(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an infant shoe, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an front perspective view of a infant shoe, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front view of the infant shoe of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a rear view of the infant shoe of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a left side view of the infant shoe of FIG. 1;

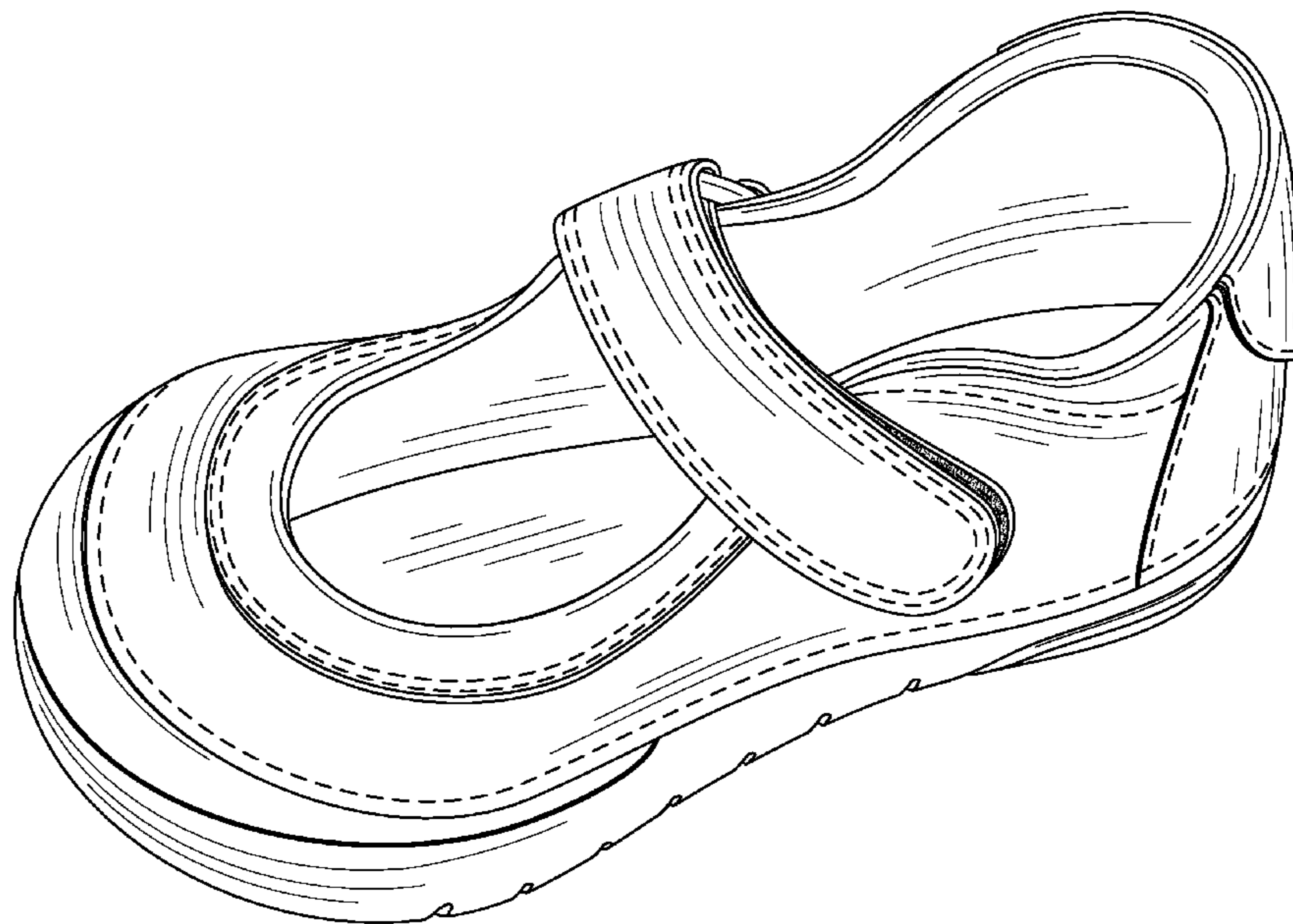
FIG. 5 is a right side view of the infant shoe of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the infant shoe of FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the infant shoe of FIG. 1.

