FIG. 5 is a front view of a fourth image thereof; and,

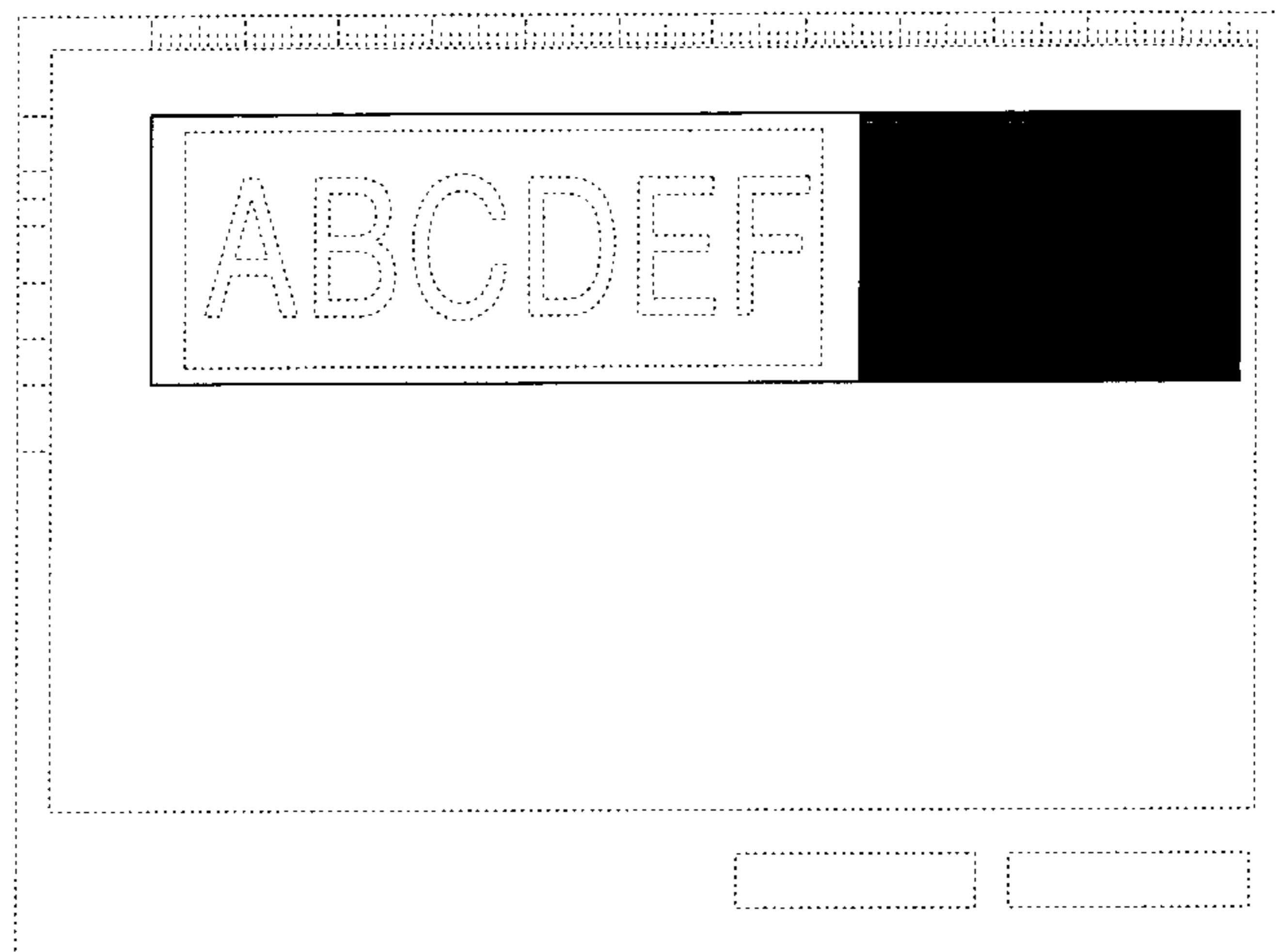

