DESCRIPTION

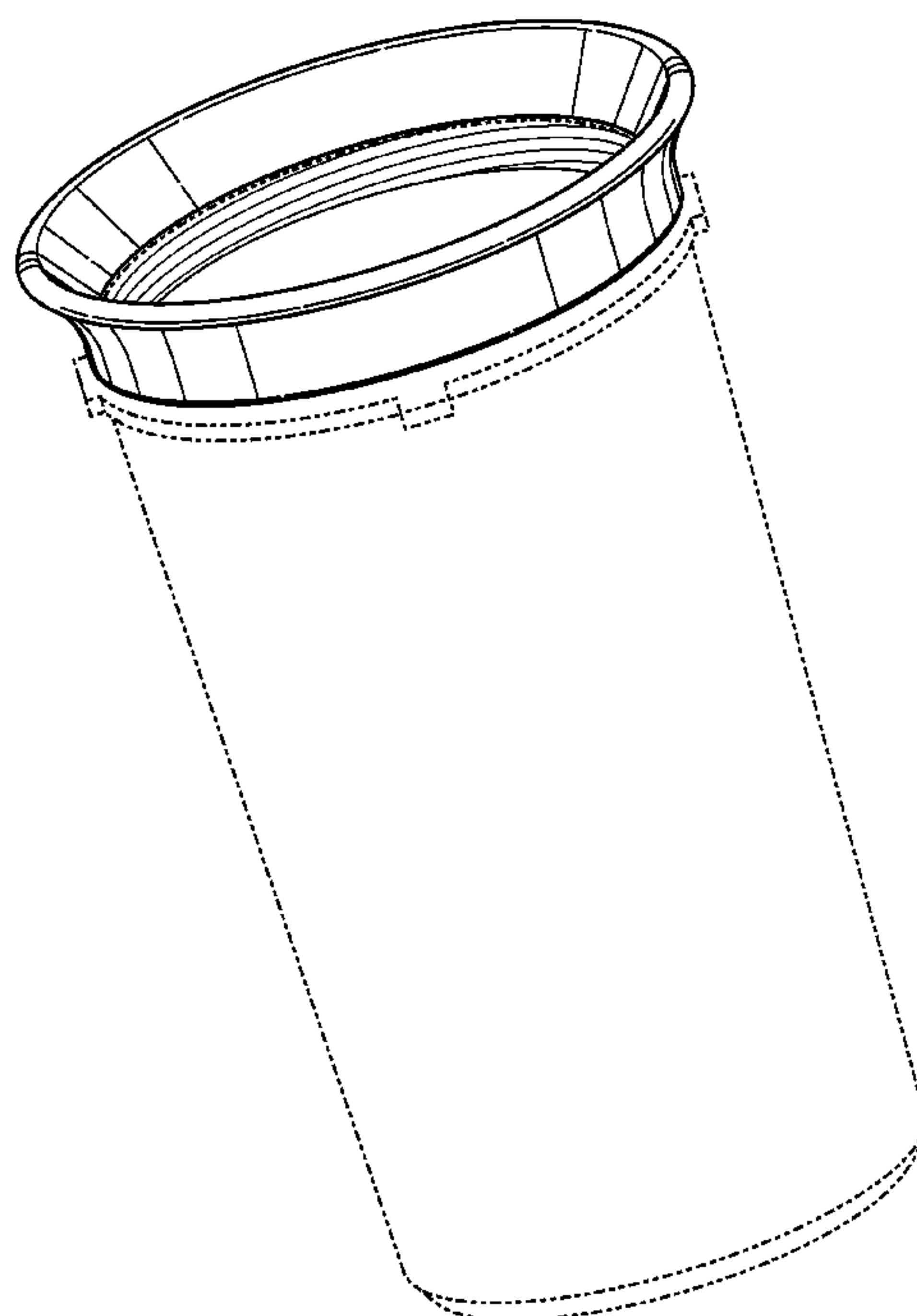
FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