FIG. 4 is a front elevation view of FIG. 2.

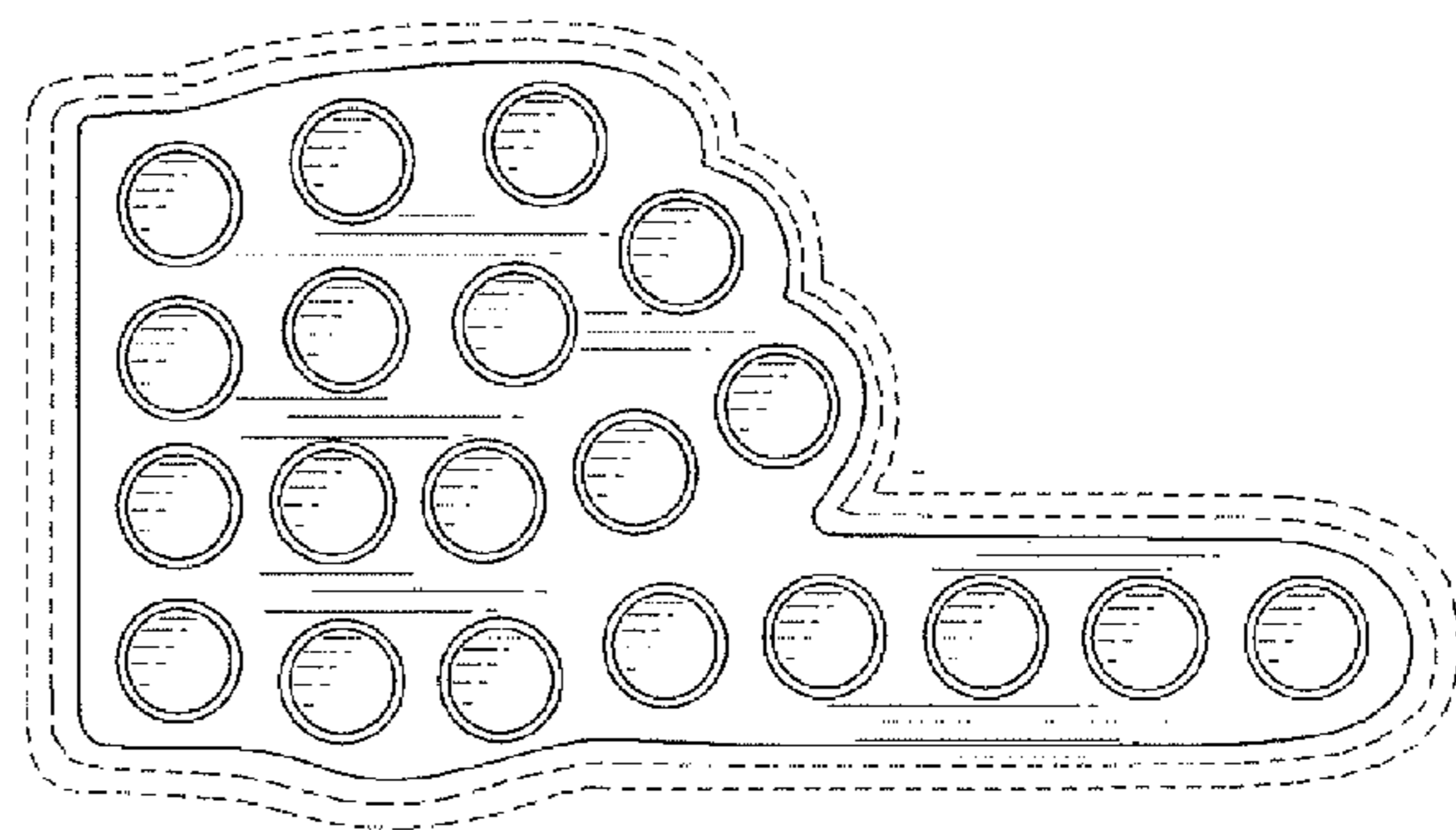
