FIG. 10 is a perspective view of the expanded mounting bracket in a using status;

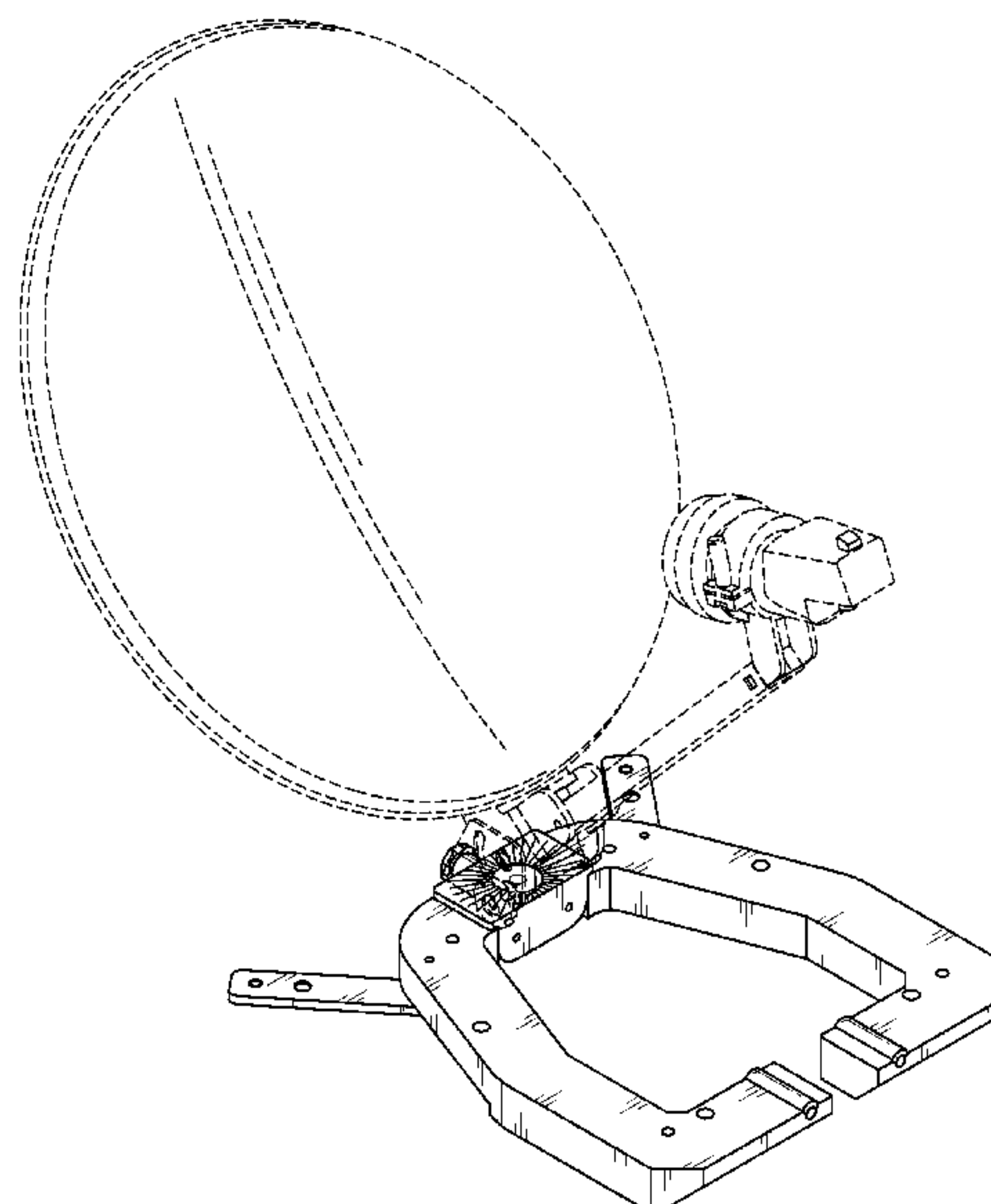
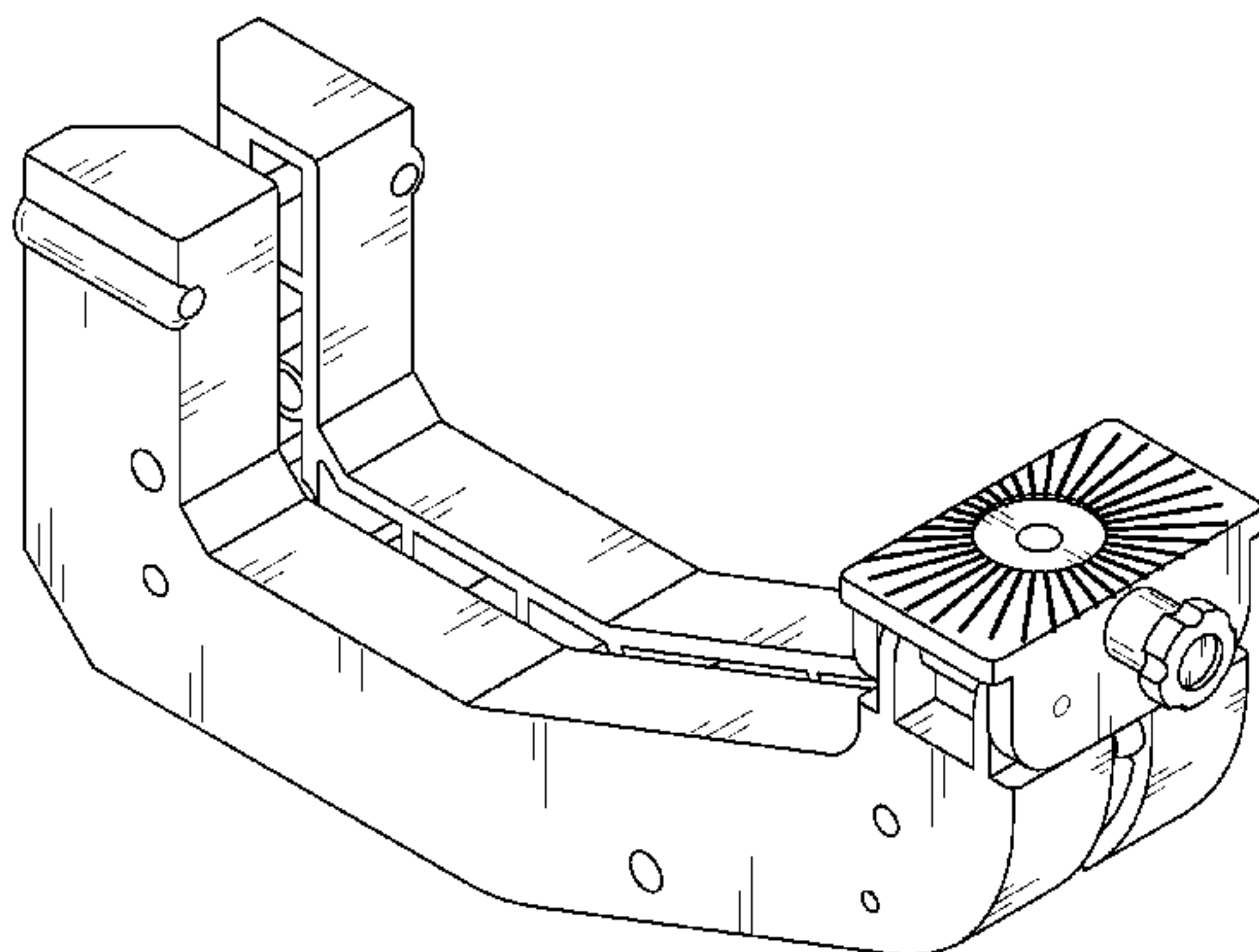