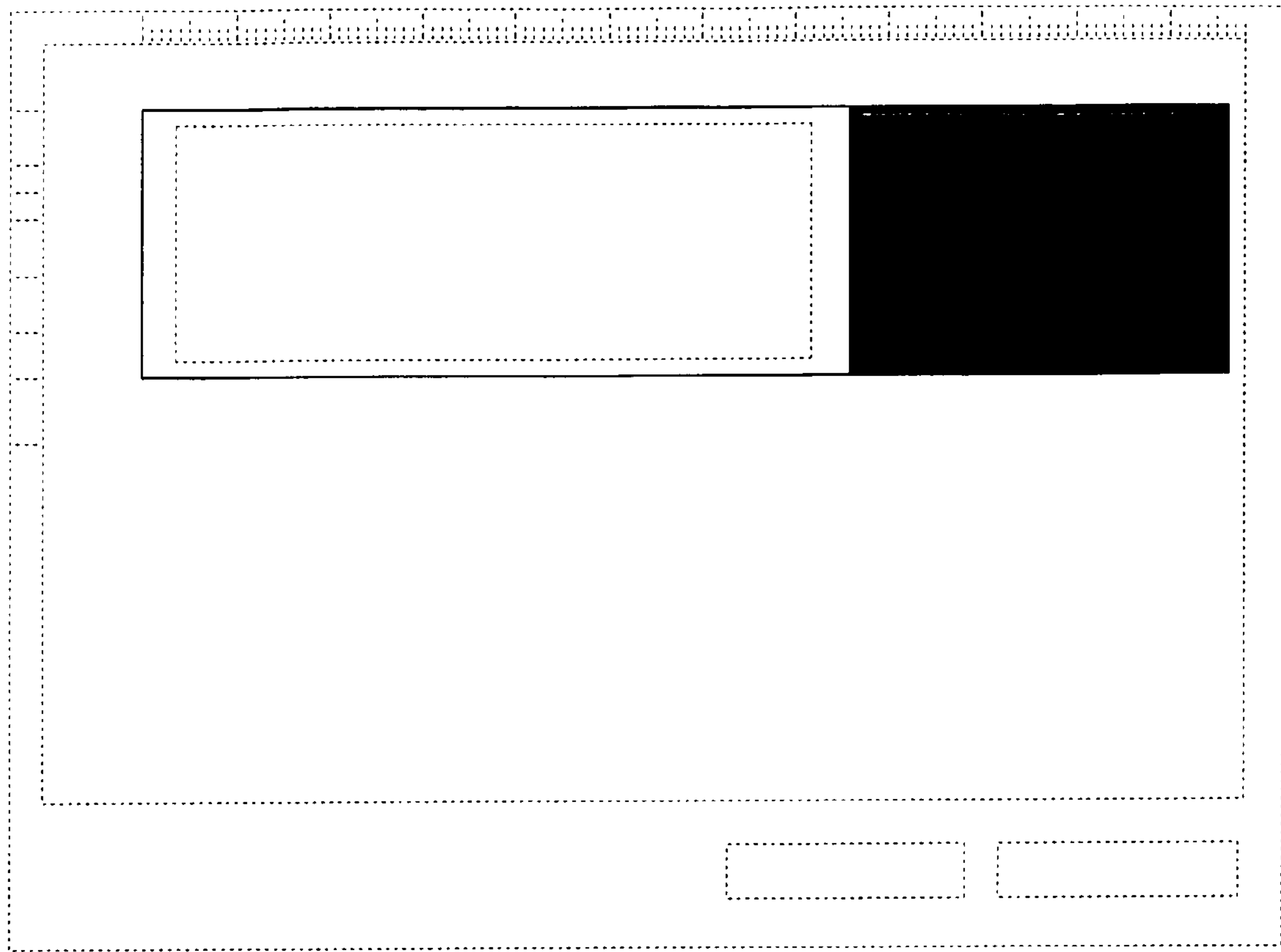

