(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a spout body, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

In a preferred embodiment, the nature of this product is a spout for a faucet.

FIG. 1 is a right, top, front perspective view of a spout body according to our new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view thereof being a mirror image of the right side shown;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a right, top, front perspective view of a spout body according to another embodiment of our new design;

FIG. 8 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view thereof being a mirror image of the right side shown;

FIG. 9 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 10 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,

FIG. 11 is a top plan view thereof.

The broken line representations in the figures, including broken line representations of spout structure and faucet environment, are for the purpose of illustration only, and form no part of the claimed design.

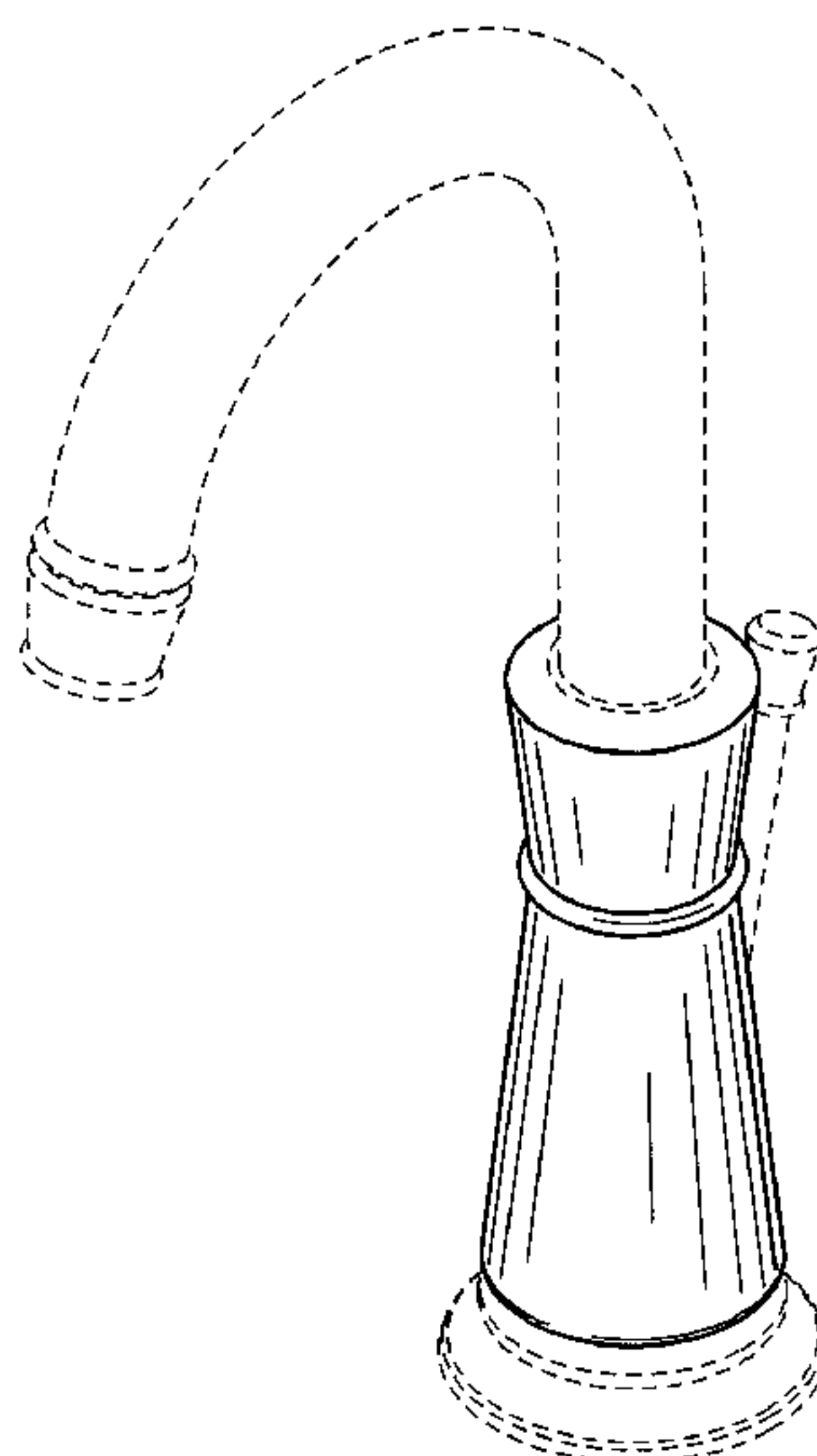

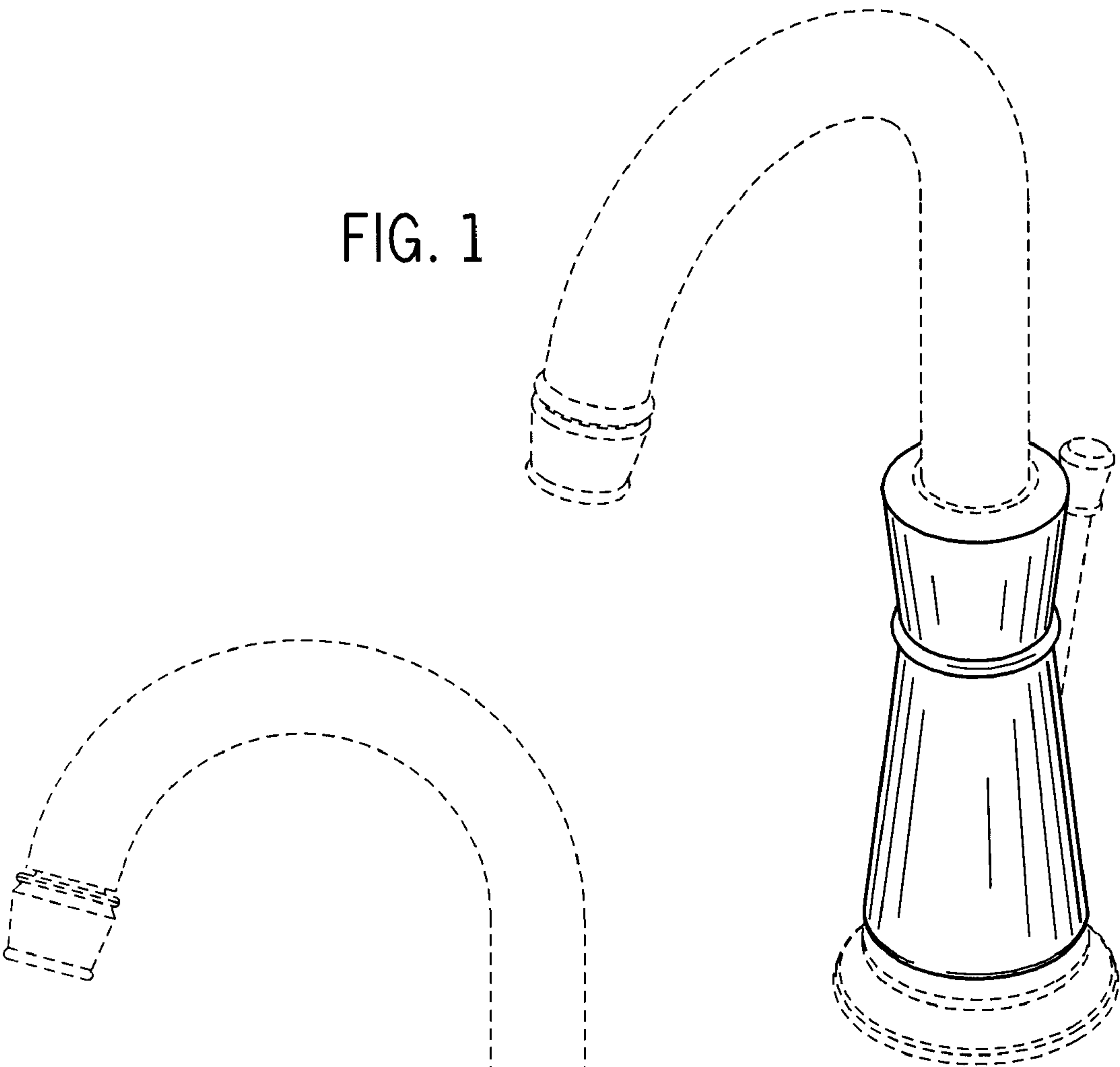
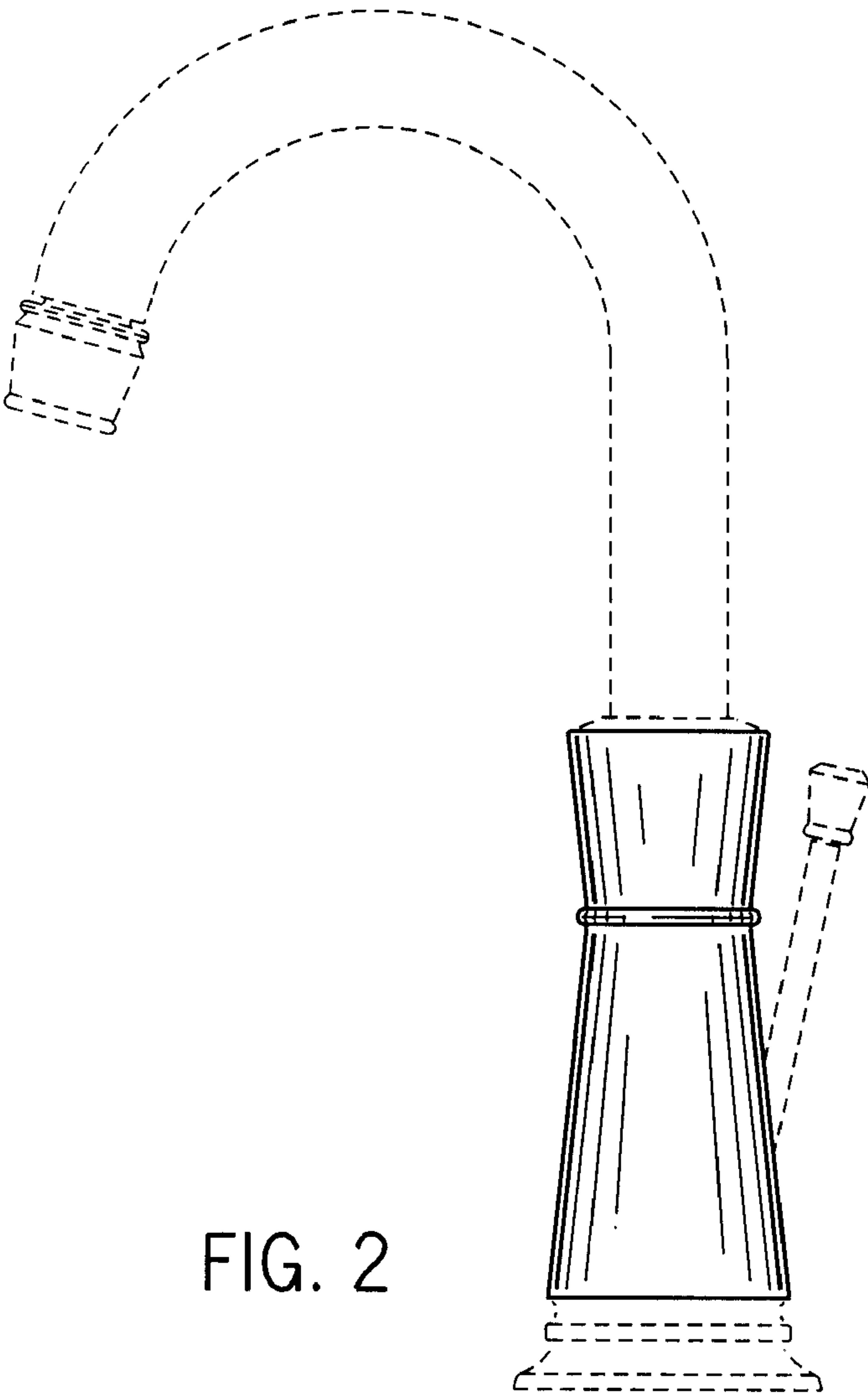

