(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an audio video cabinet, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of an audio video cabinet showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front orthographic view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top orthographic view thereof;

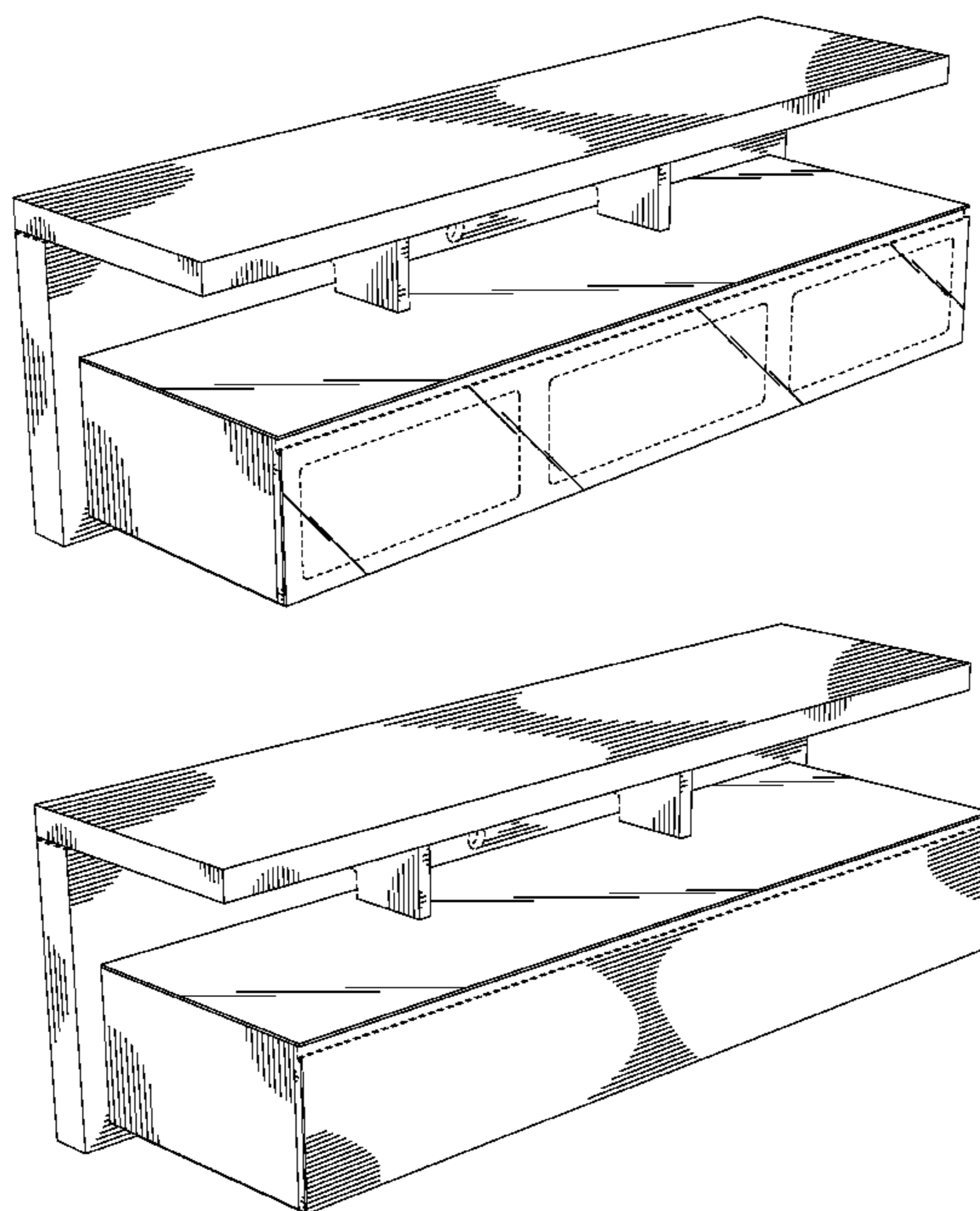
FIG. 4 is a left side orthographic view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side orthographic view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of an audio video cabinet showing my new design, which is identical to the first embodiment, except that the front door is opaque instead of being transparent or semi-transparent.

