(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an antenna for wireless tag, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of an antenna for wireless tag showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a left side view thereof; and,

FIG. 7 is an enlarged view showing the area defined by indicia 7A and 7B on FIG. 3.

The shading in FIGS. 3, 4, and 7 indicates that the base layer of the design is transparent. The broken lines in the figures depict environmental subject matter only and form no part of the claimed design. In FIG. 3 the indicia outside the broken-line perimeter are not part of the claimed design.

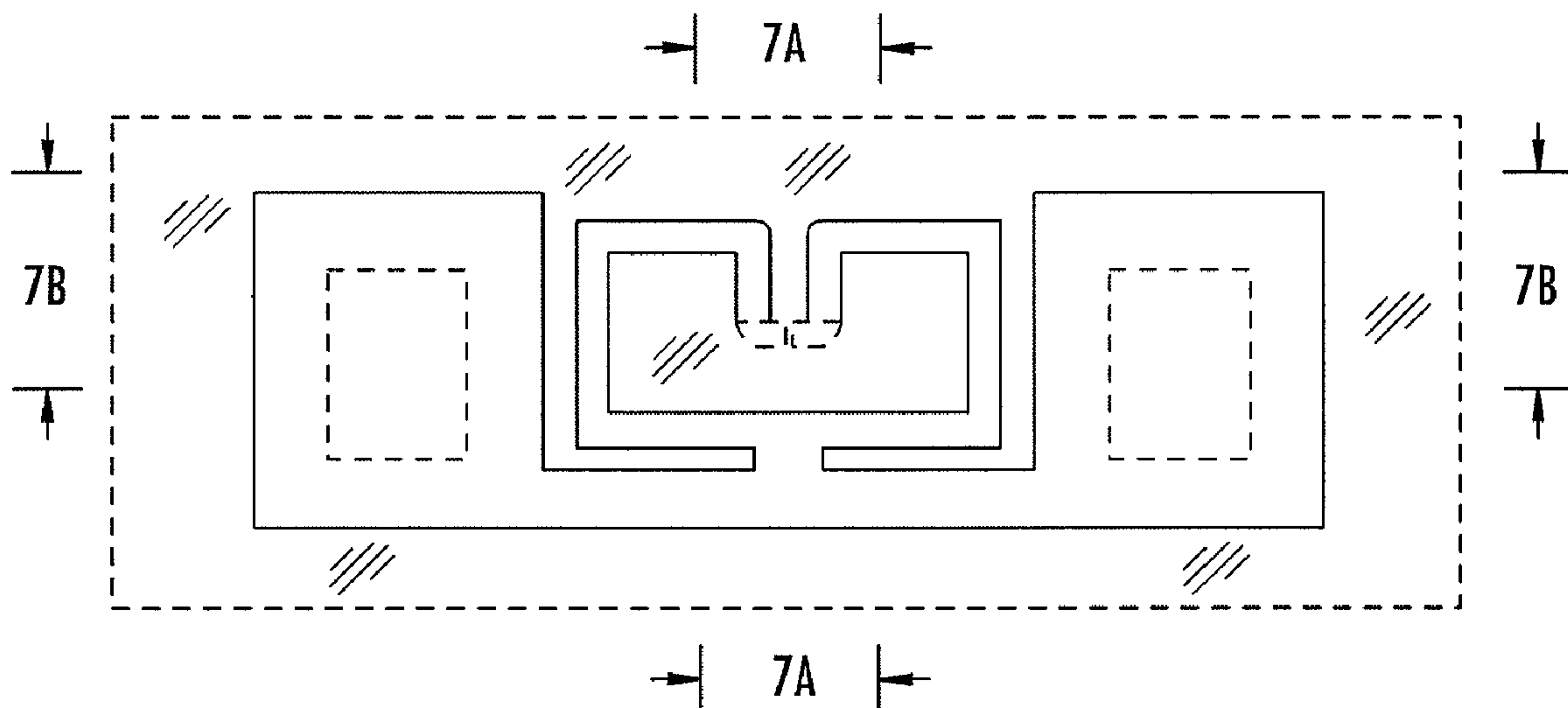

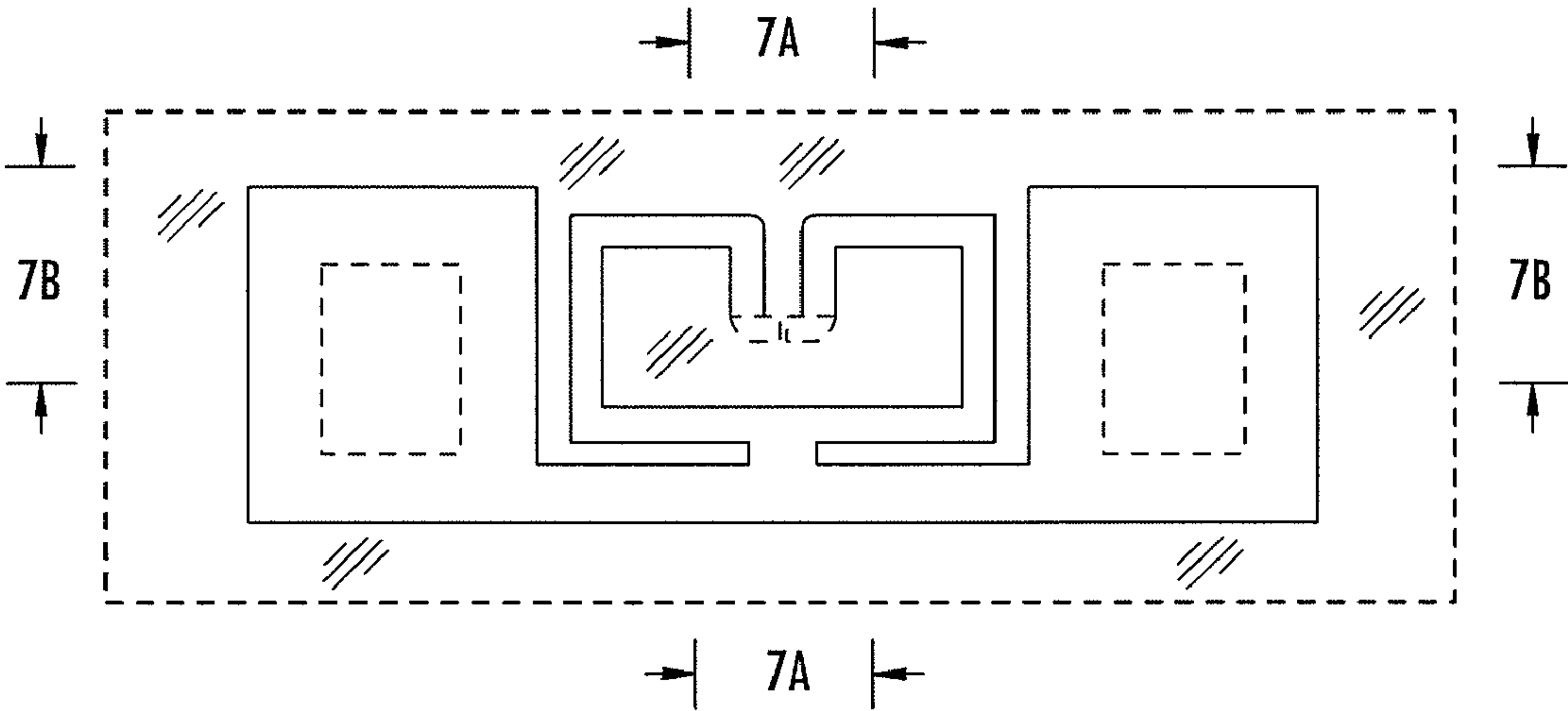

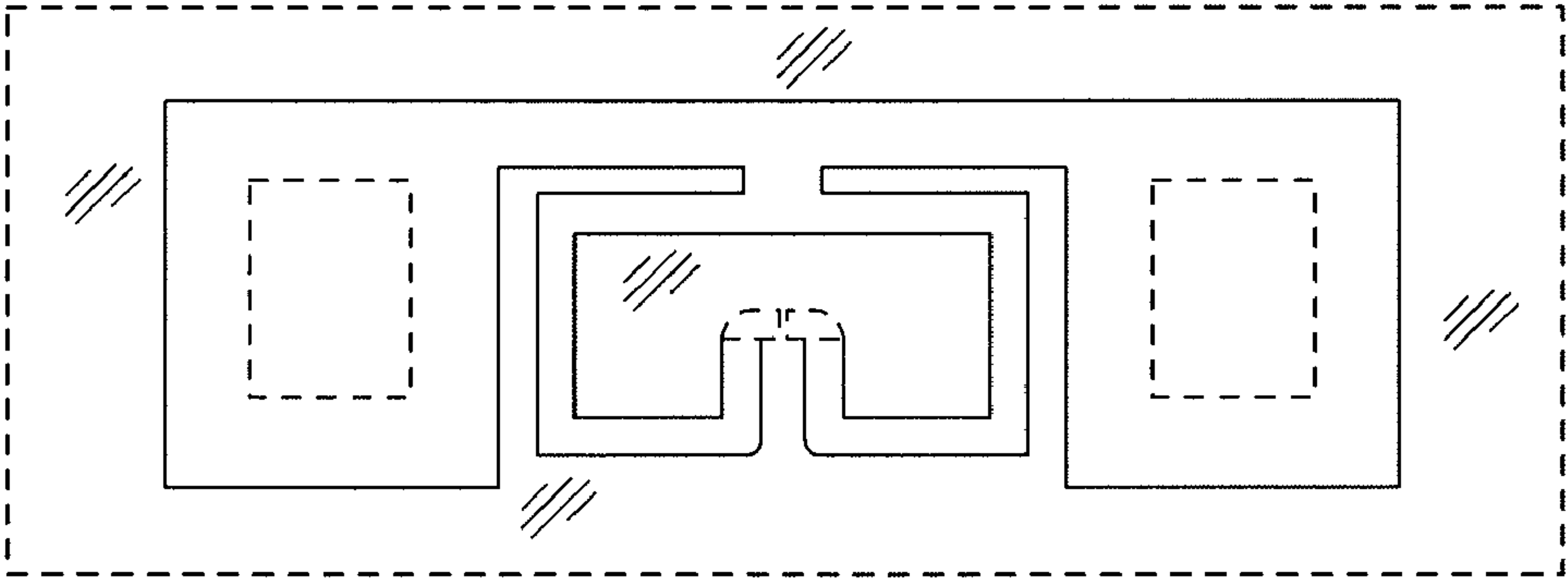

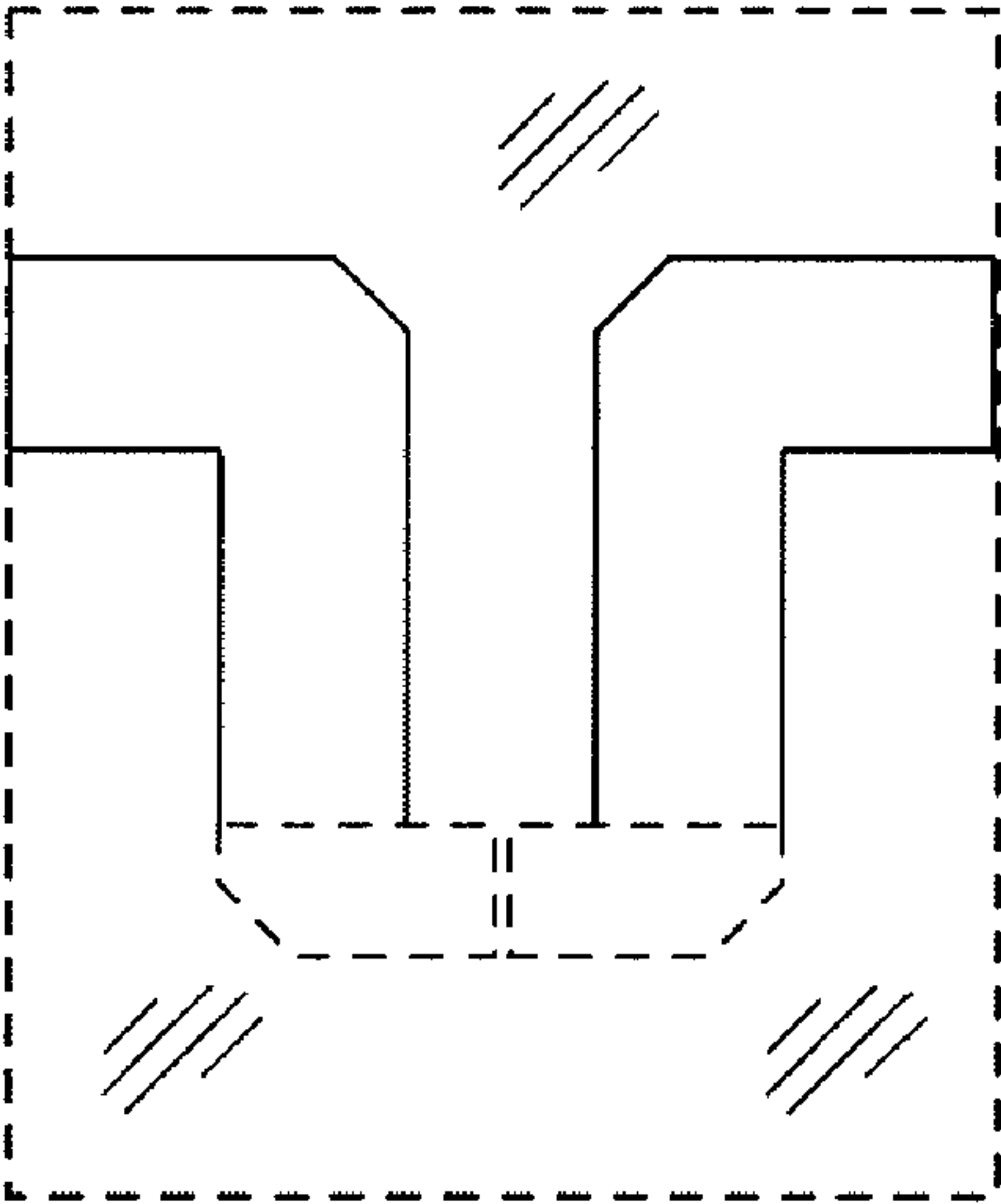
