claimed design.

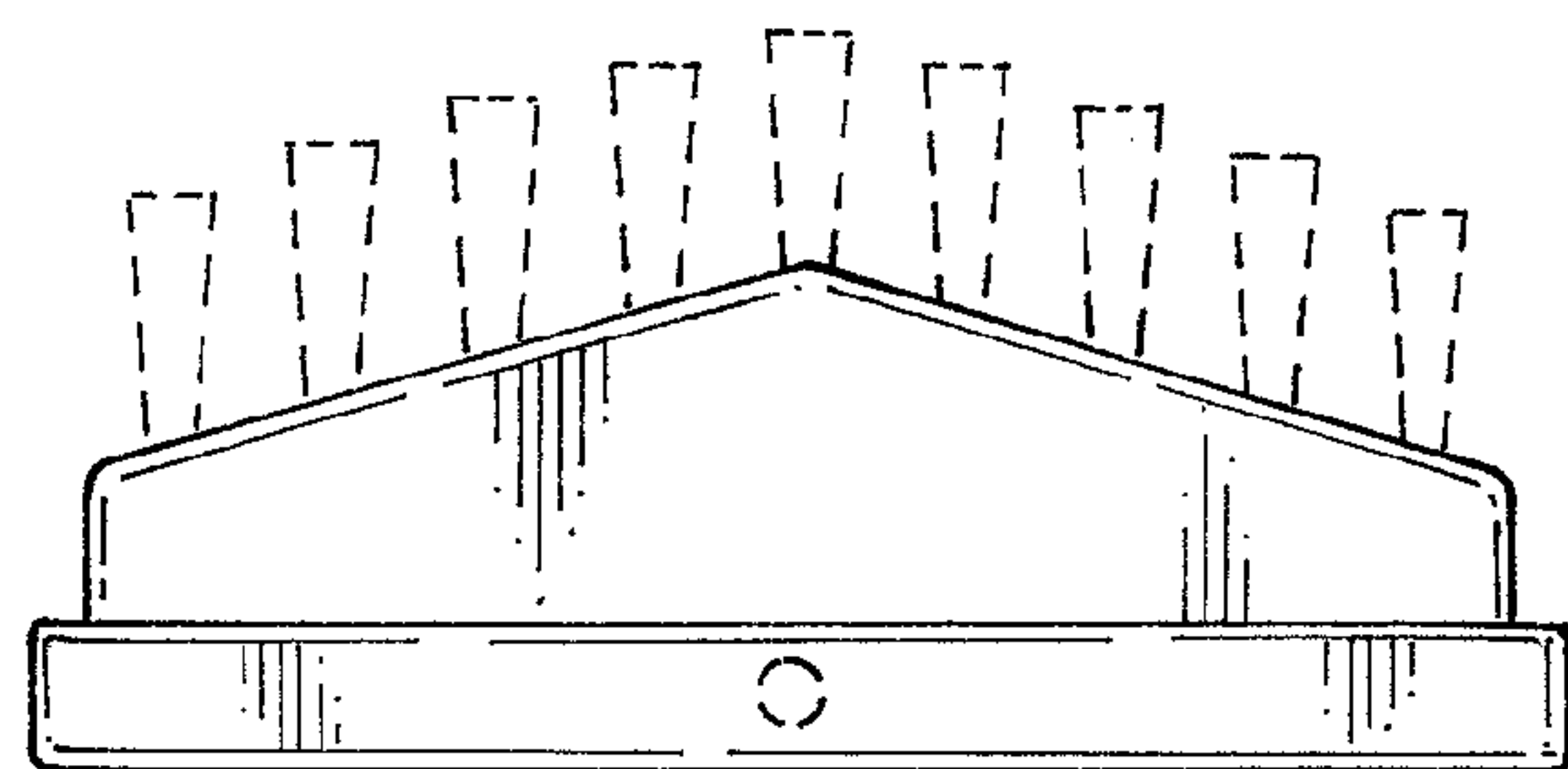