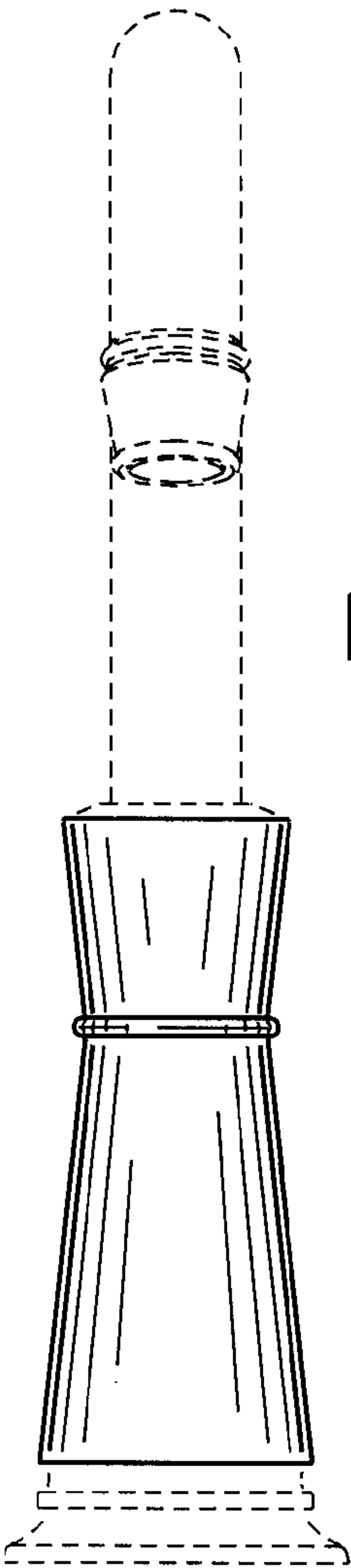

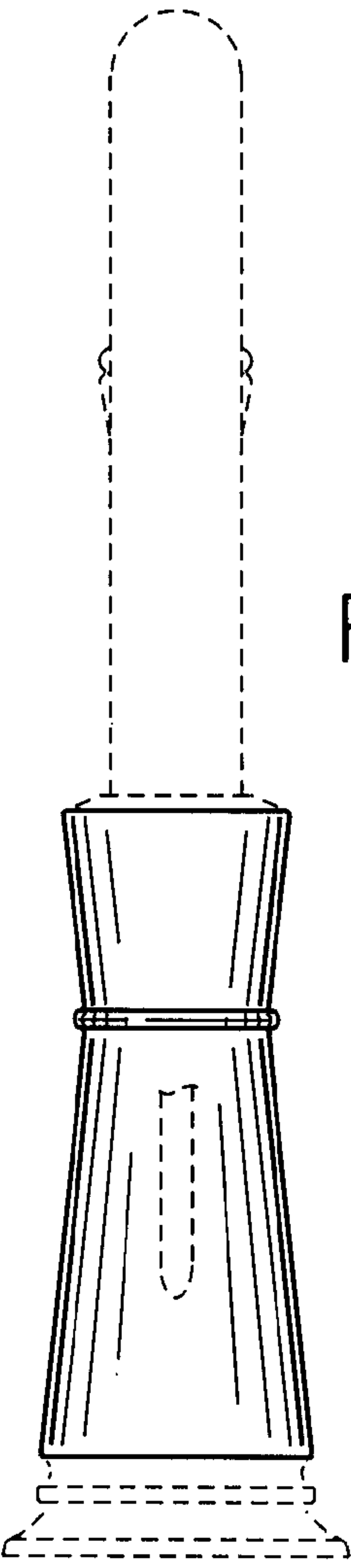

