FIG. 4. is a left side elevational view thereof;

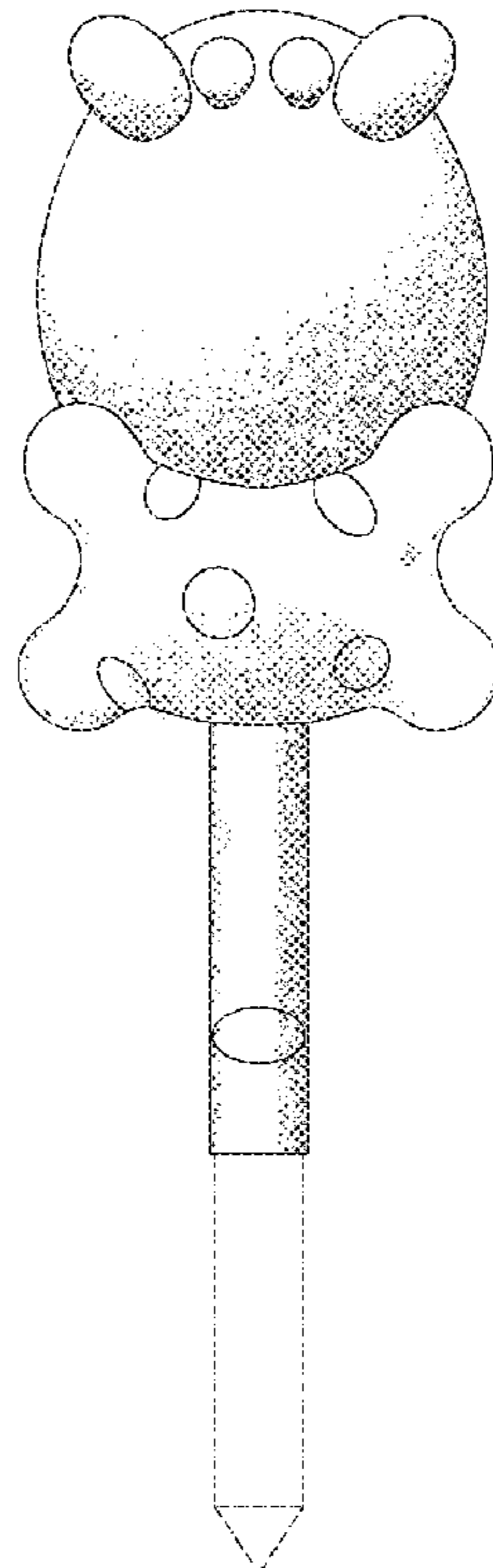
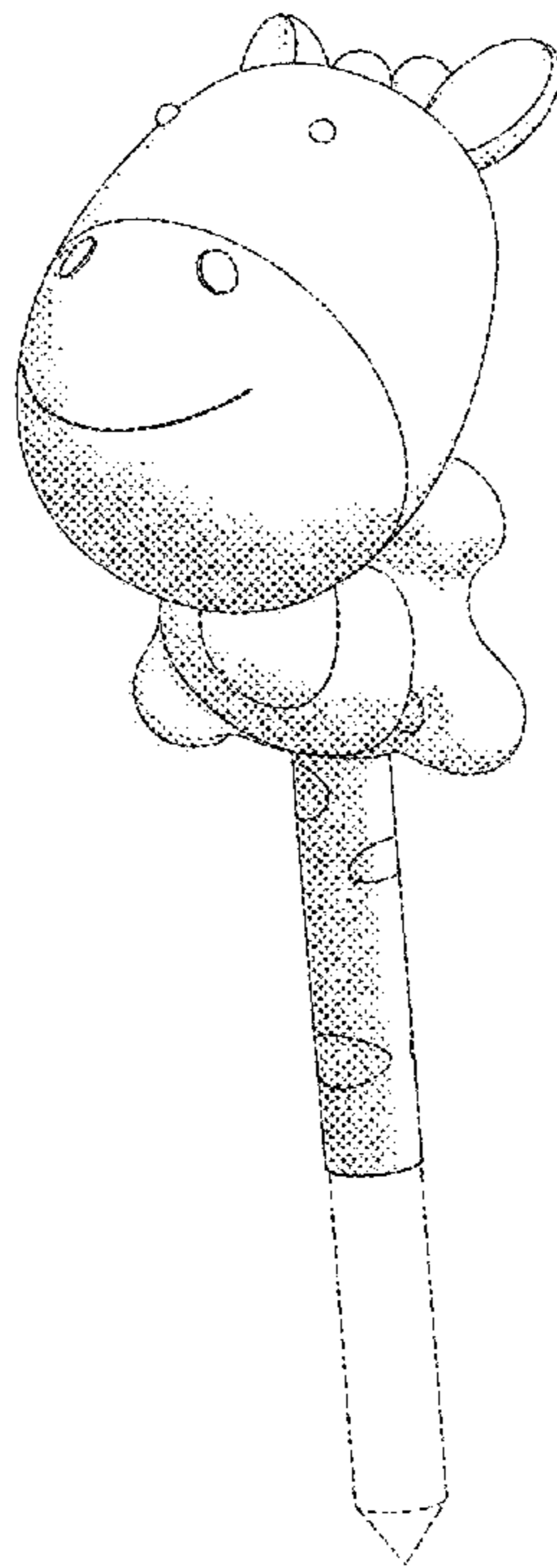
