(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an adjustable tab divider, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, left side perspective view of a first embodiment of the adjustable tab divider;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the embodiment of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the embodiment of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the embodiment of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the embodiment of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view of the embodiment of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view of the embodiment of FIG. 1;

FIG. 8 is a top, front, left side perspective view of a second embodiment of the adjustable tab divider;

FIG. 9 is a front elevational view of the embodiment of FIG. 8;

FIG. 10 is a rear elevational view of the embodiment of FIG. 8;

FIG. 11 is a top plan view of the embodiment of FIG. 8;

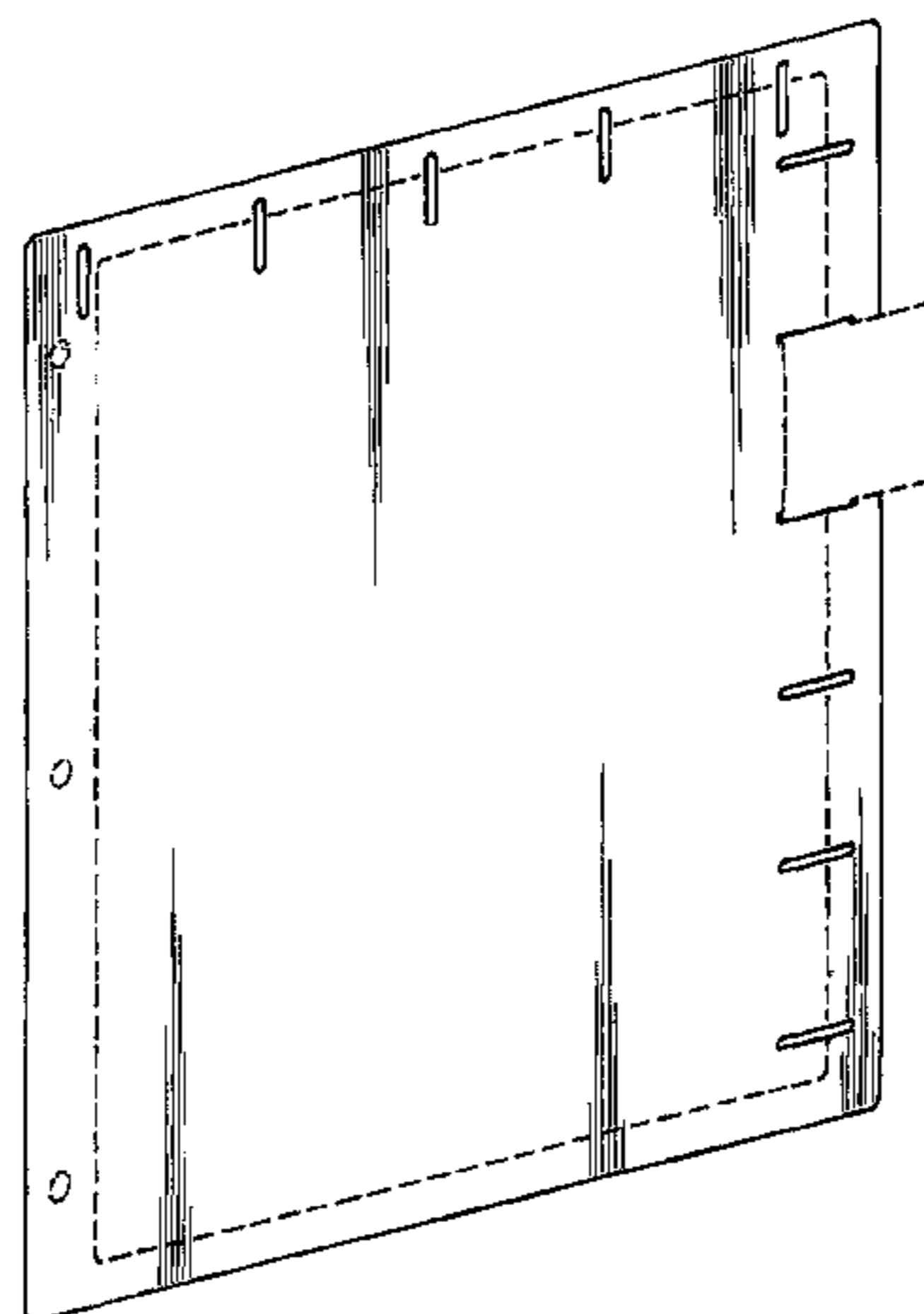
FIG. 12 is a bottom plan view of the embodiment of FIG. 8;

