(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a stair-climbing chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a stair-climbing chair showing our new design in a closed position;

FIG. 2 is a rear view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side view thereof, the left side being a mirror image;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a front view thereof, in an opened position;

FIG. 8 is a right side view thereof, the left side being a mirror image;

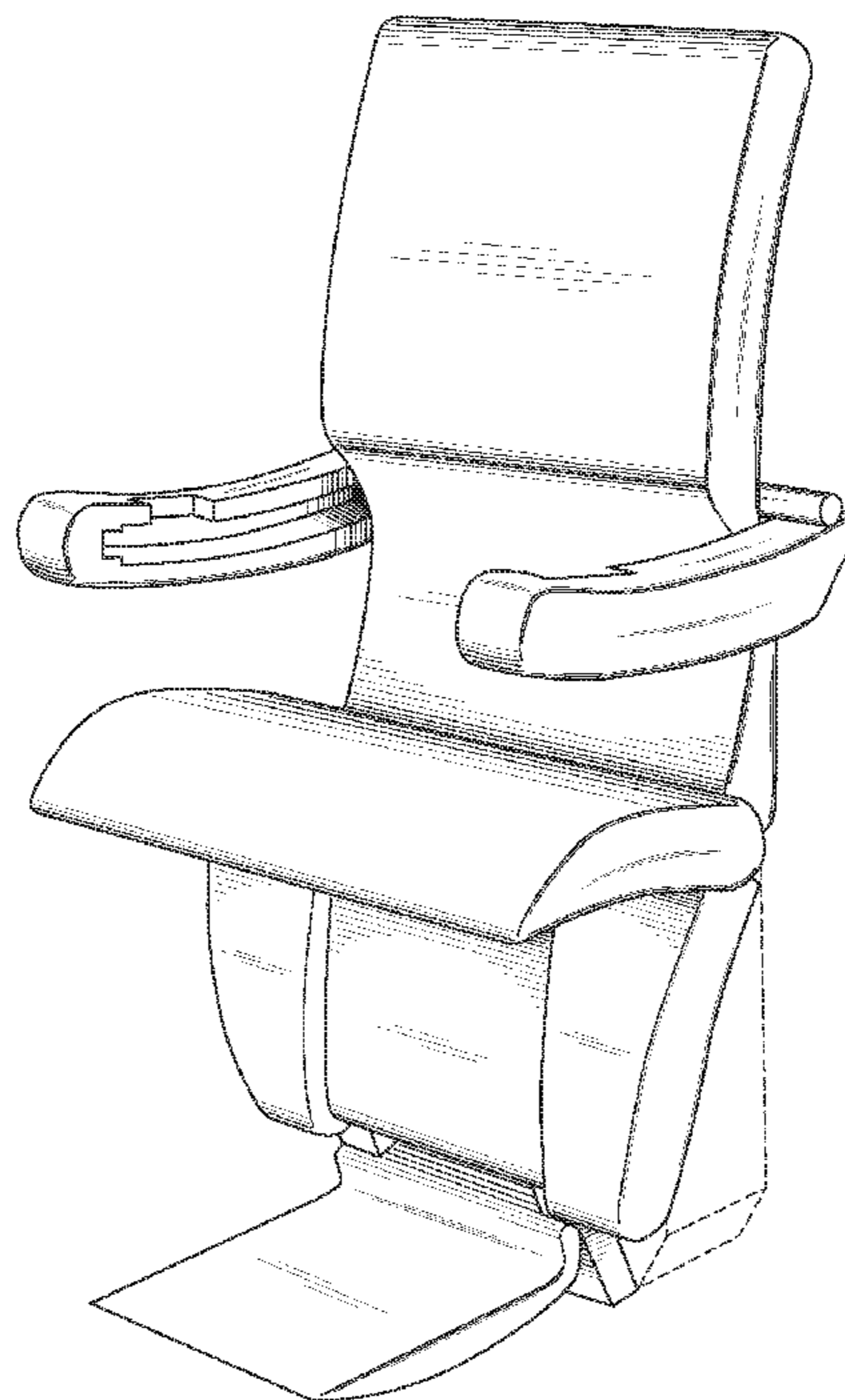