FIG. 11 is a perspective view of the expanded mounting bracket in another using status;

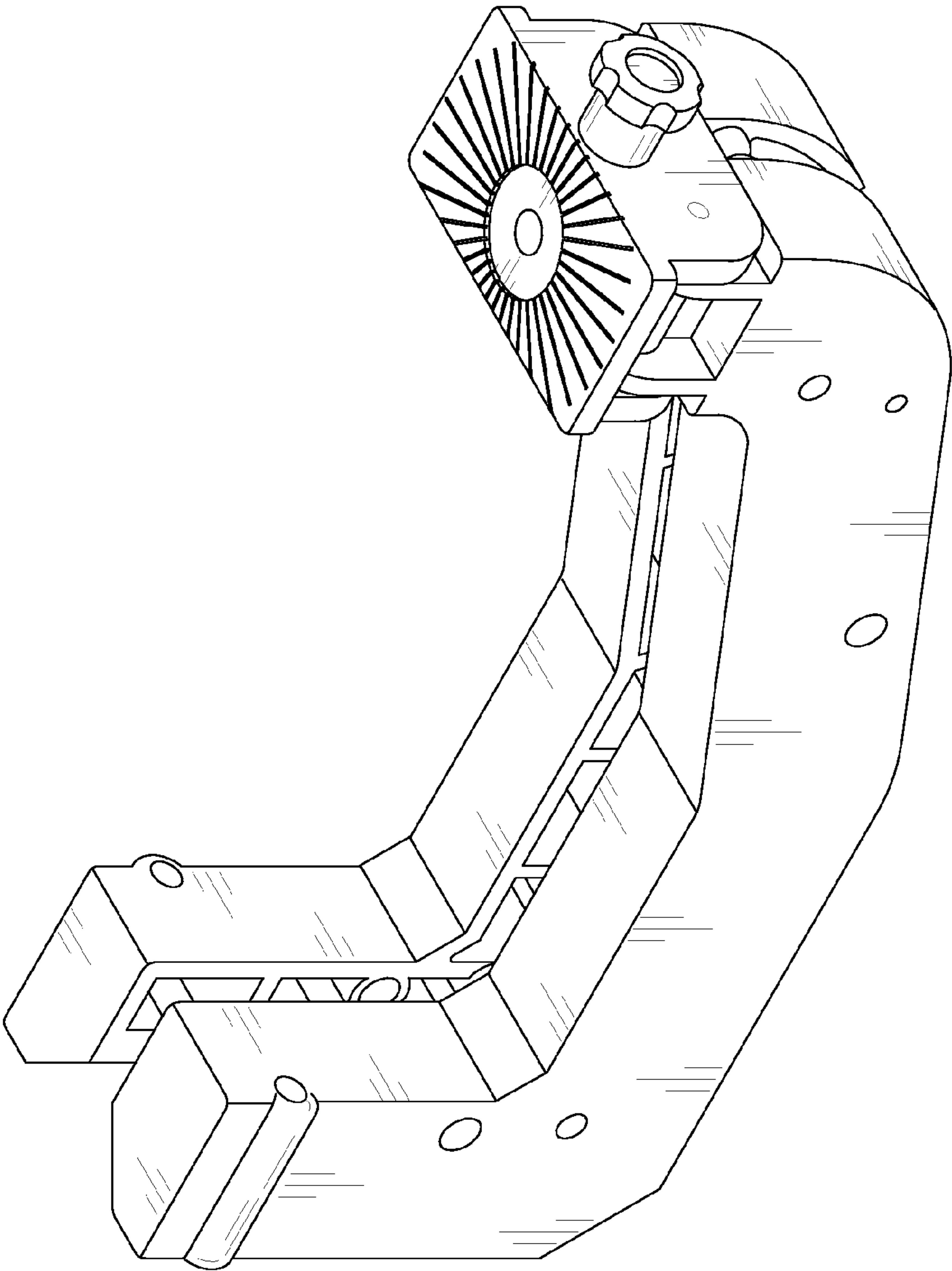

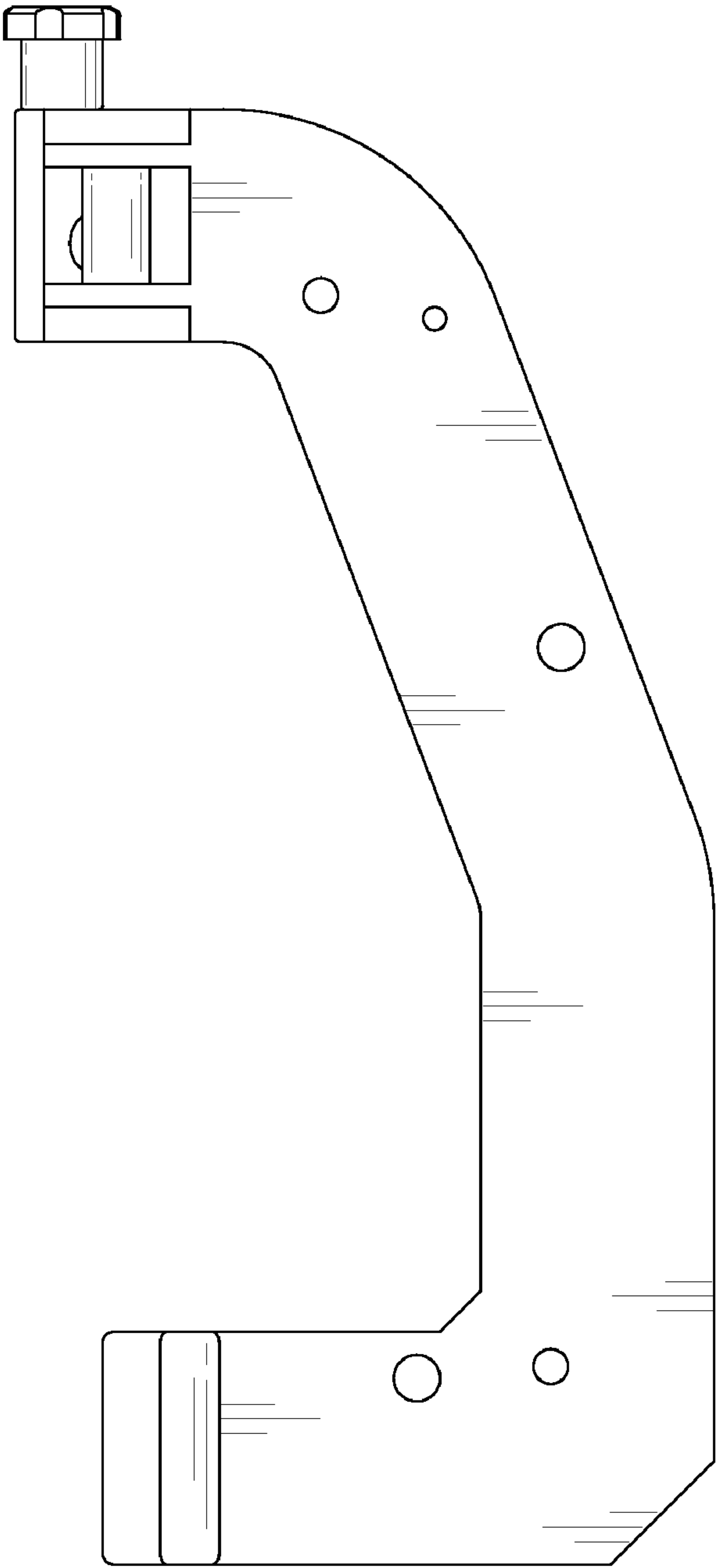

