The ornamental design for a crib, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a lower perspective view showing our new design for
a crib.

FIG. 2 is an upper perspective view thereof.

FIG. 3 is a right side plan view thereof, the left side being a
mirror image.

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.

FIG. 5 is a cross-section plan view along lines 5—5 of FIG. 4.

FIG. 6 is a cross-section plan view along lines 6—6 of FIG. 4.

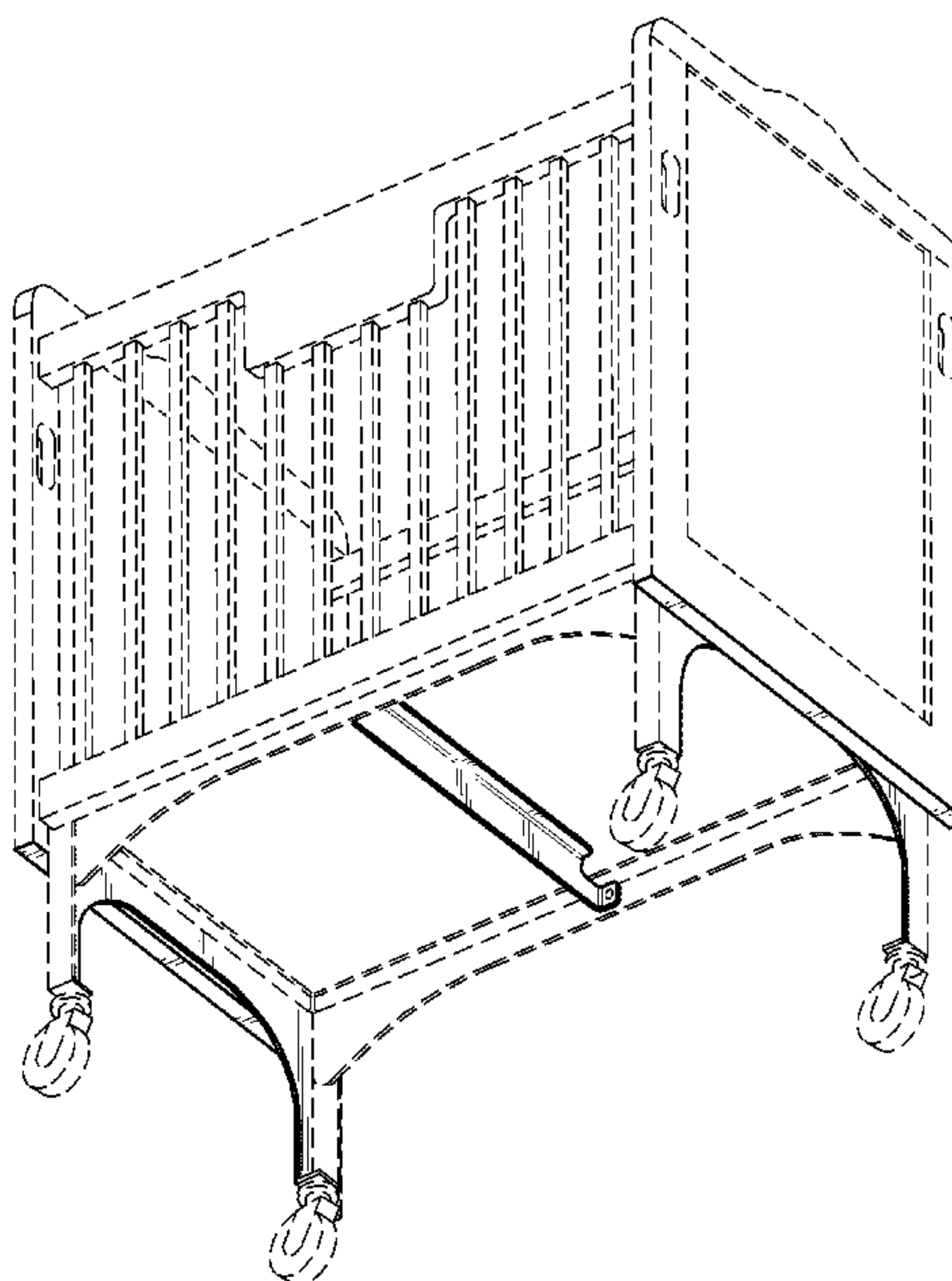
FIG. 7 is a cross-section plan view along lines 7—7 of FIG. 4.

FIG. 8 is a front side plan view thereof, the back side being a
mirror image; and,

FIG. 9 is a top plan view thereof.

The broken lines adjacent the shaded areas represent the

representing the outline of the crib are for illustrative pur-
poses only, and form no part of the claimed design. The hatch
marks shown in cross-section in FIG. 7 are for illustrative
purposes only, form no part of the claimed design, and rep-
resent the interior portions of the material forming the design.

