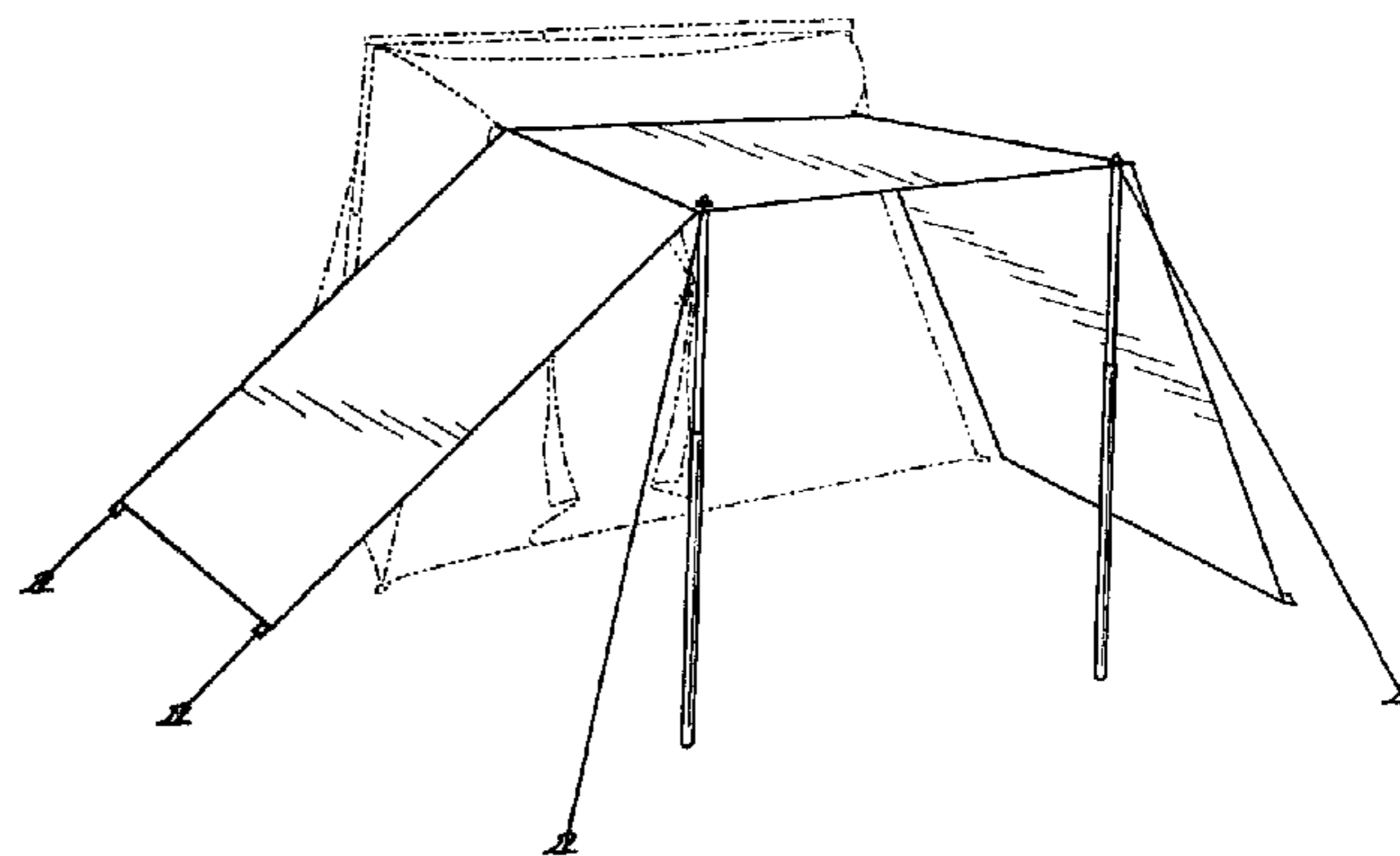
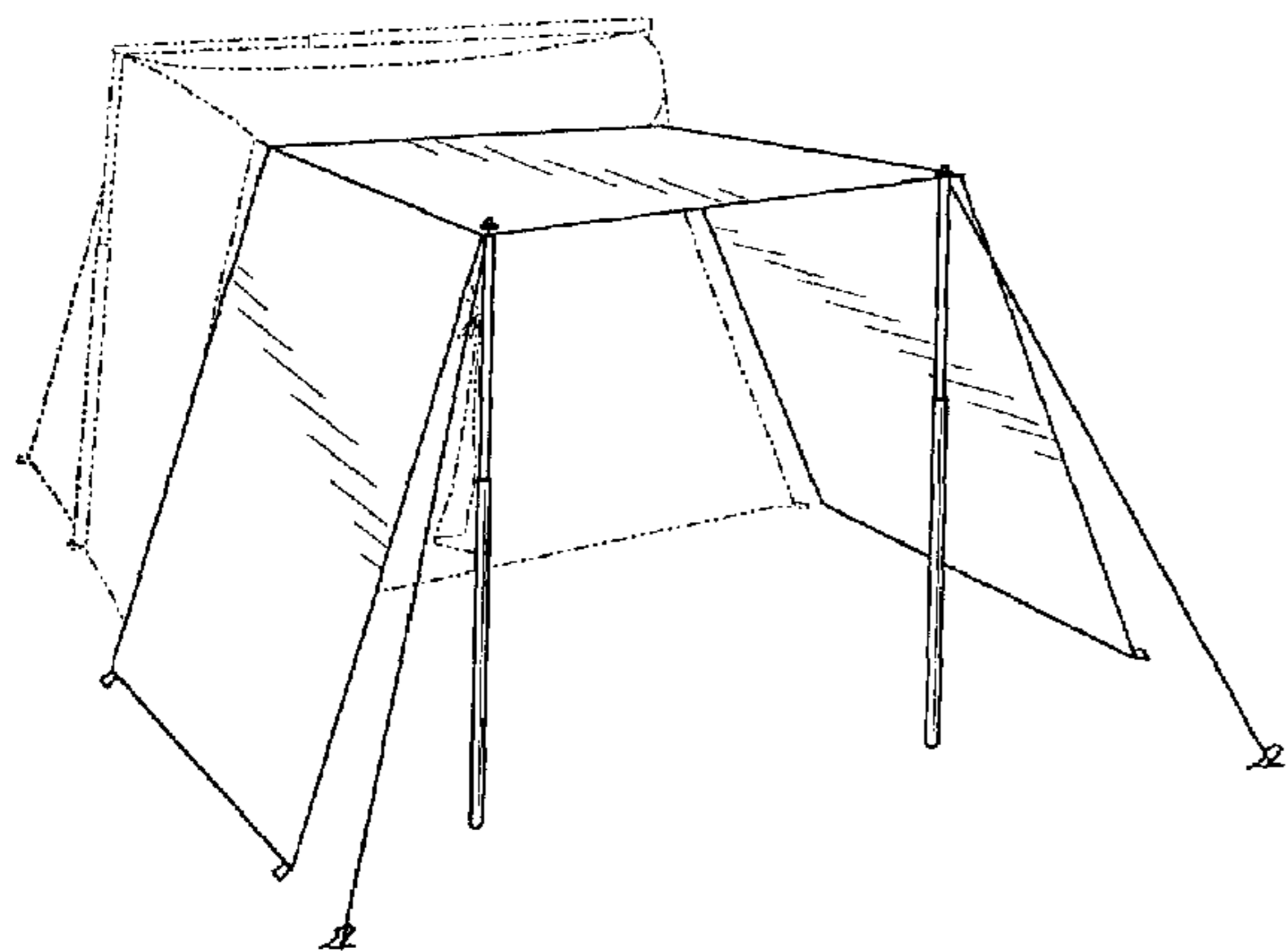
