FIG. 8 is bottom plan view thereof;

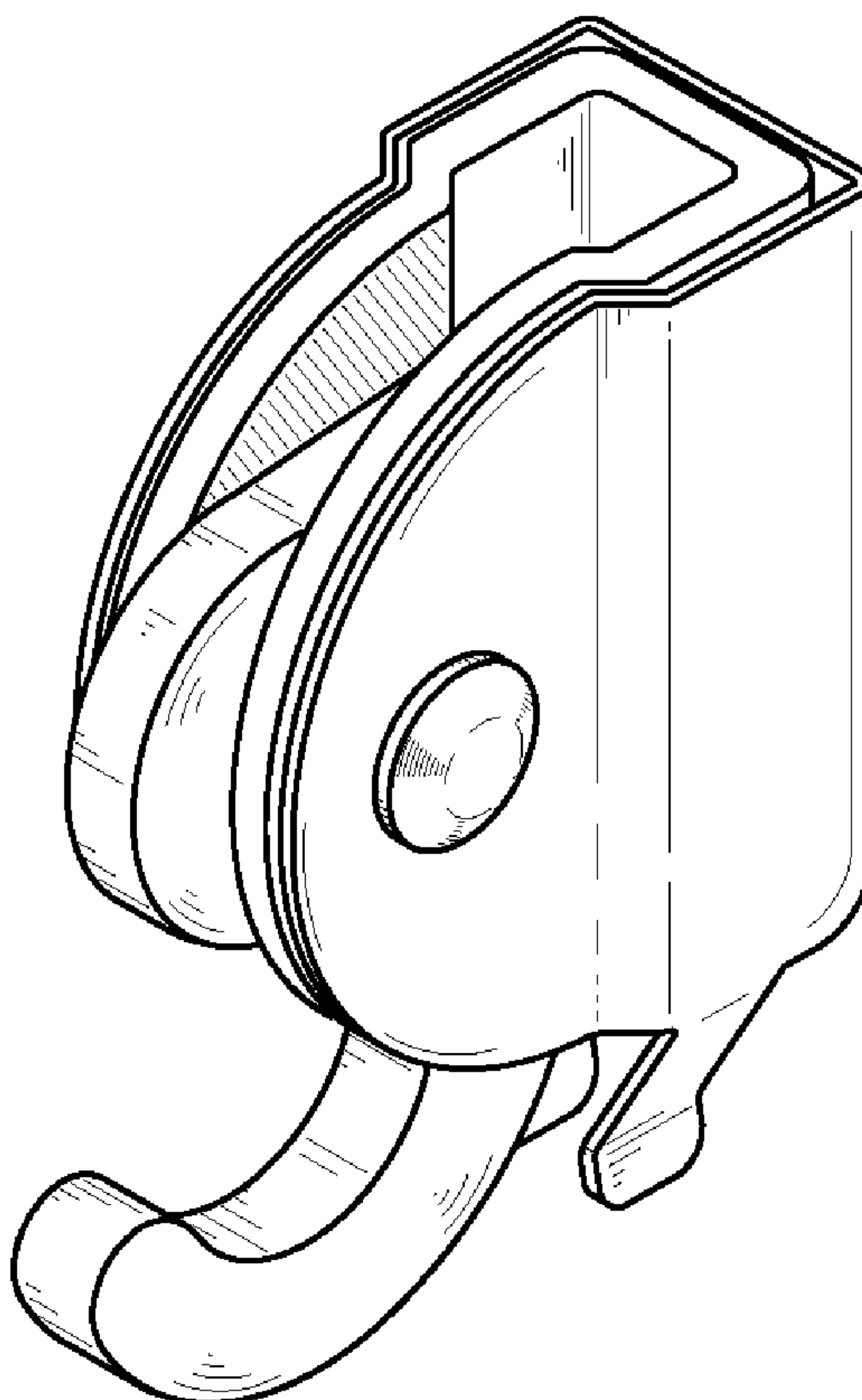