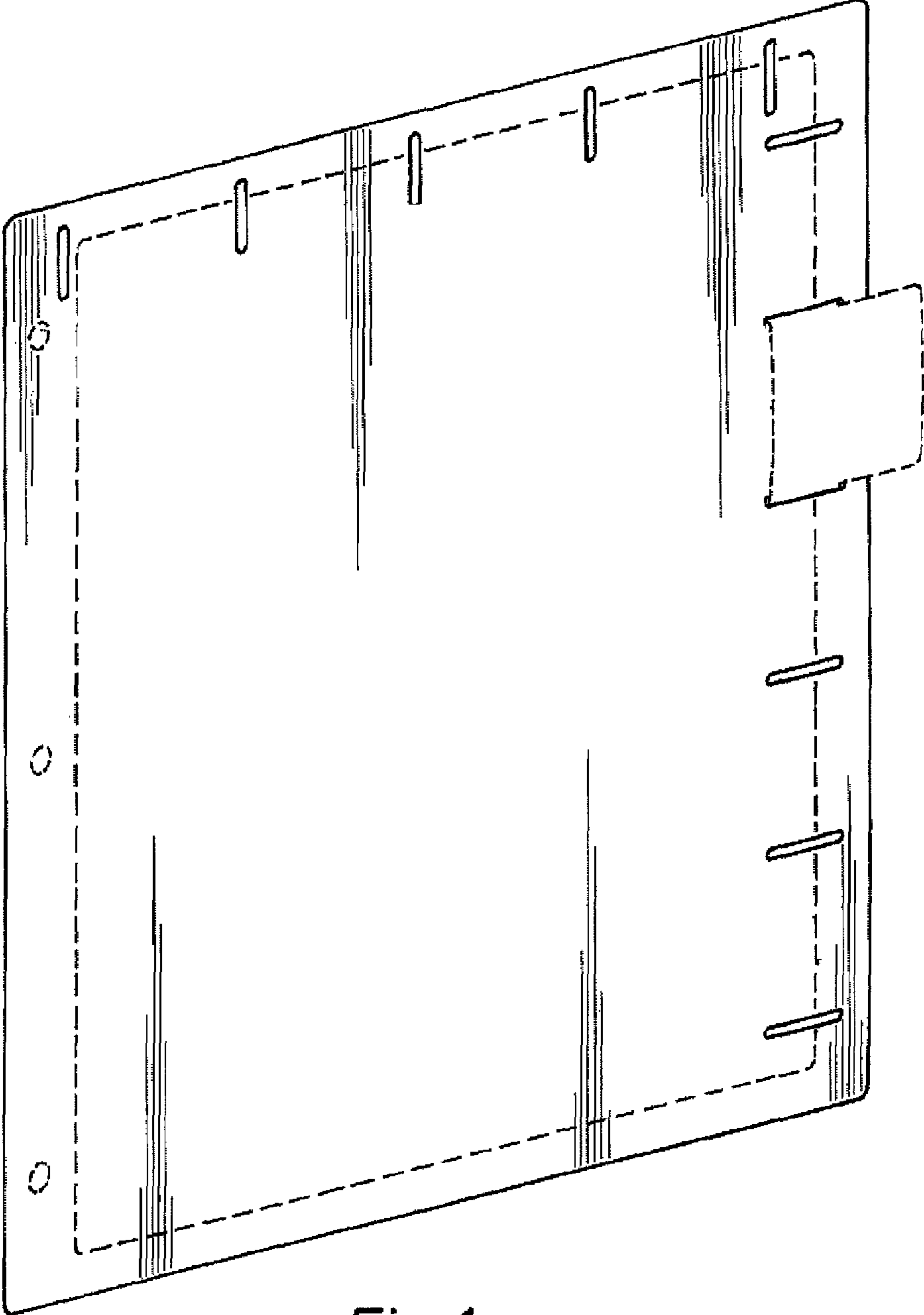

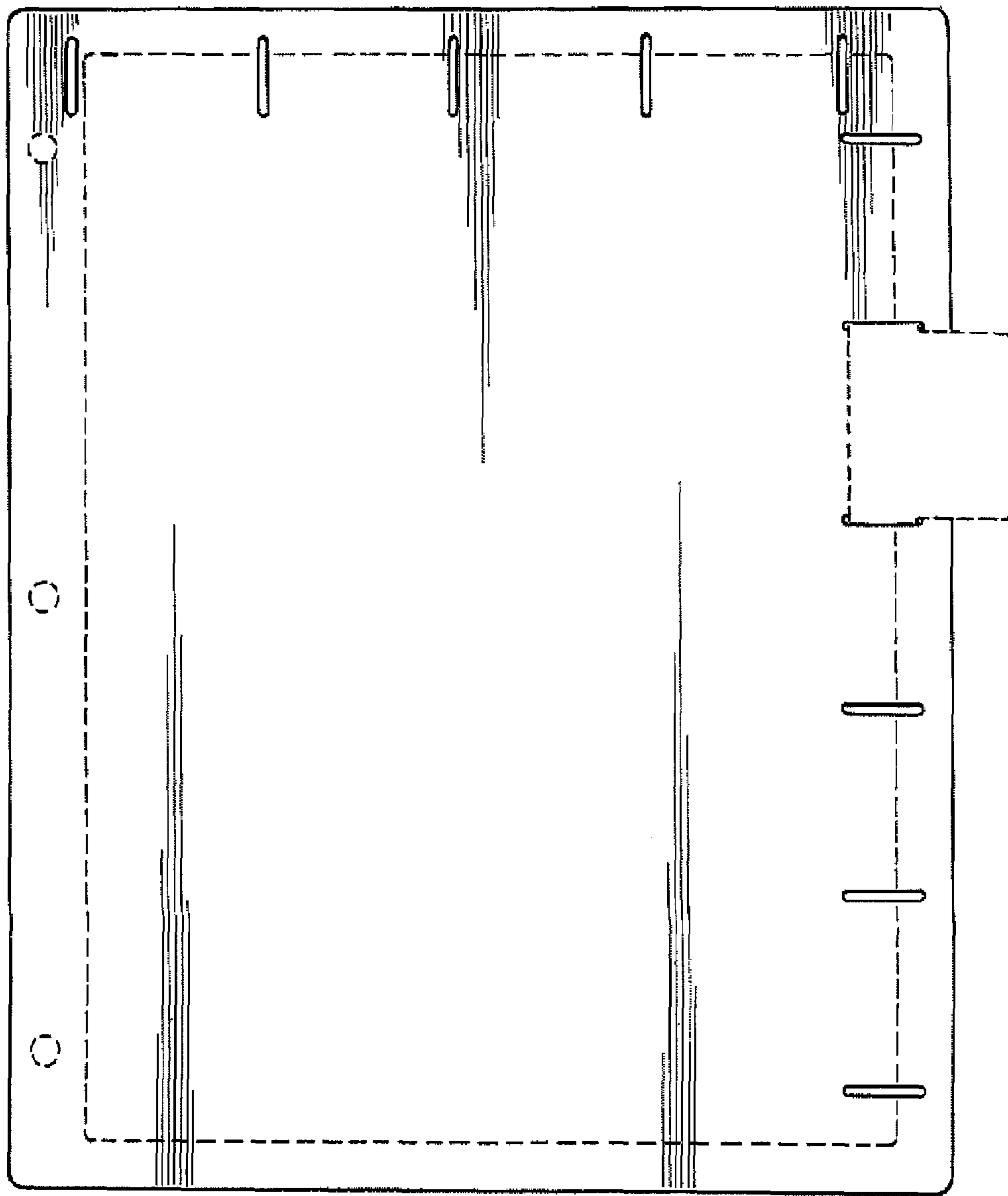