The broken lines shown in FIGS. 1-2 and 4-6 are included for the purpose of illustrating environmental elements only and form no part of the claimed design. Elements that are shaded for transparency in FIGS. 1-3 and 6 may be either transparent or translucent (including smoked glass). The rectangular broken line areas visible on the front door in FIGS. 1-2 represent openings in a frame located behind the door face. Any elements that may be visible through the unclaimed openings form no part of the claimed design. The rear and bottom views are omitted and form no part of the claimed design.

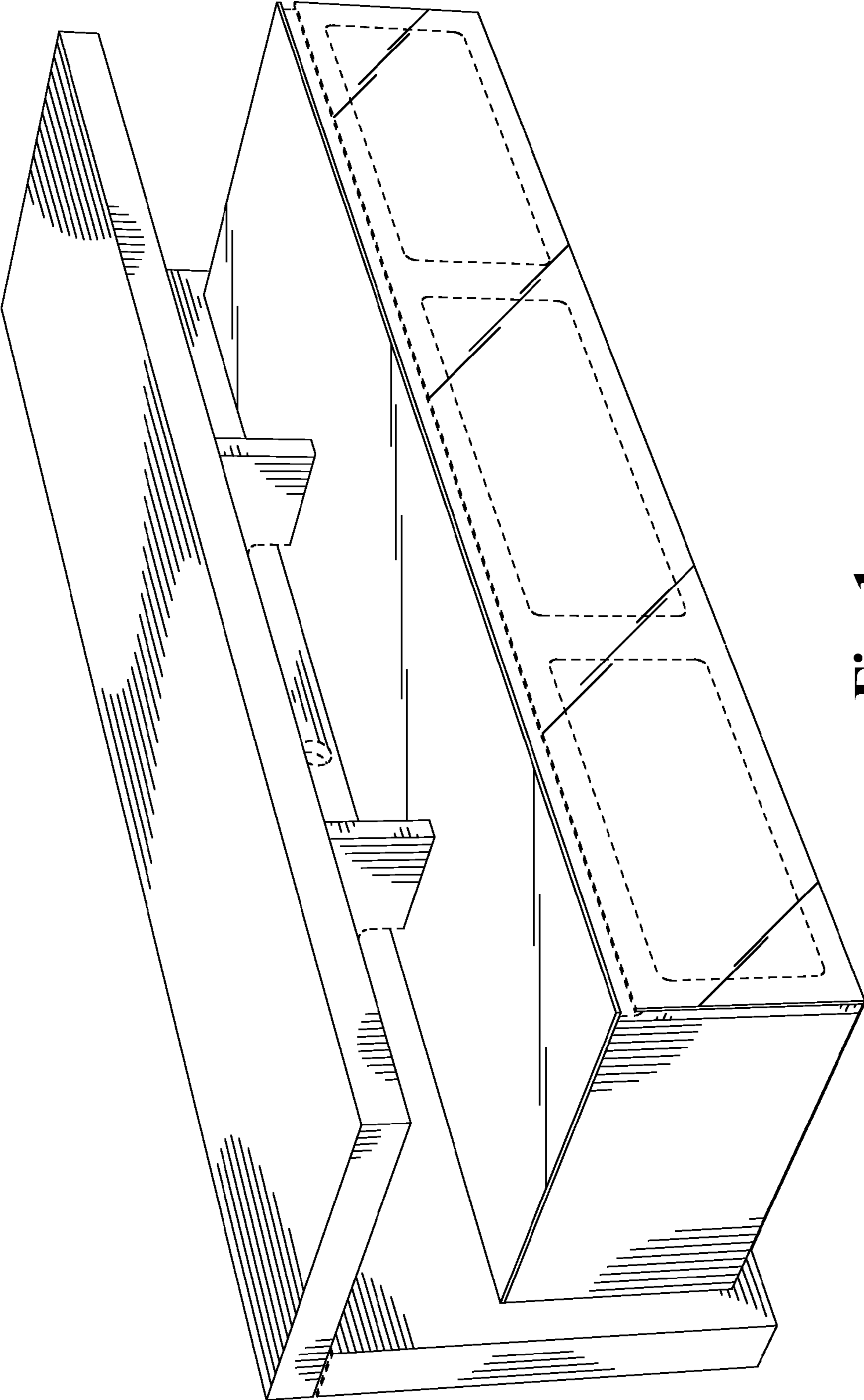

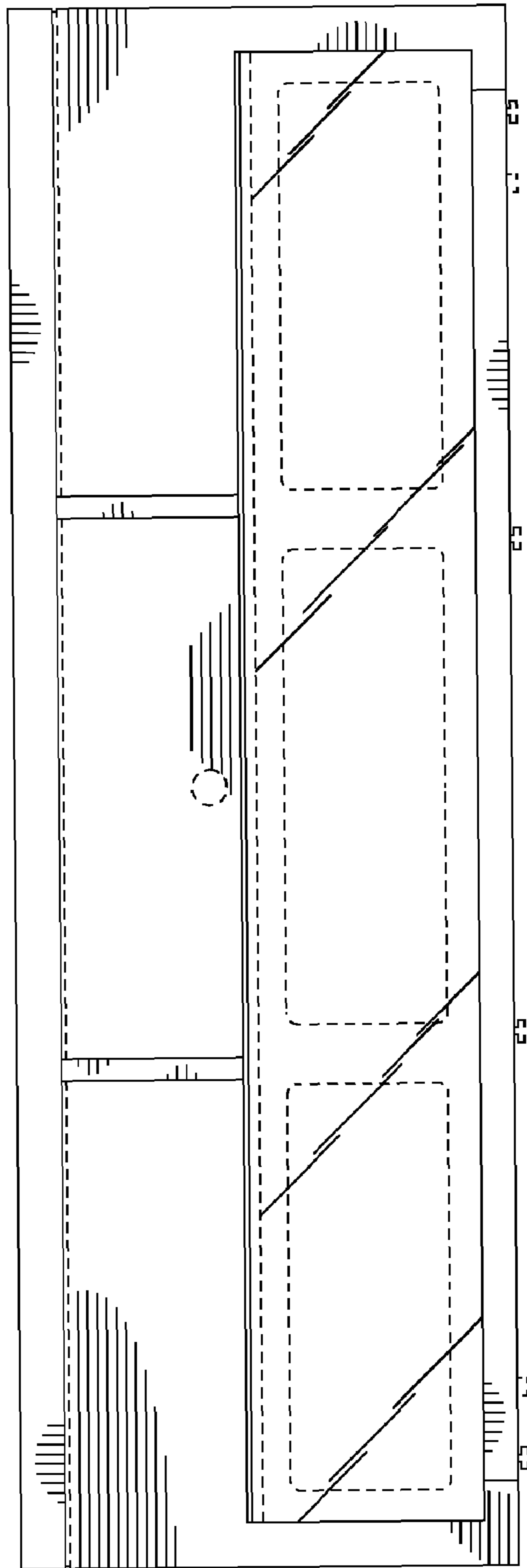

