FIG. 4: is an elevational view of the right side of the first embodiment of the sports ball tumbler;

FIG. 5: is an elevational view of the left side of the first embodiment of the sports ball tumbler;

FIG. 6: is a perspective view of a second embodiment of the sports ball tumbler taken from above and to one side;

FIG. 7: is an elevational view of the front of the second embodiment of the sports ball tumbler, which is identical to the elevational view of the rear of the second embodiment of the sports ball tumbler;

FIG. 8: is a side elevational view of the second embodiment of the sports ball tumbler;

FIG. 9: is a perspective view of the left side of a third embodiment of the sports ball tumbler taken from above and to one side;

FIG. 10: is an elevational view of the front of the third embodiment of the sports ball tumbler;

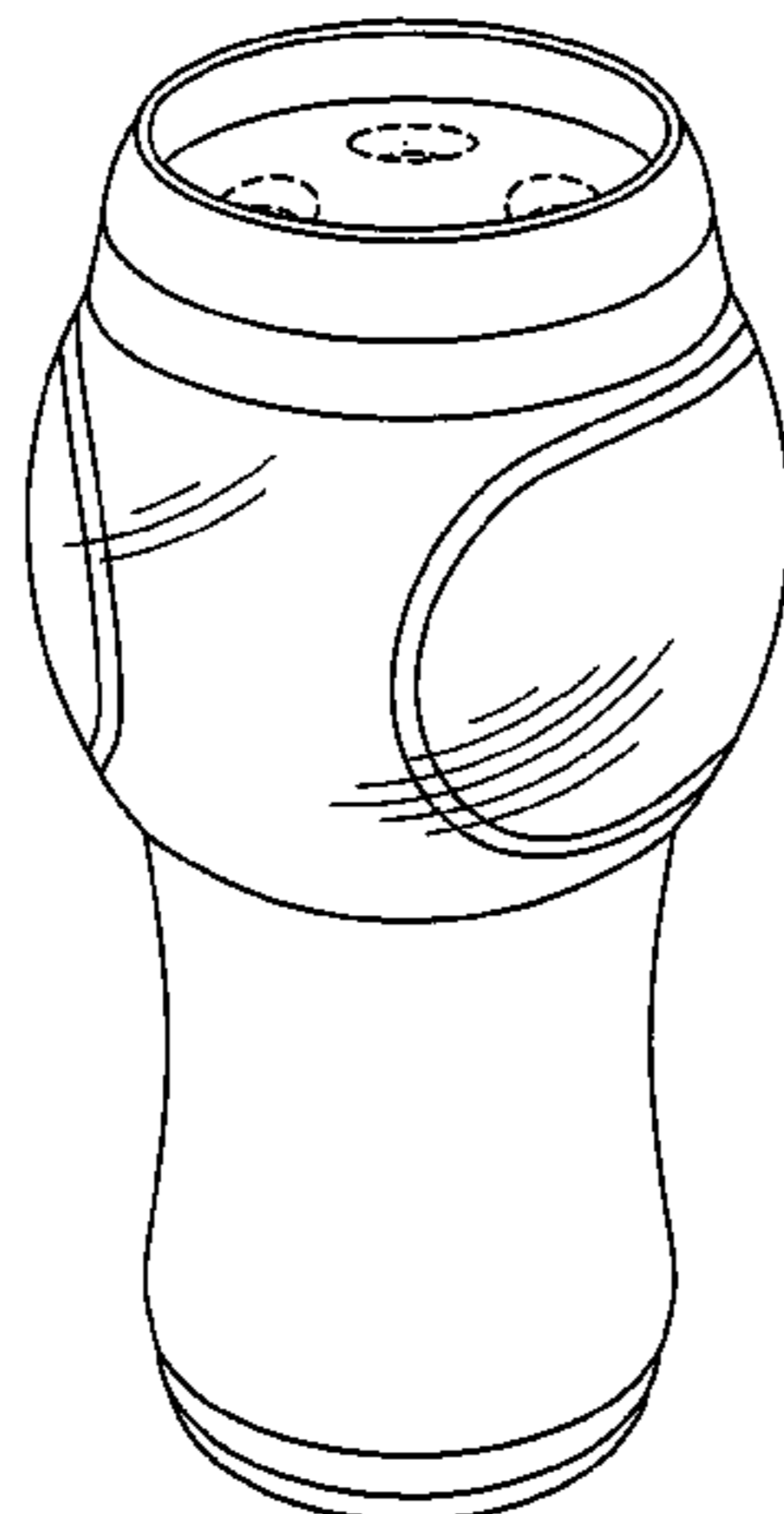
FIG. 11: is an elevational view of the rear of the third embodiment of the sports ball tumbler;

FIG. 12: is an elevational view of the left side of the third embodiment of the sports ball tumbler; and,

