The ornamental design for a headpiece, as shown and
described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a headpiece showing my new
design;

FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a back view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left view thereof;

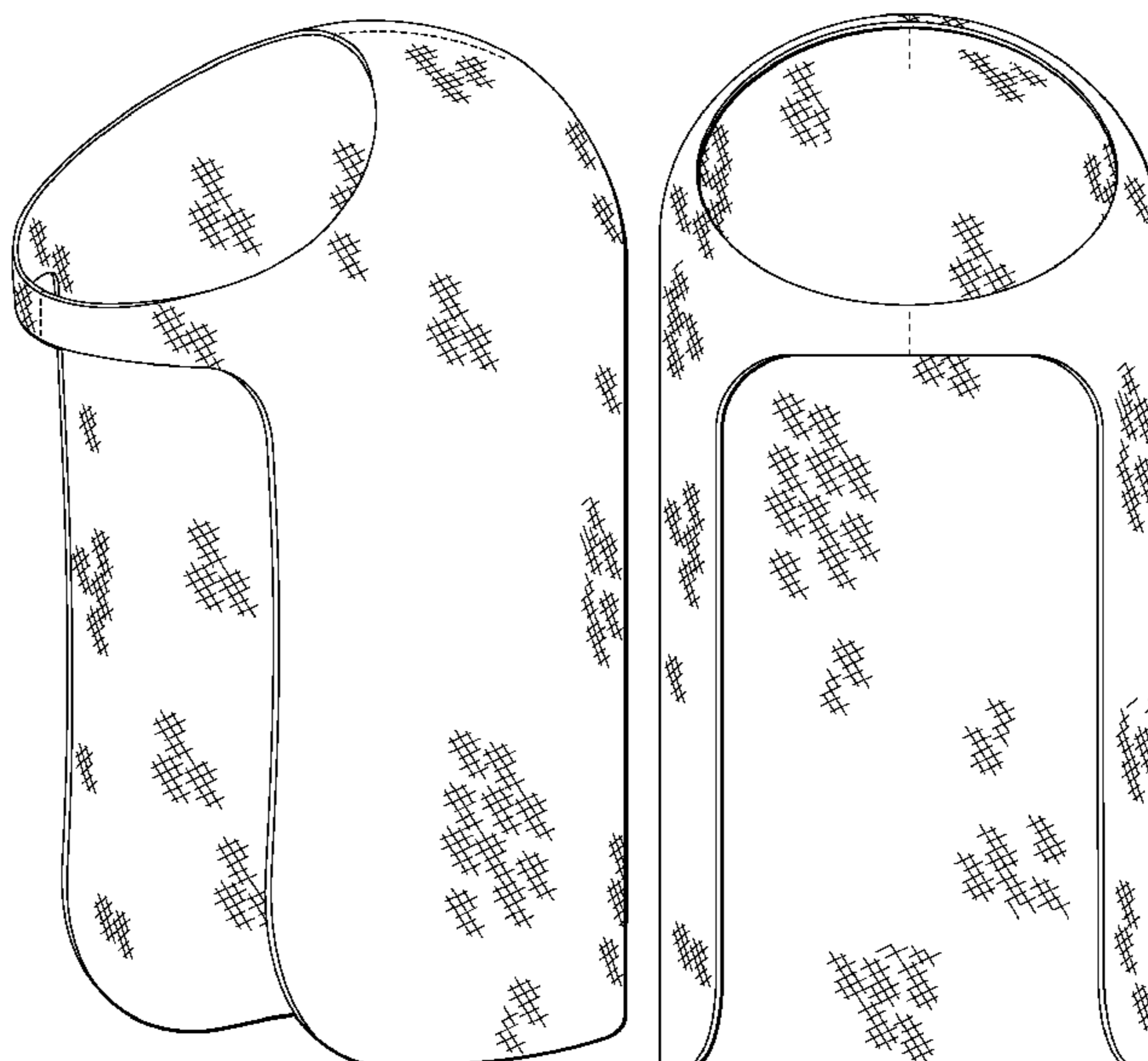
FIG. 6 is a top view thereof; and,

uniformly over the surfaces of the claimed design.