FIG. 5. is a right side elevational view thereof;

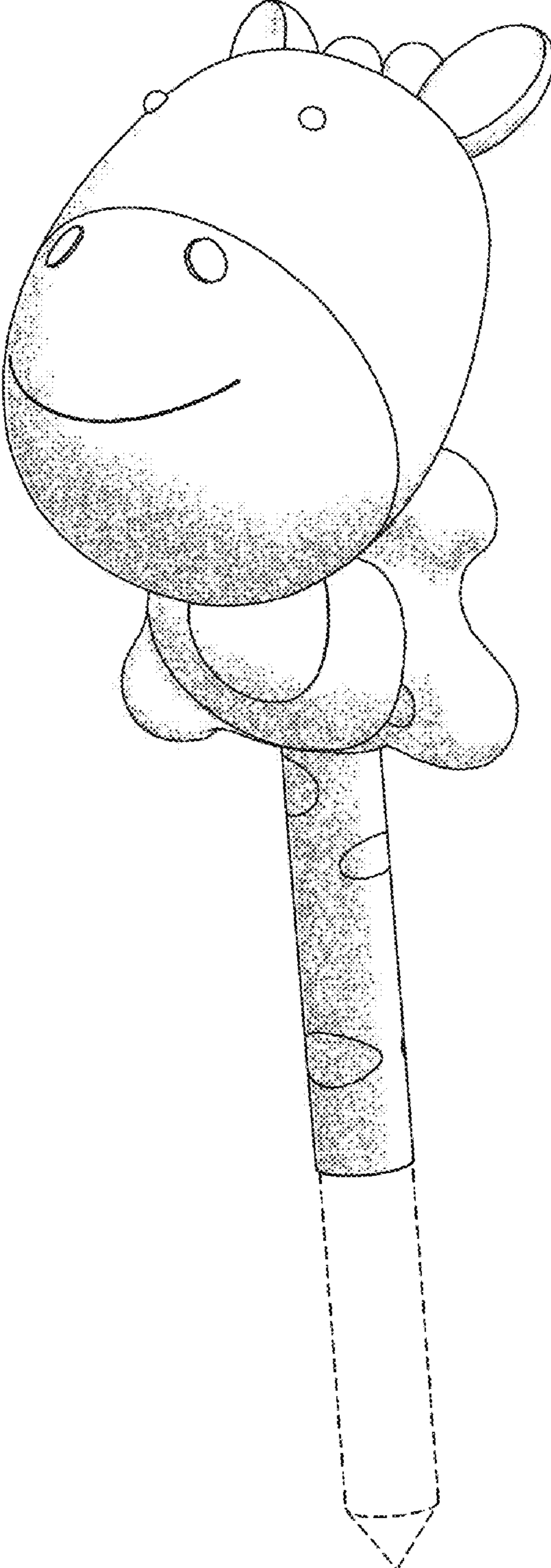