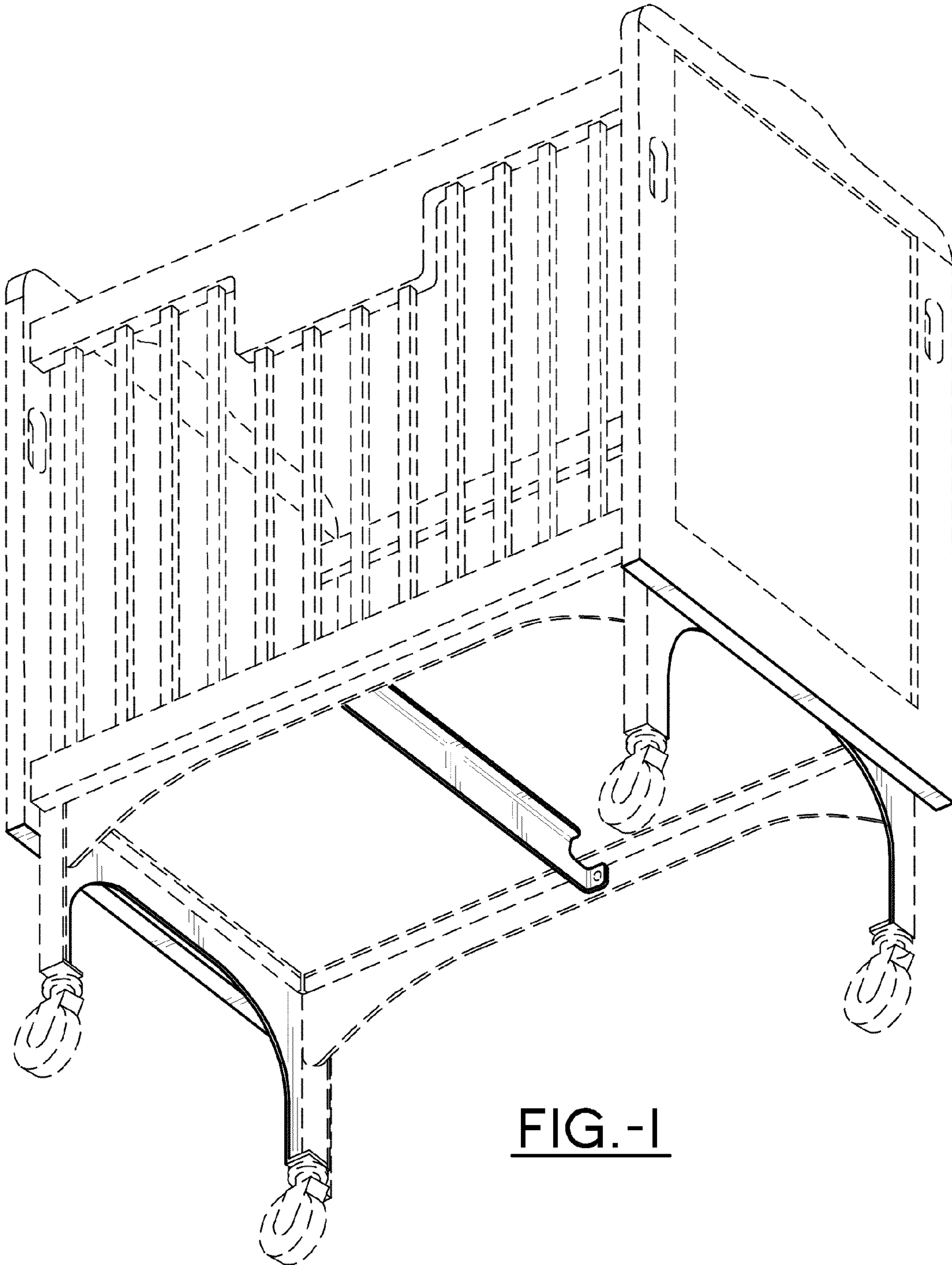

