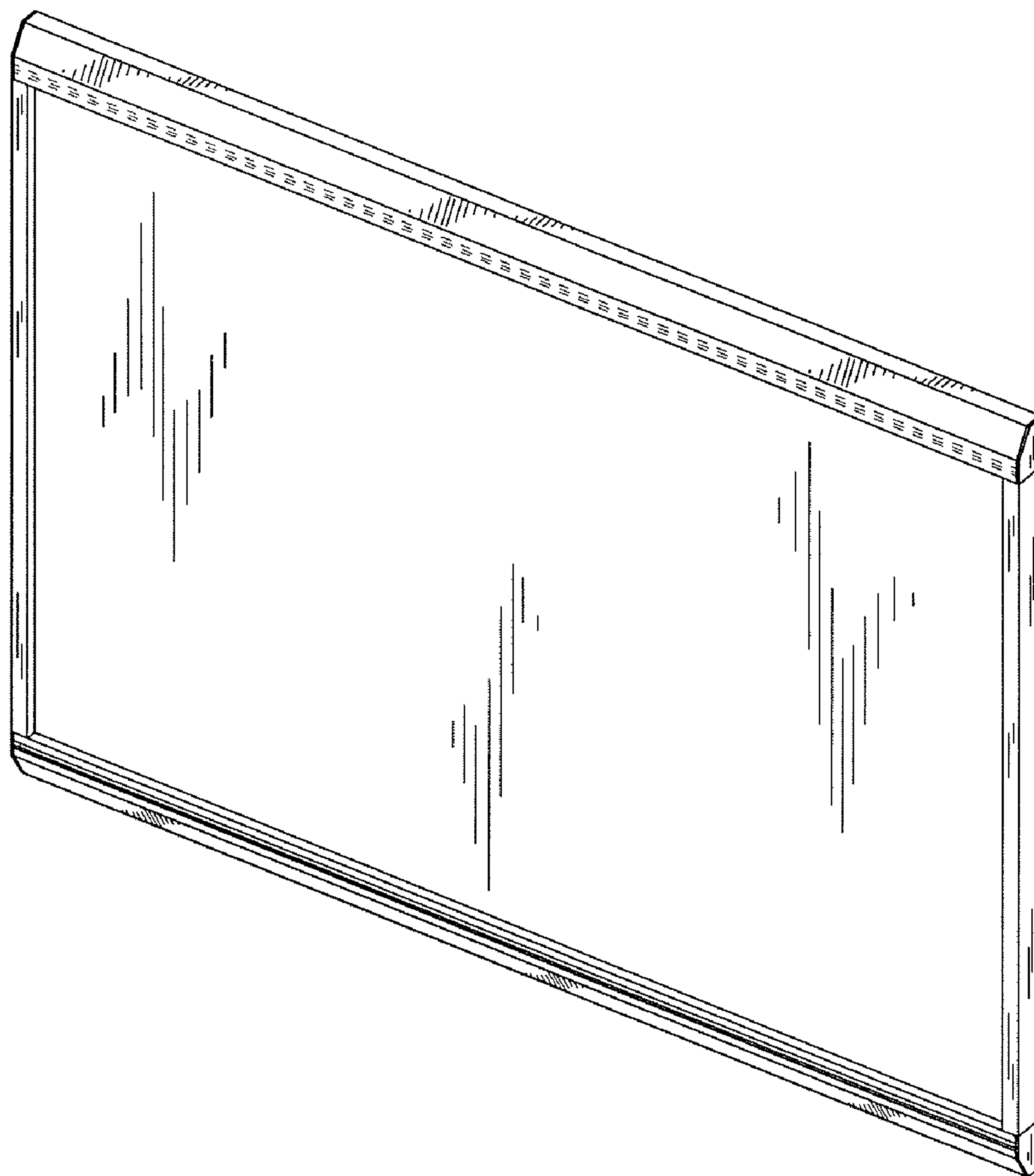