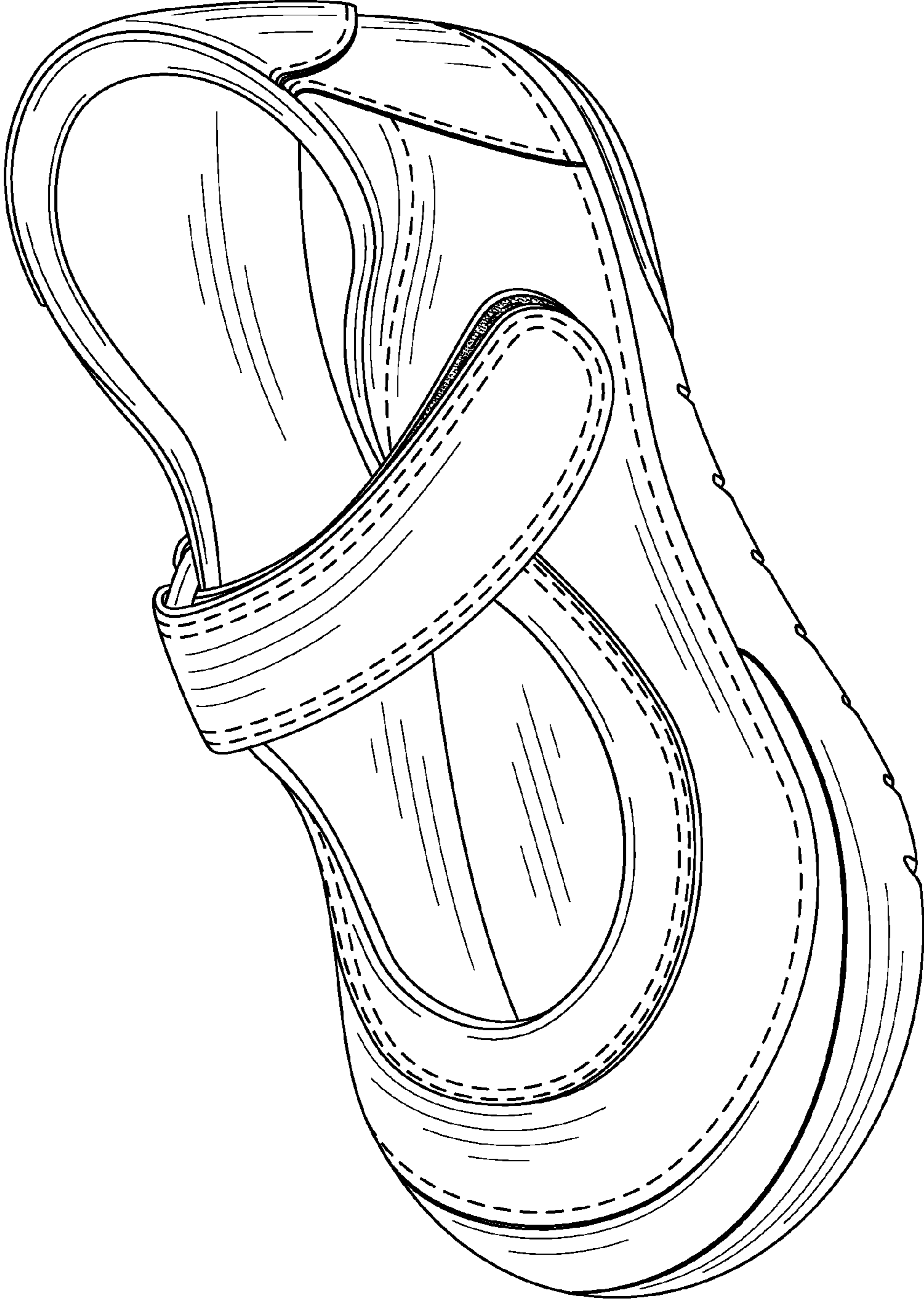

