(57) **CLAIM**

We claim an ornamental design for the one-piece molded old world tuscan wainscot panel, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a one-piece molded old world tuscan wainscot panel showing our design;

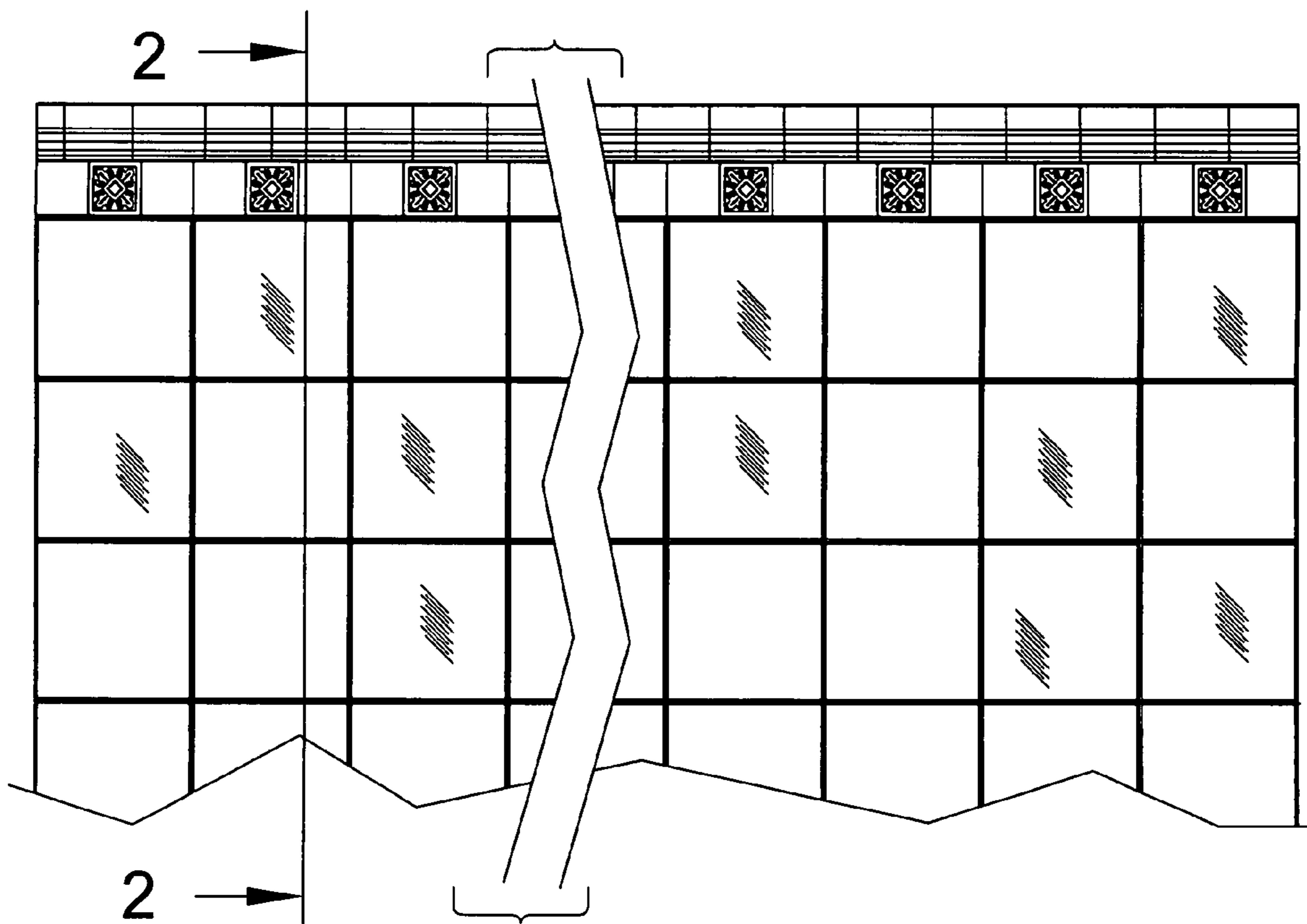
FIG. 2 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 2—2 of FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 3 is a blown up view of the squares shown in the design in FIG. 1.