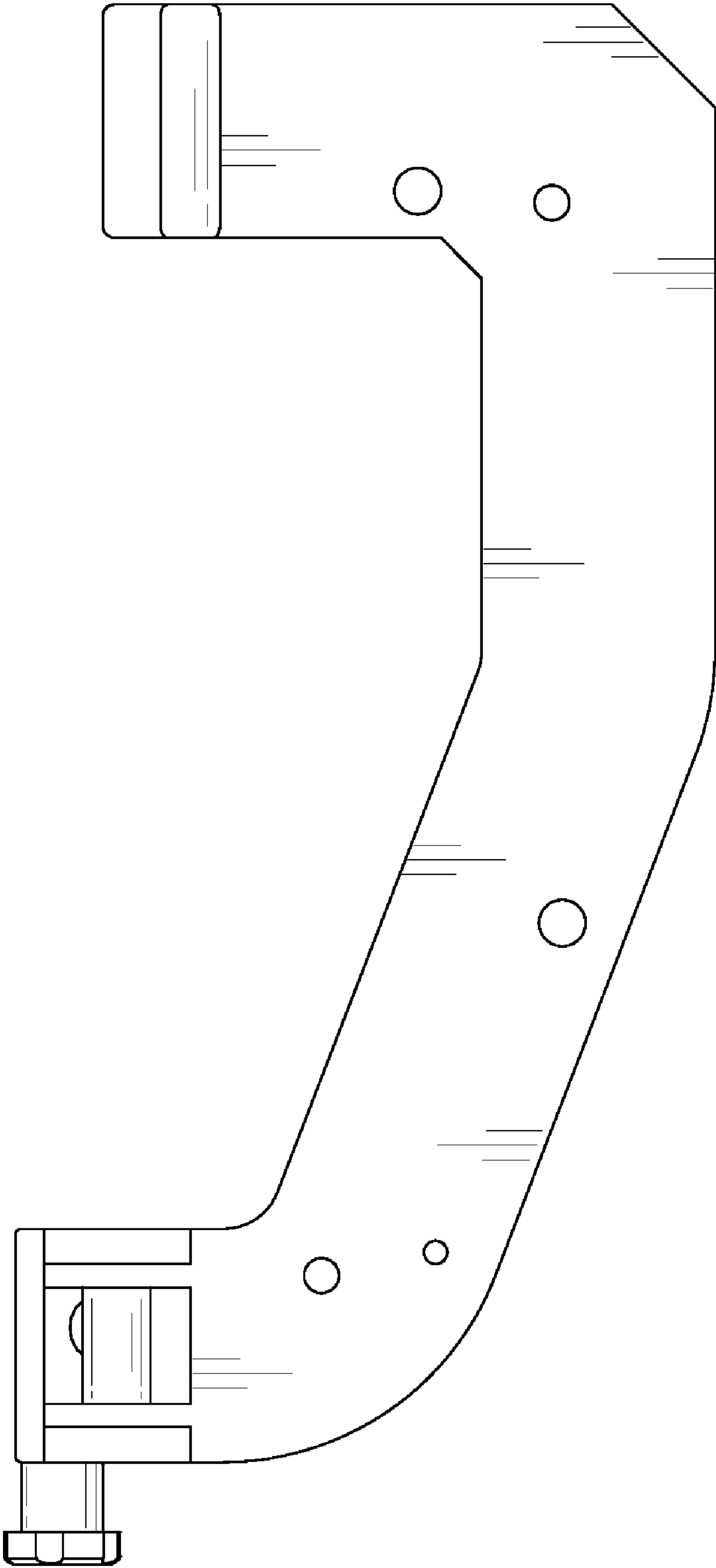

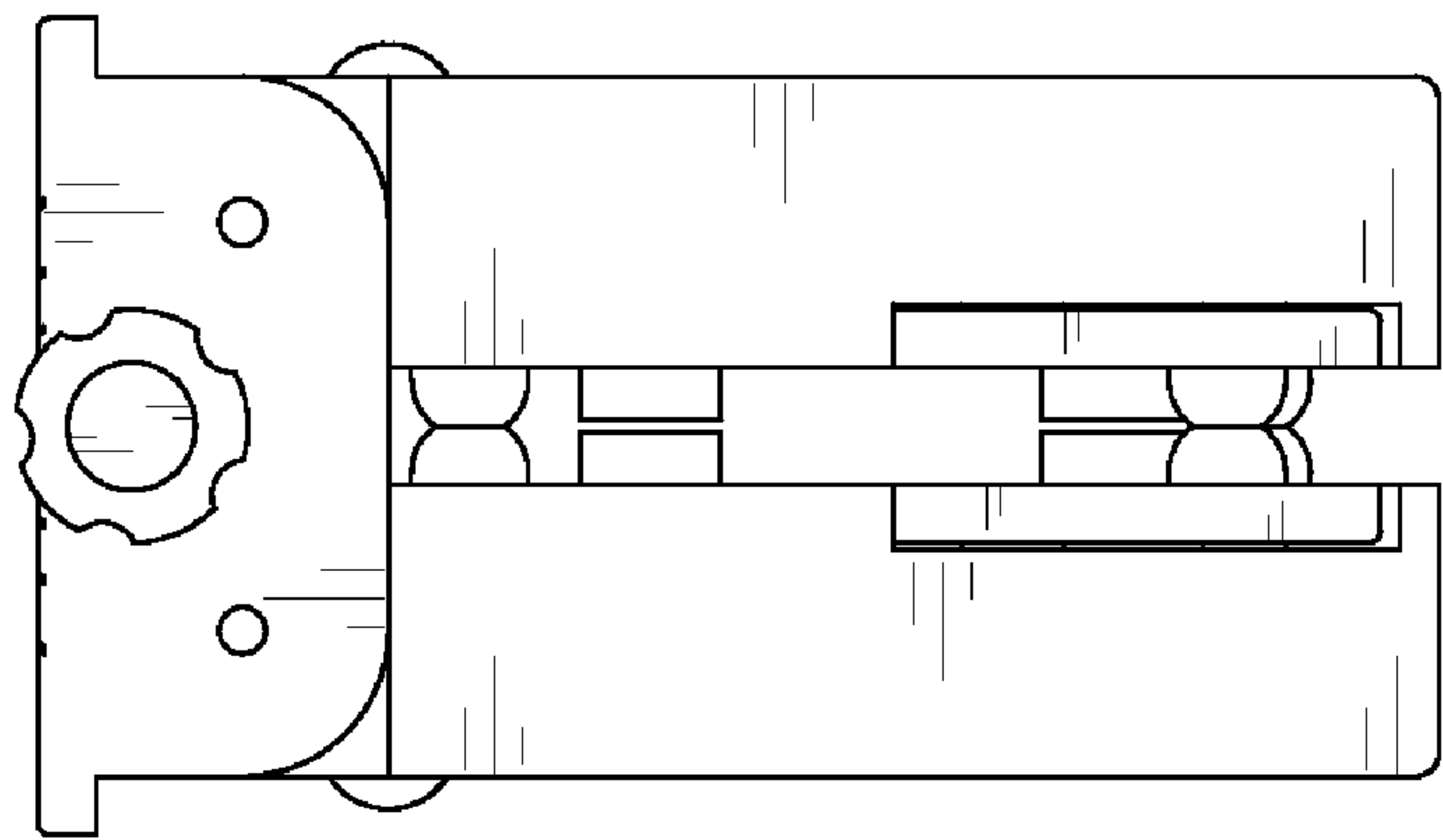