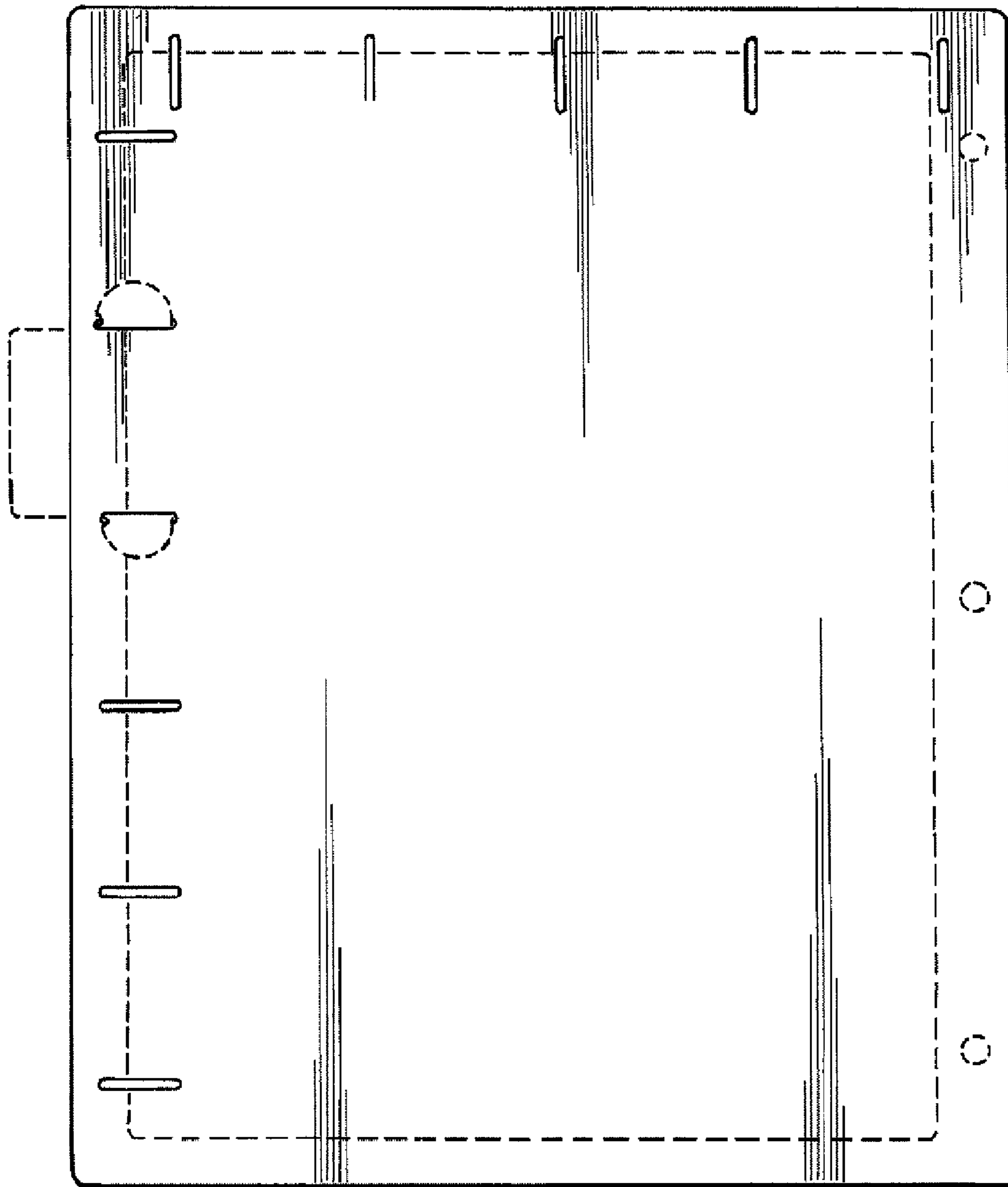