a comfort rim for a blender container showing my new design therefor, with the container shown in phantom lines and showing no part of the design;

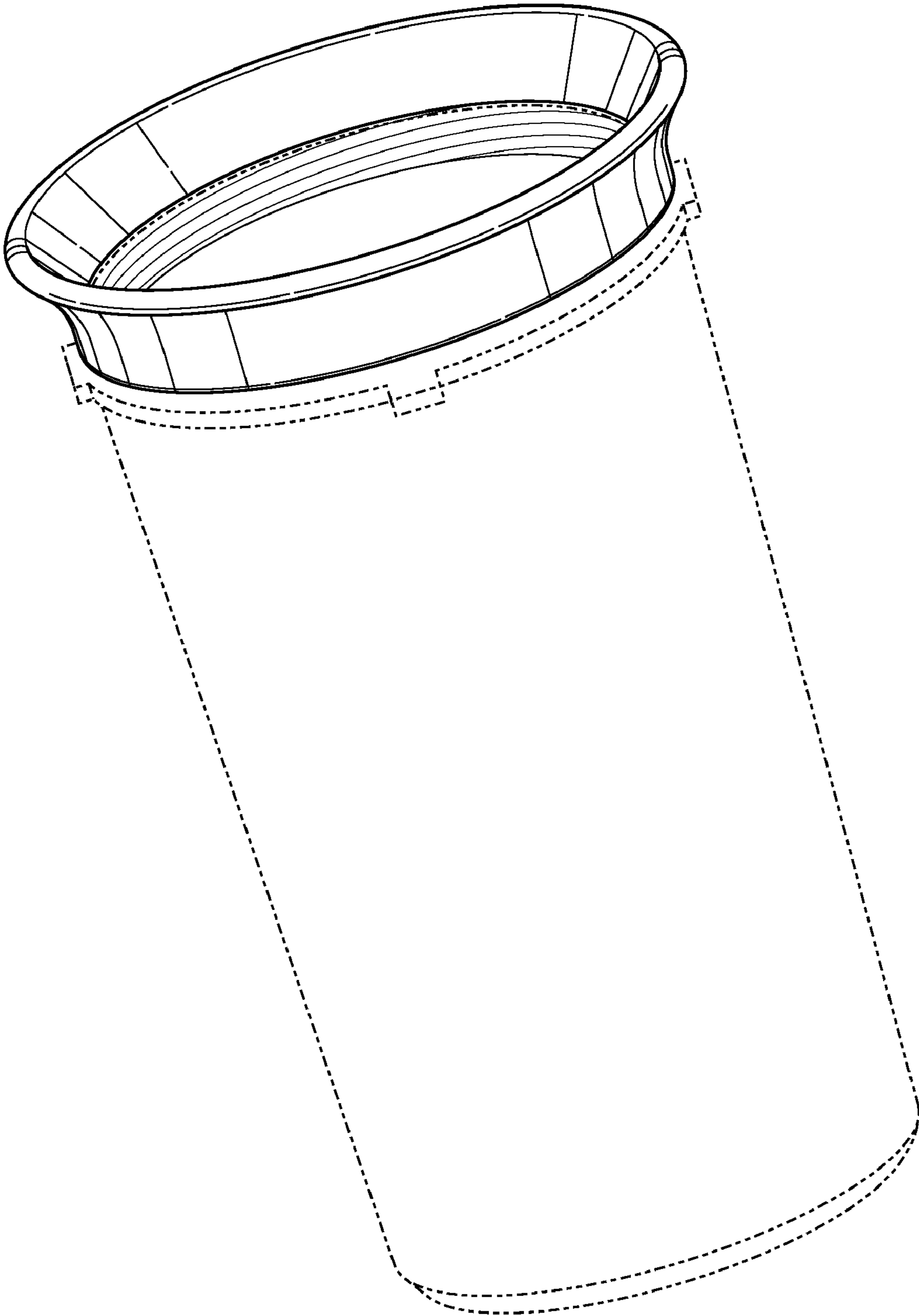

