The ornamental design for a roller board, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a right roller board showing my new design, the left being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 2 is a left side view thereof, the right side view being a mirror image;

FIG. 3 is a front view thereof;

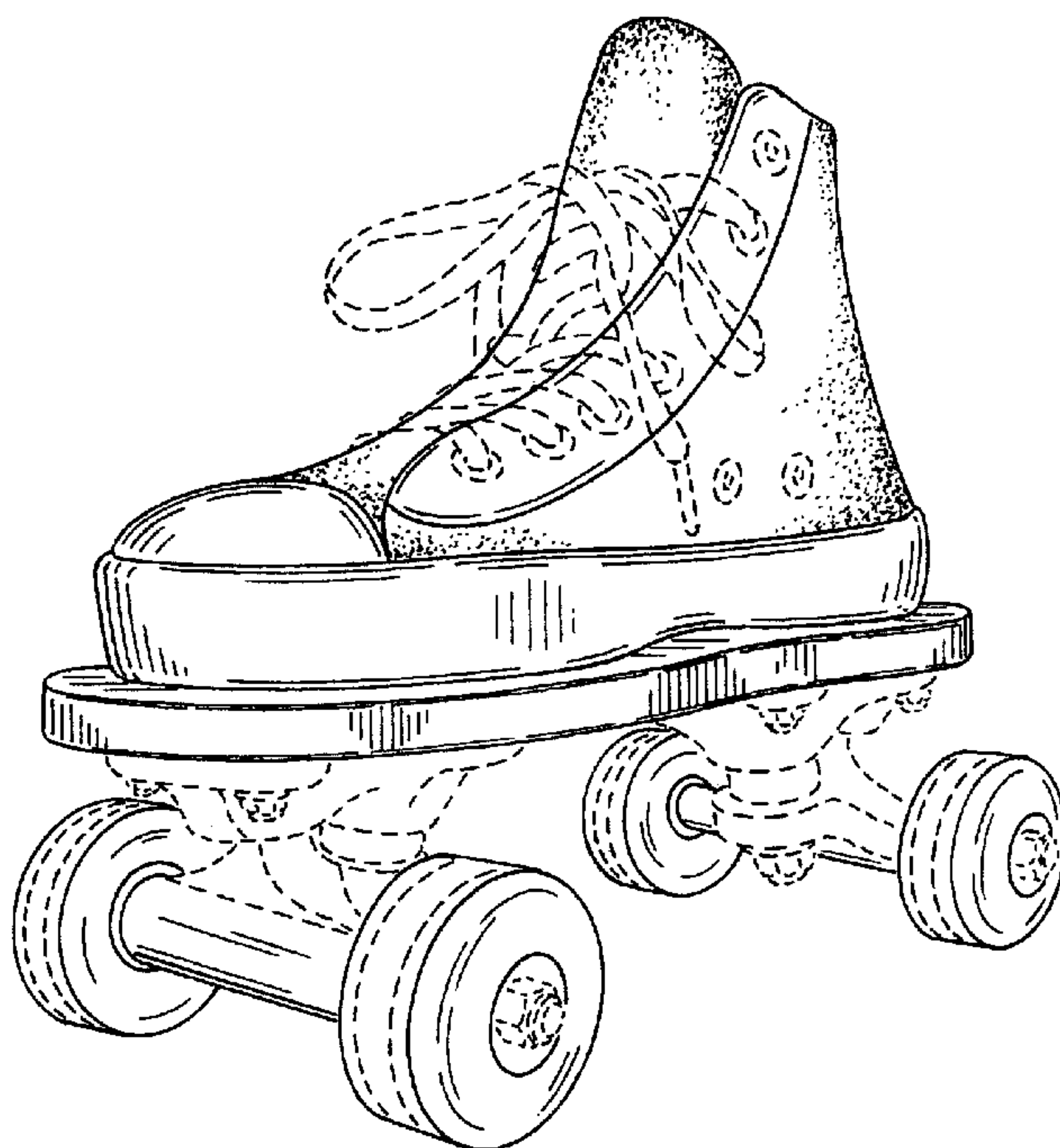