FIG. 9 is a right side view thereof showing an alternate position; and,

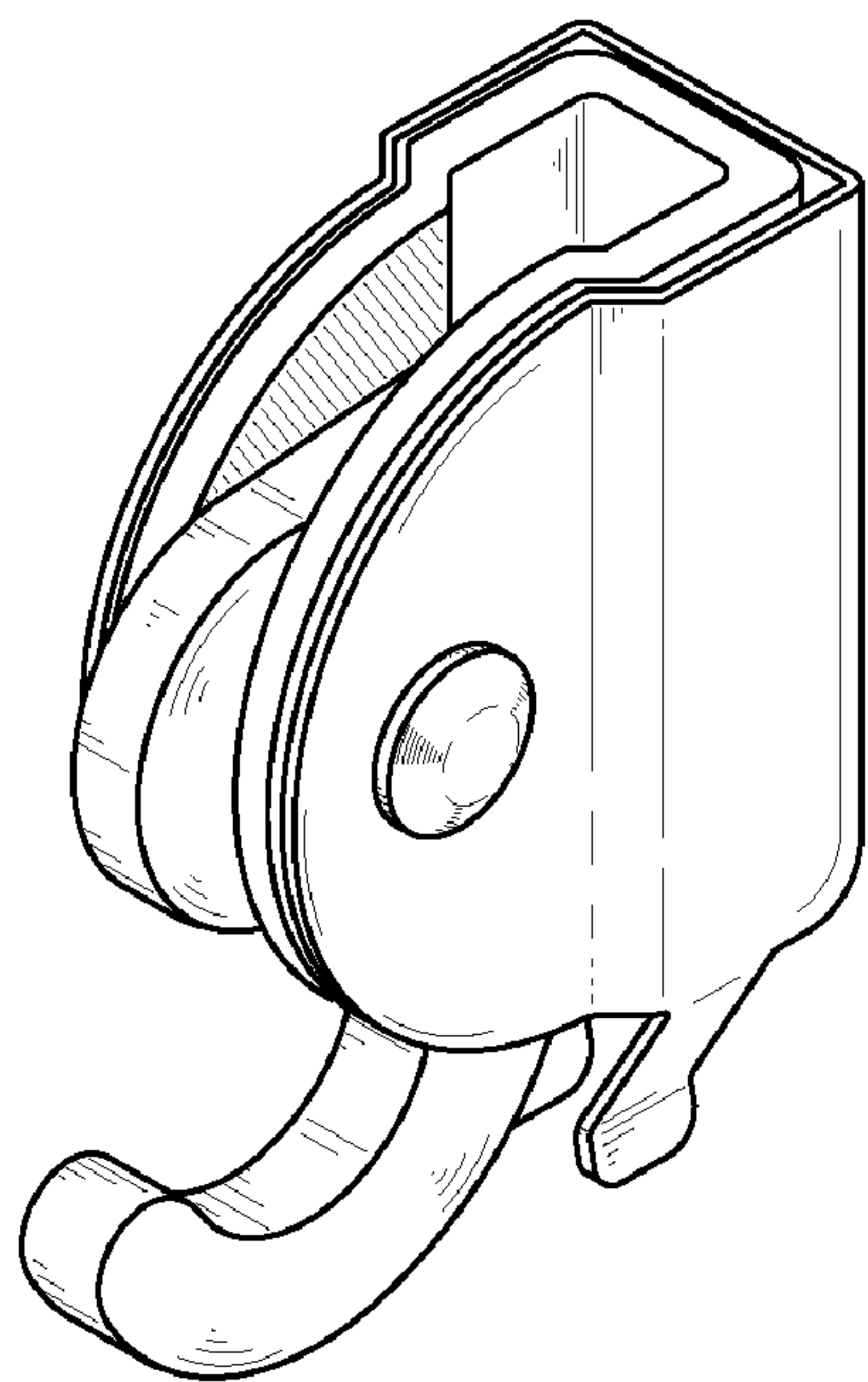

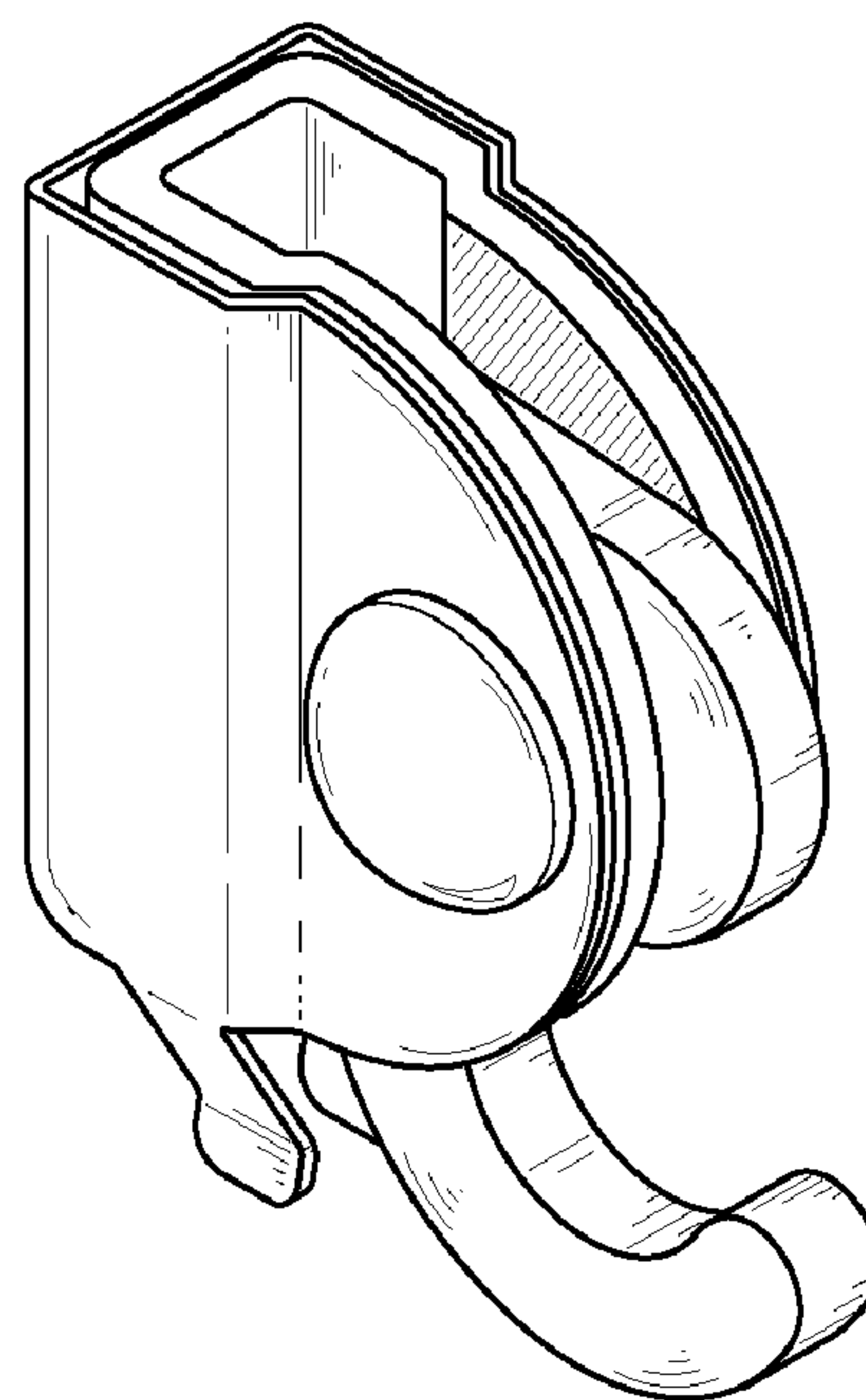

