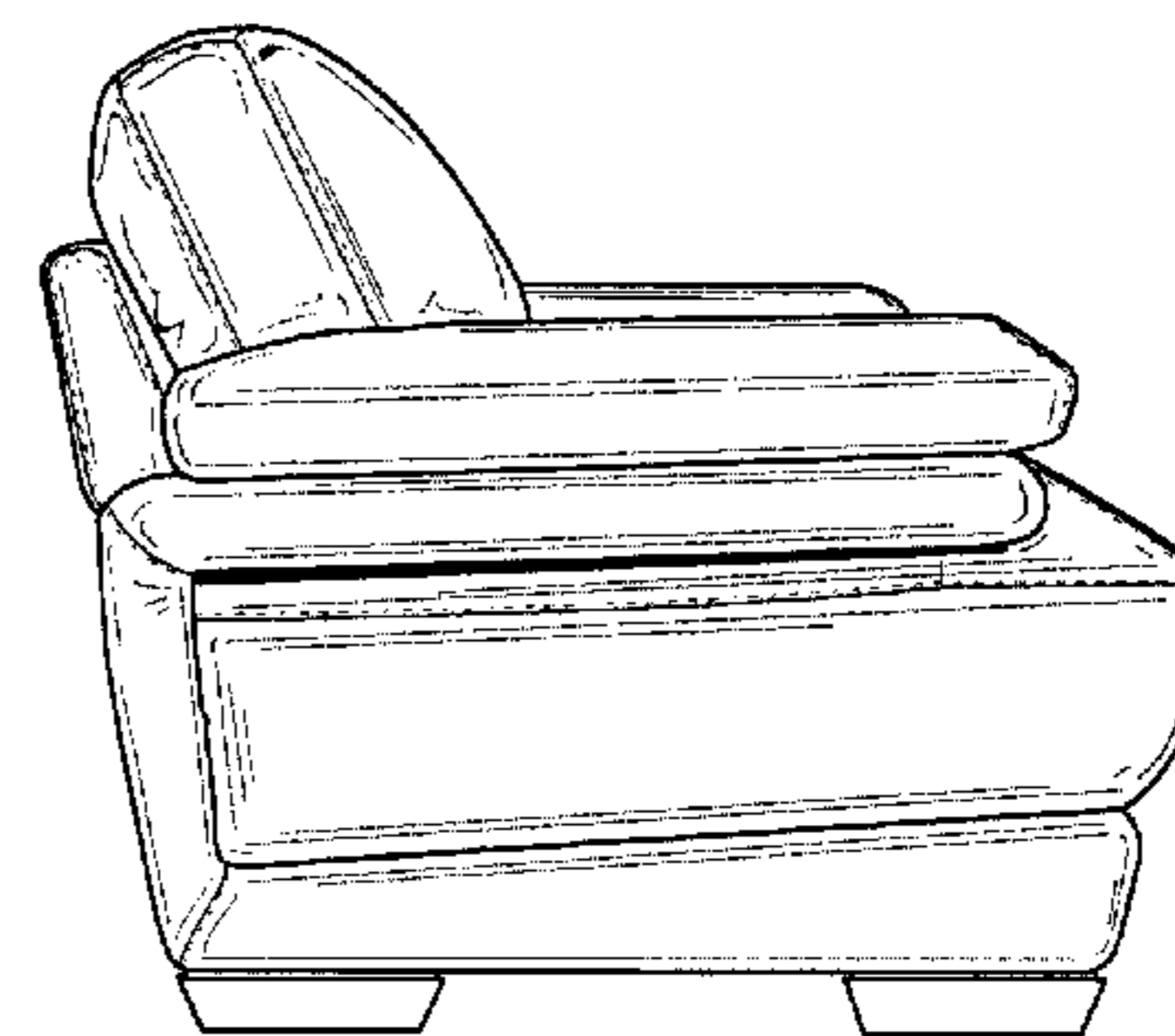
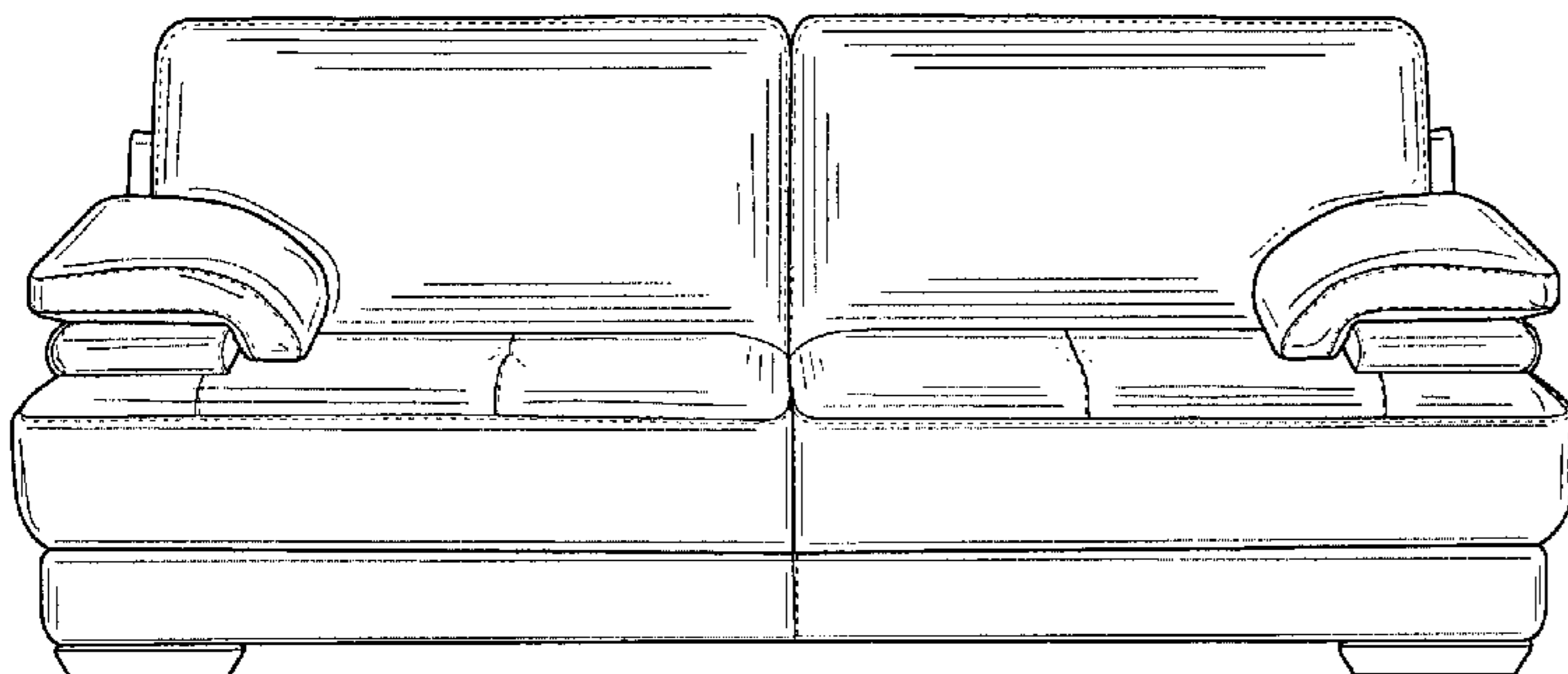
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a sofa, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a sofa in accordance with the new design;  
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a side perspective view, an opposite side perspective view being a mirror image view thereof; and,  
FIG. 4 is a back perspective view thereof.  
Broken lines shown on the sofa are understood to represent stitching.