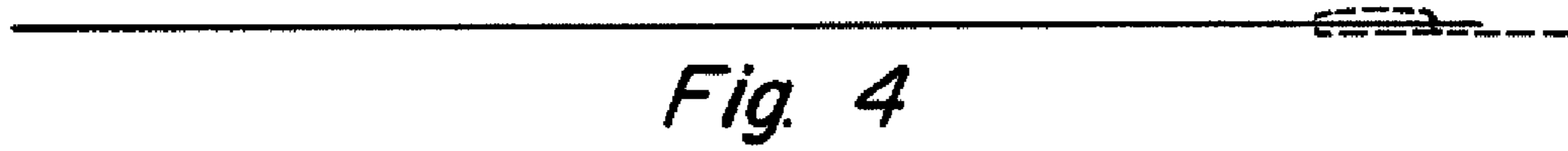

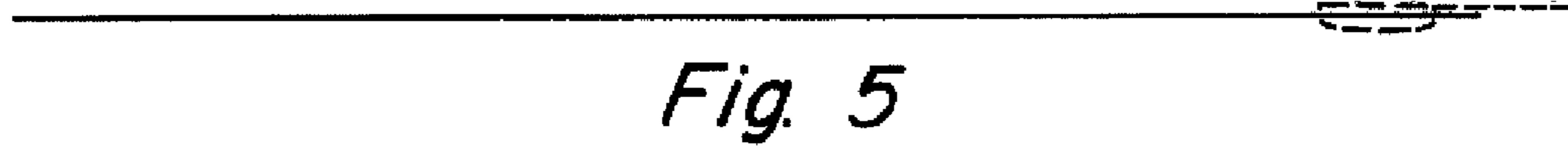

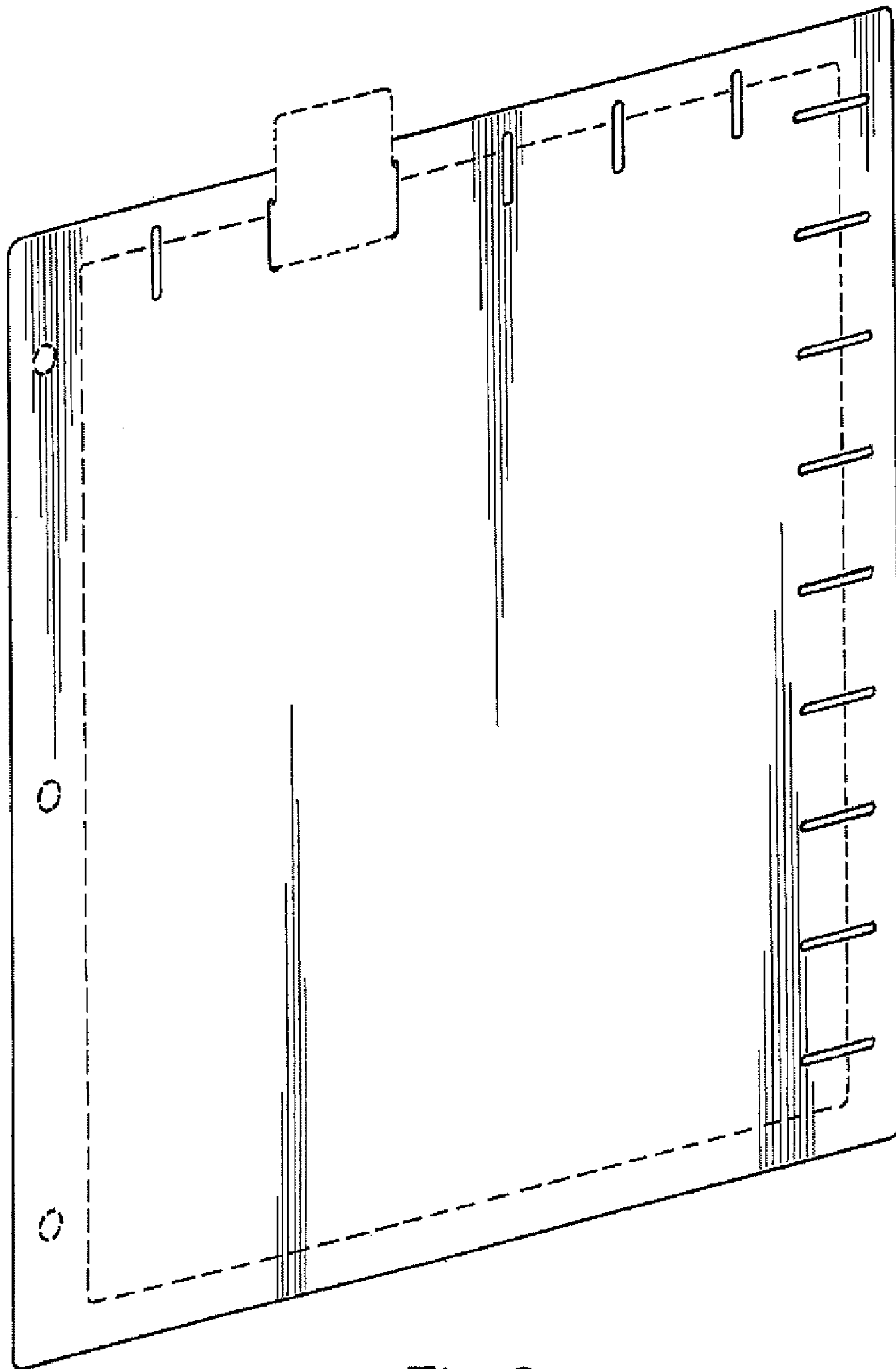