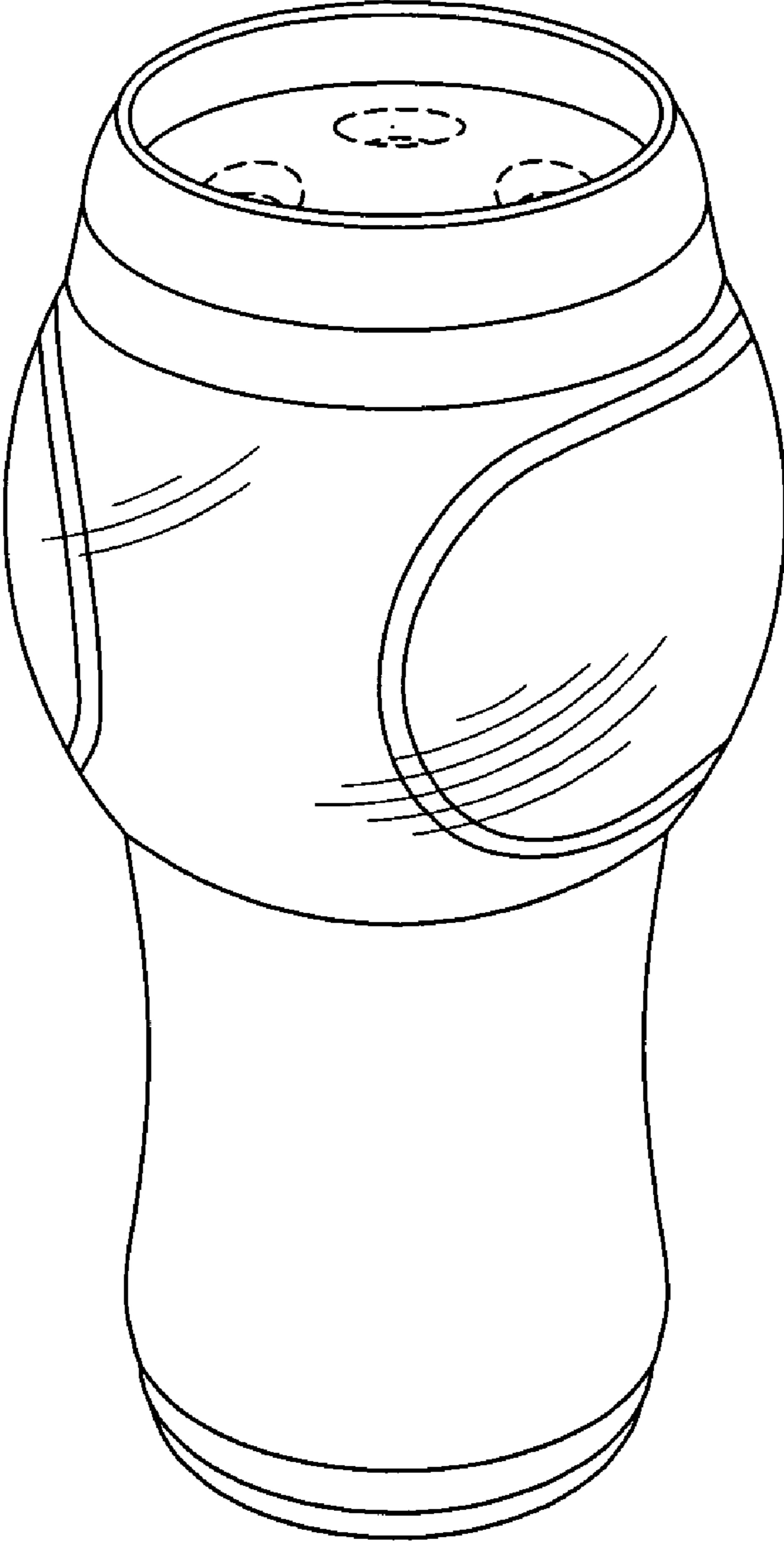

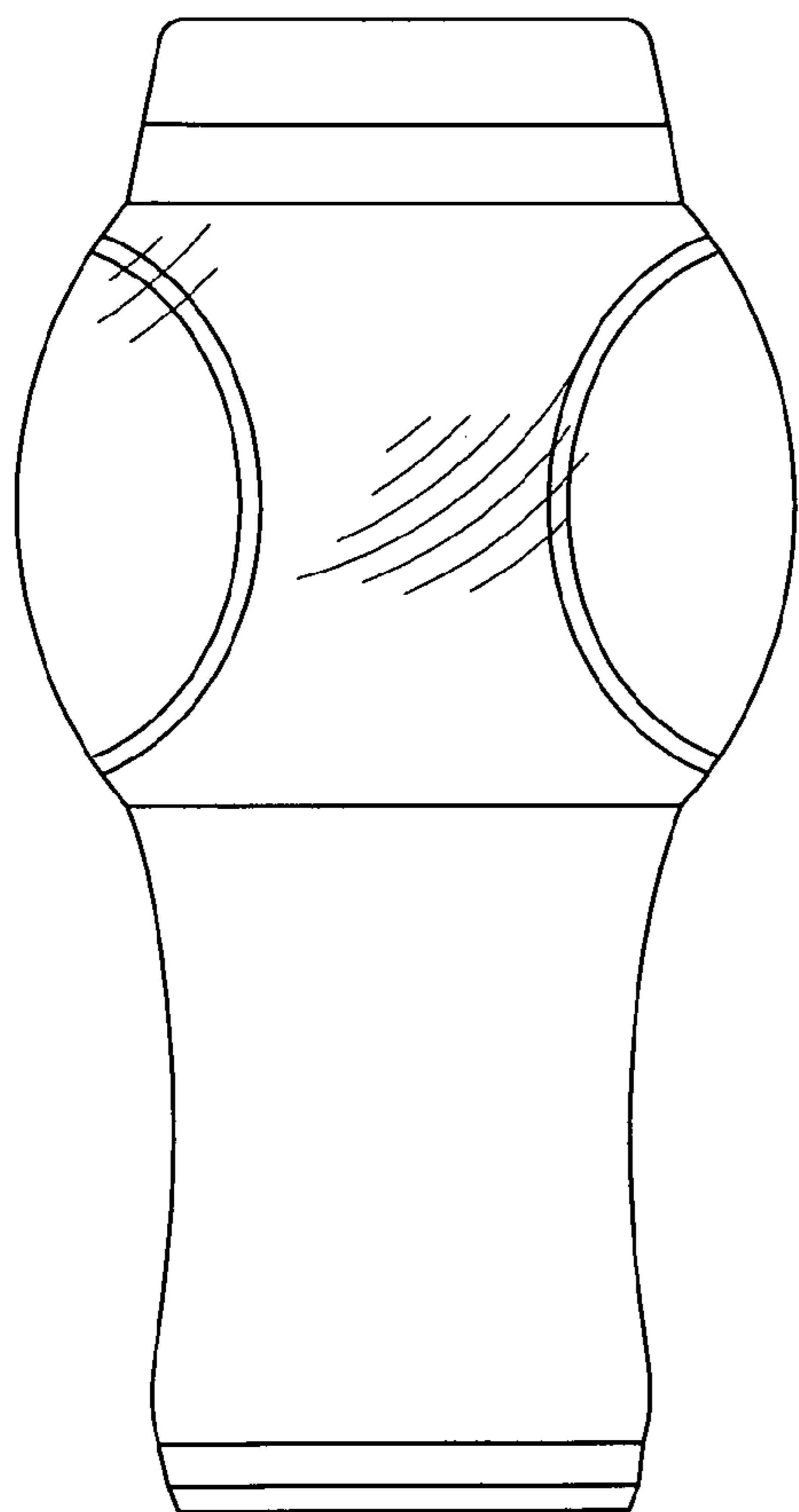