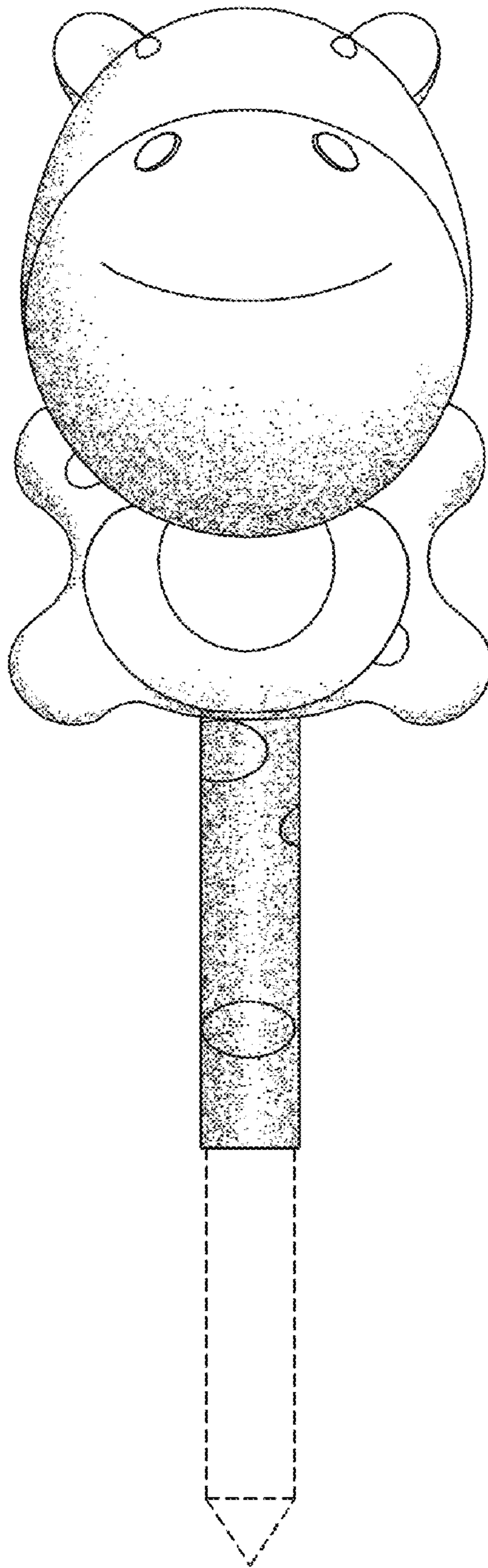