FIG. 3 illustrates a side view of the portico shade system of FIG. 1;

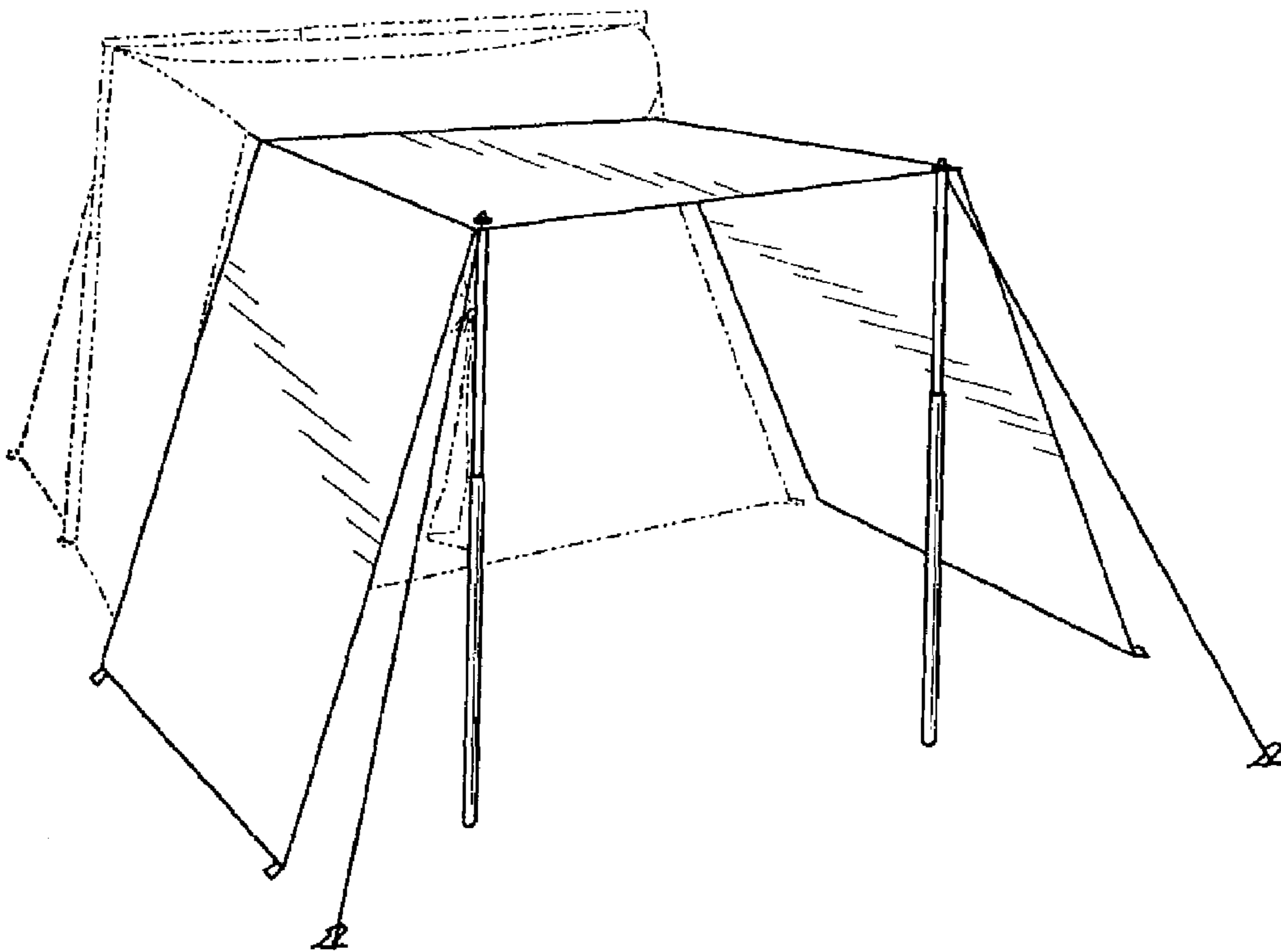