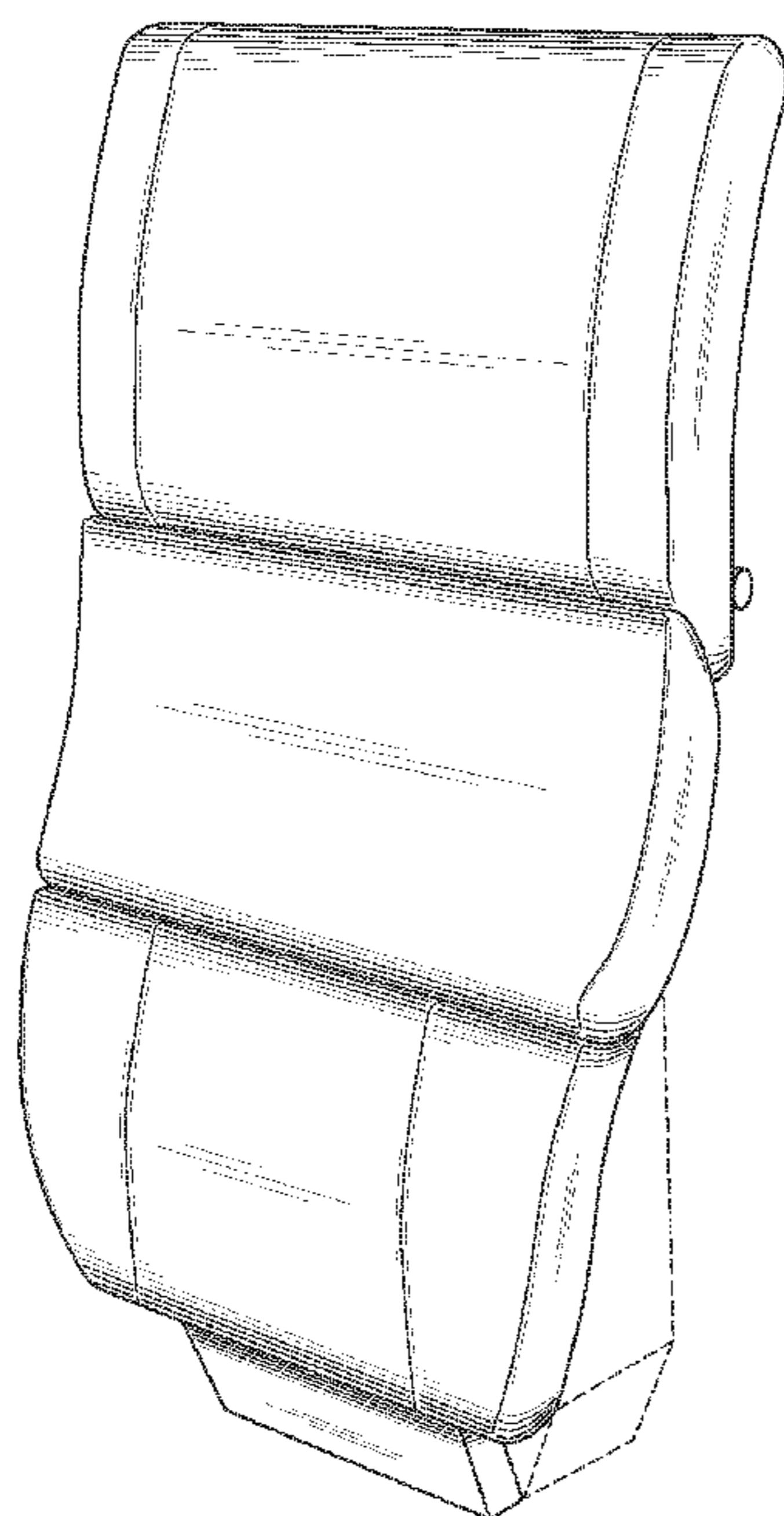
FIG. 9 is a top plan view thereof;

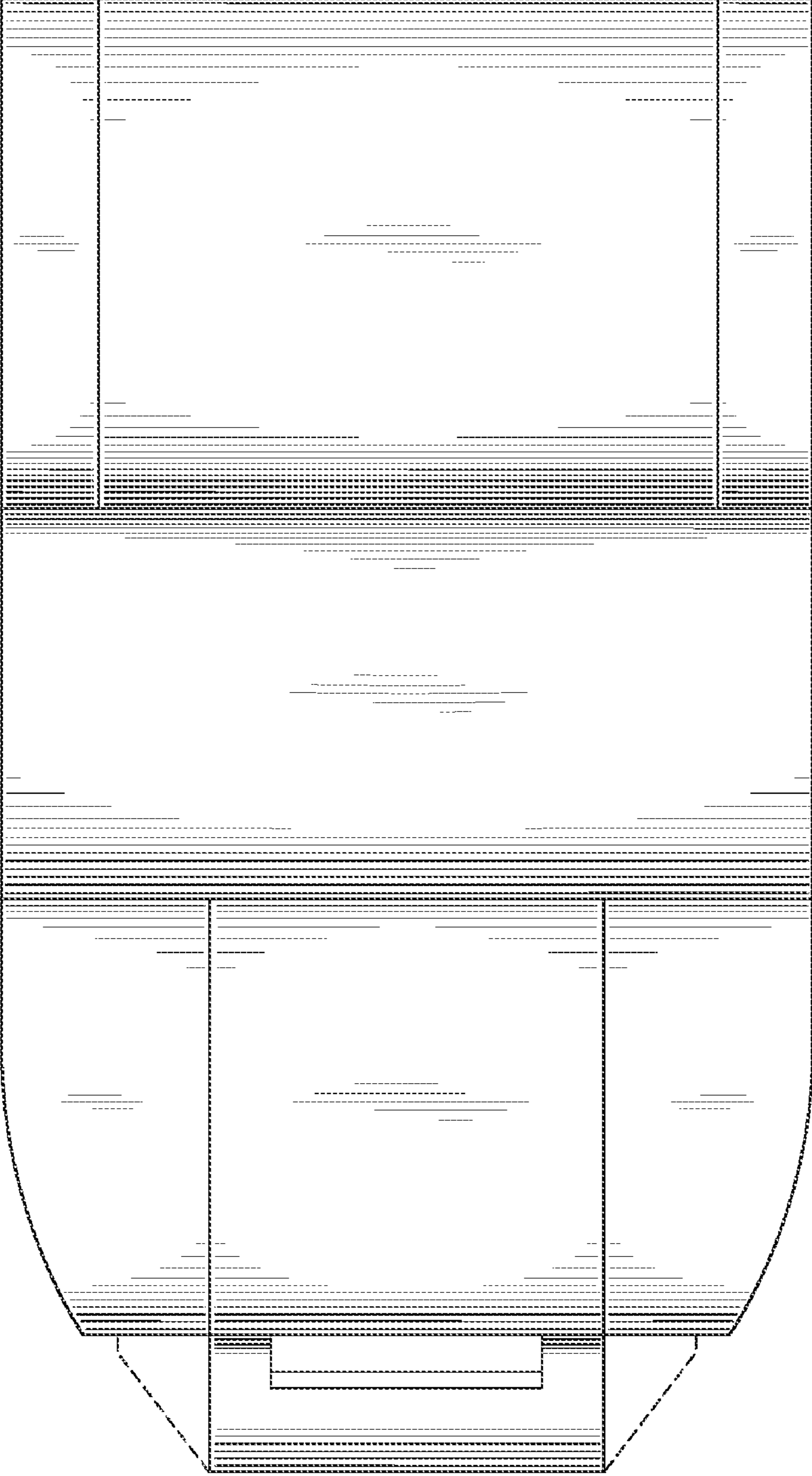