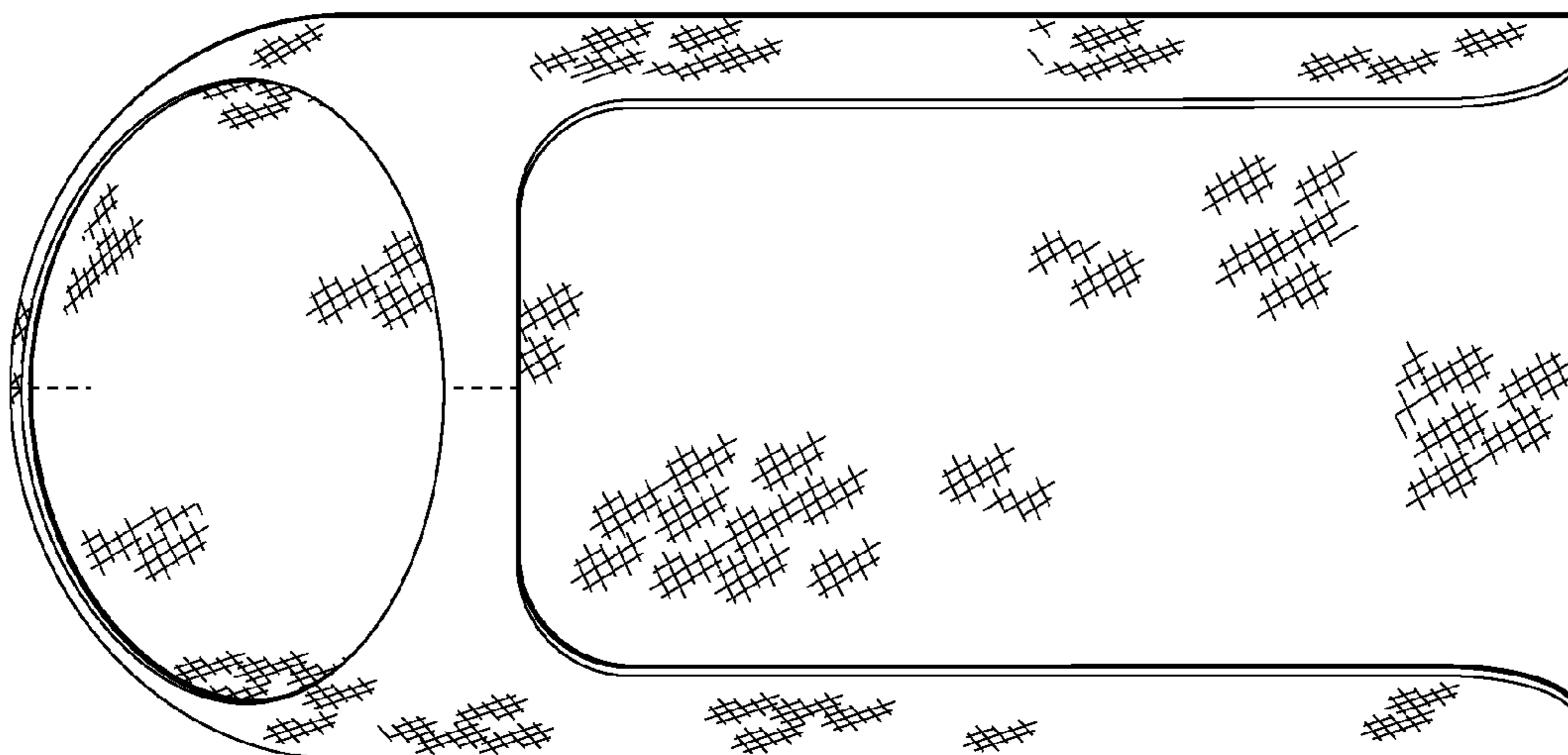