FIG. 4 illustrates a perspective rear view of the portico shade system of FIG. 1; and,

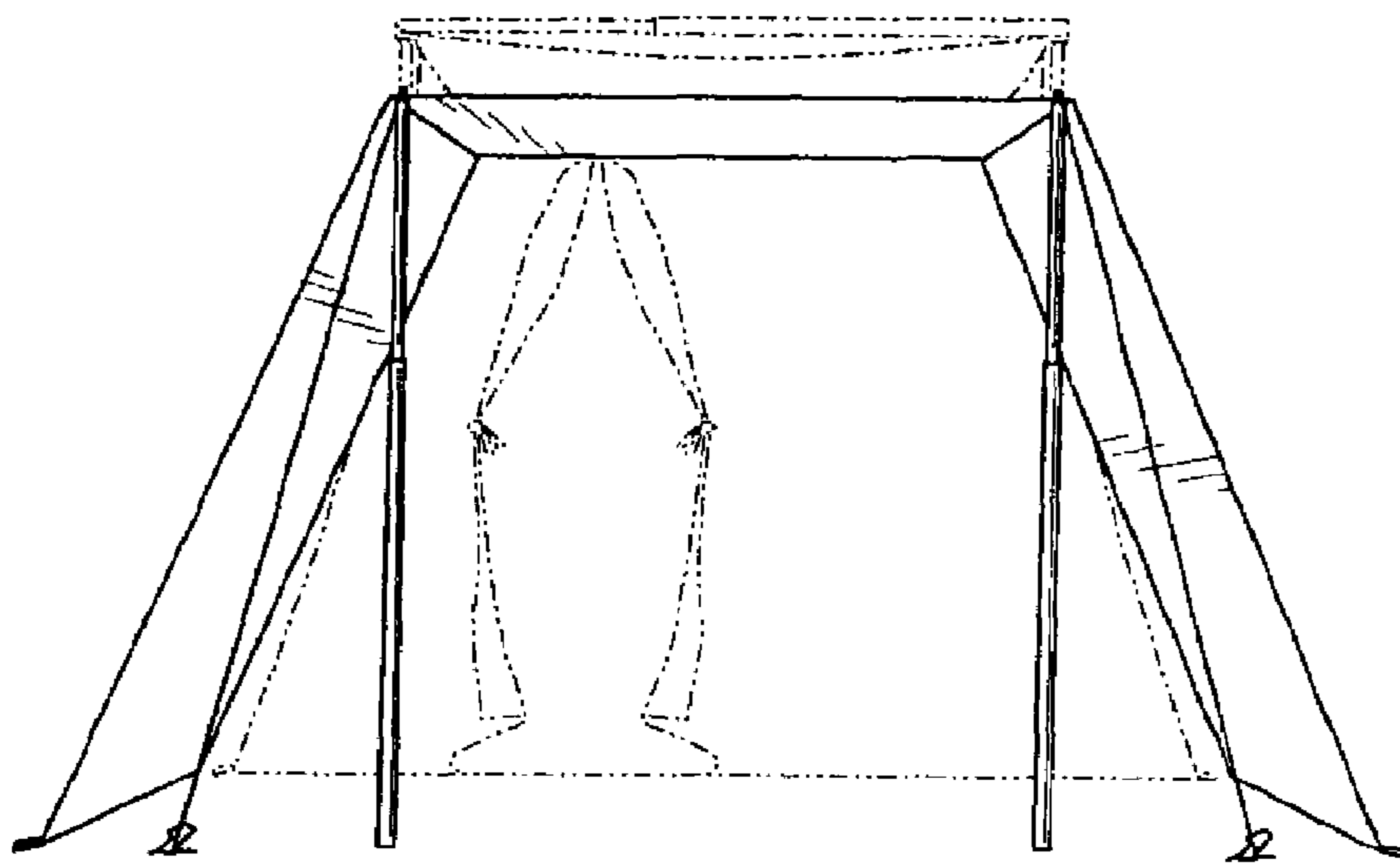