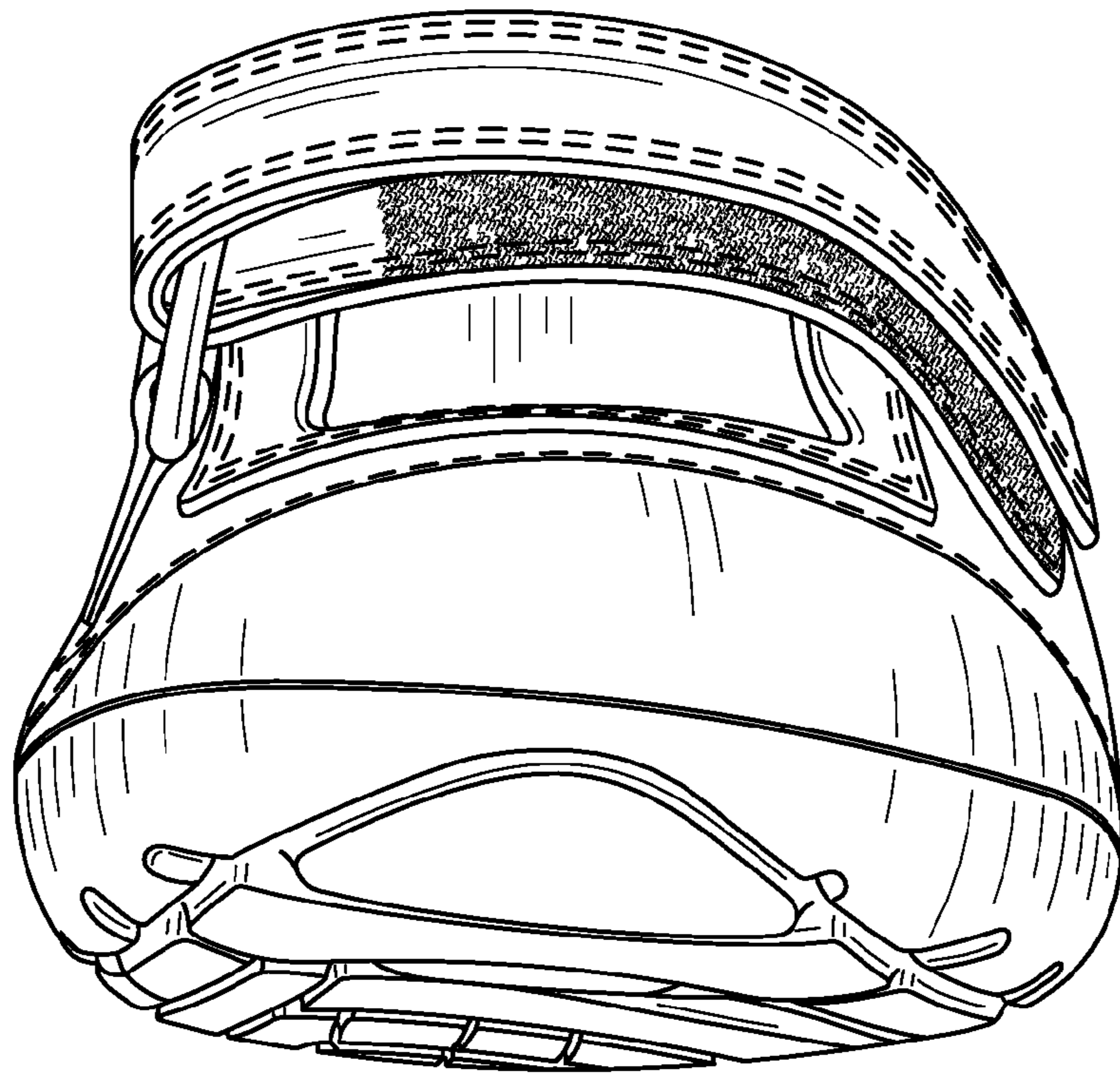