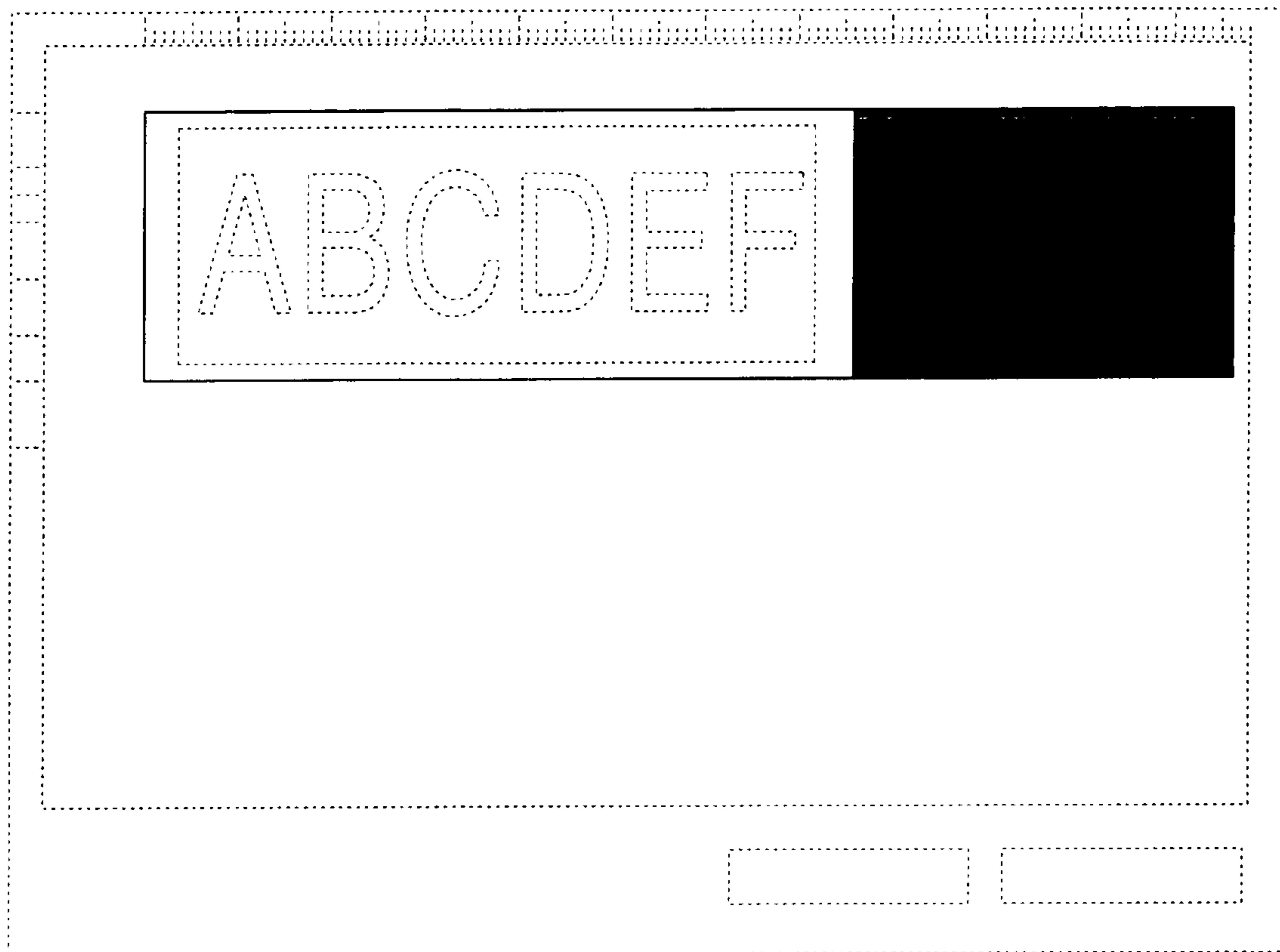

