DESCRIPTION

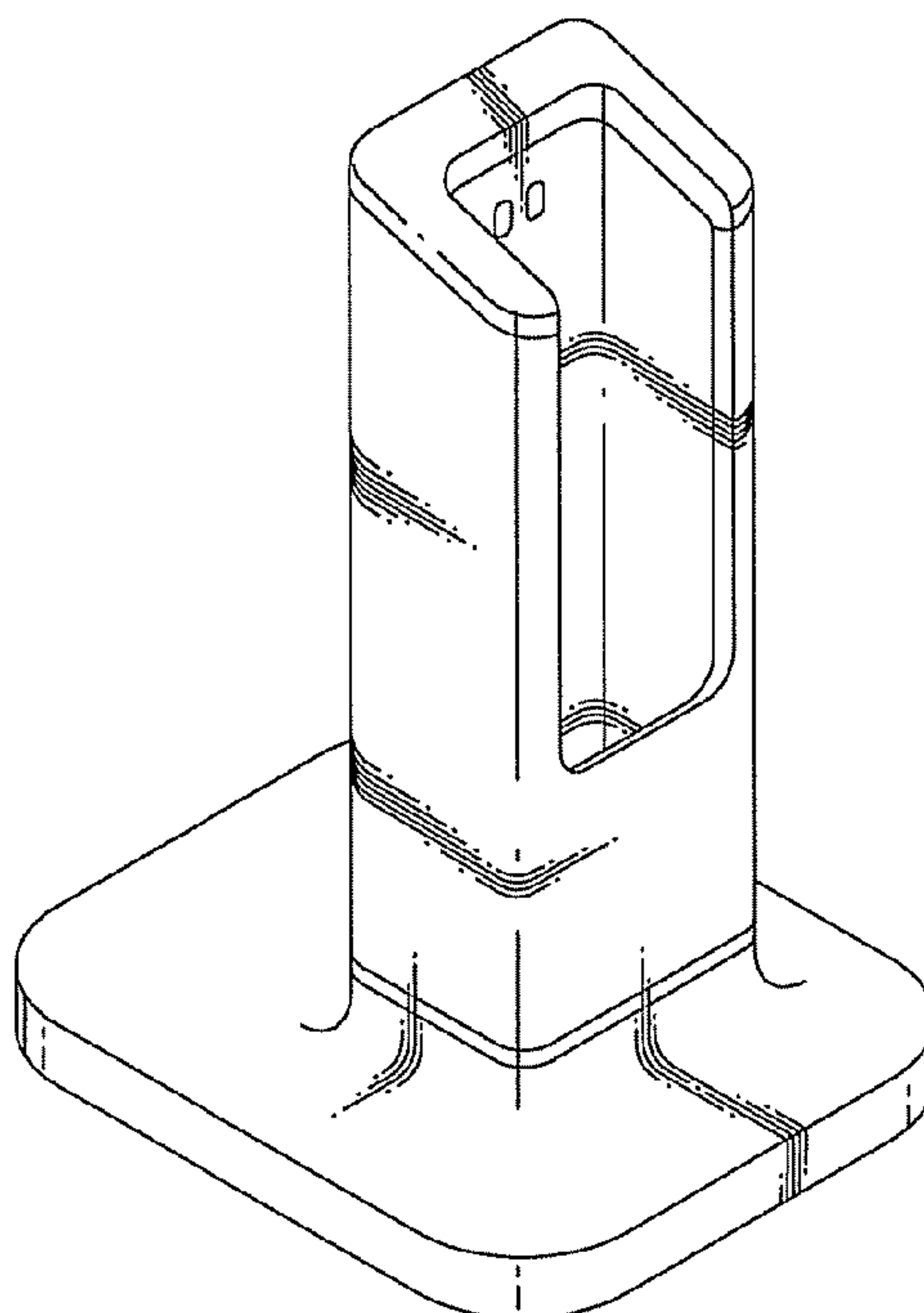