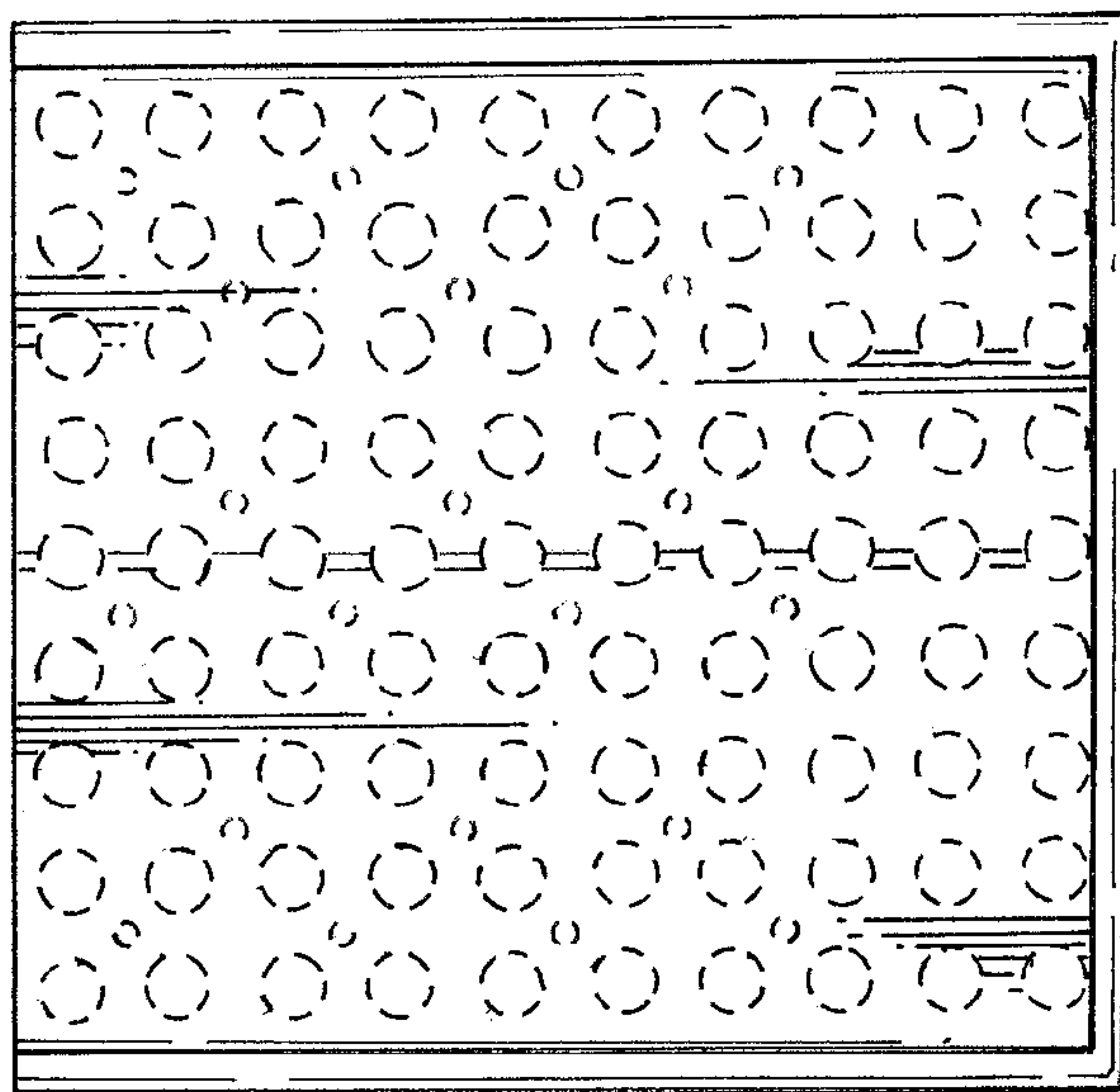

