showing my new design;

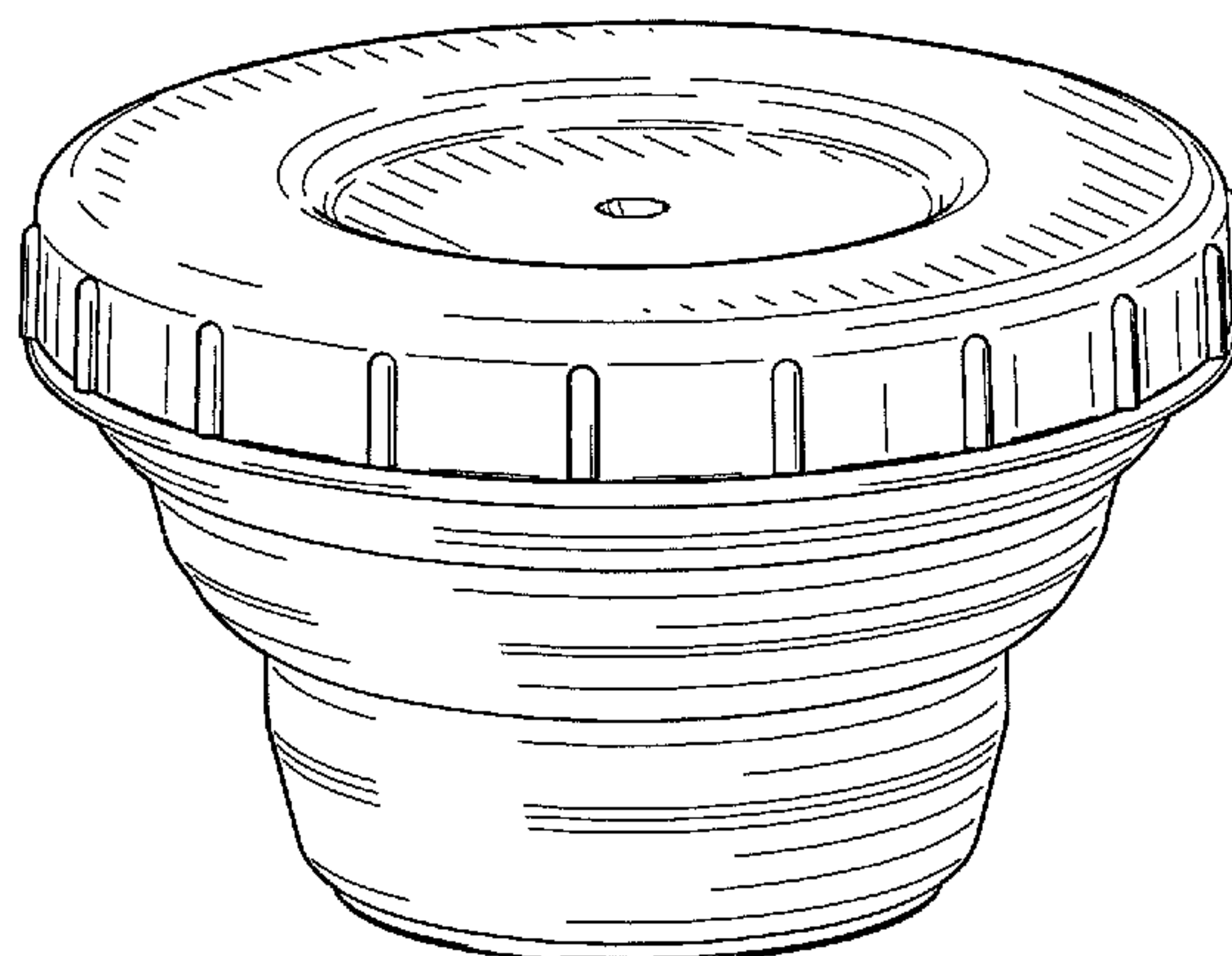