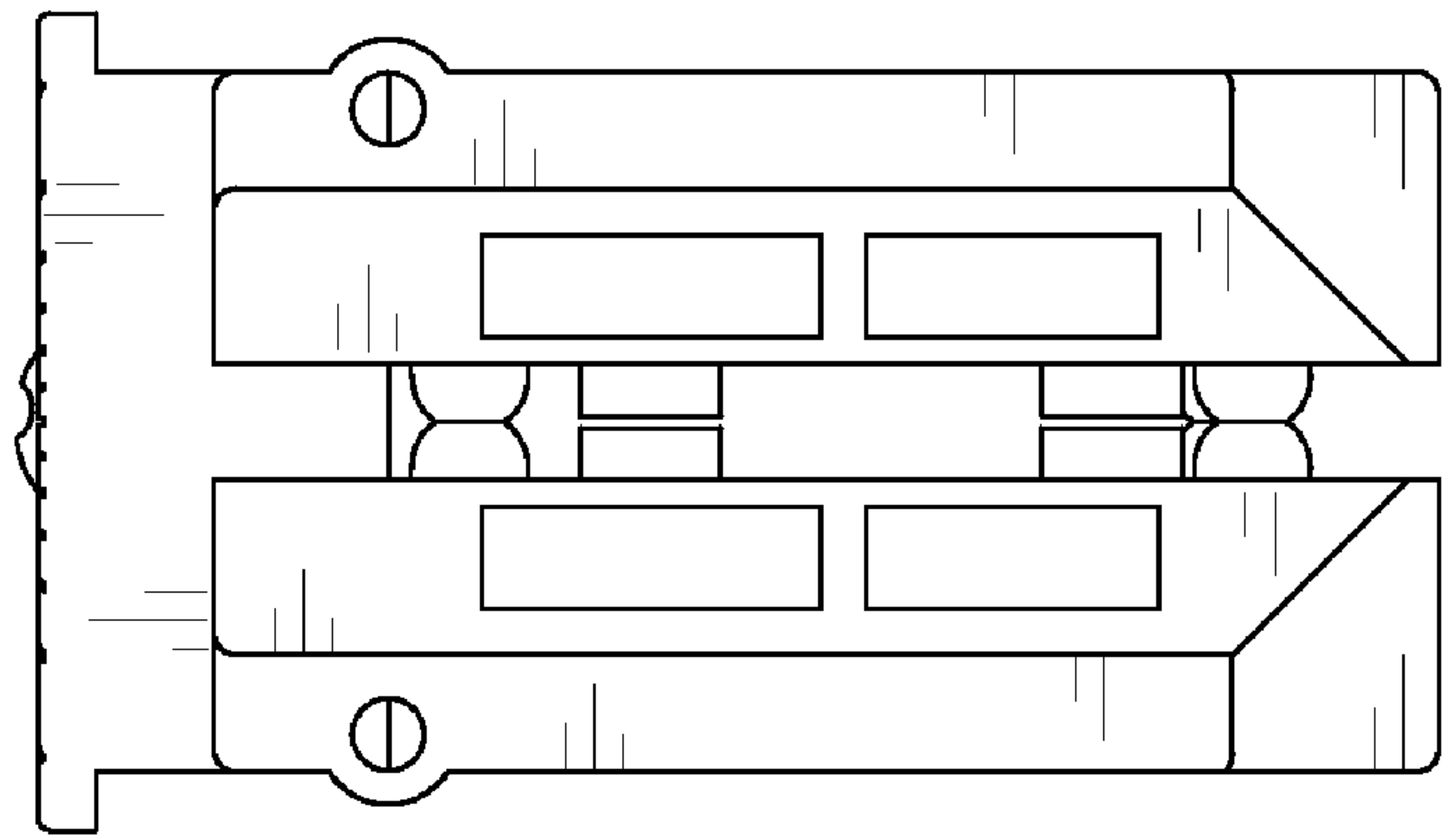

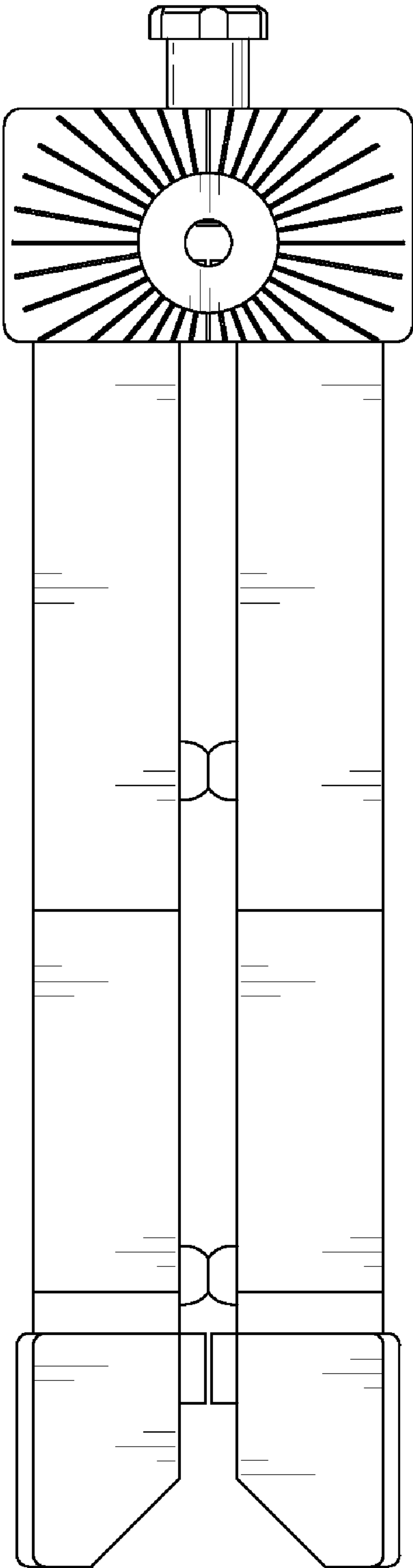

