(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a portion of an embossed shelf edge in shelf unit, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric view of the design in a shelving unit with the unit shown in broken lines for environment;

FIG. 2 is an enlarged perspective view of a portion of the shelf edge of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a front view of the design of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a right side view of the design of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a rear view of the design of FIG. 1;

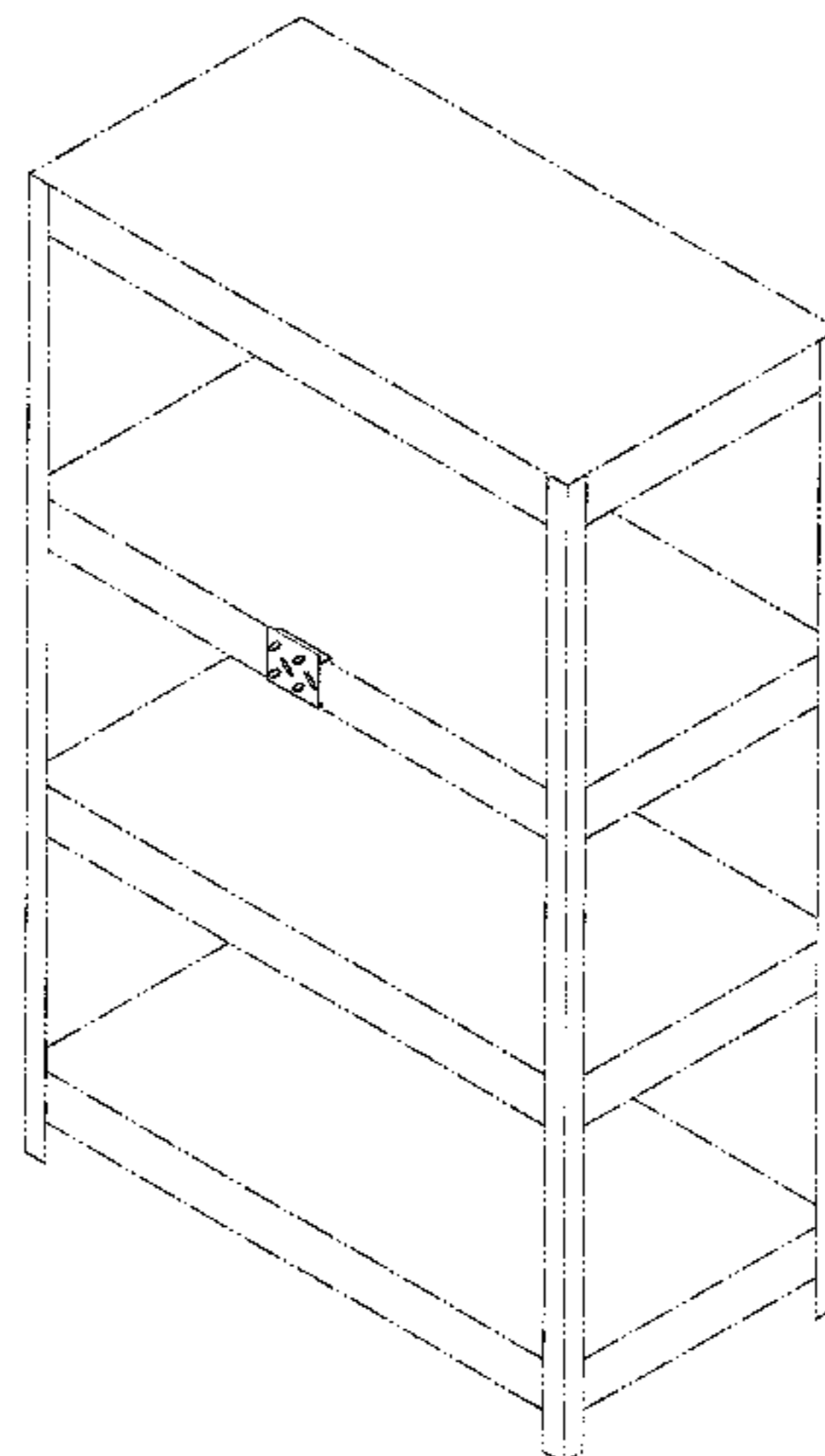
FIG. 6 is a left side view of the design of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a top view of the design of FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 8 is a bottom view of the design of FIG. 1.