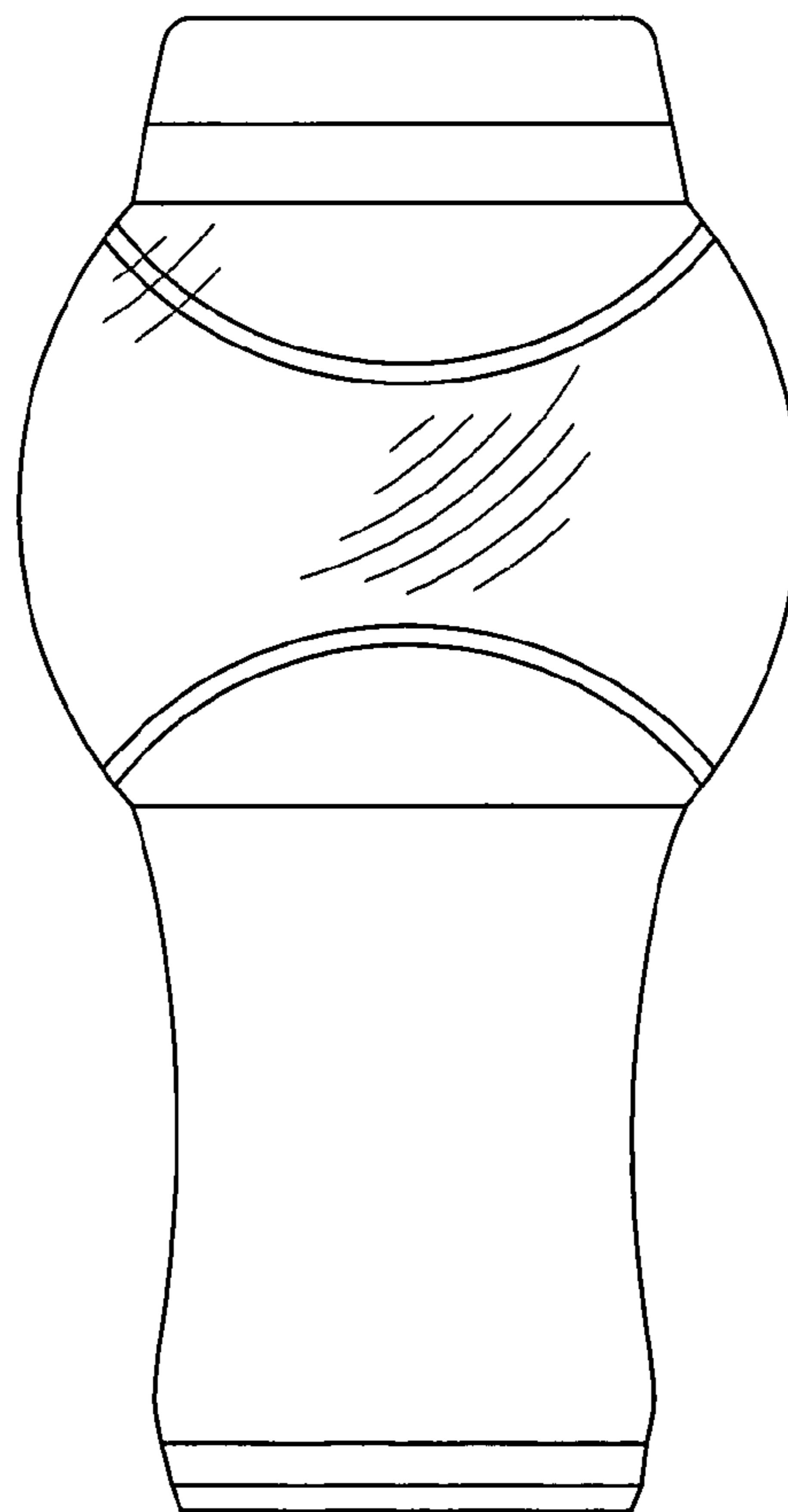

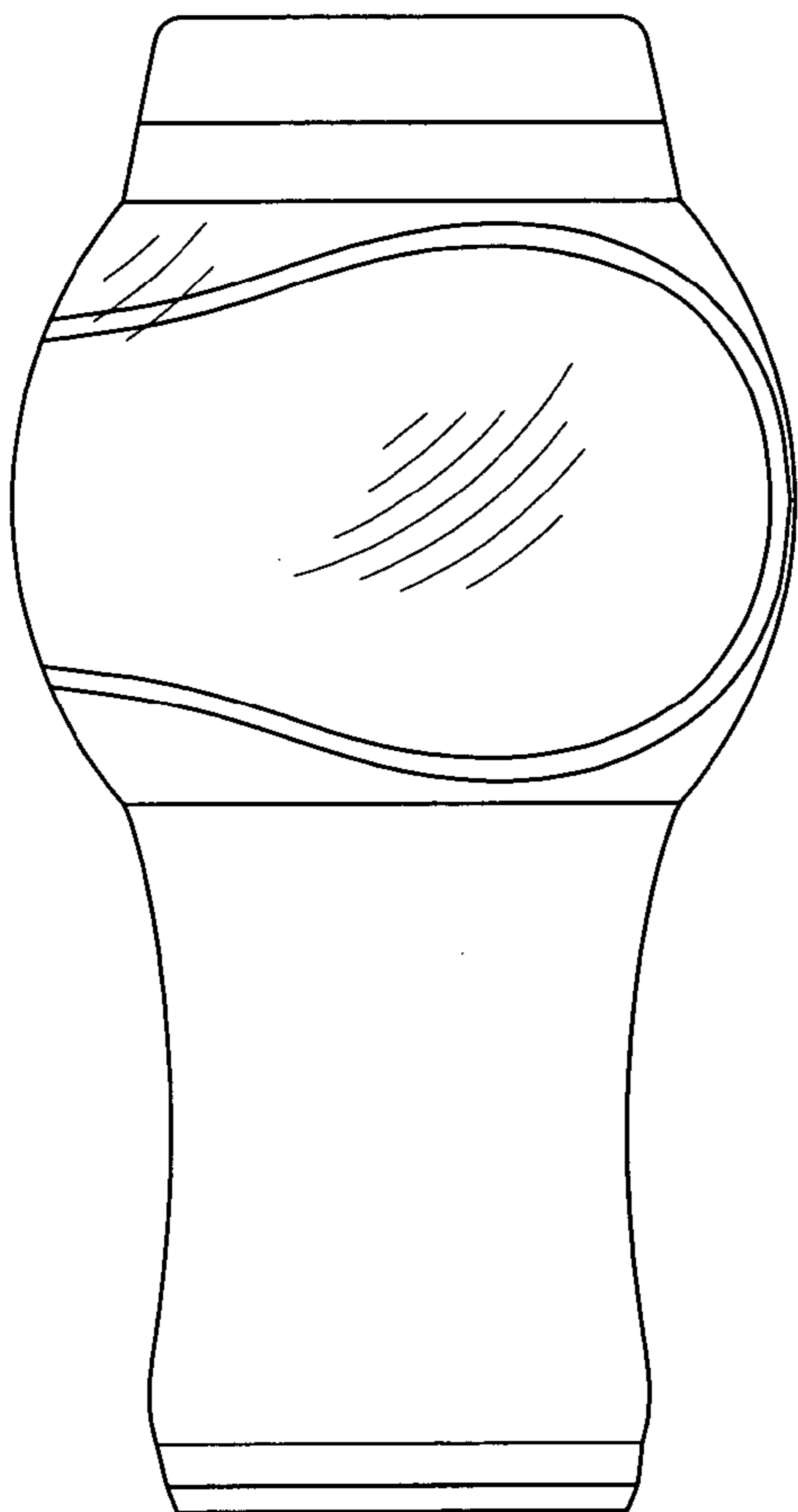