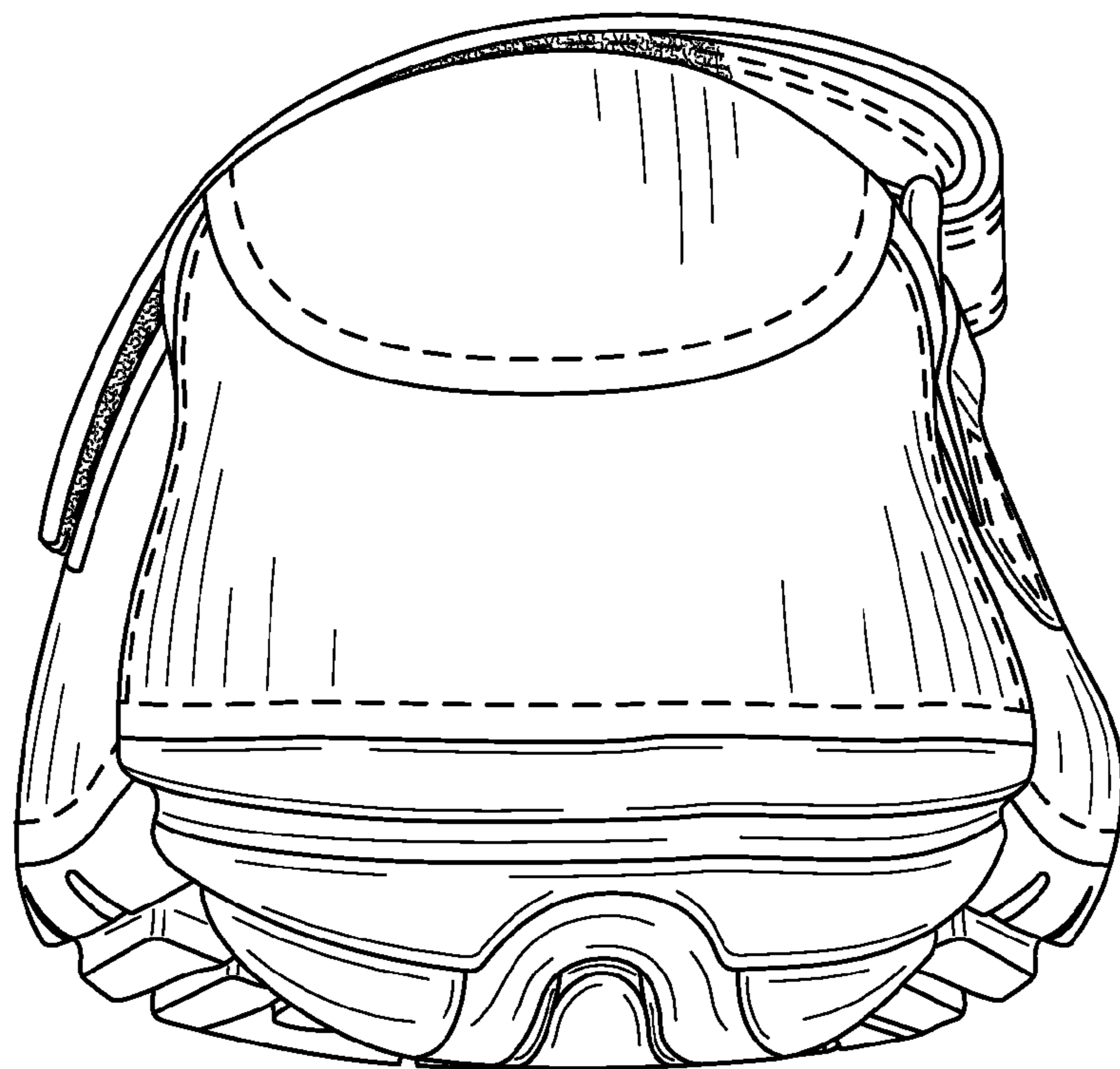