FIG. 2 is a front view of the collapsible bowl with lid, the back

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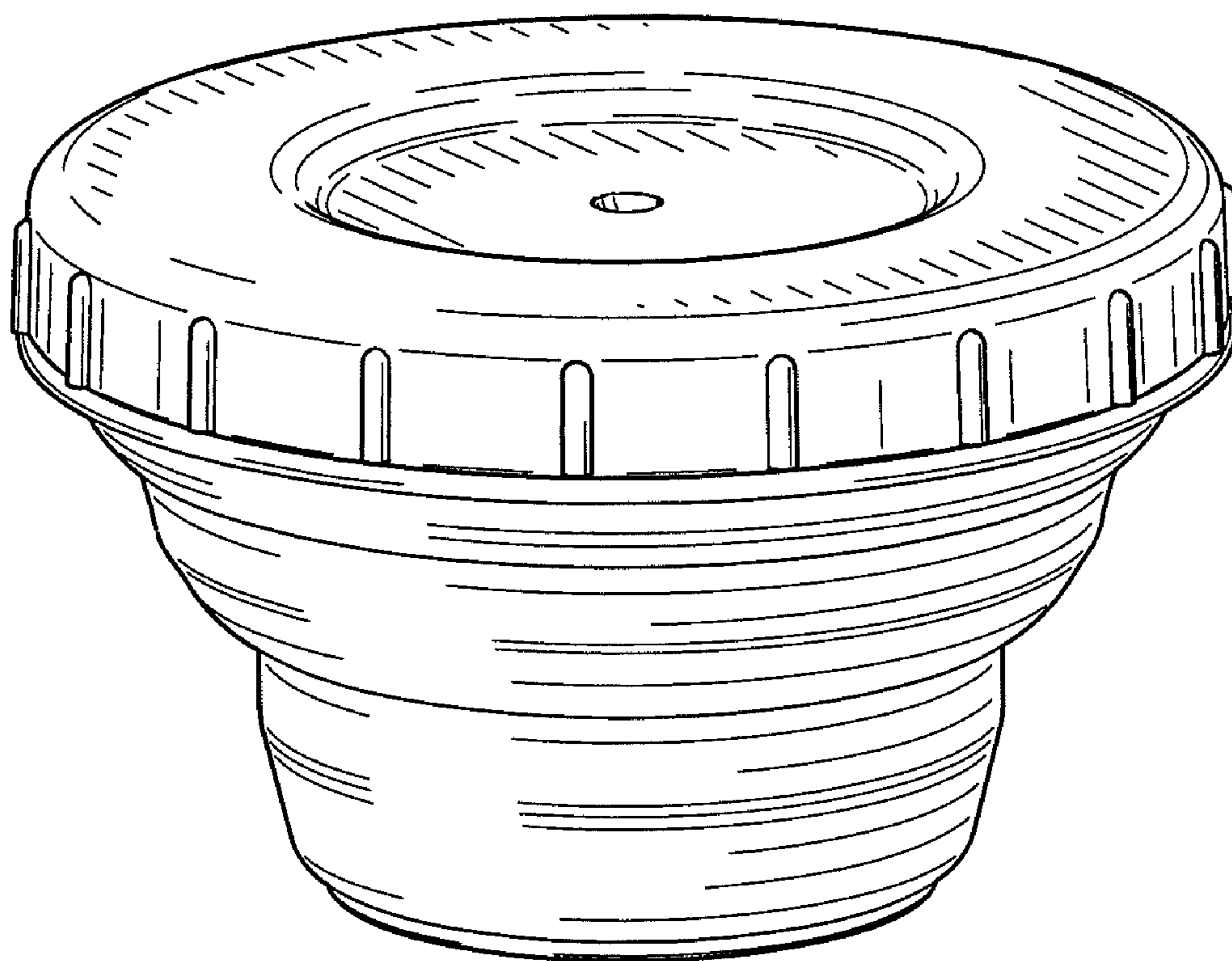

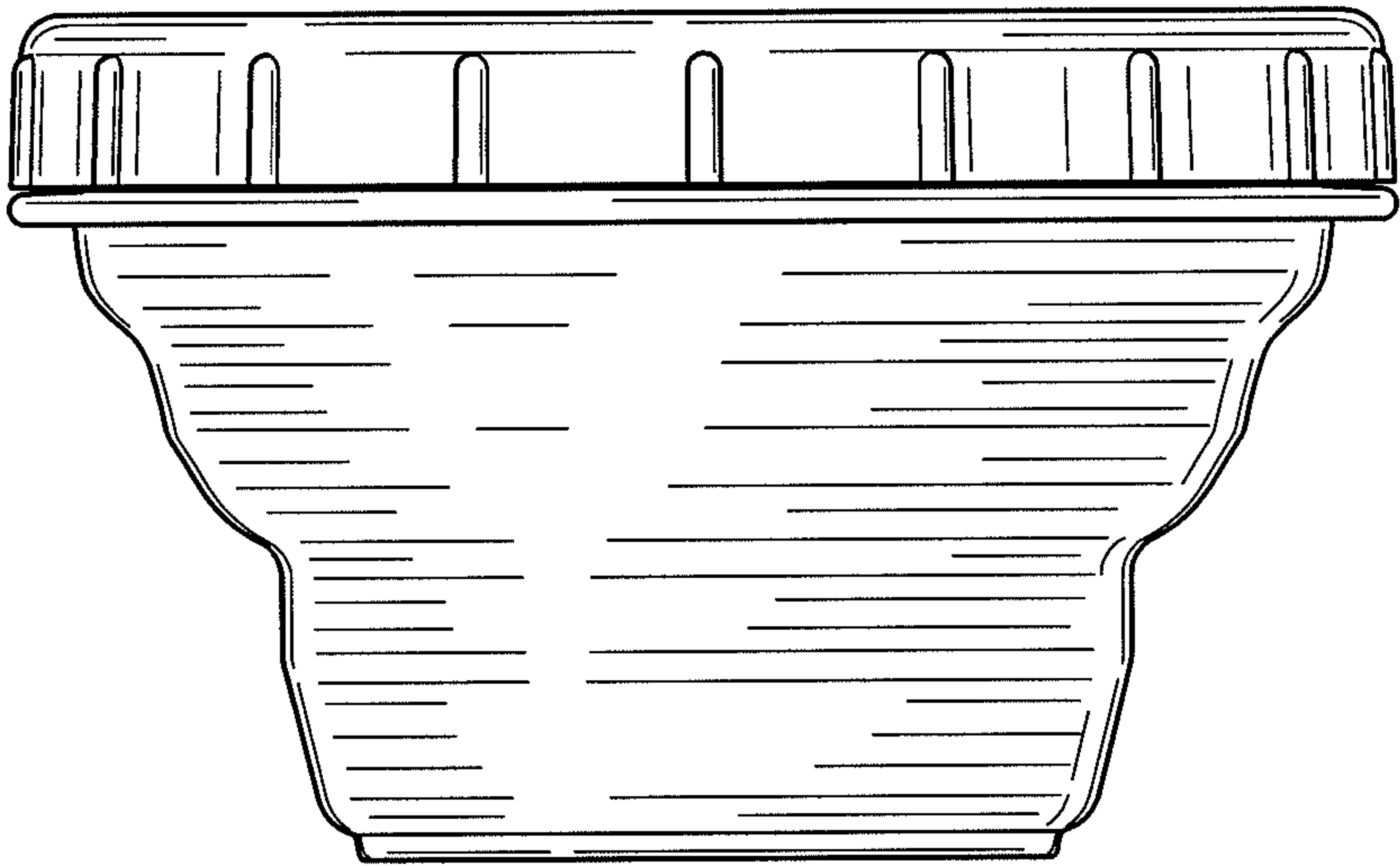