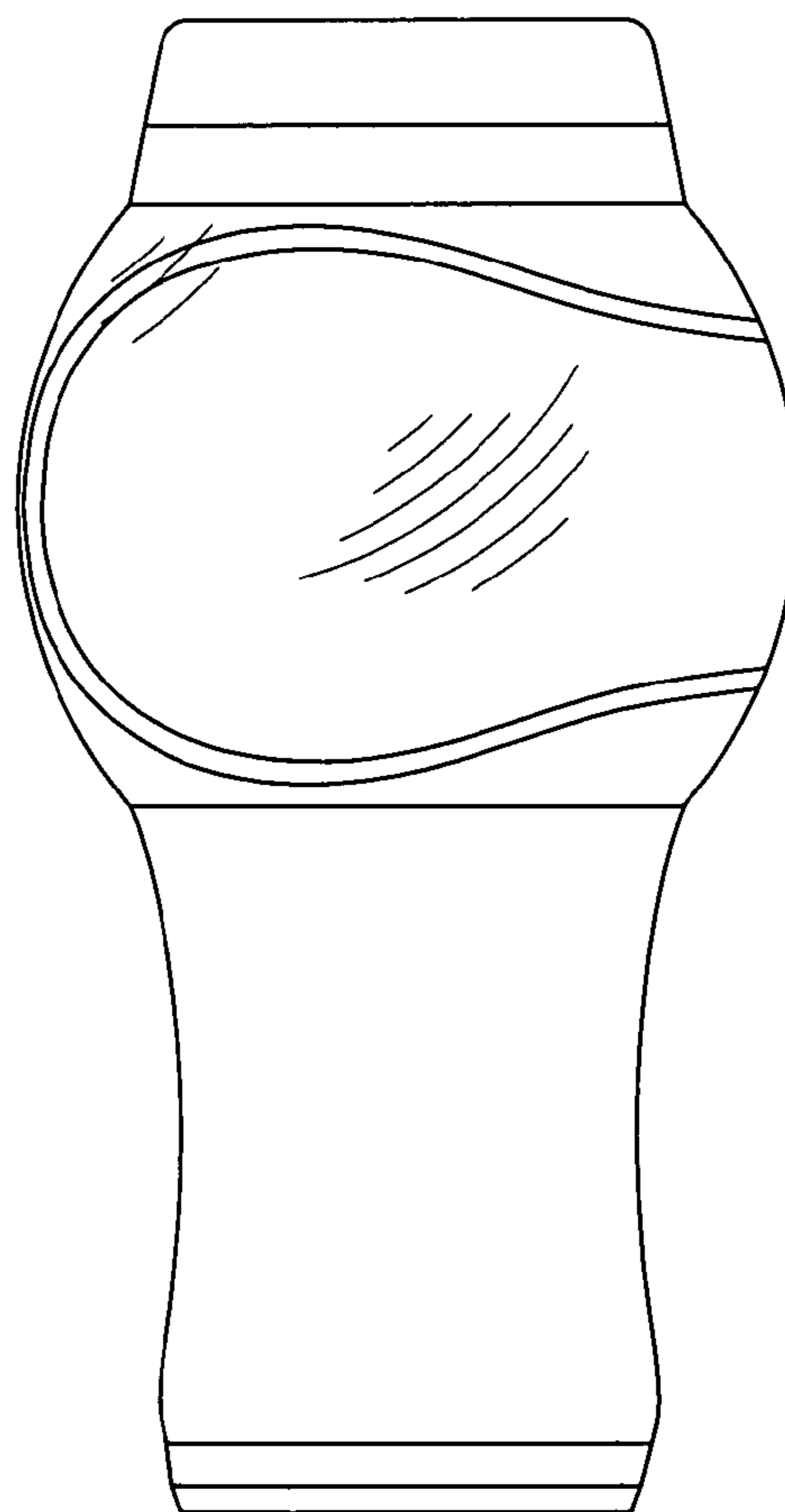

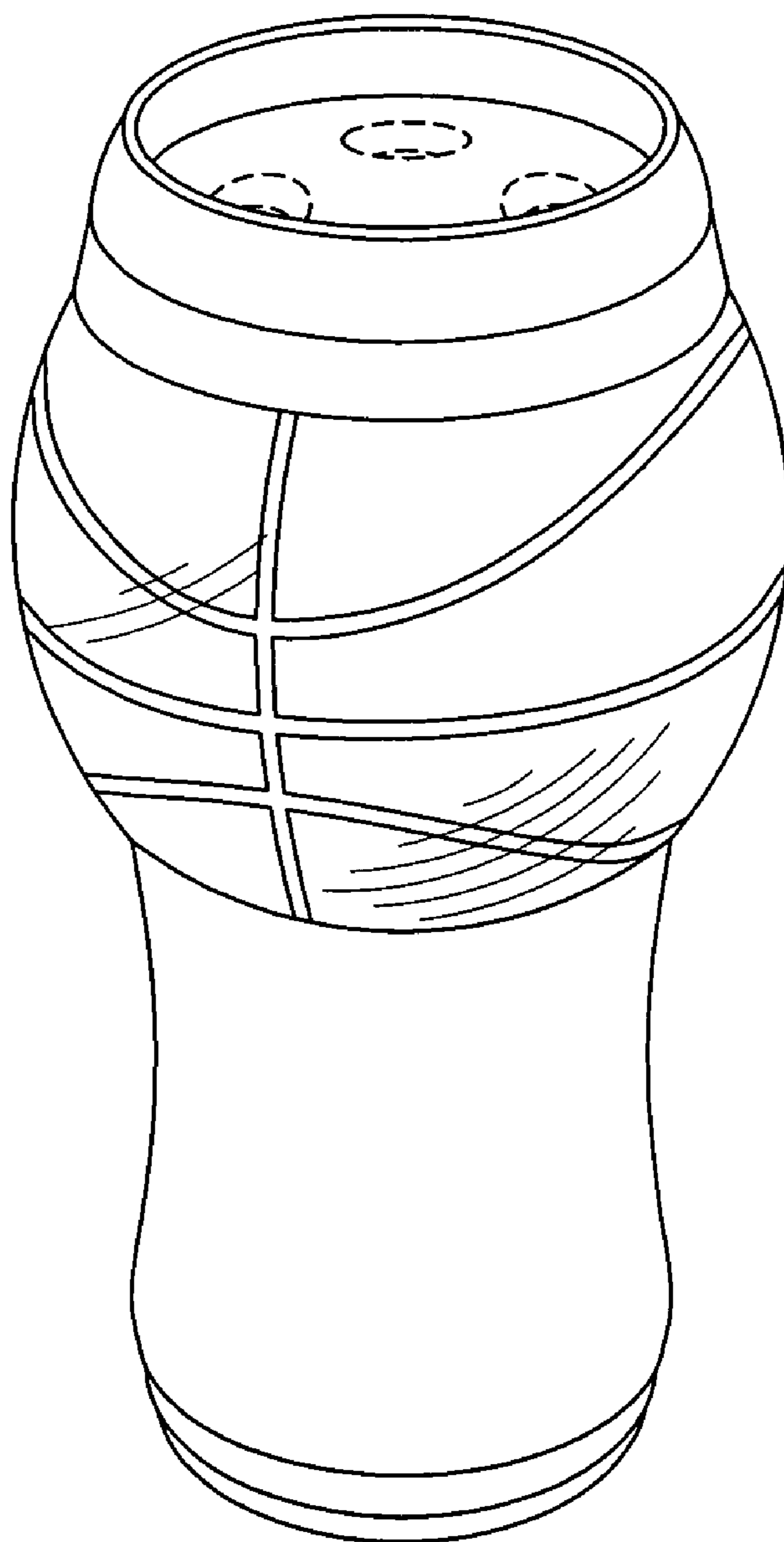