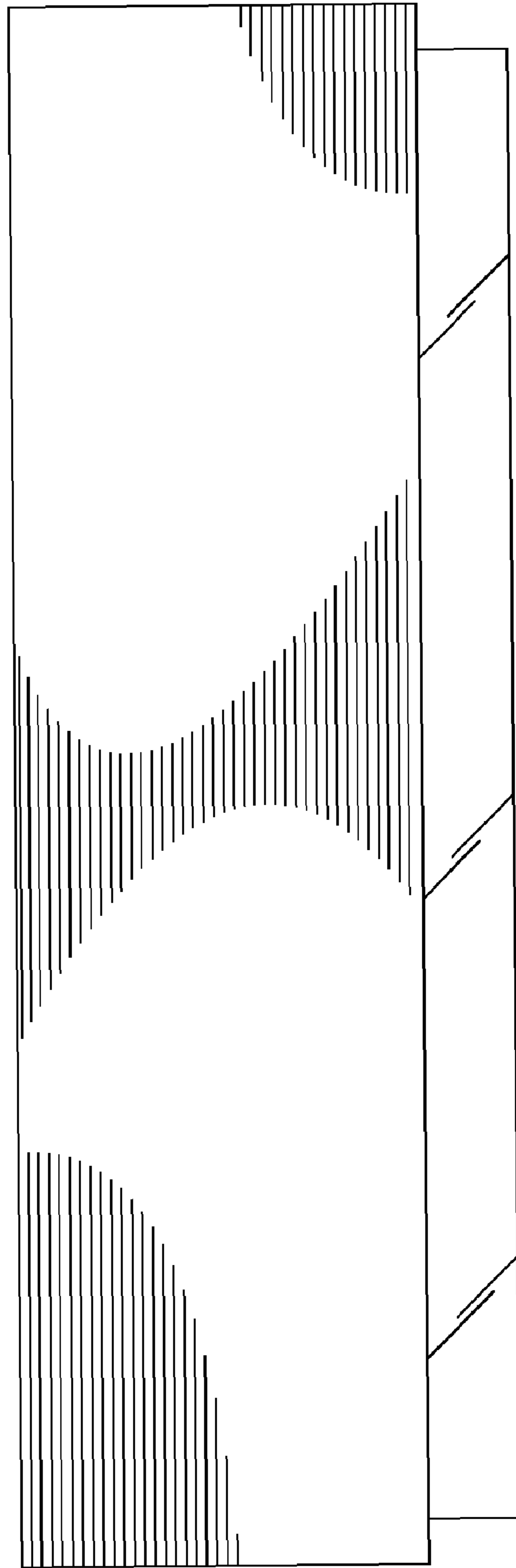

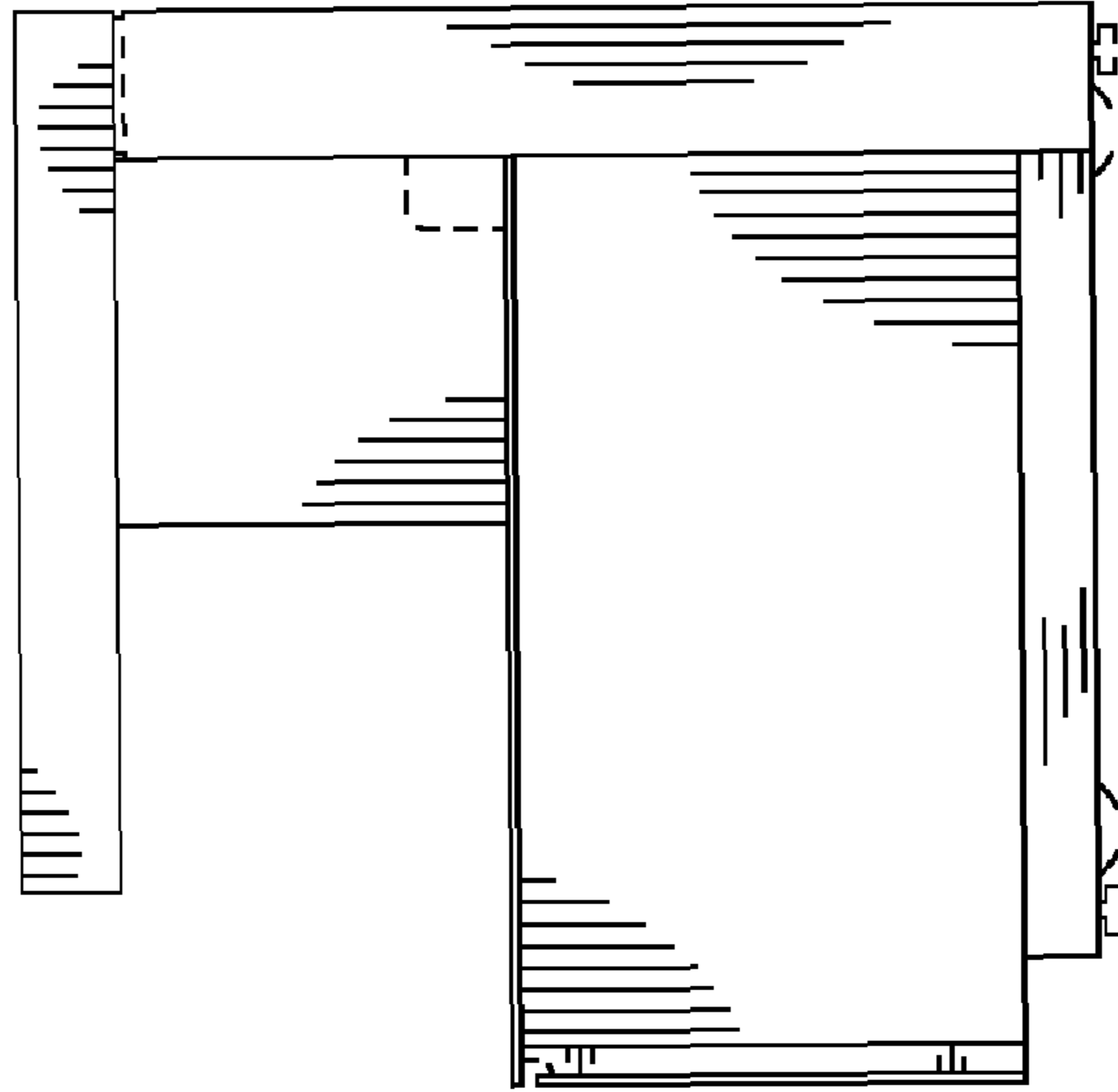

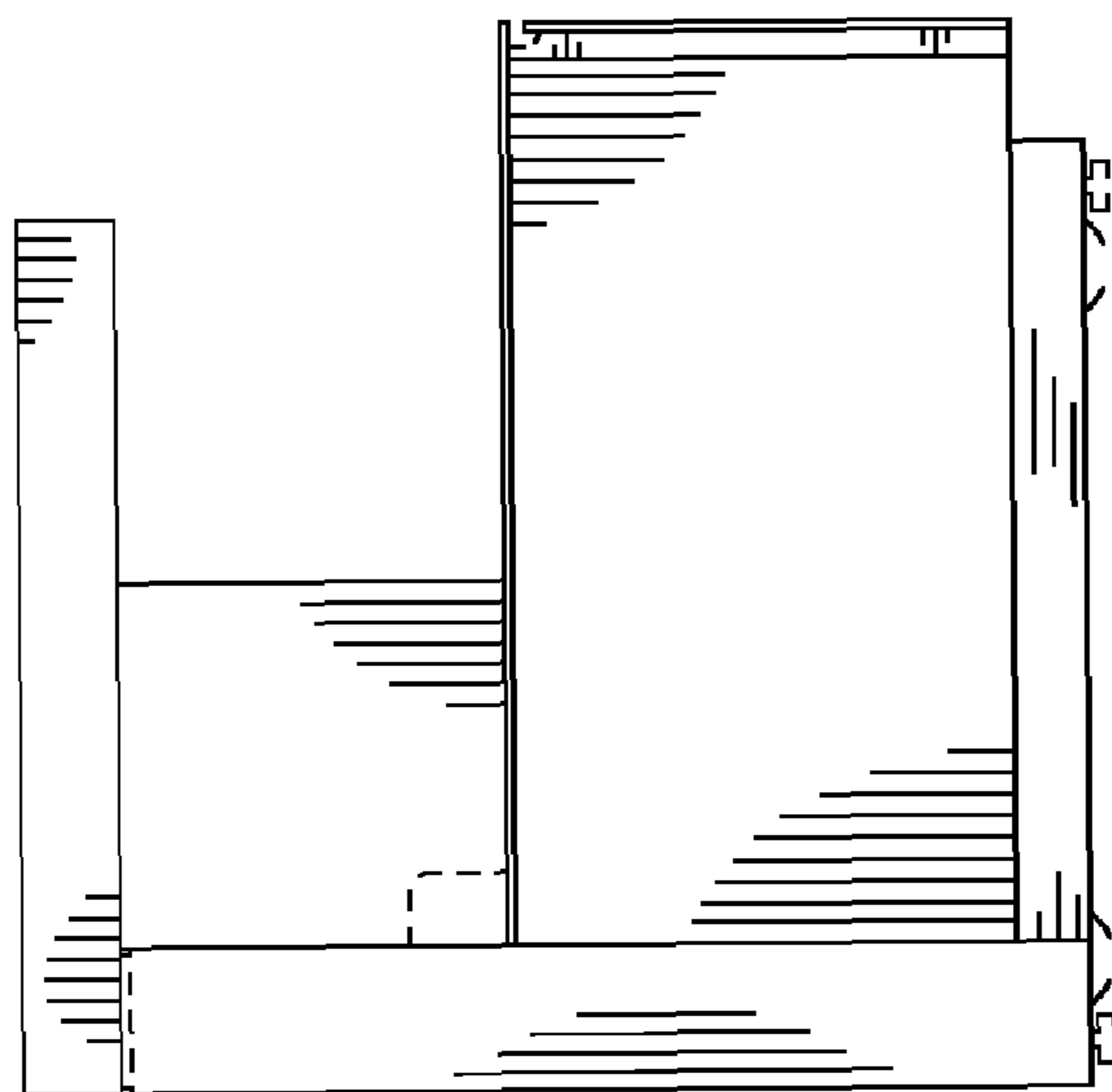

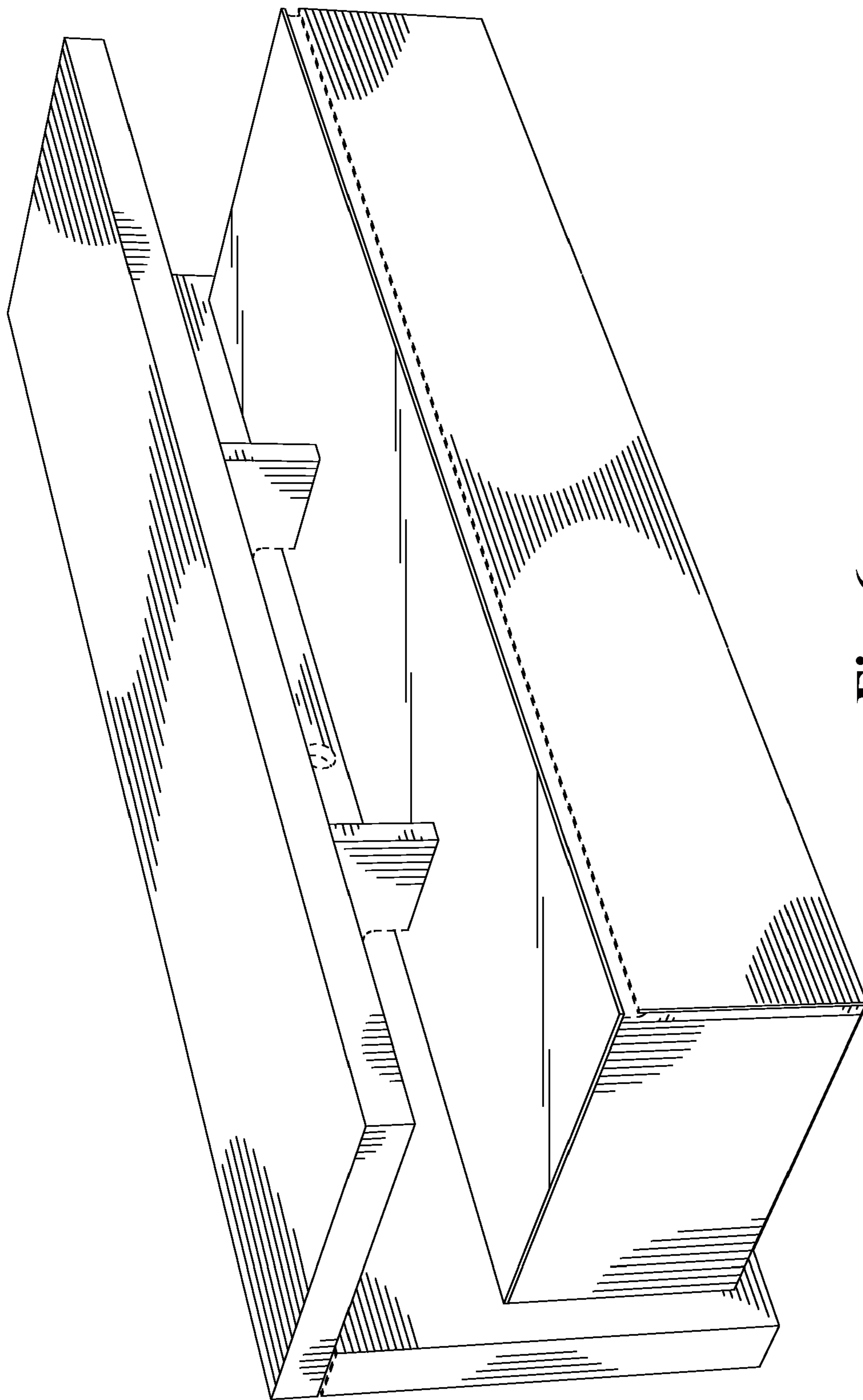