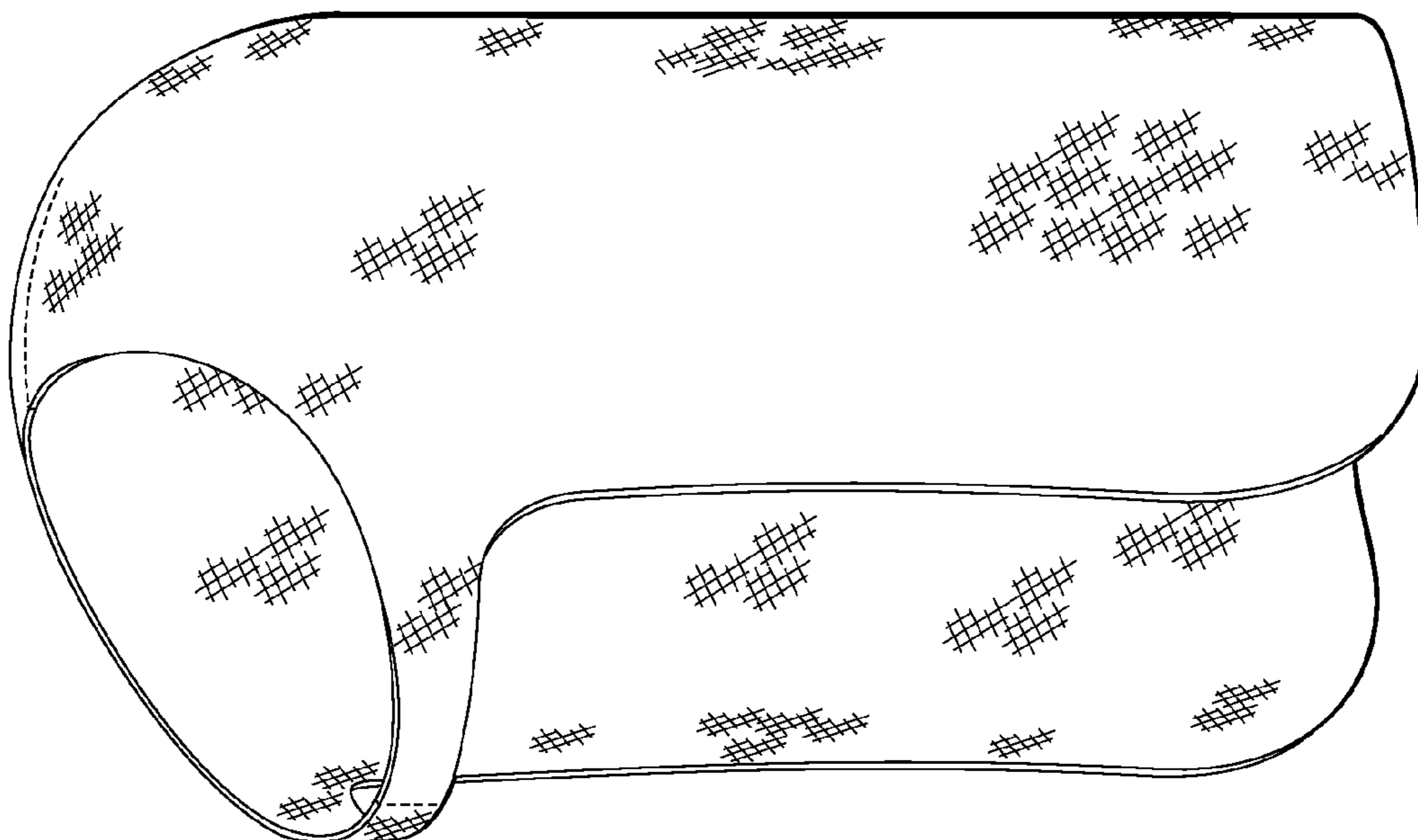