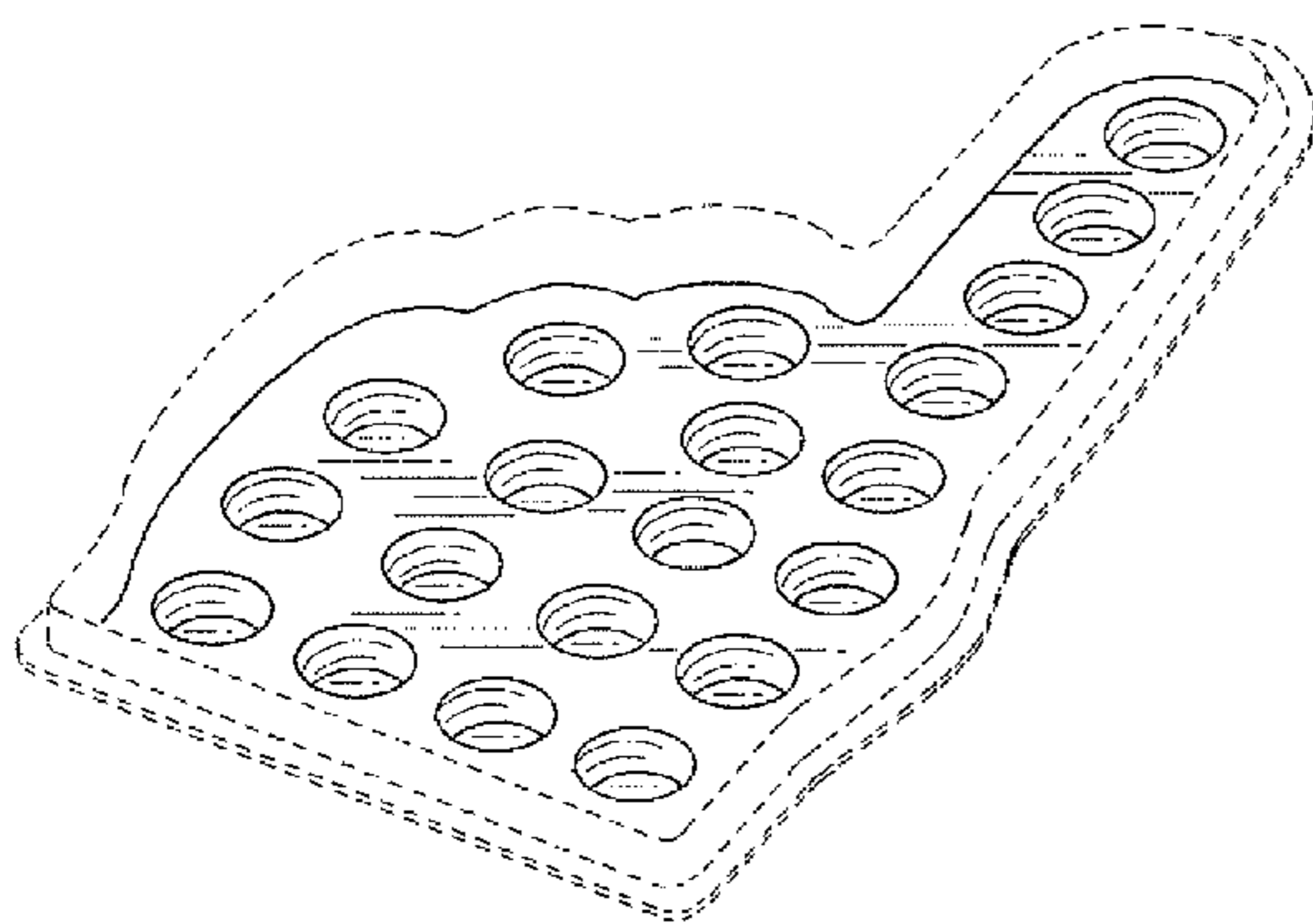
FIG. 5 is a left side elevation view of FIG. 6.