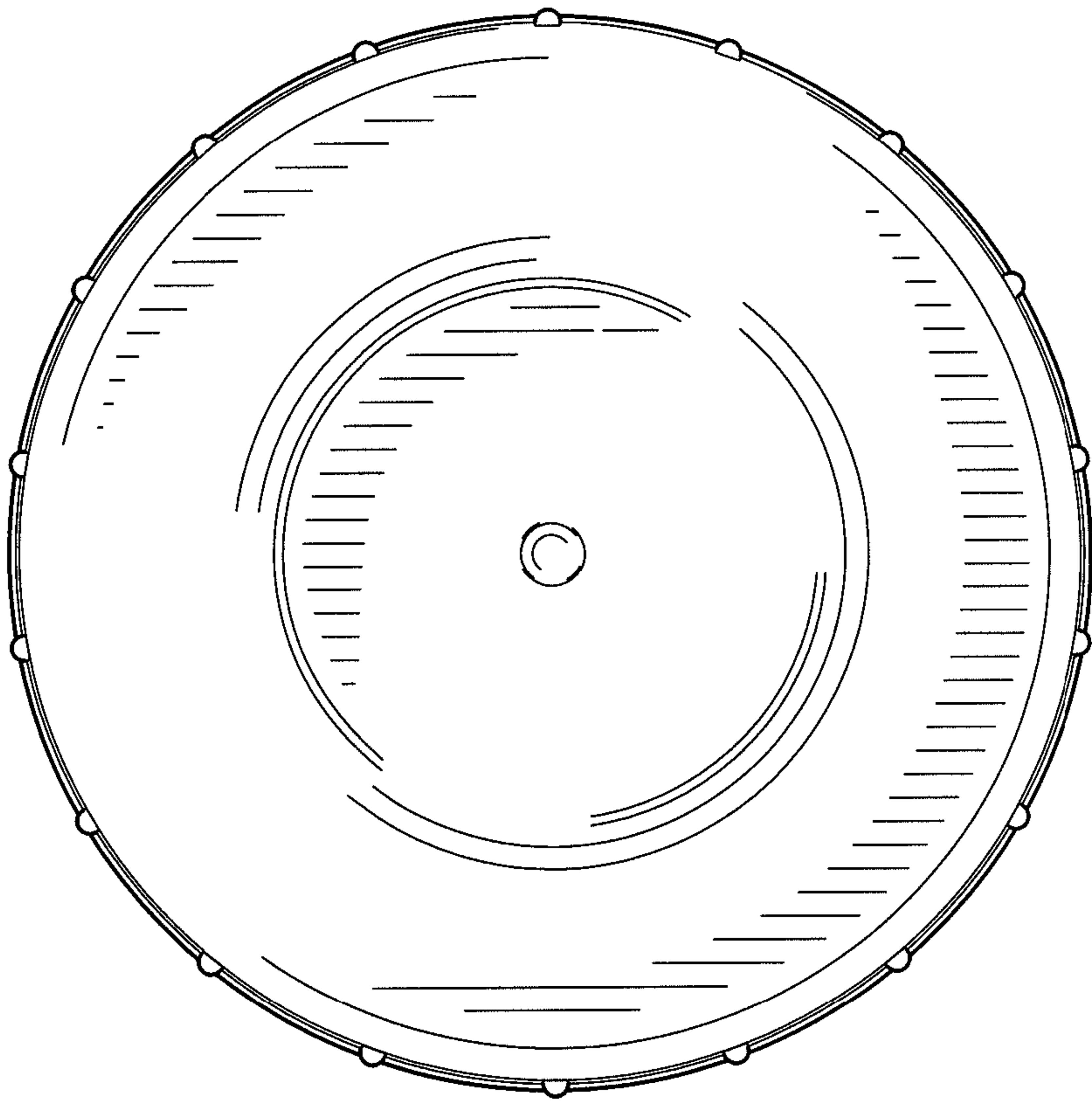