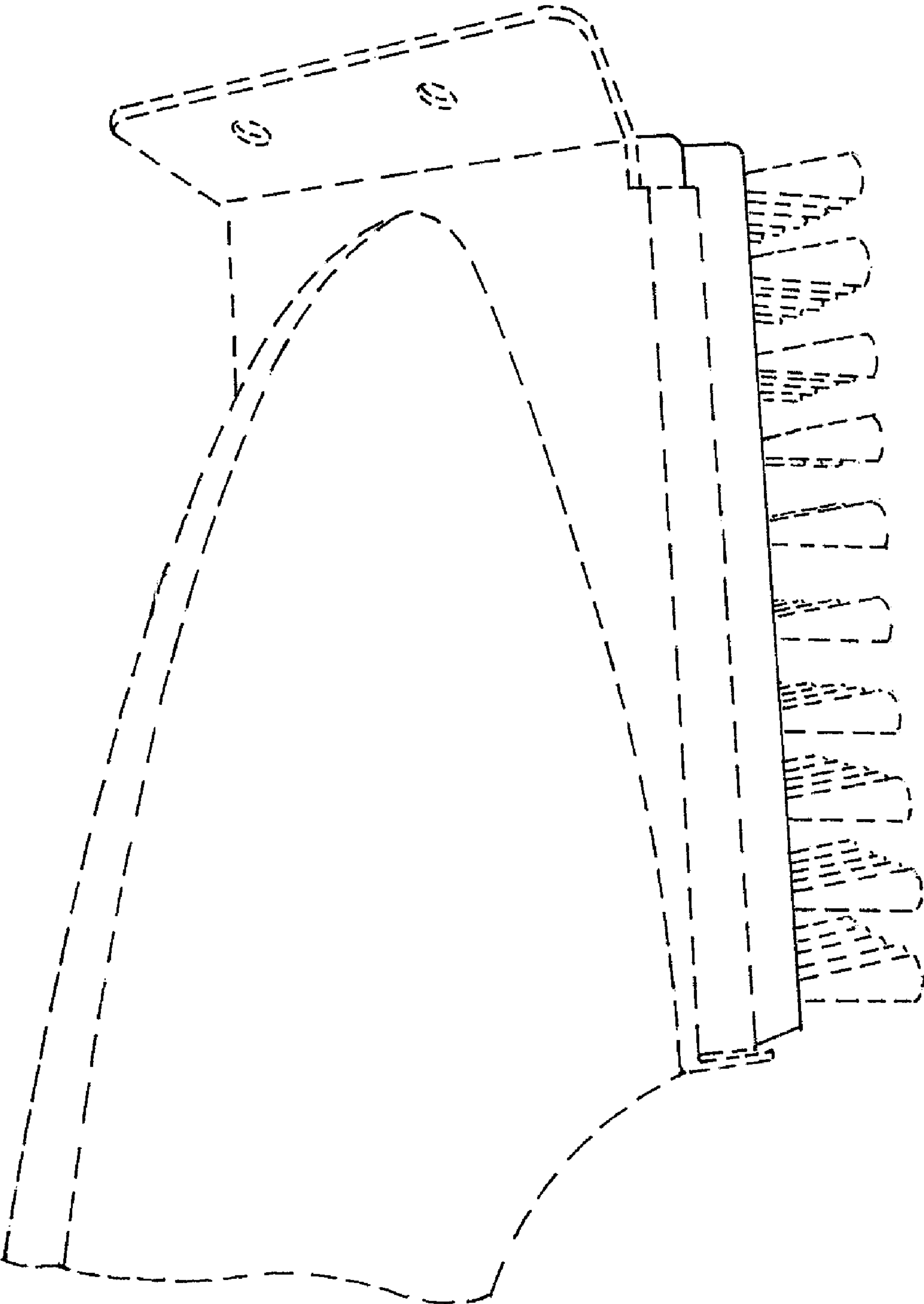