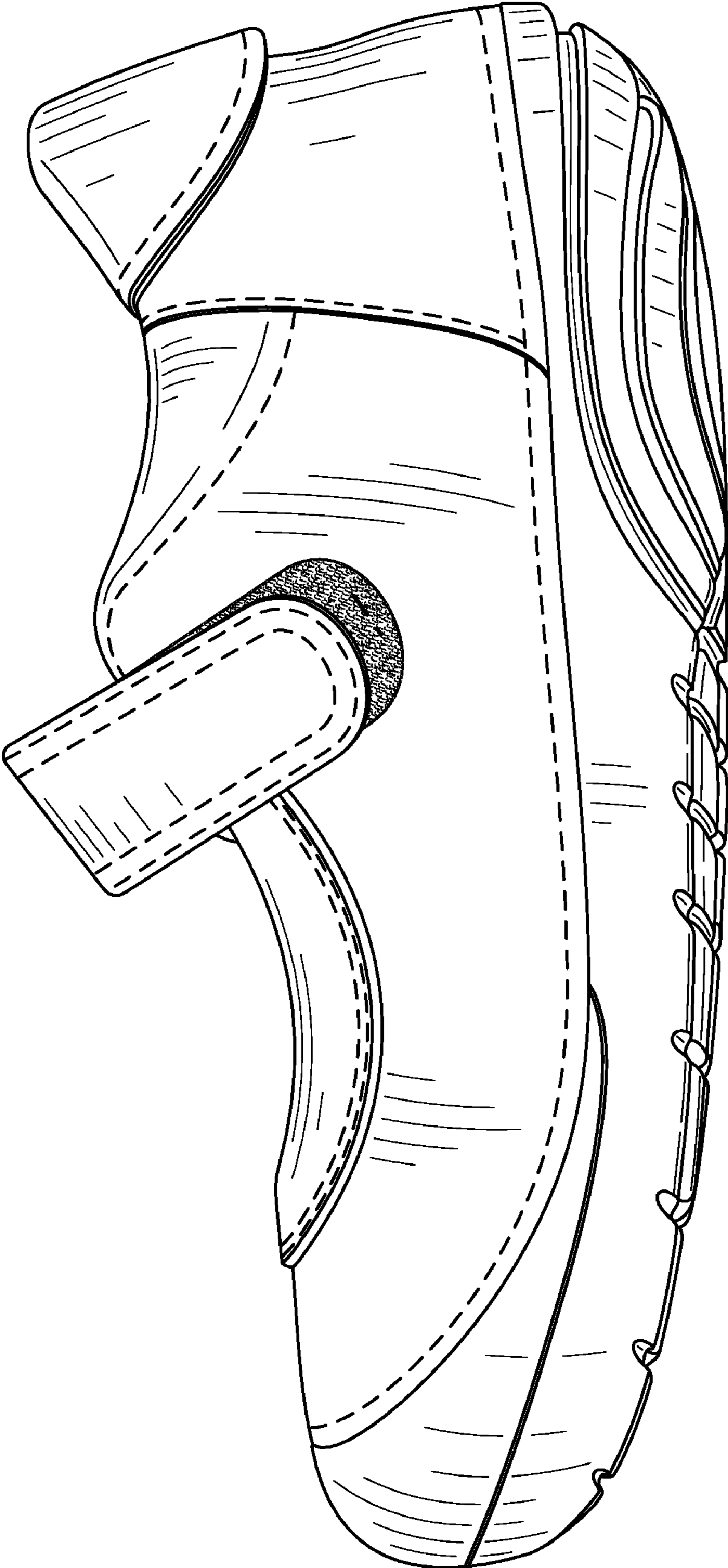

