**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 2—is a left side view thereof; the right side view being a mirror image thereof;

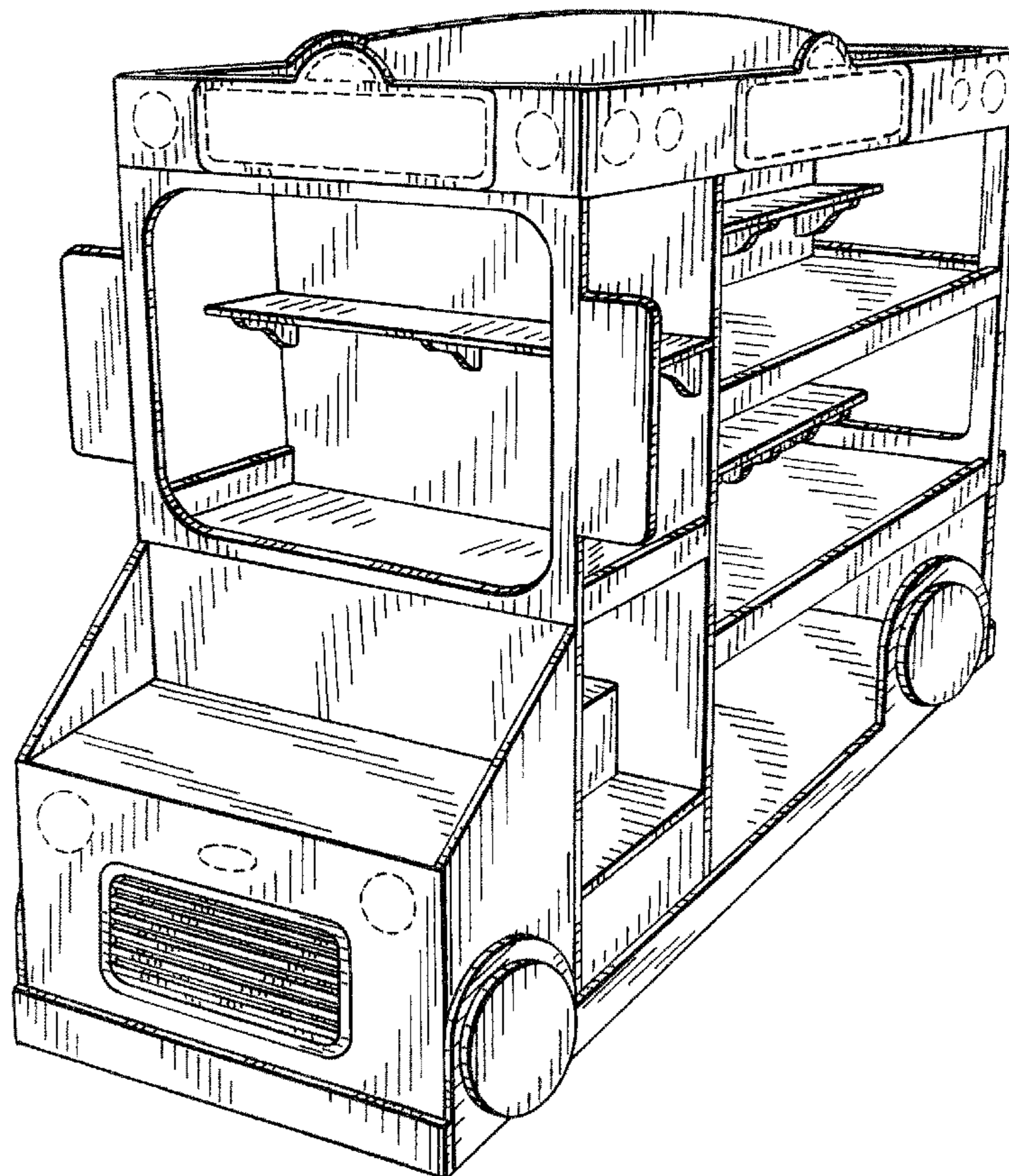
FIG. 3—is a front elevational view thereof;