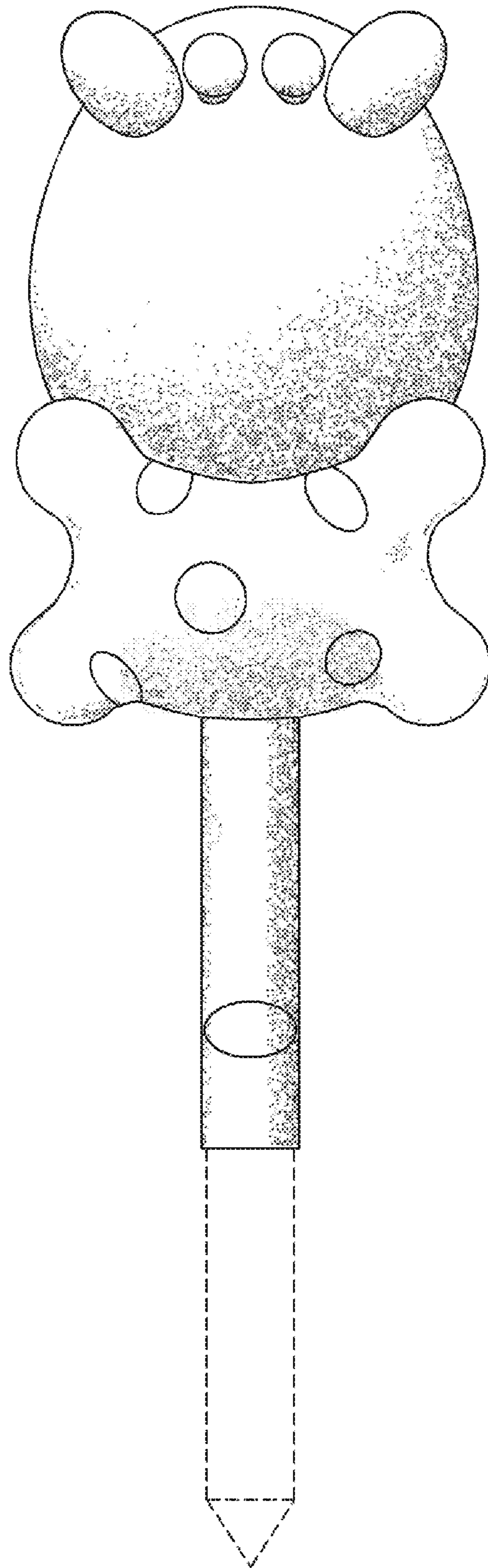

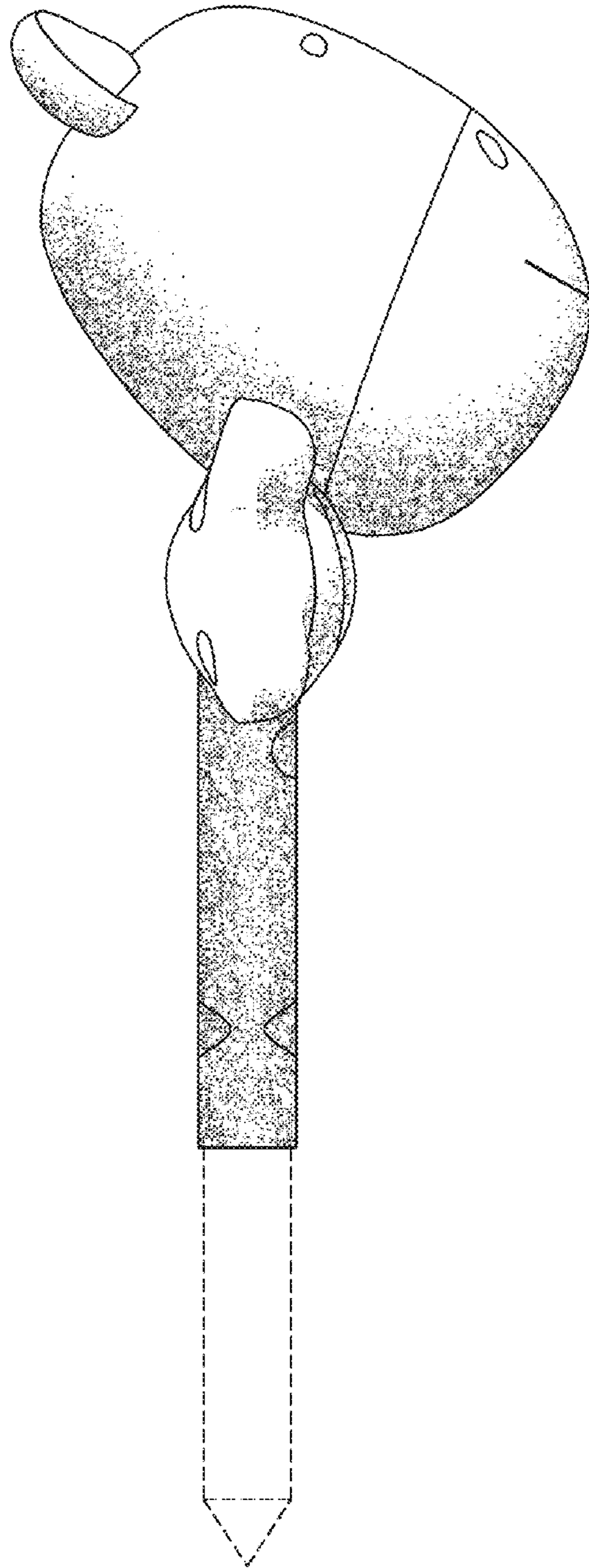