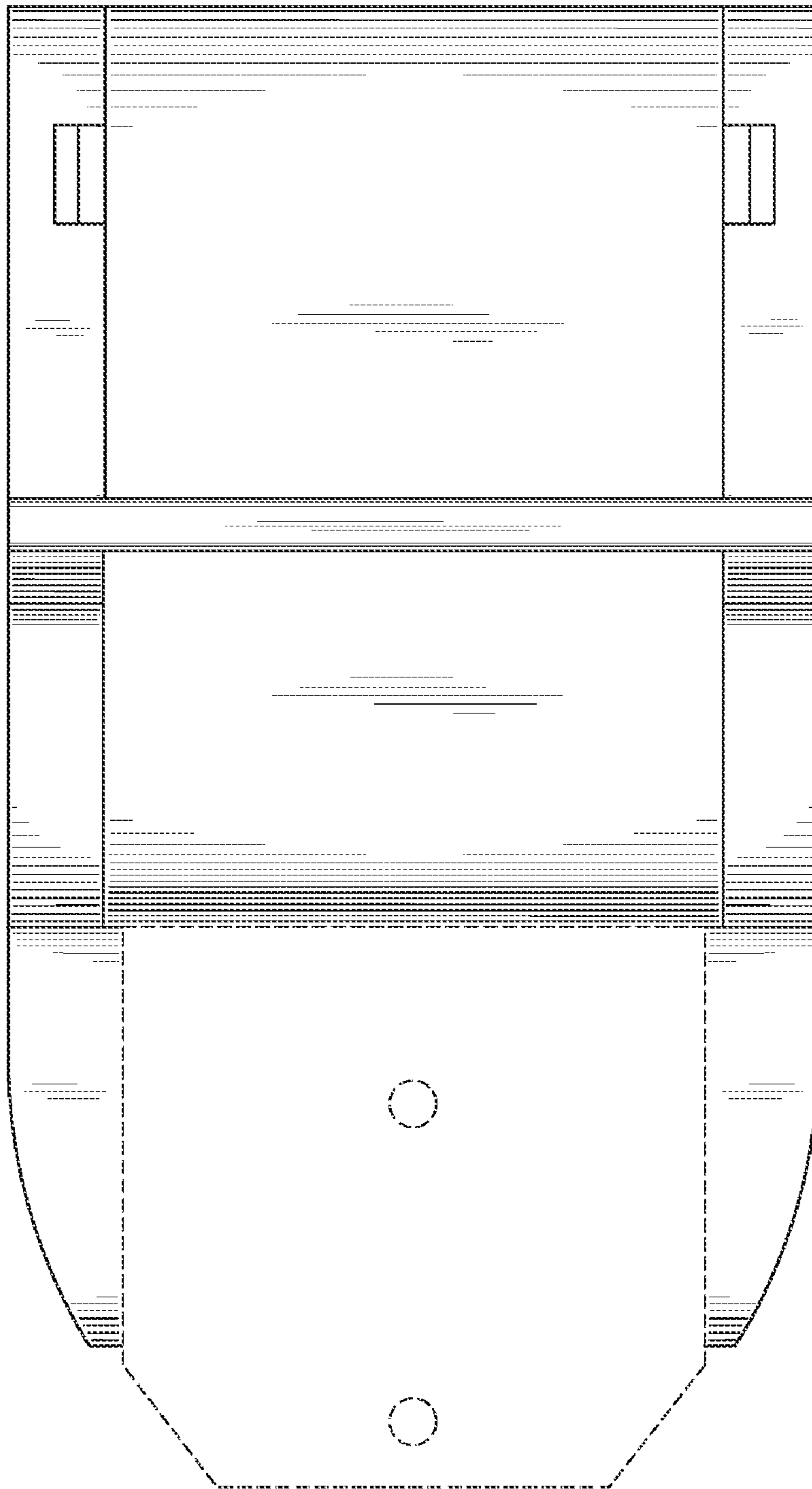

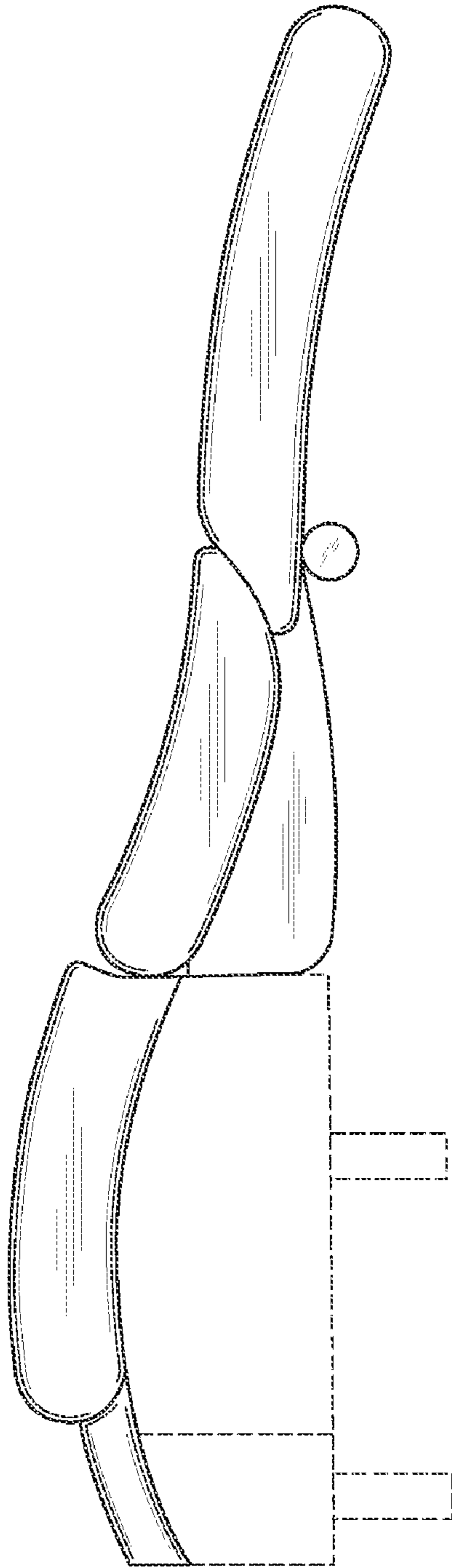

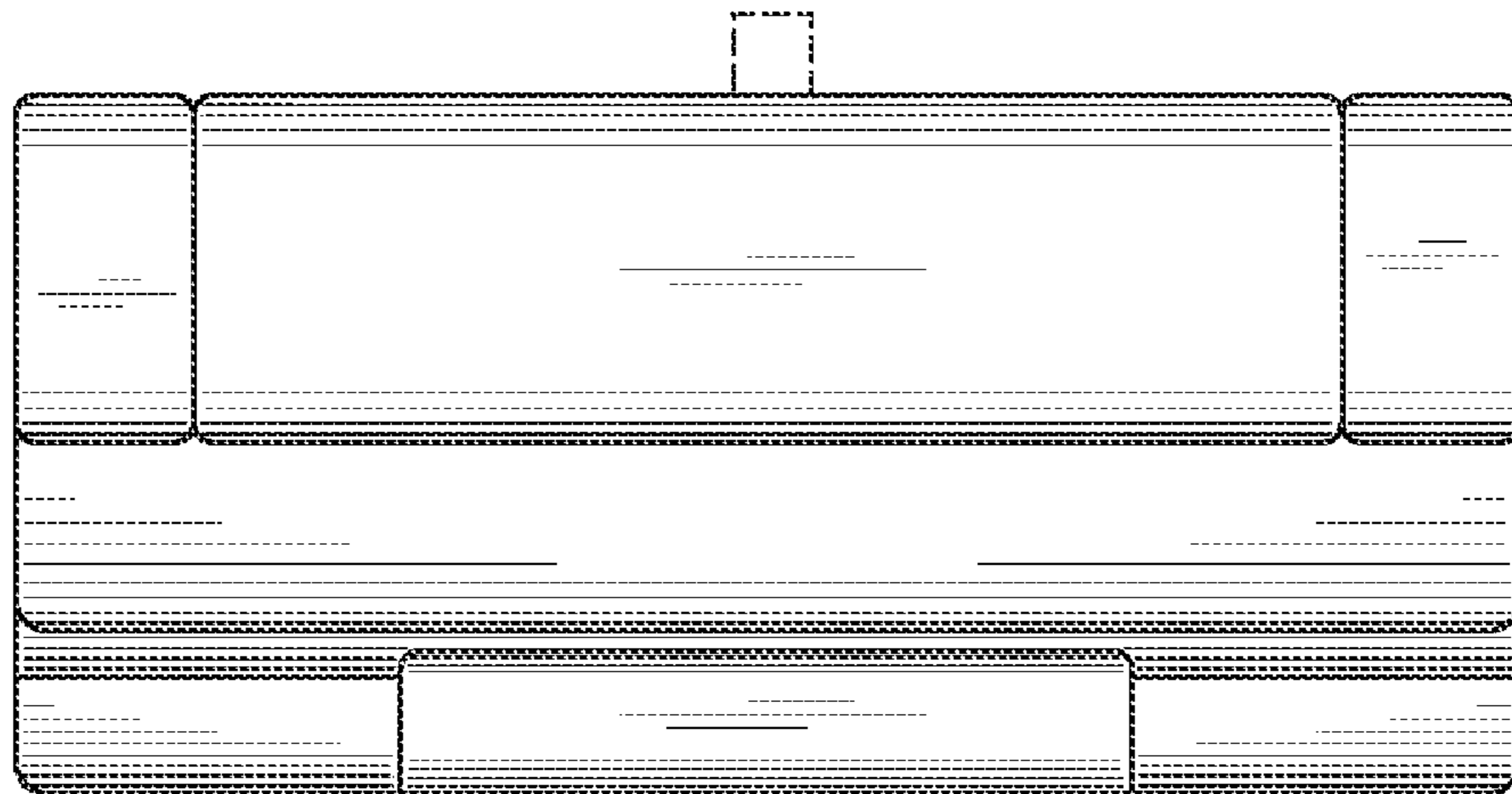

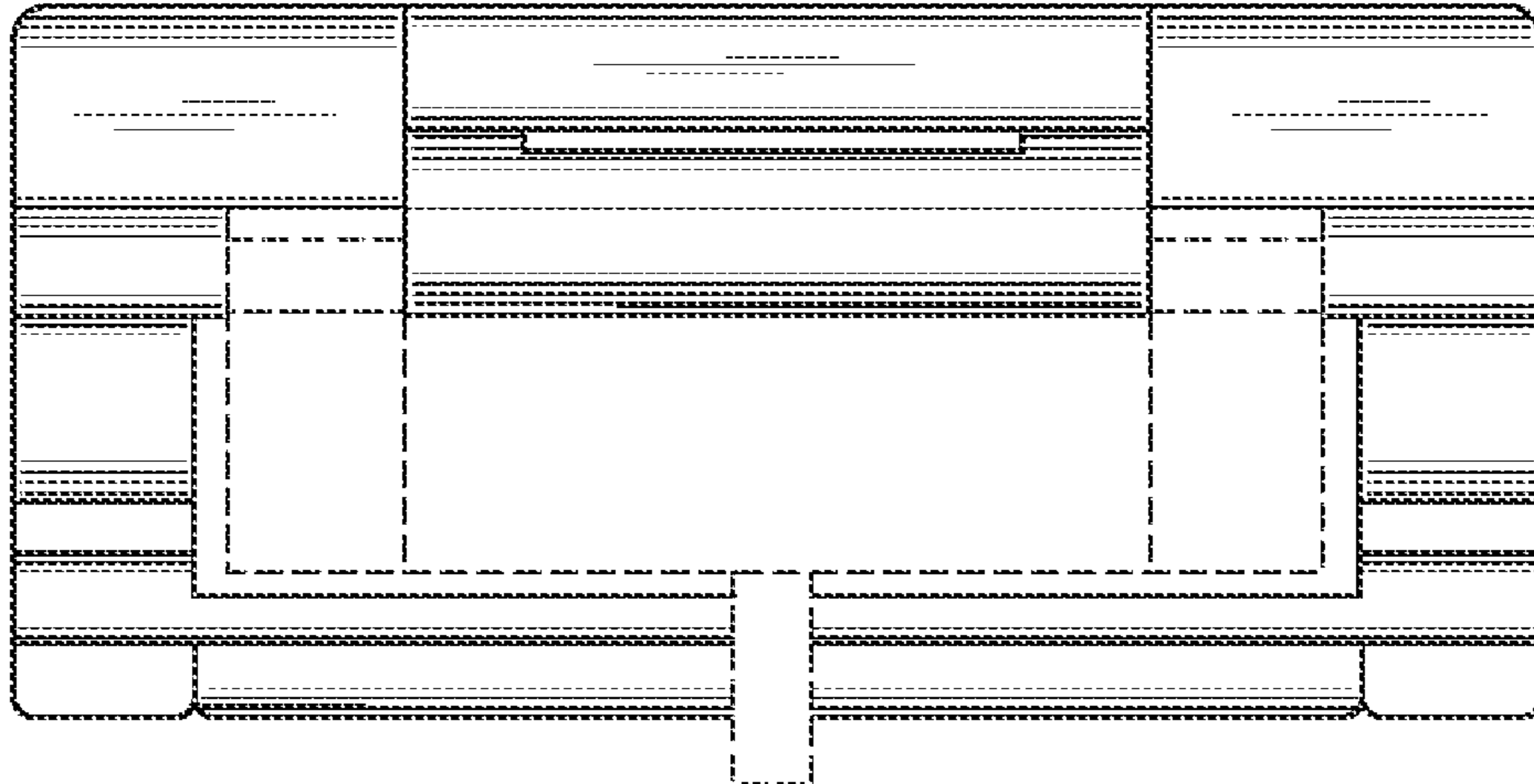