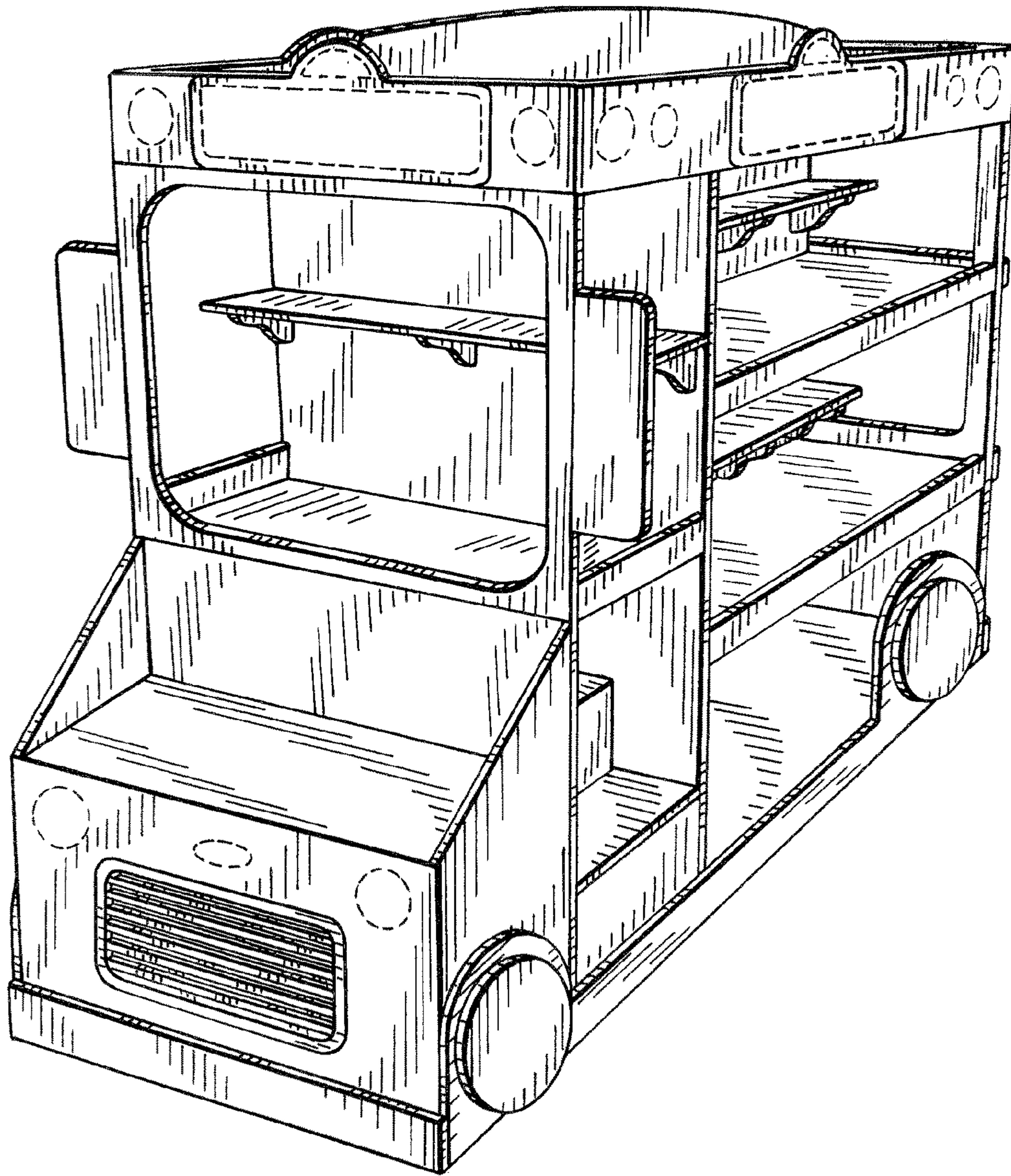

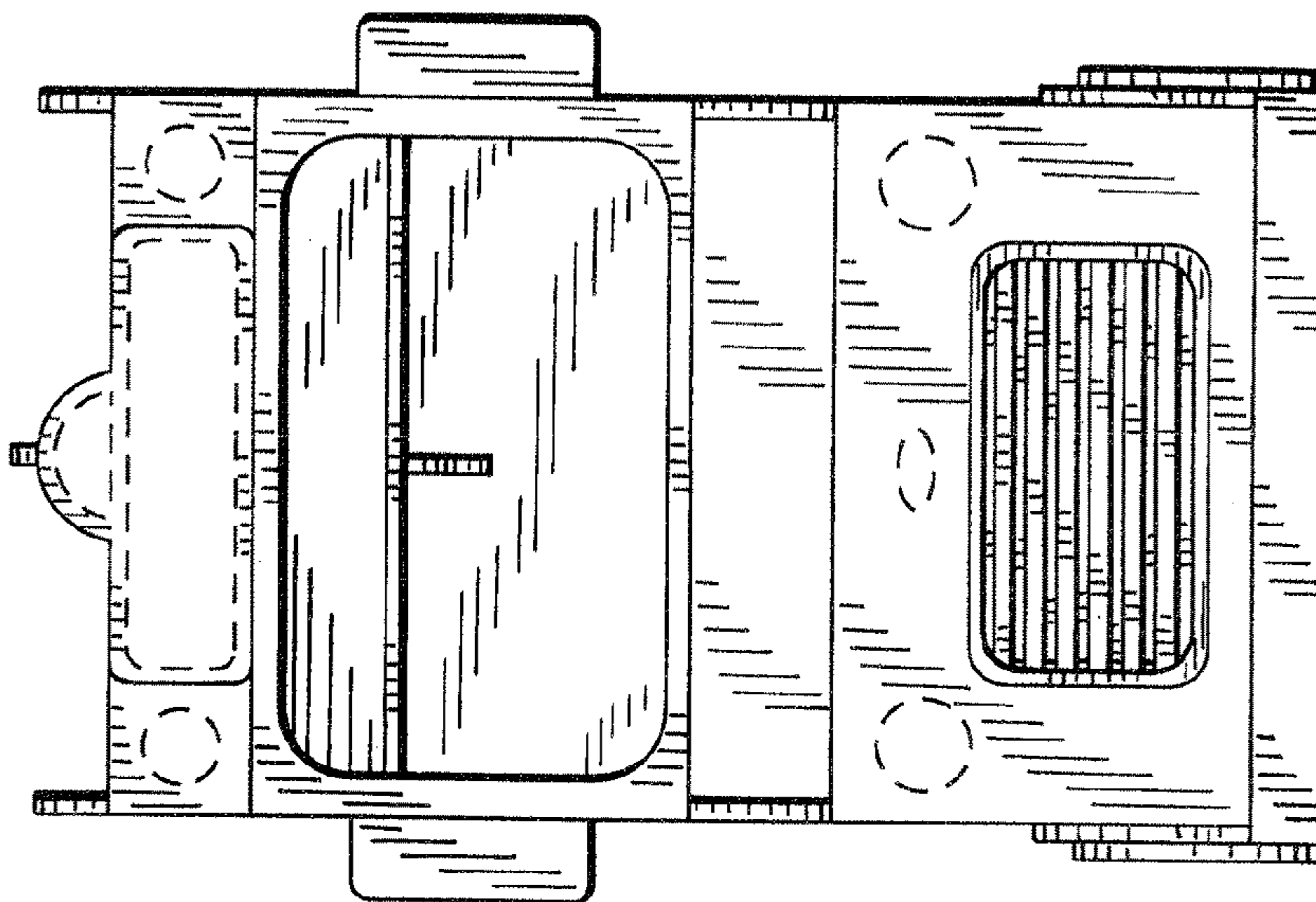