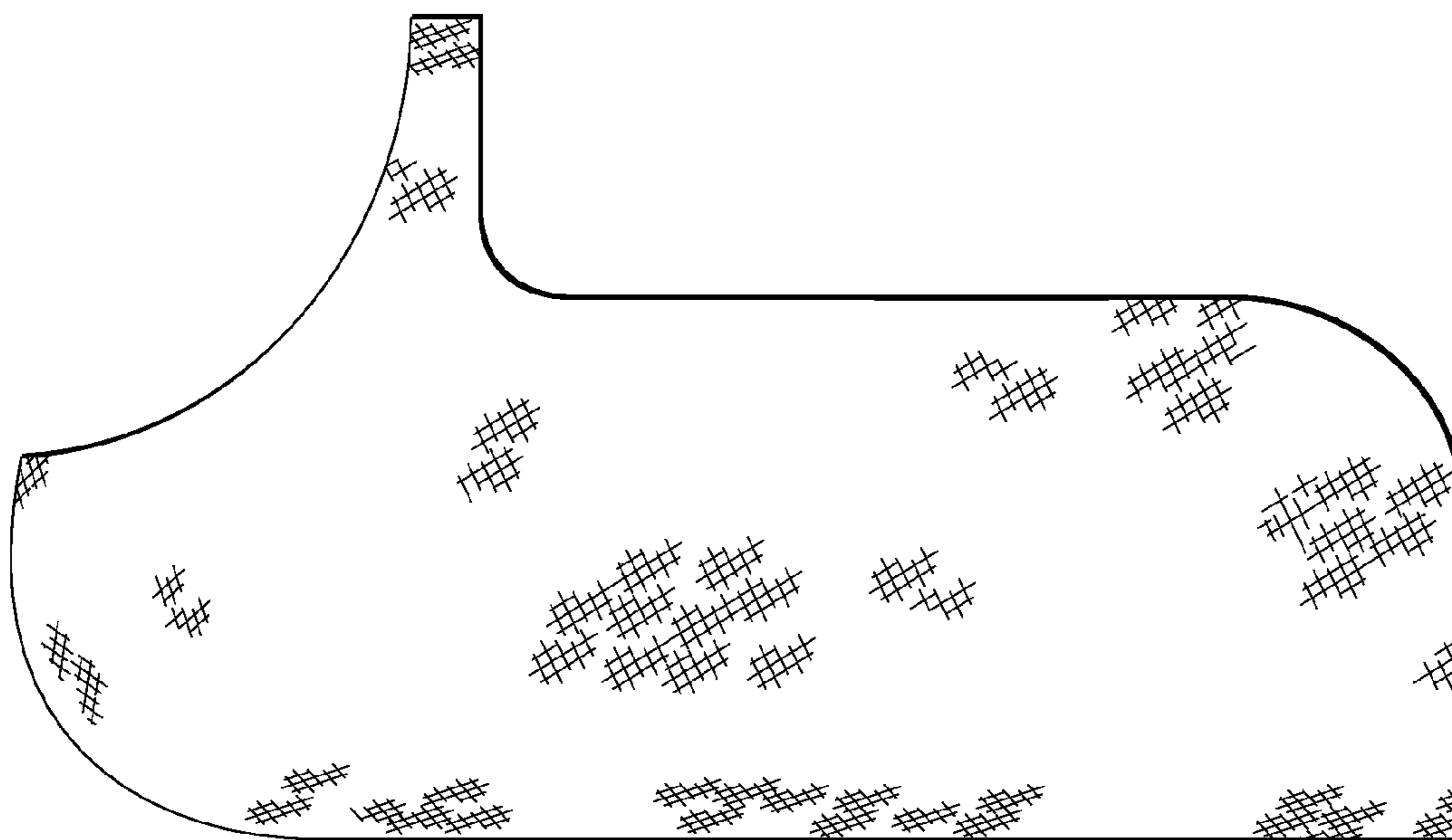