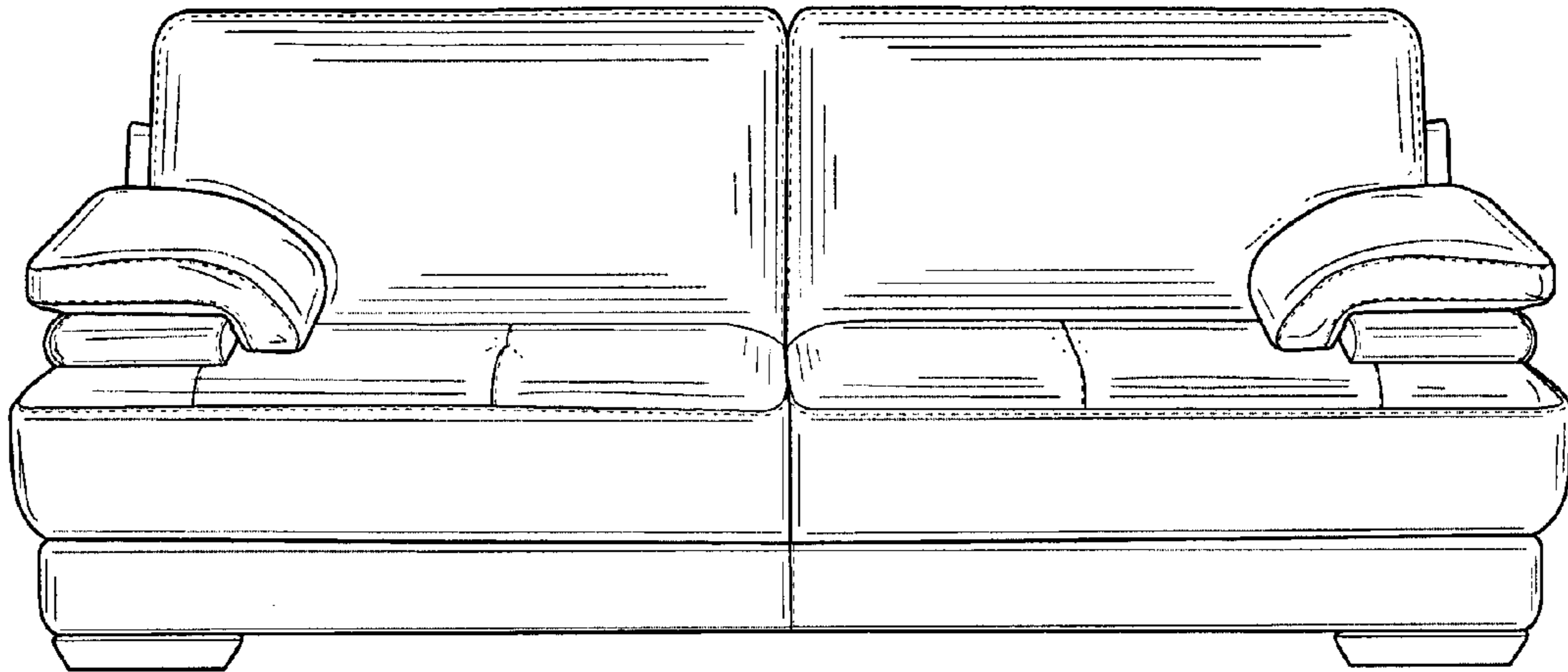