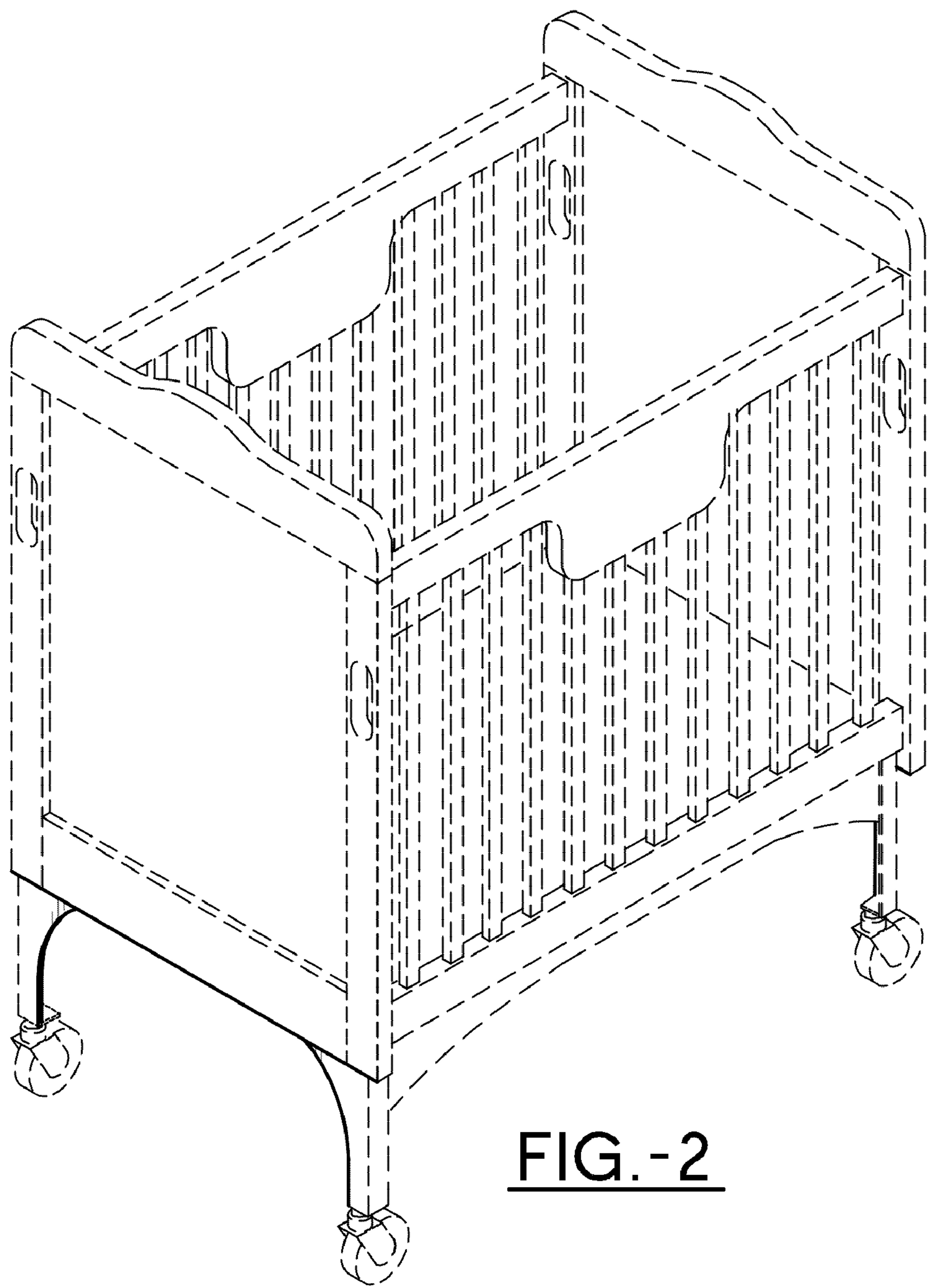

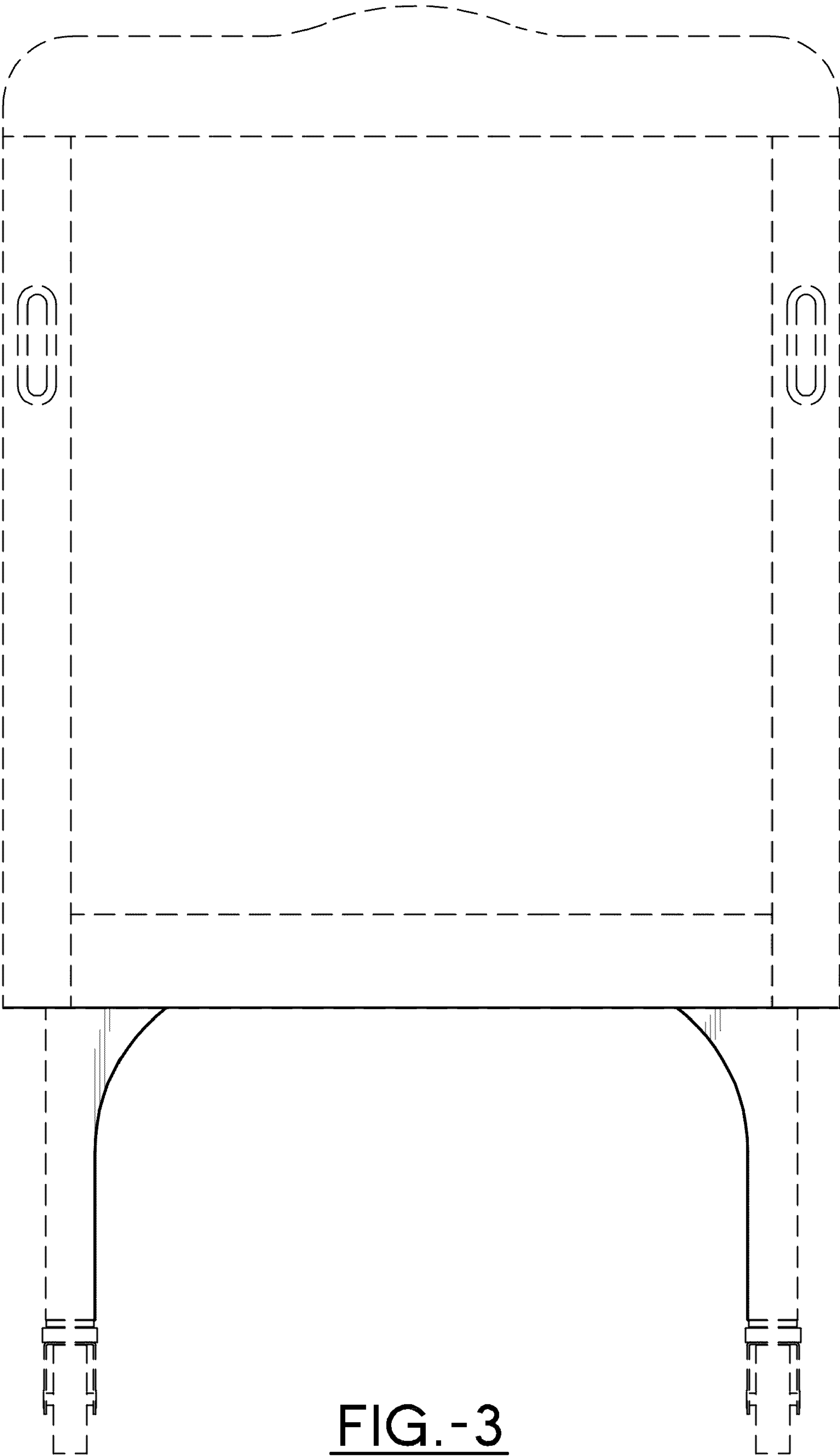