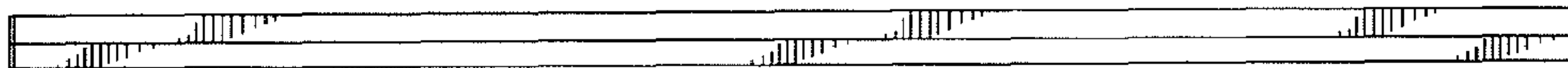

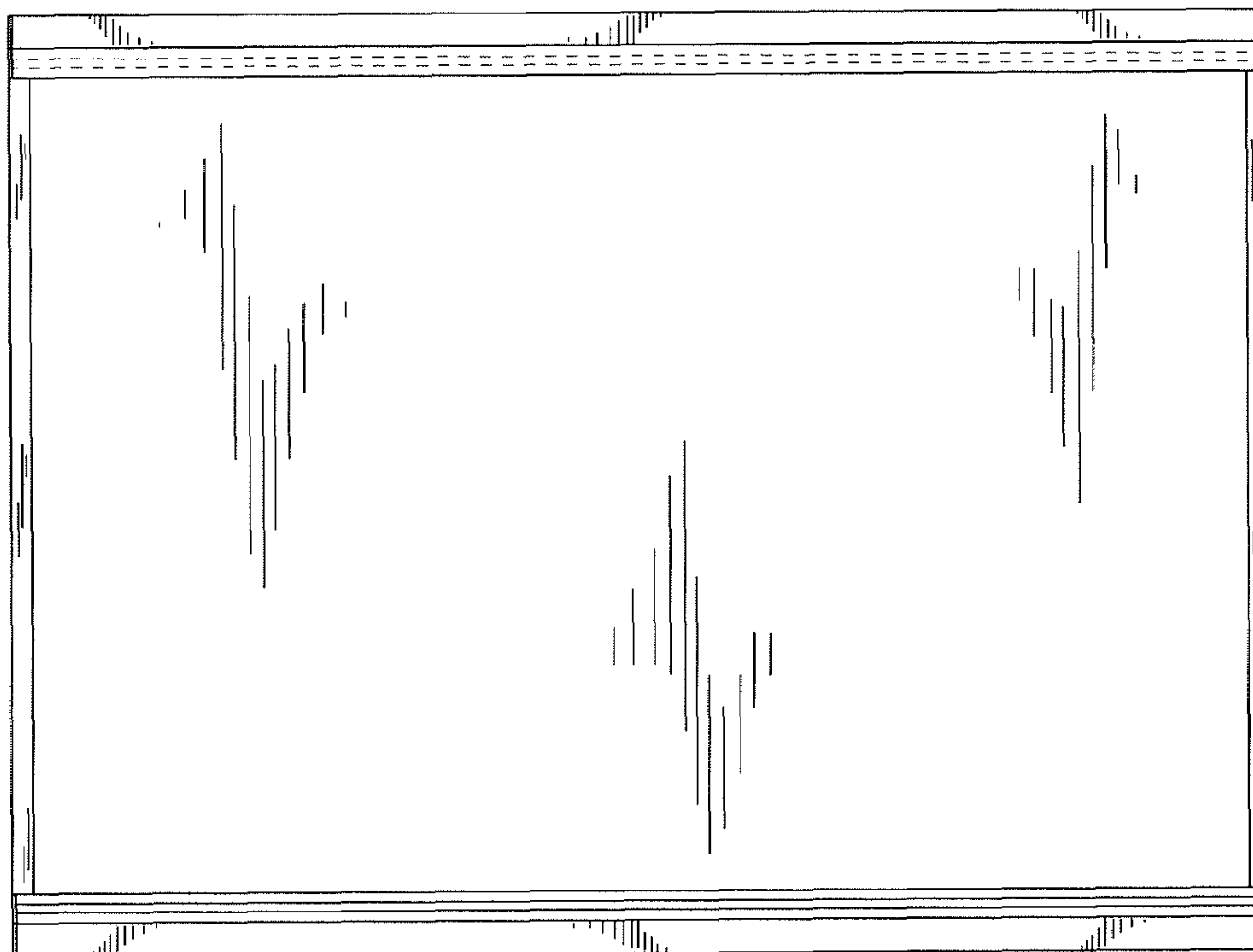

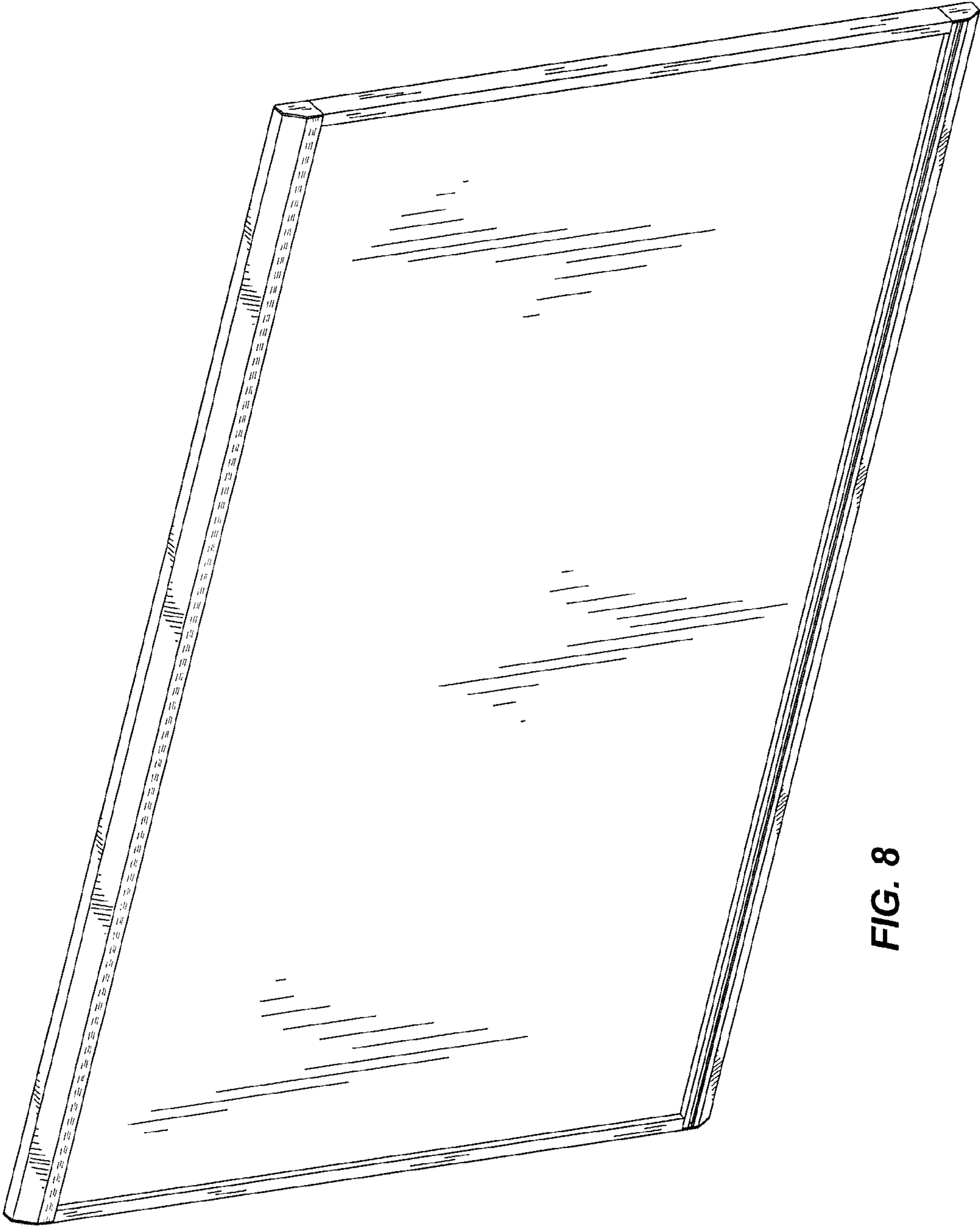