The right side, left side, top, bottom and back of the one-piece molded old world tuscan wainscot panel are flat and unadorned and do not form a part of the claimed design.

The claimed design is broken on one end and in the center to indicate indeterminate length and width thereof.

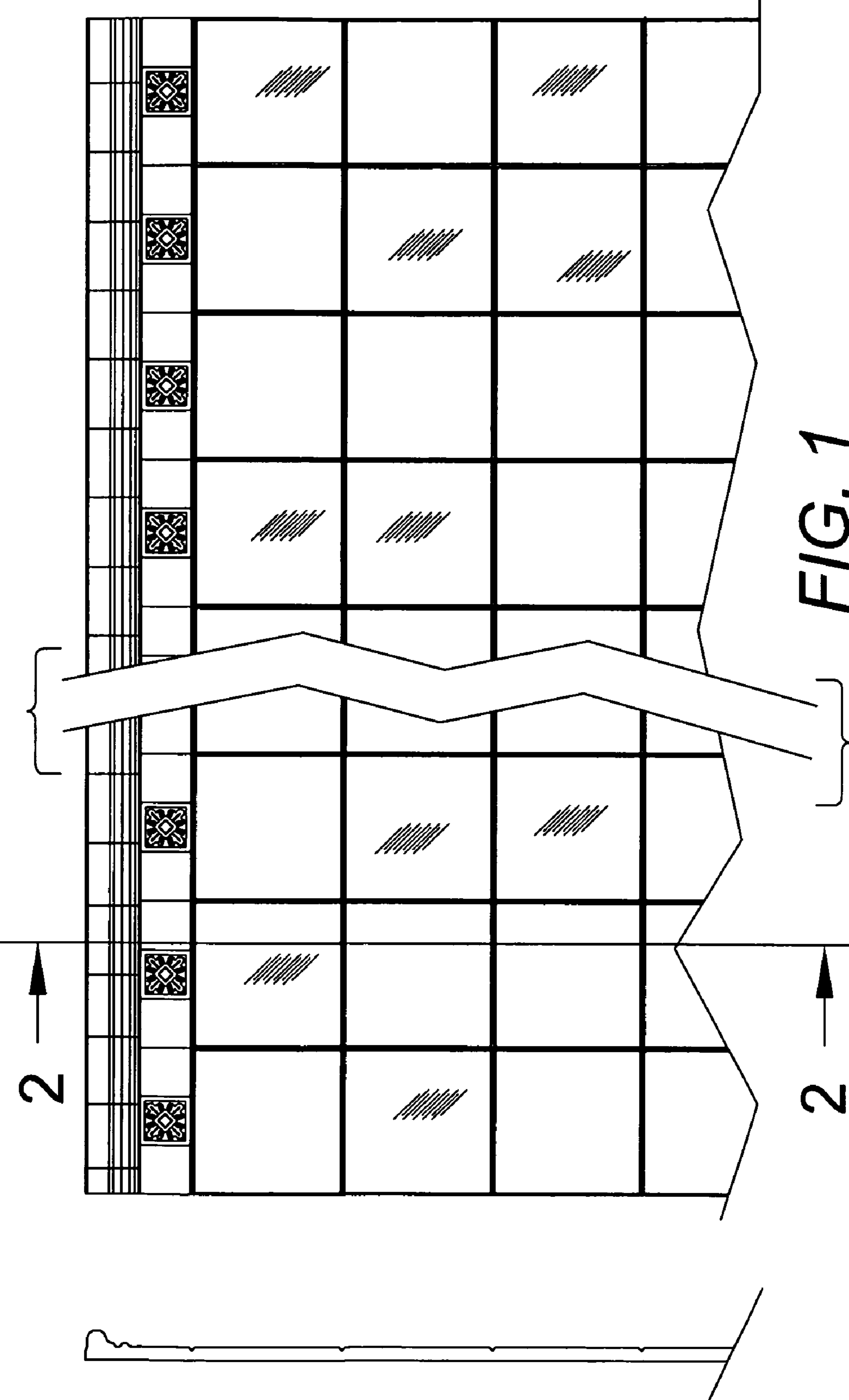

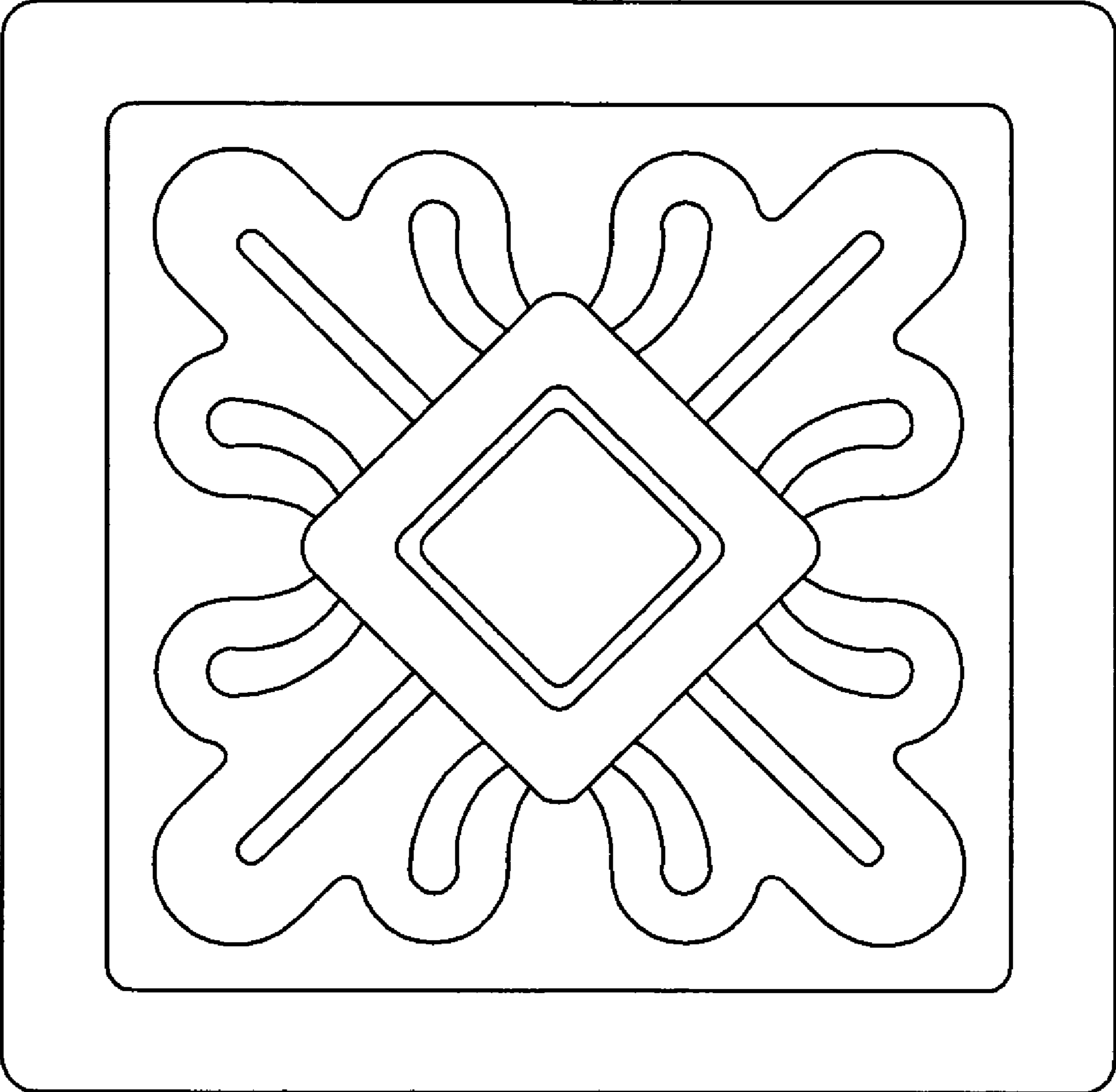