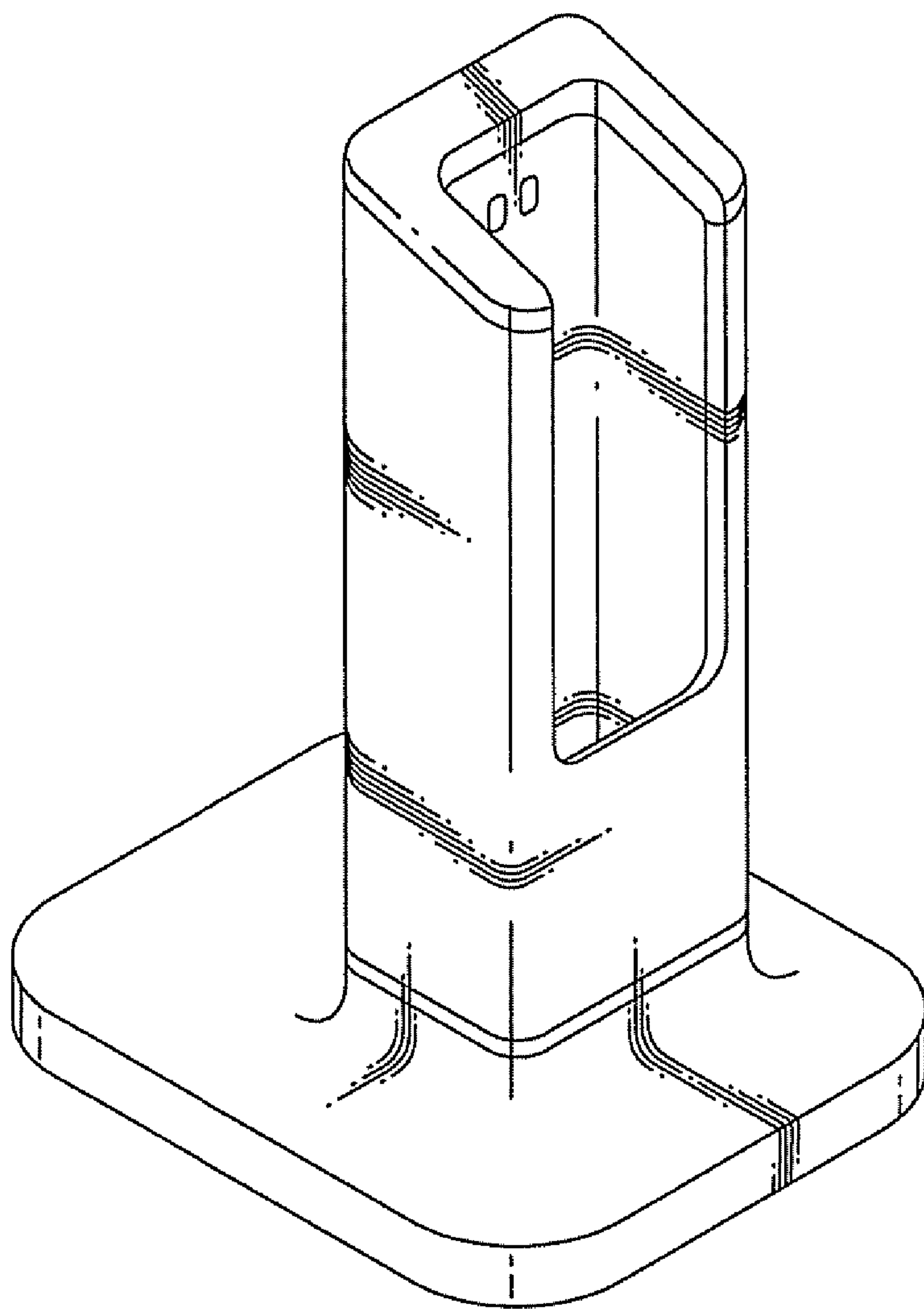

