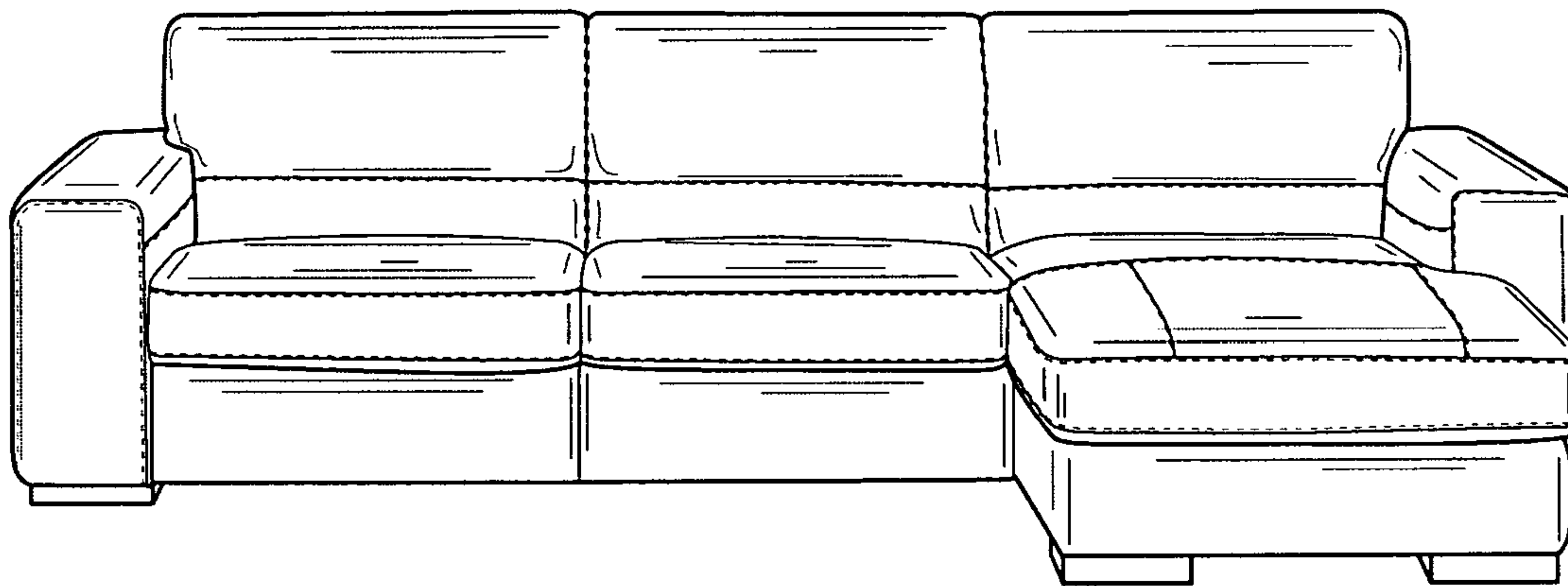
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a sofa, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a sofa in accordance with the new design;
FIG. 2 is a top perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a back perspective view thereof; and,
FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view, the right side elevation view being a mirror image thereof.
Broken lines shown on the sofa are understood to represent stitching.

