(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an outsole for a golf shoe, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an outsole for a golf shoe showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof; and,

FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof.

The broken line showing a shoe upper in FIGS. 1–7 is for illustrative purposes only and represent the portions of the design that form no part of the claim.

The outermost broken lines showing the cleats throughout the views are intended to represent internal boundaries, with the broken lines forming no part of the claim.

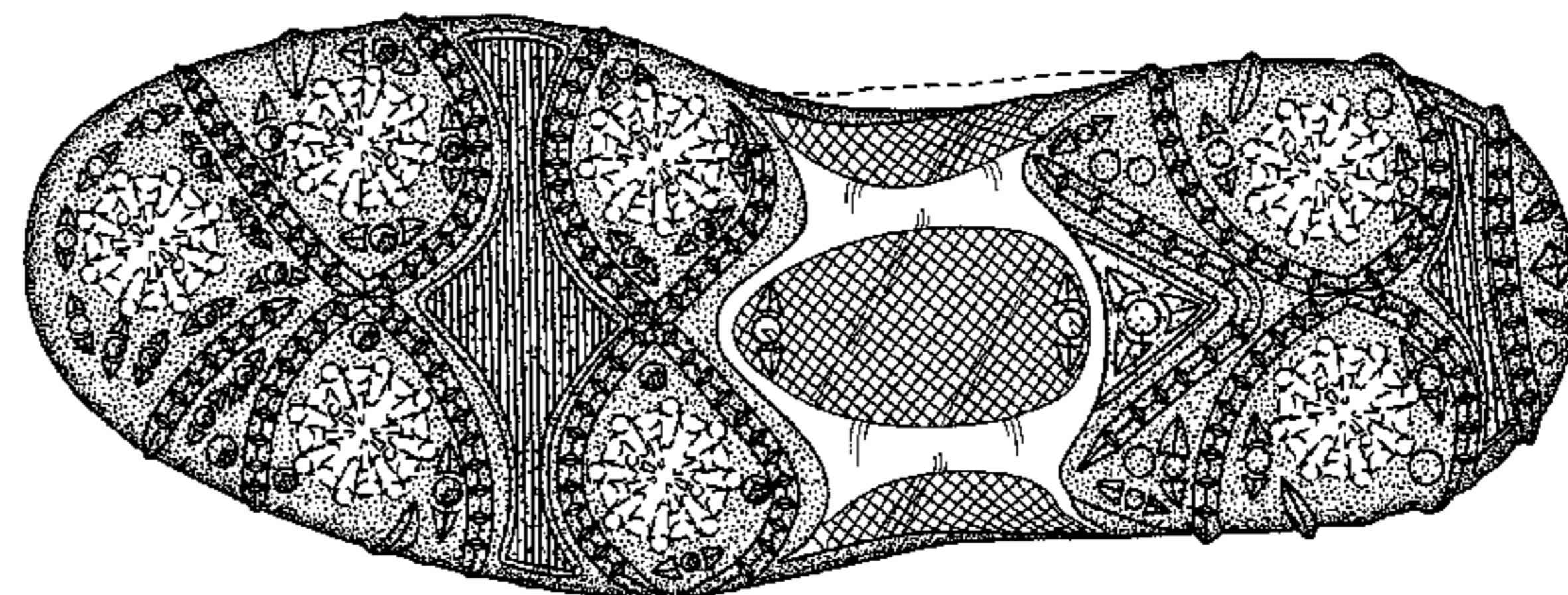
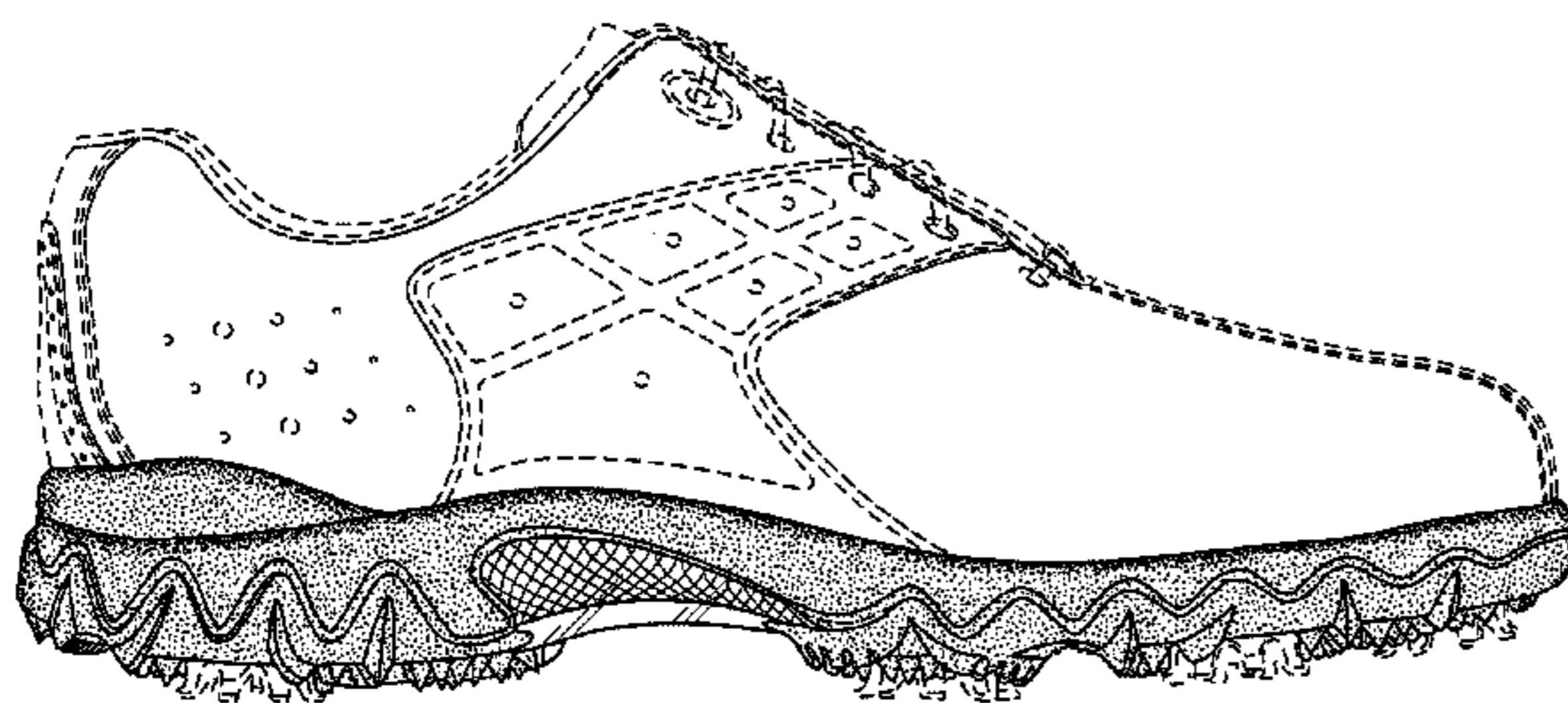