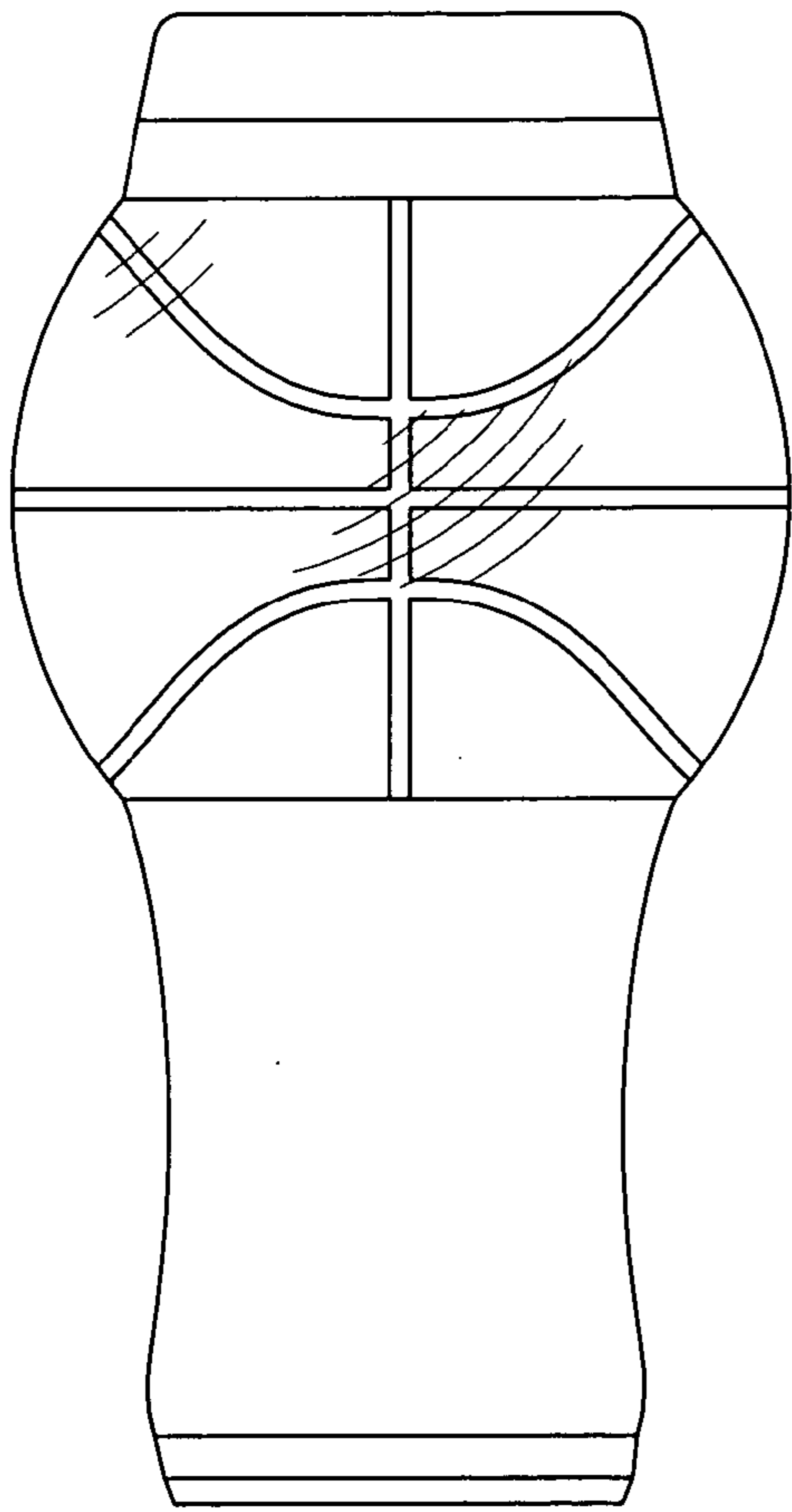