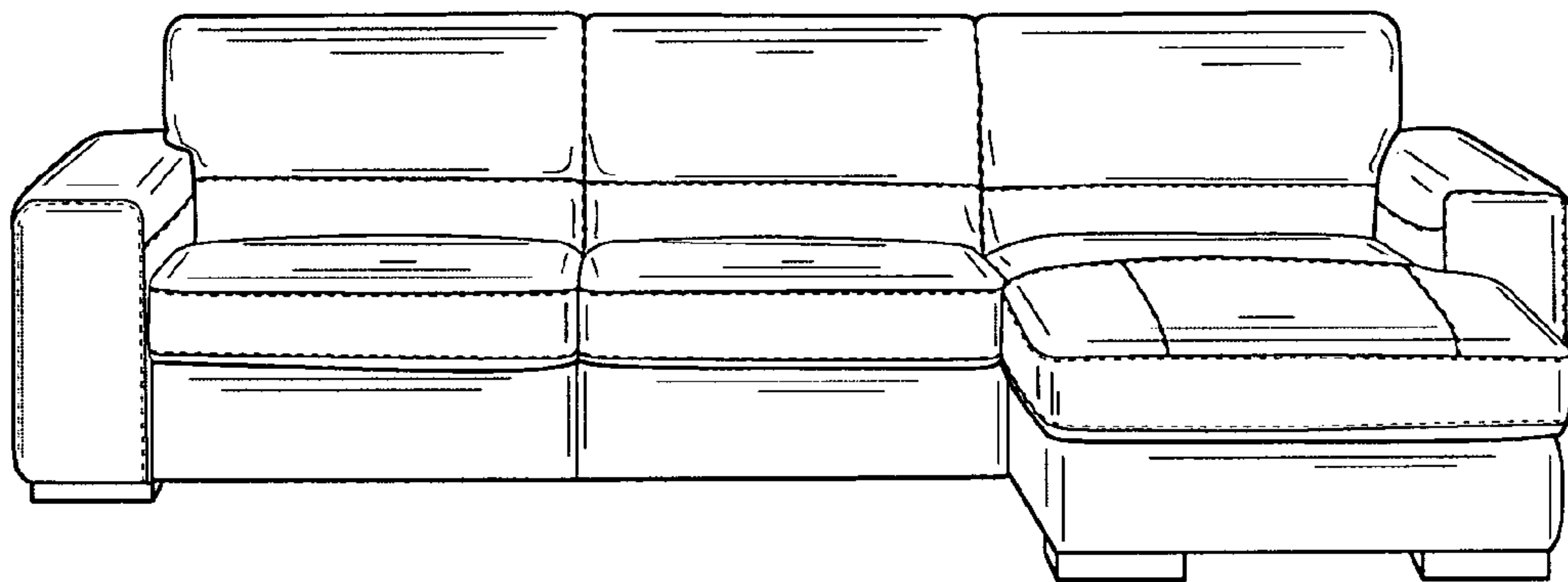