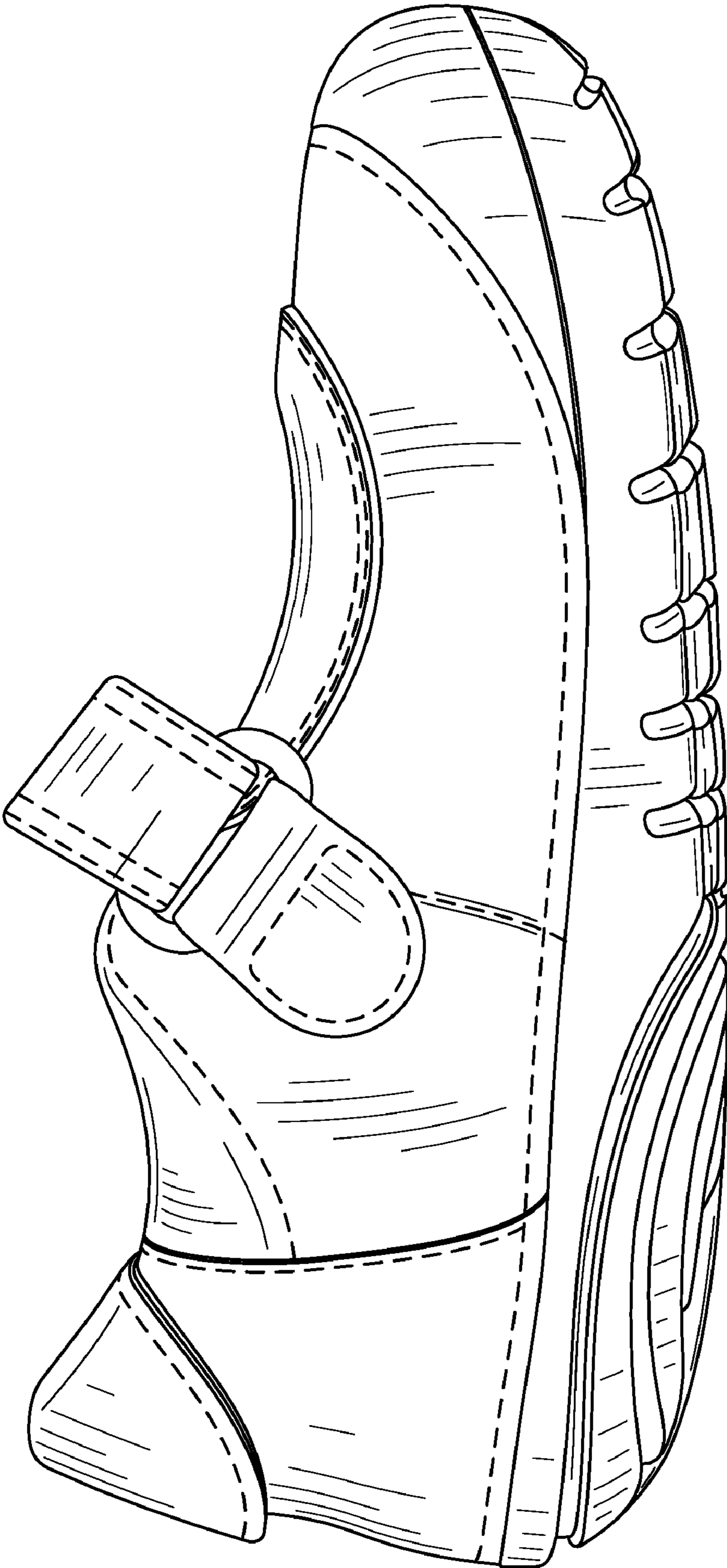