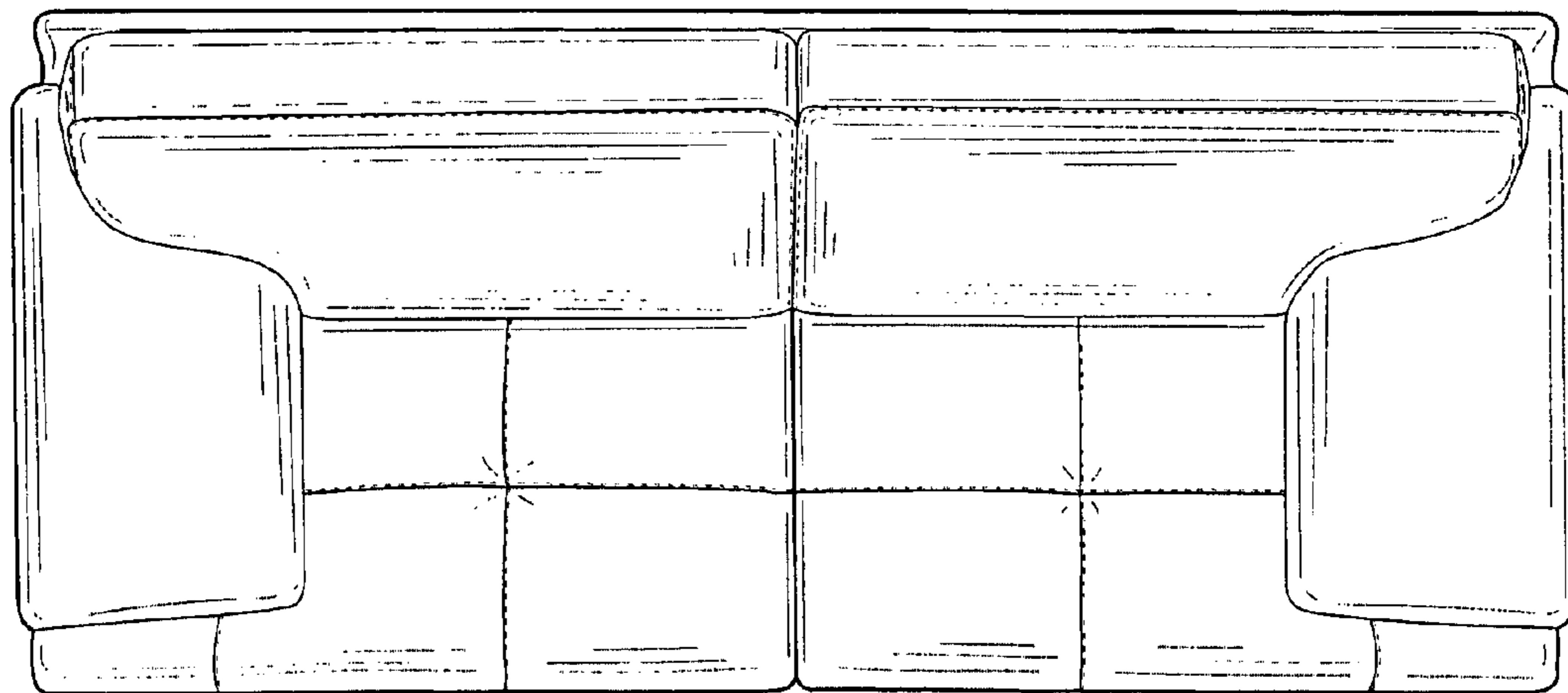

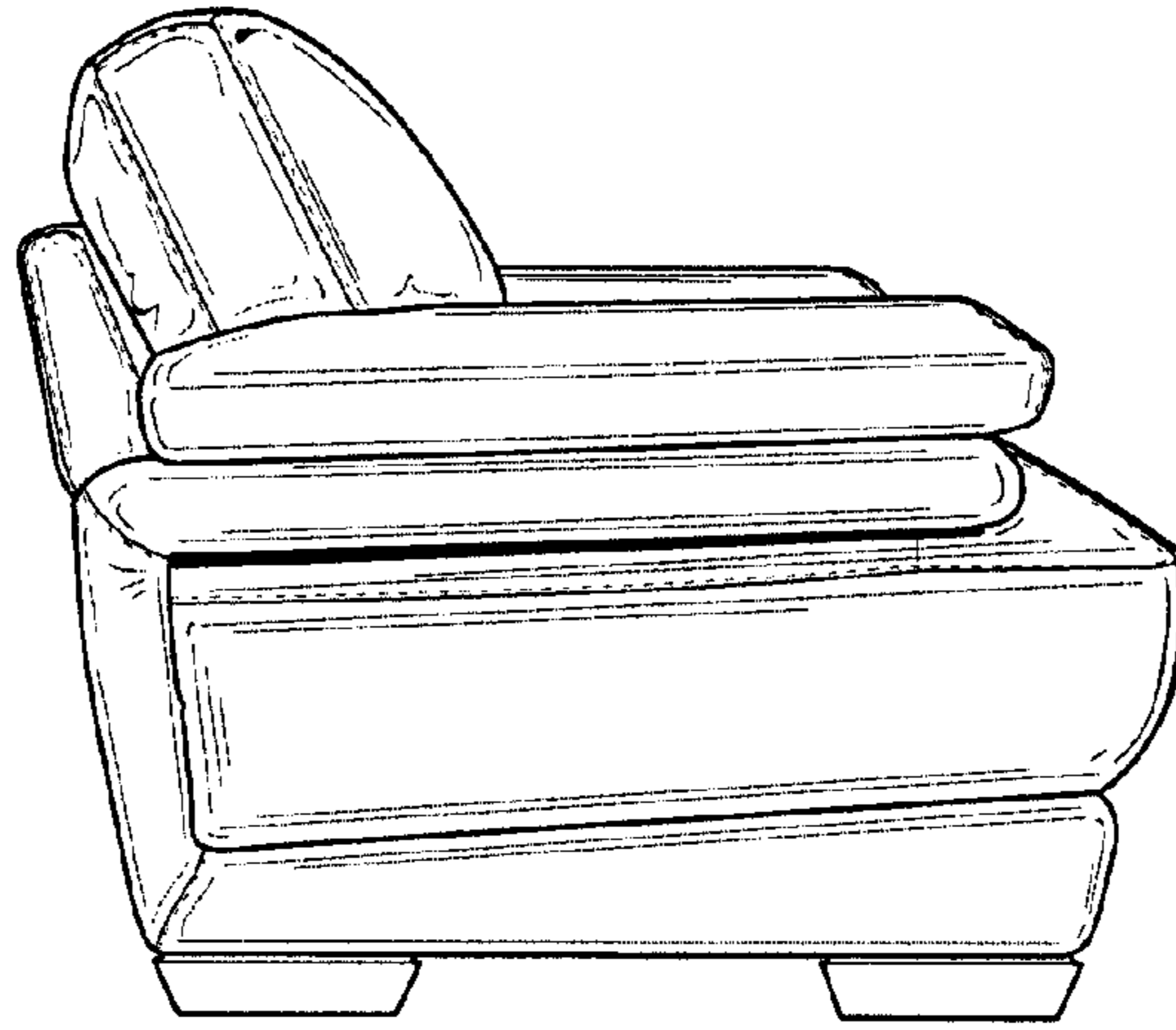