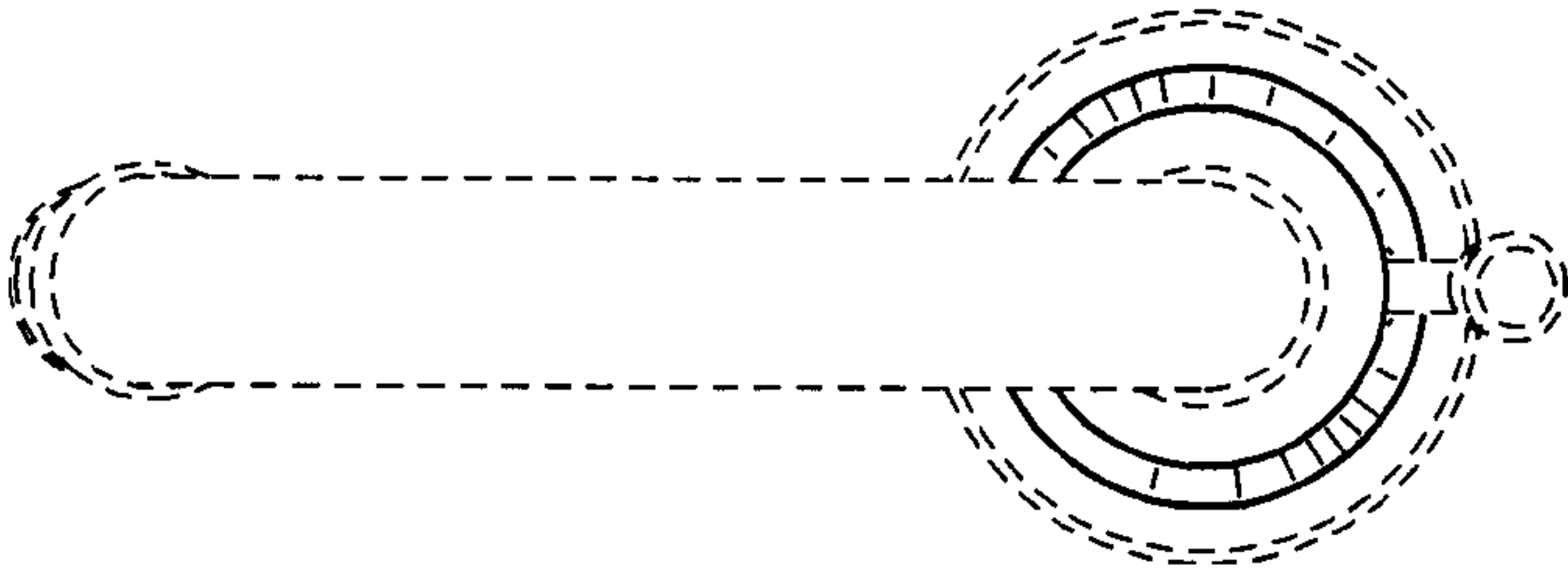

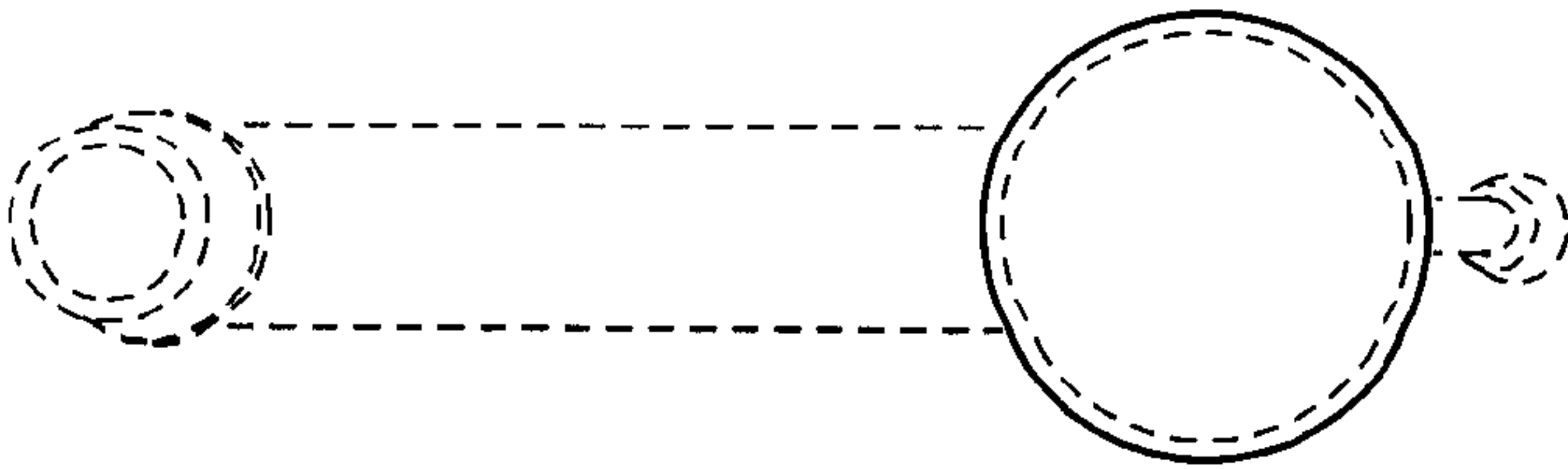