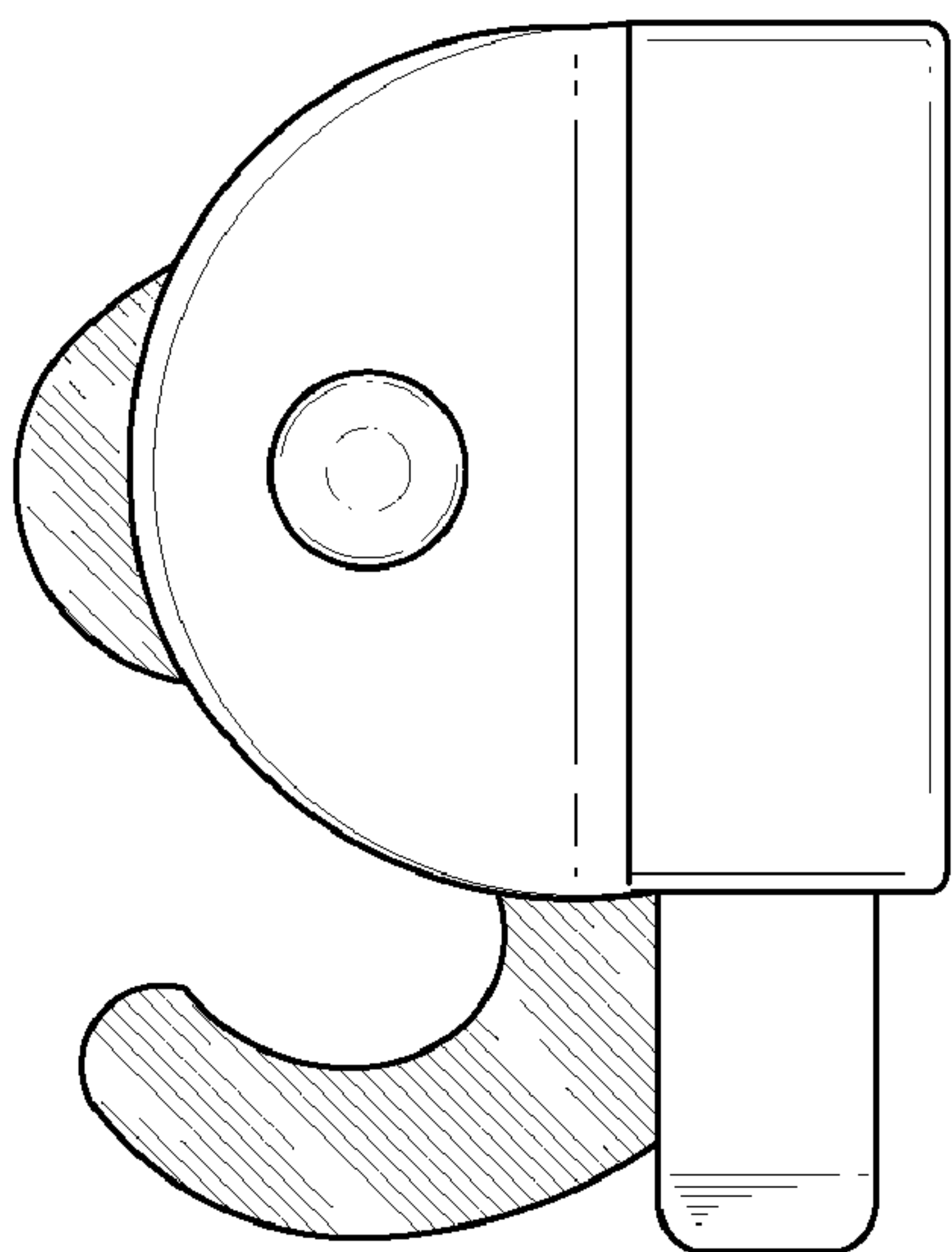