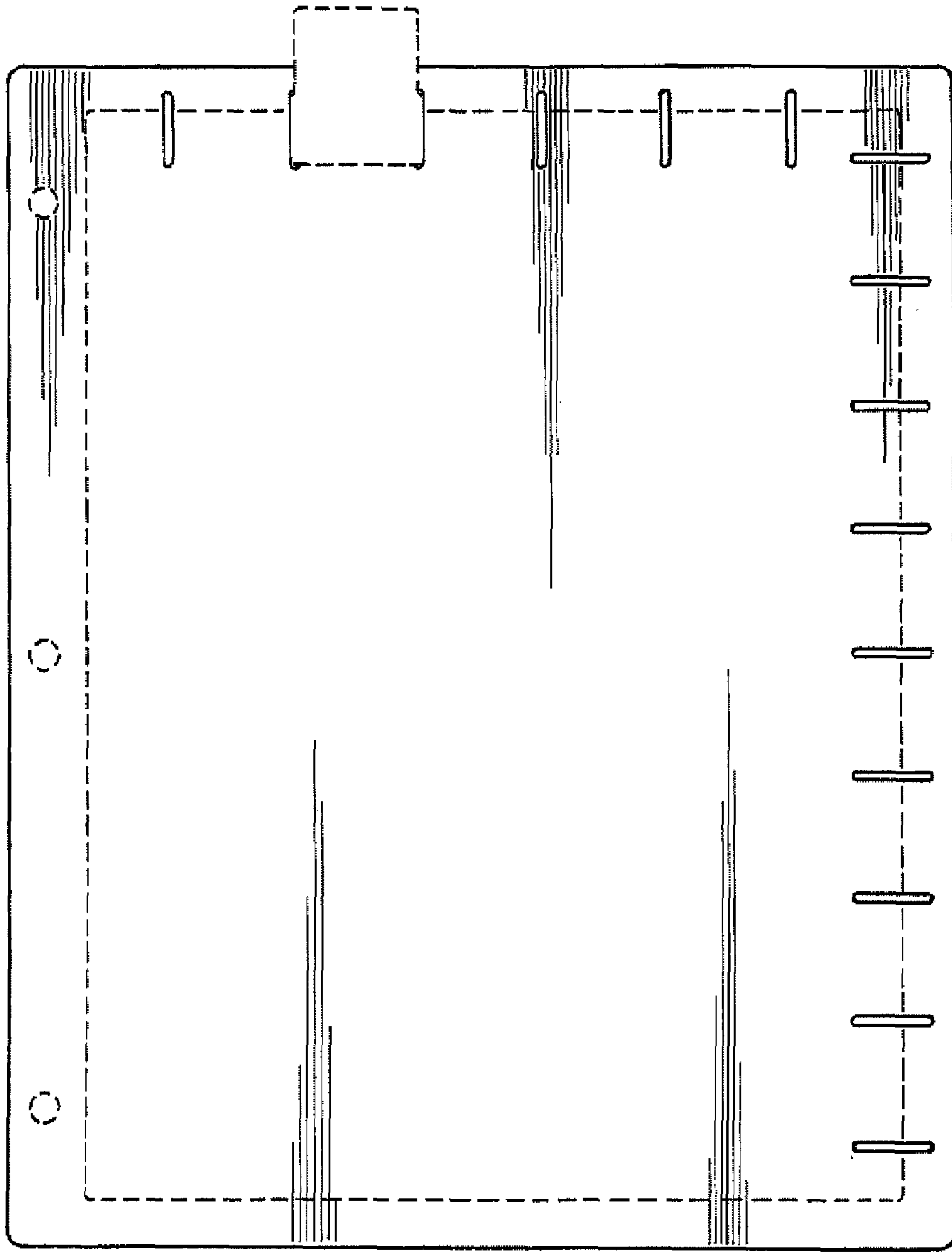