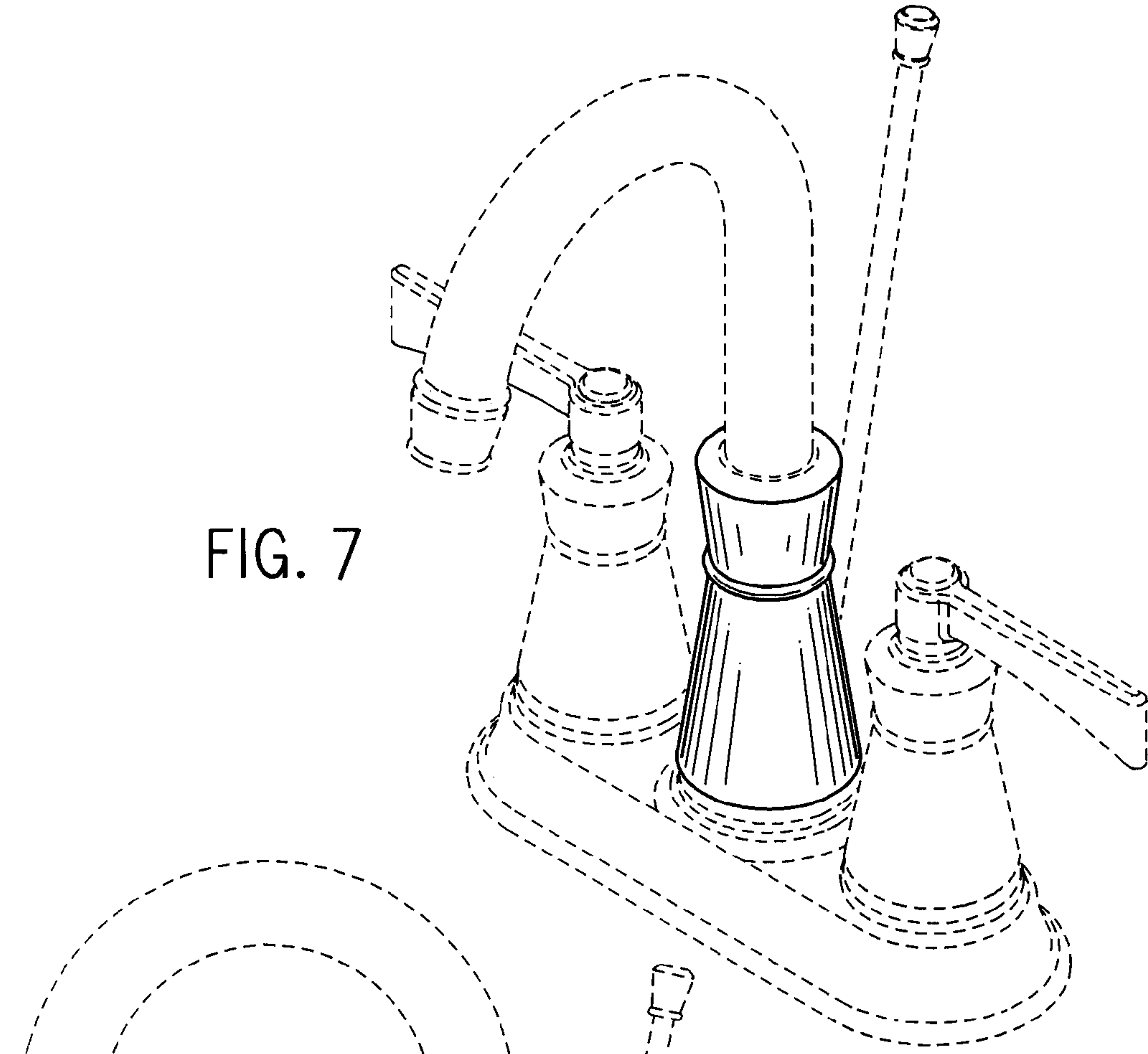
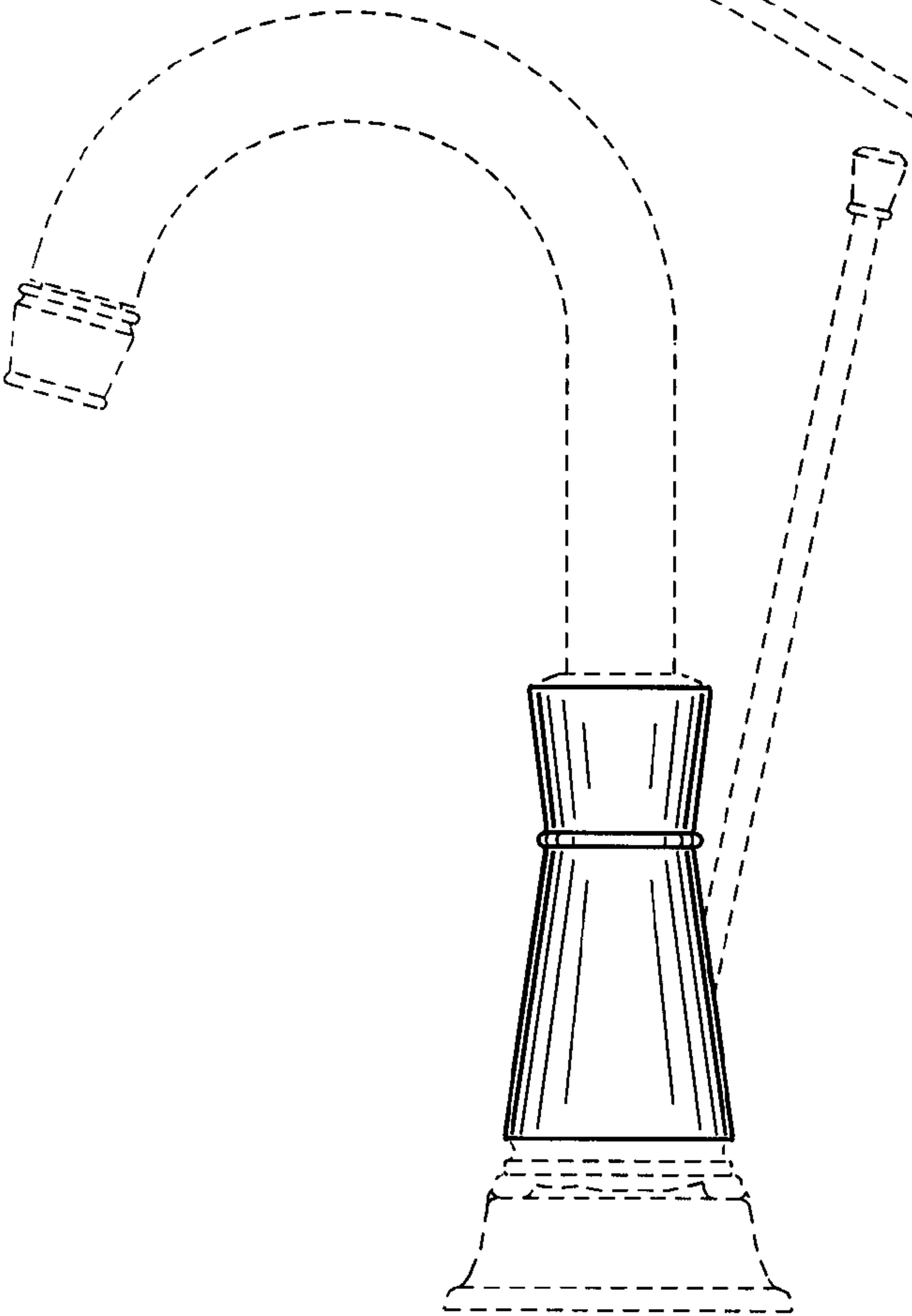