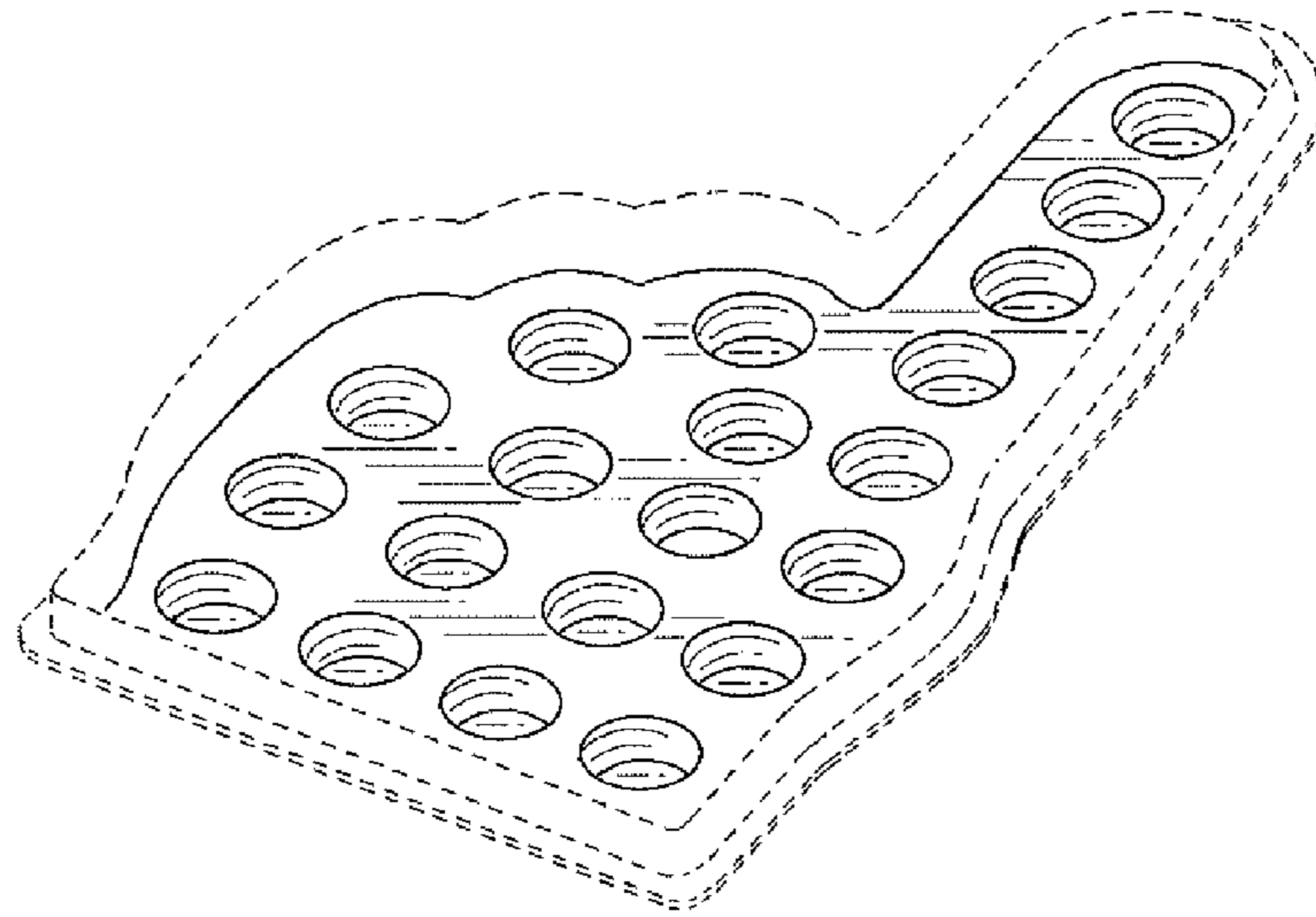

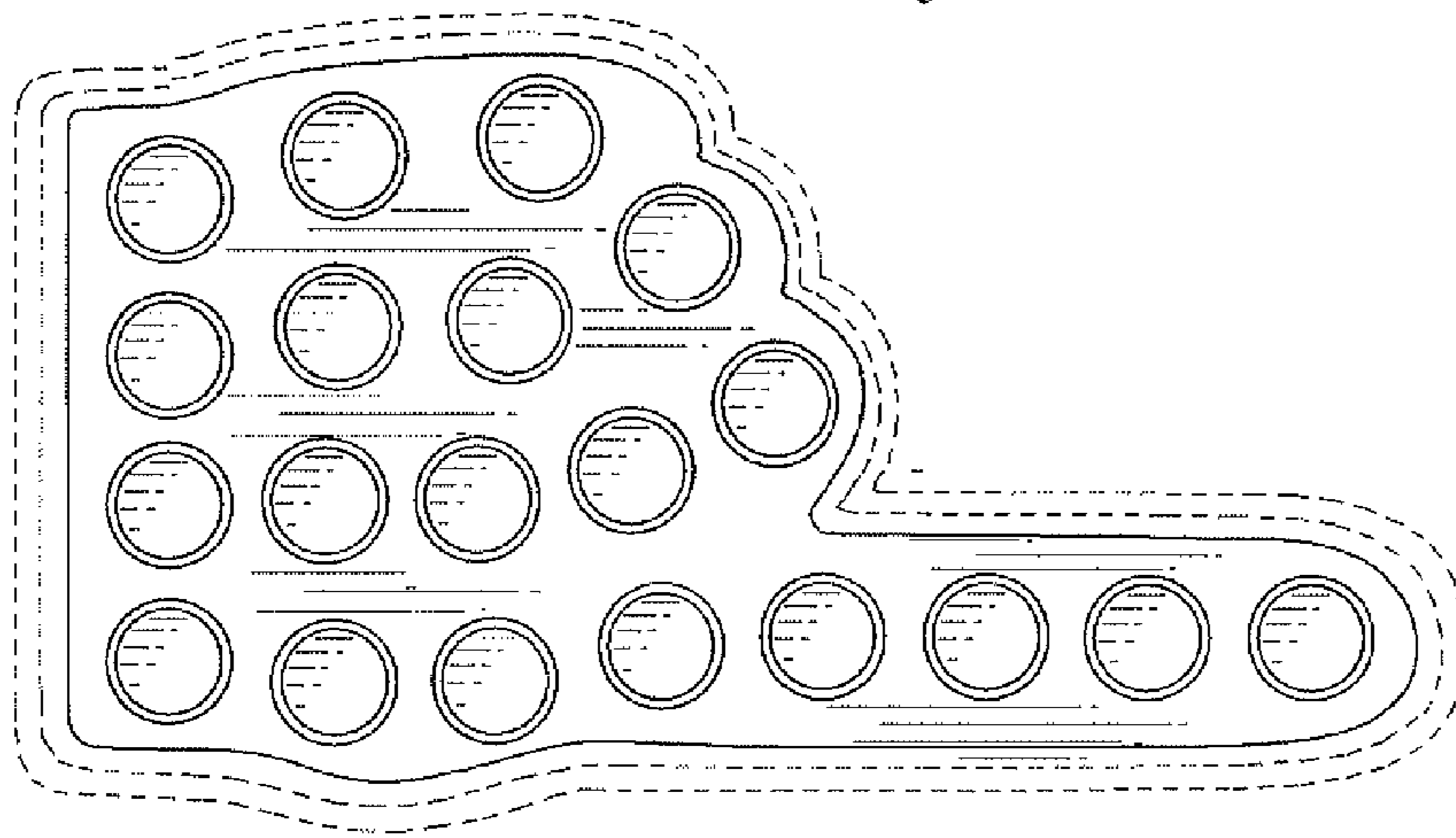