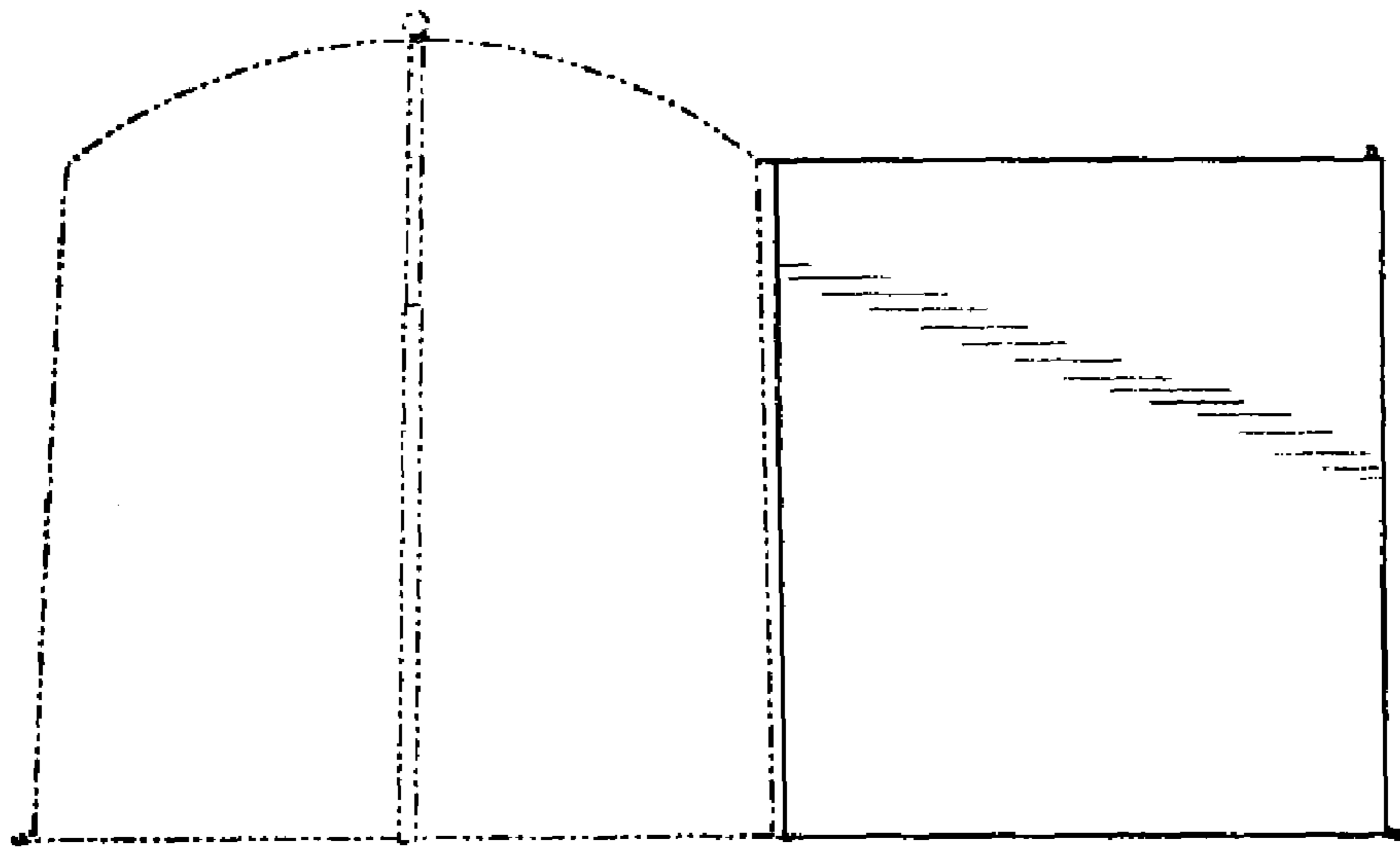