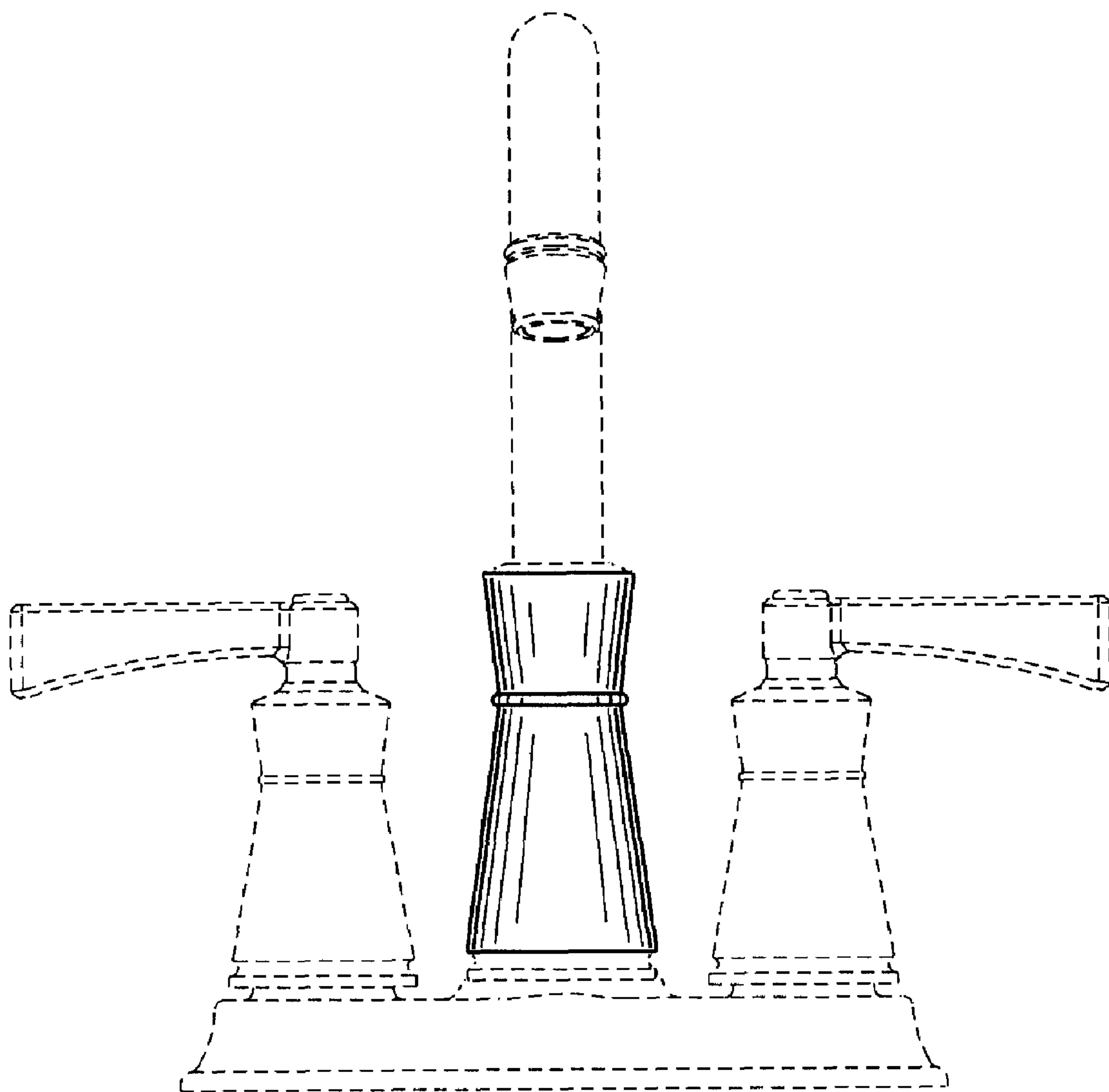