FIG. 4 is a back view thereof;

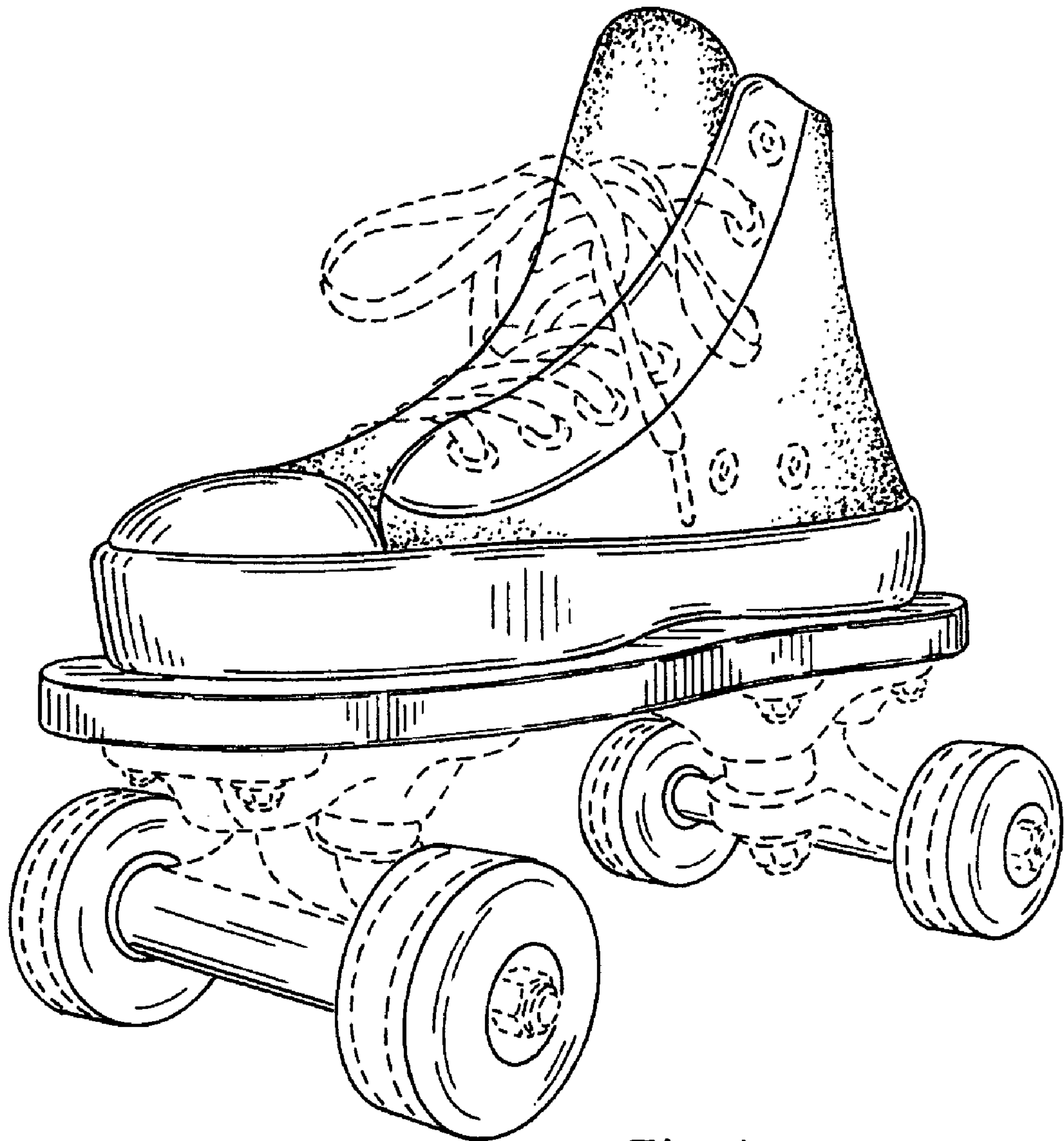

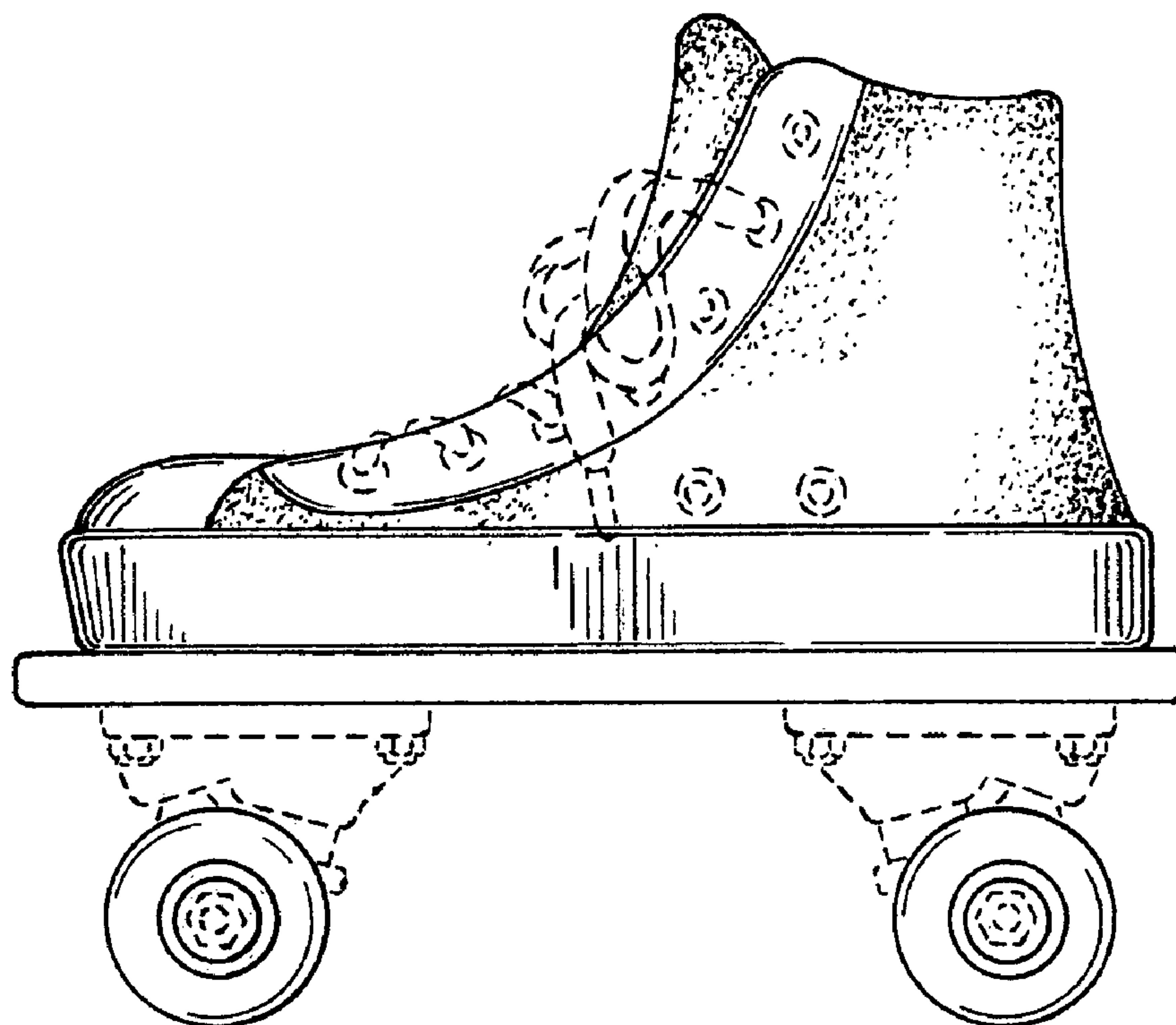