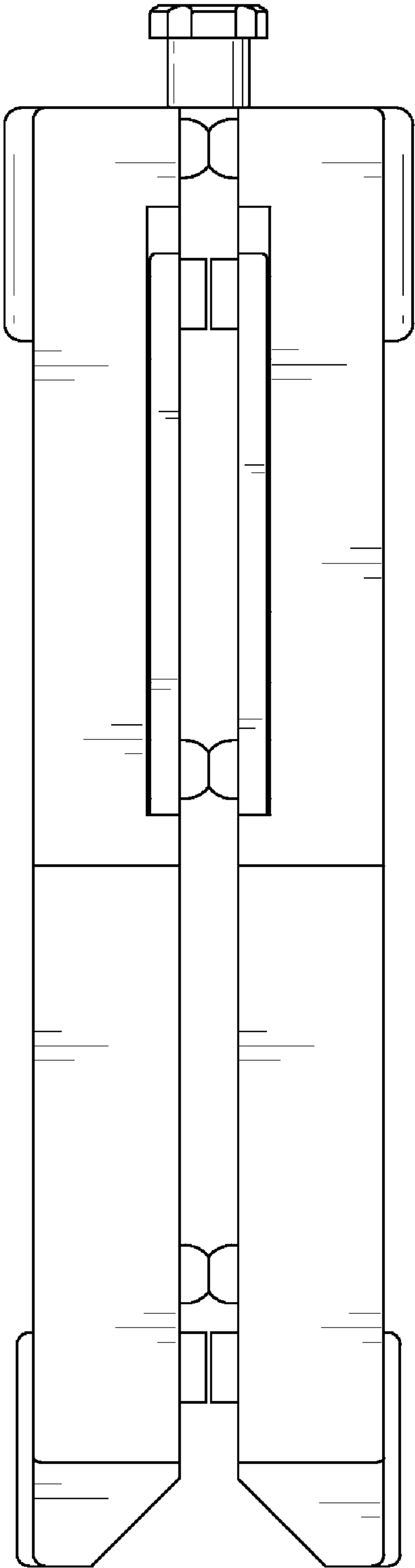

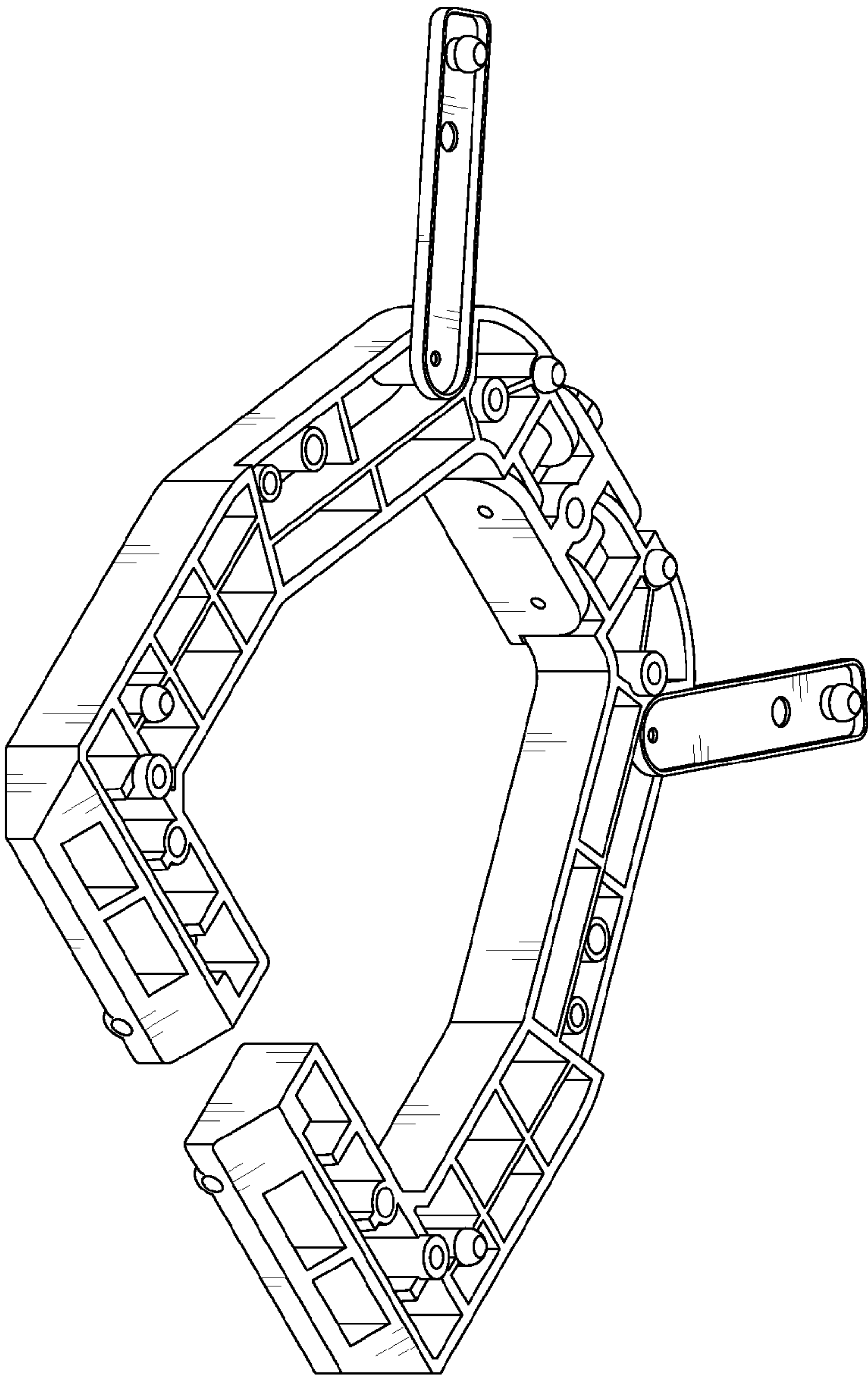