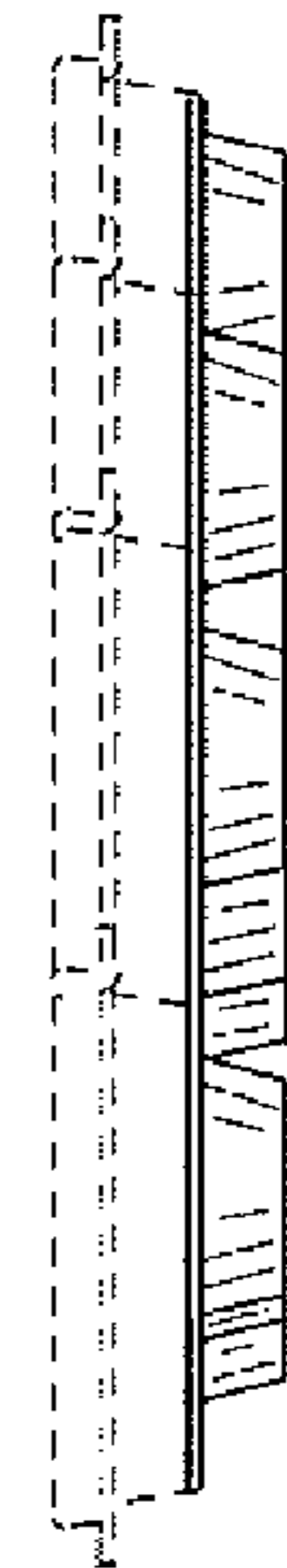