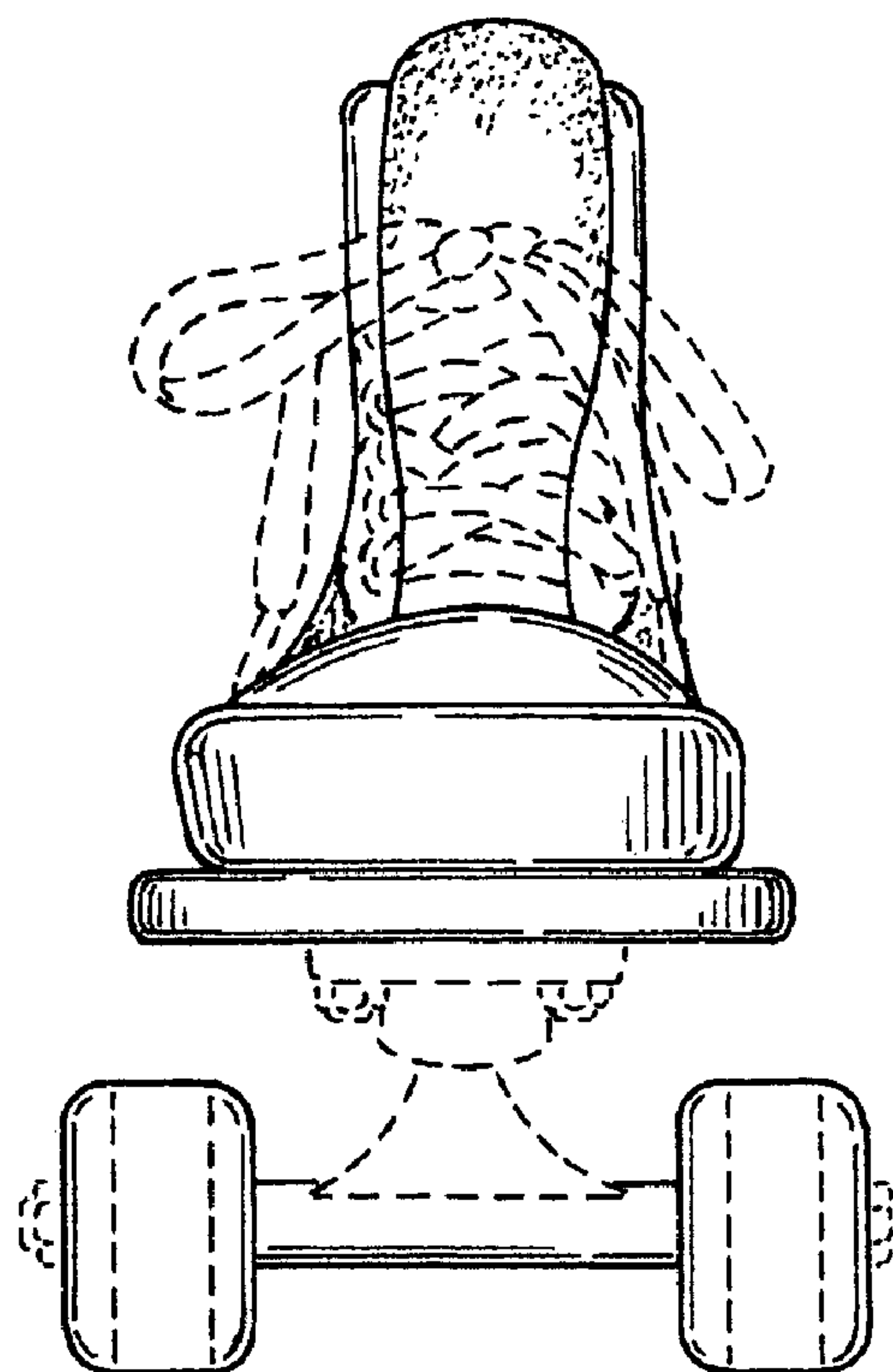

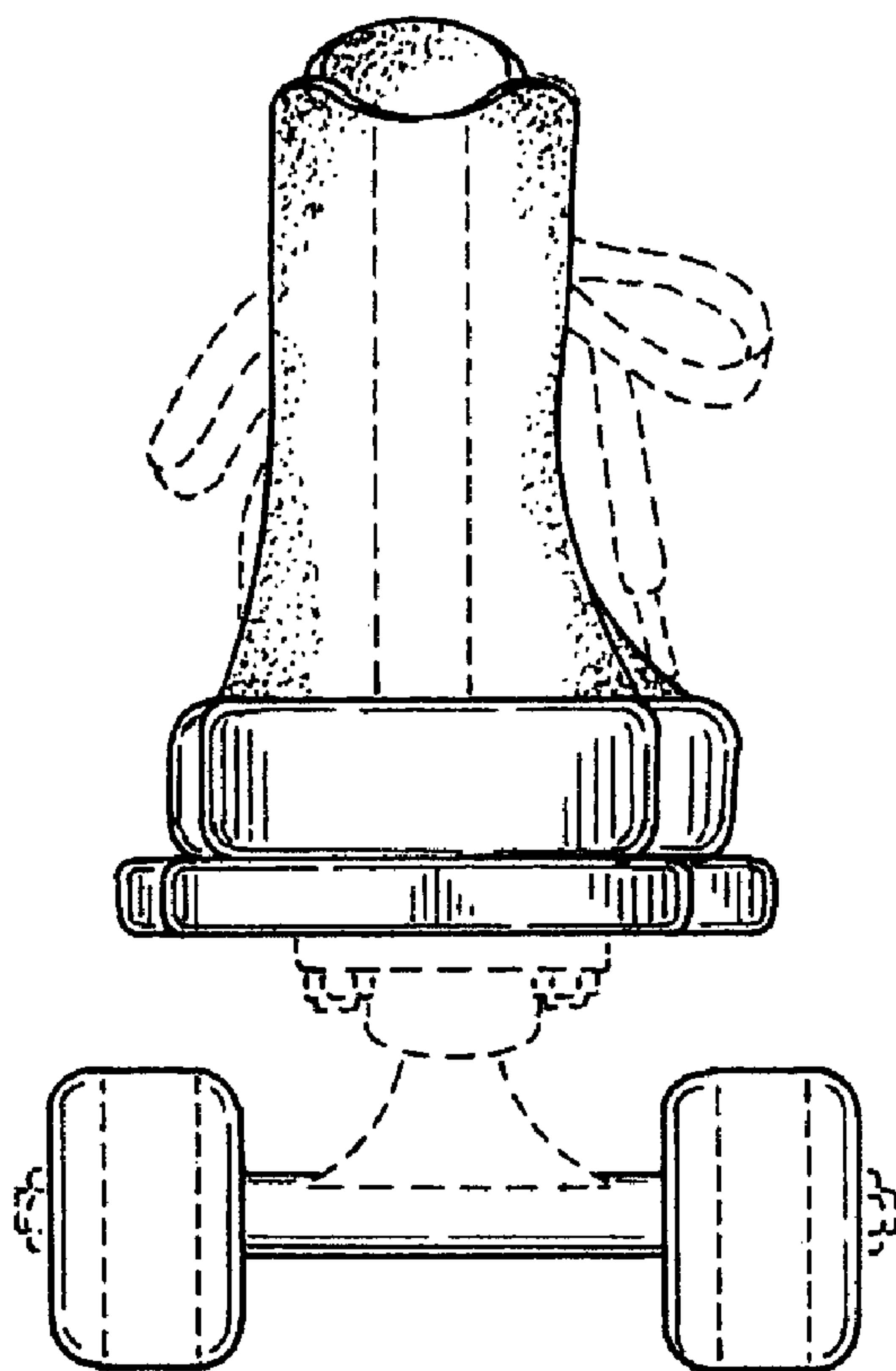

