DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the massage chair of the present invention, the chair shown in a partially reclined position;

FIG. 2 is a side view of the massage chair of the present invention, the chair shown in an upright position;

FIG. 3 is a front view of the massage chair of the present invention;

FIG. 4 is another side view of the massage chair of the present invention;

FIG. 5 is a back view of the massage chair of the present invention; and,

FIG. 6 is a top view of the massage chair of the present invention.

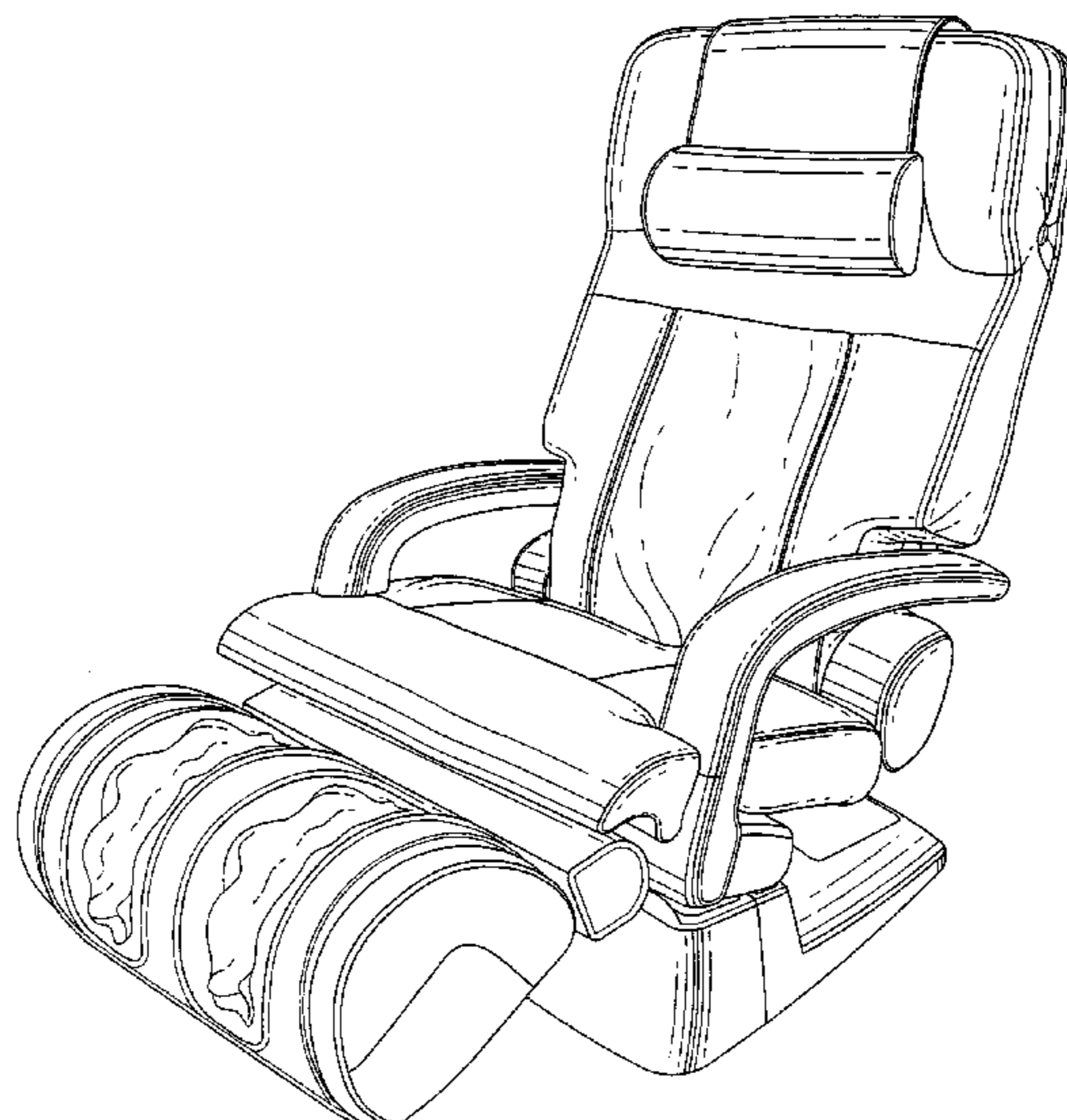

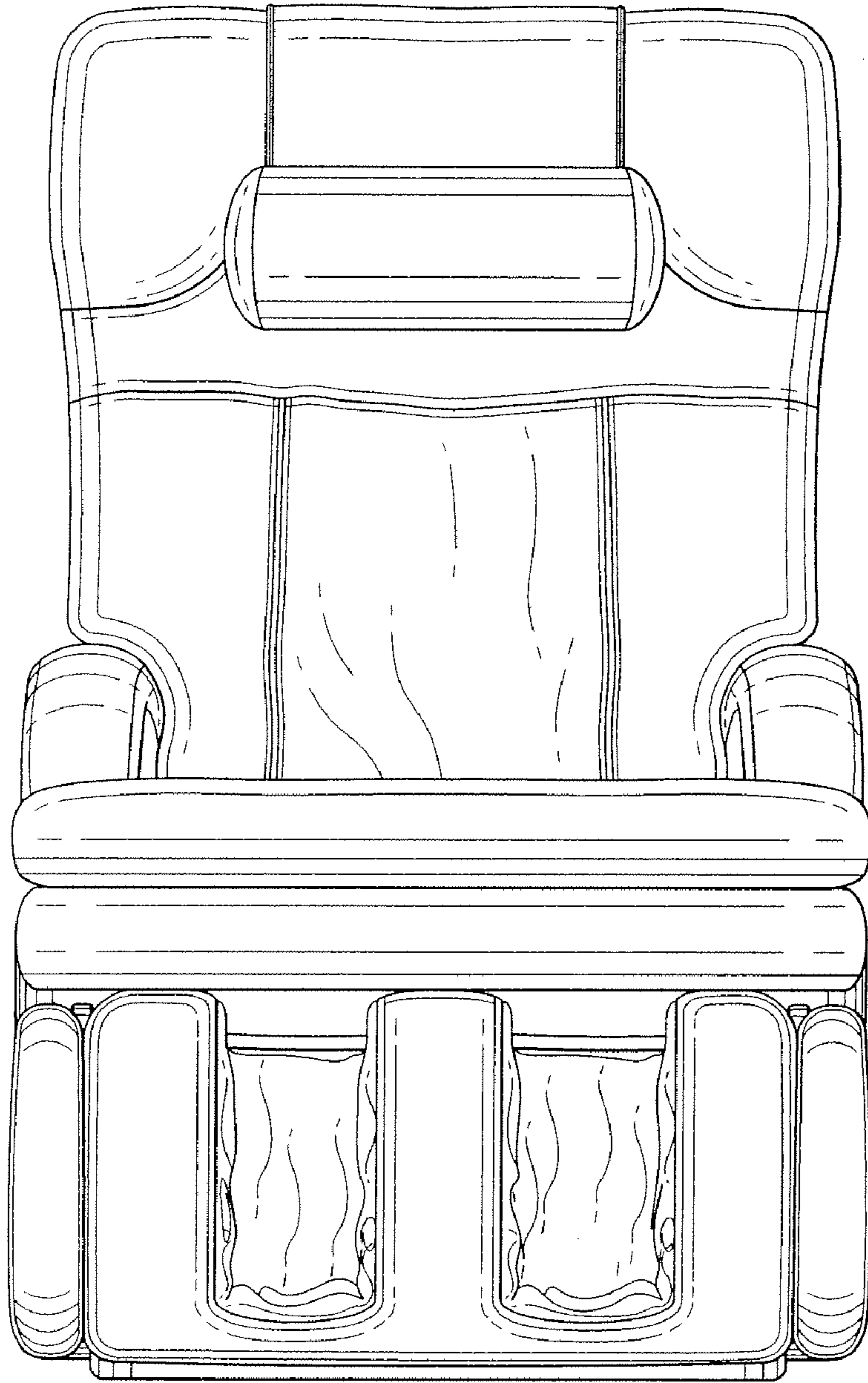

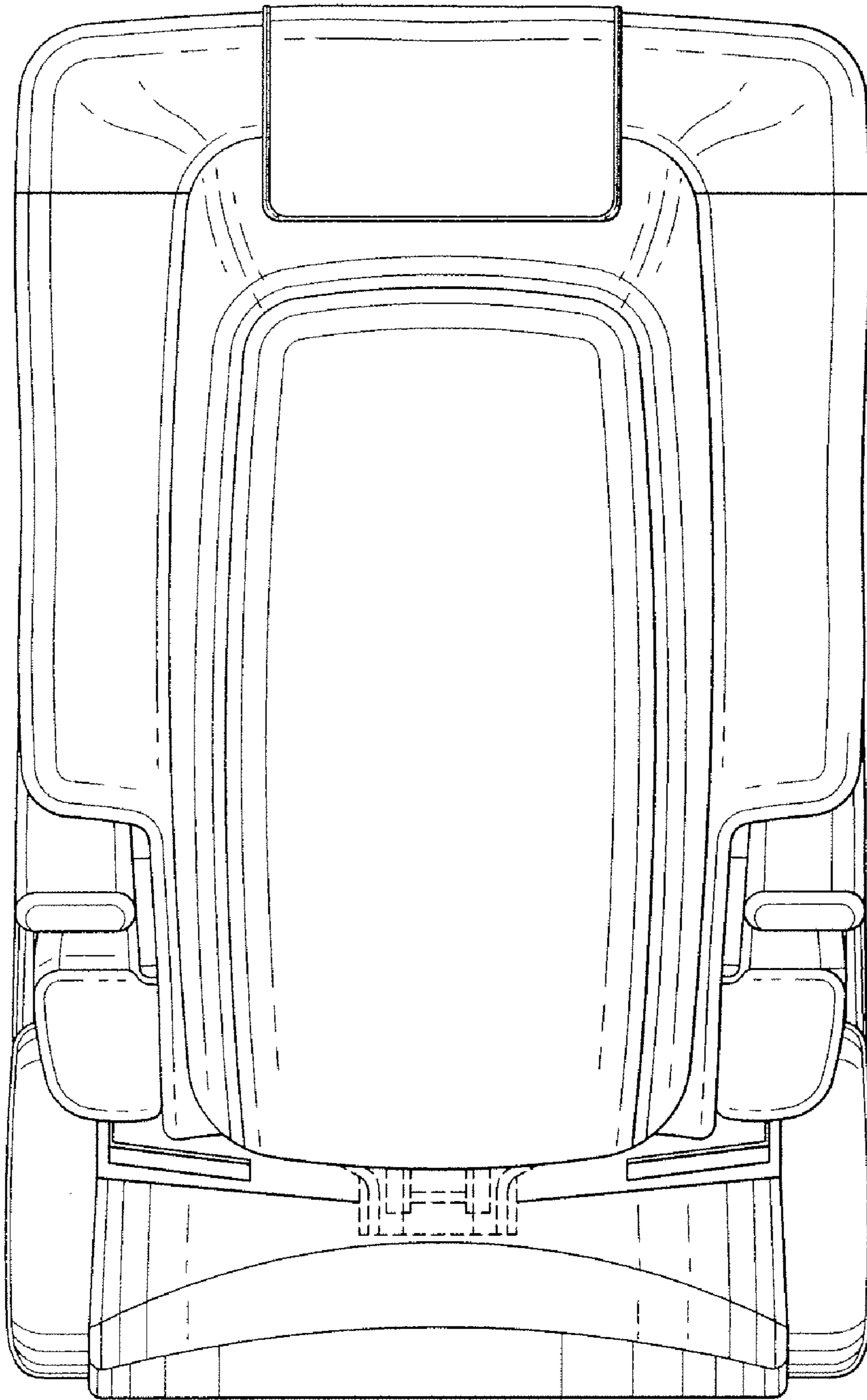