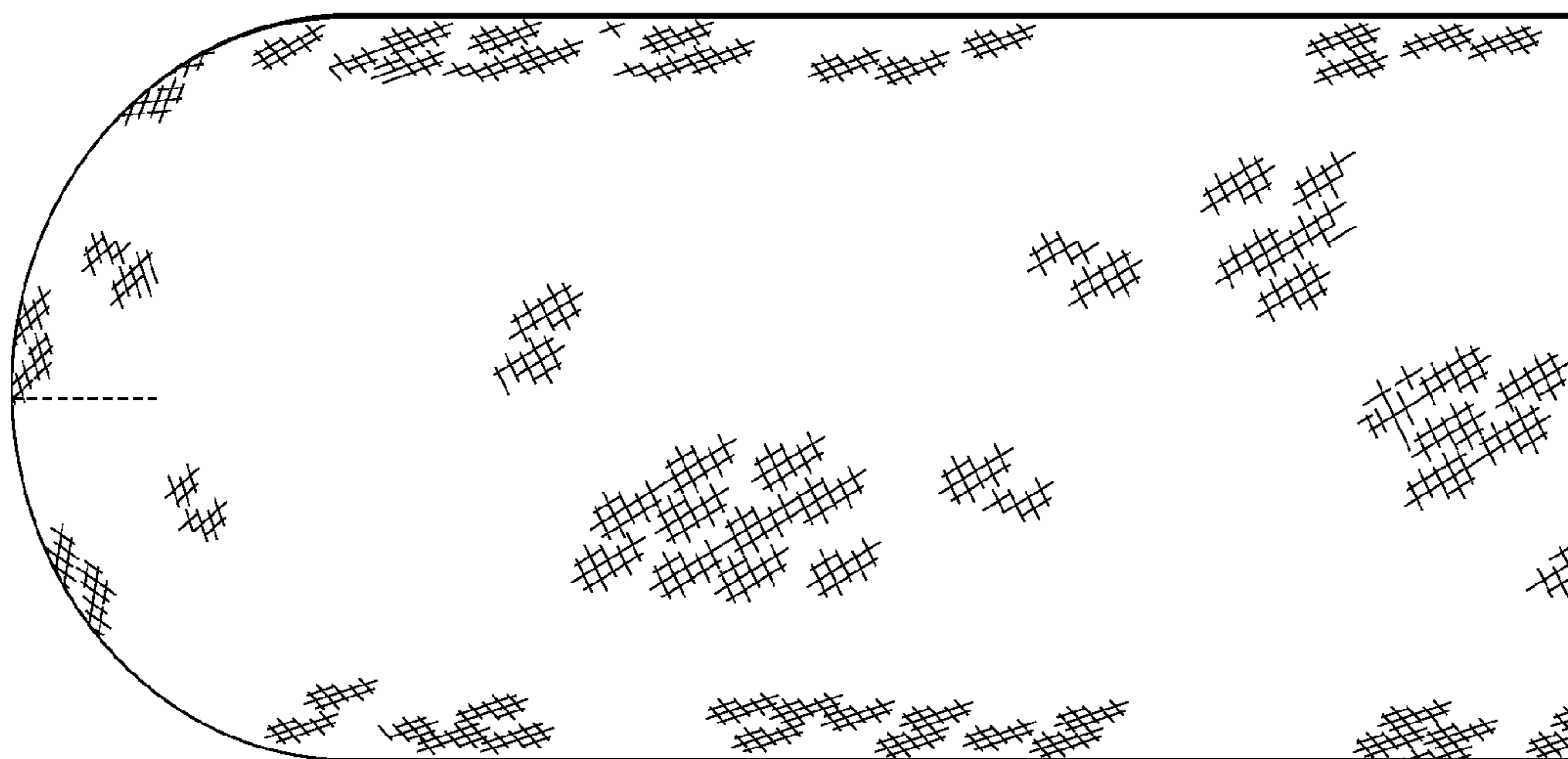