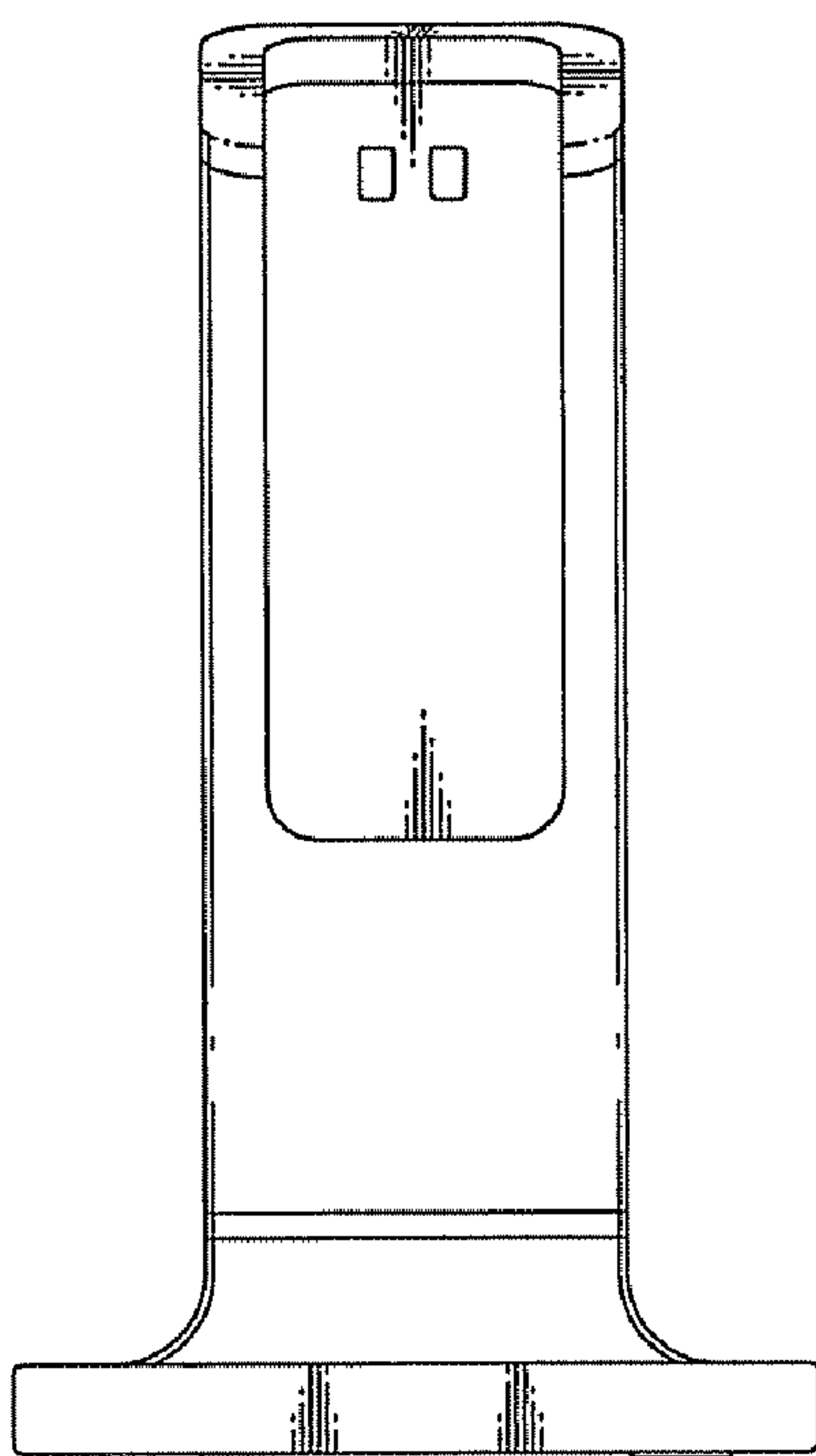

