The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of a chair according to the principles of the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the chair shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the chair shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view of the chair shown in FIG. 1, a left side elevational view not being shown as it is a mirror image of the right side elevational view;

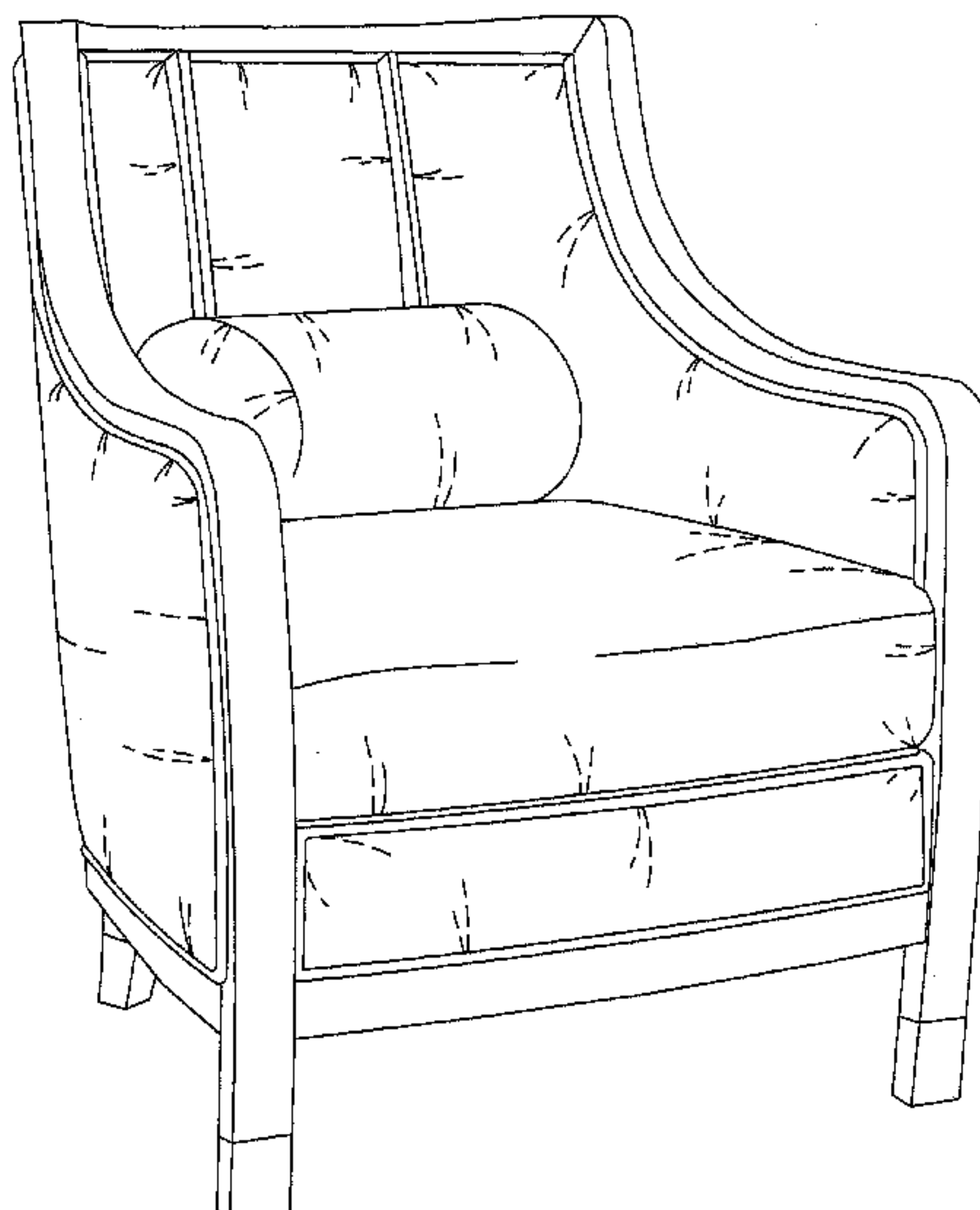
FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the chair shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of a chair according to the principles of the present invention;

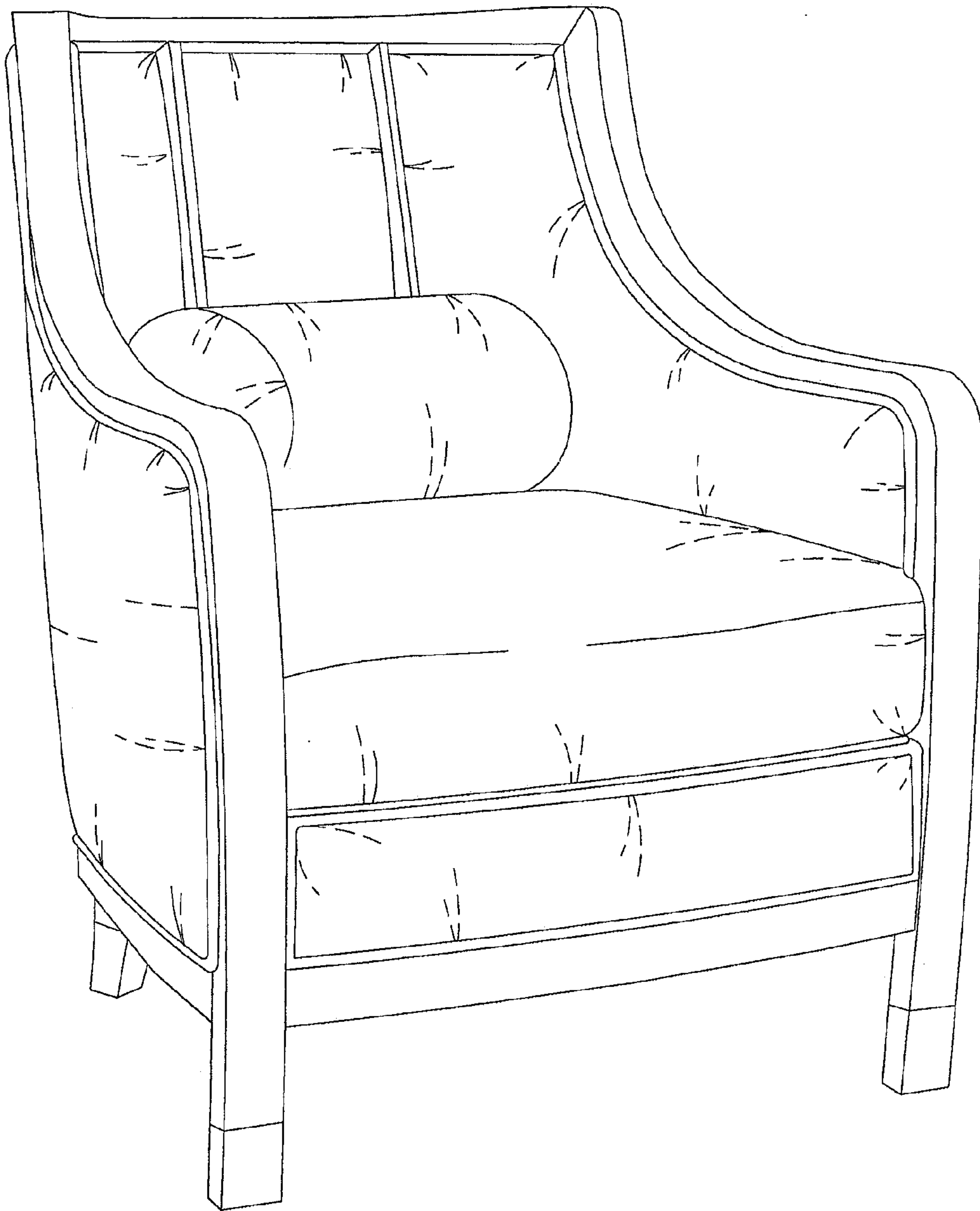

