(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a pretzel chip, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a pretzel chip of the present invention.

FIG. 2 is a top view of a pretzel chip of the present invention.

FIG. 3 is bottom view of a pretzel chip of the present invention.

FIG. 4 is an elevated front view of the pretzel chip shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 is an elevated right side view of the pretzel chip shown in FIG. 1.

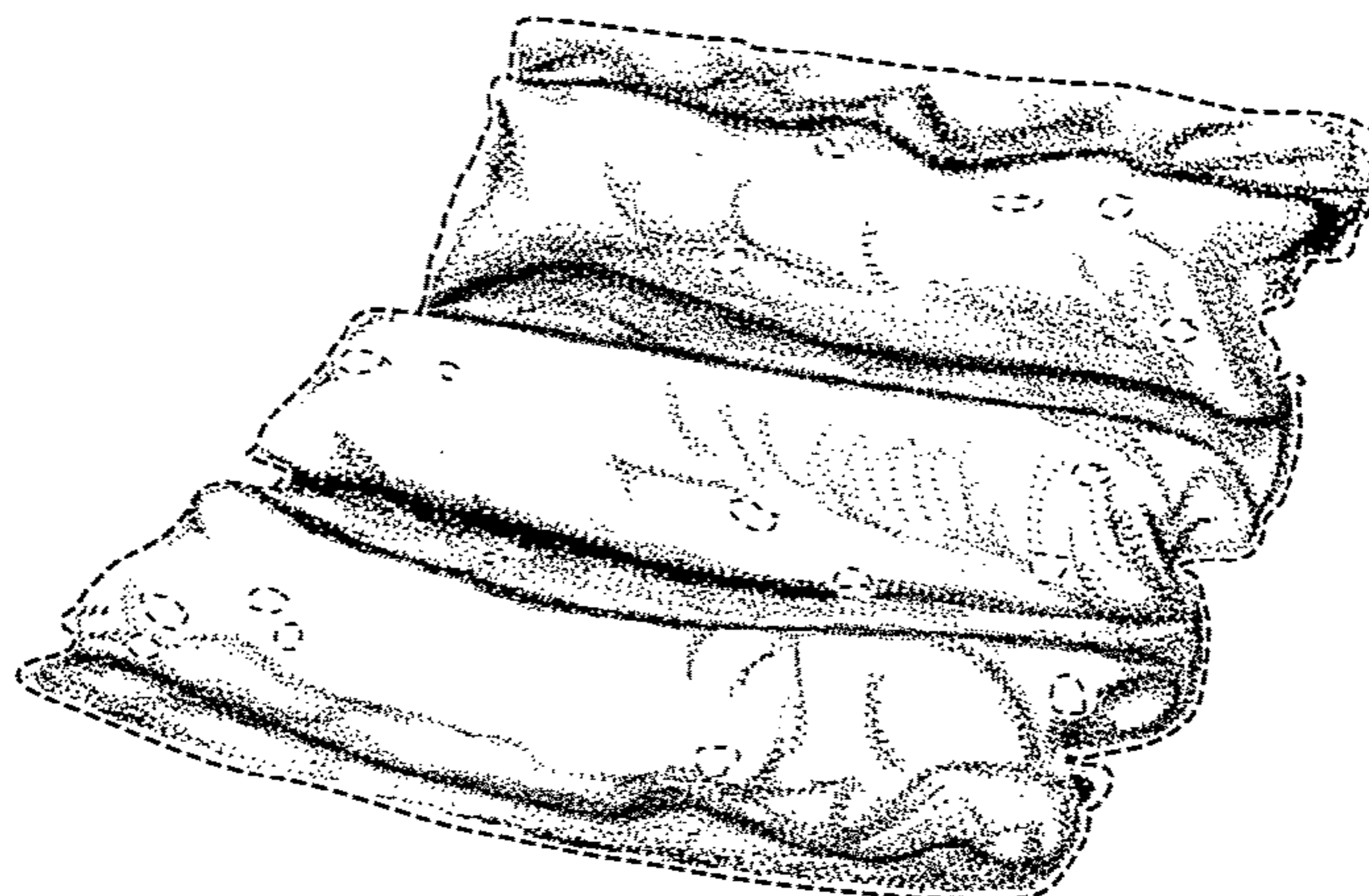
FIG. 6 is an elevated back view of the pretzel chip shown in FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 7 is an elevated left side view of the pretzel chip shown in FIG. 1.

The broken lines which define the bounds of the claimed design form no part thereof.

