FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a table showing our new design, the opposite rear view thereof being identical;

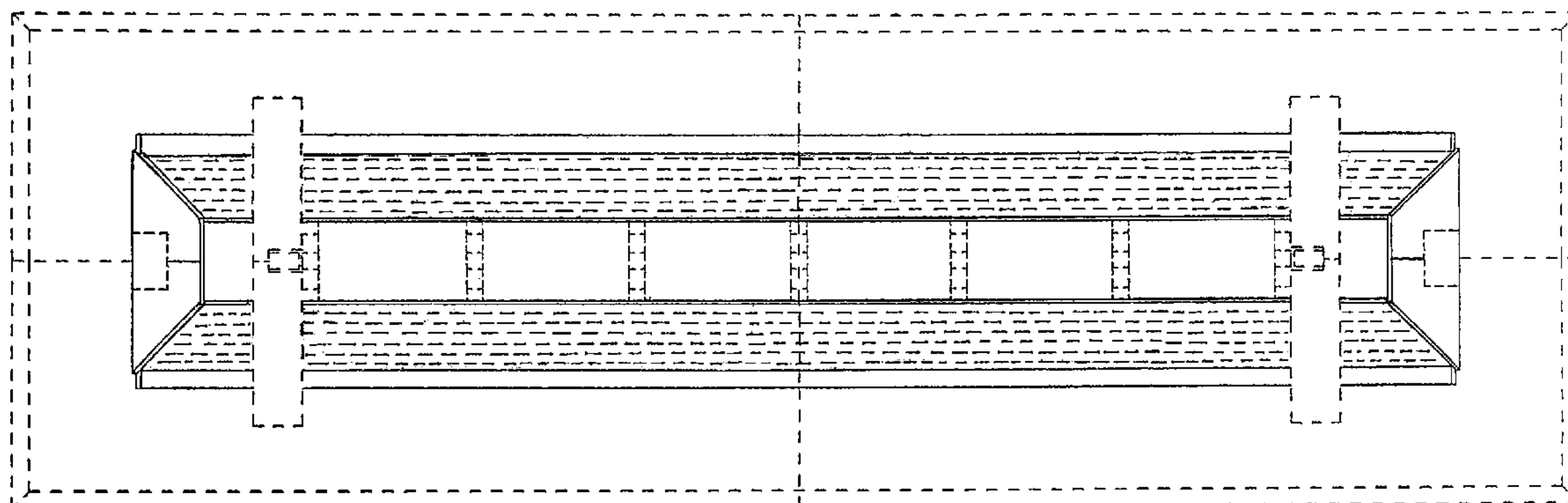
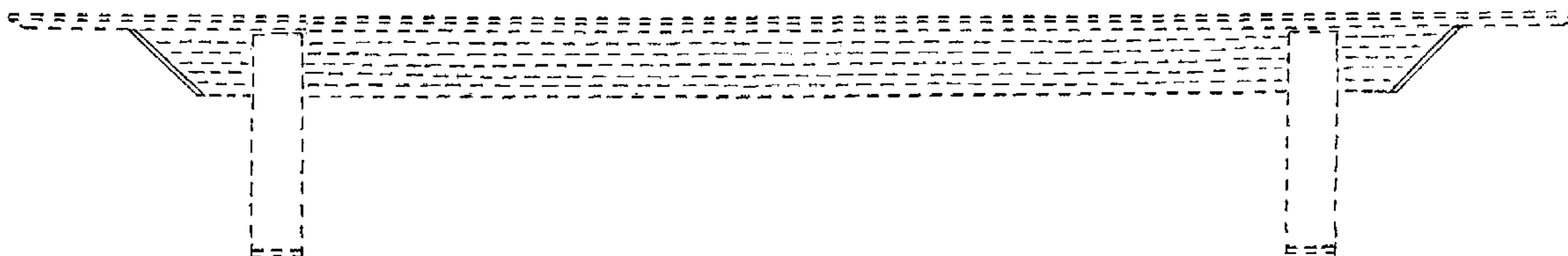
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