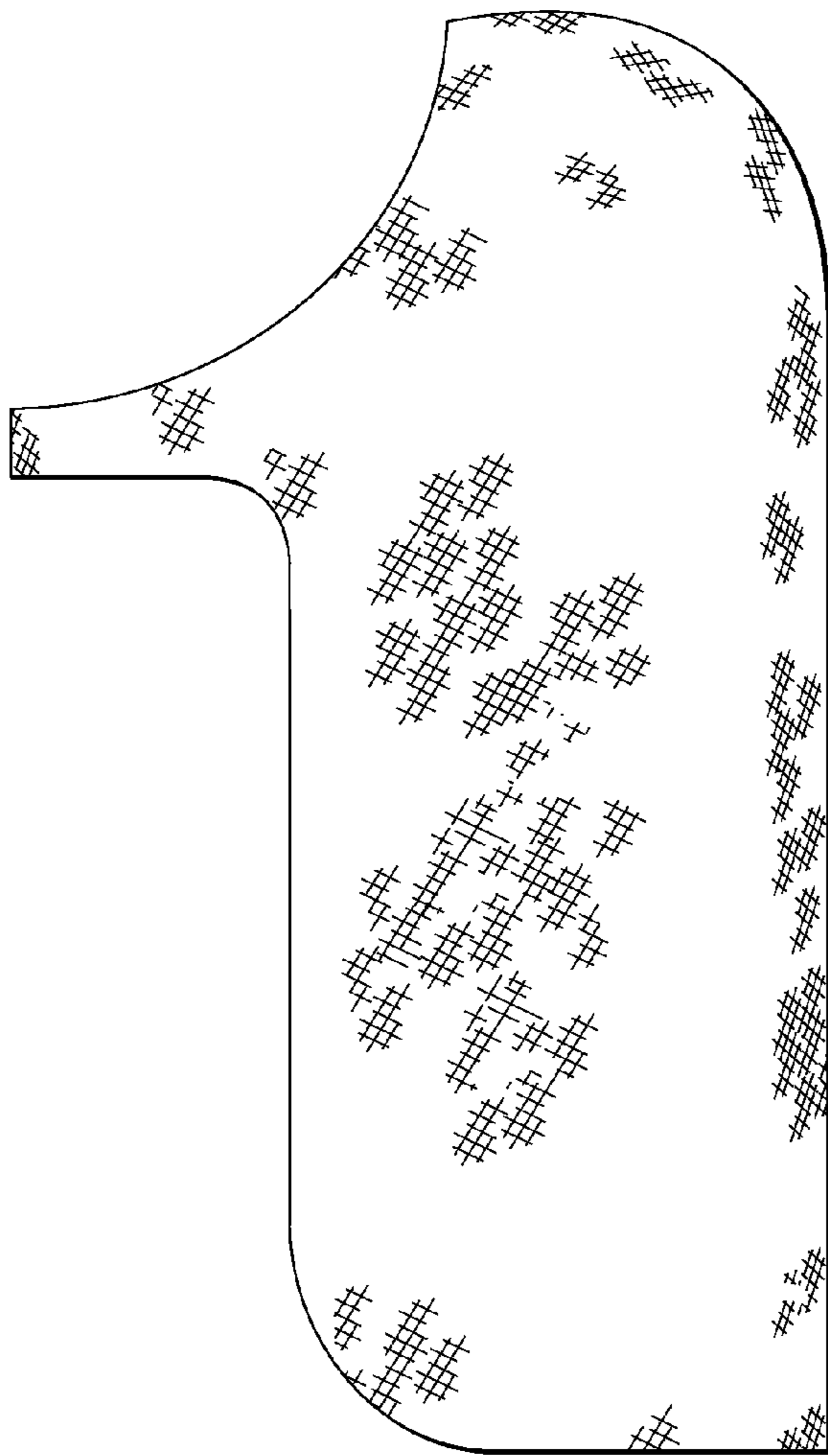