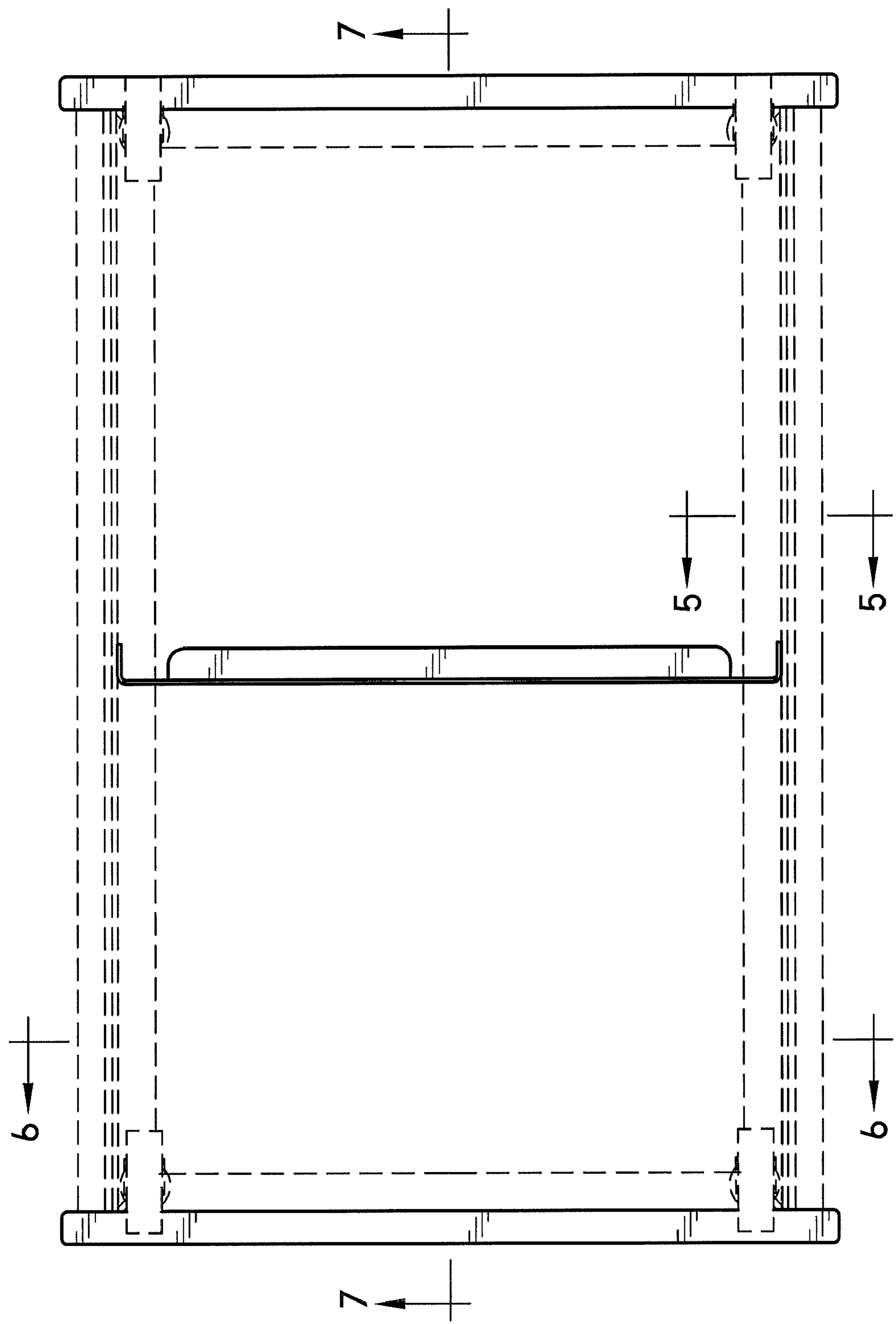