The break lines on the edges of FIGS. 1, 2, 3, 5, 7 and 8 are not part of the claimed design and represent that no particular length is claimed. Diagonal lines on edges of pieces in FIGS. 2, 4 and 6 and break lines on the edges of the pieces in FIGS. 2, 3, 5, 7 and 8 are used to indicate cutaway portions and are not shading or design features.

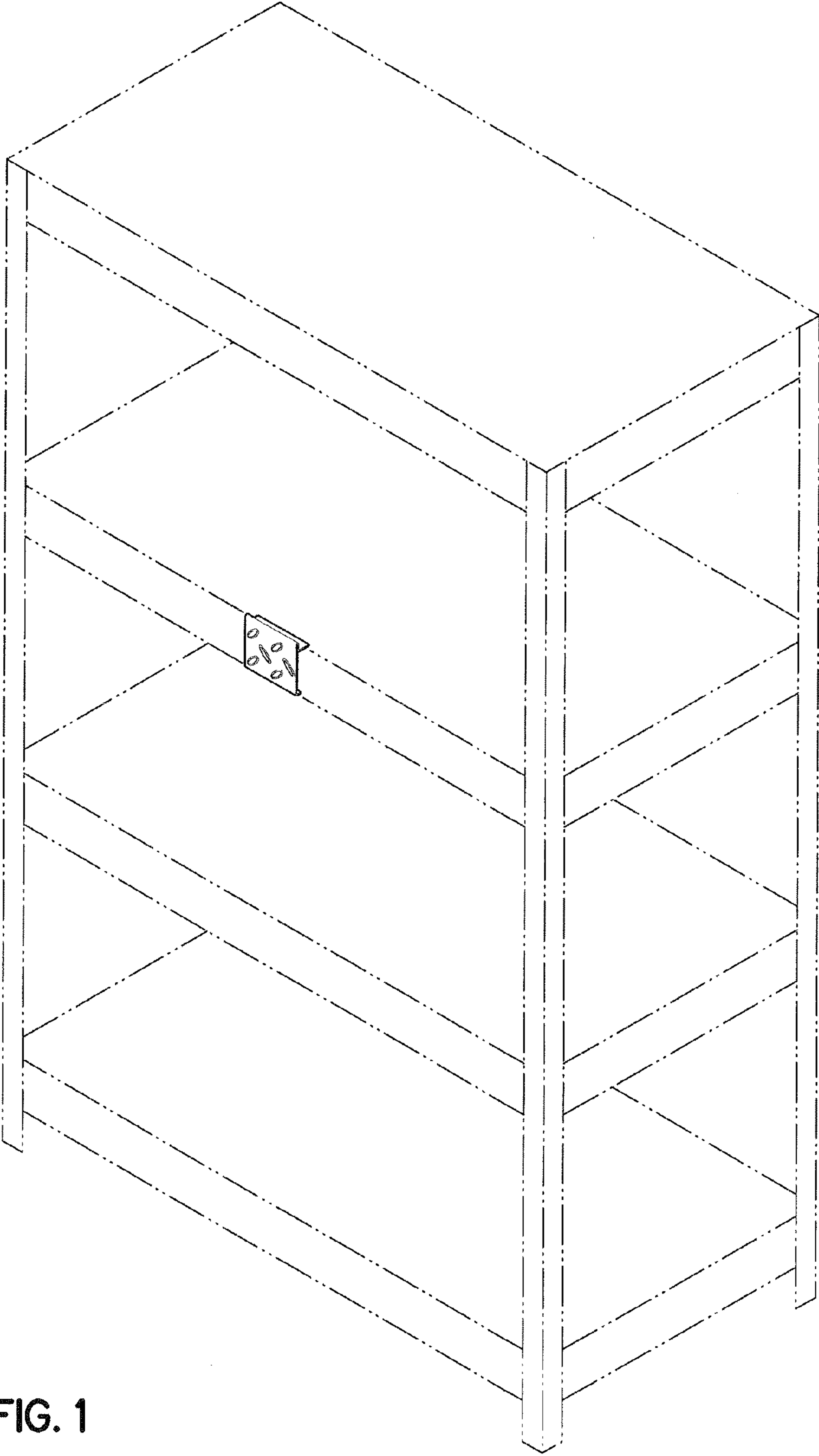

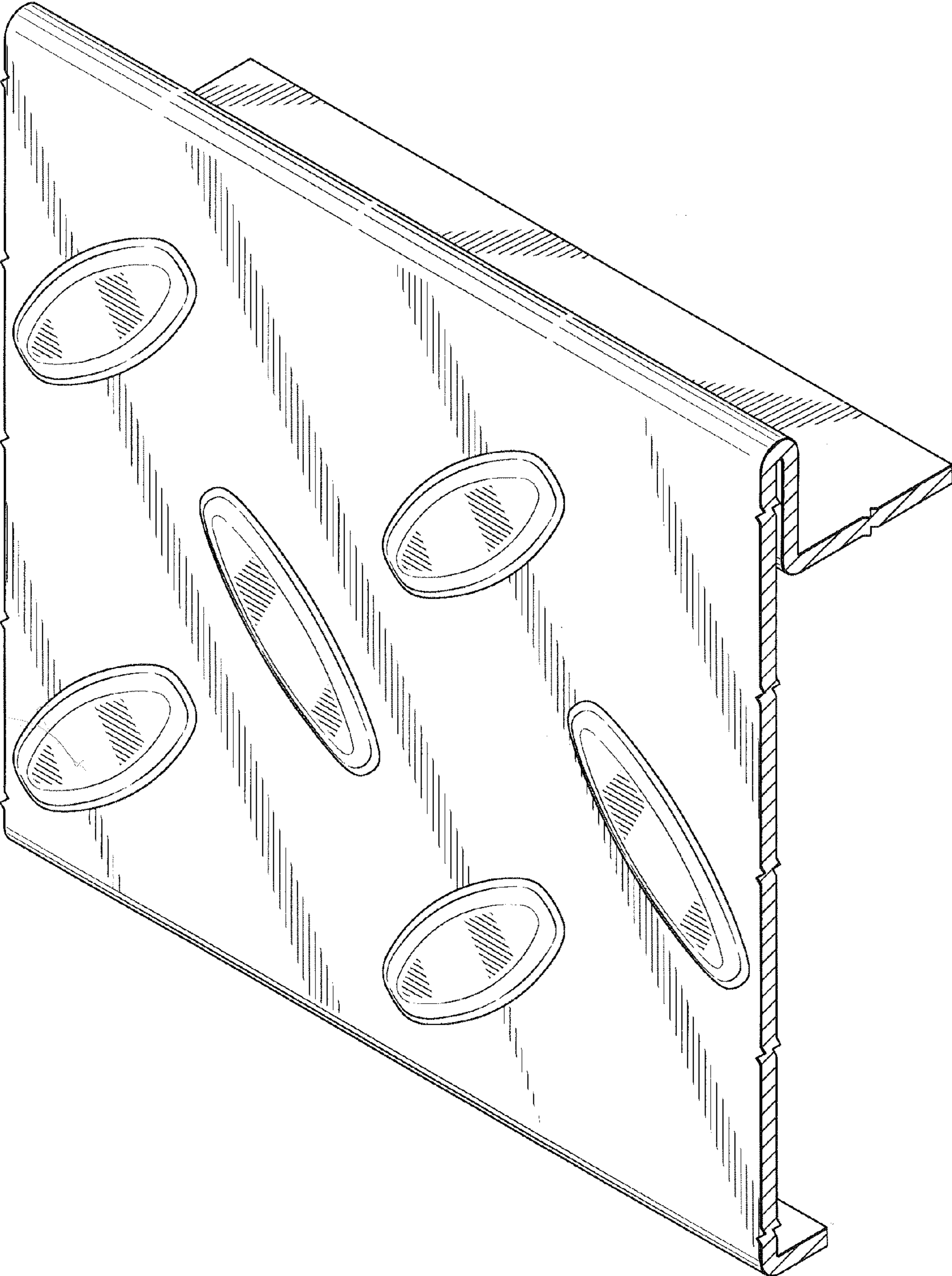

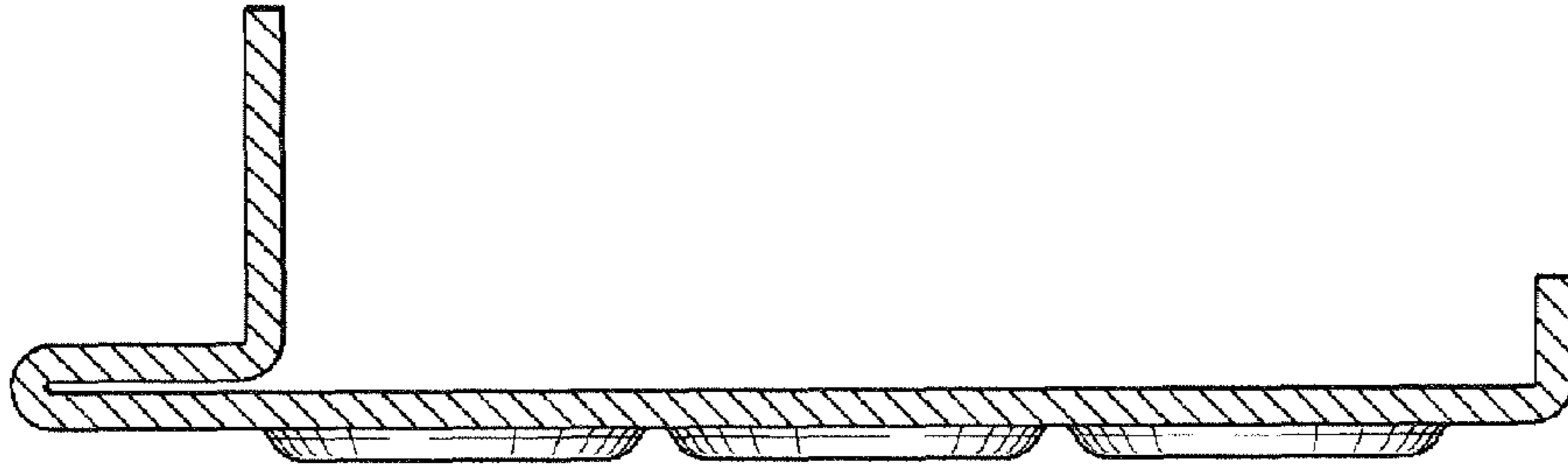

