FIG. 1 is an absorbent pad for buttocks, as shown and described in an environmental view;

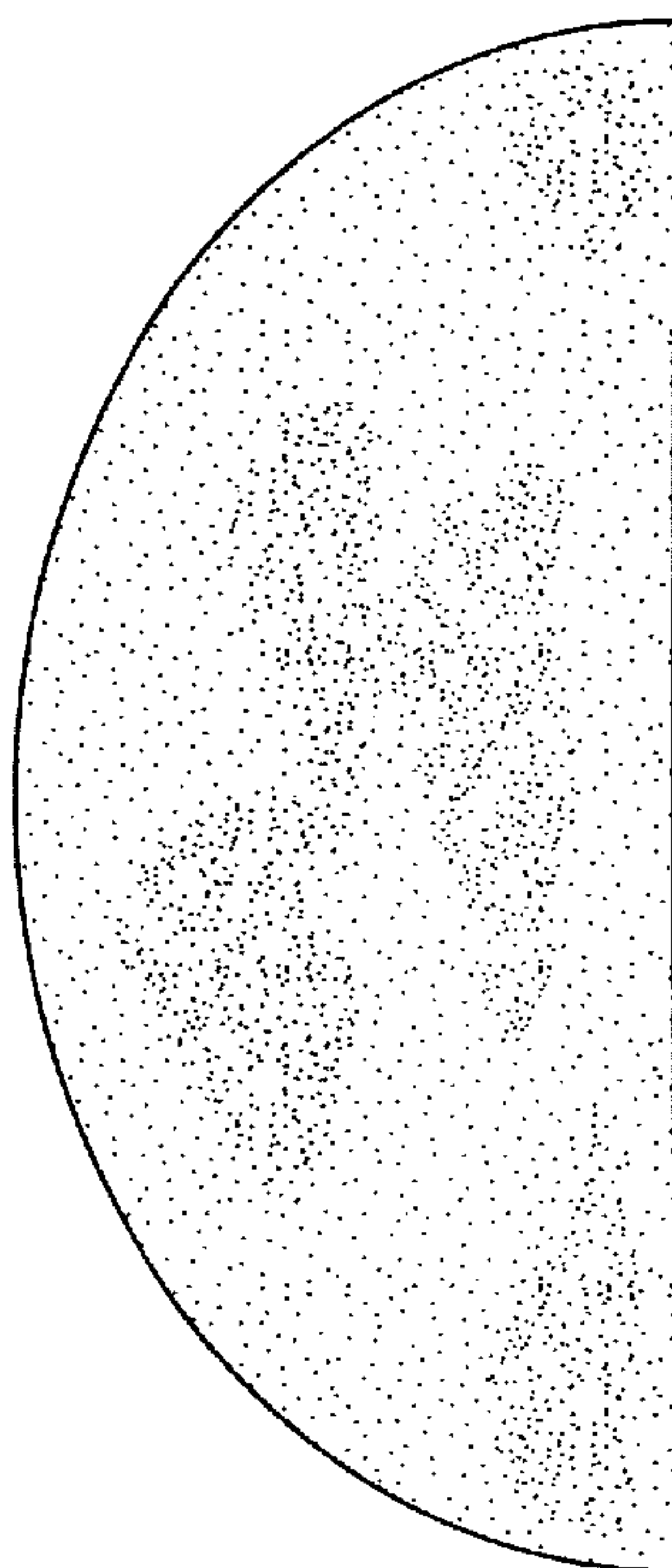
FIG. 2 is a side thereof said absorbent pad for buttocks;