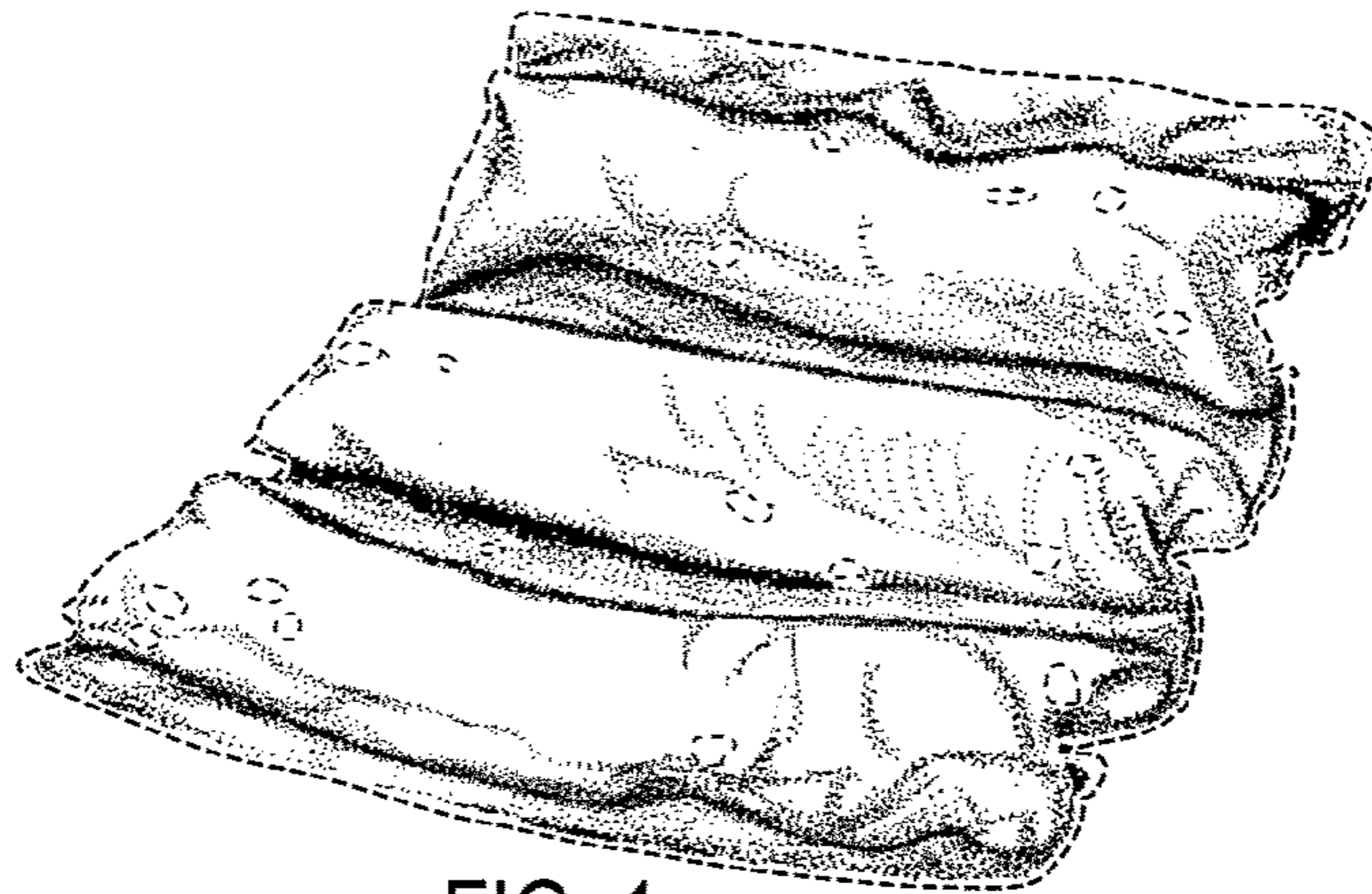