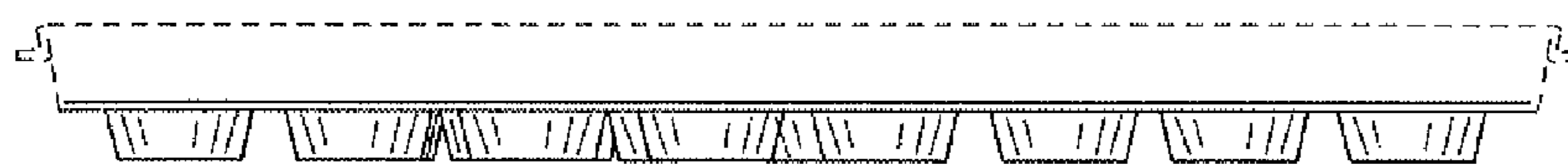

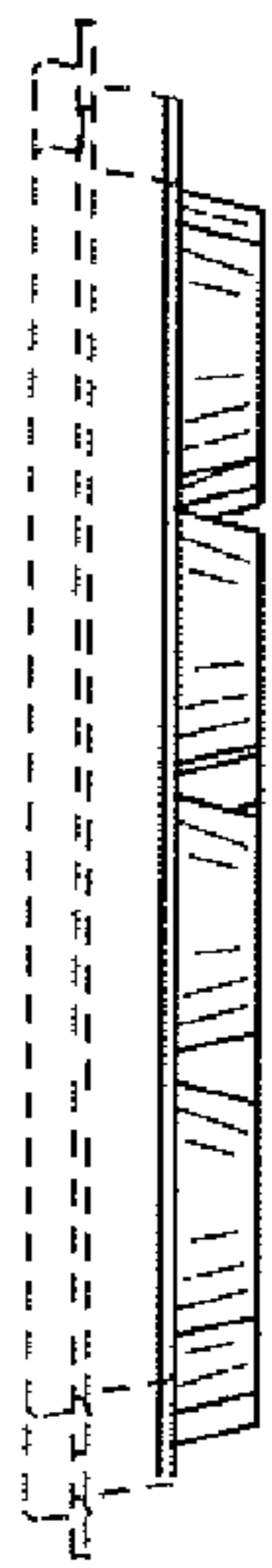