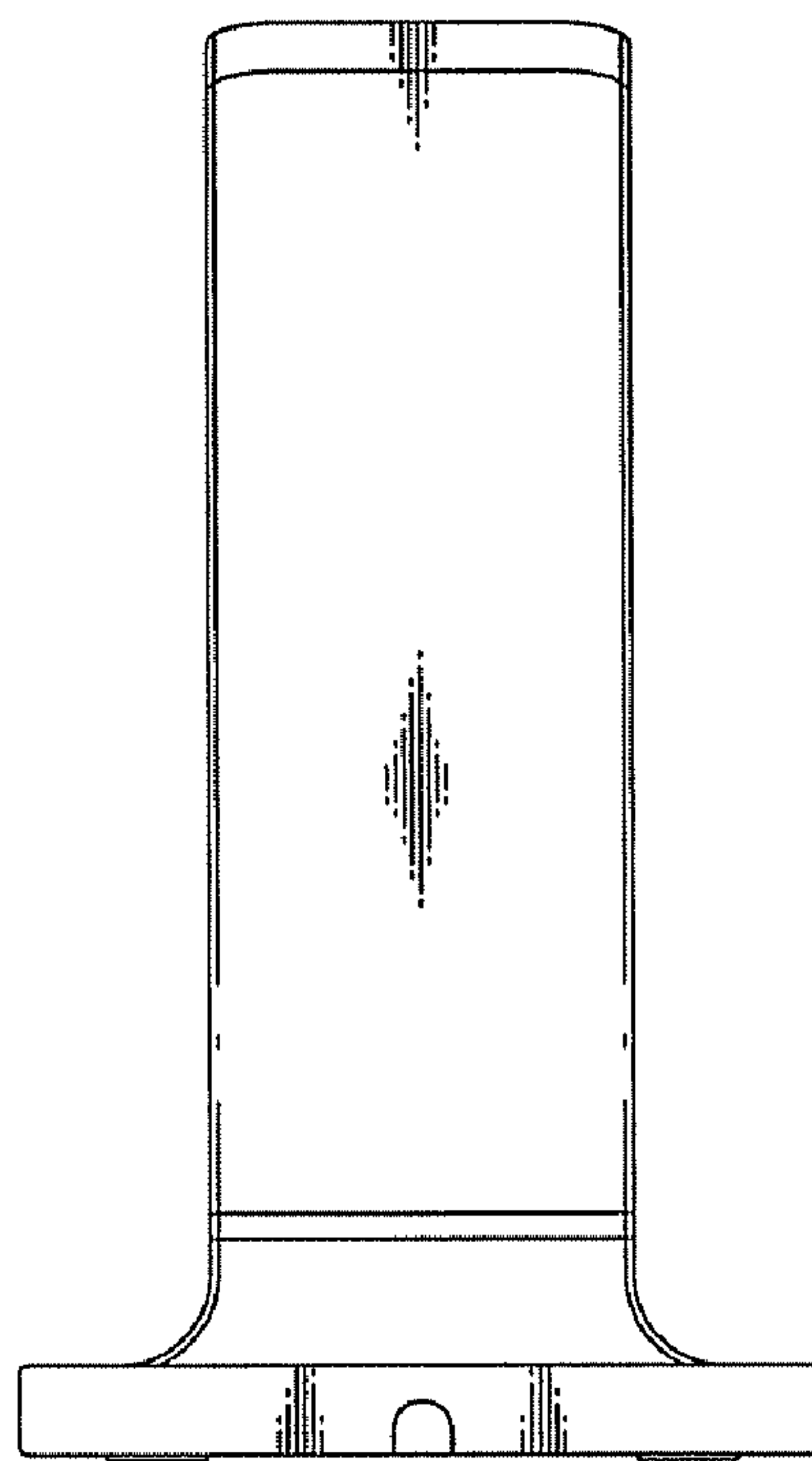