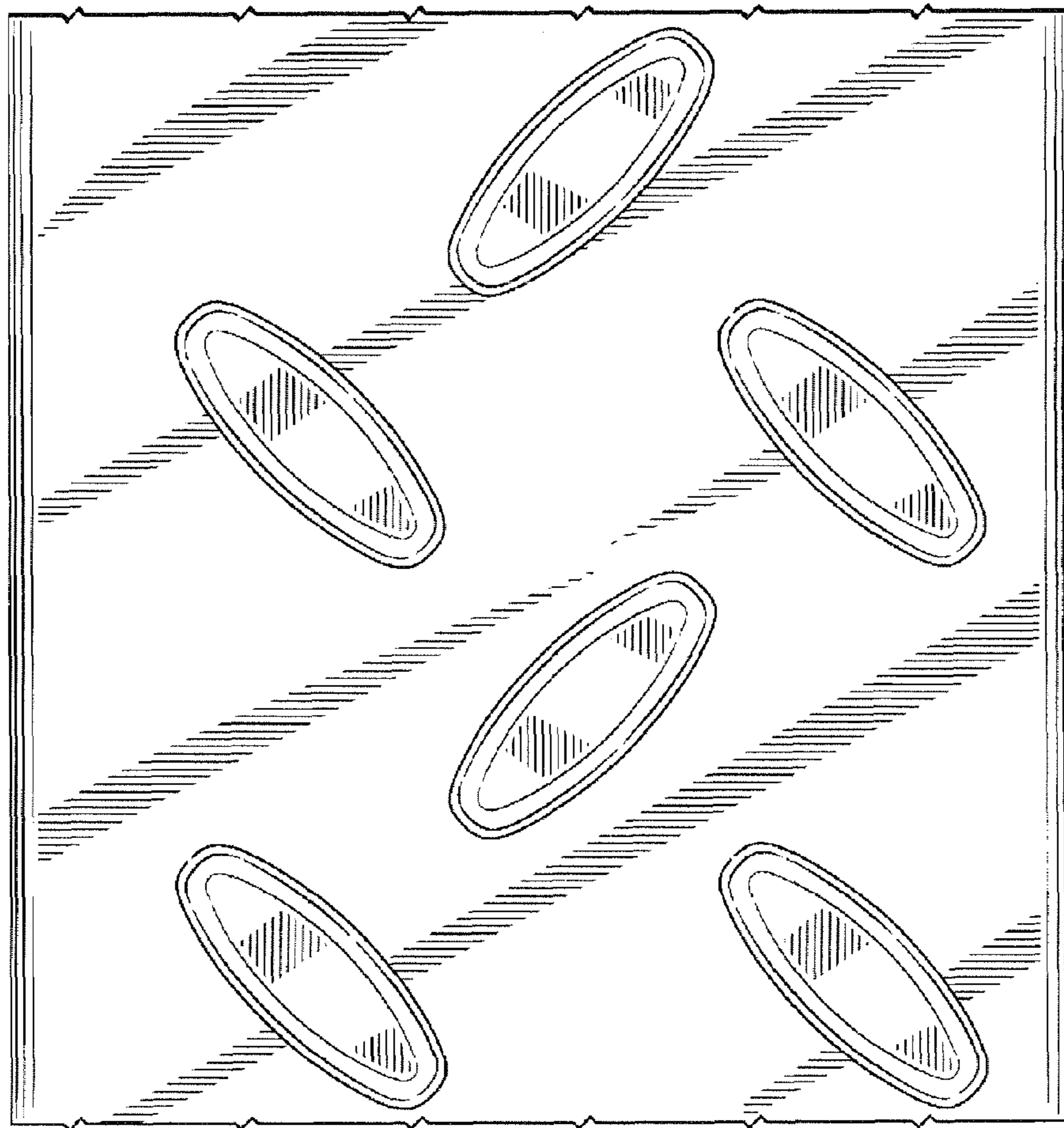

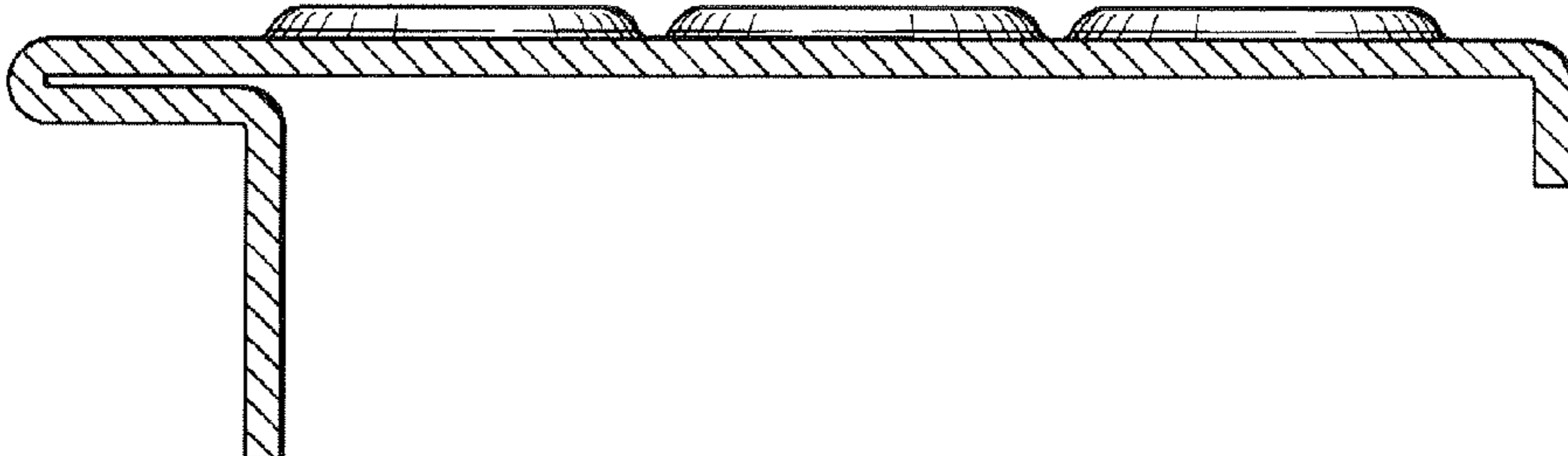

