(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a binder cover for a multi-part note pad, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

The single FIGURE is a top plan view of the binder cover for a multi-part note pad.

The binder cover for a multi-part note pad has no appreciable thickness. The spiral element shown in broken lines in FIG. 1 forms no part of the claimed design.

A variety of shading means are used throughout the Figures to differentiate colors in a color coding system and are not intended to represent any specific color(s).