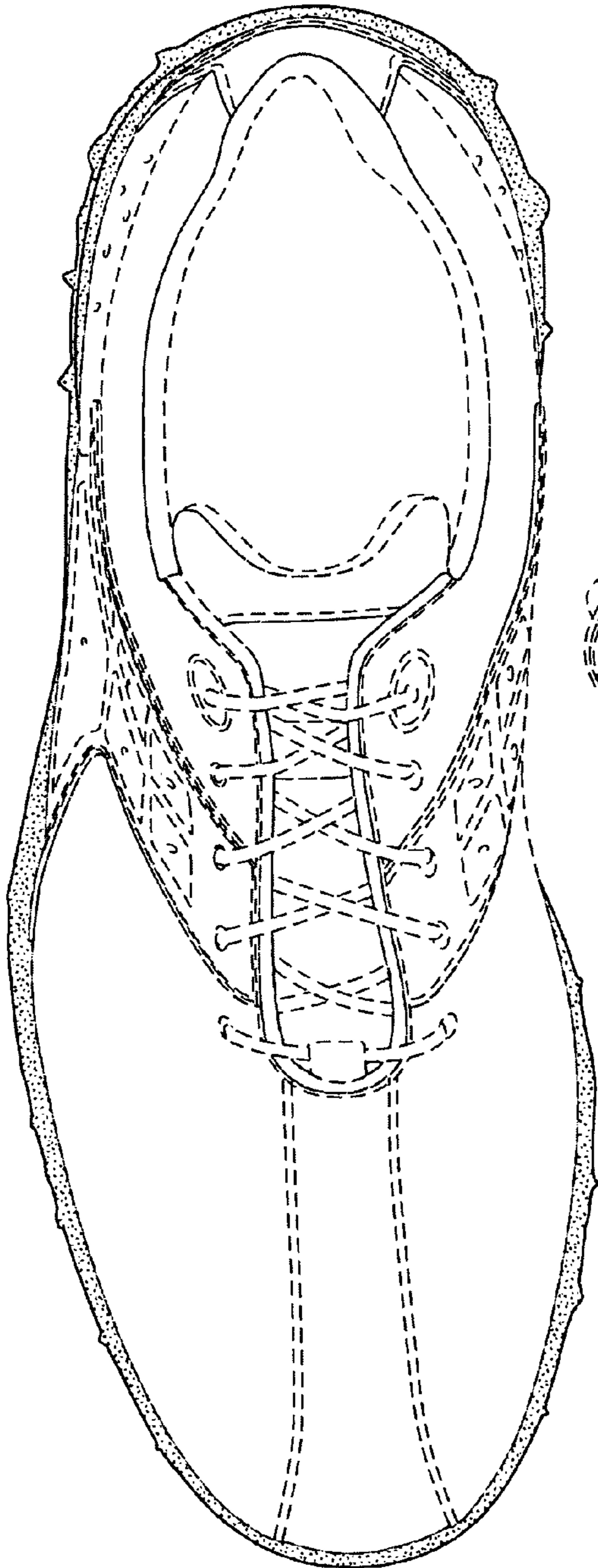
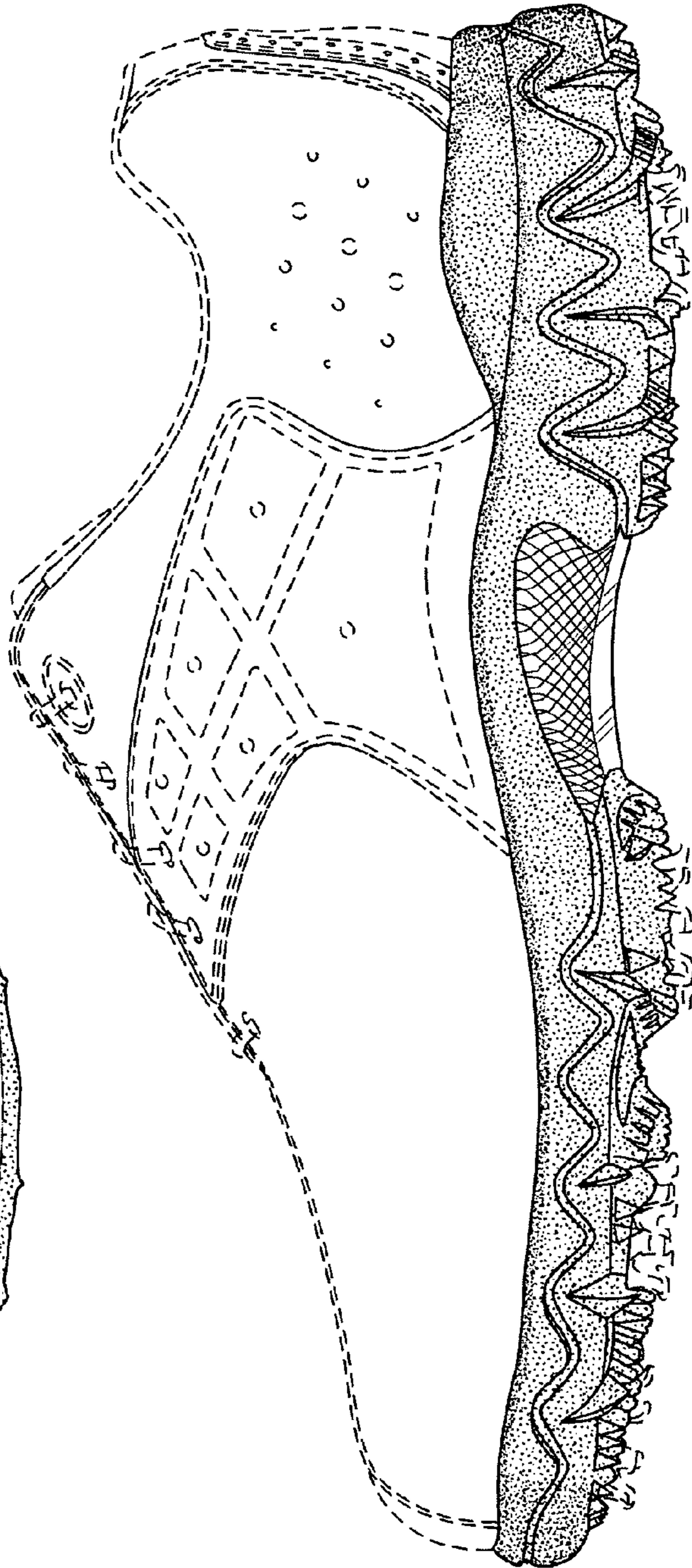

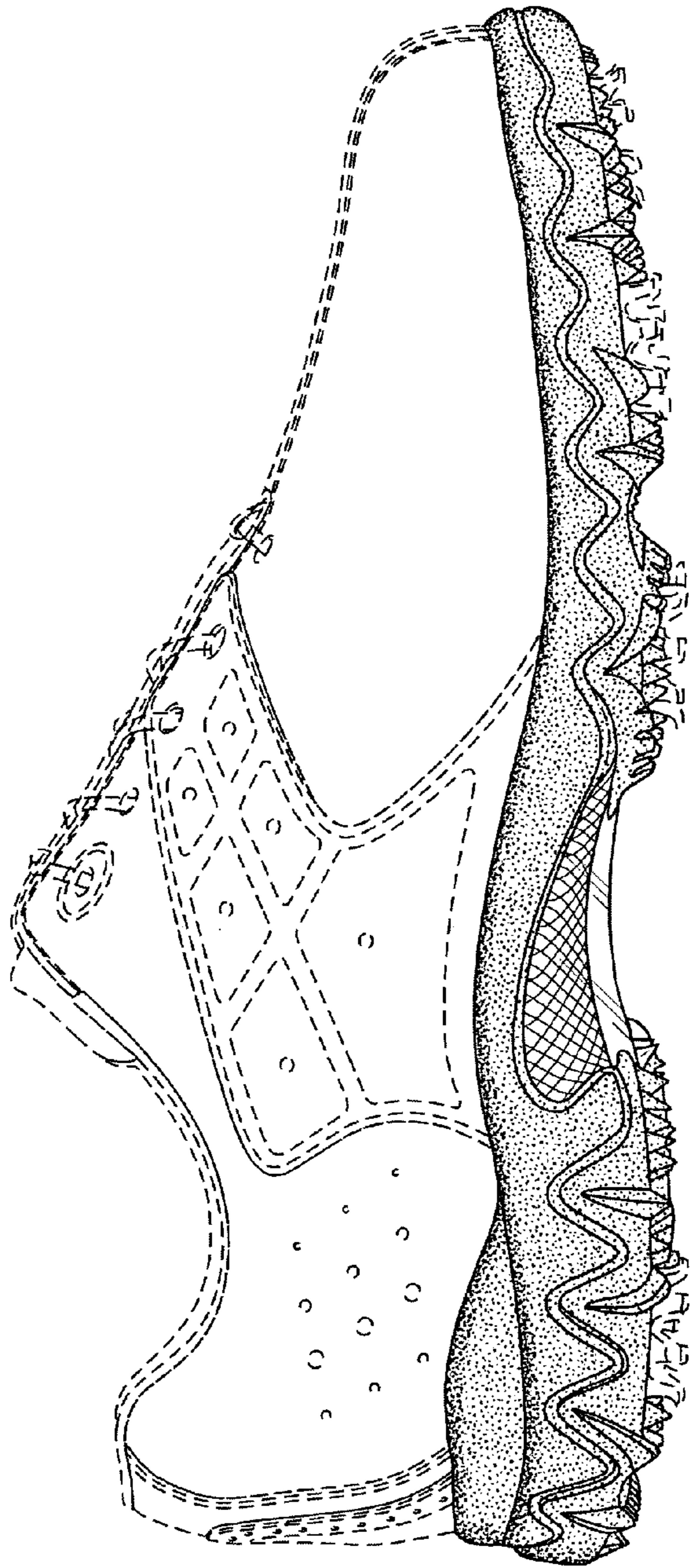