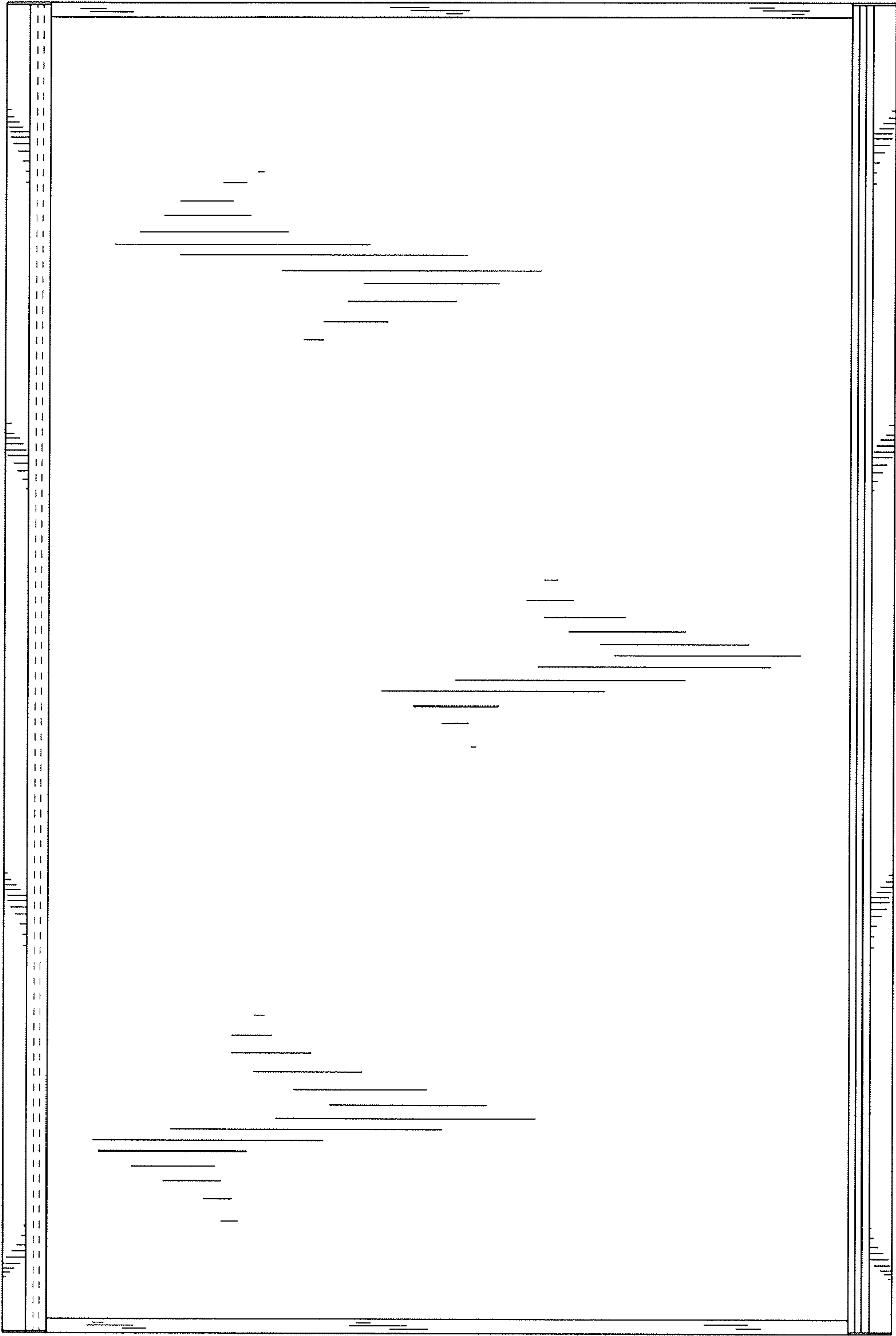