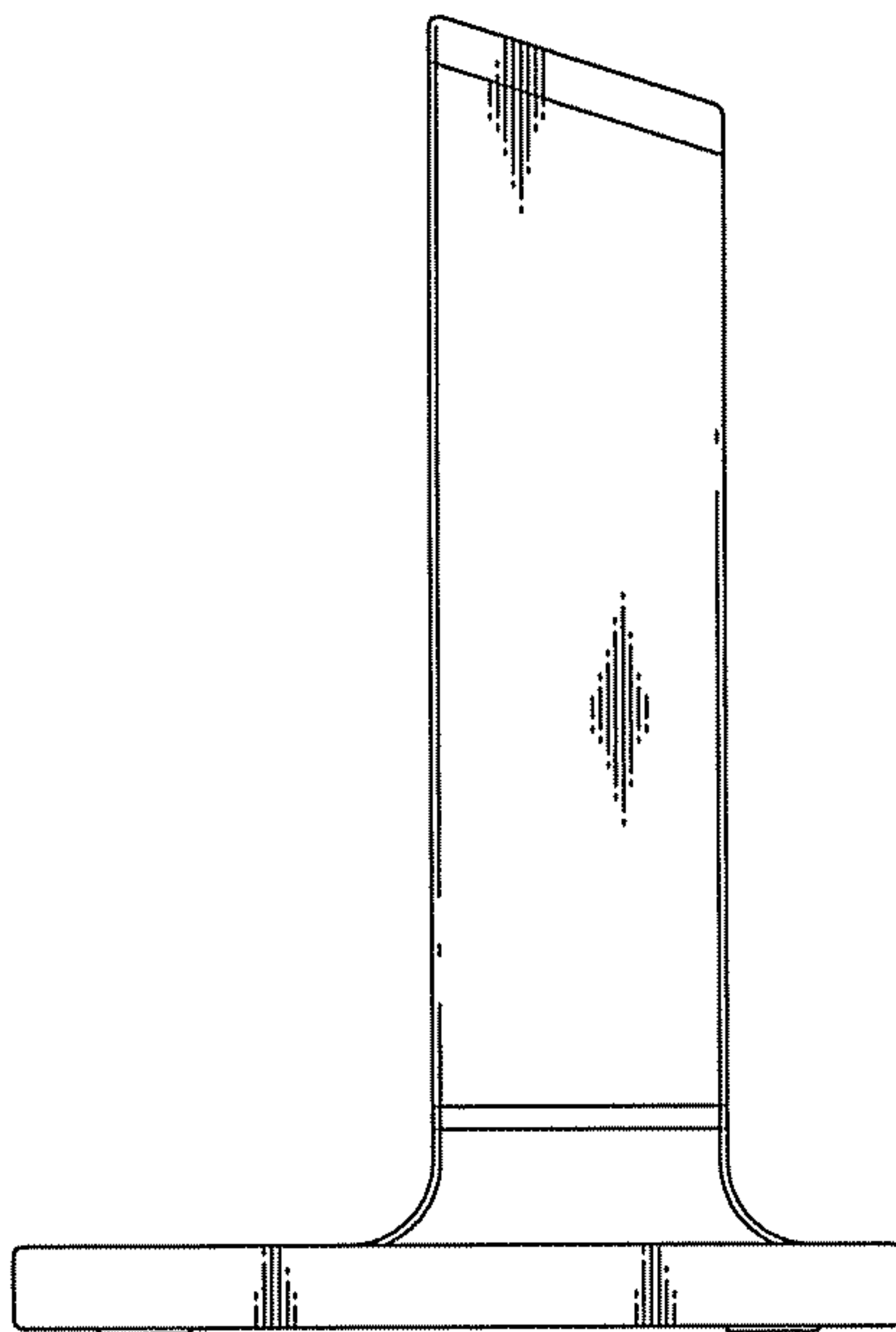