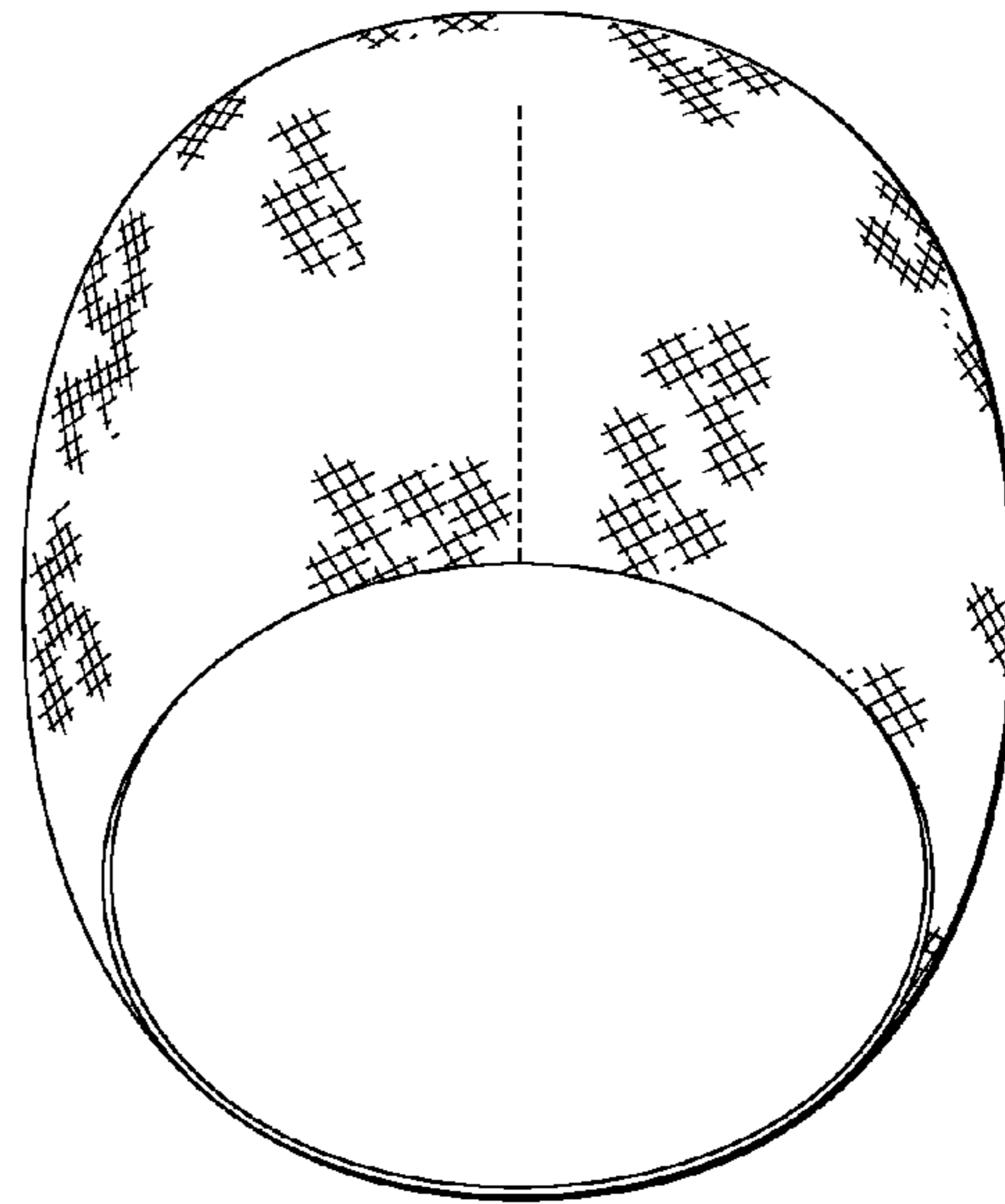