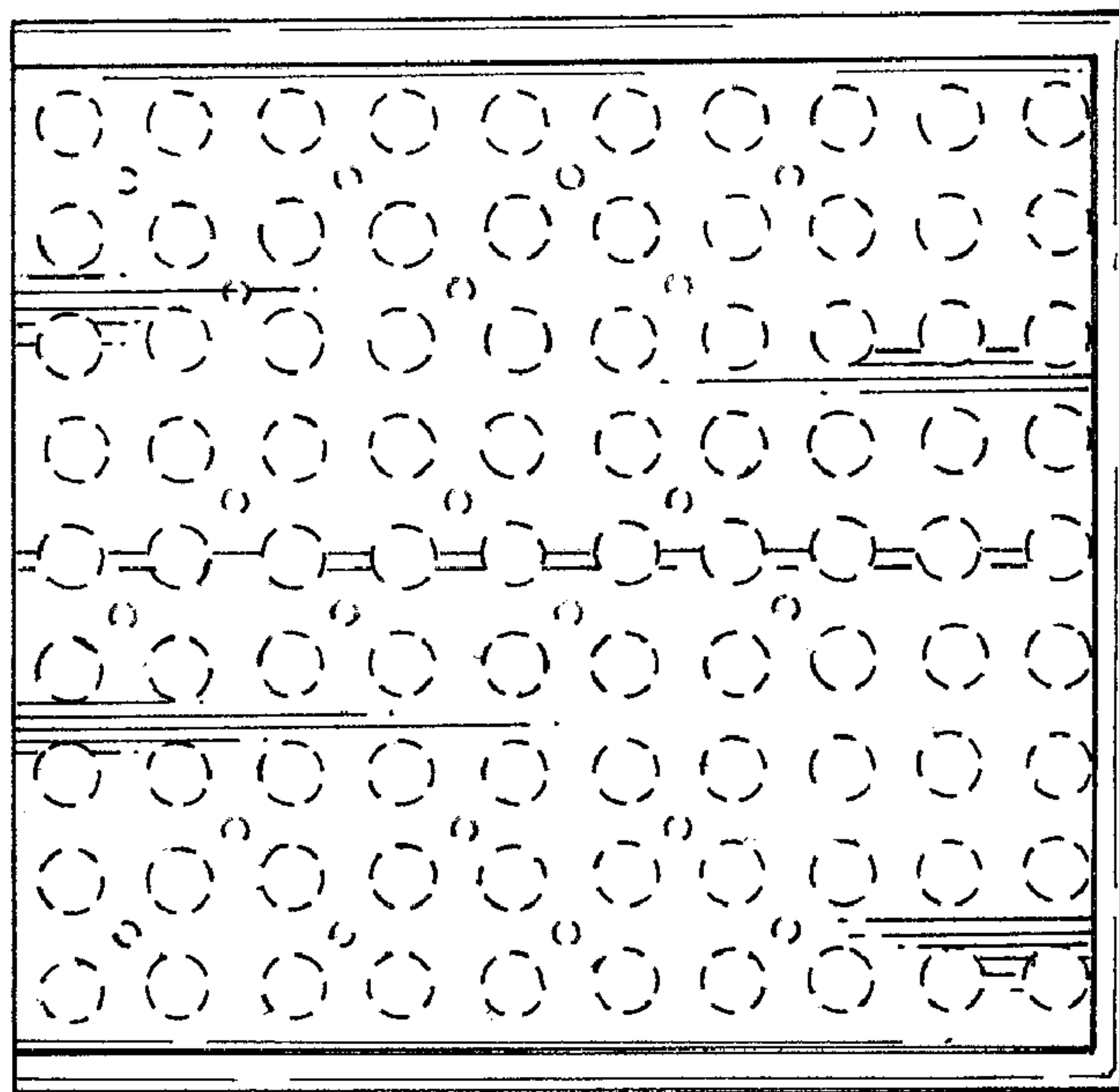