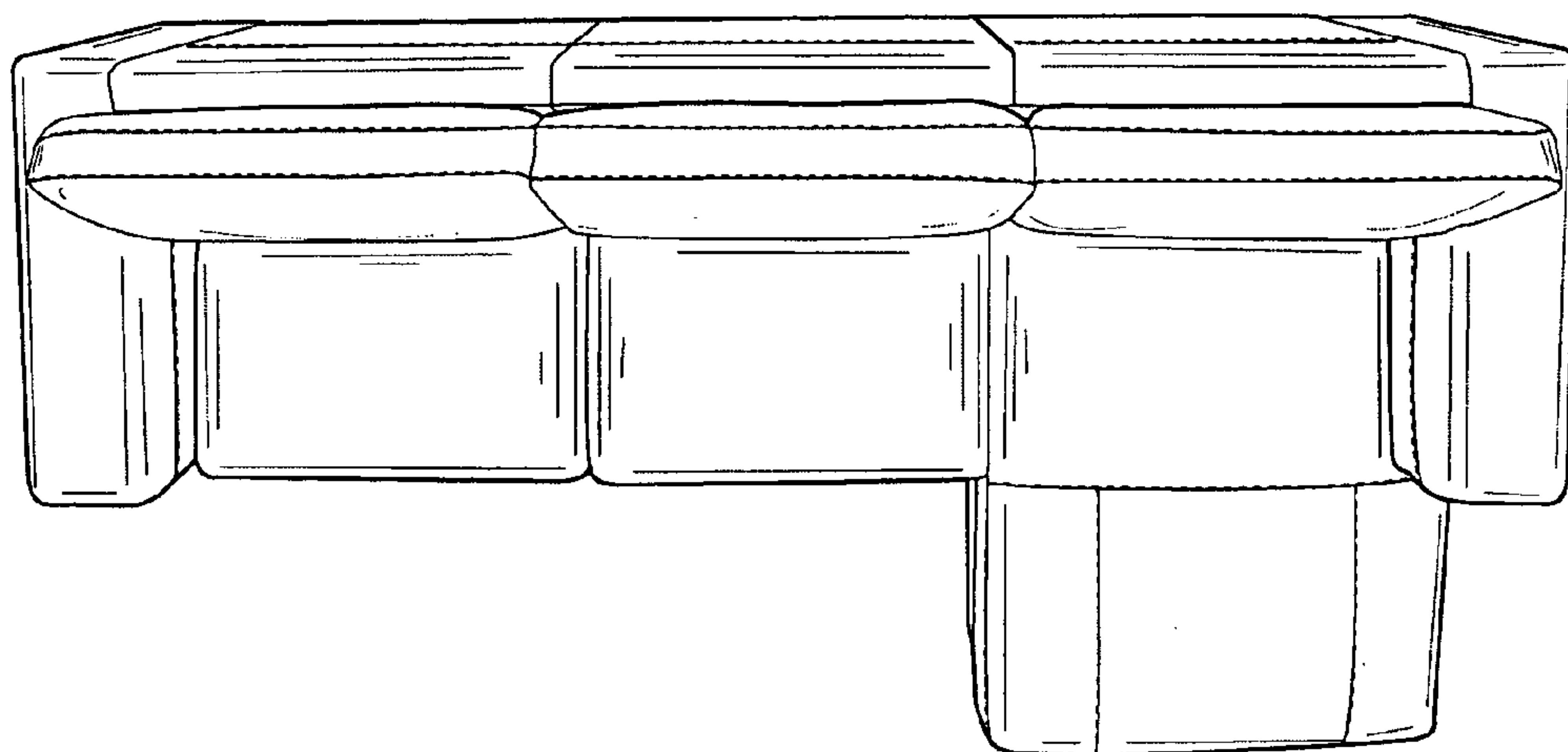

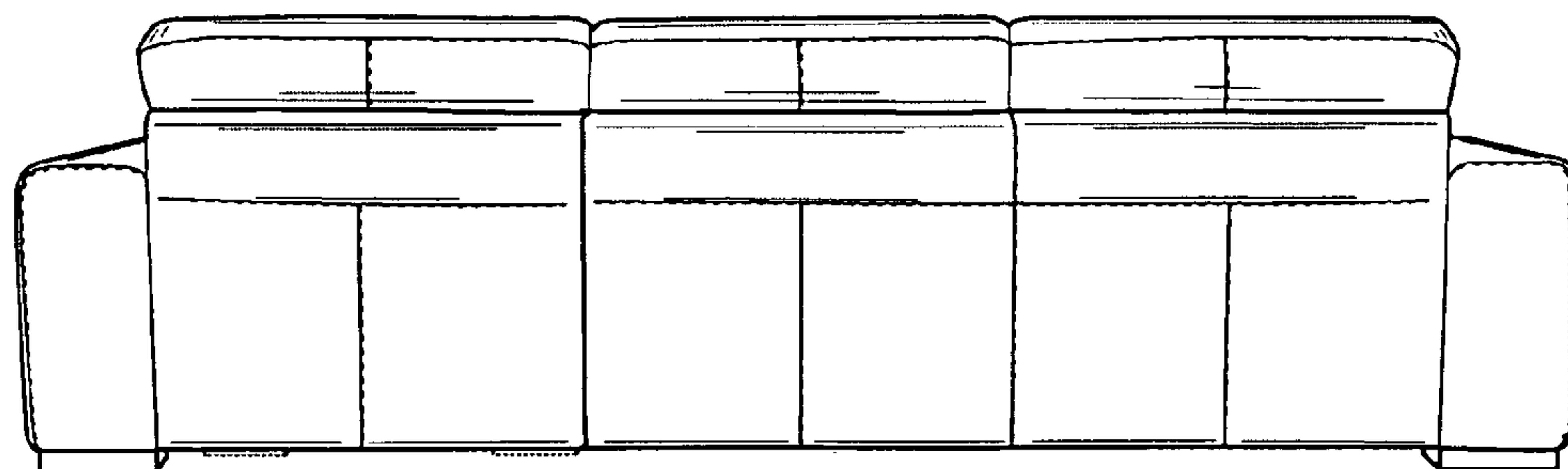