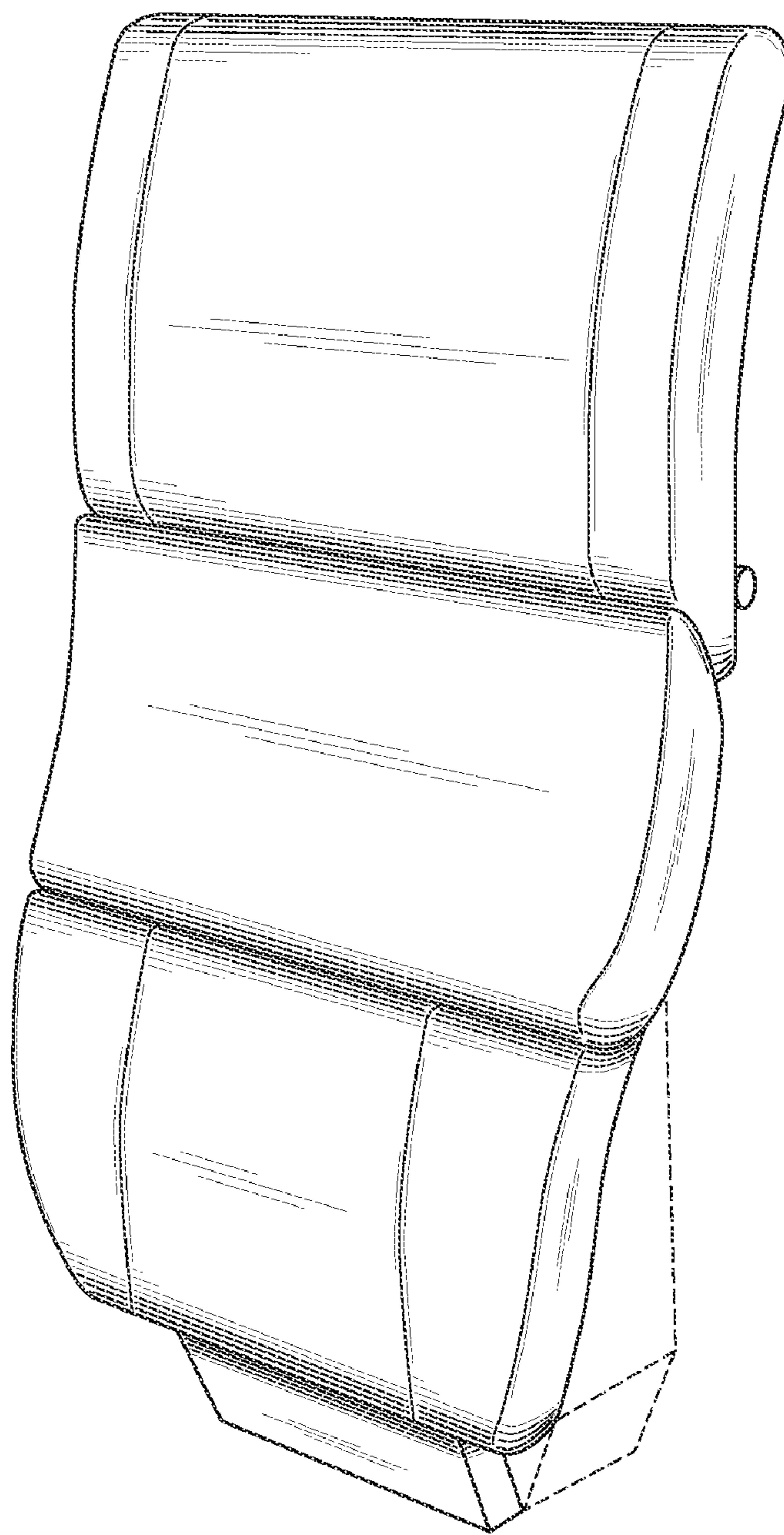

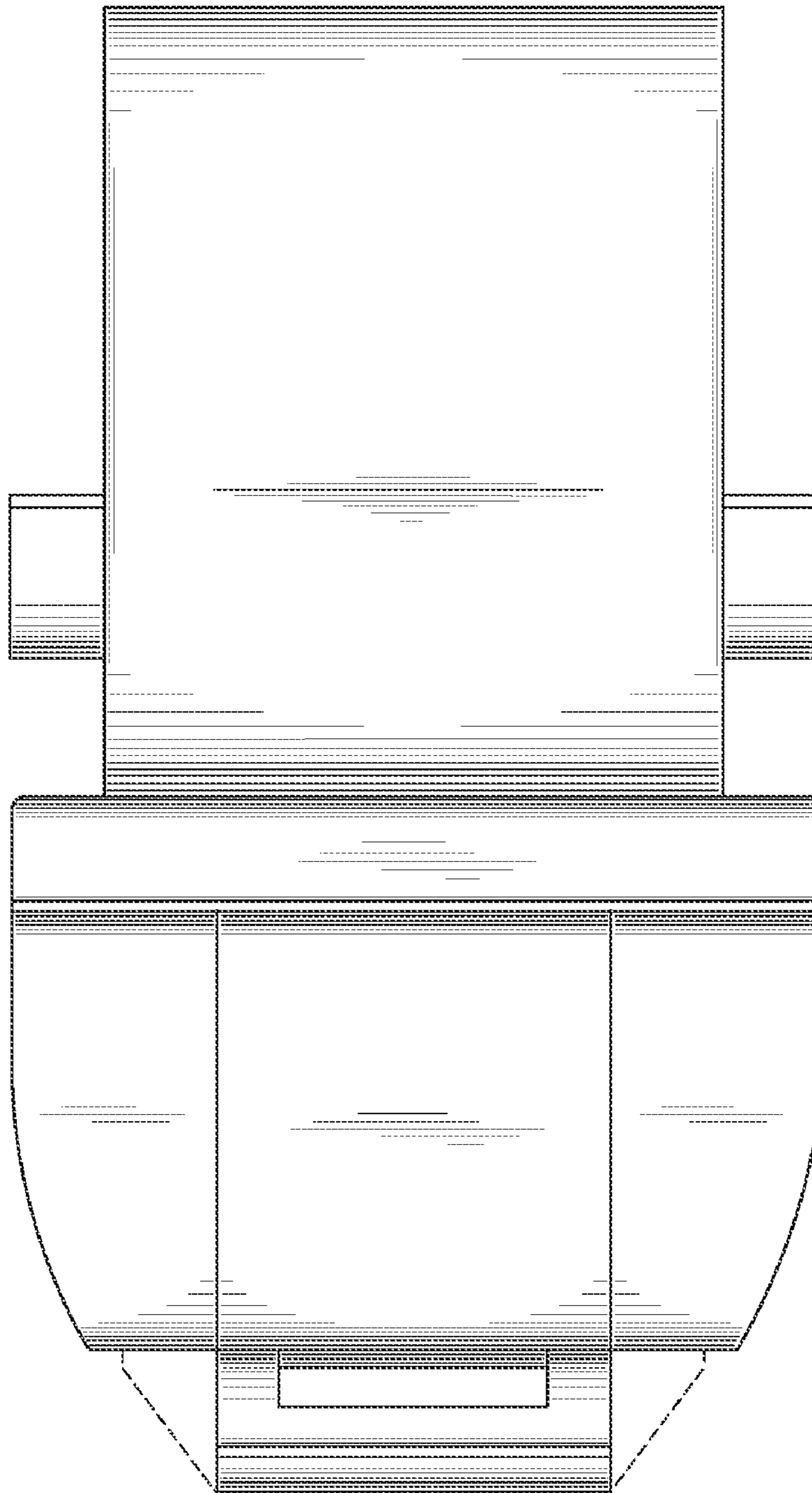

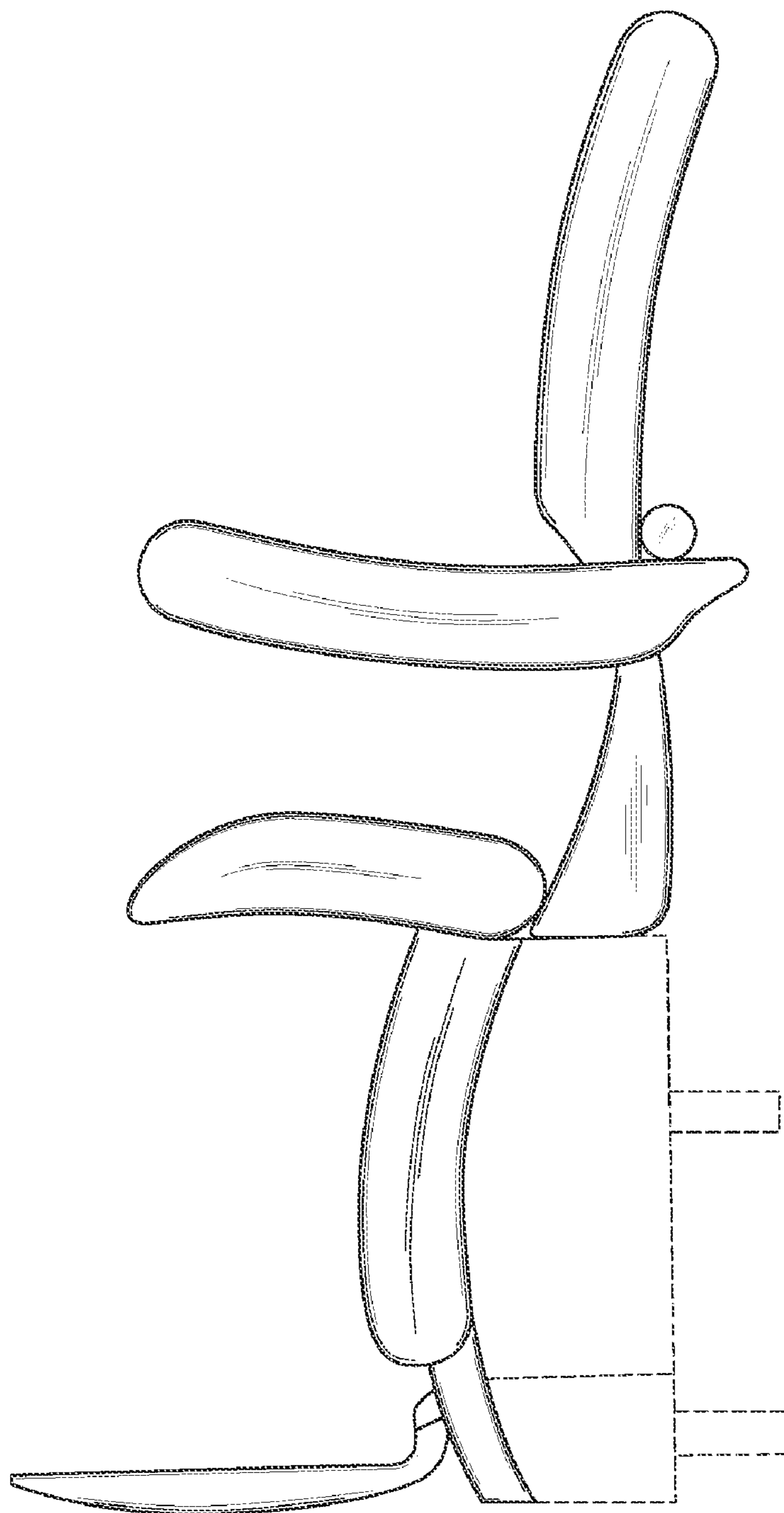