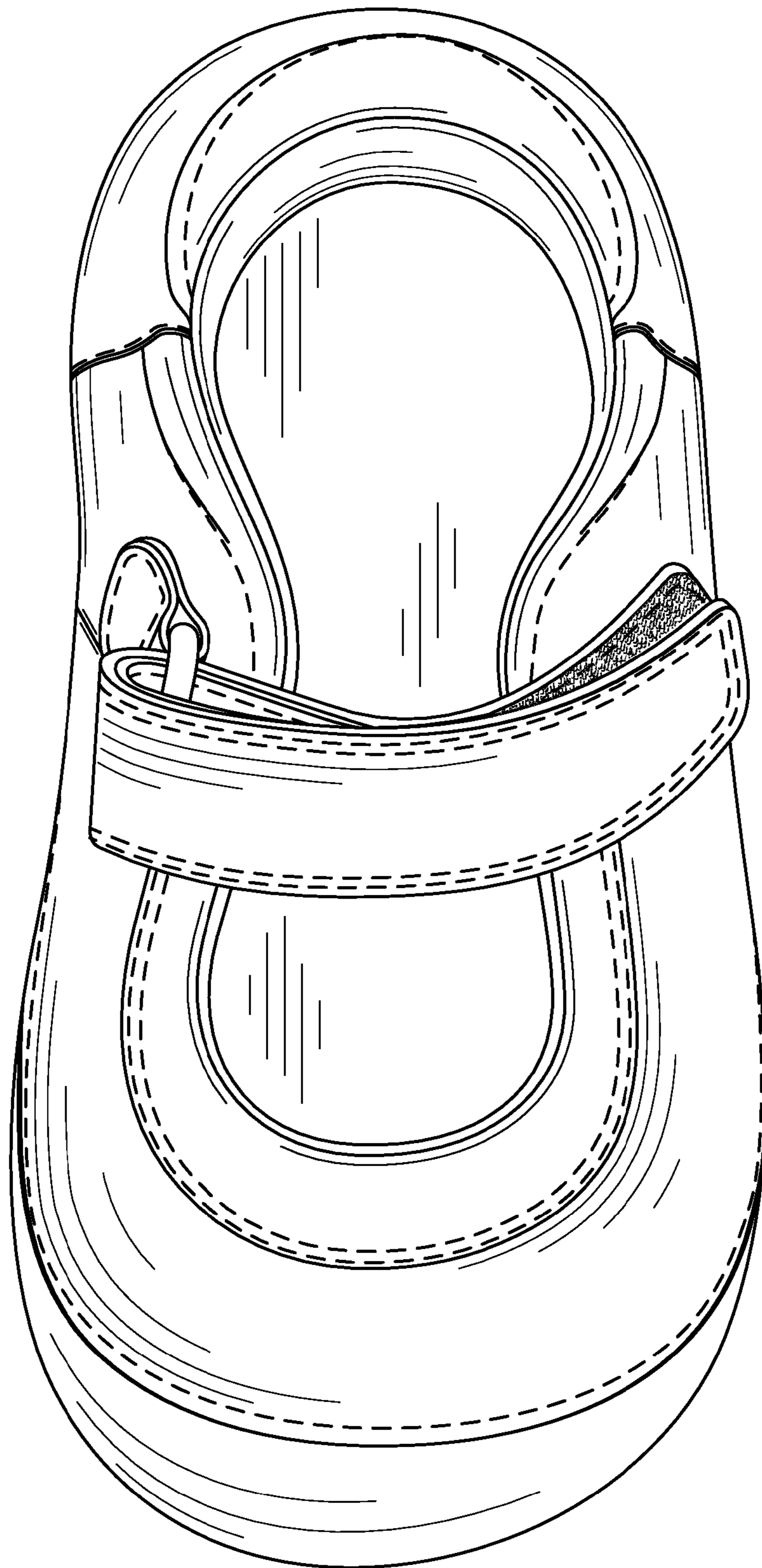