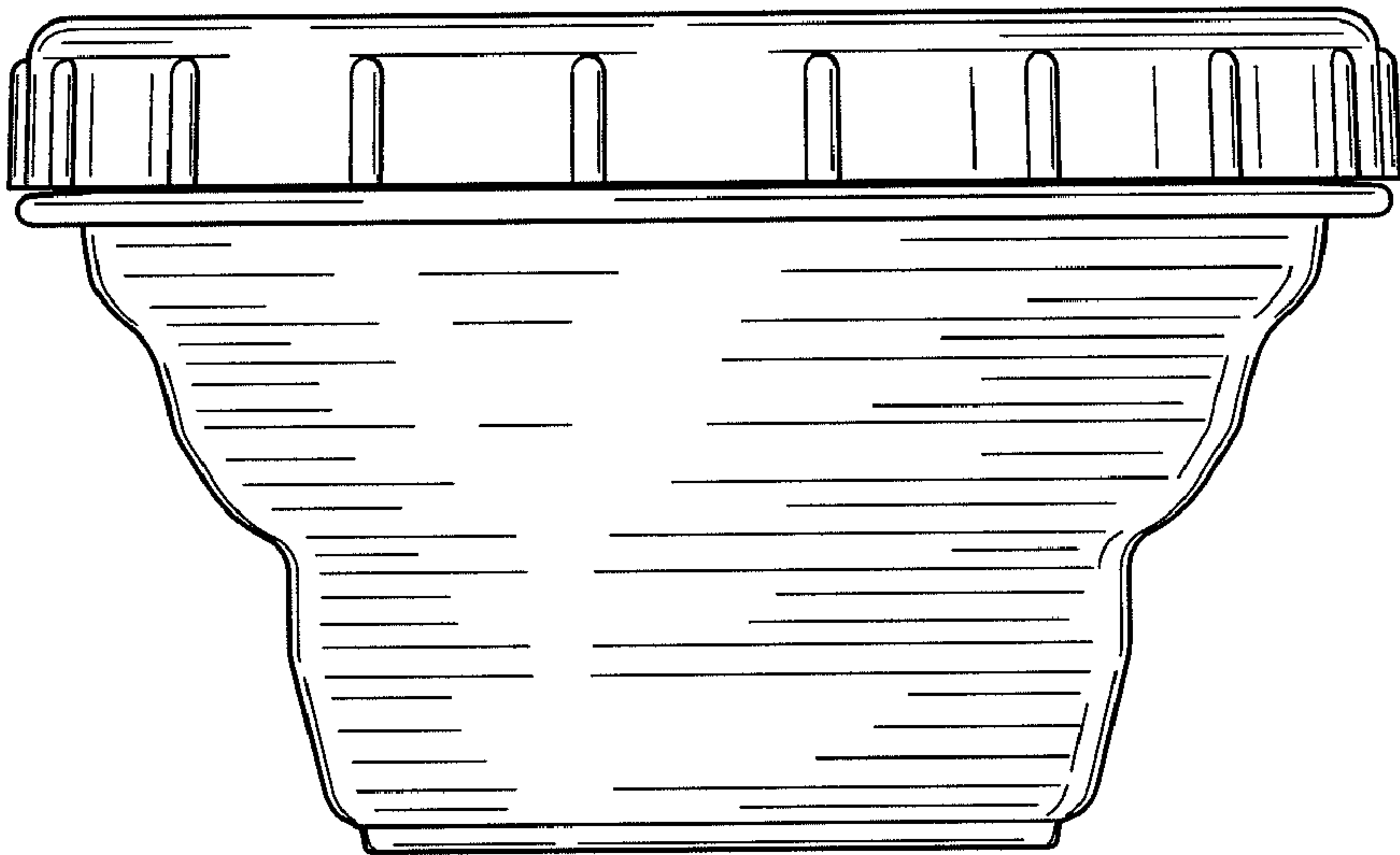

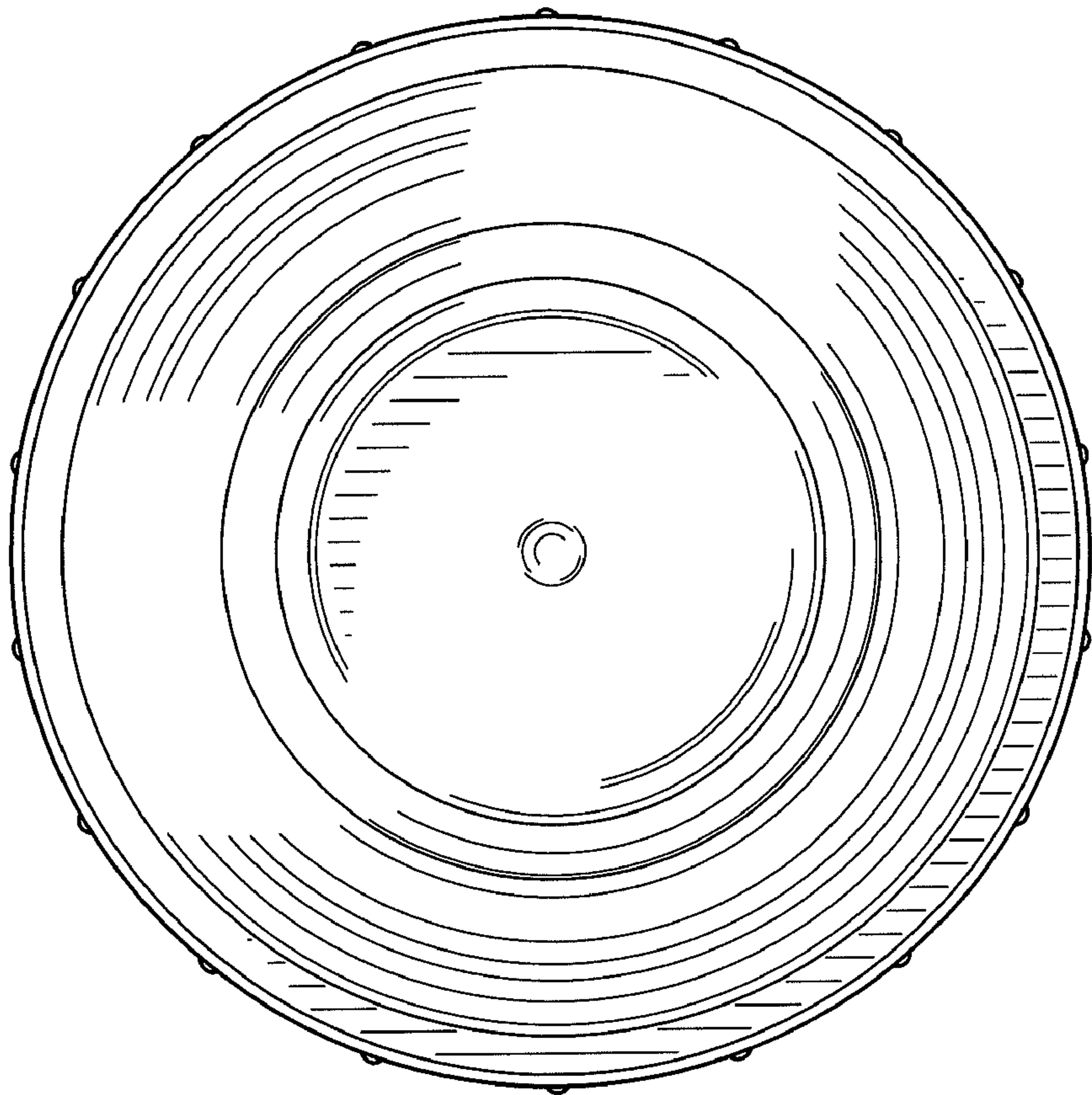