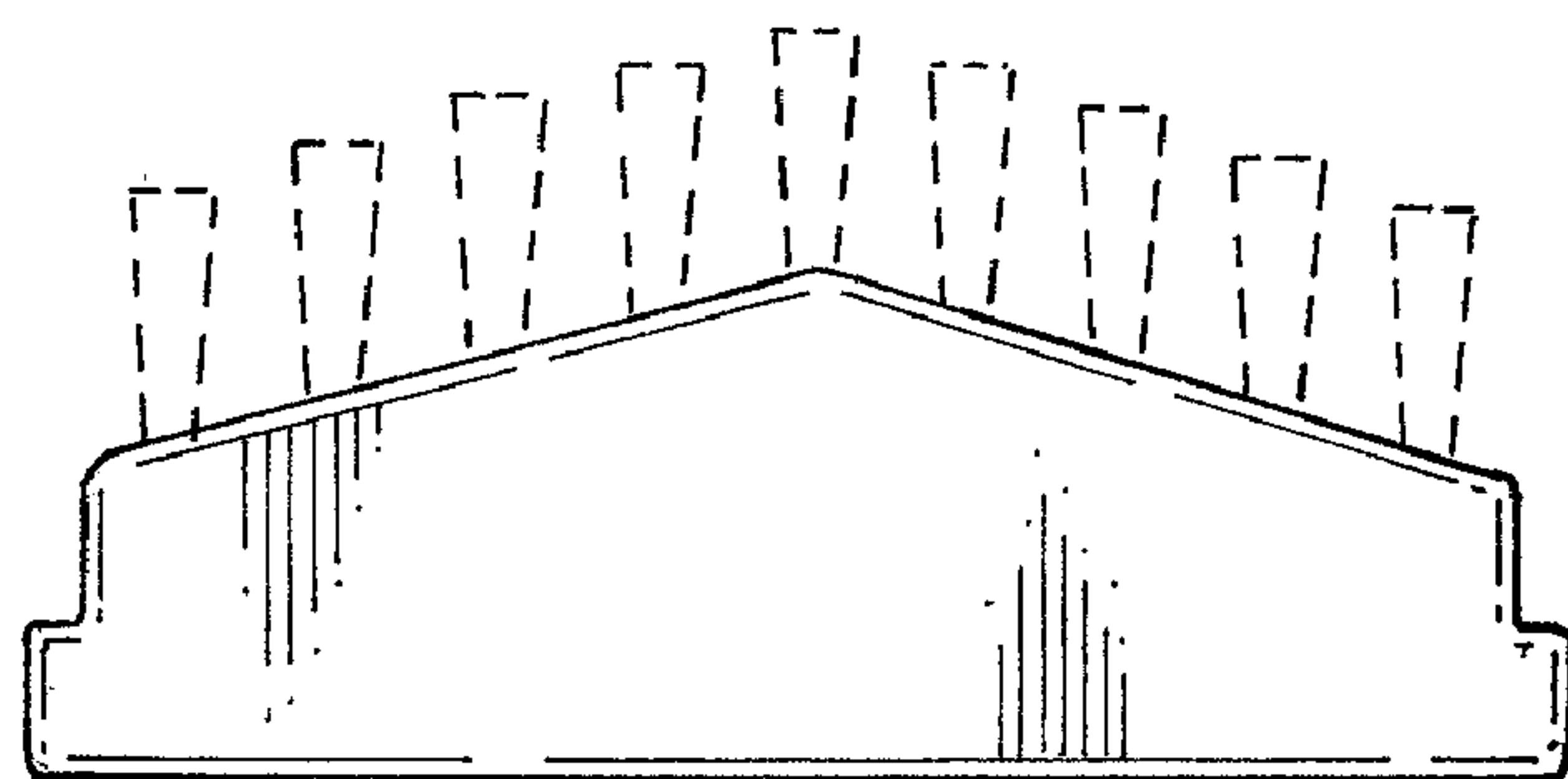