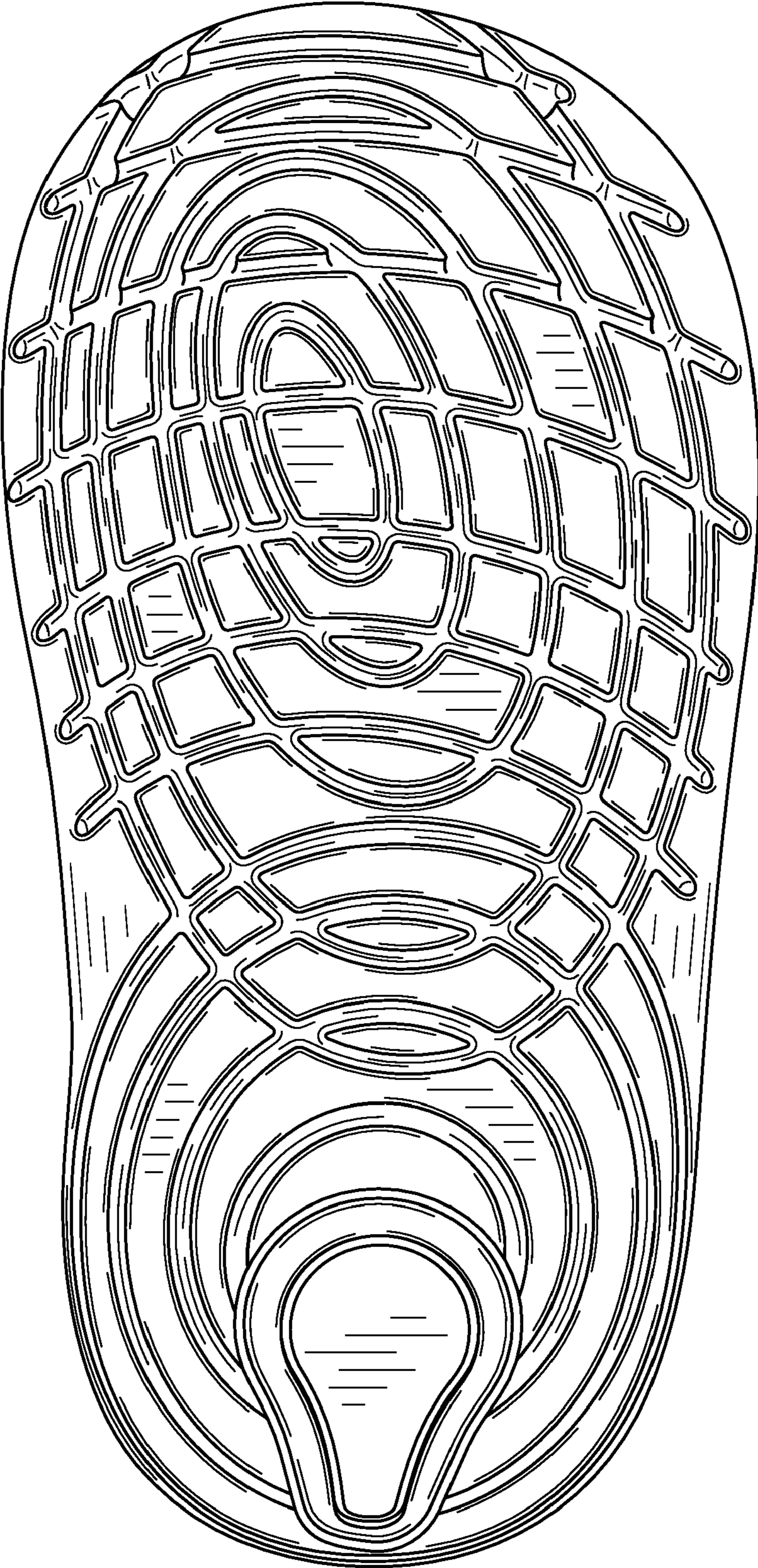