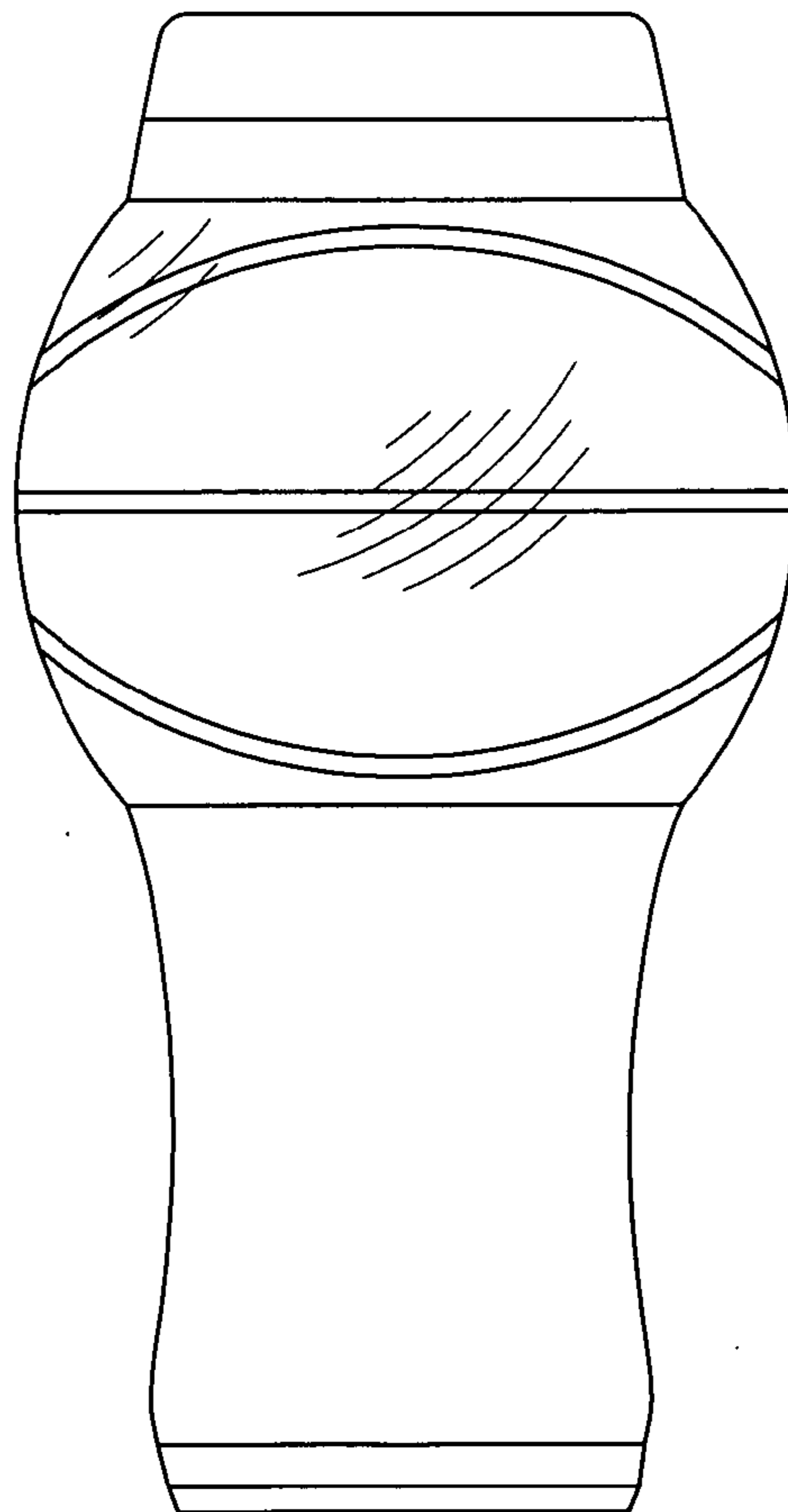

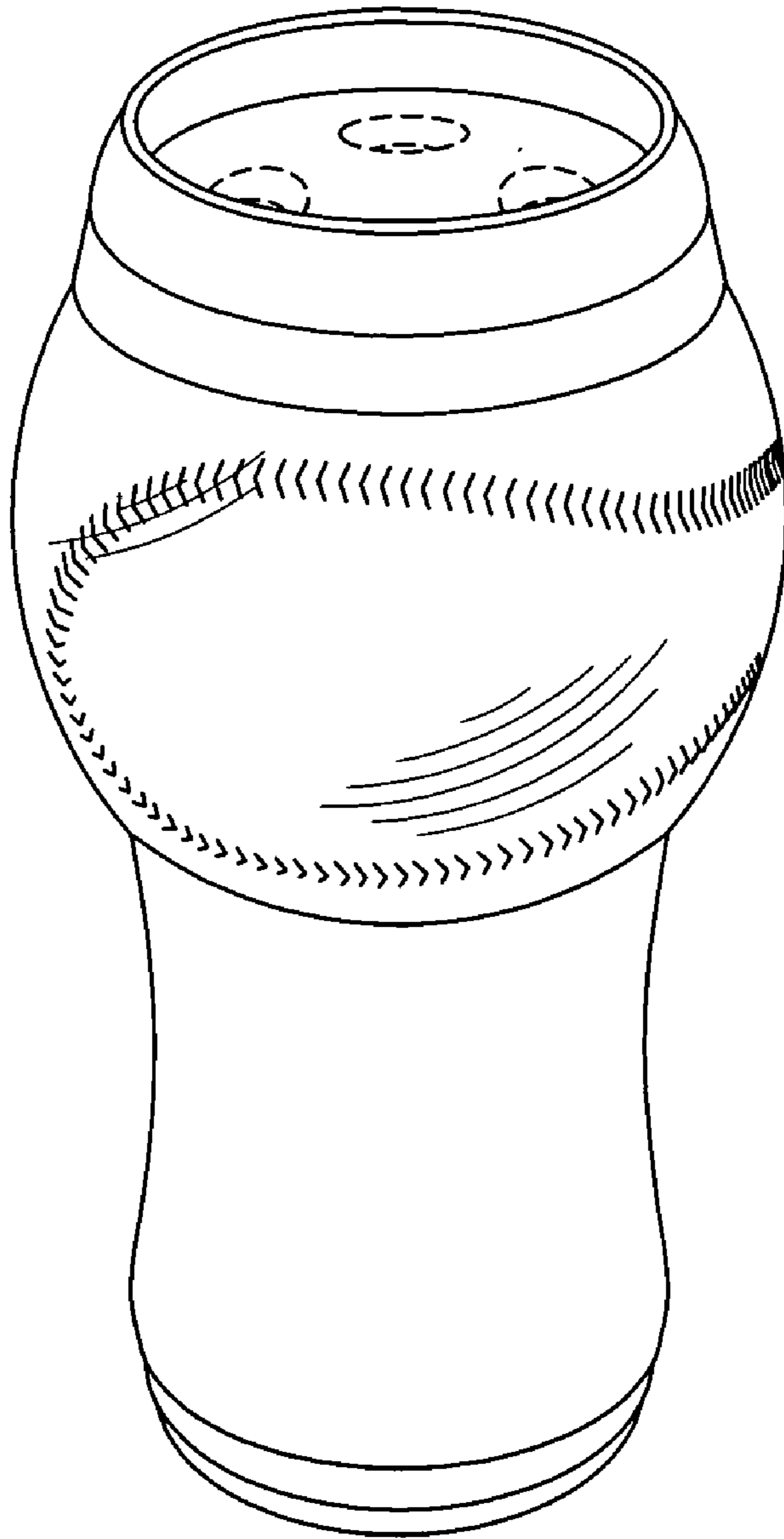