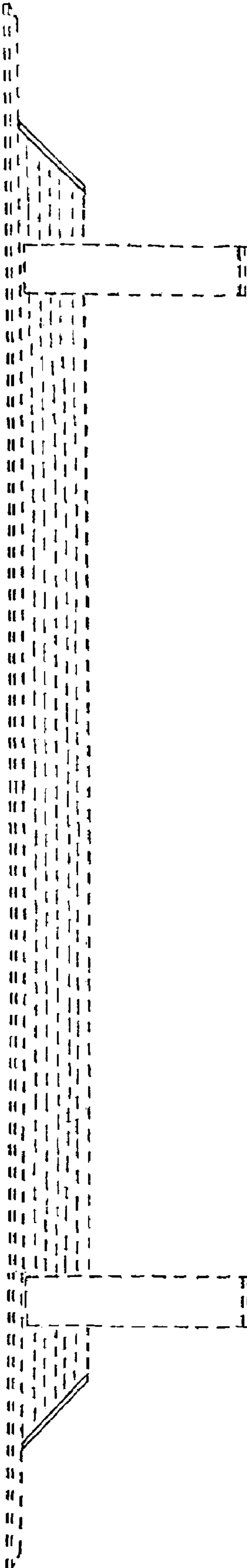
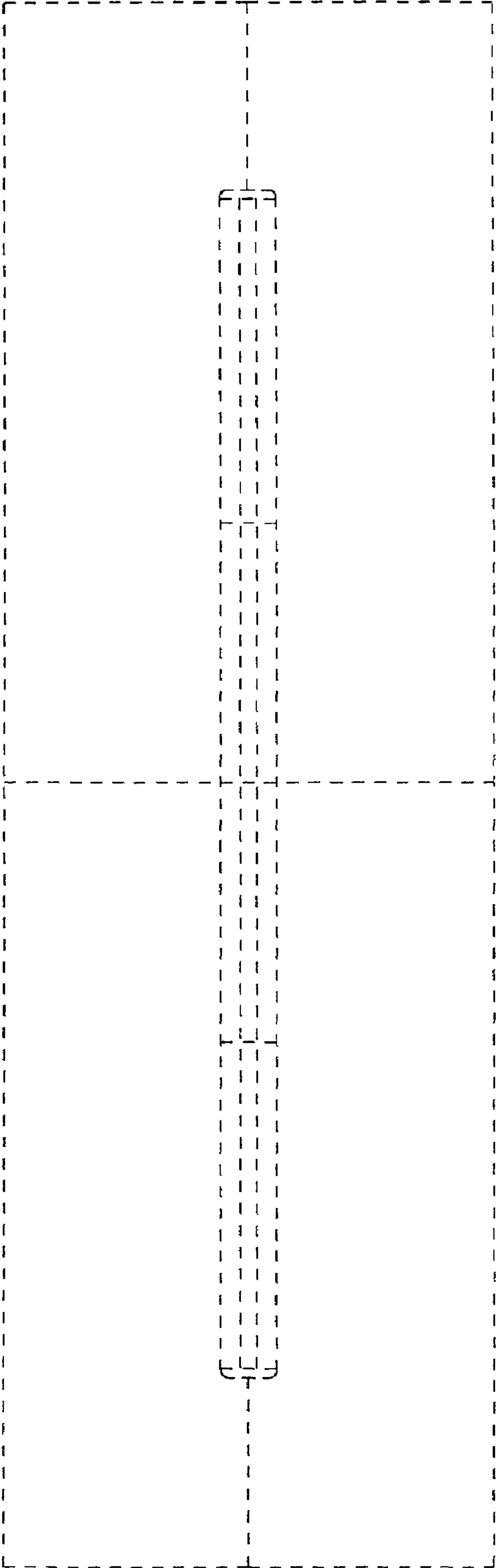

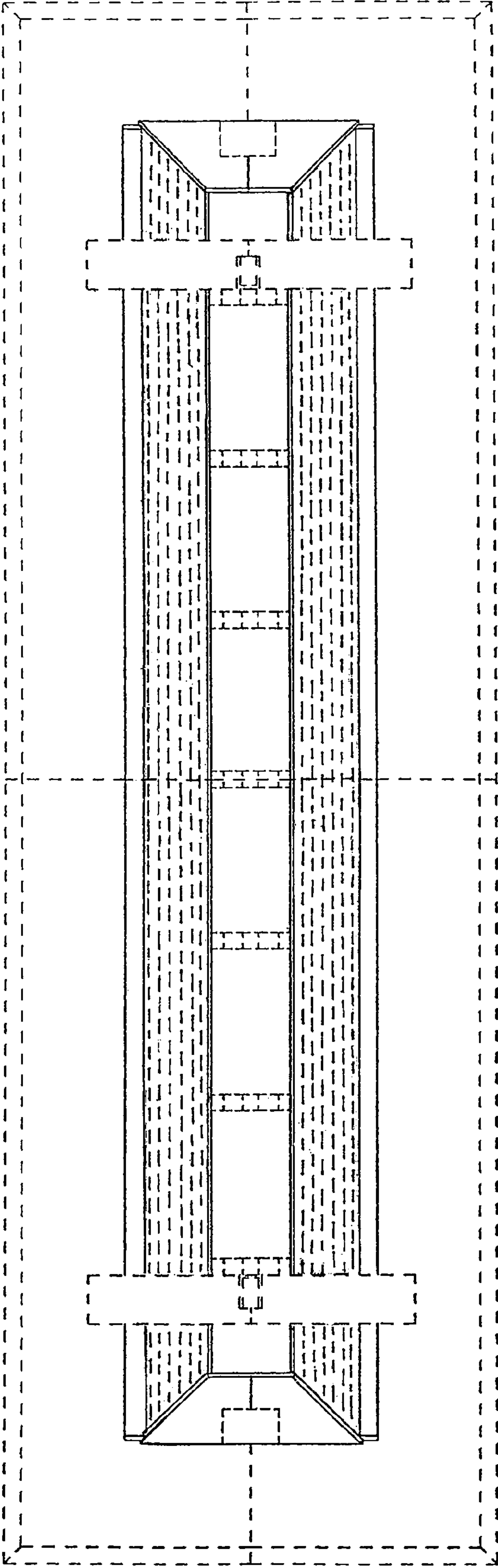