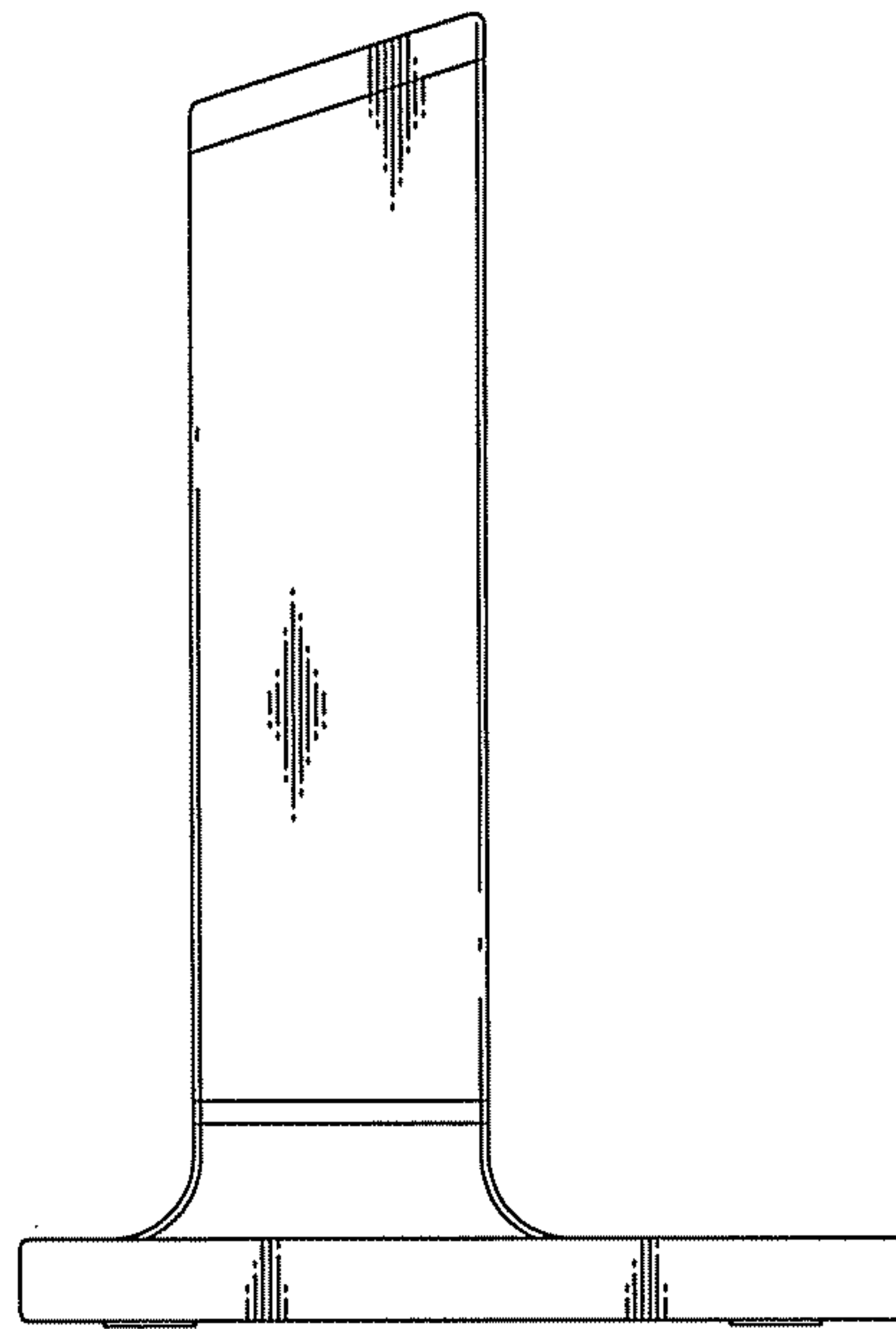

