The ornamental design for a portion of a container, as shown and described.

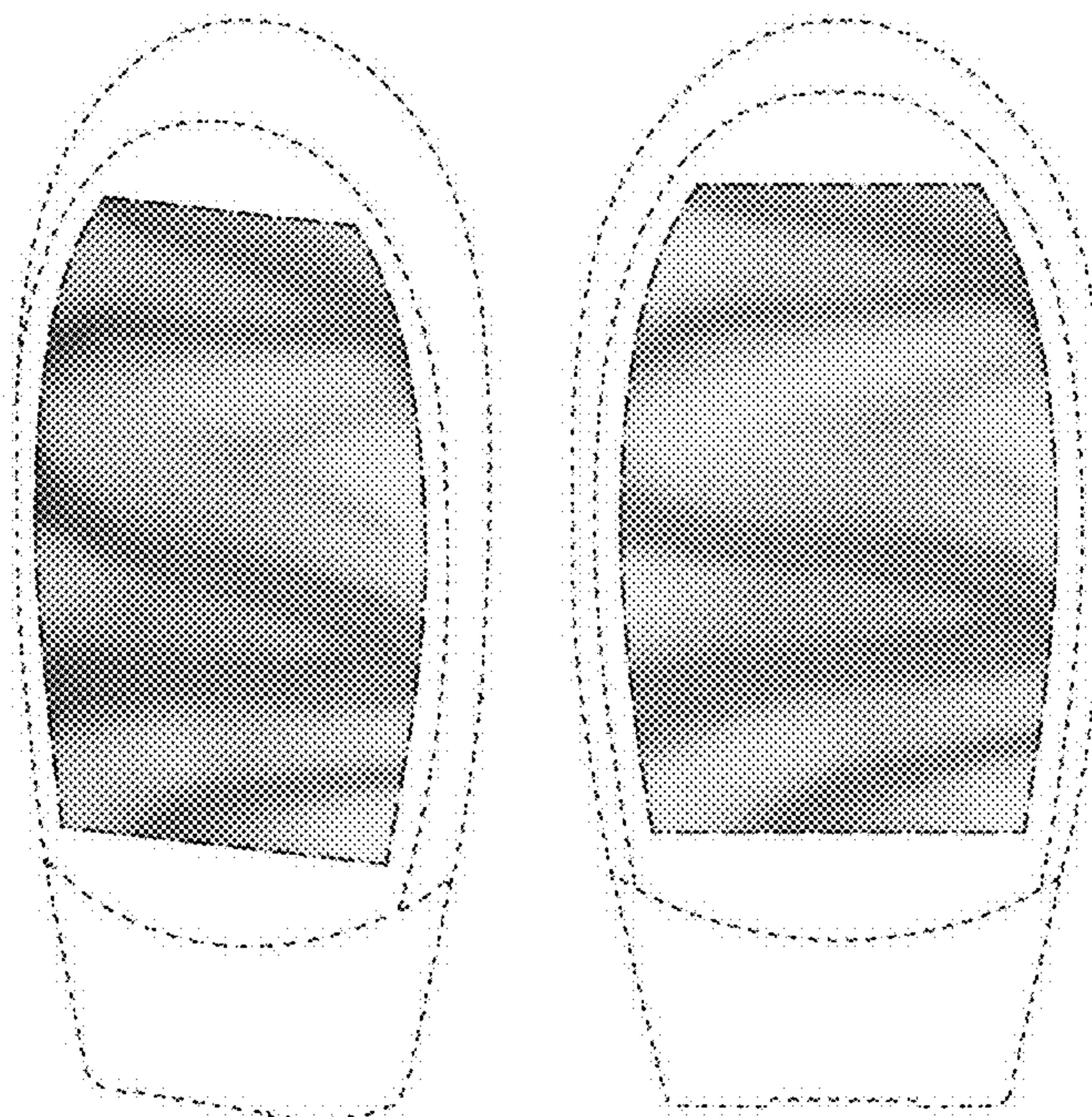