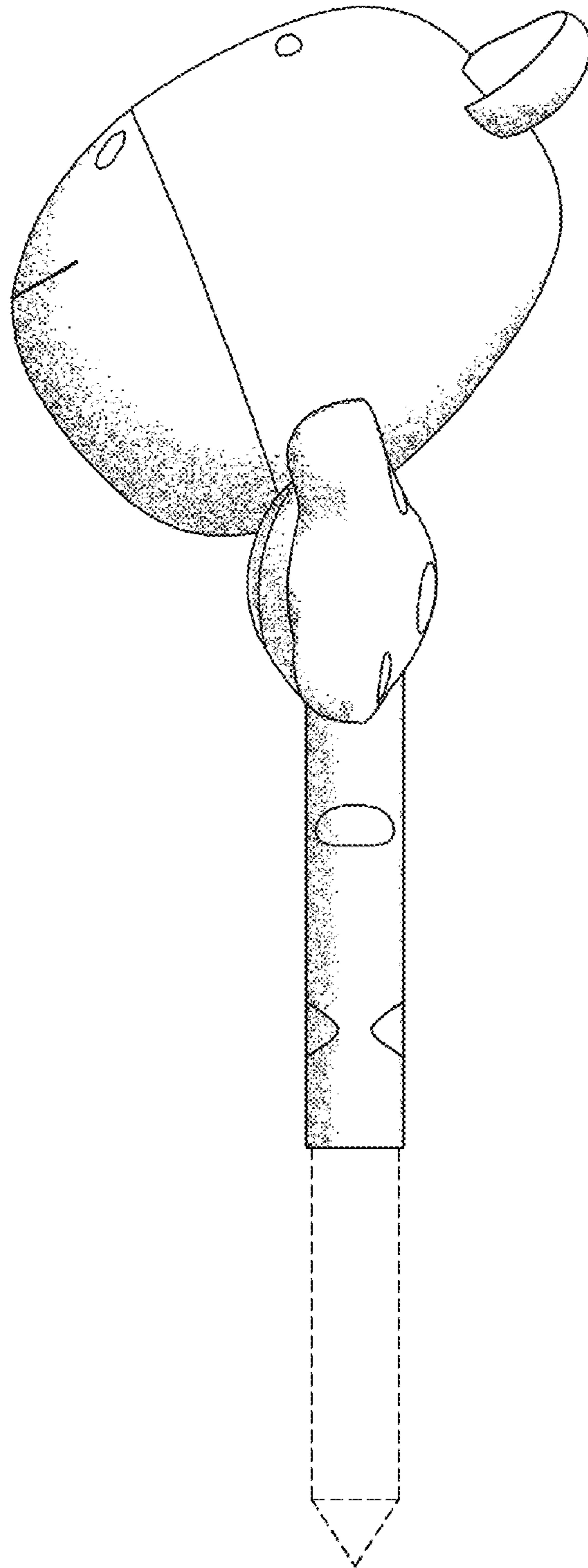