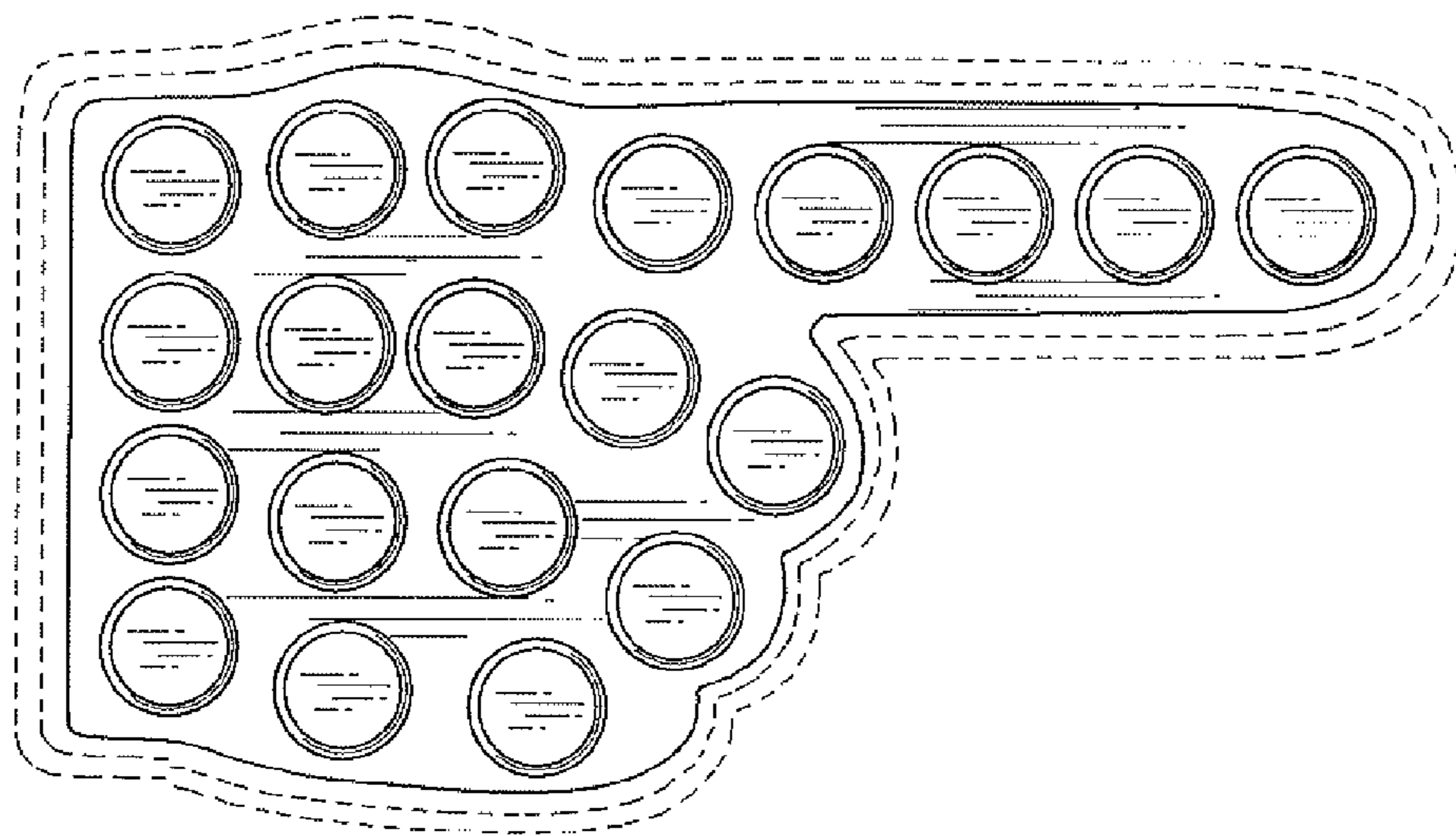

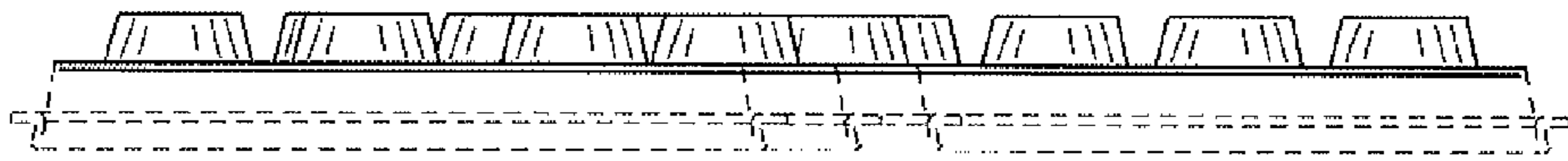