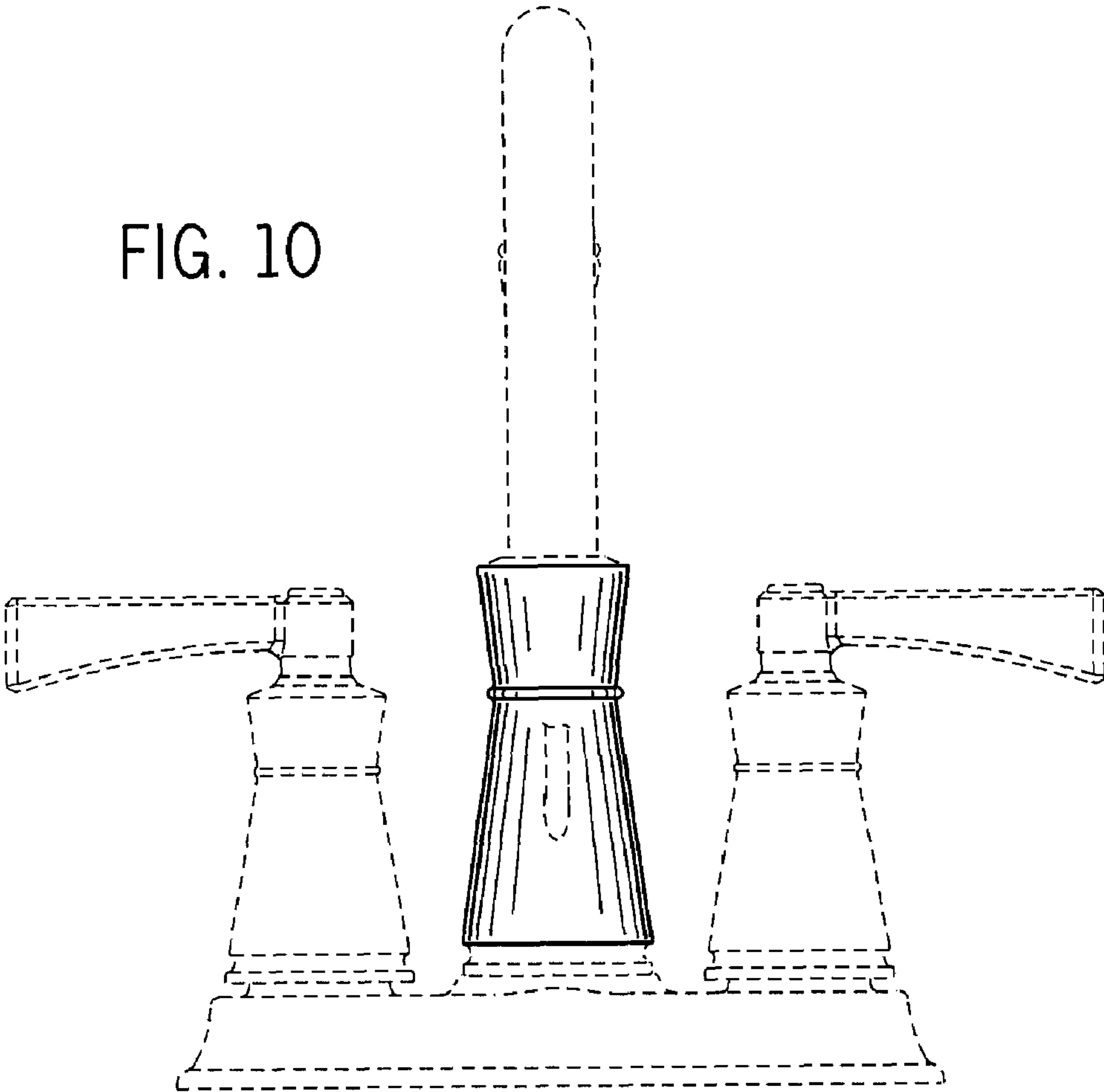