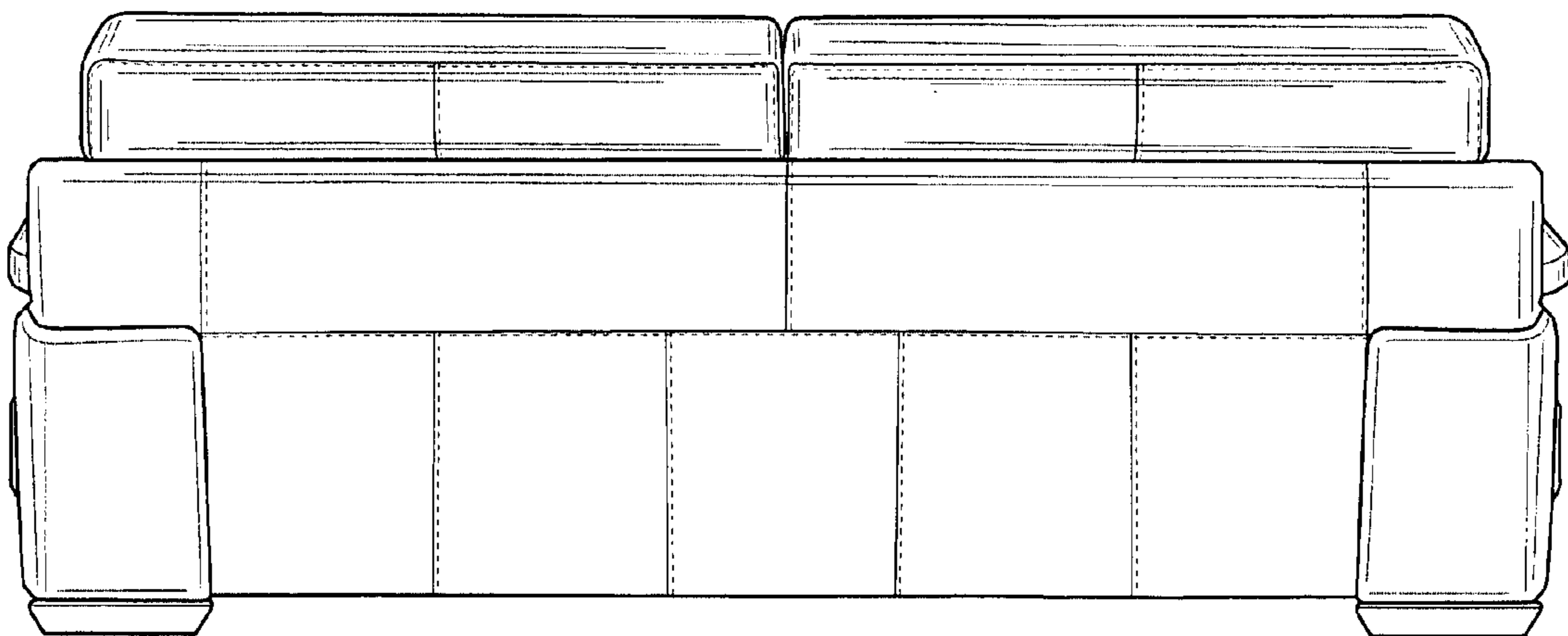