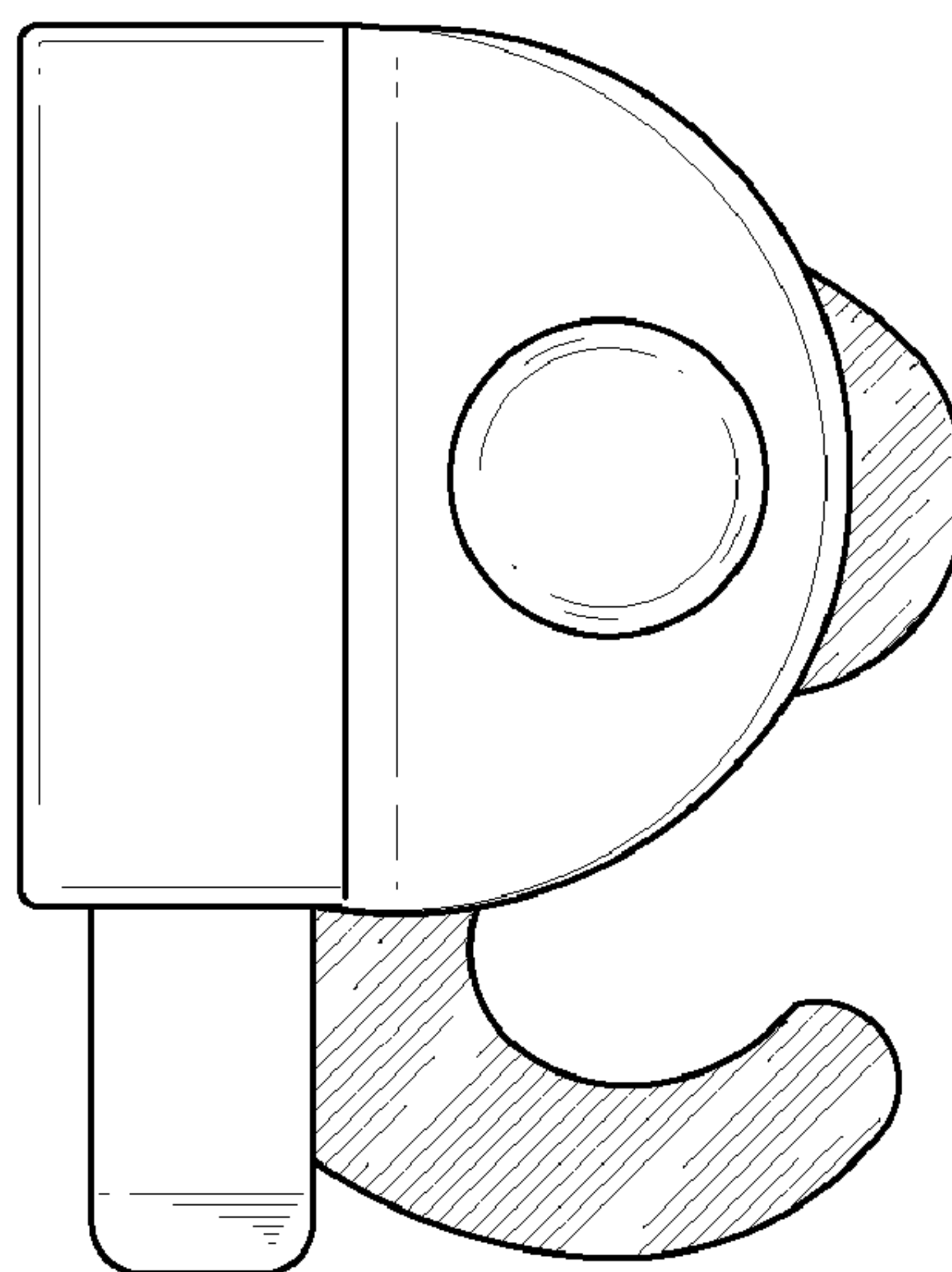

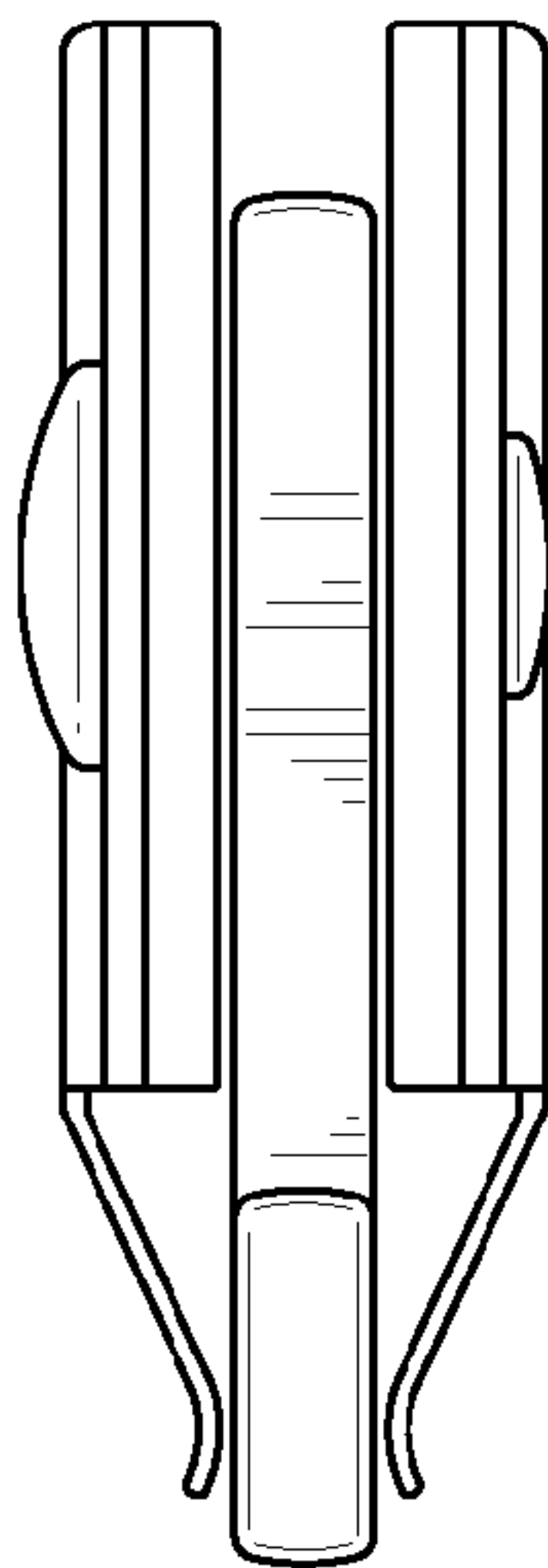