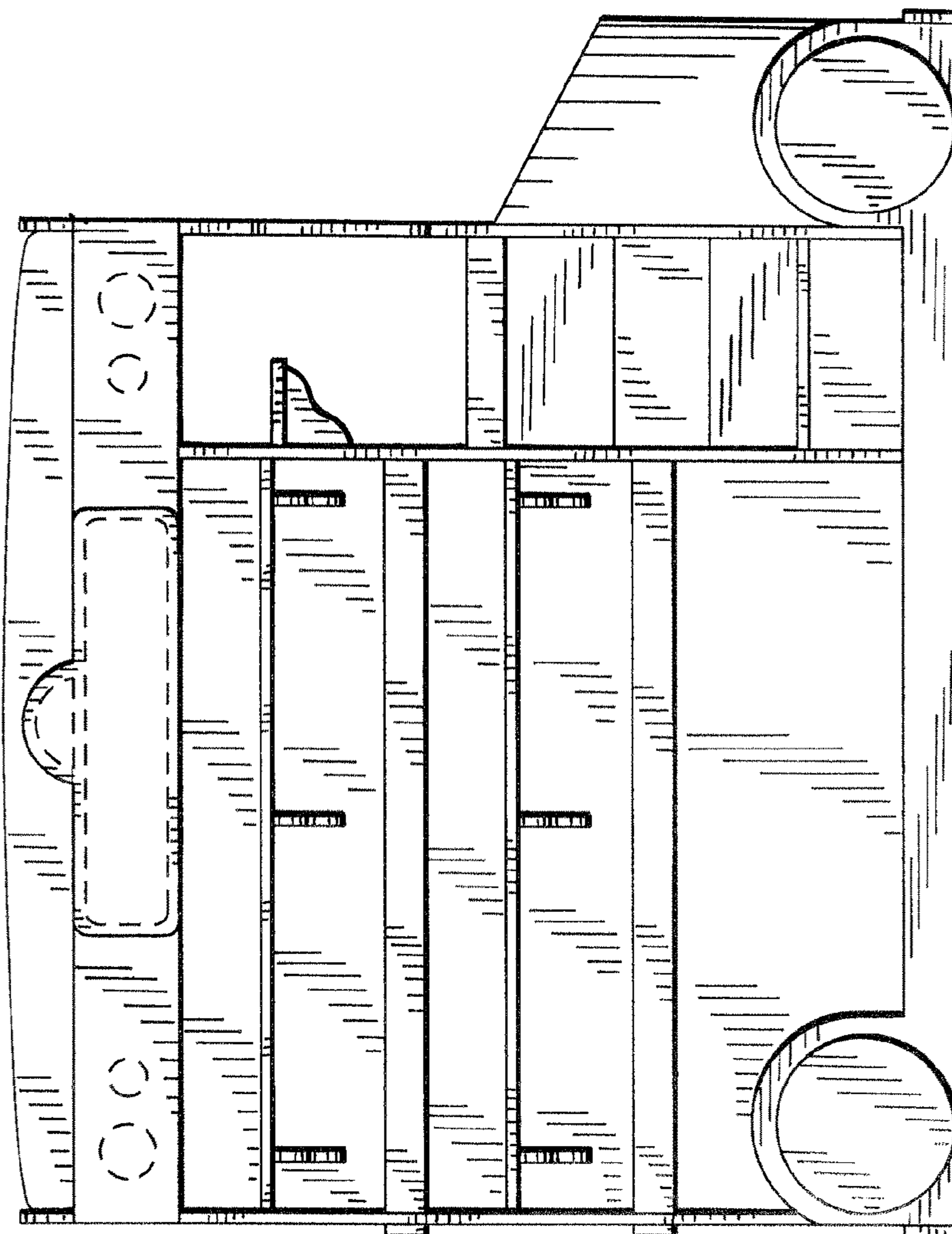