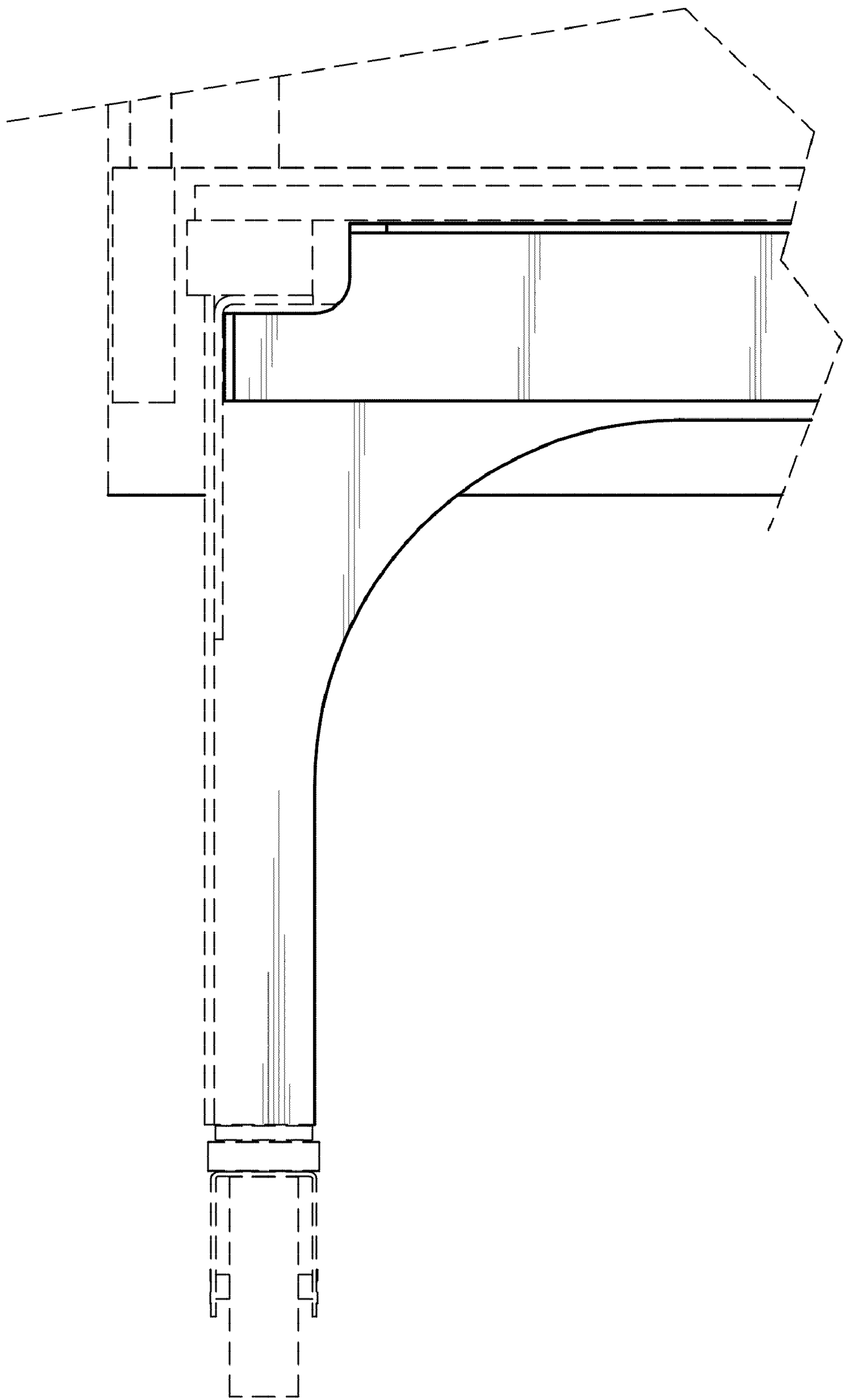