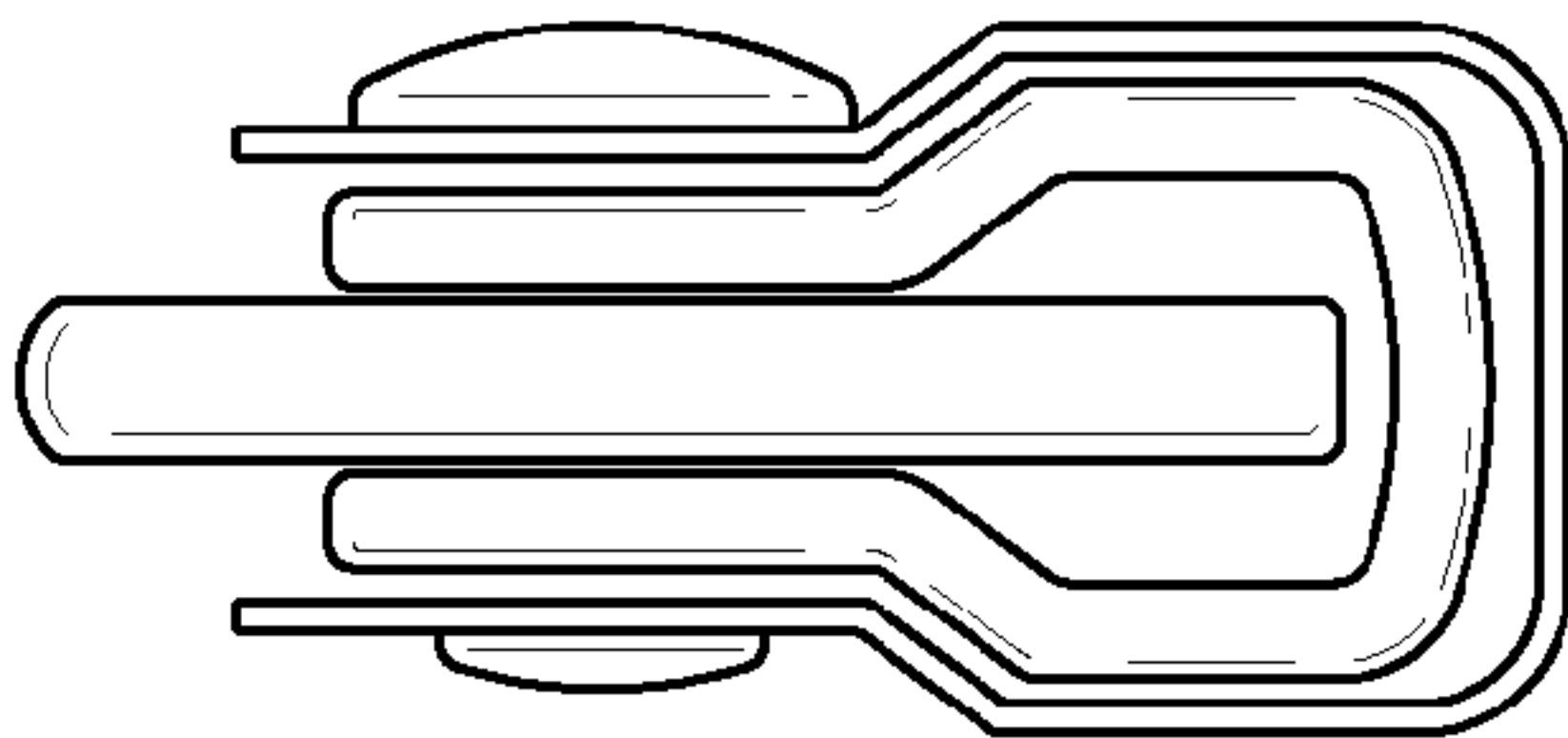

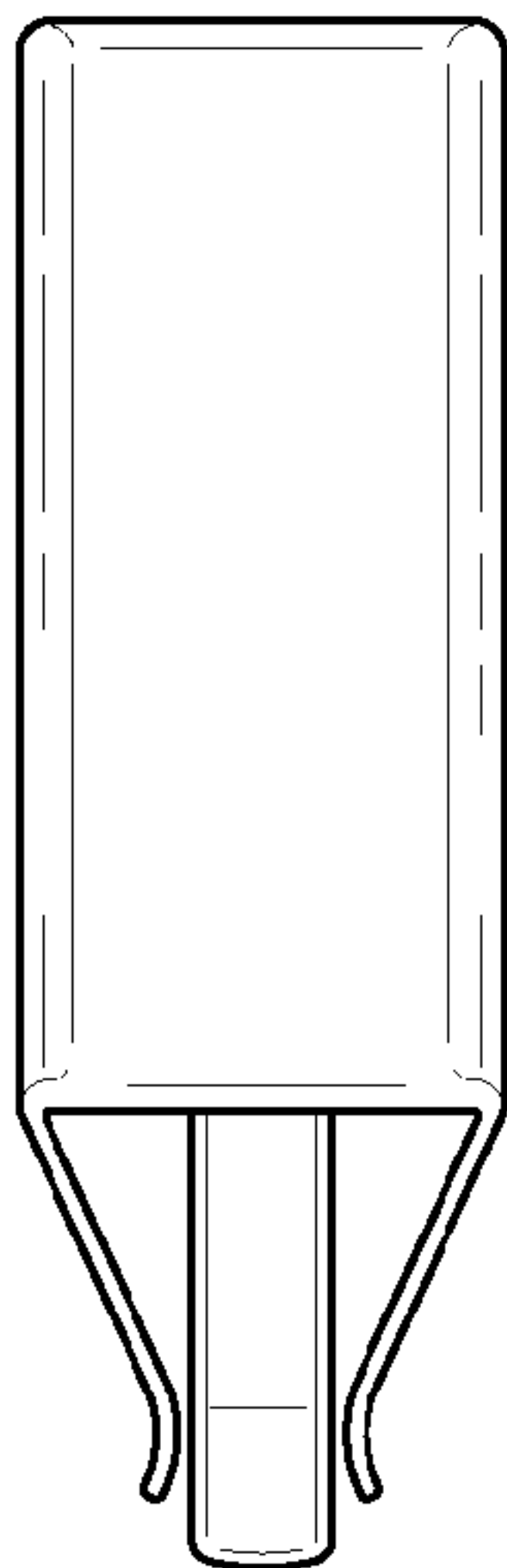