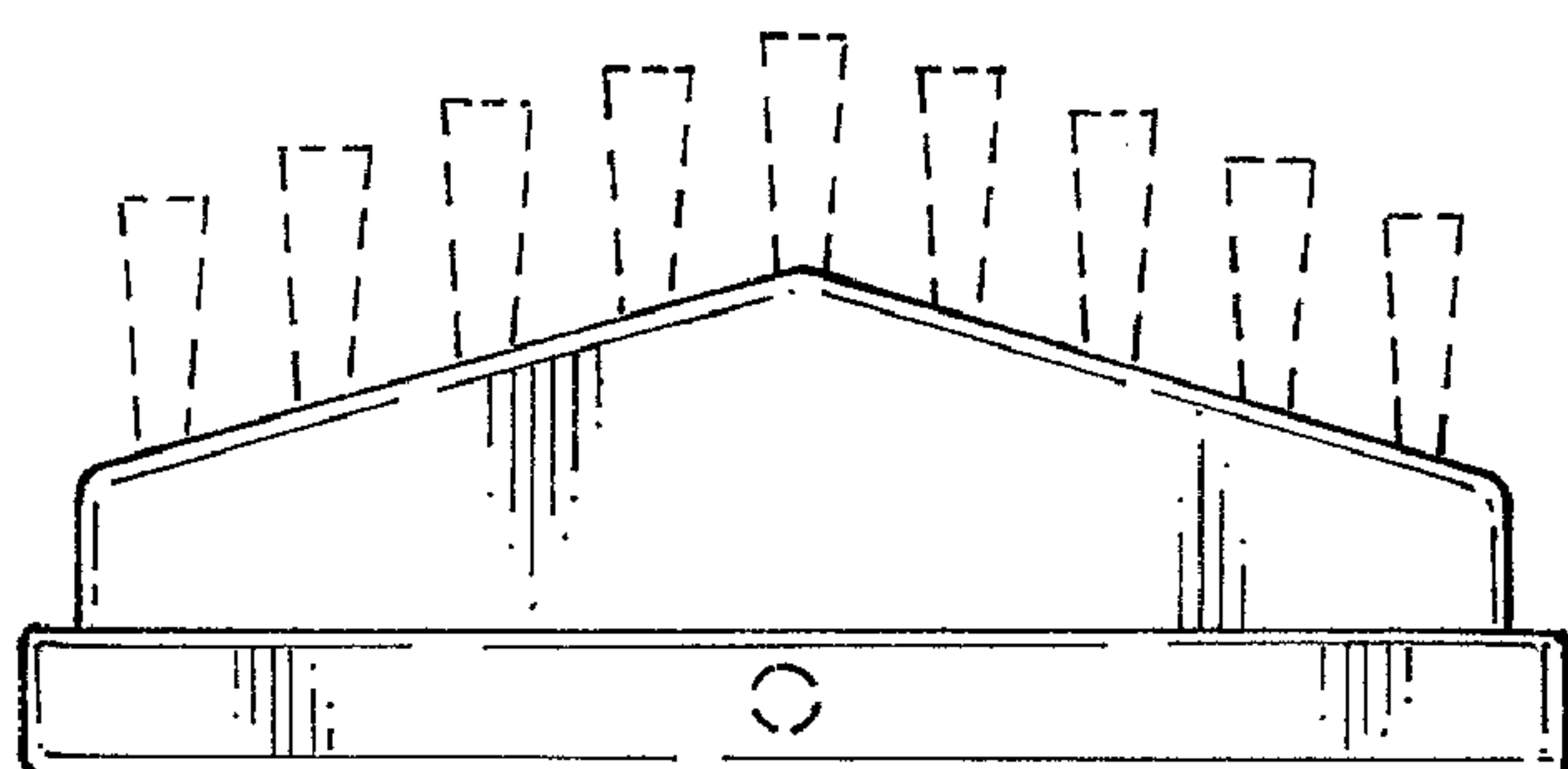