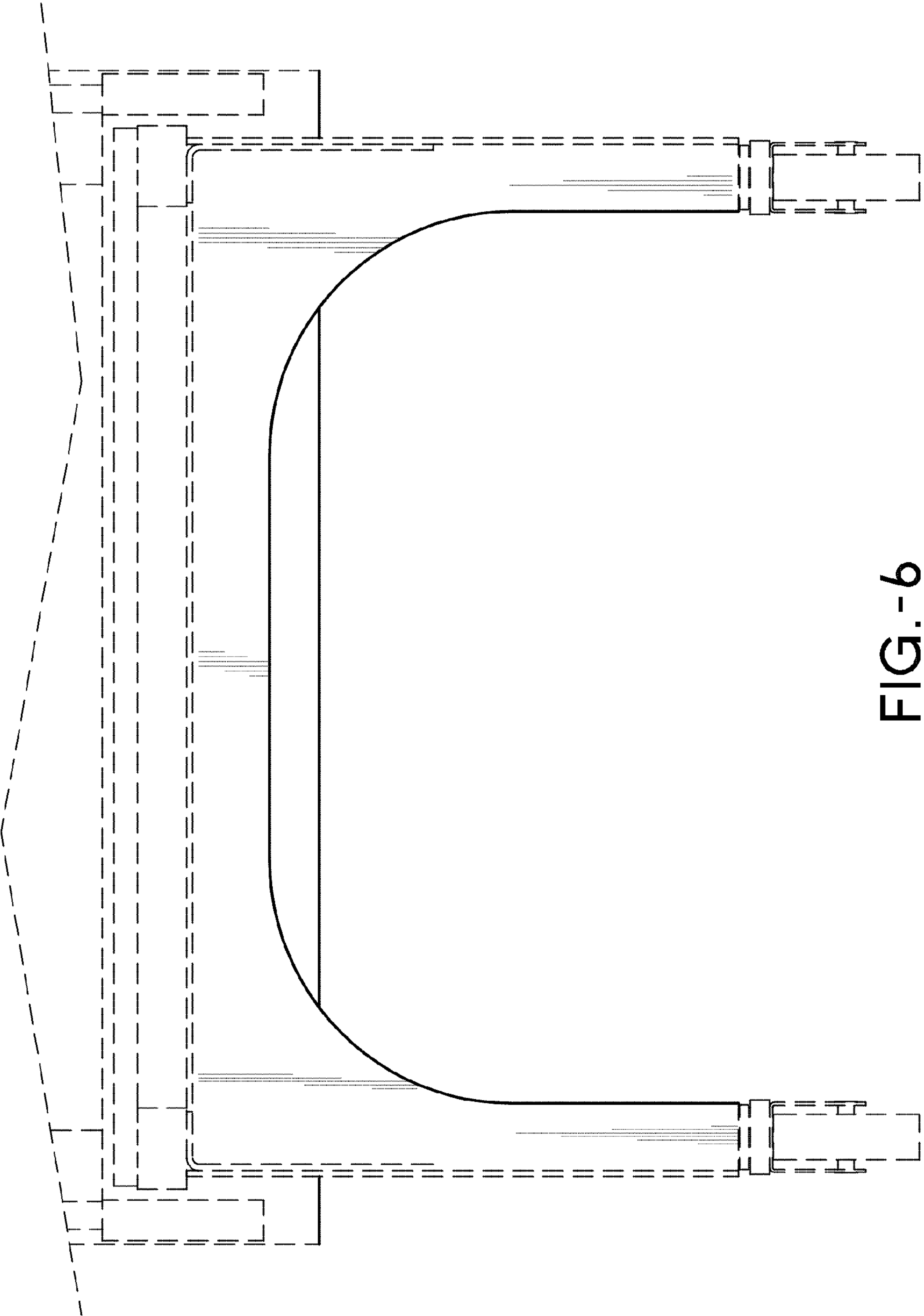