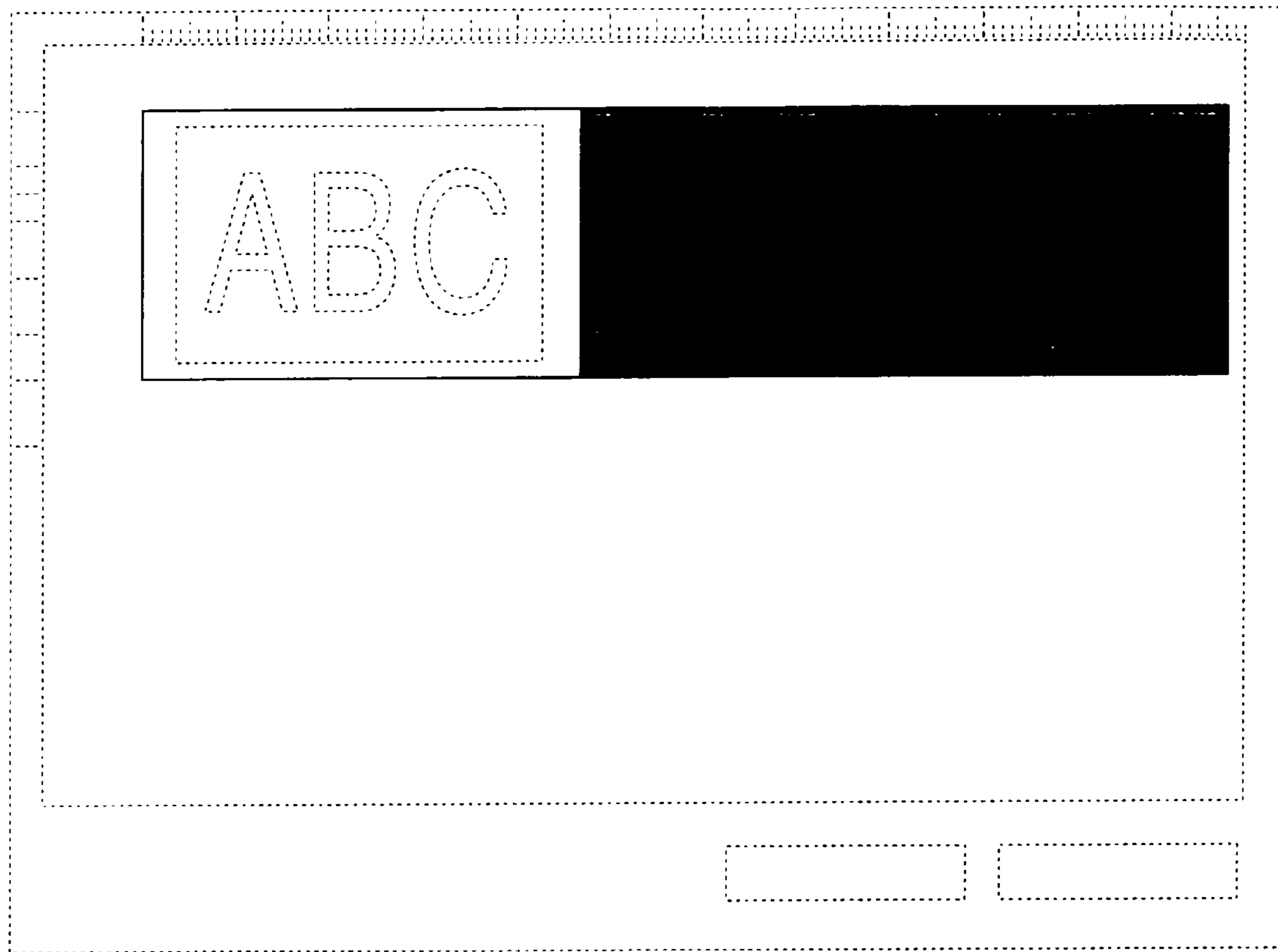

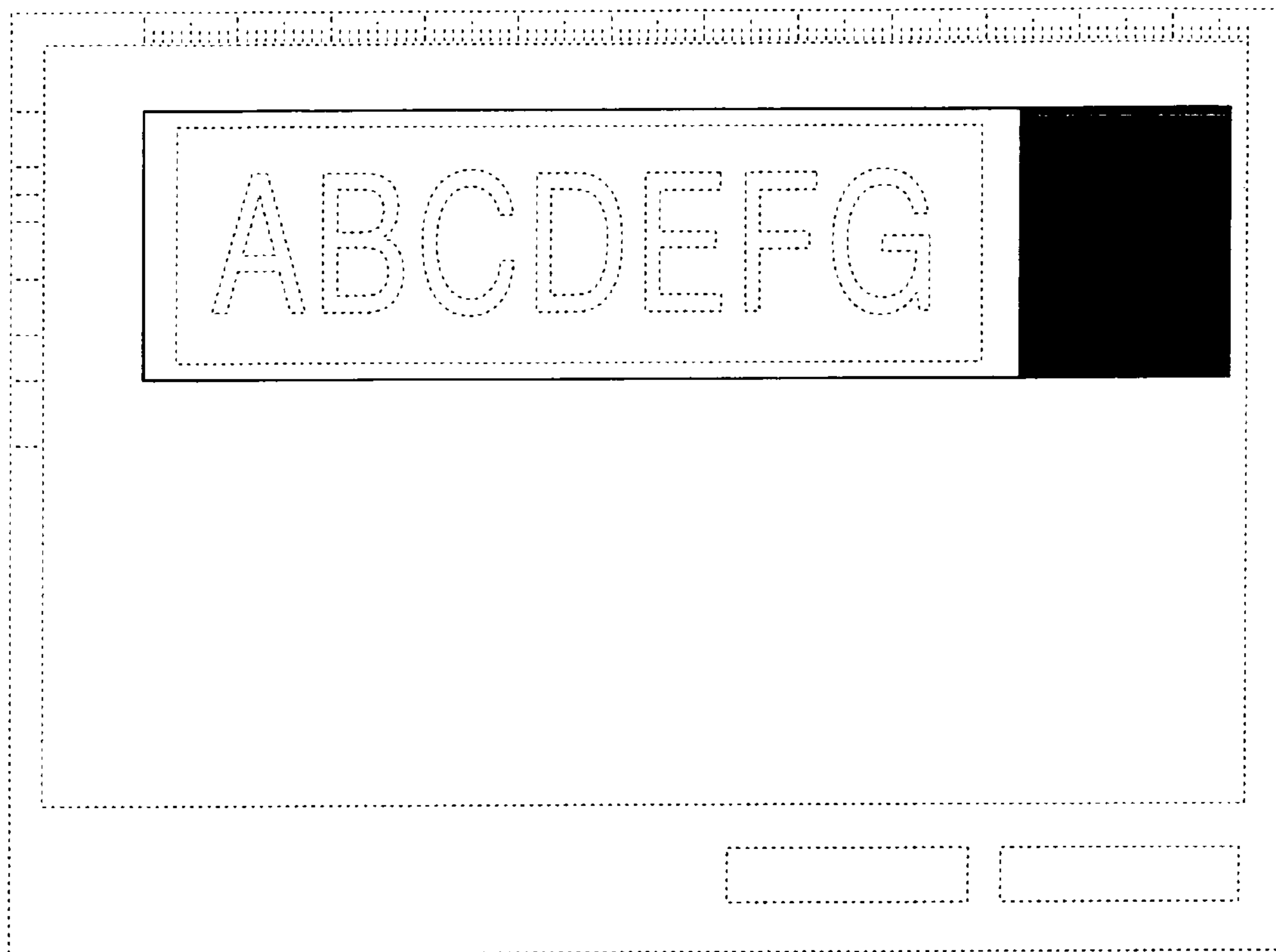