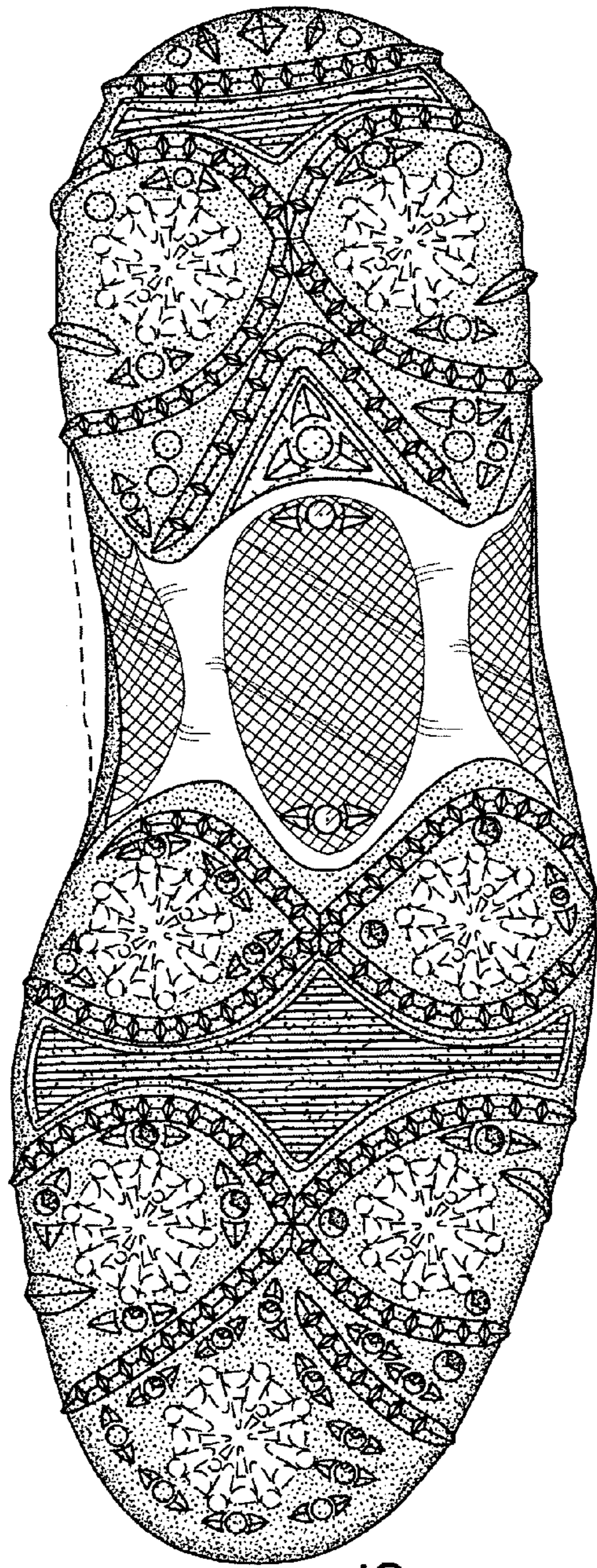

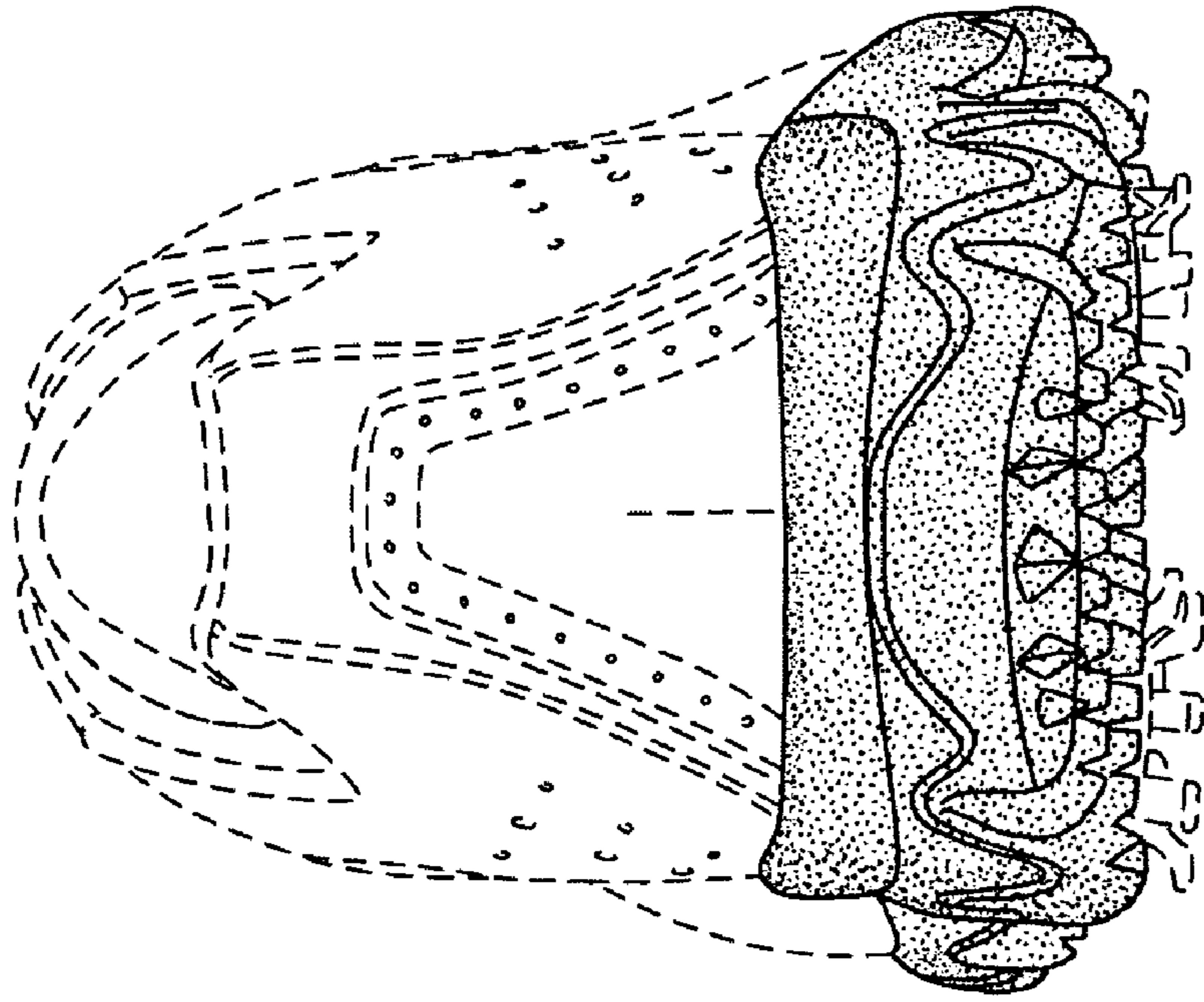

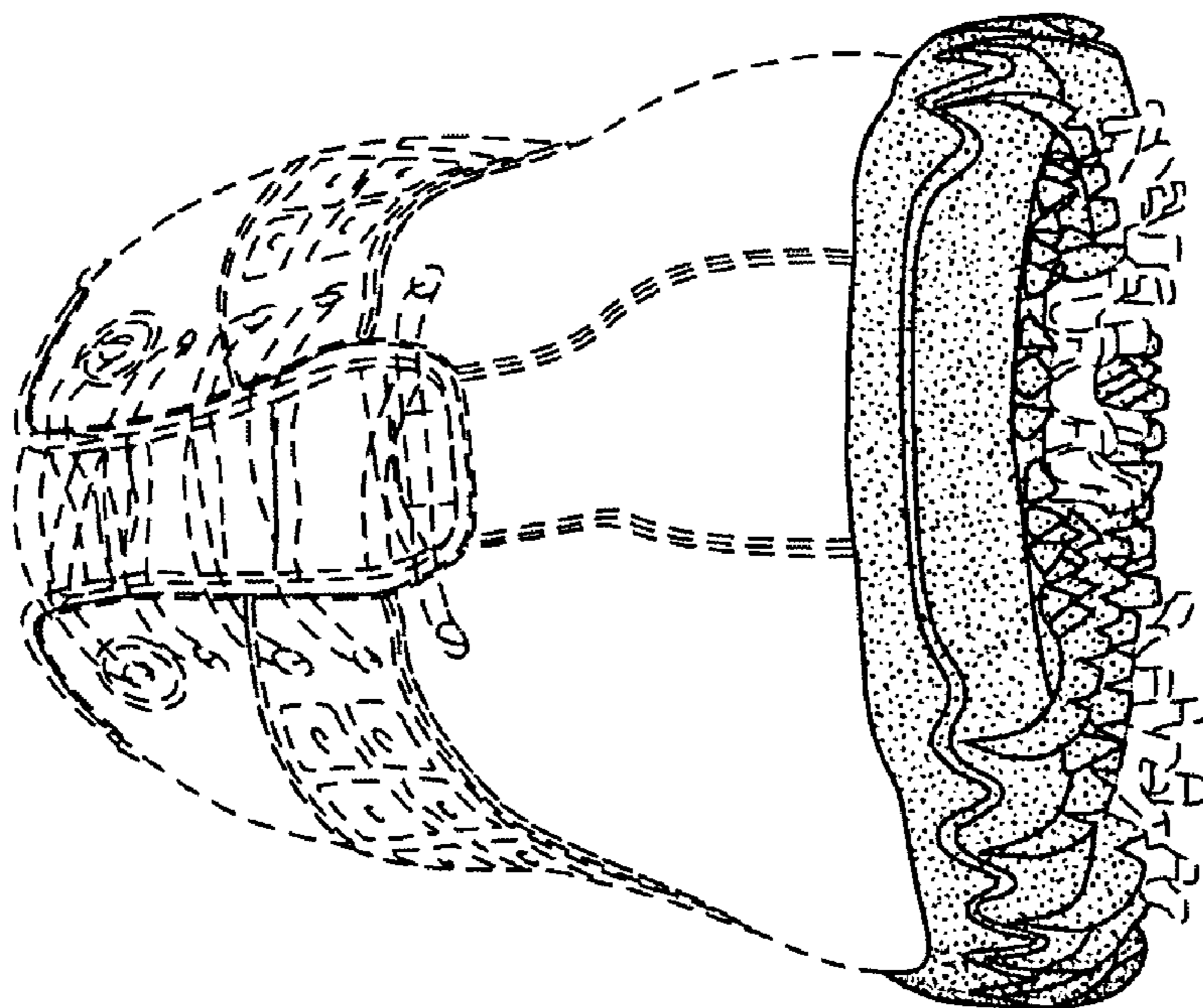