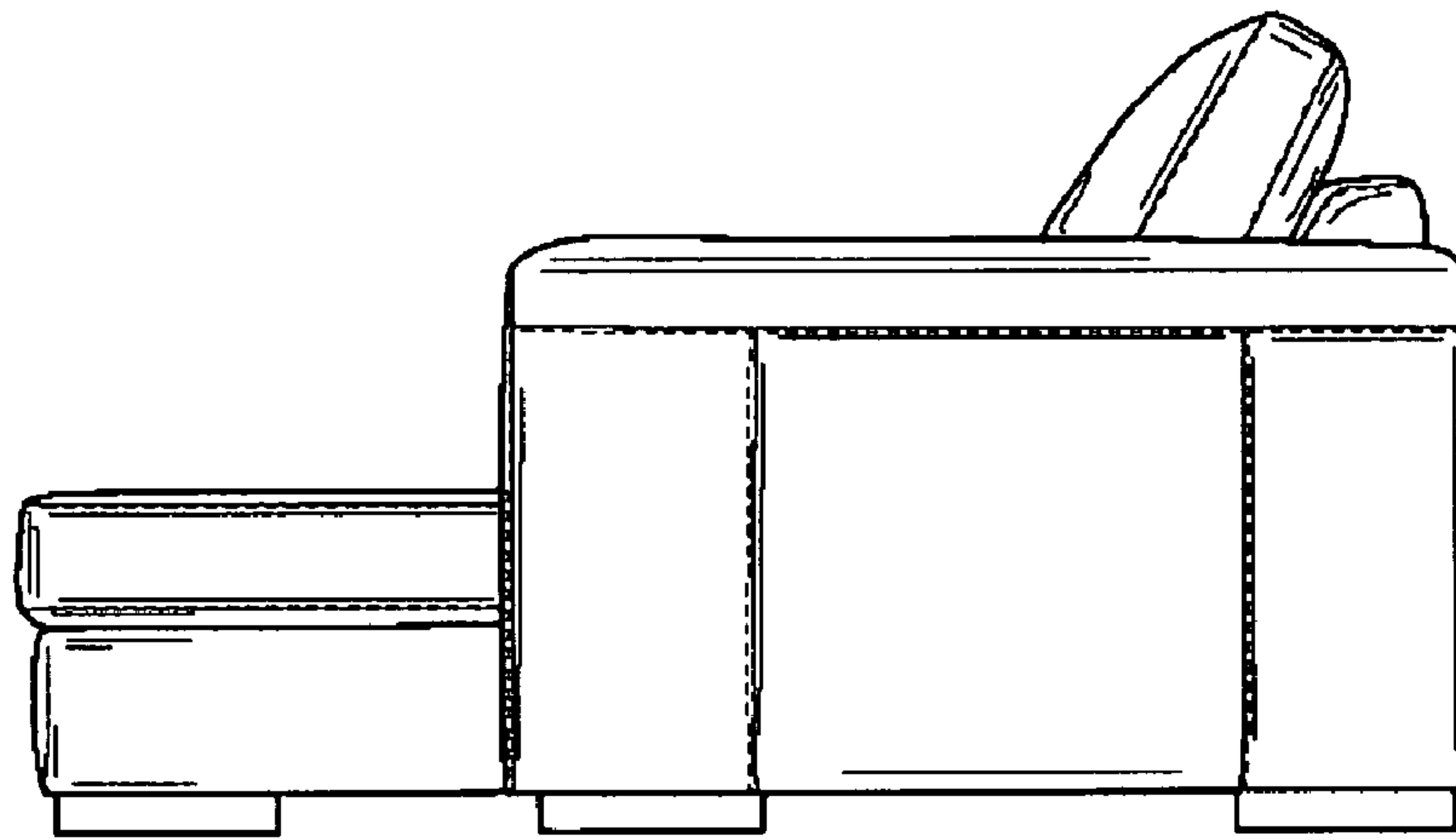