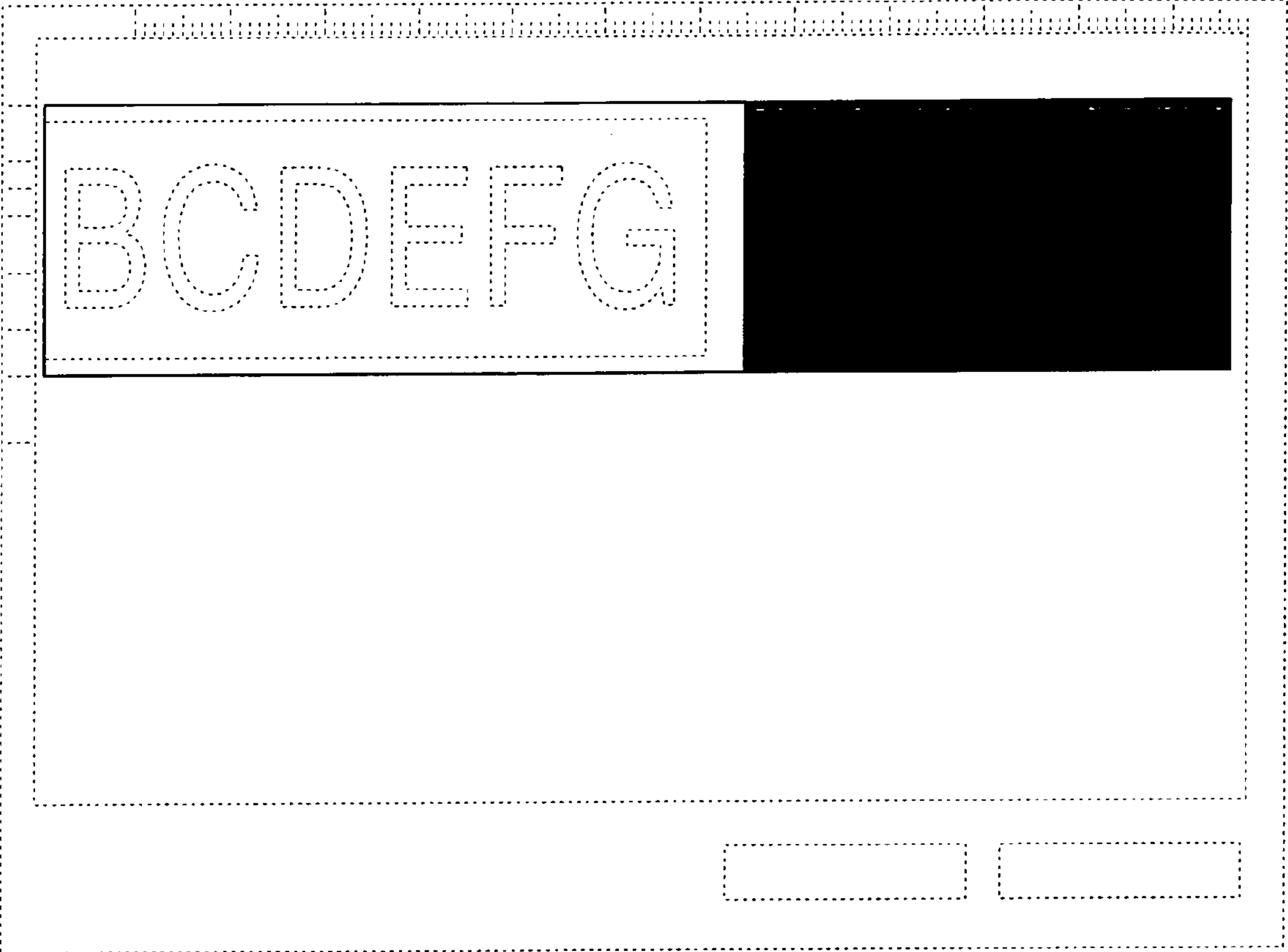