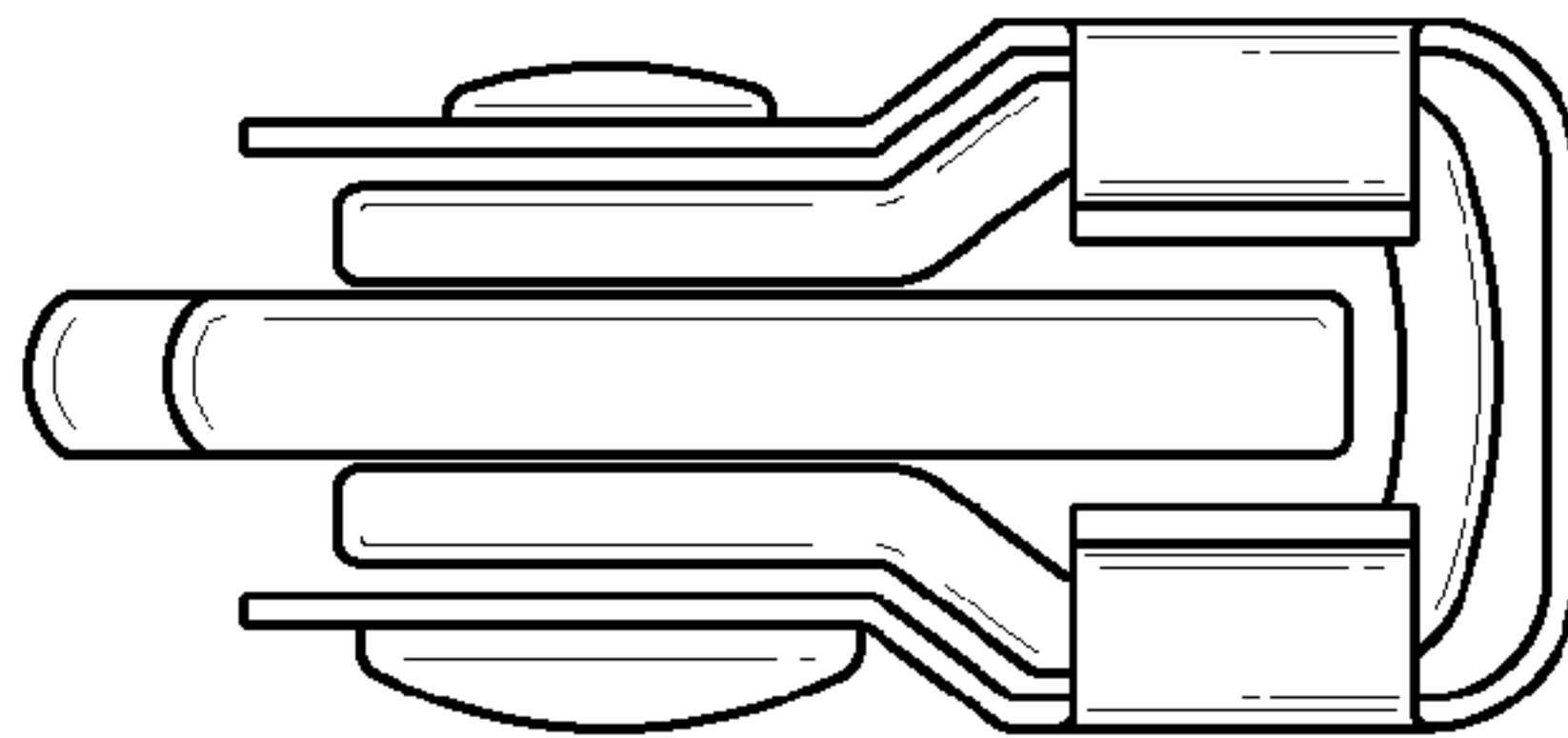