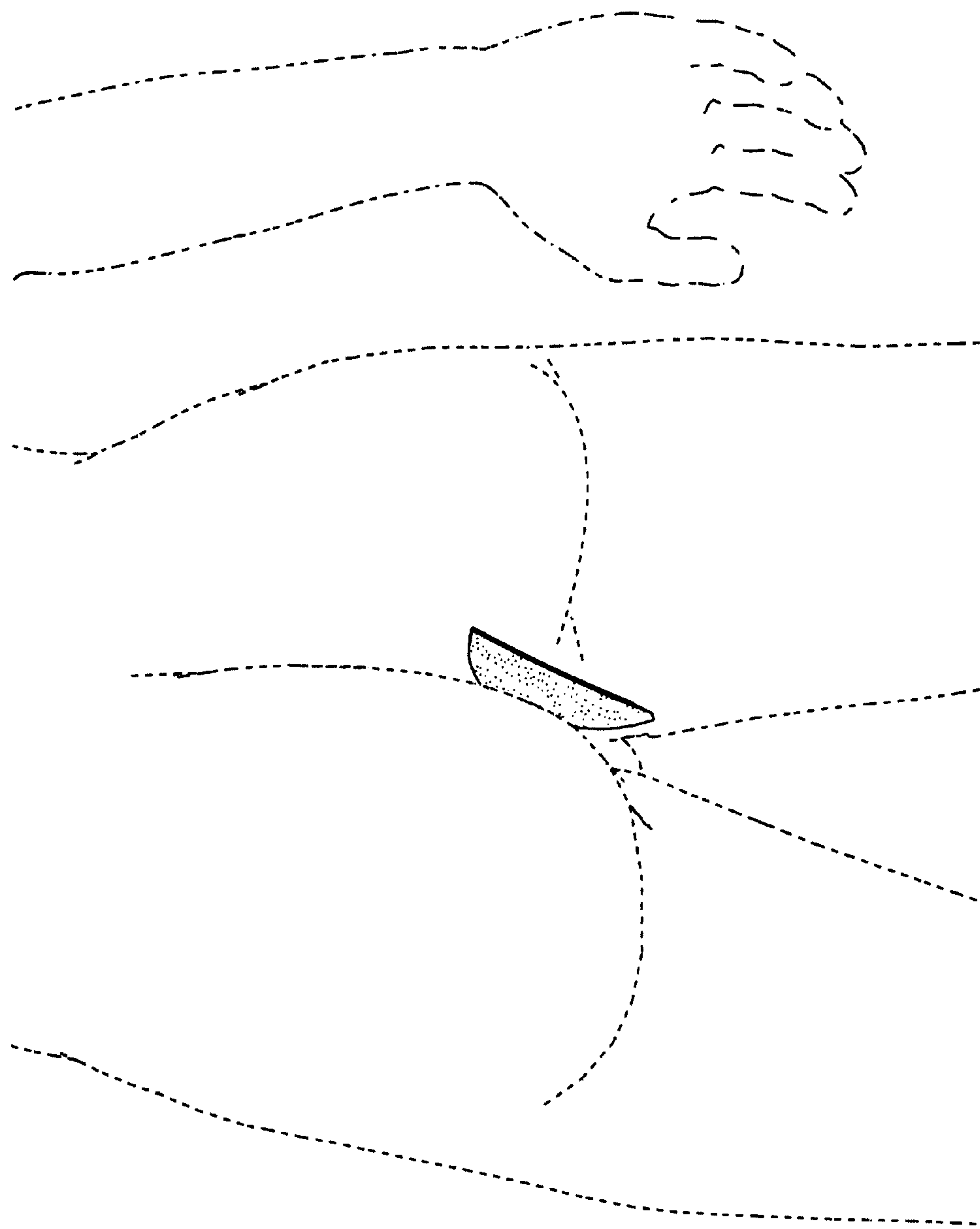

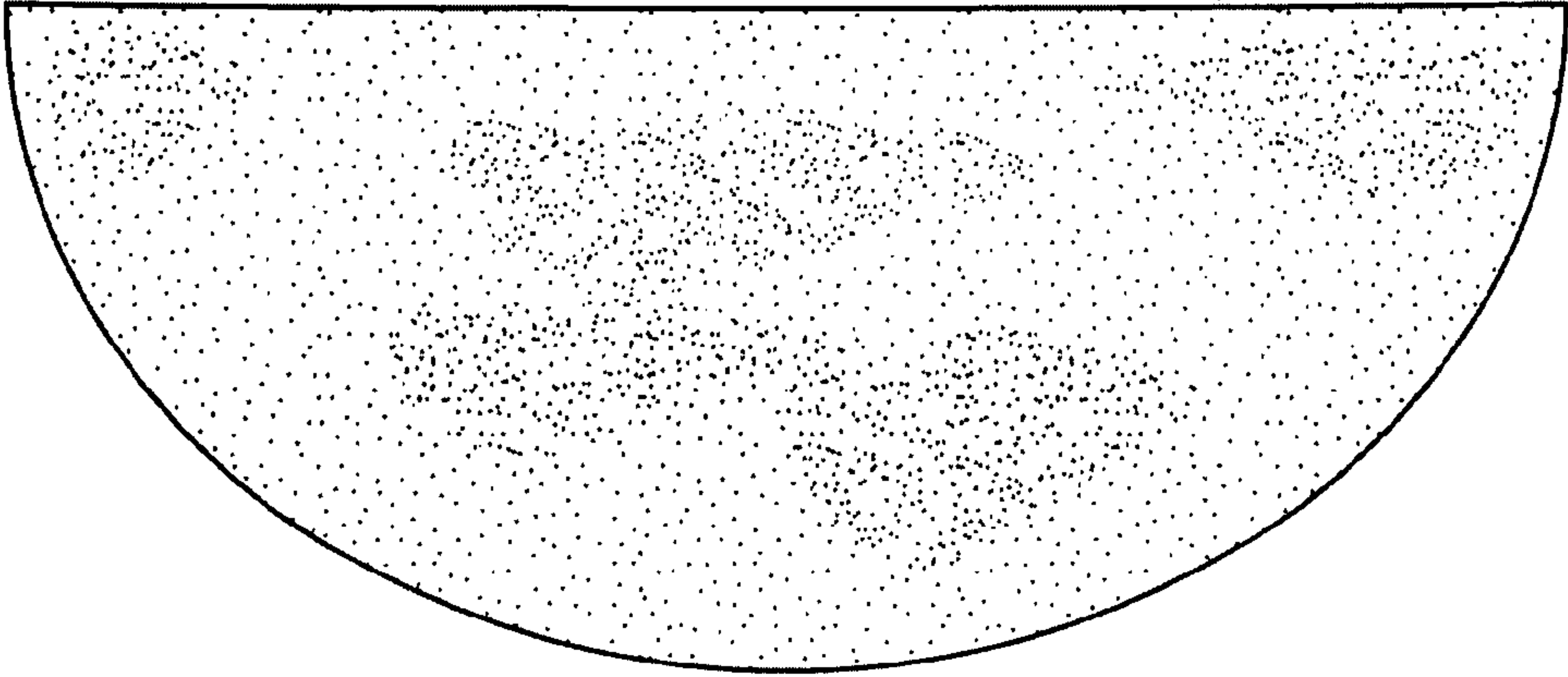