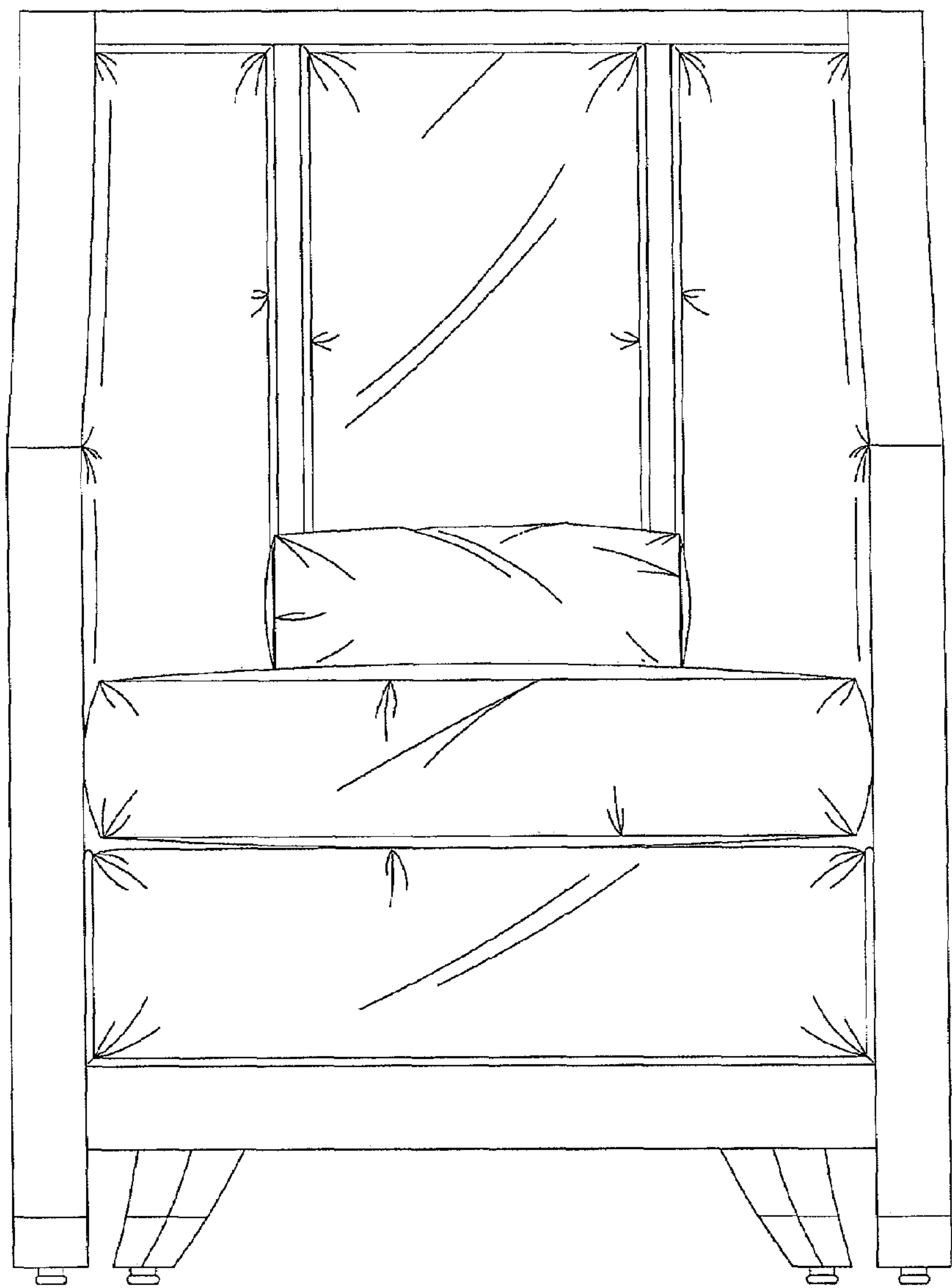

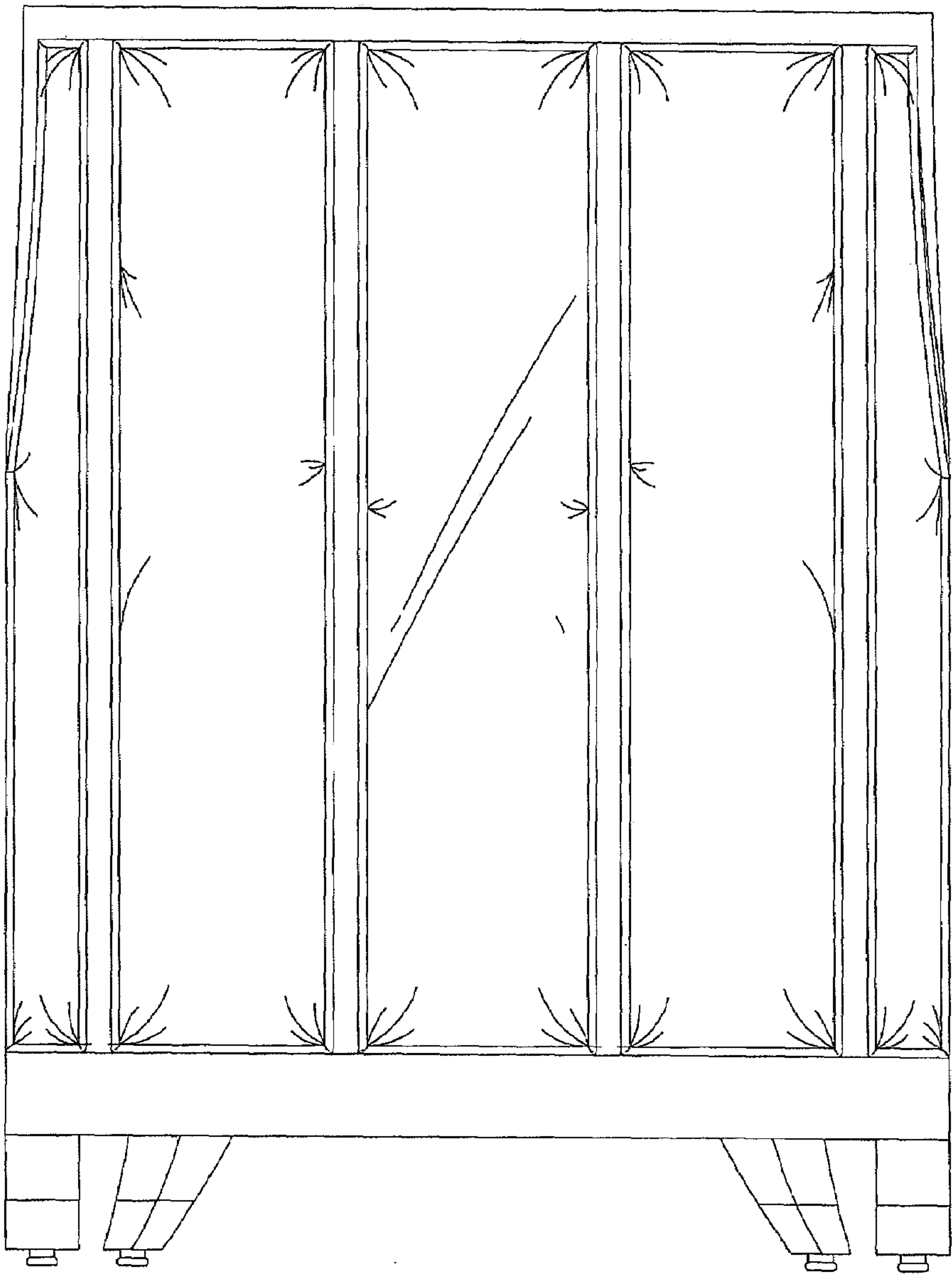

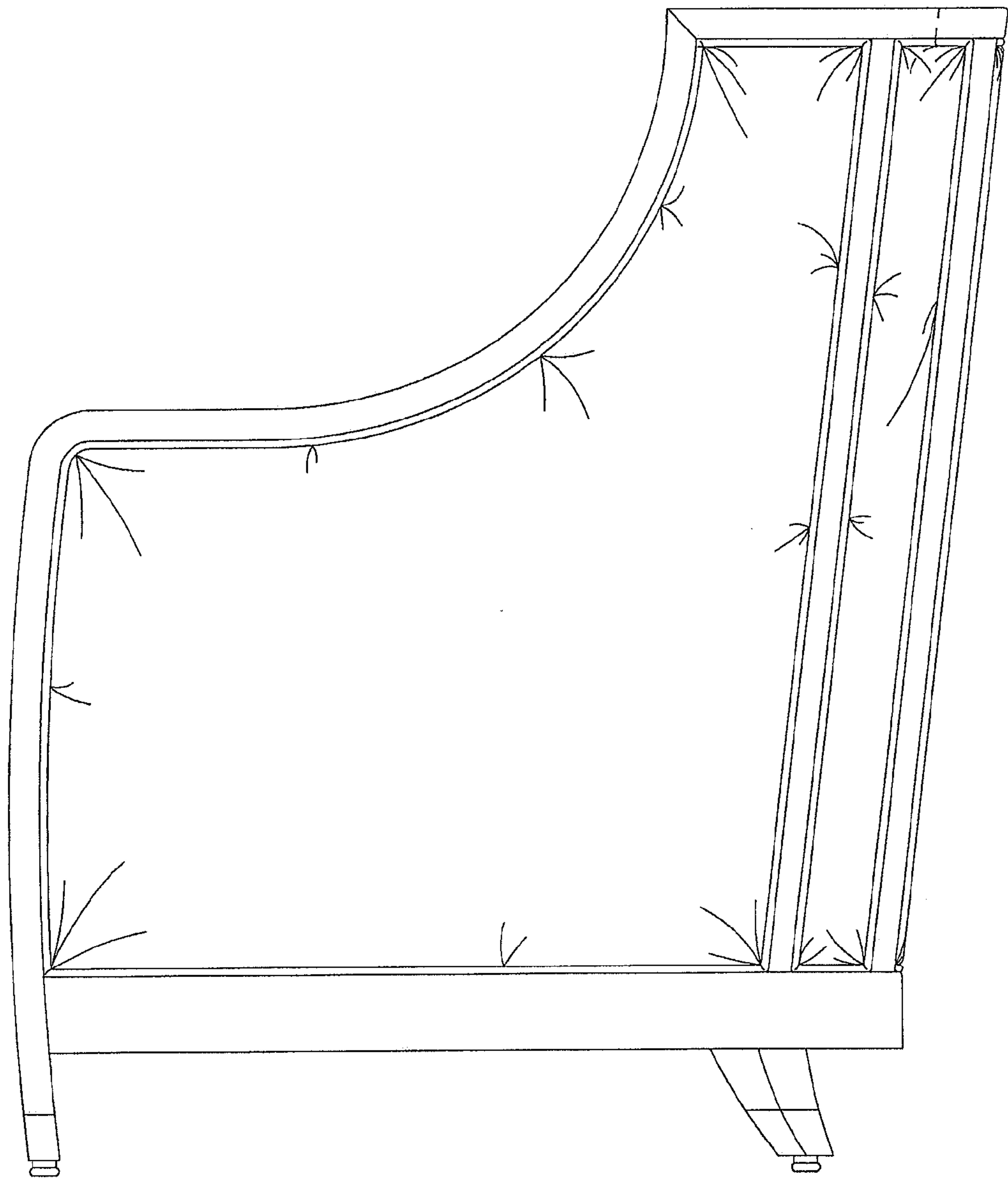