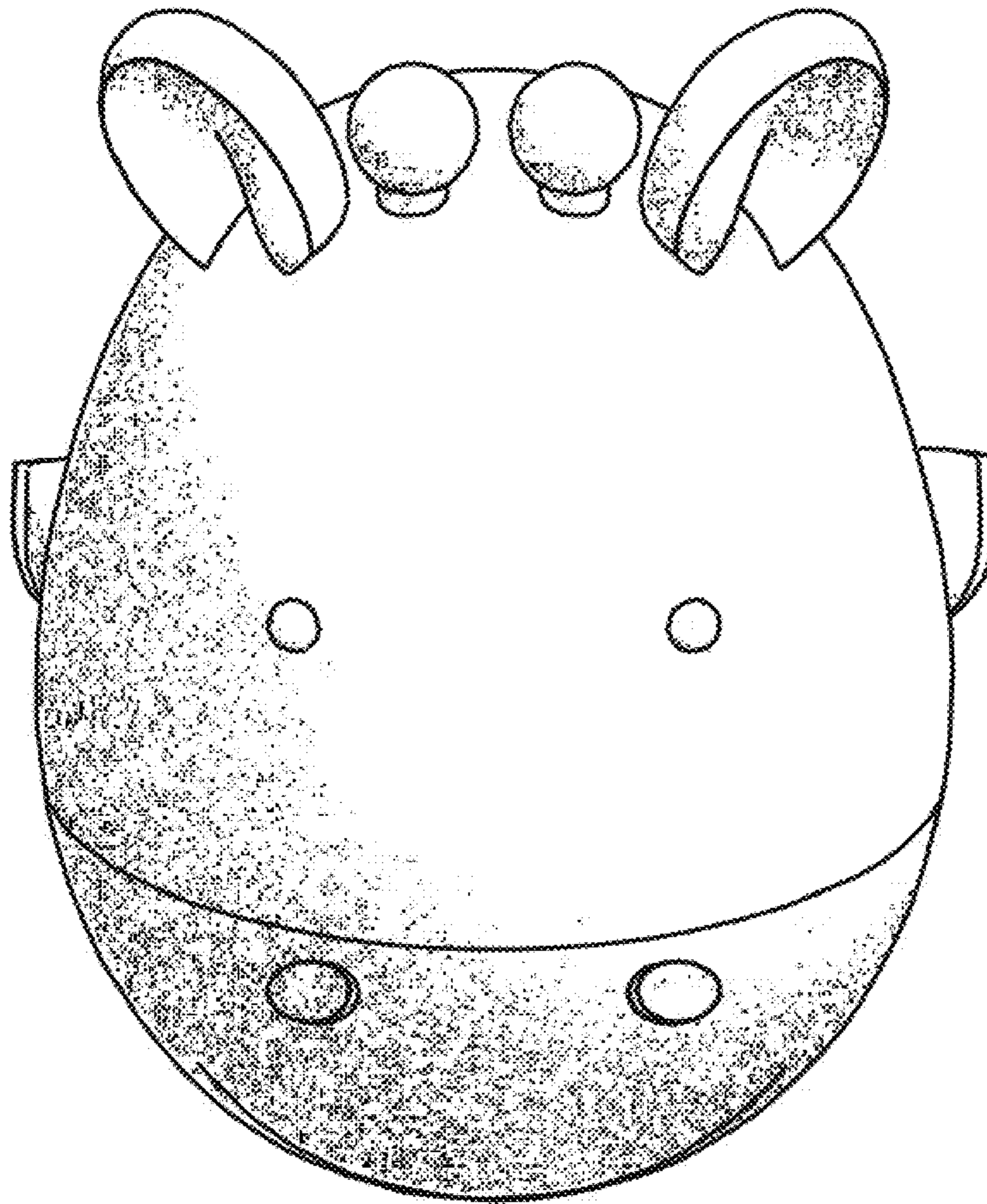

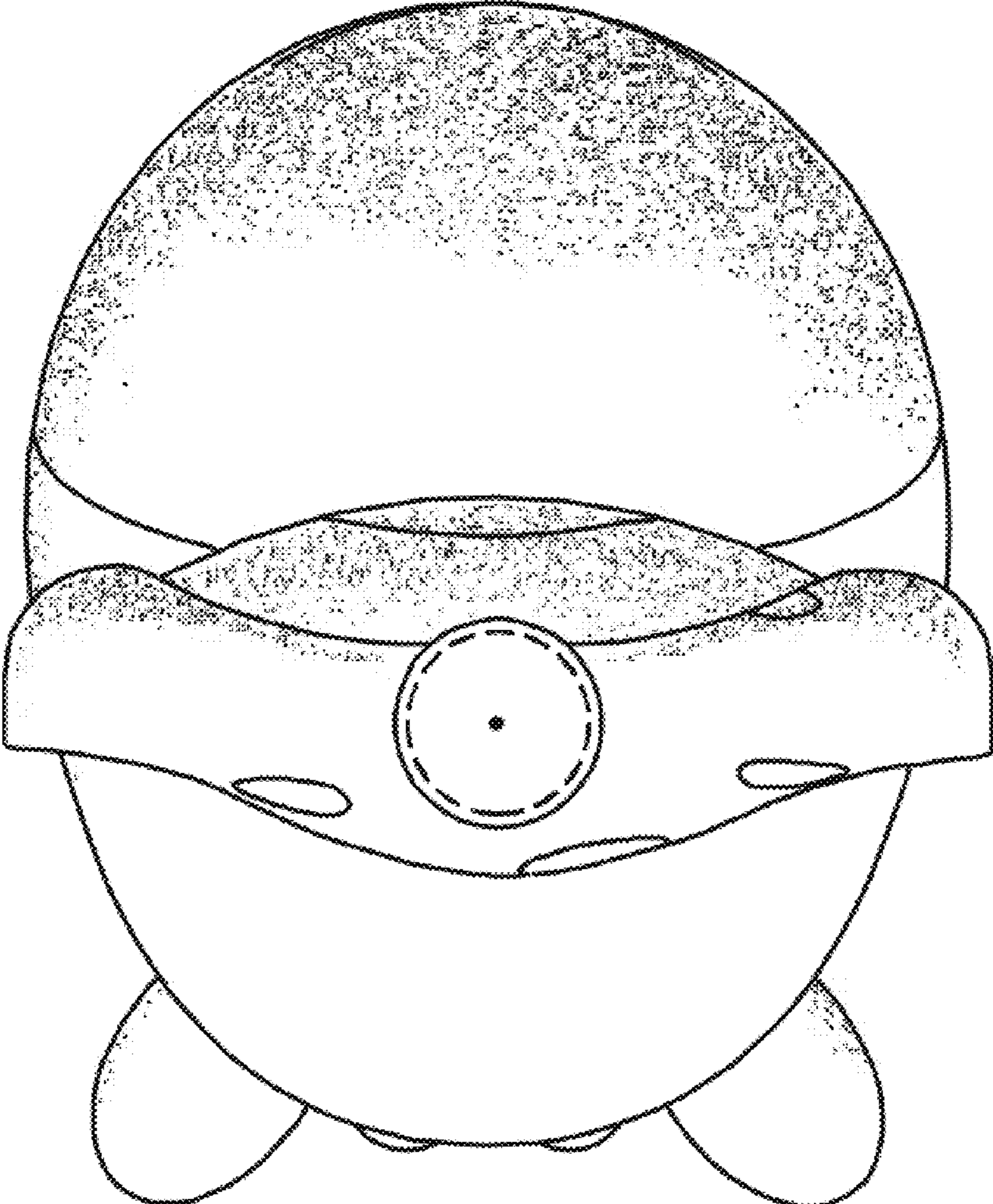
