DESCRIPTION

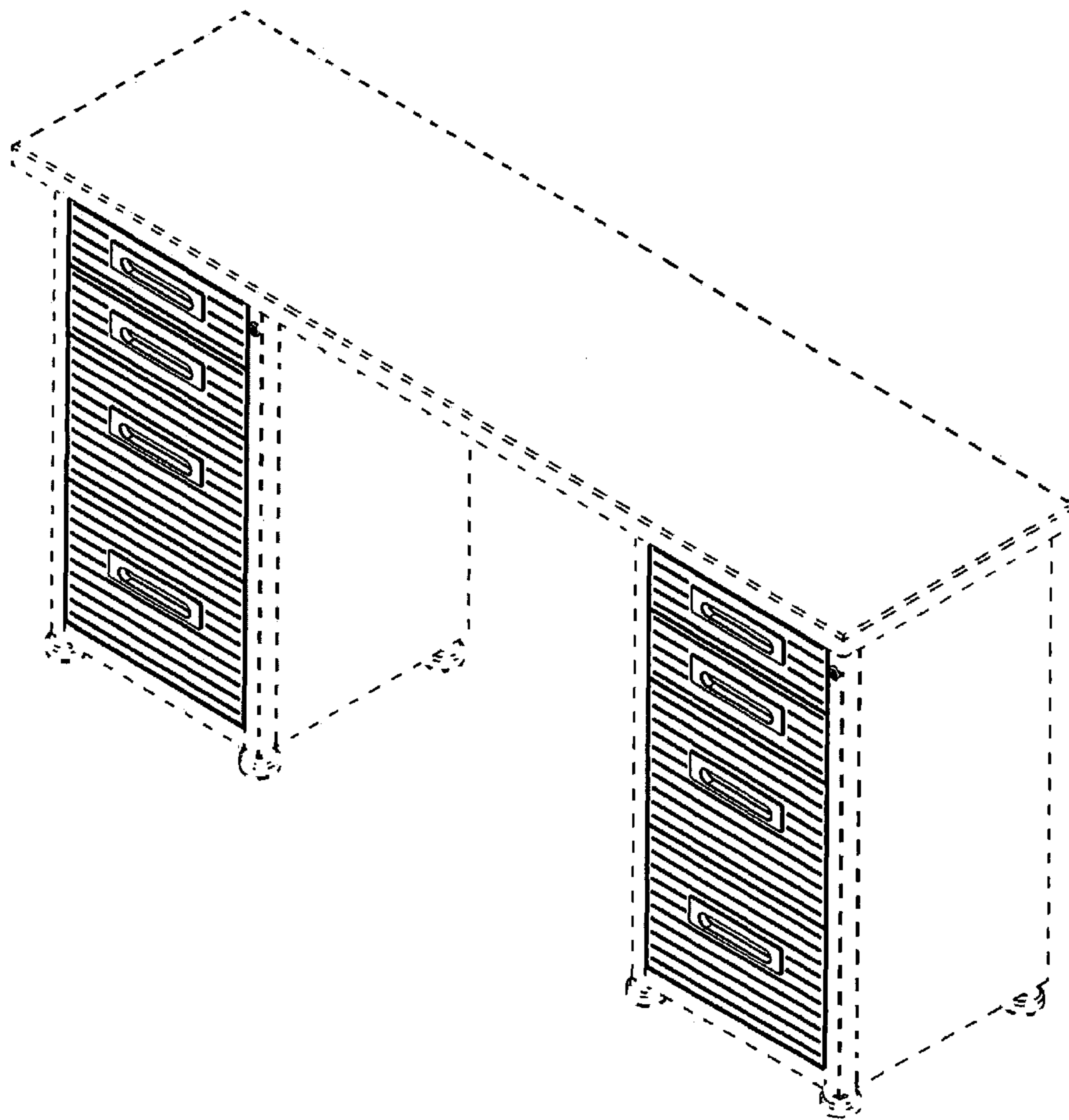