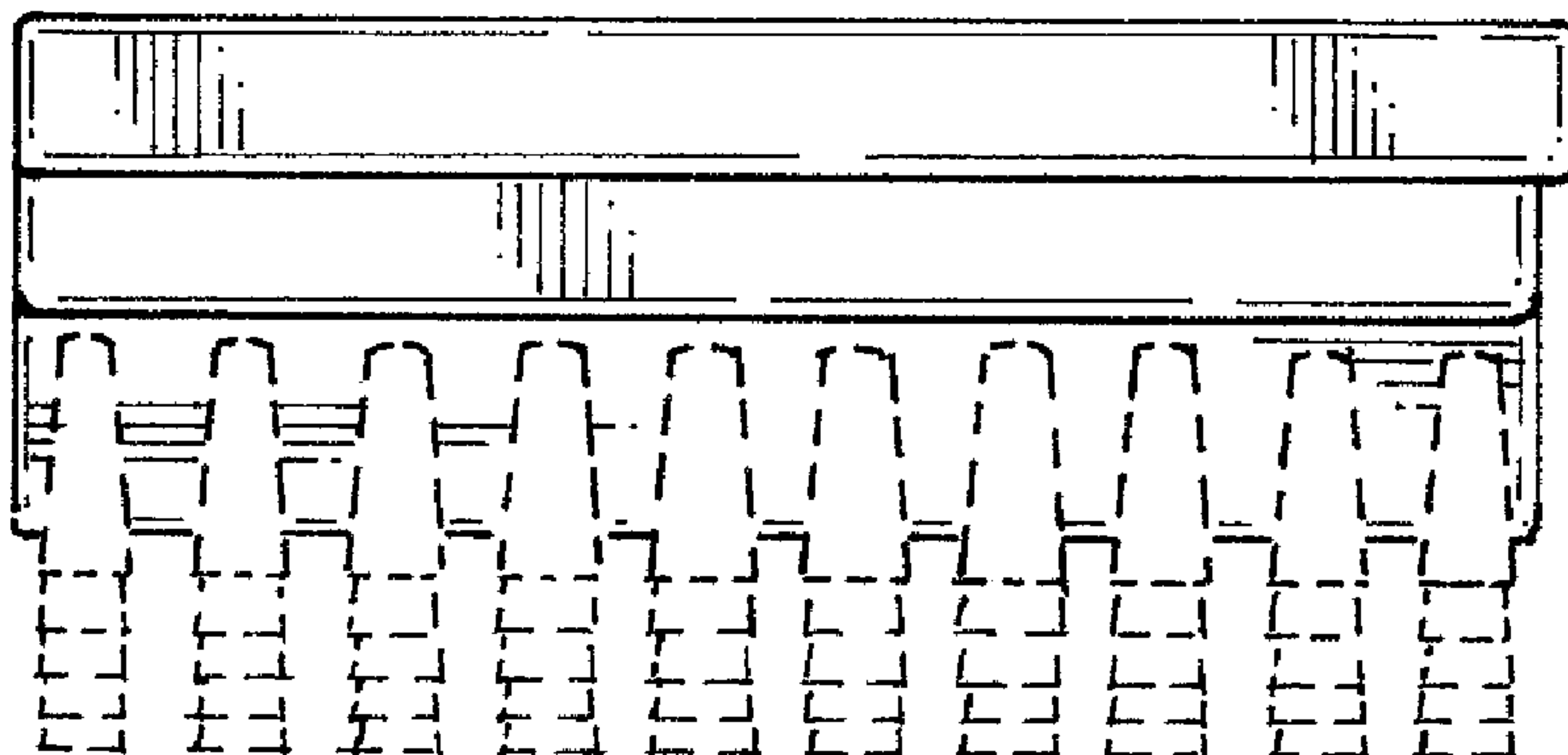