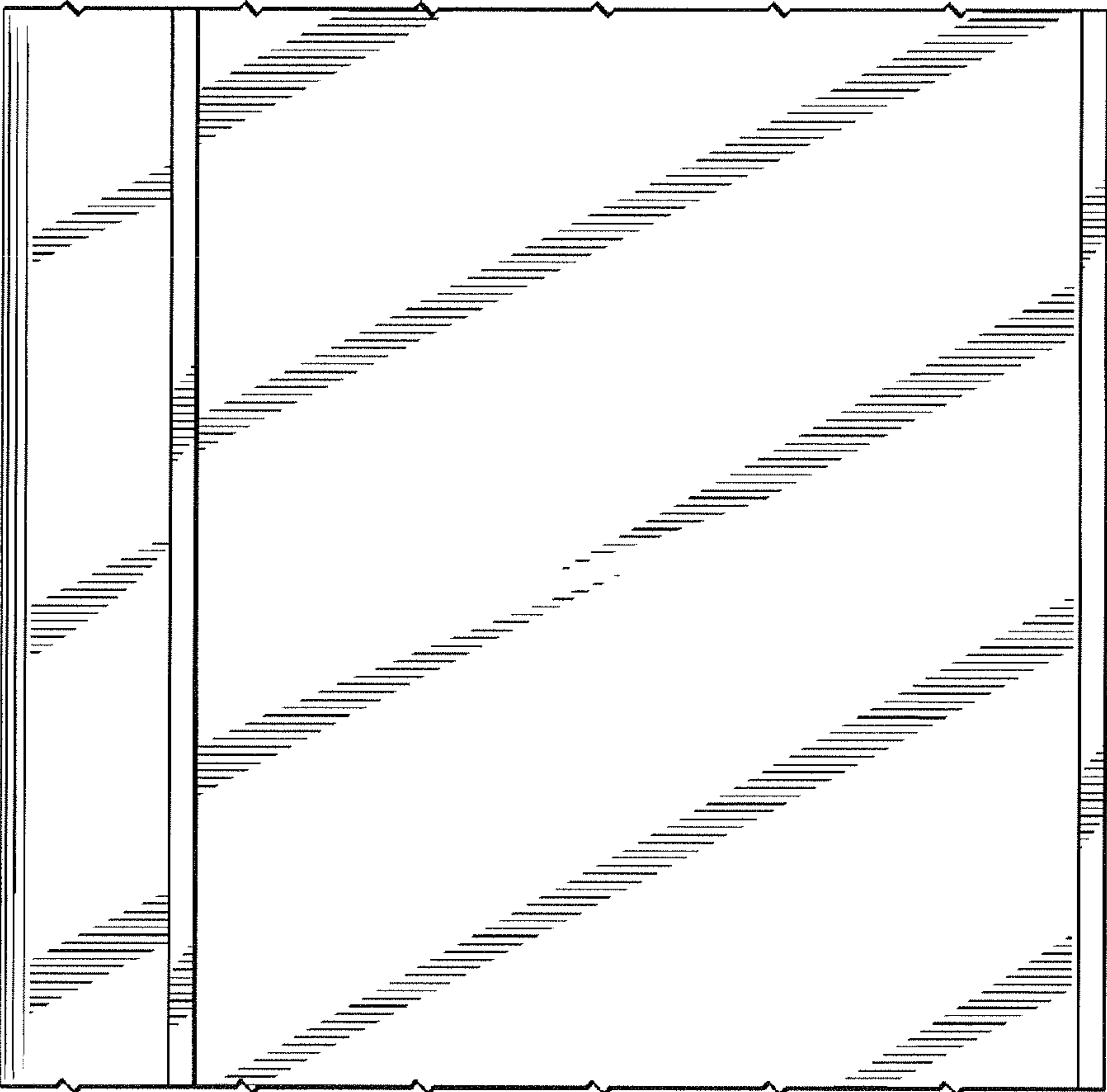

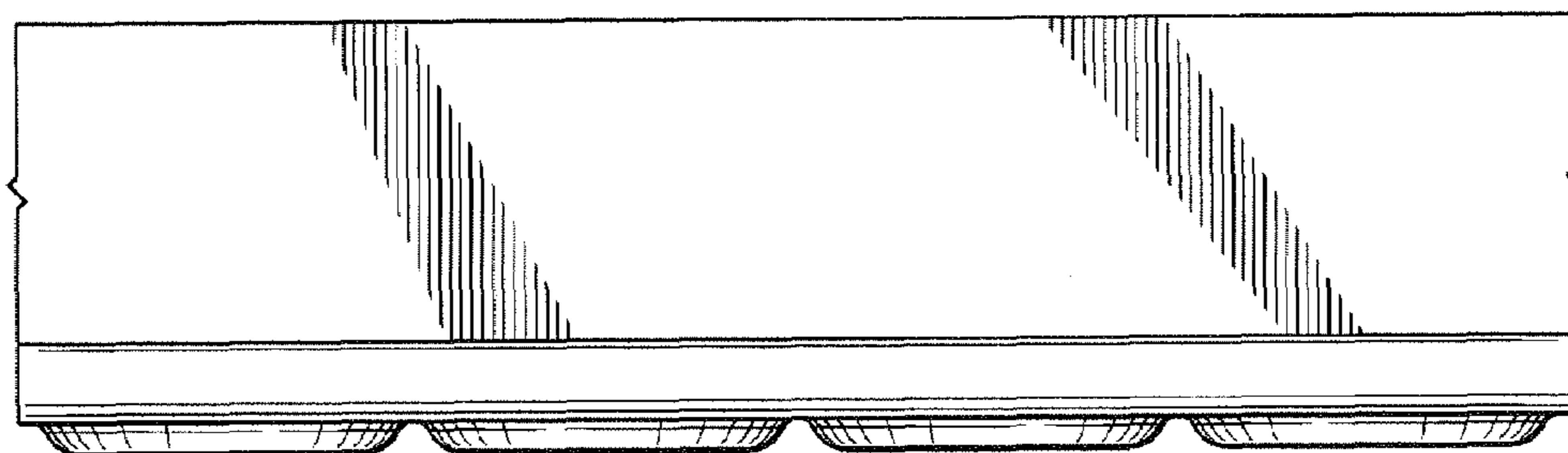

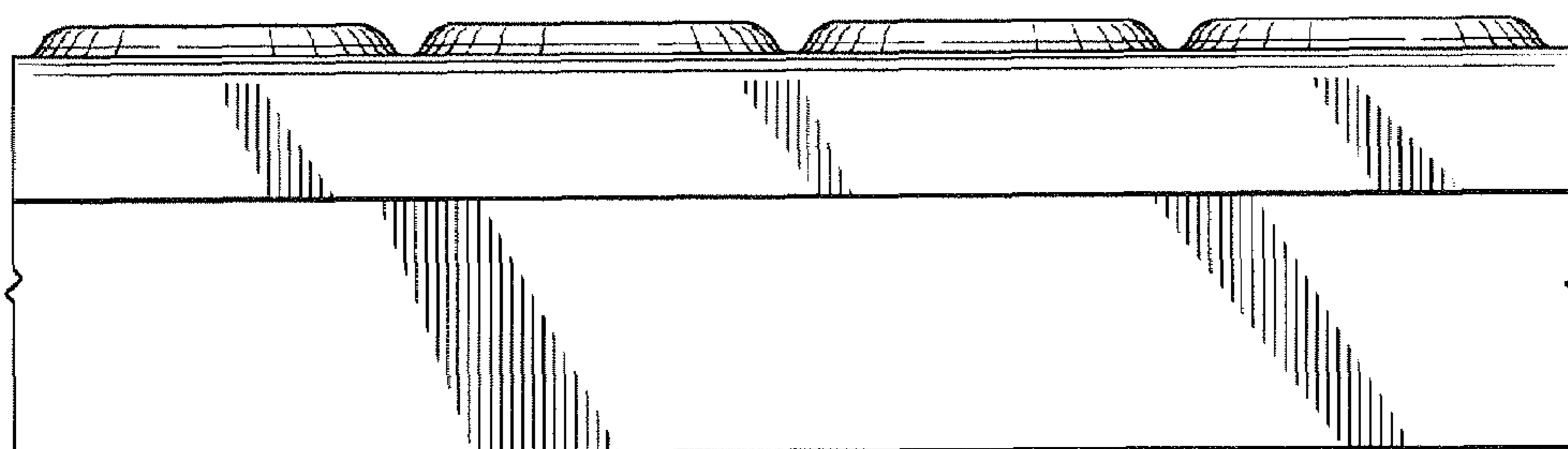