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a workcenter showing my new design;

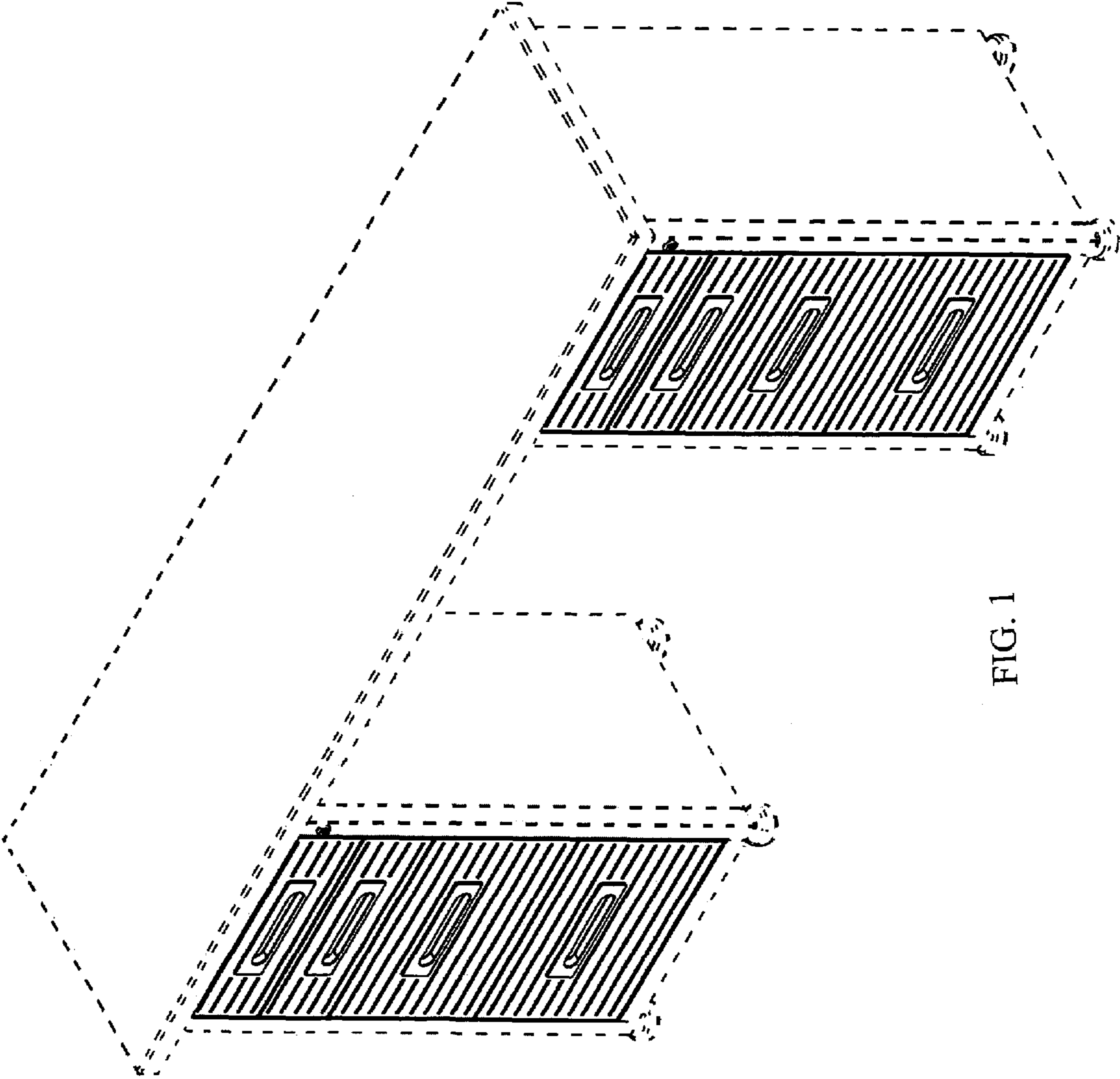