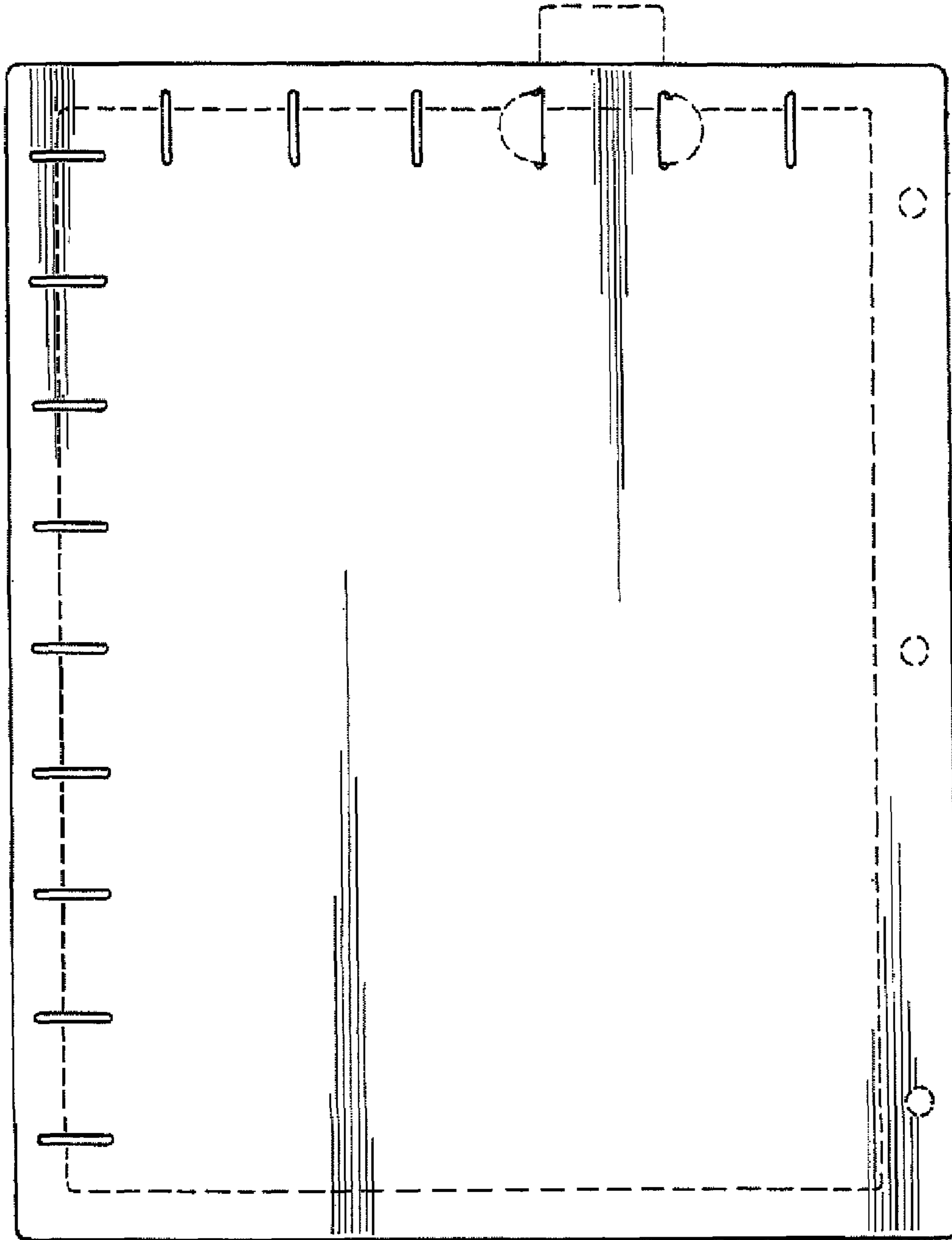

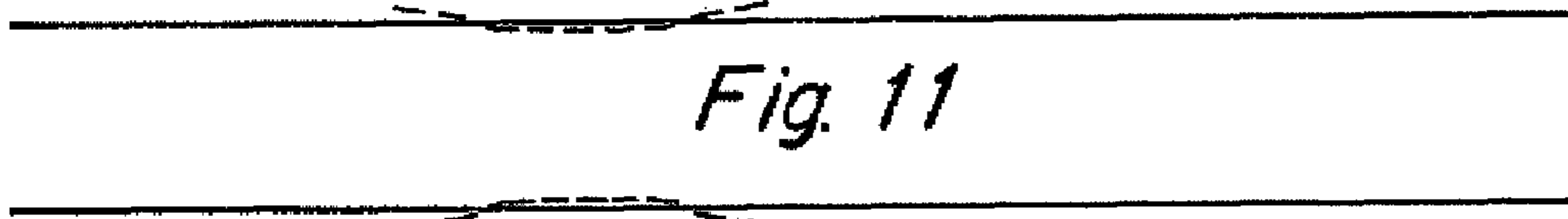