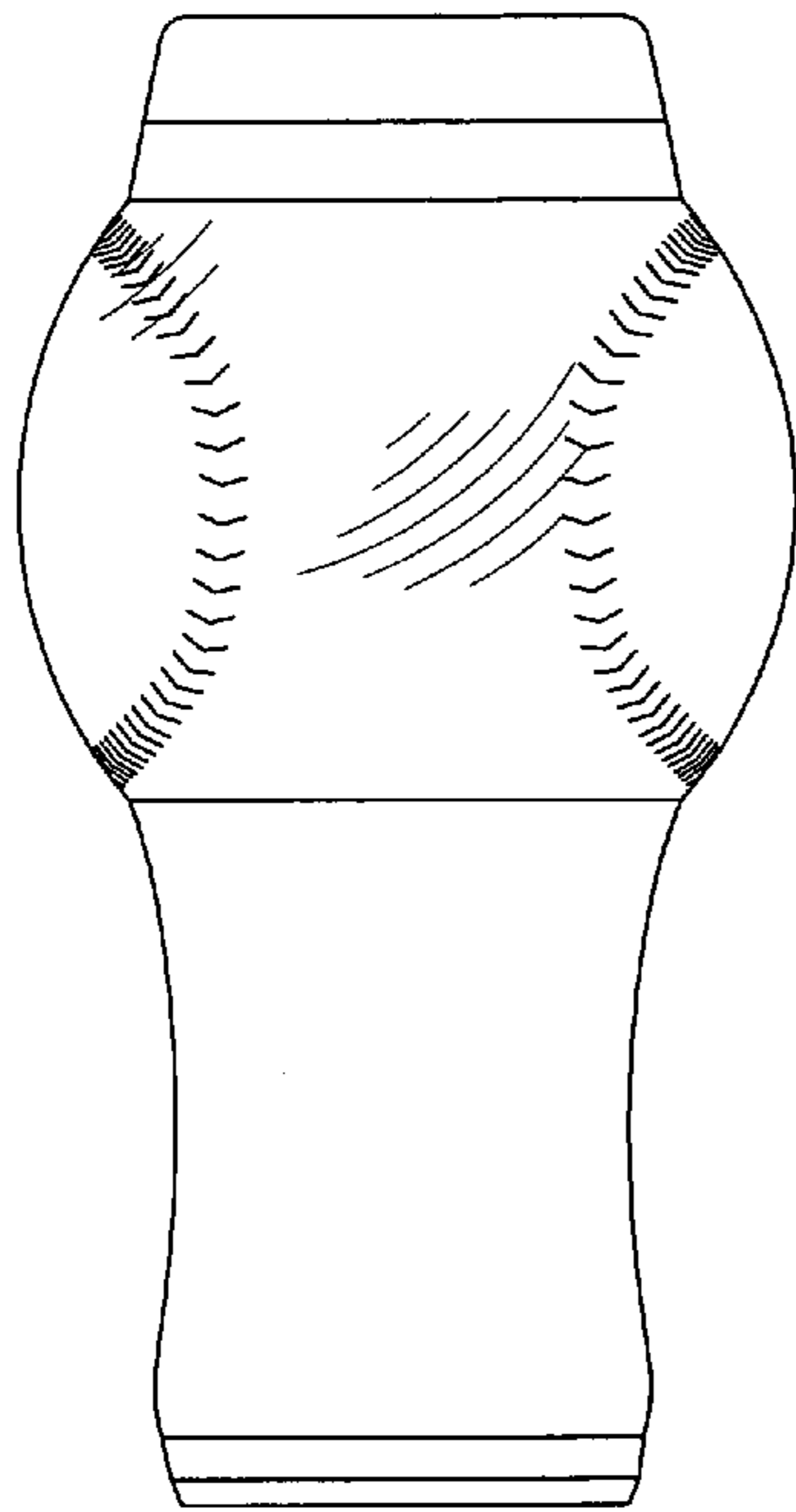

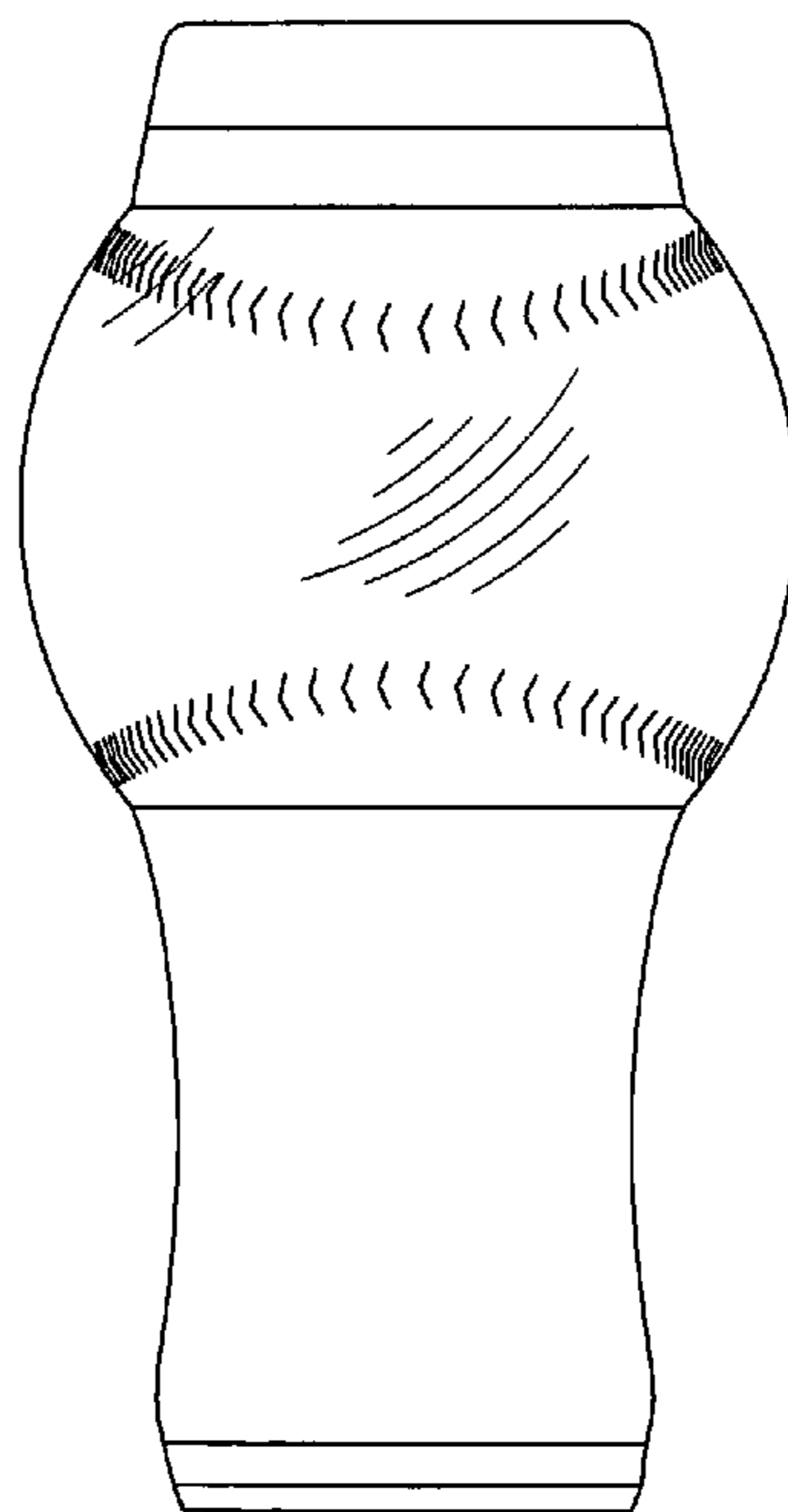

