(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a lavatory, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

In a preferred embodiment, the nature of this product is a  
lavatory for washing various items and human body parts.

FIG. 1 is a top, left, front perspective view of a lavatory  
embodying my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side  
elevational view thereof being a mirror image of the left side  
shown;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 7 is a sectional view take along line 7—7 of FIG. 2.

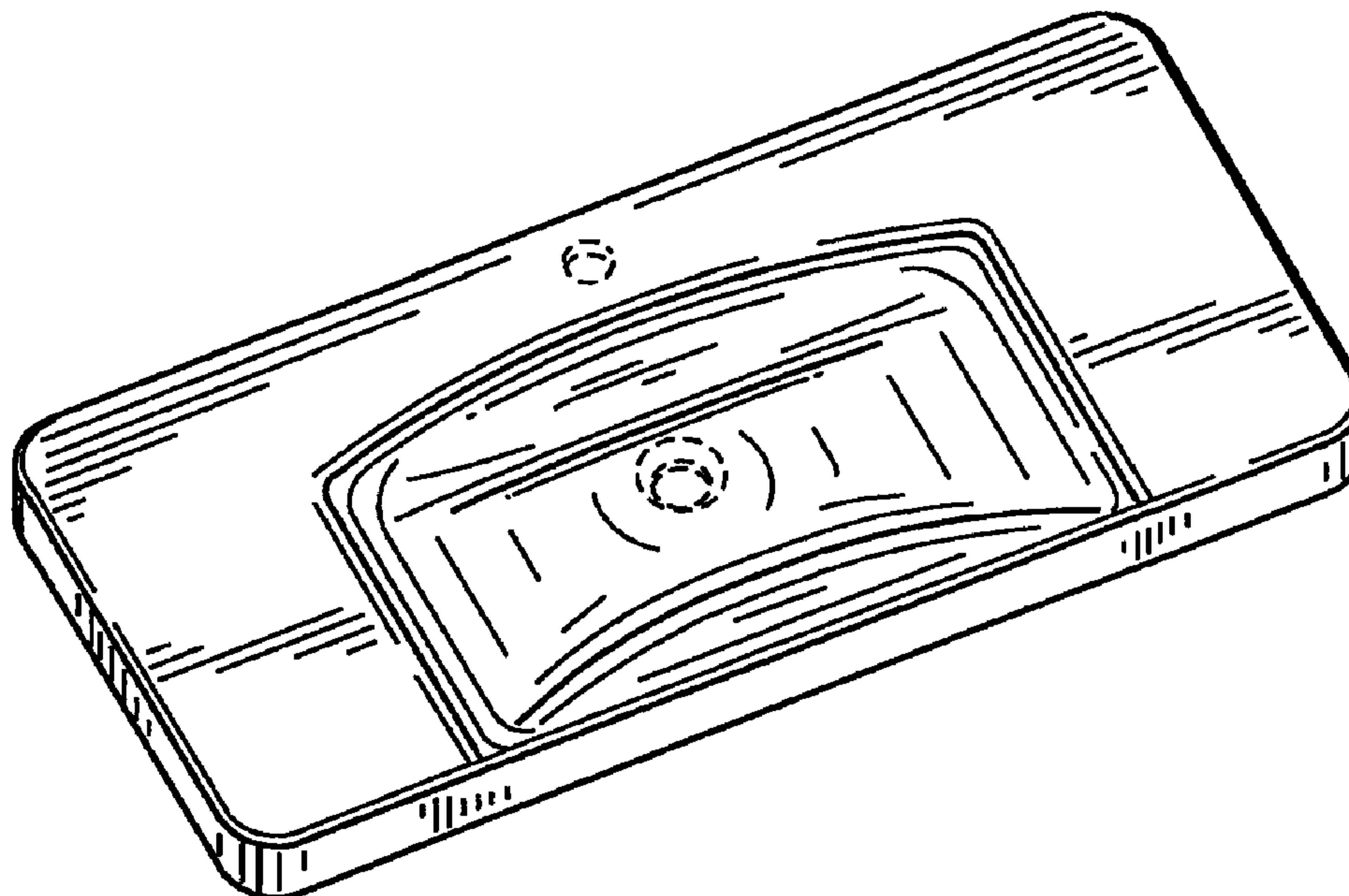

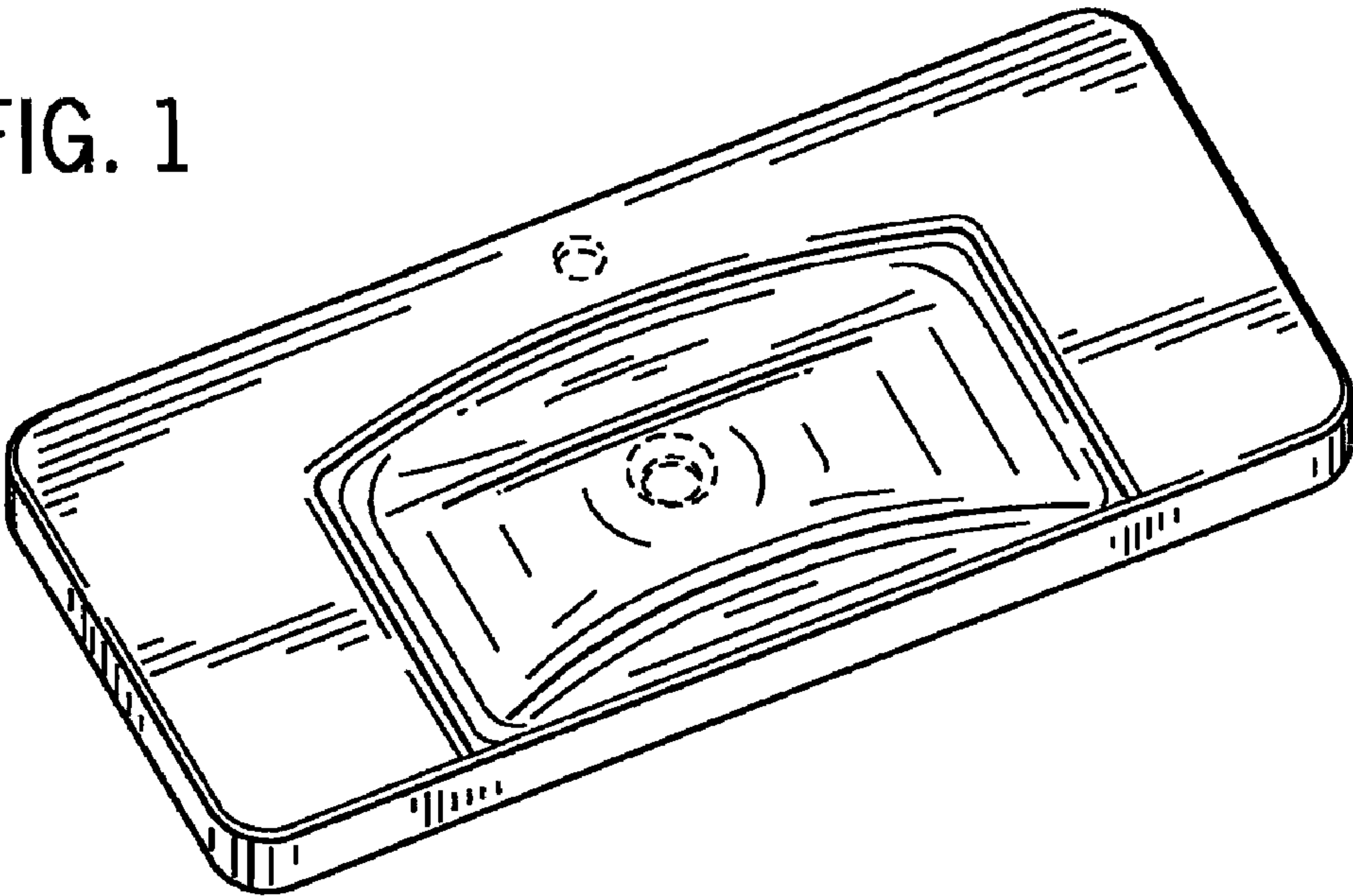

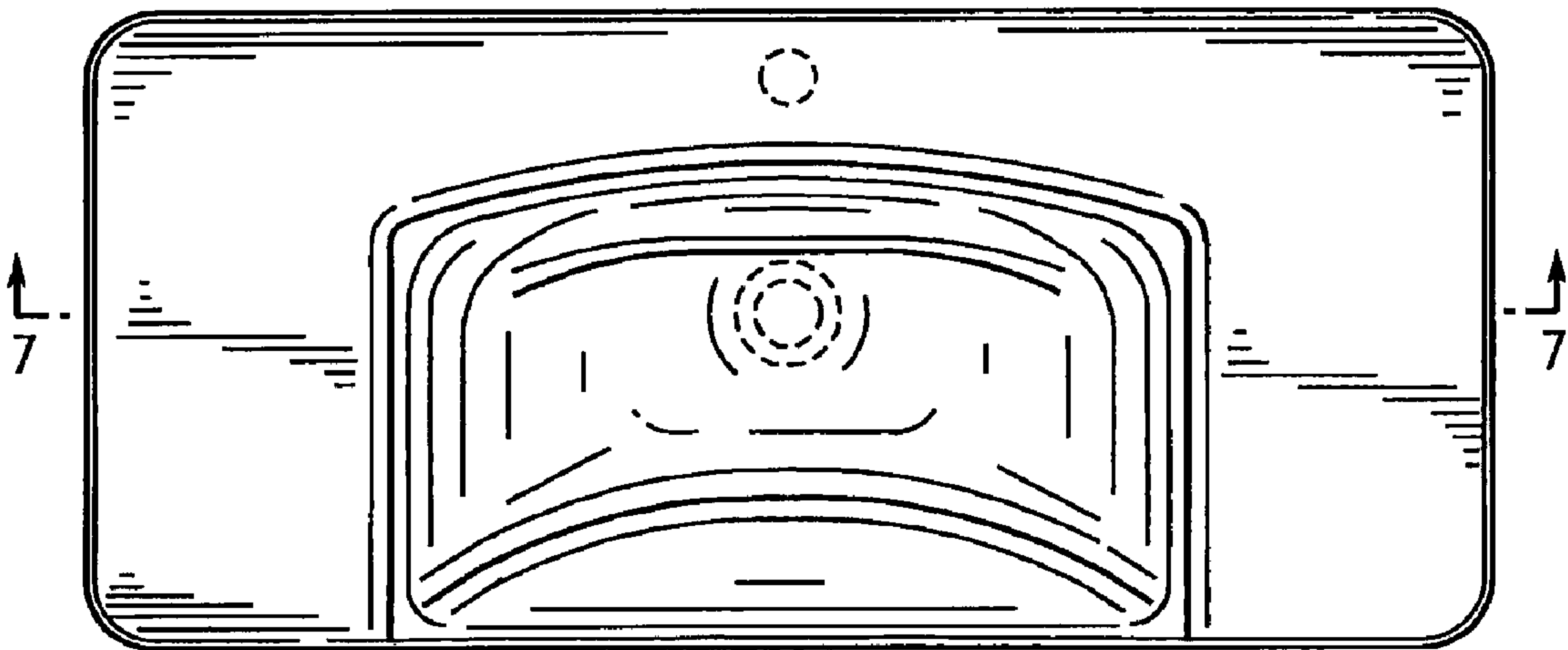

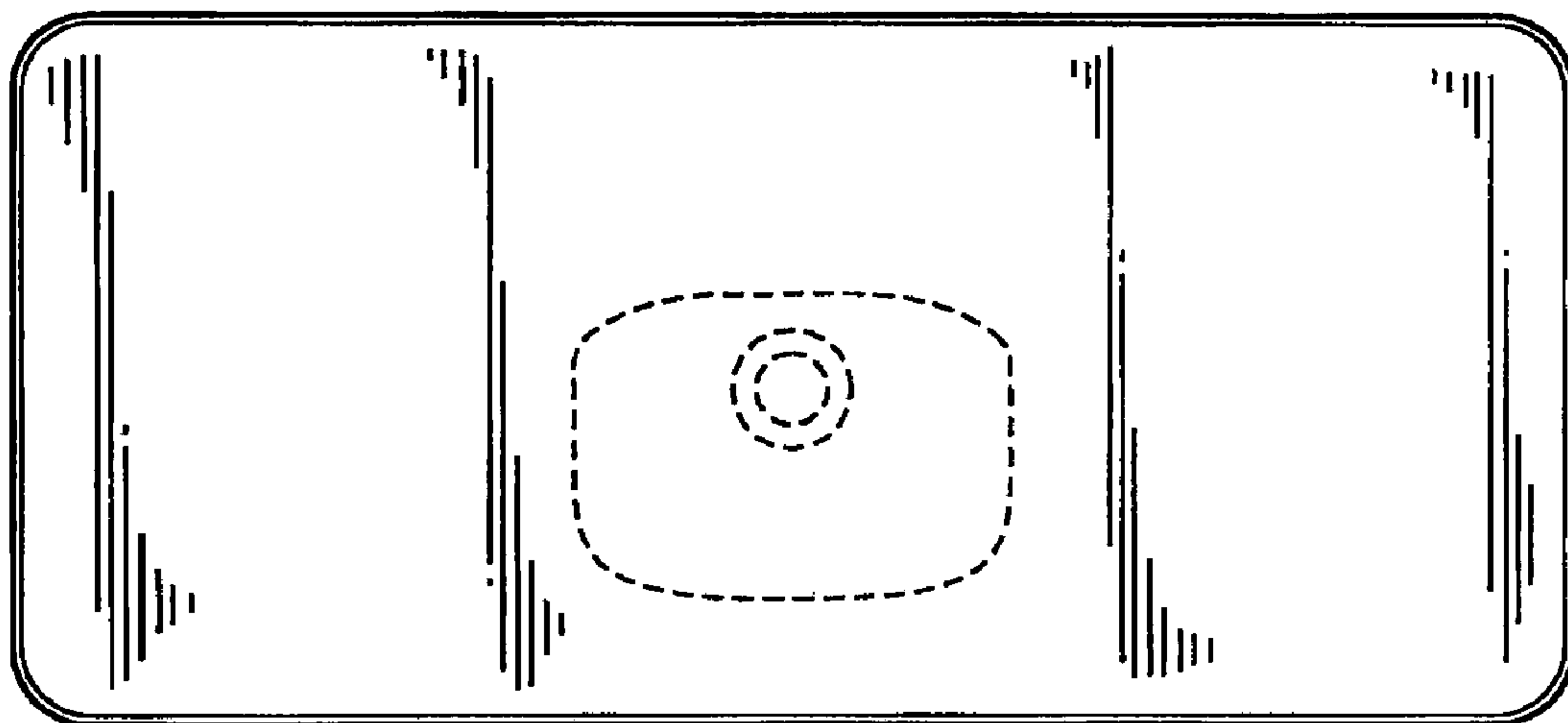