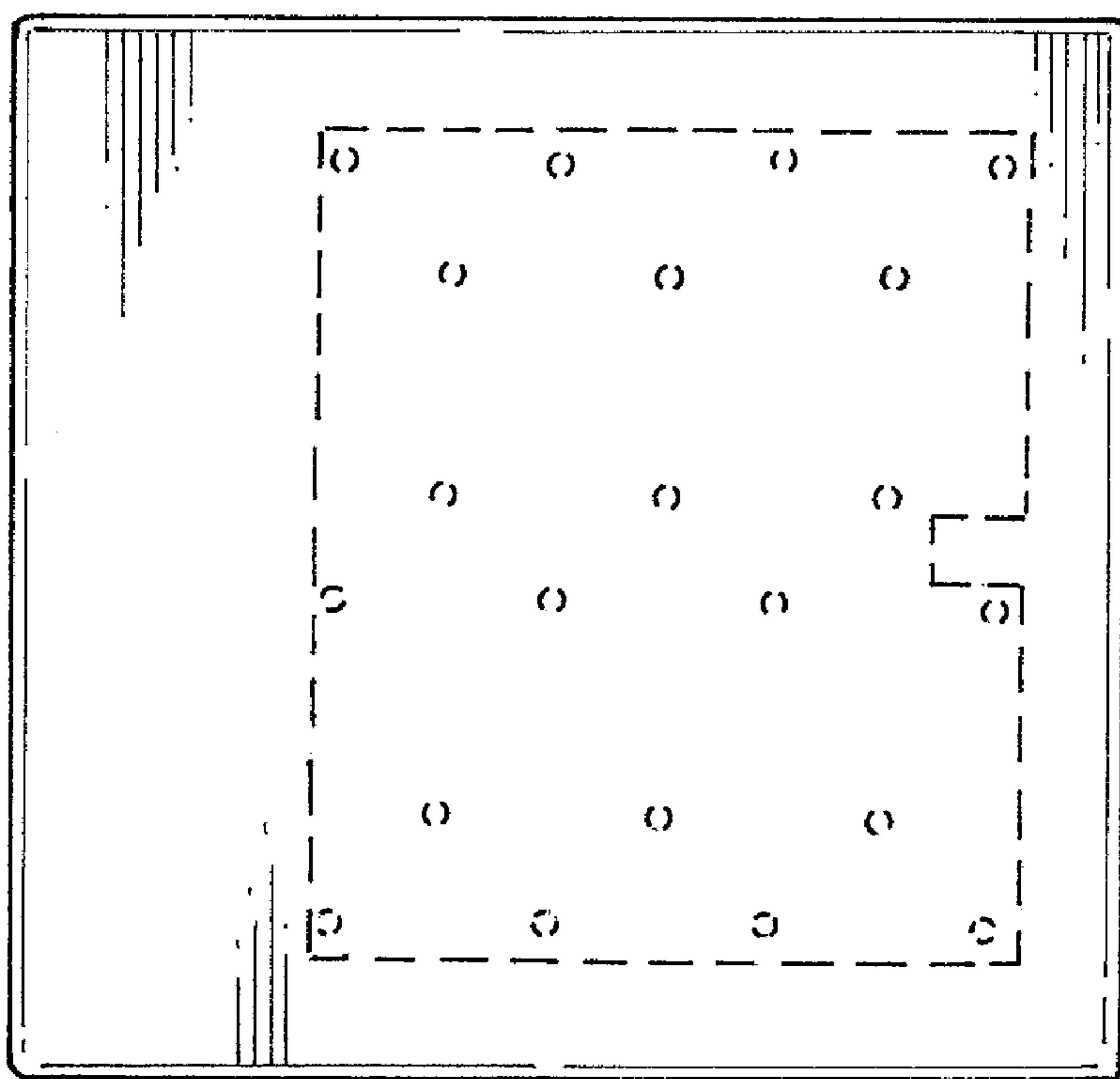