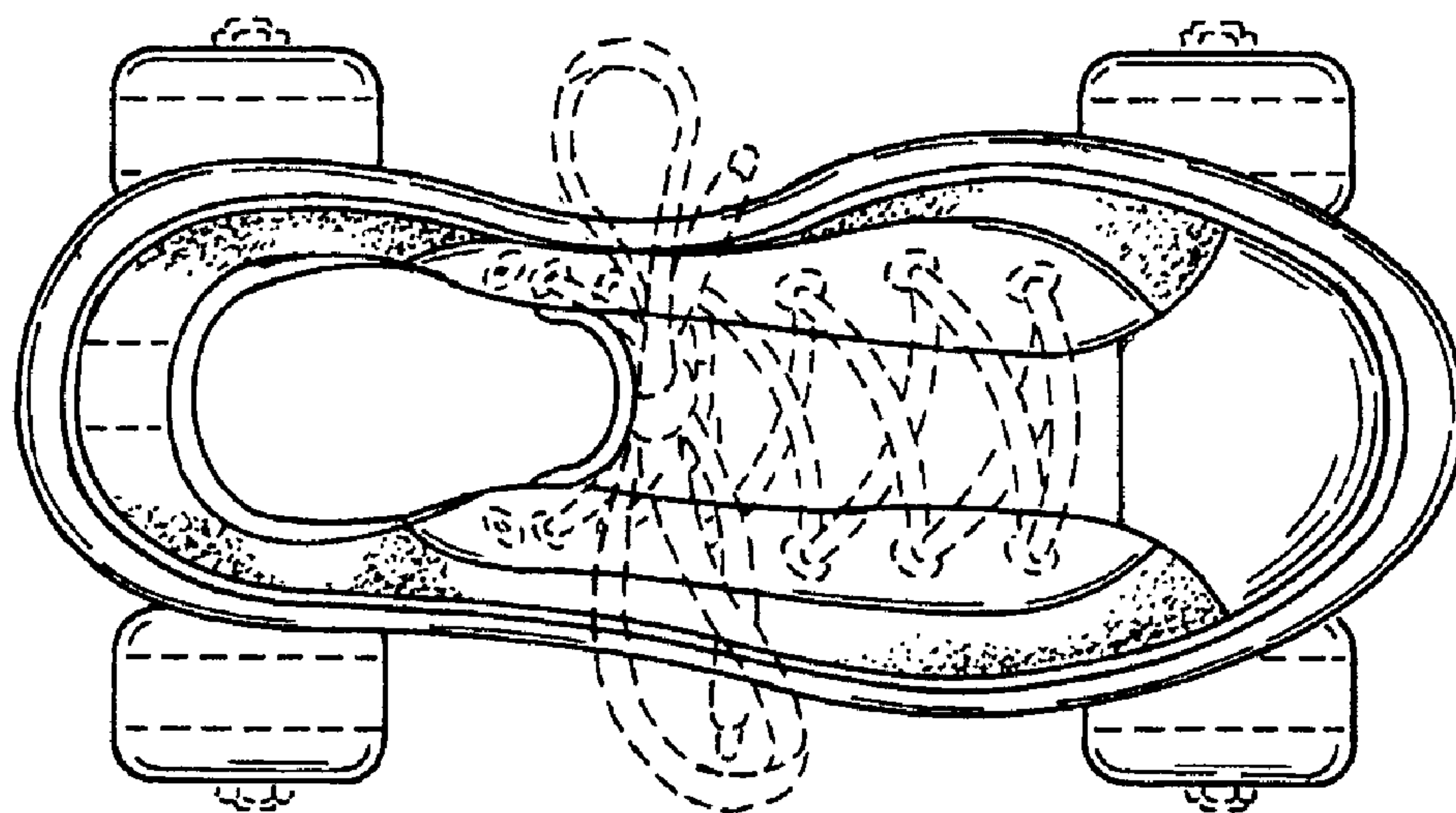

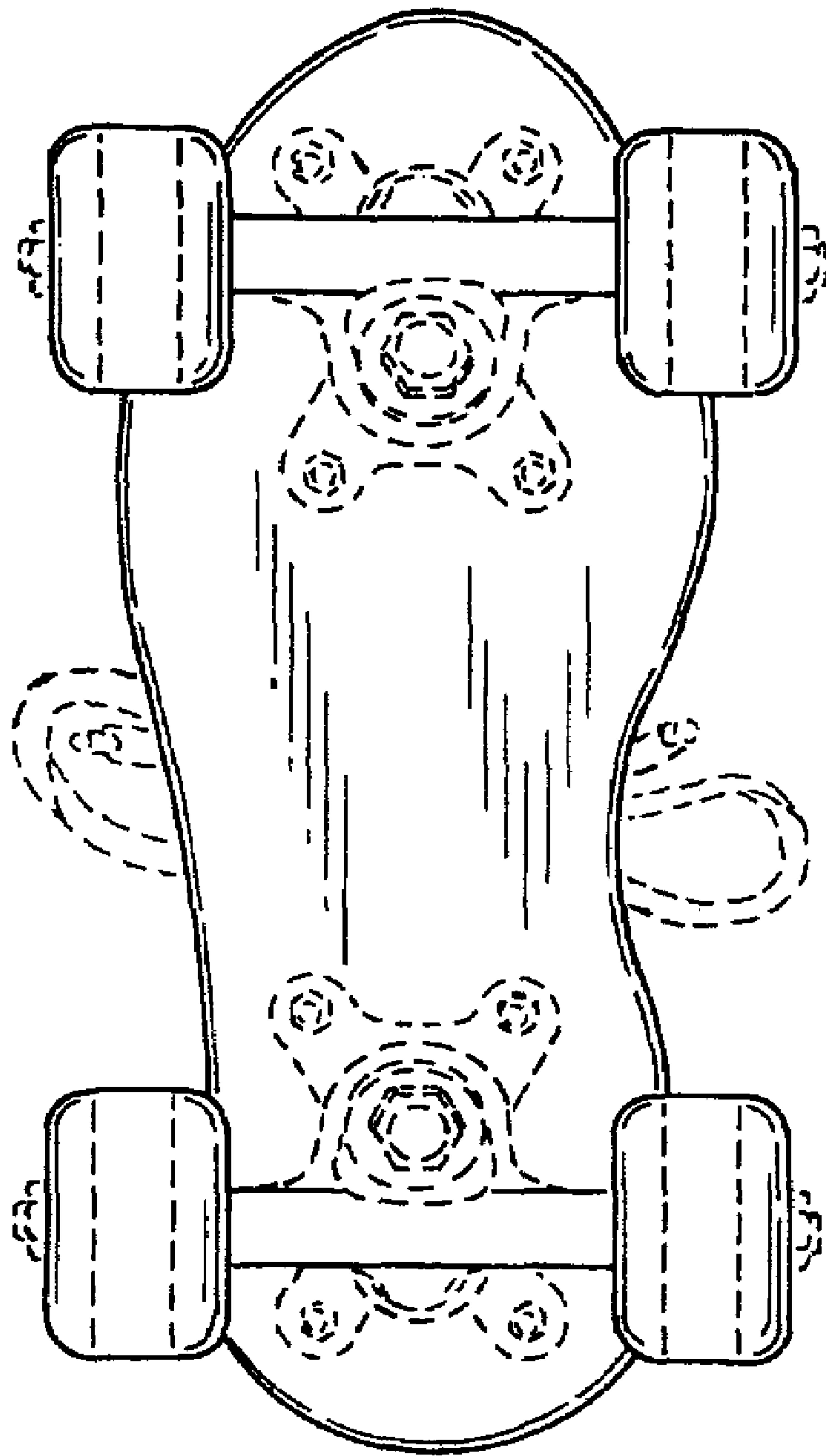