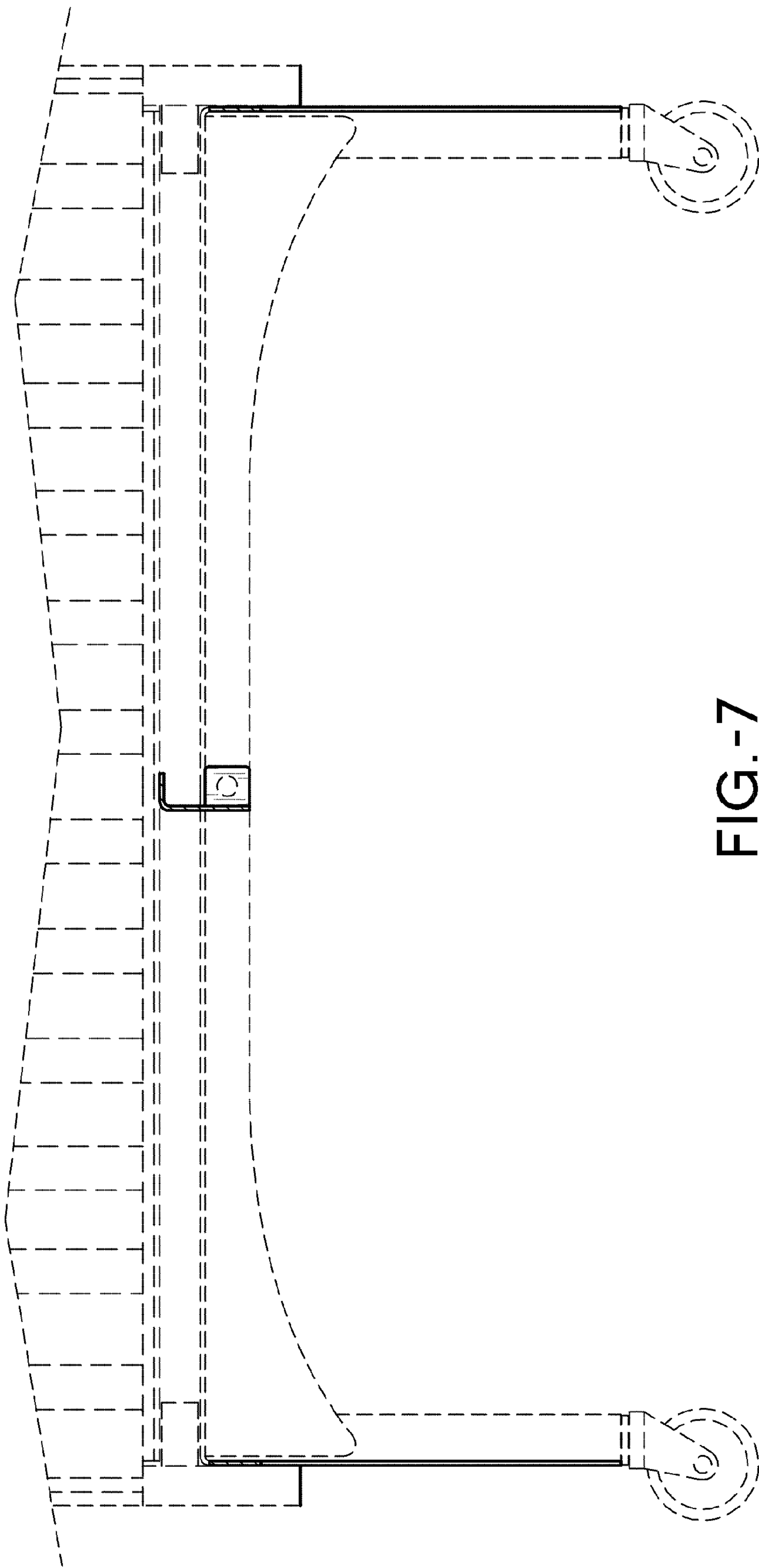

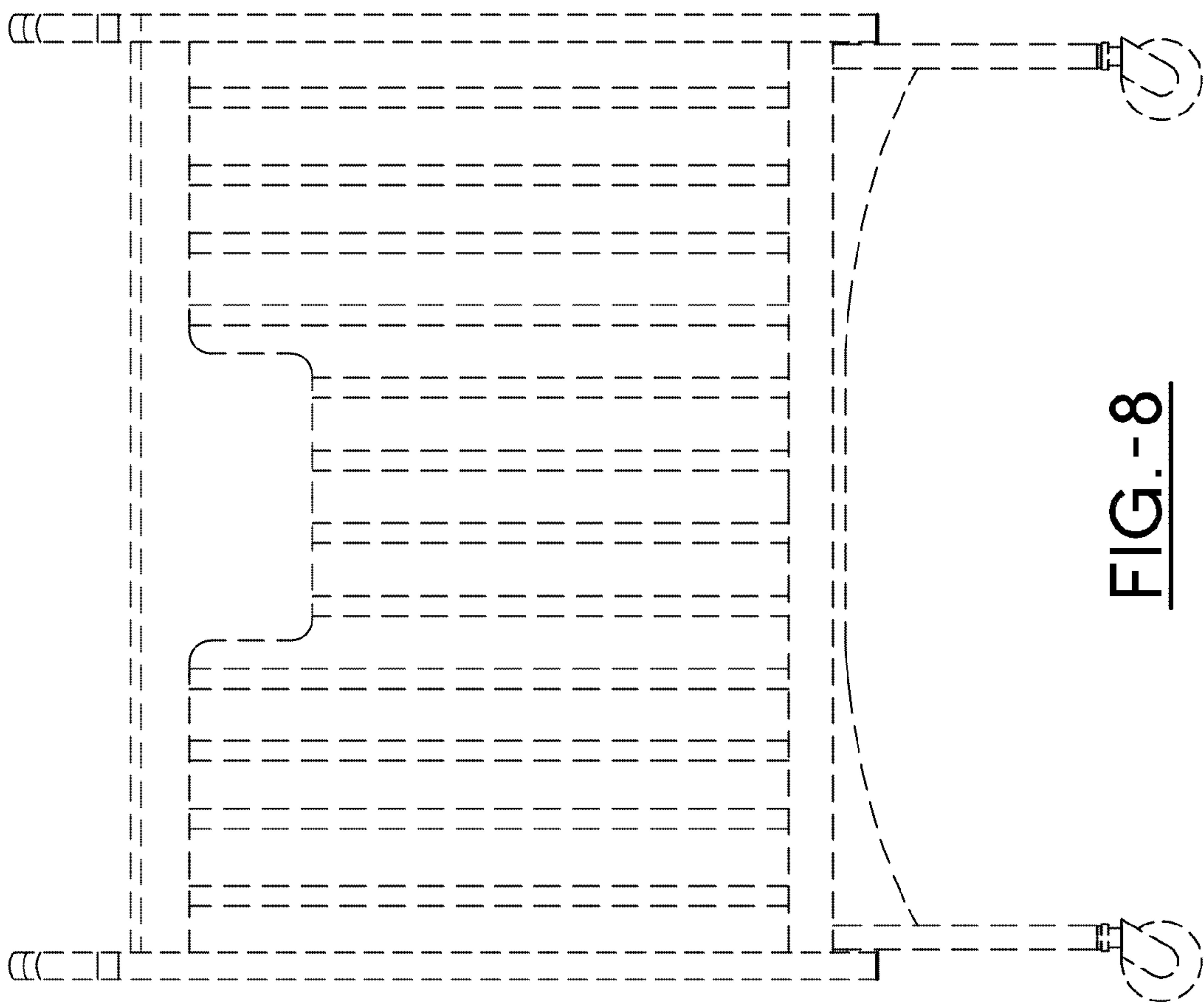