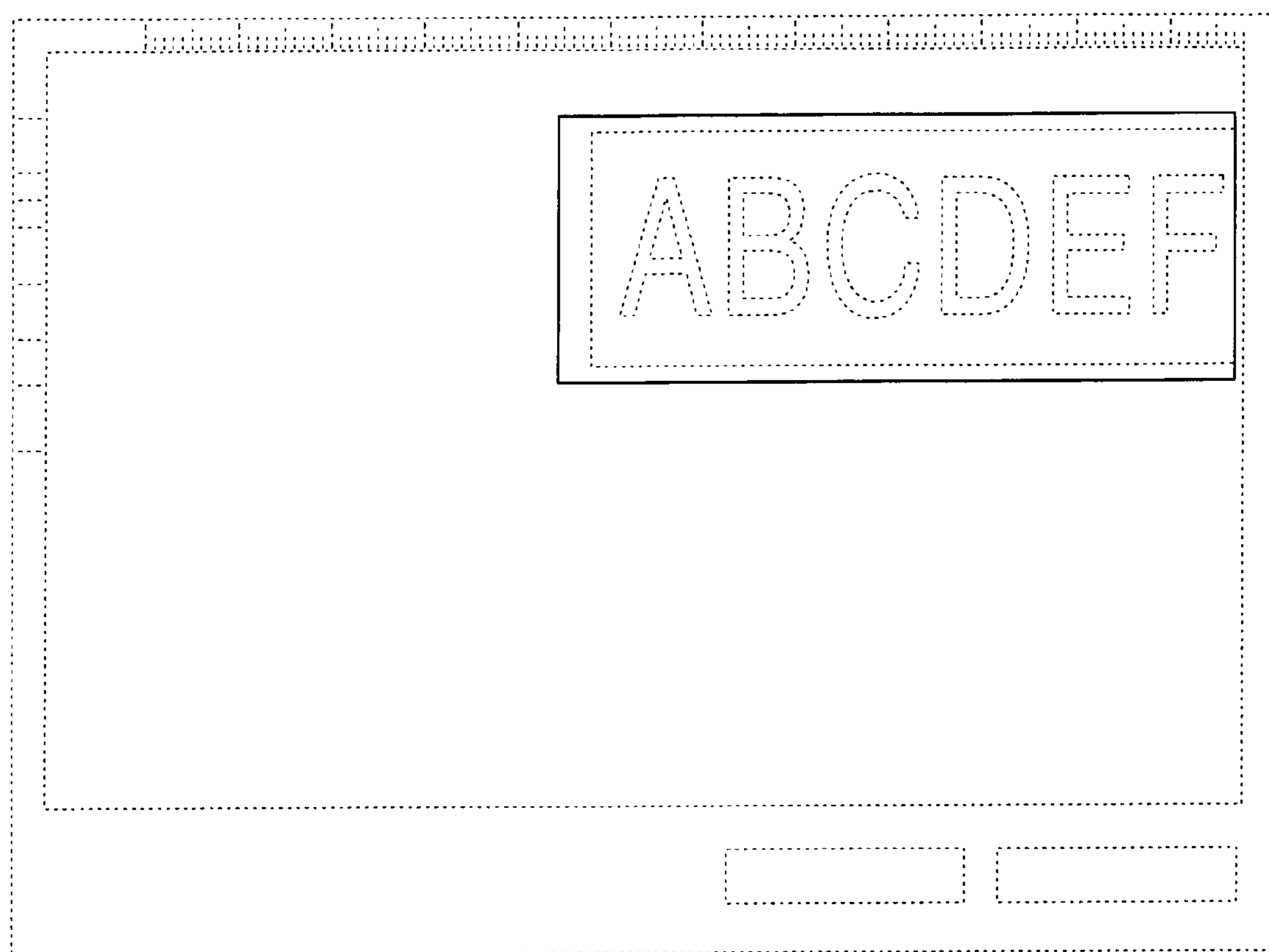