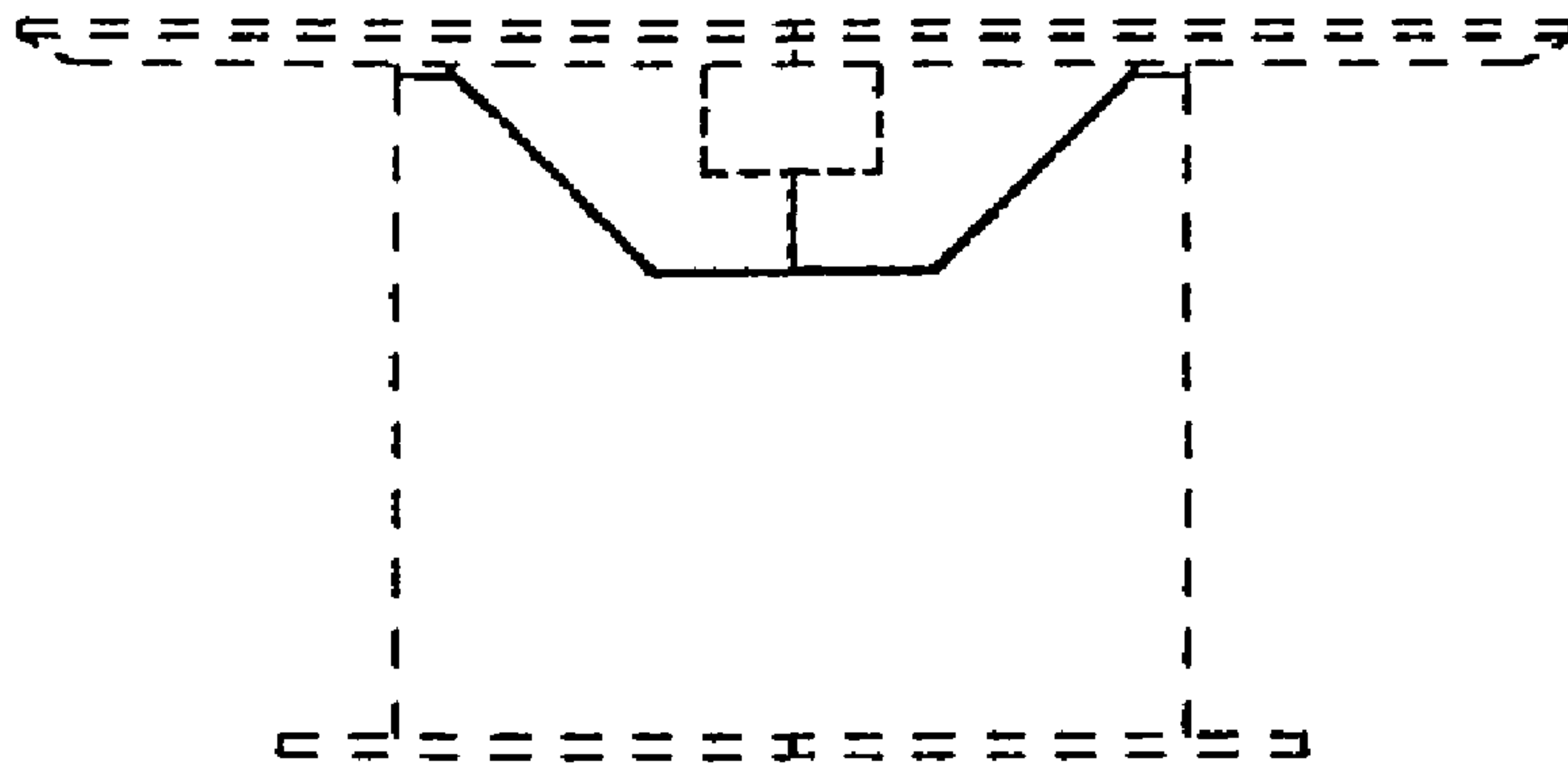

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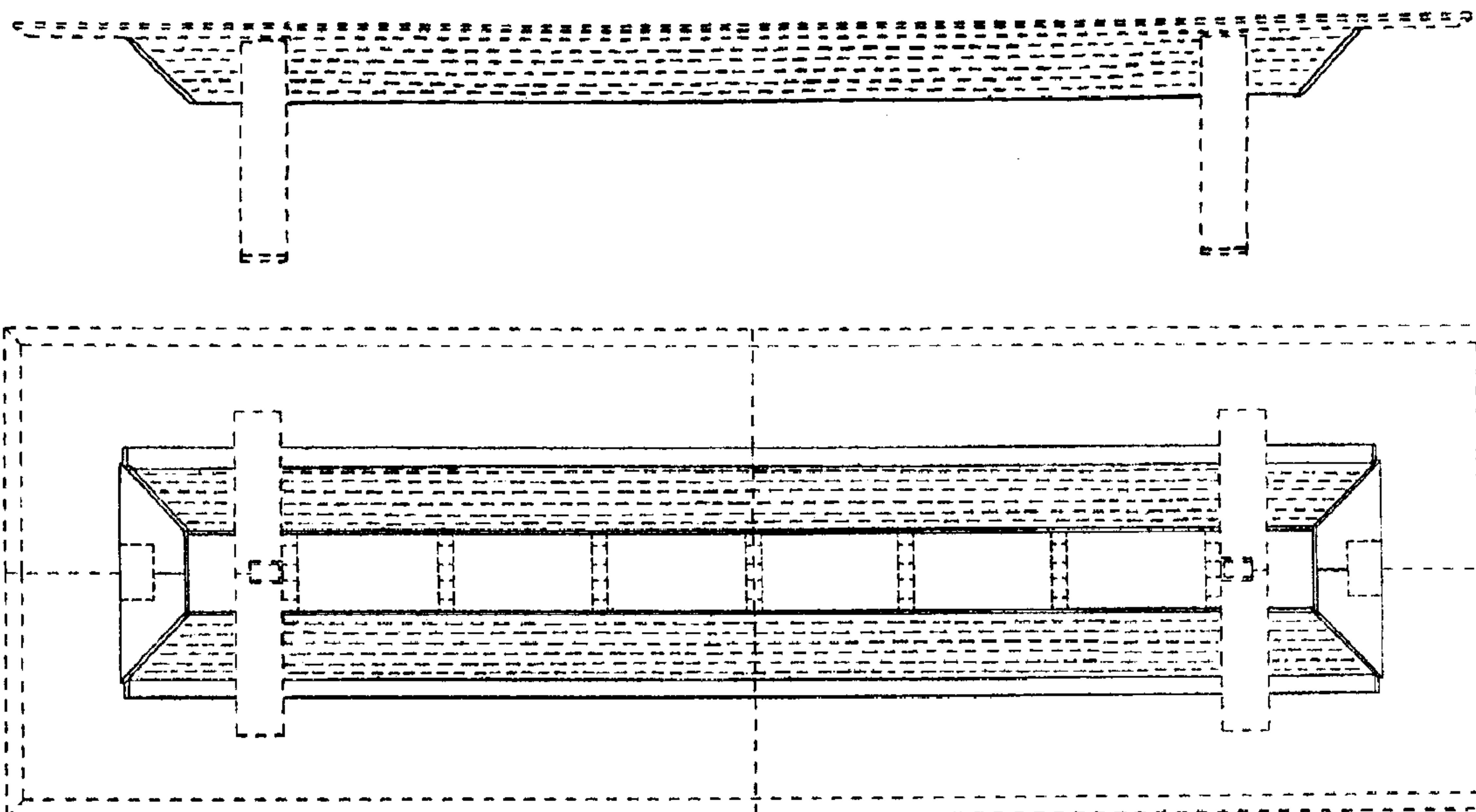