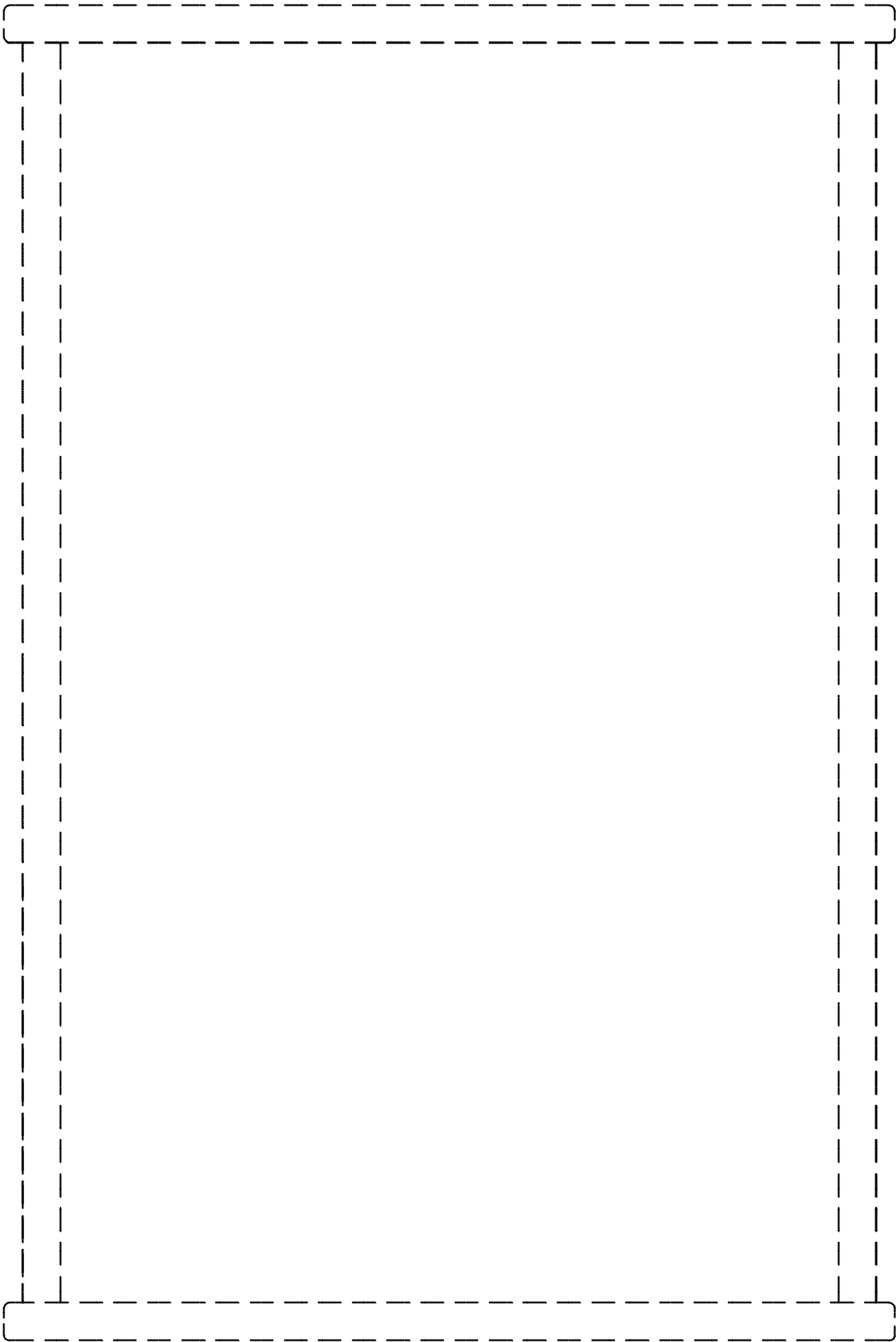