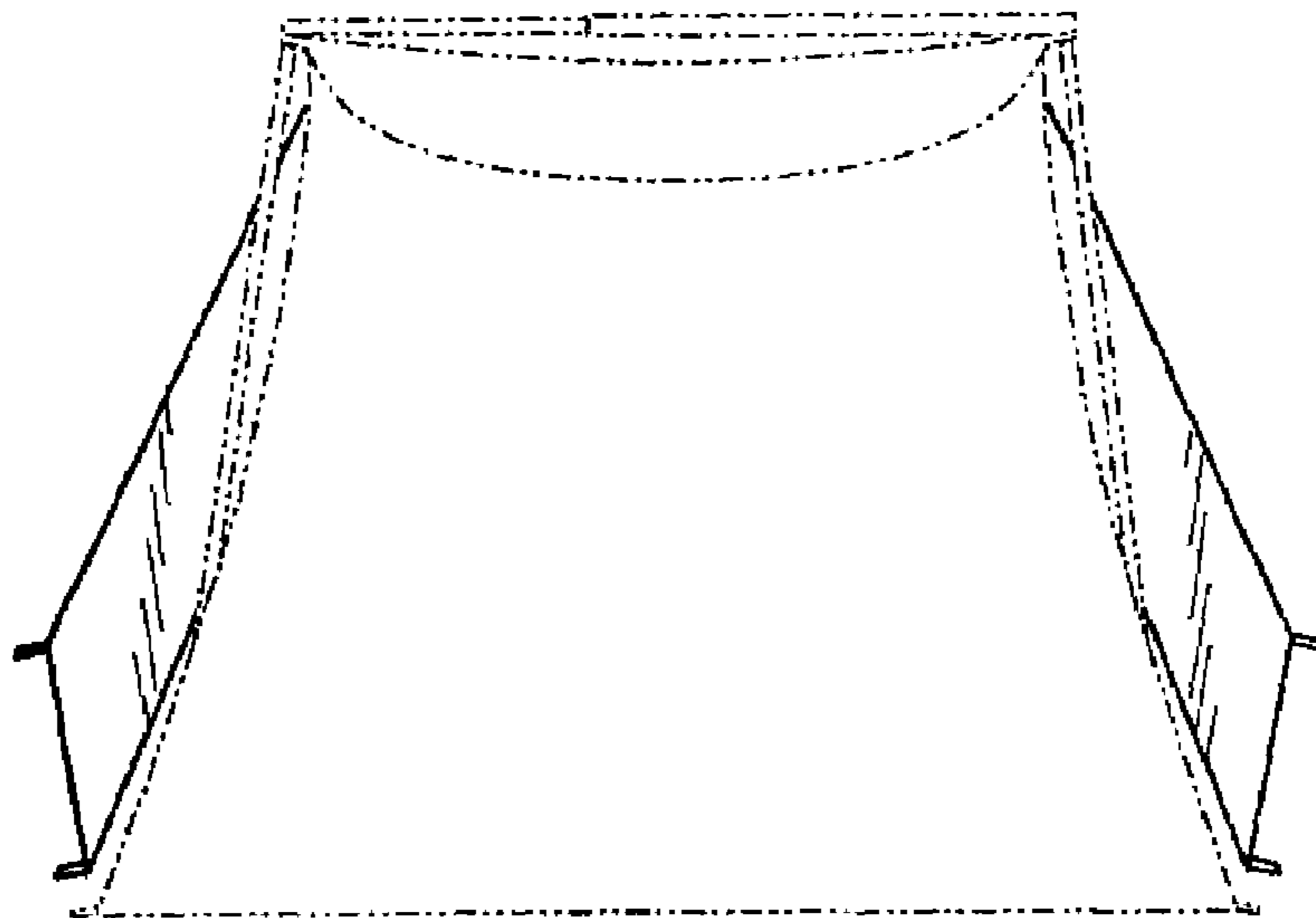

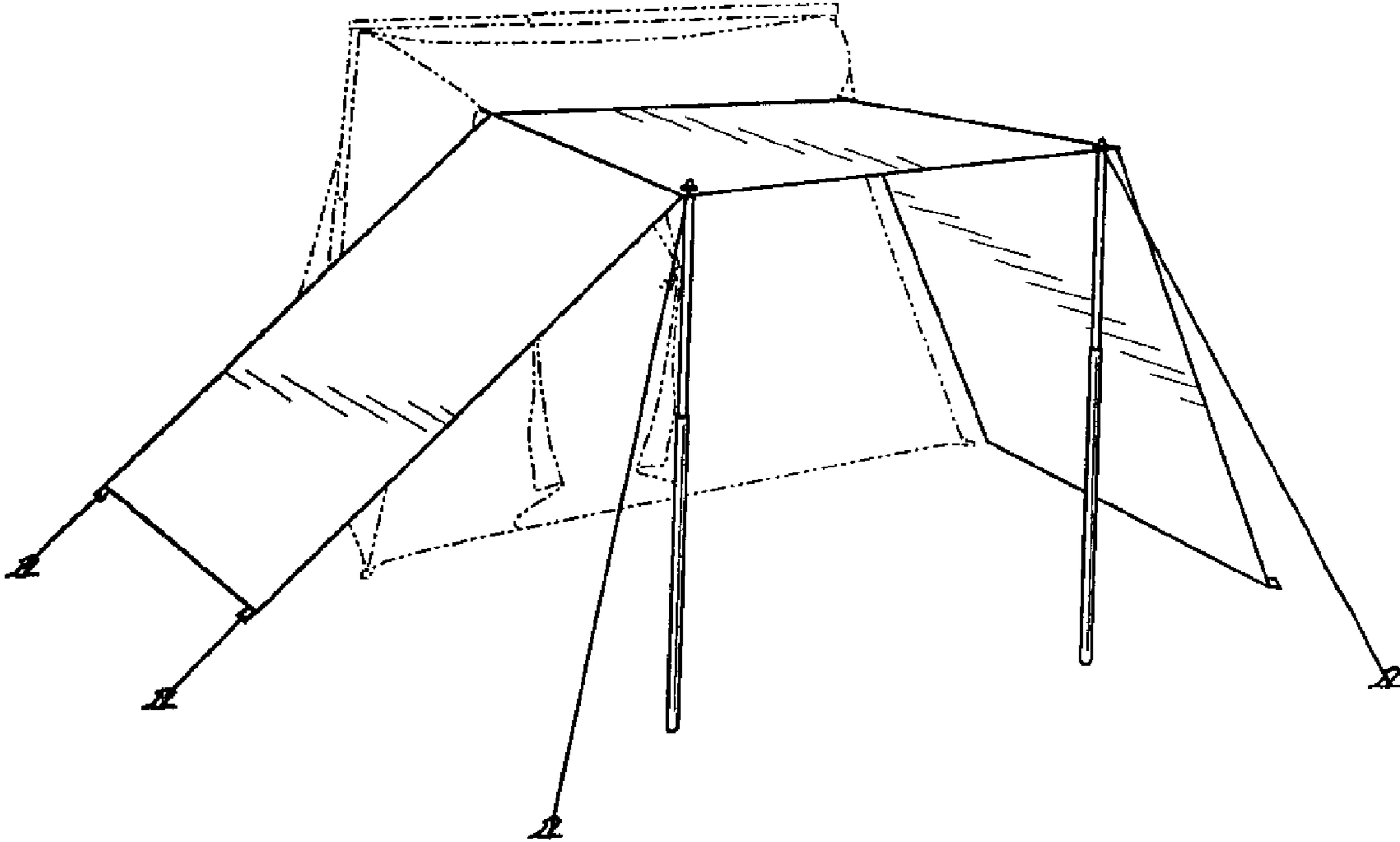