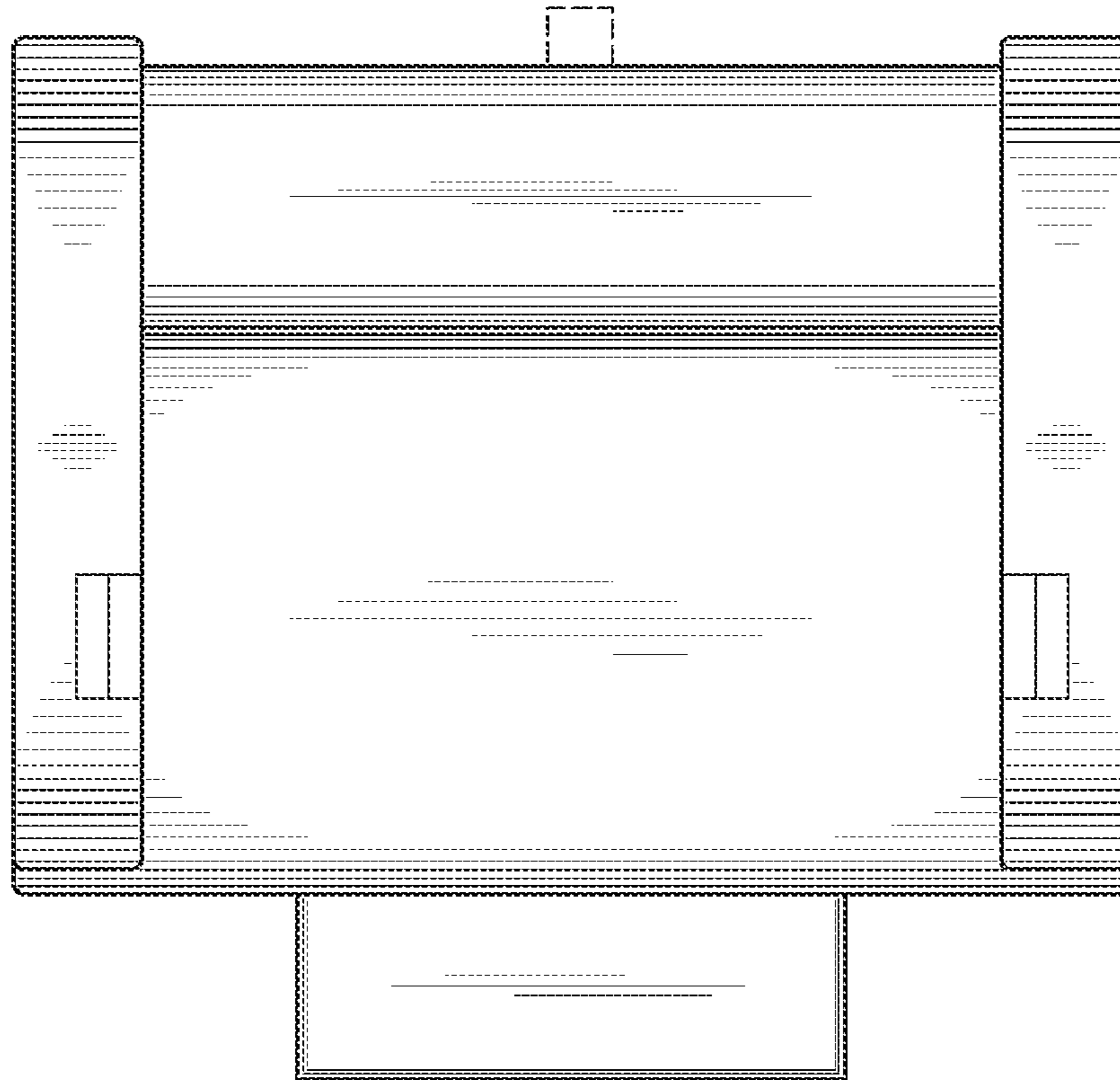

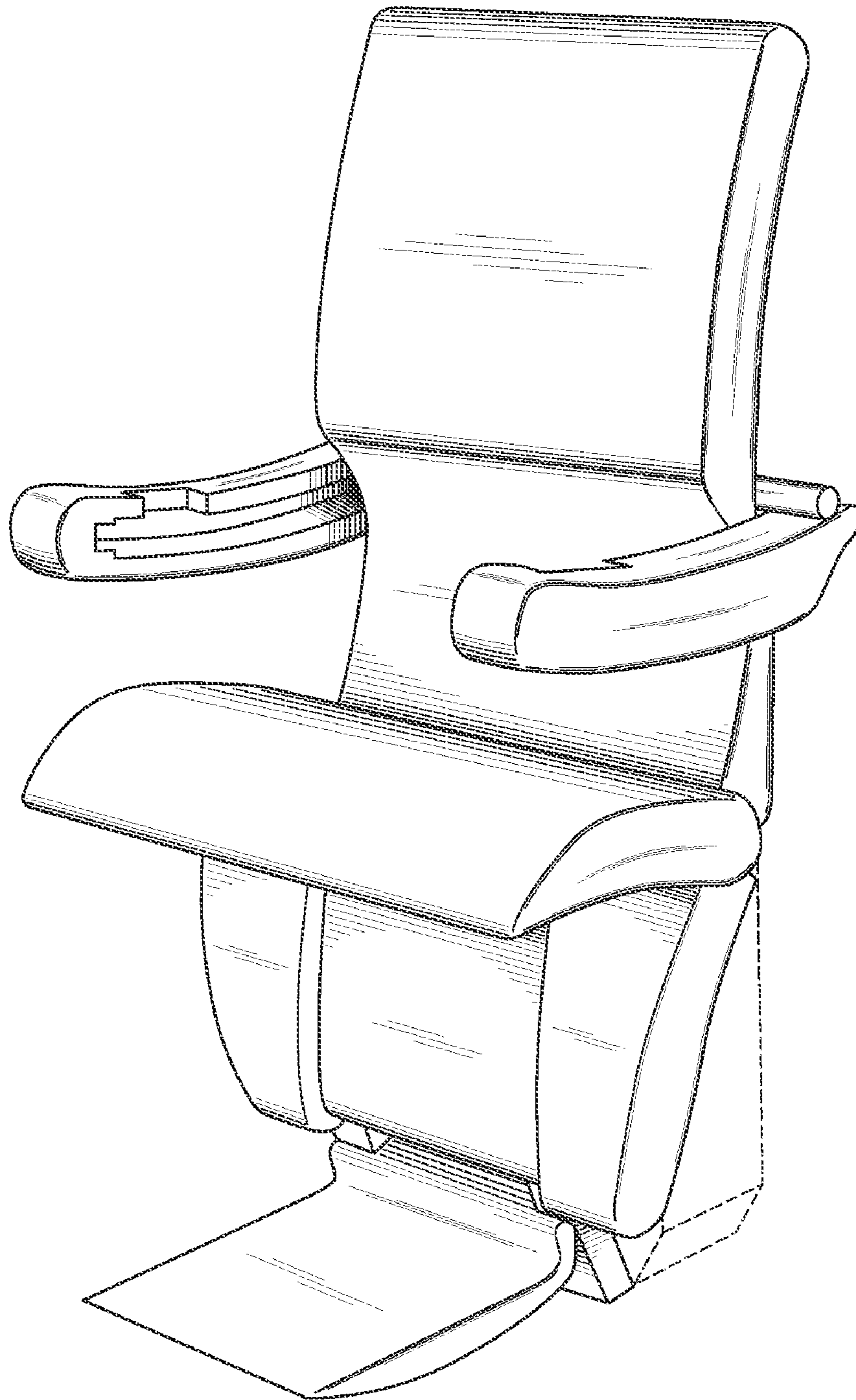

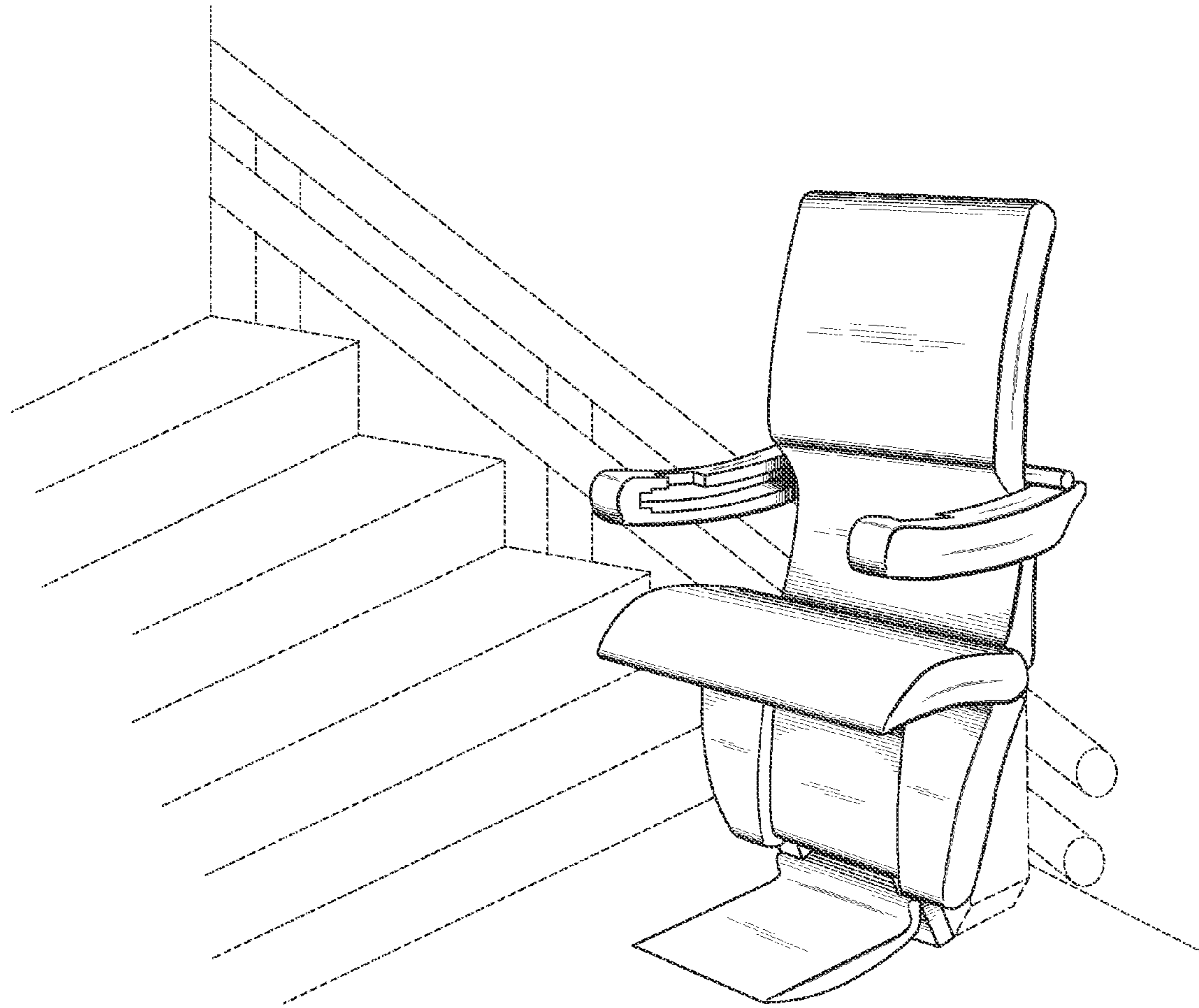