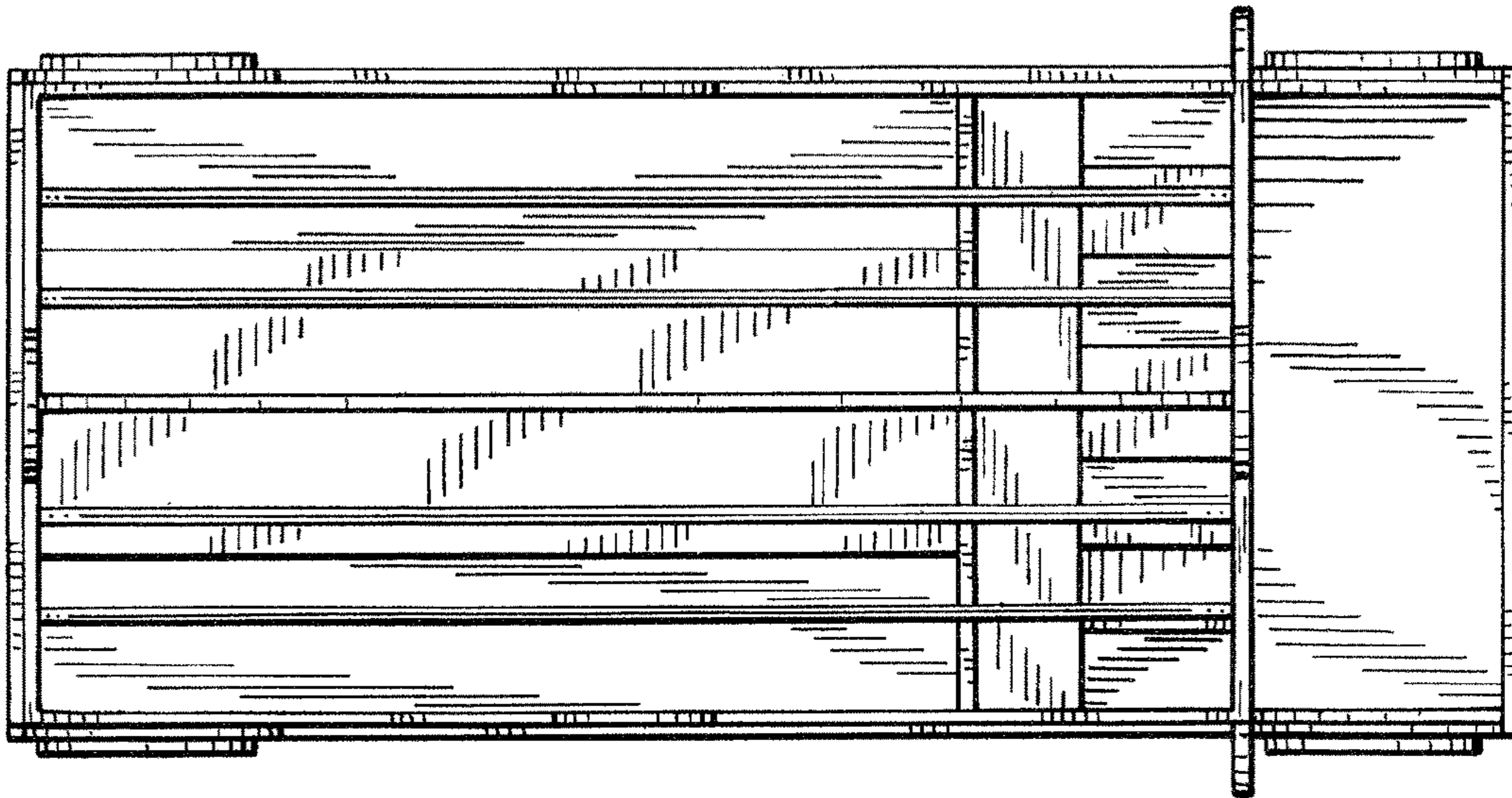

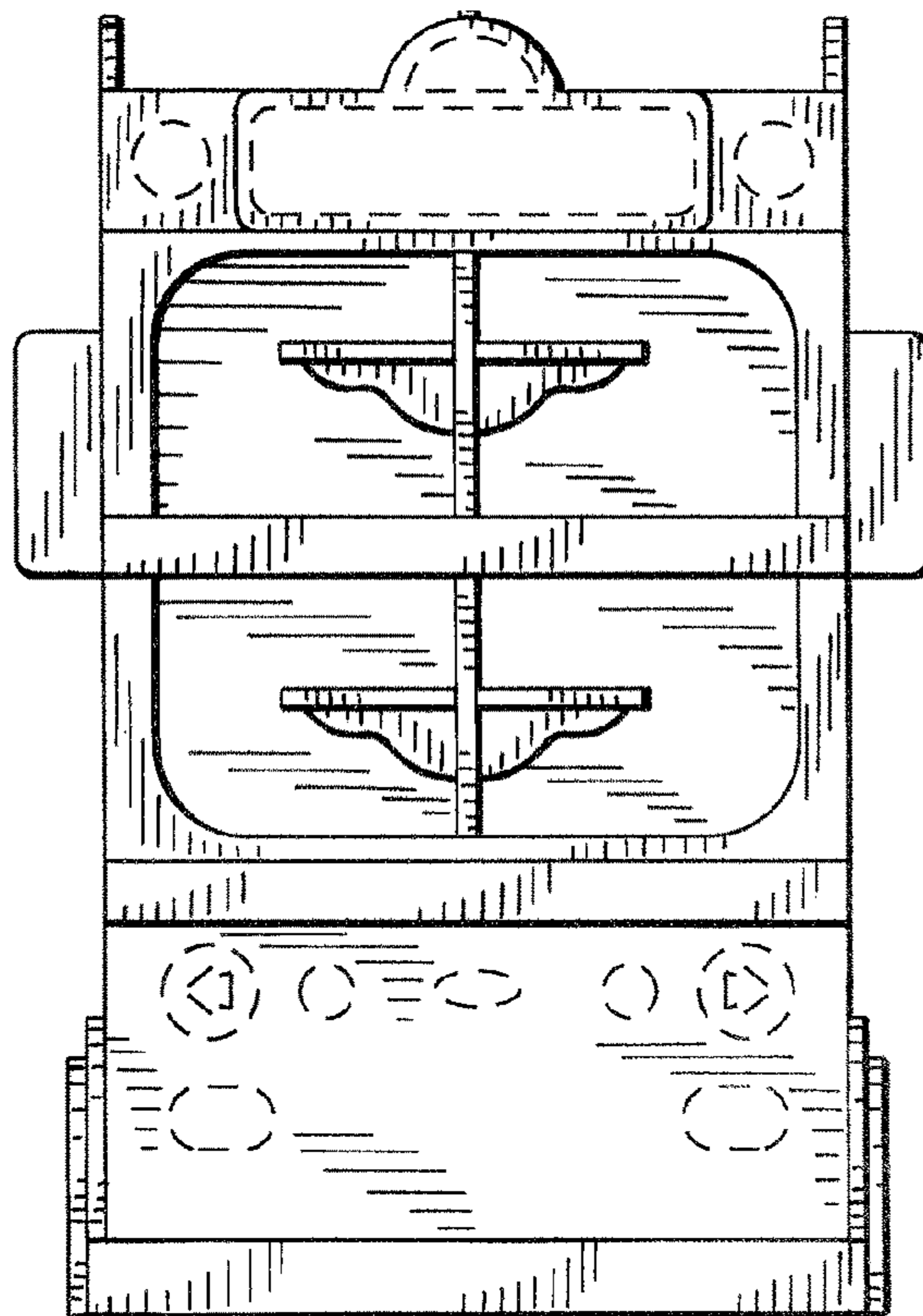