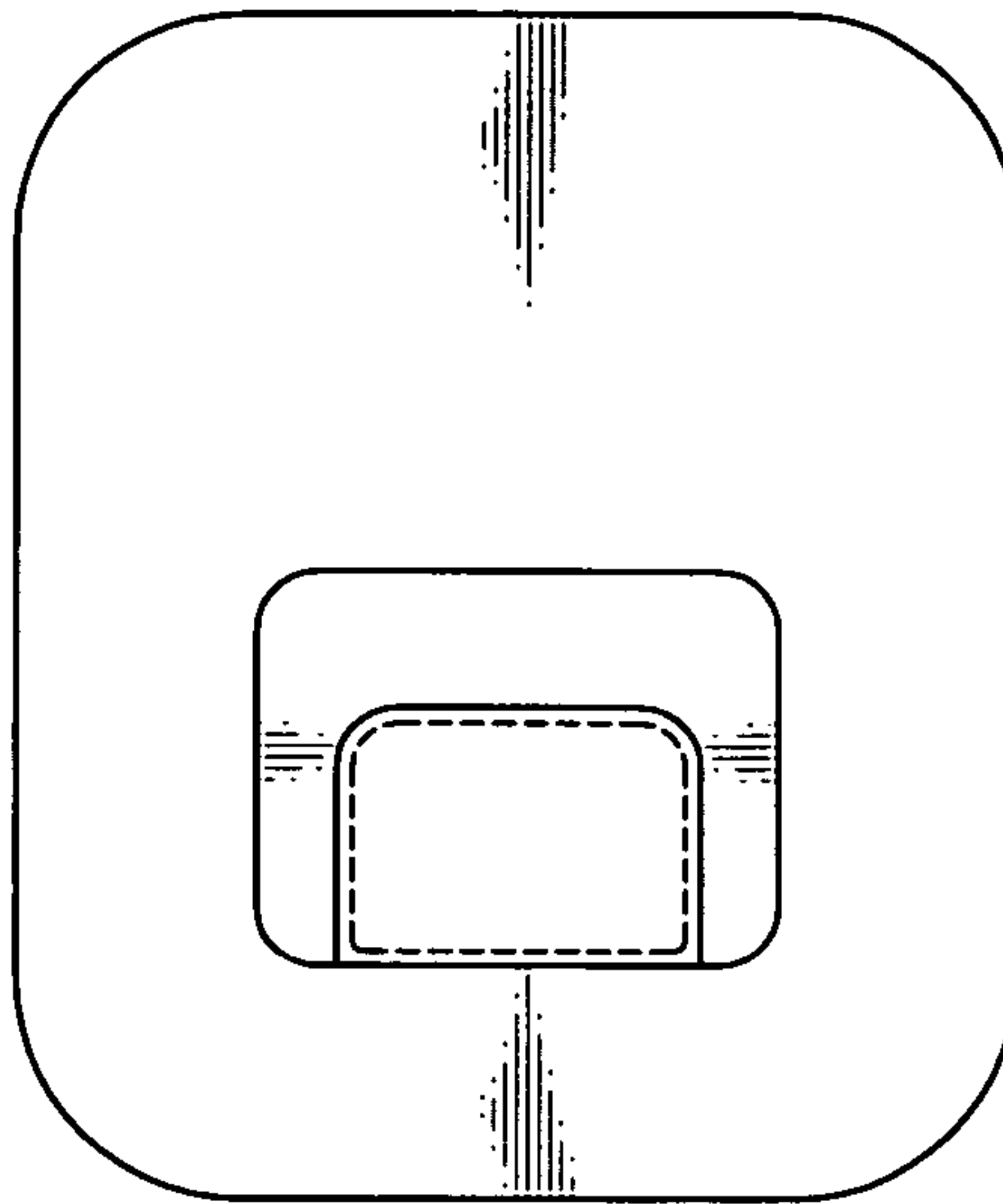