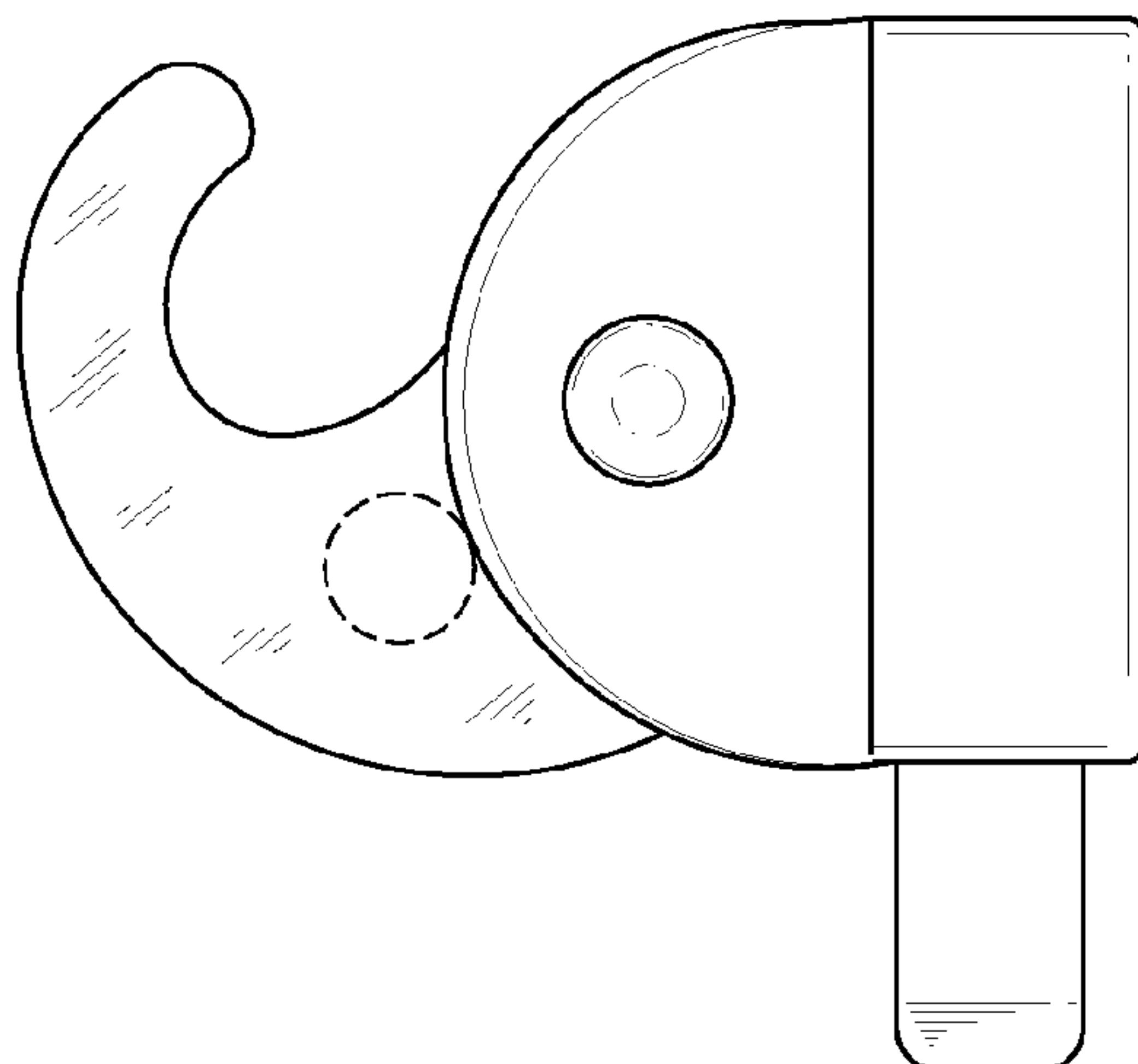

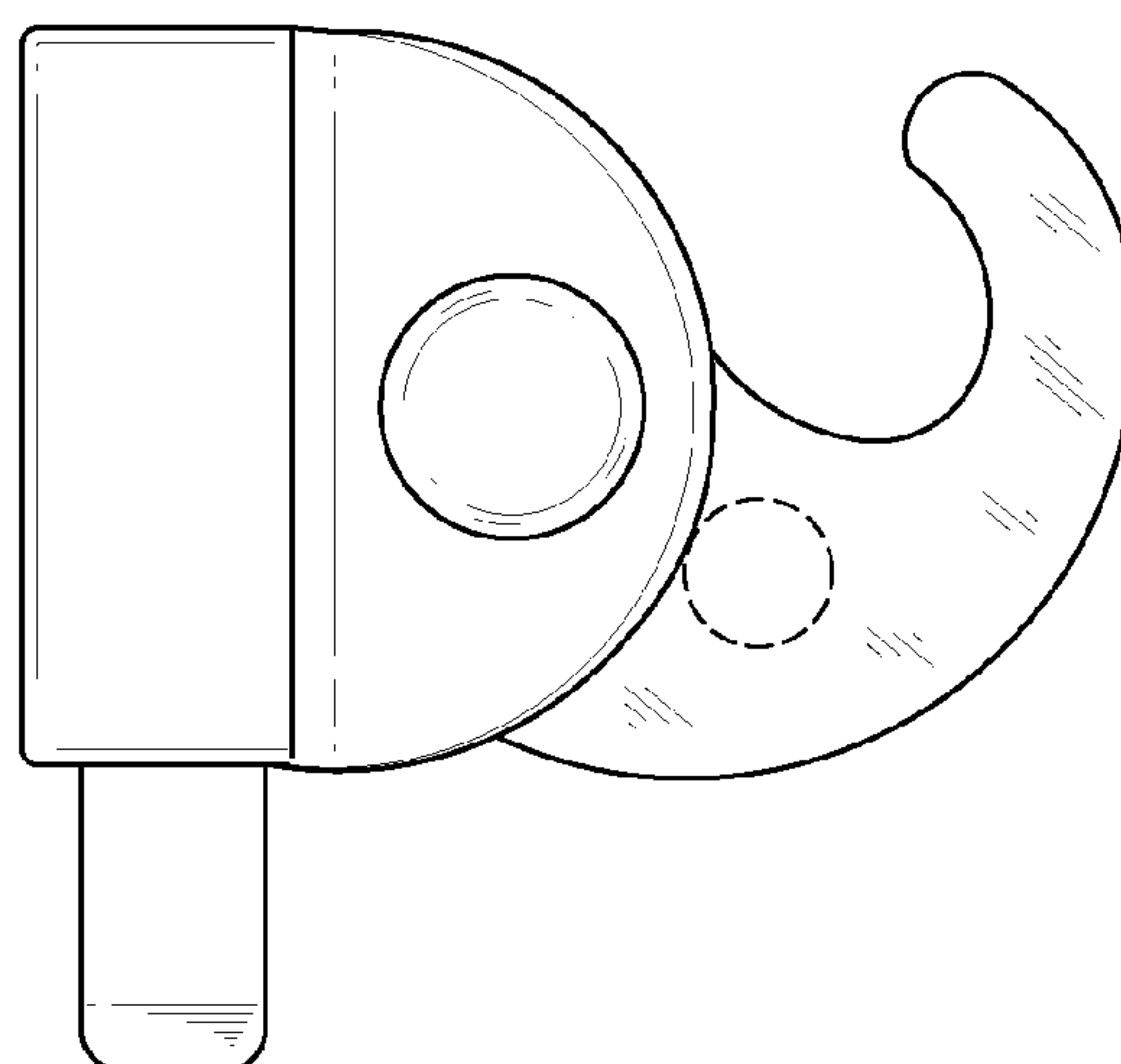