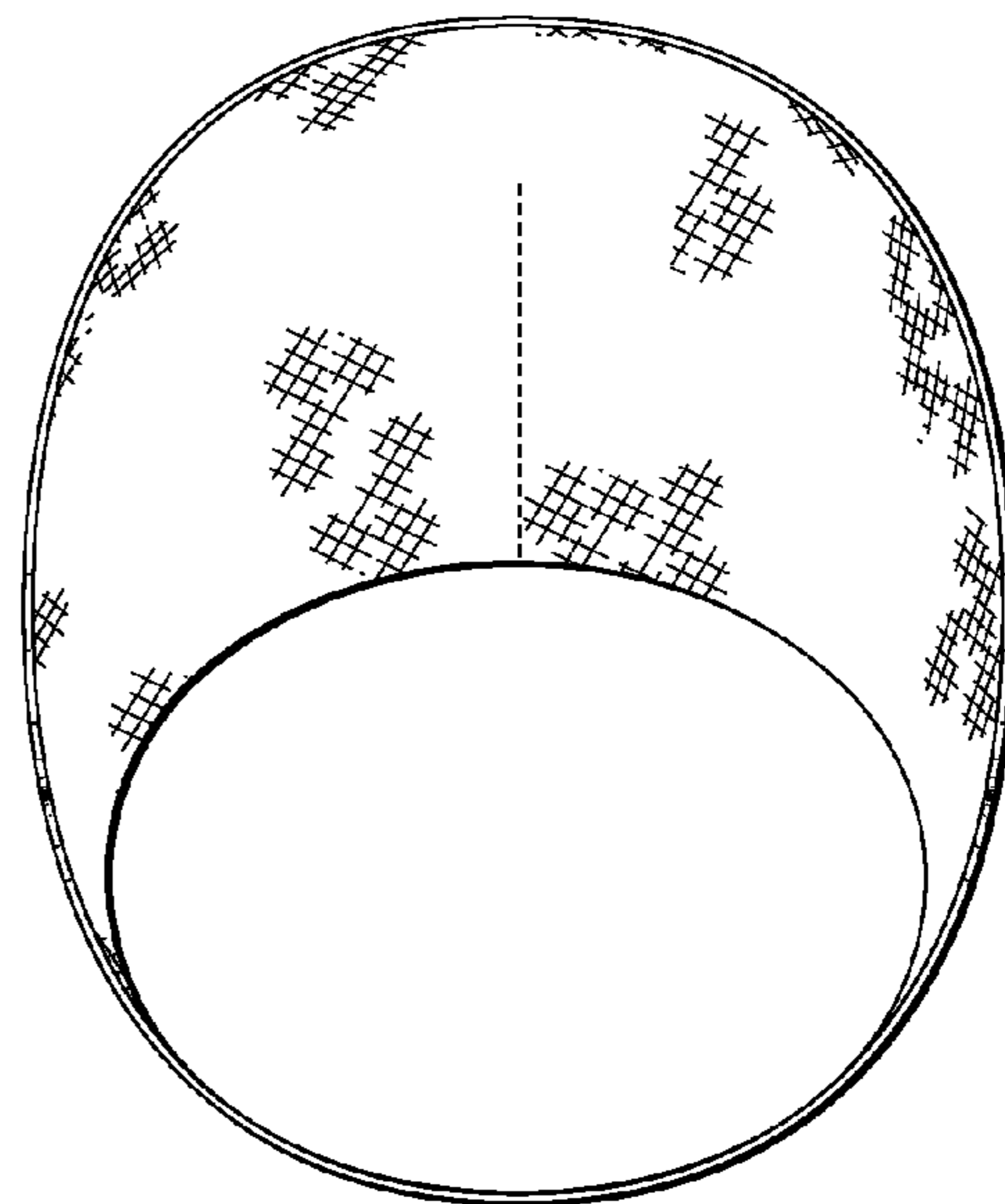