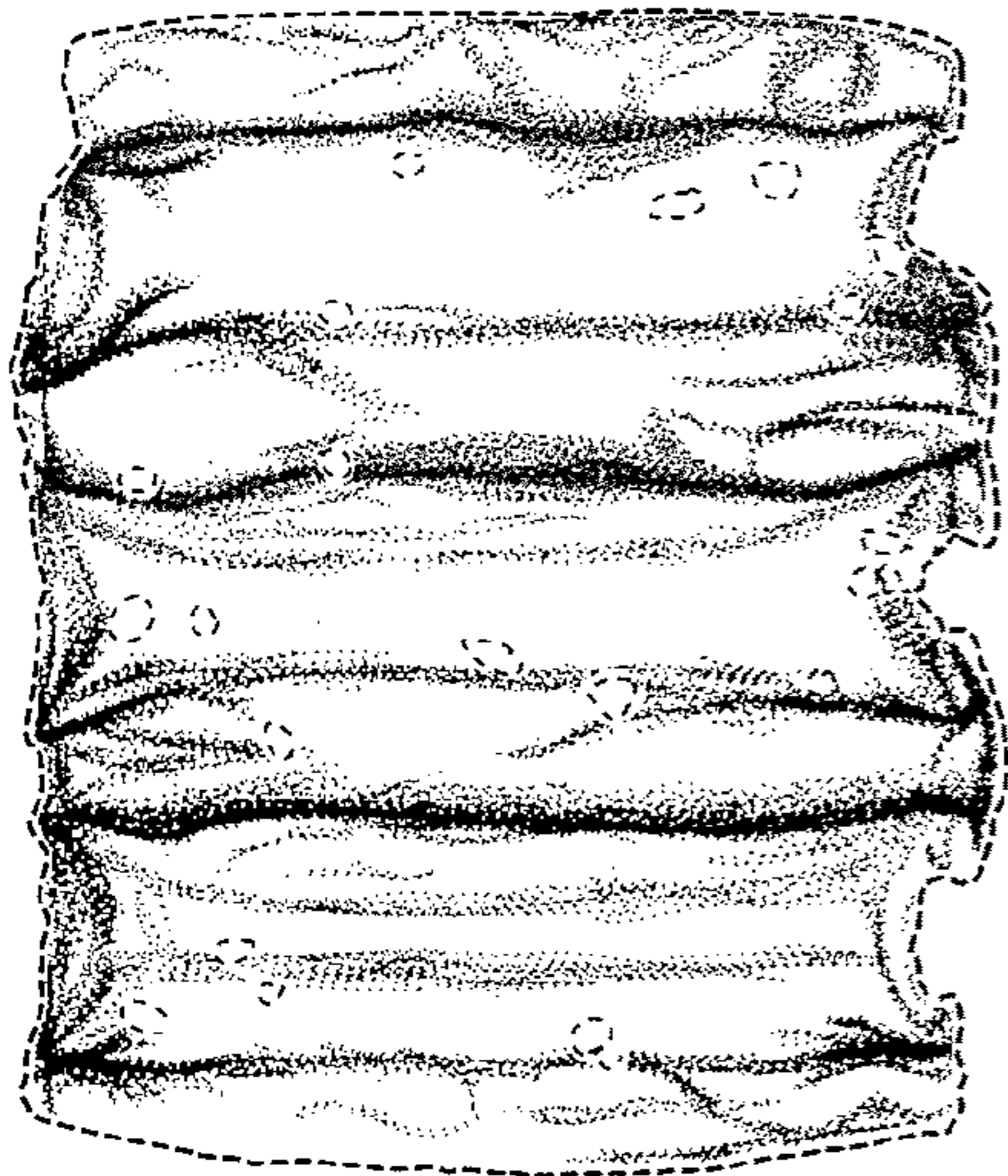

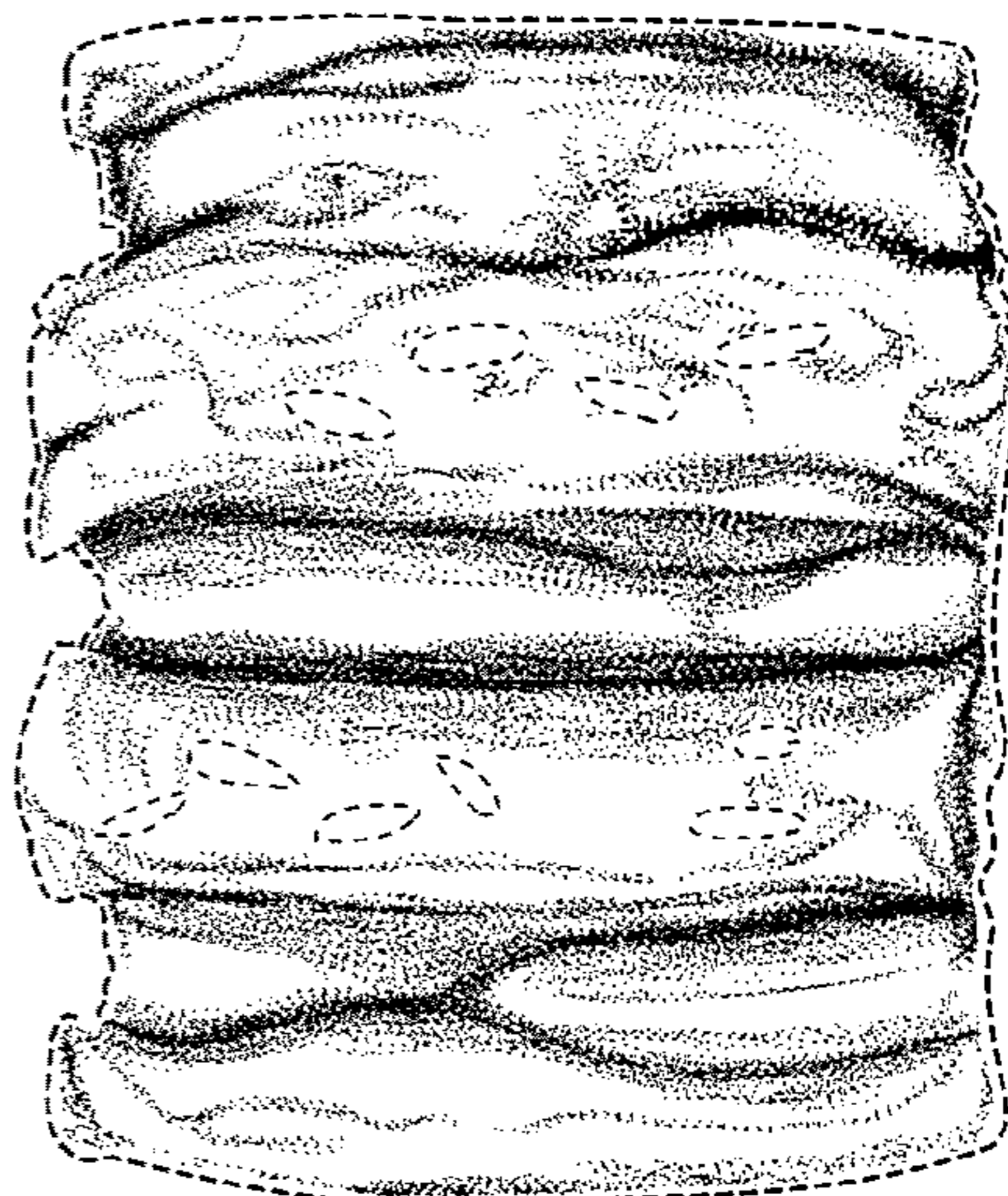