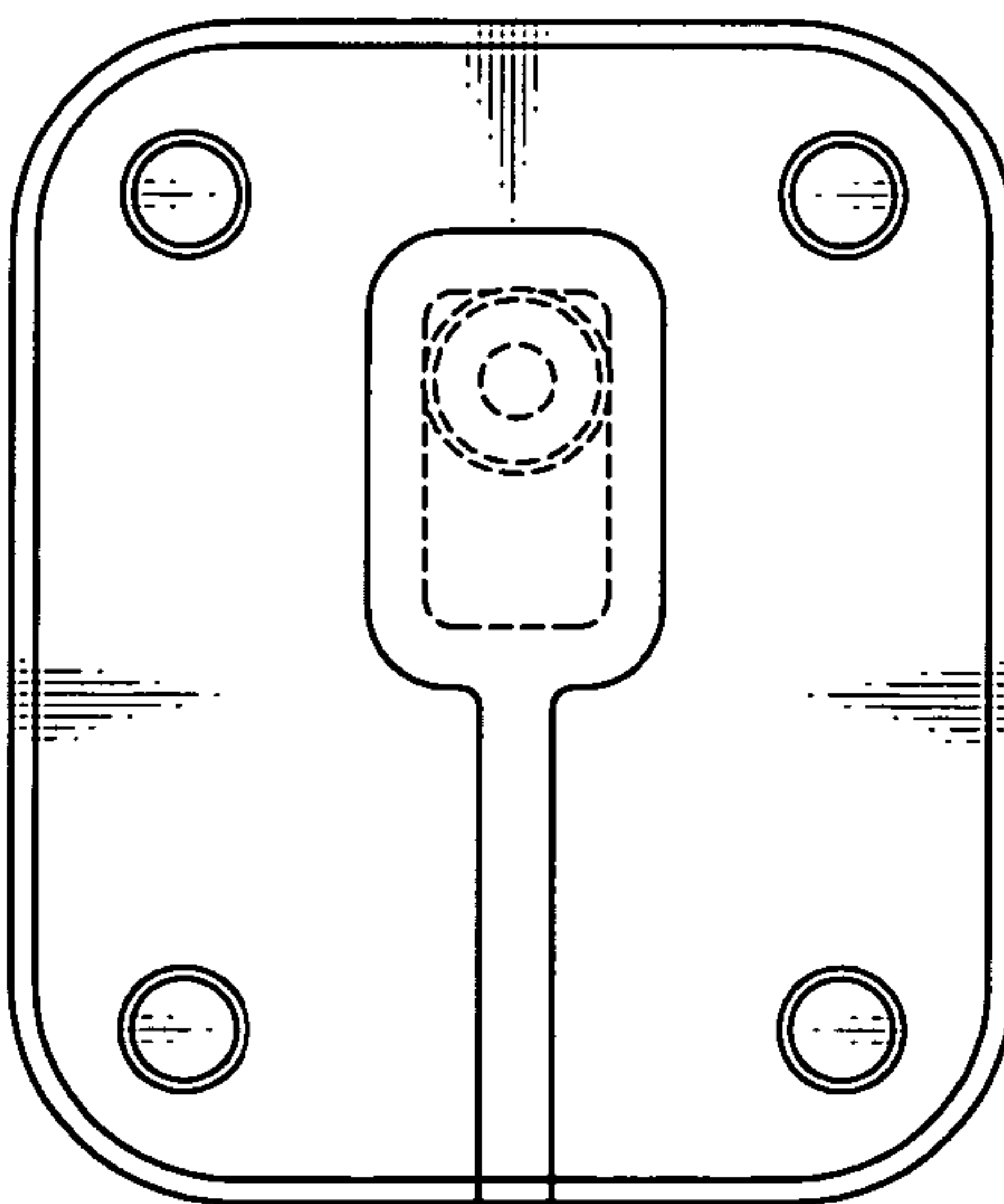