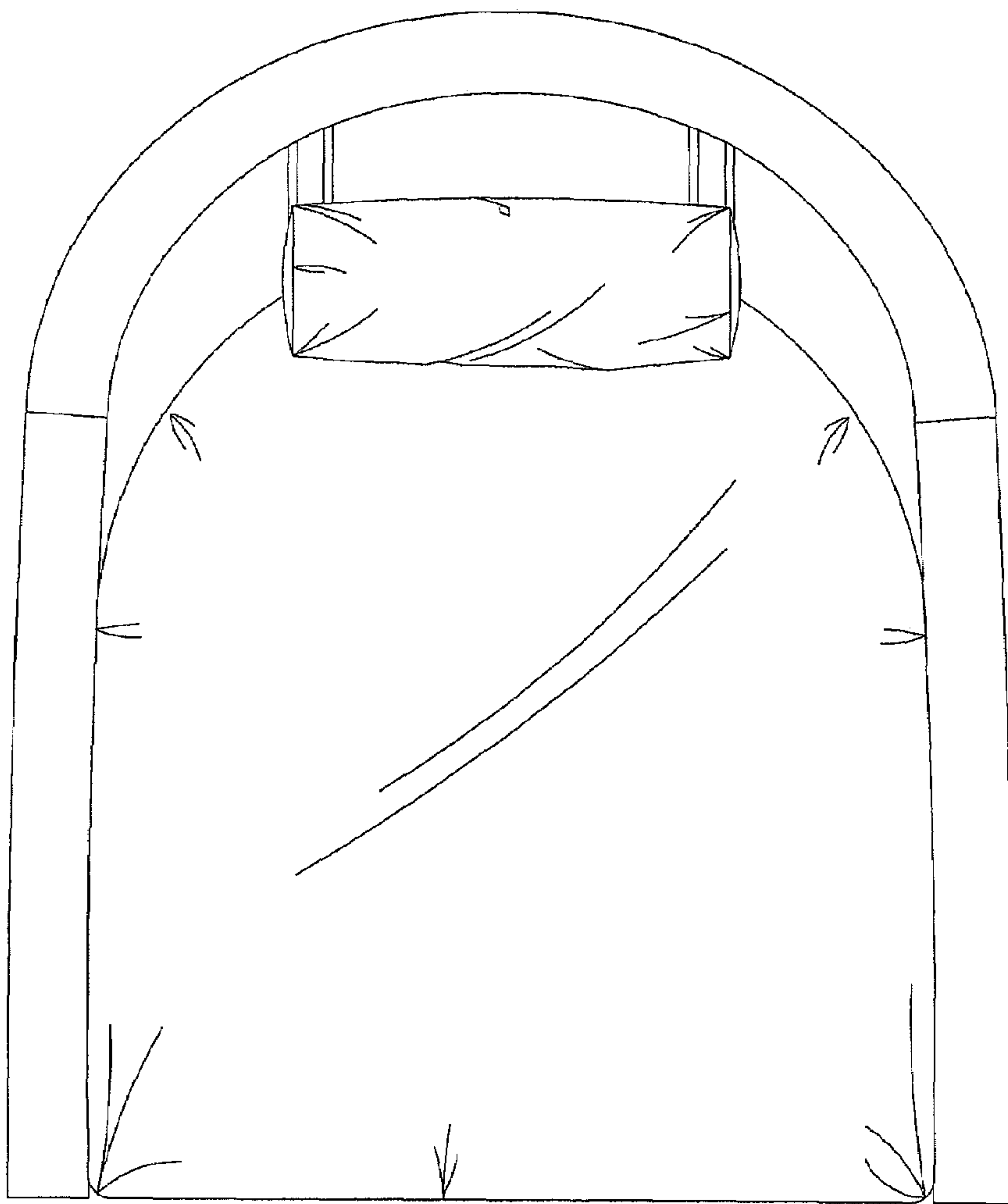

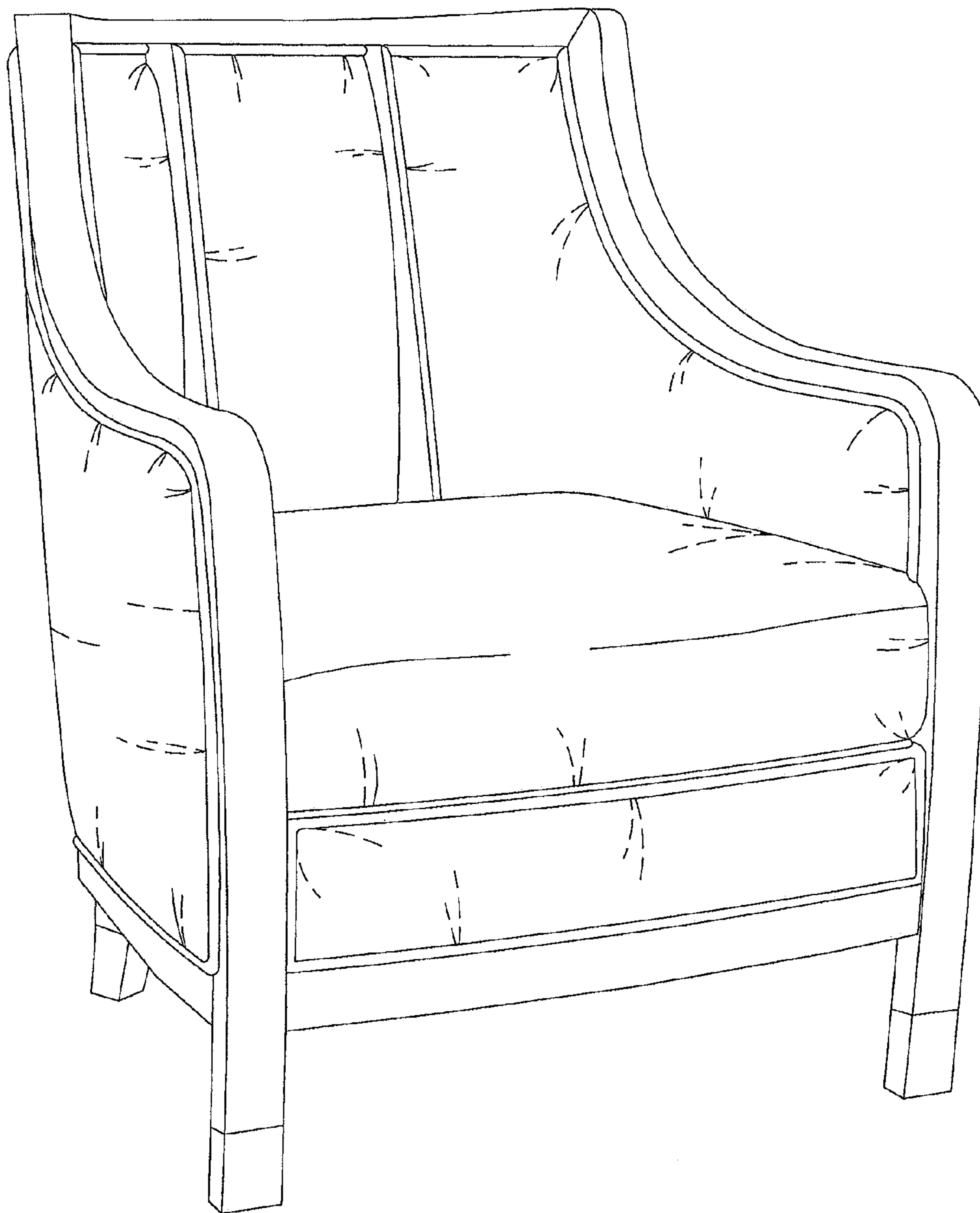

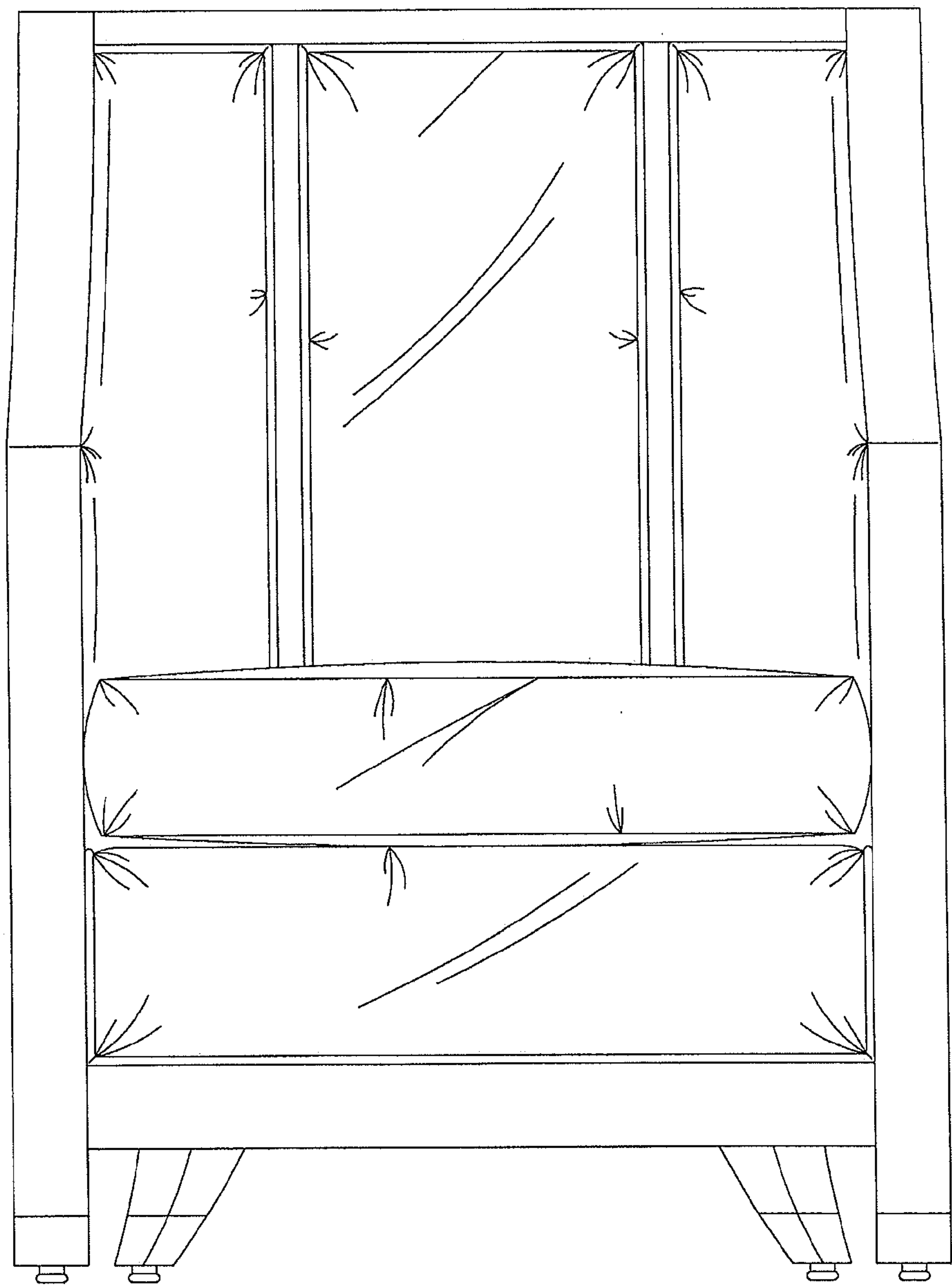