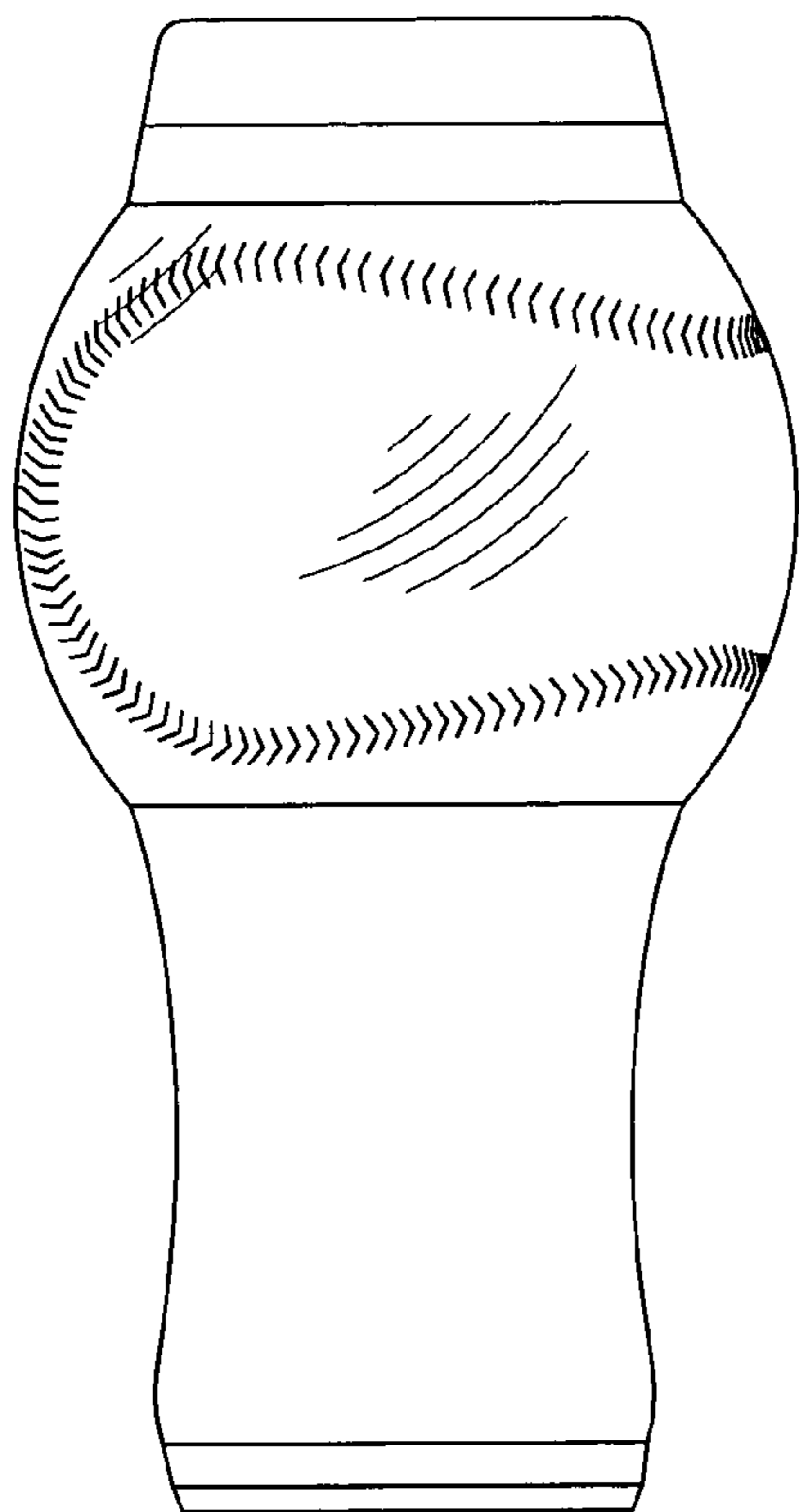

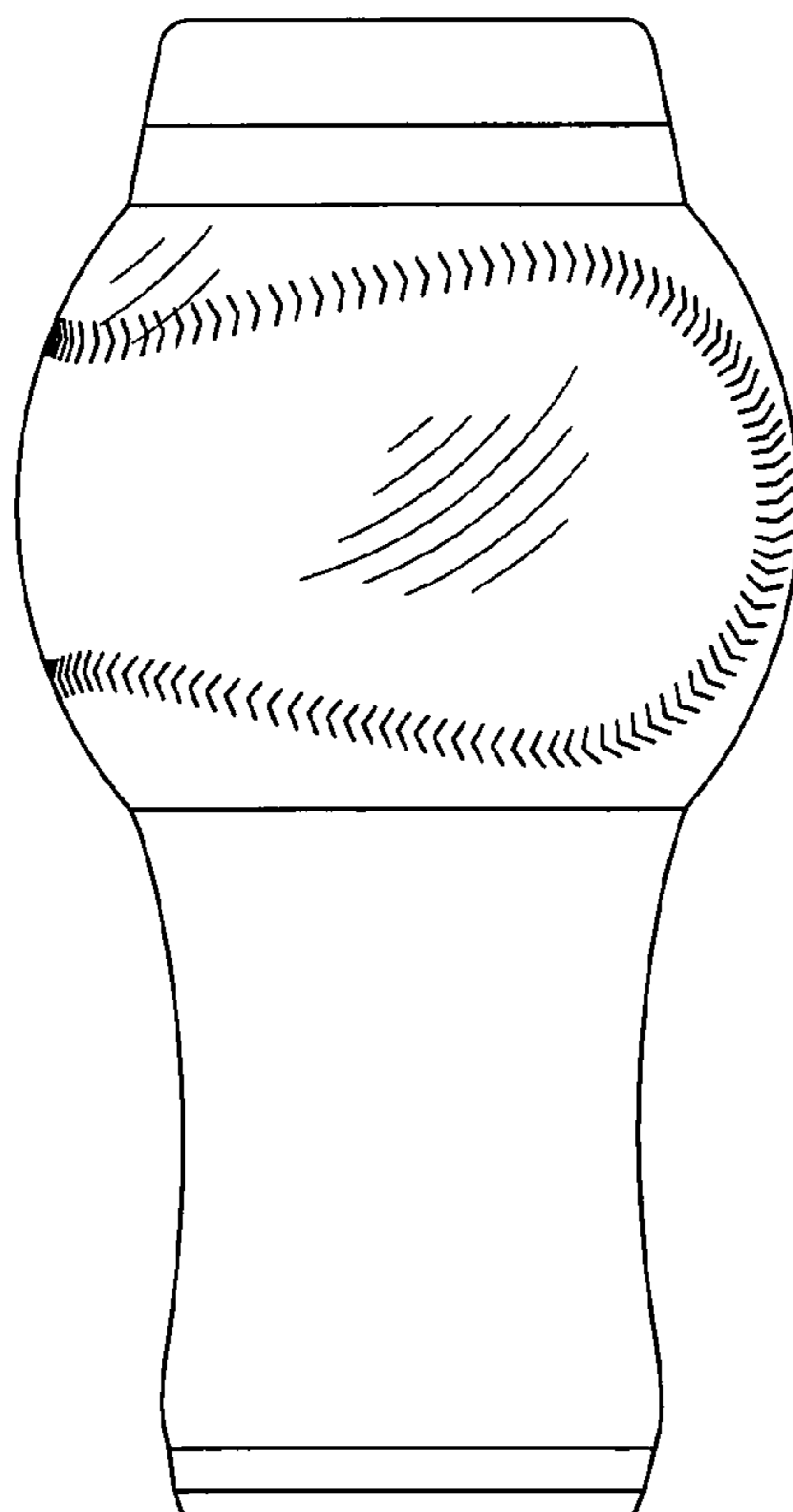
