FIG. 5 is an enlarged end view.

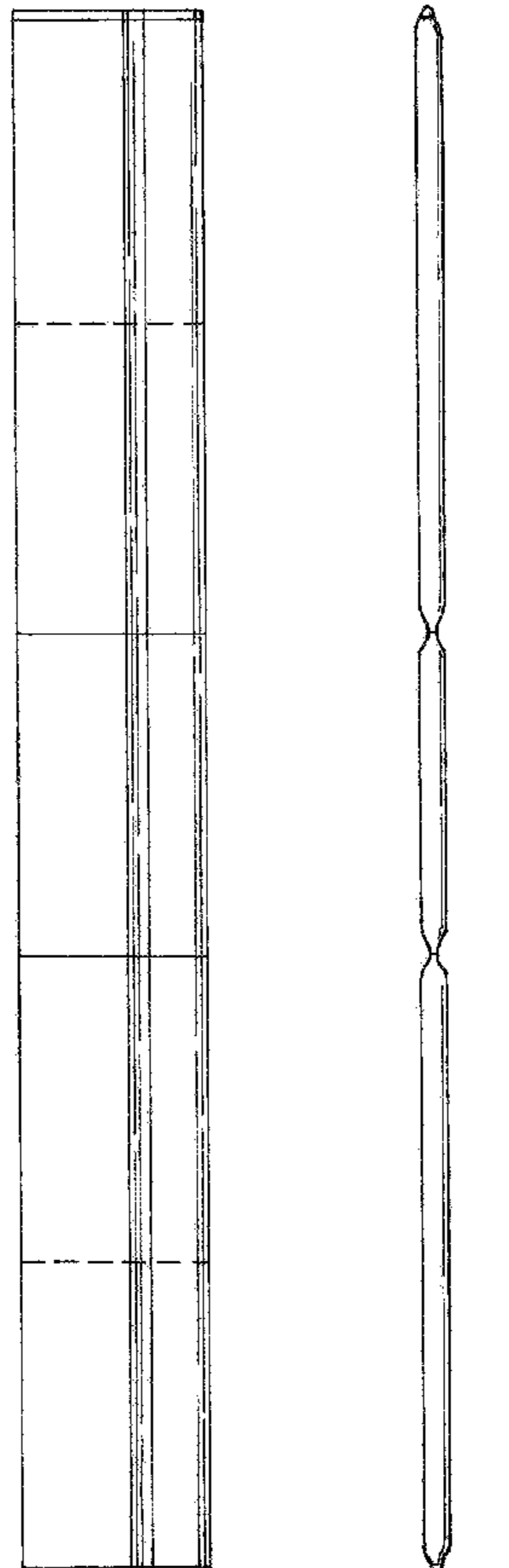
The broken lines shown in FIGS. 1 and 2 are fold lines.

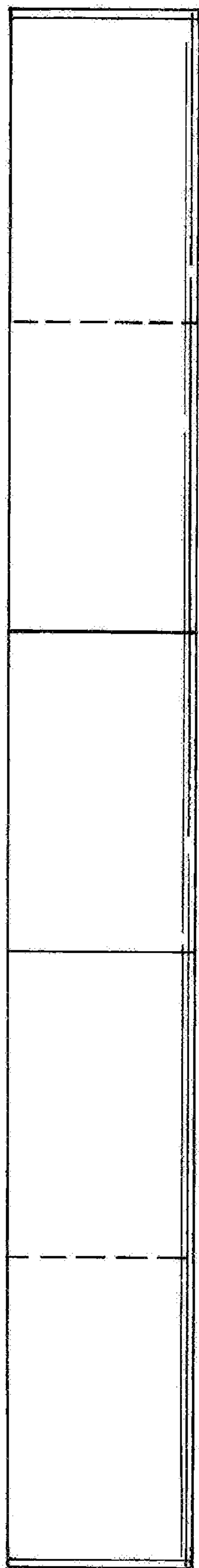

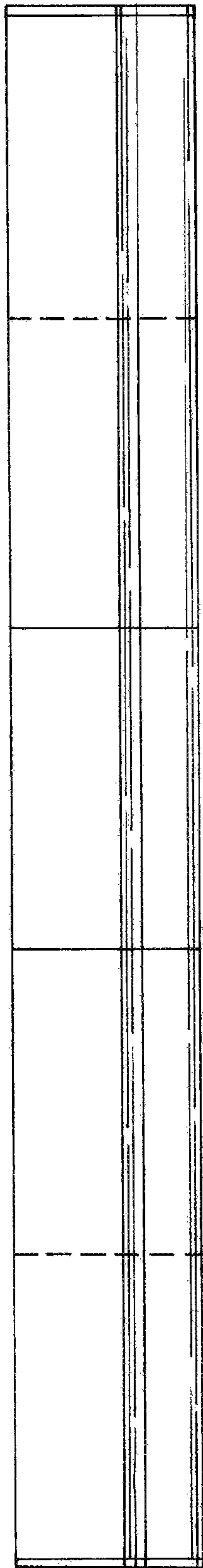