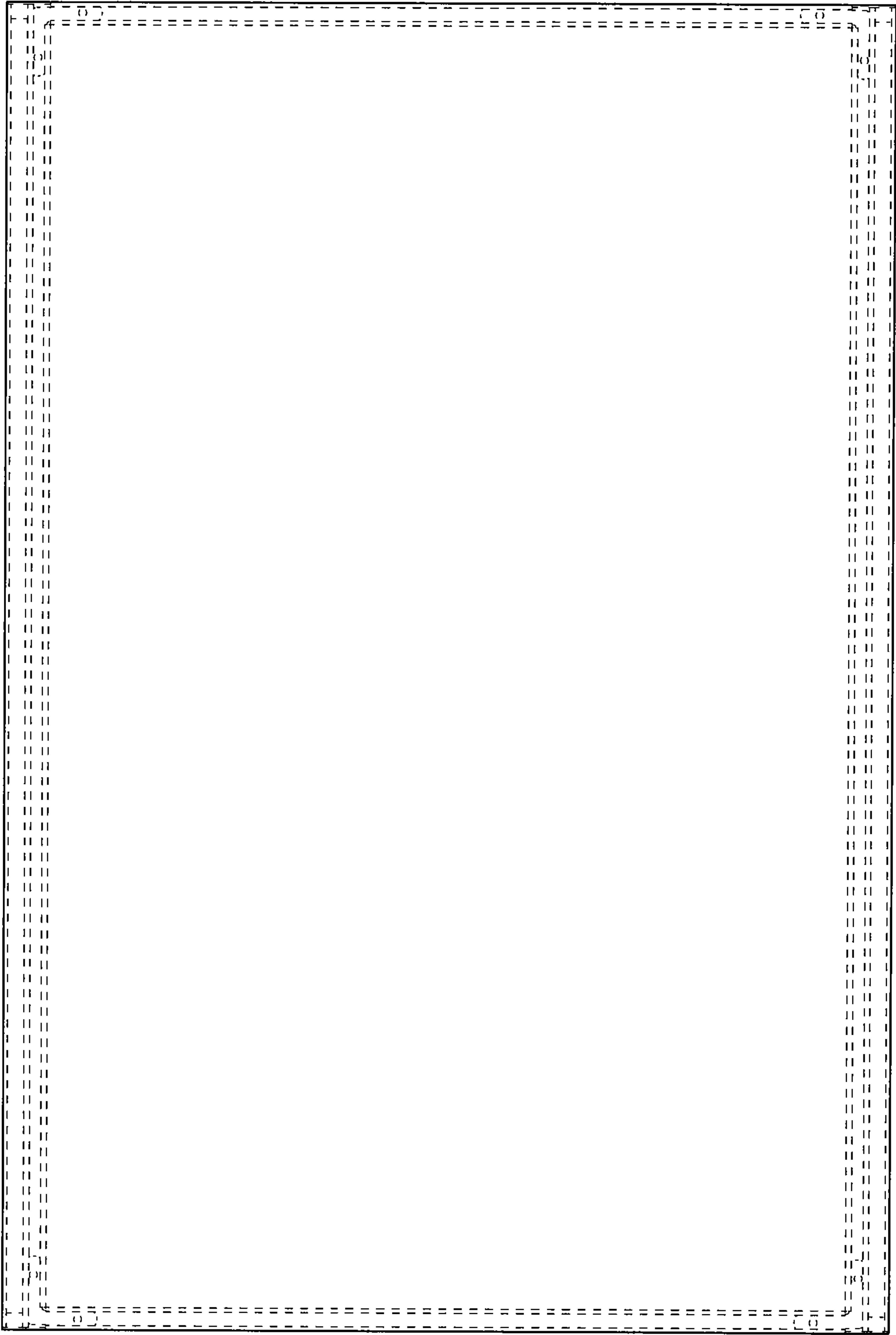