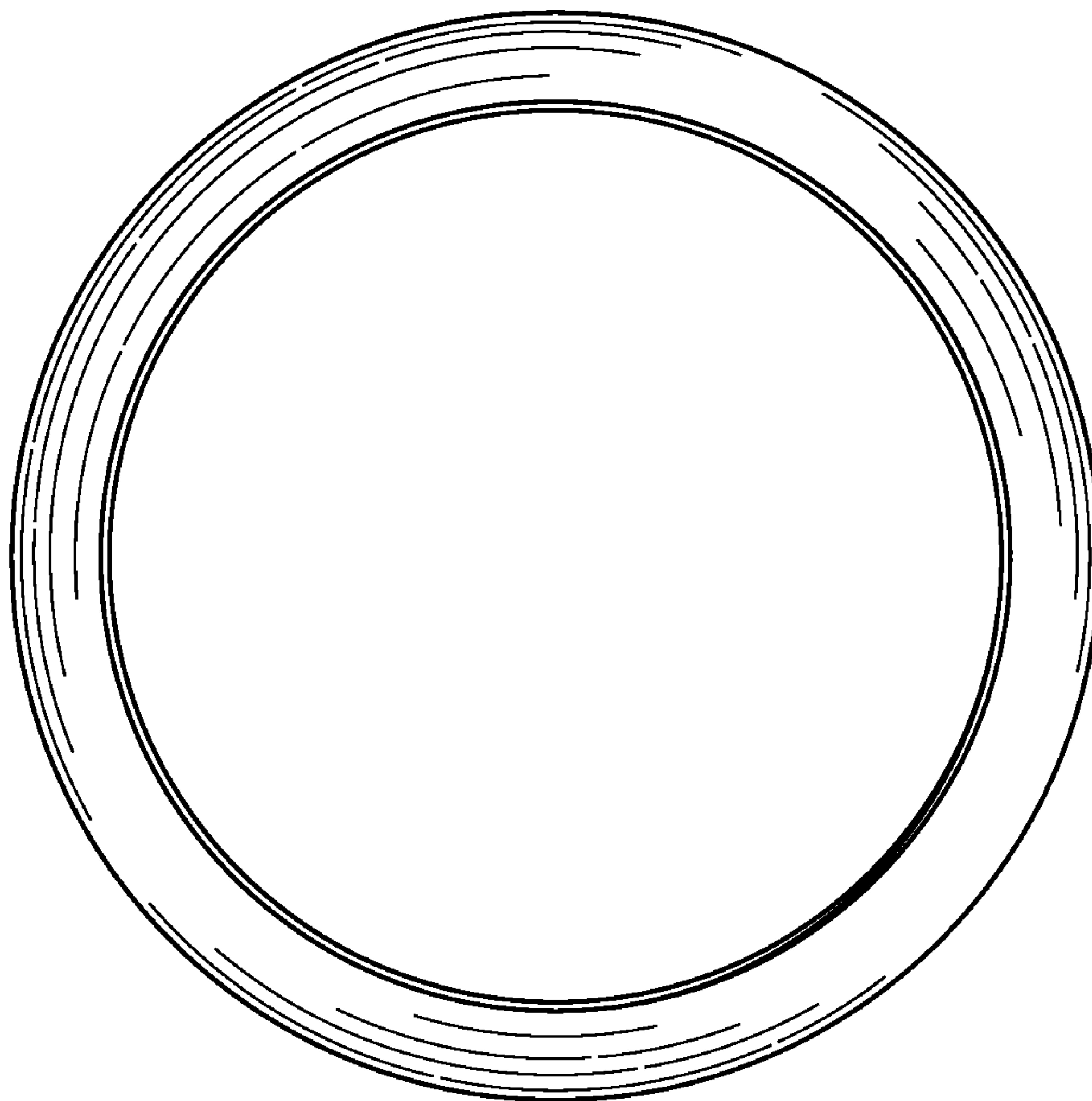

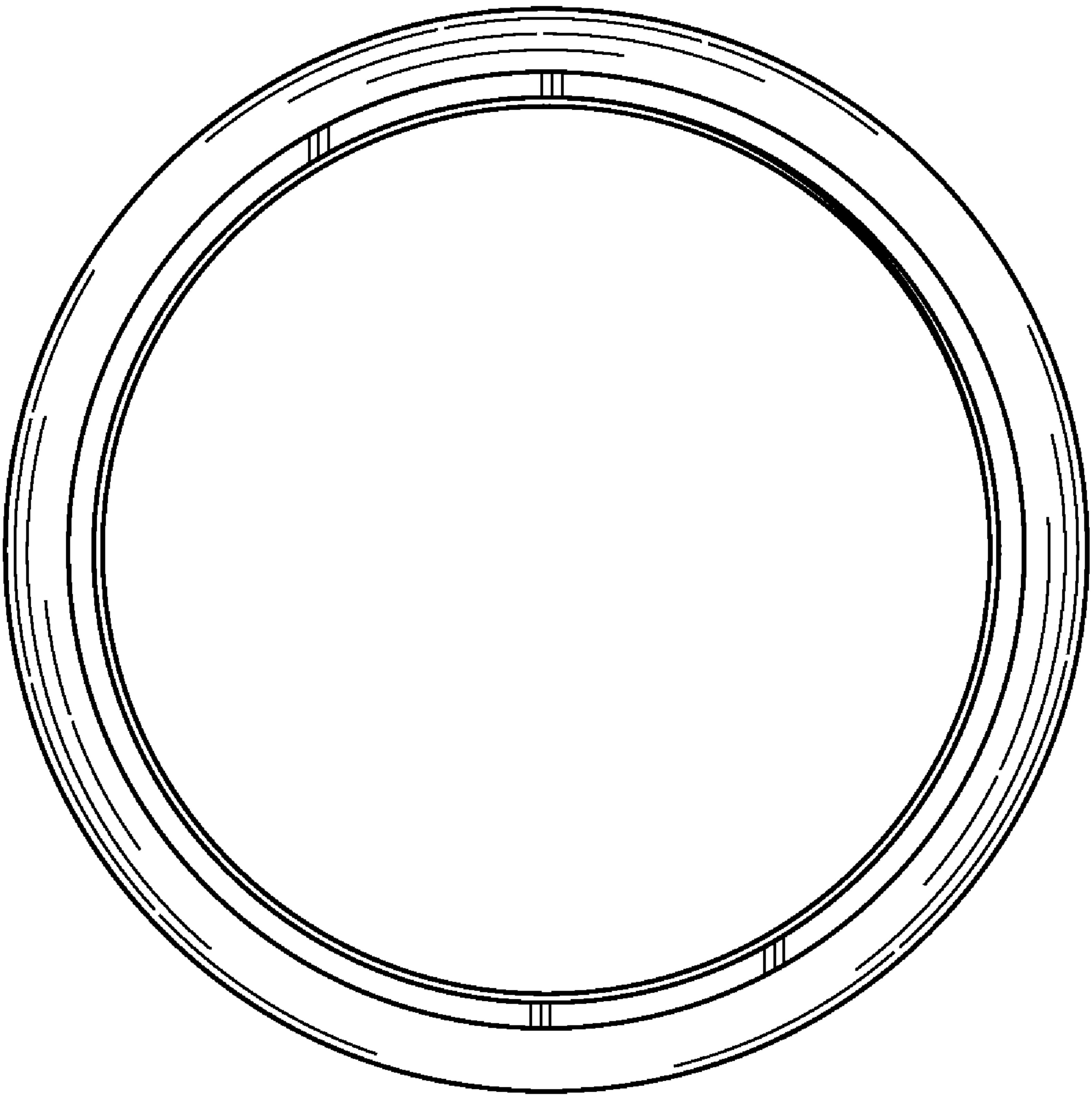