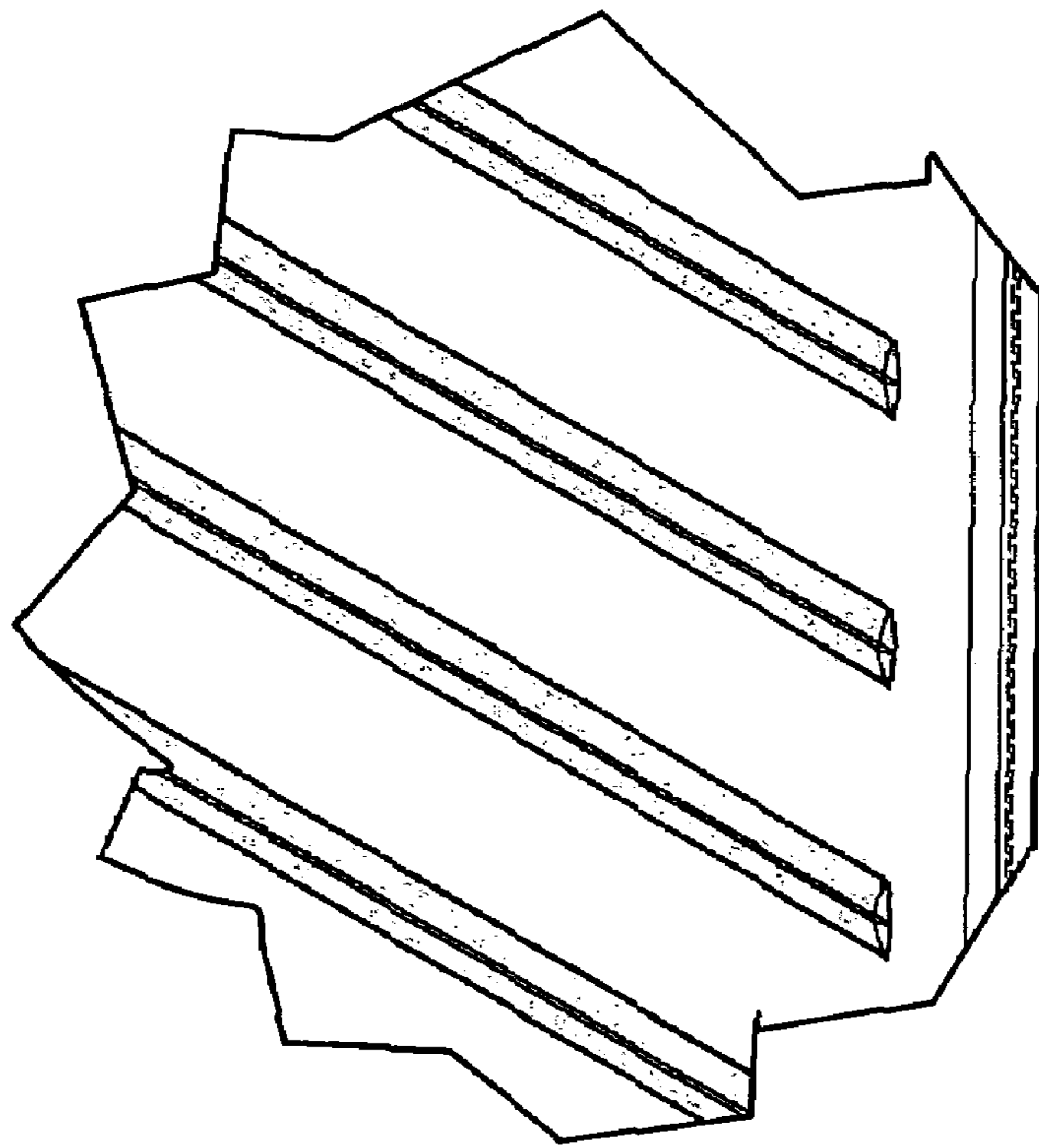

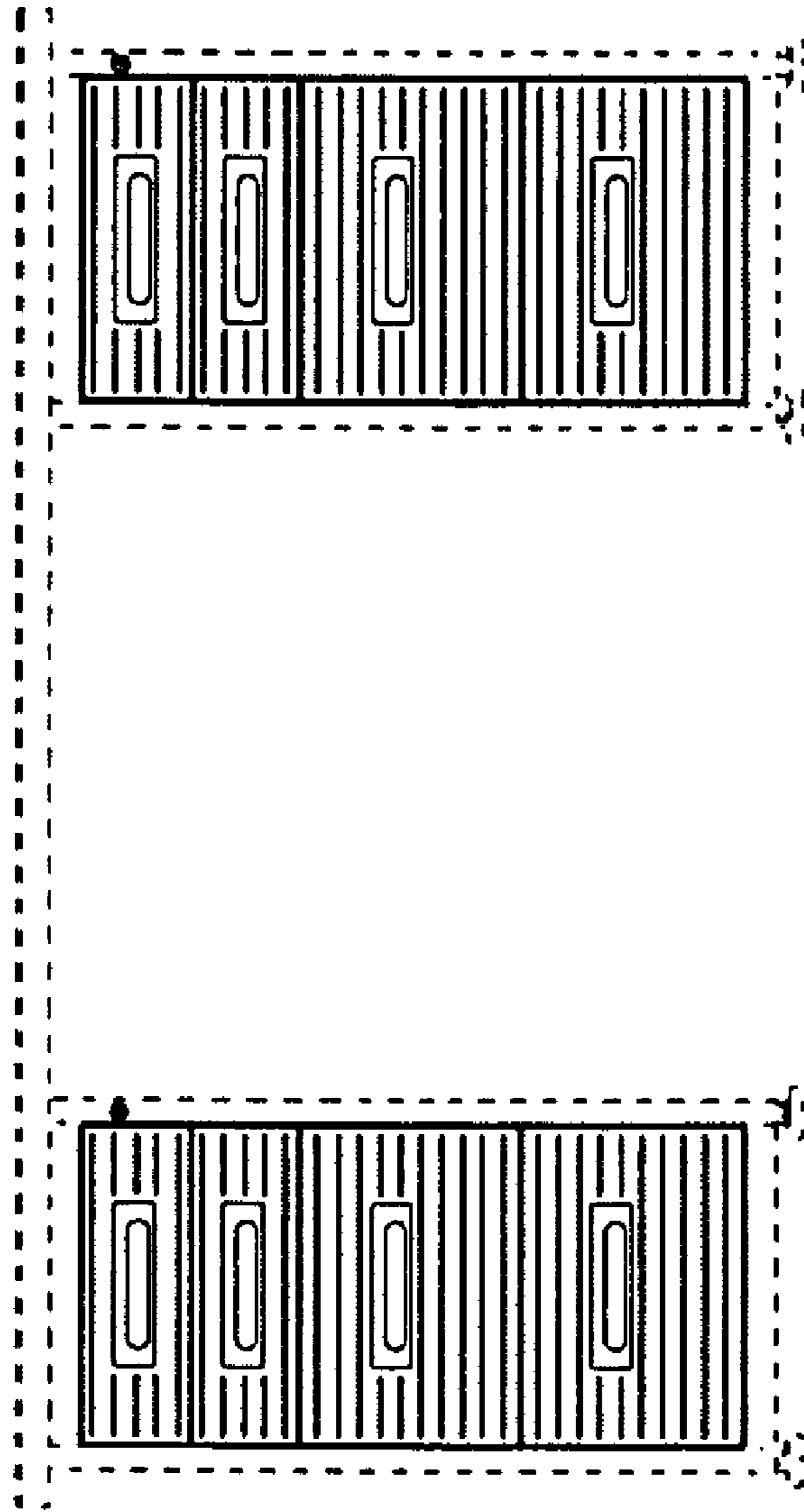