DESCRIPTION

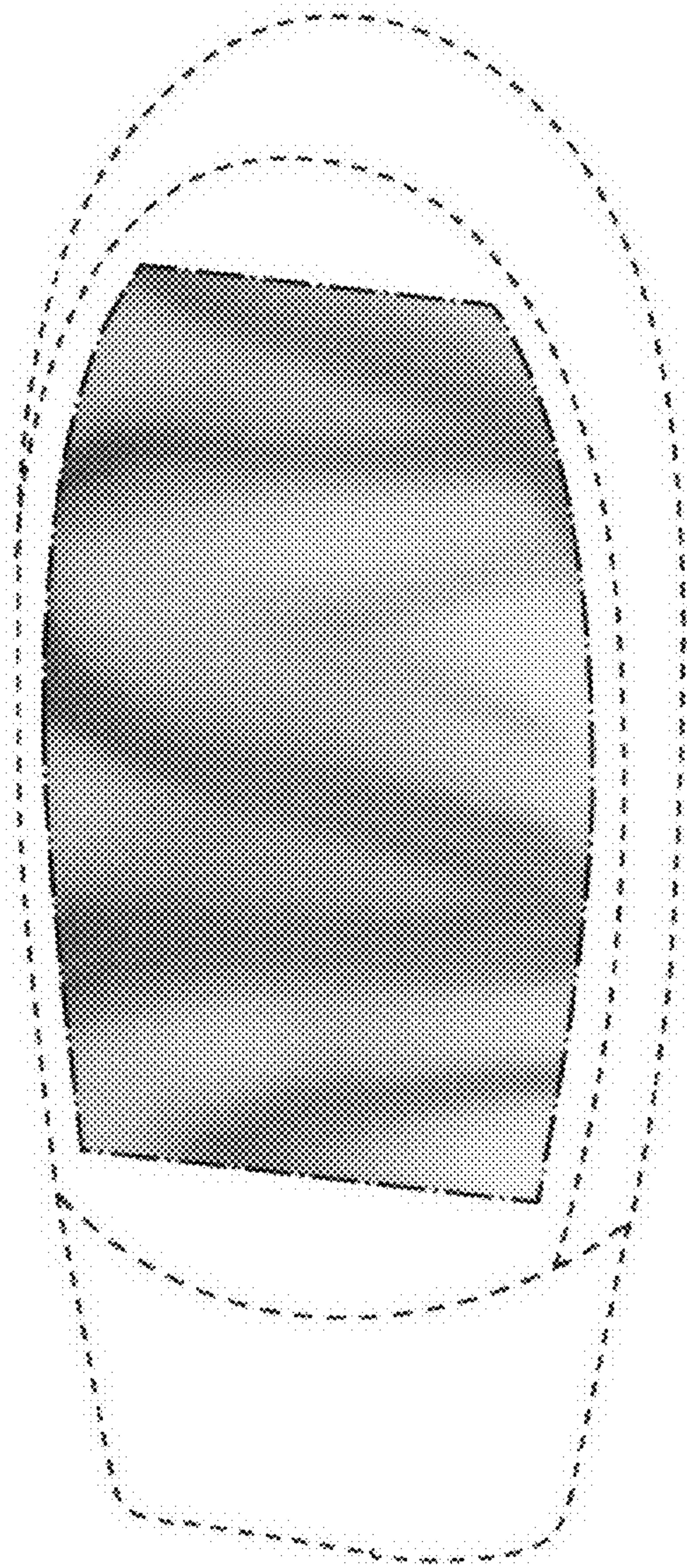

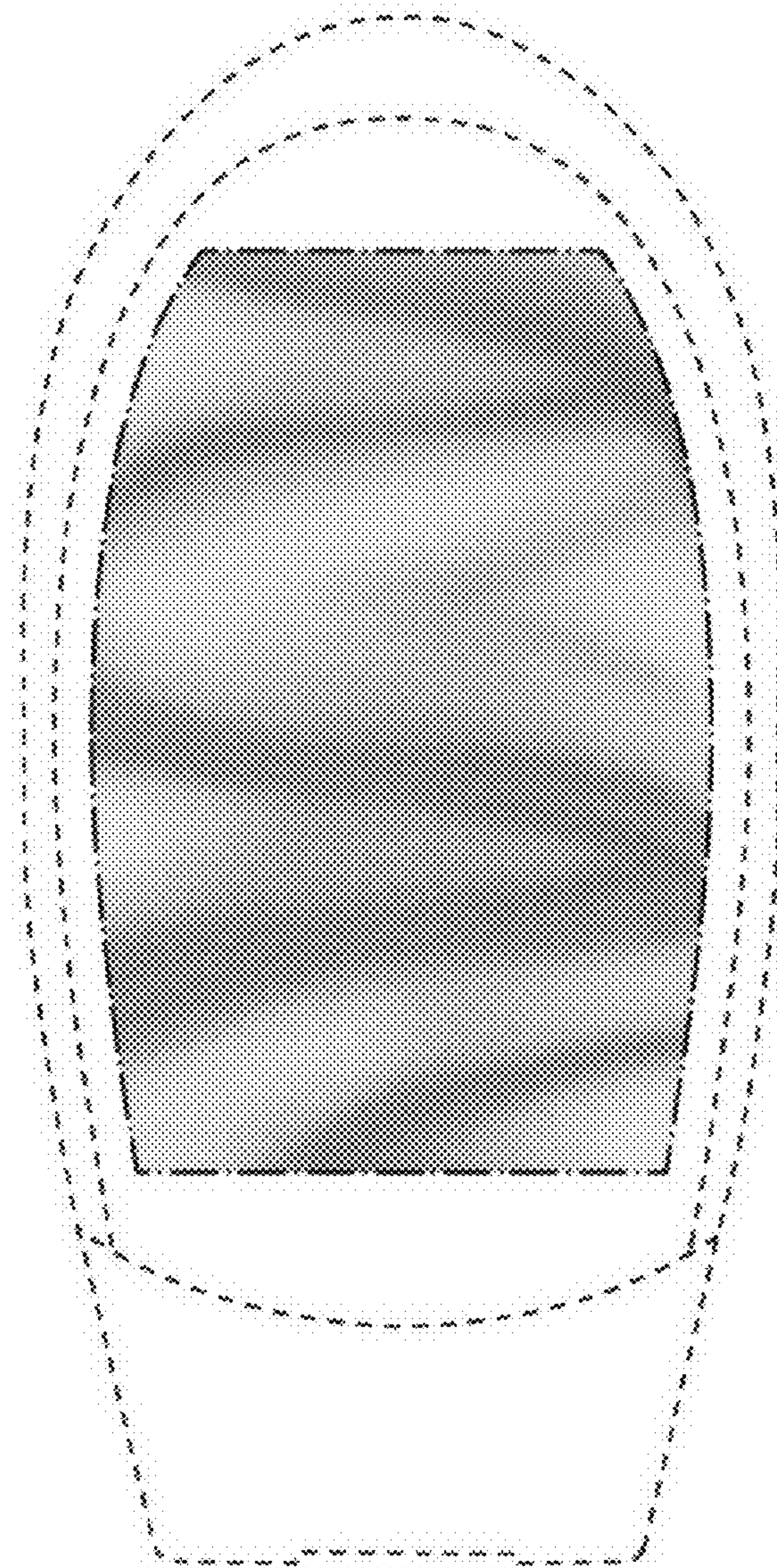