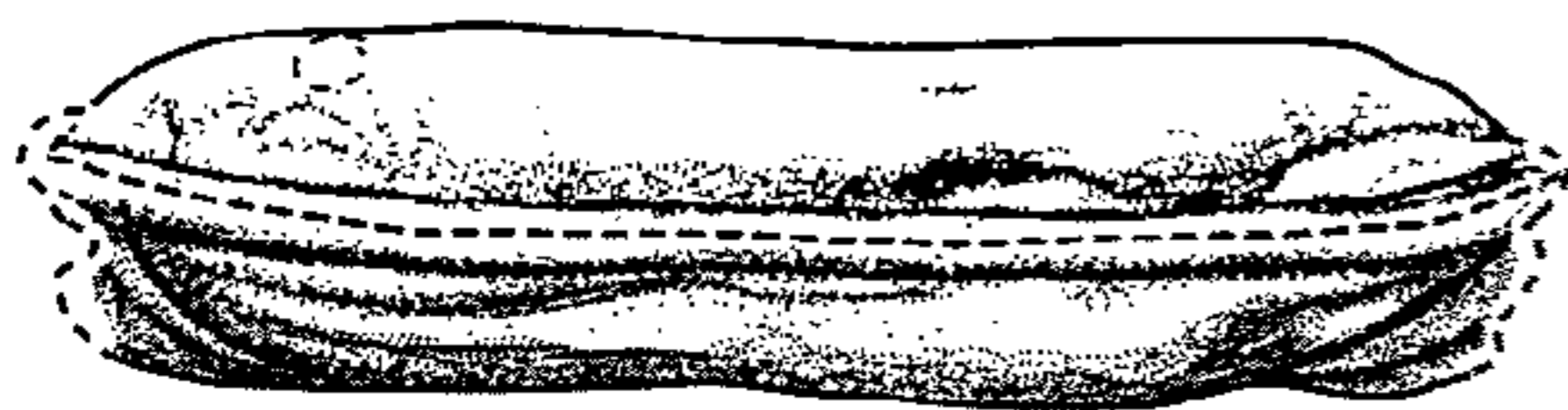