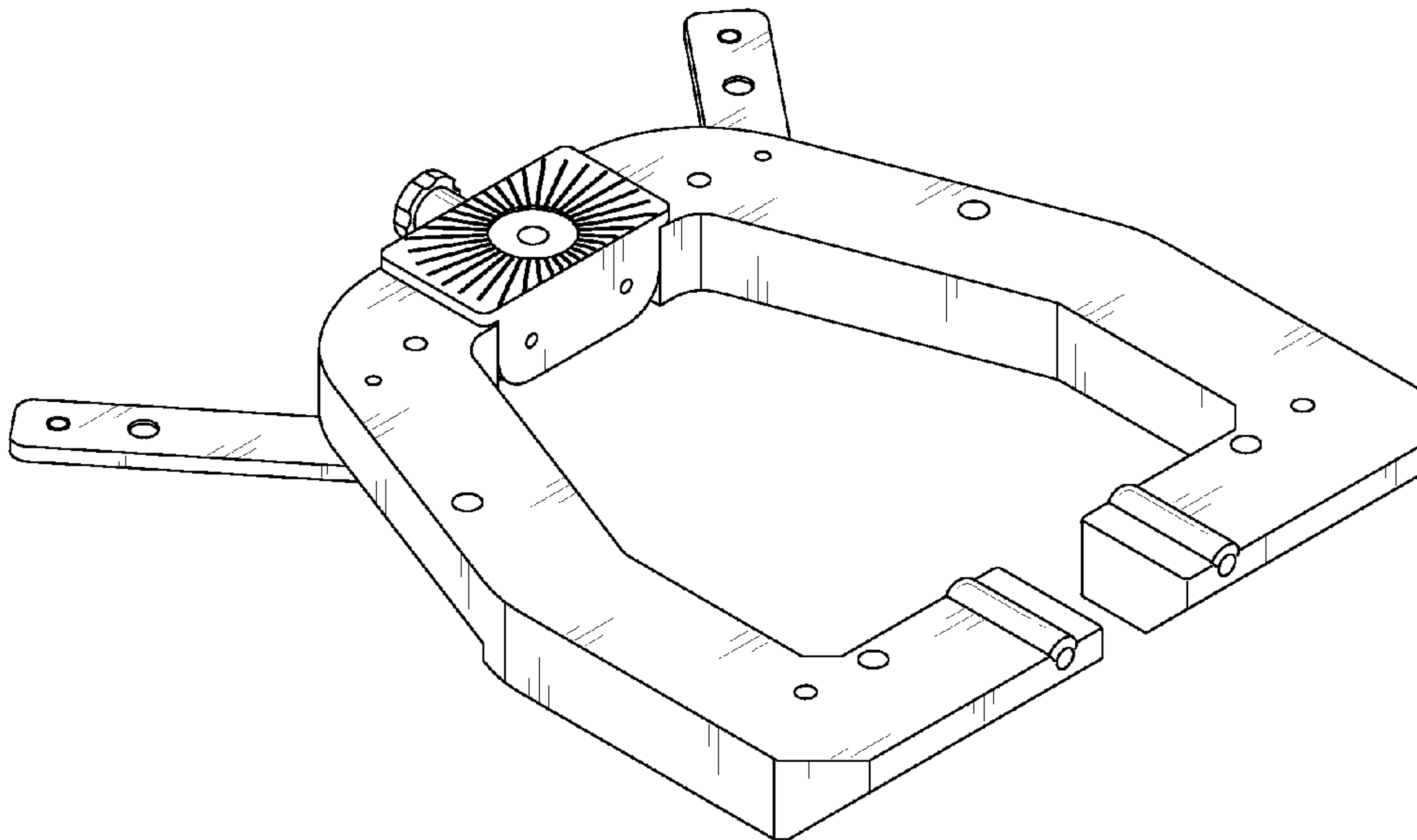

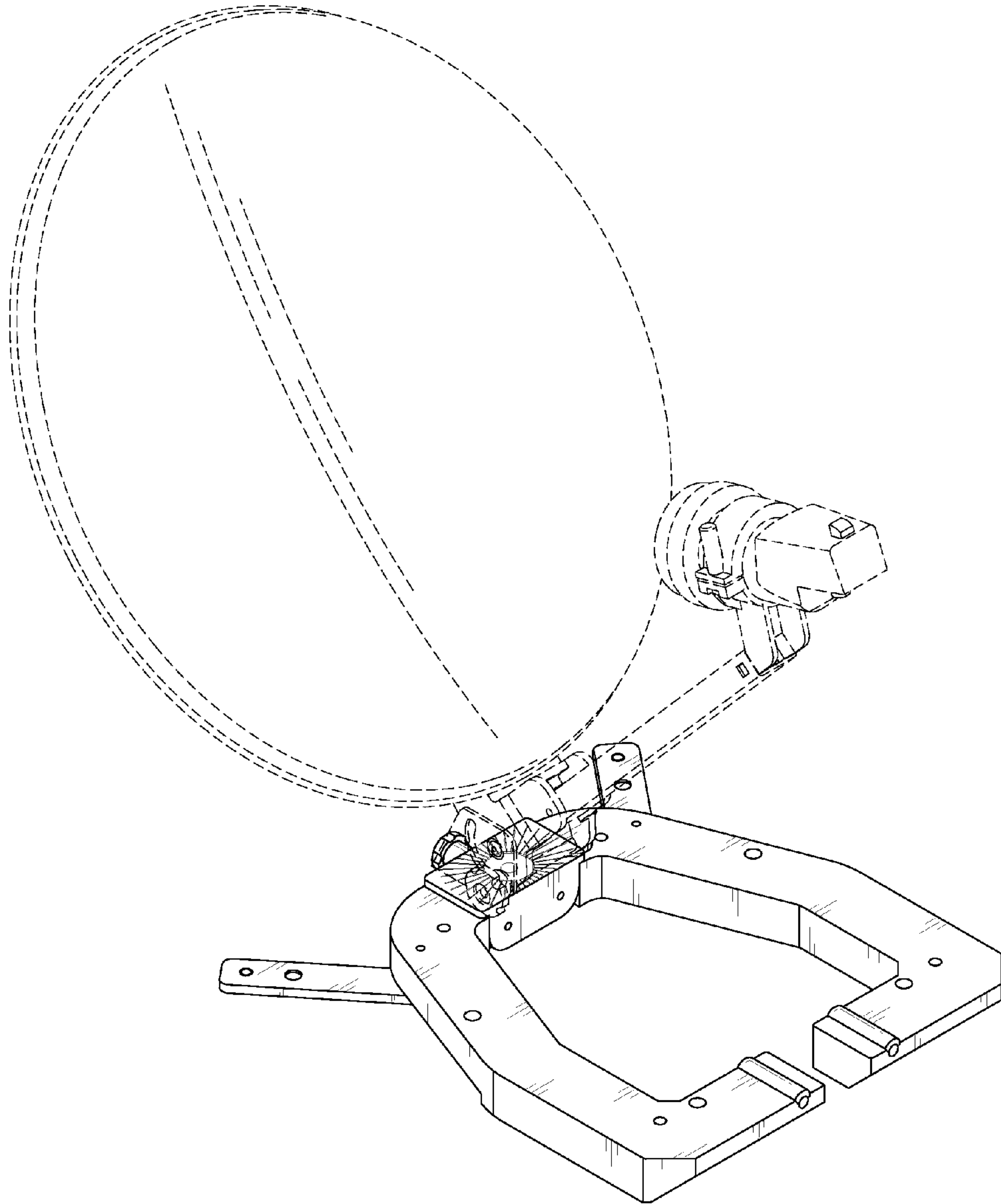

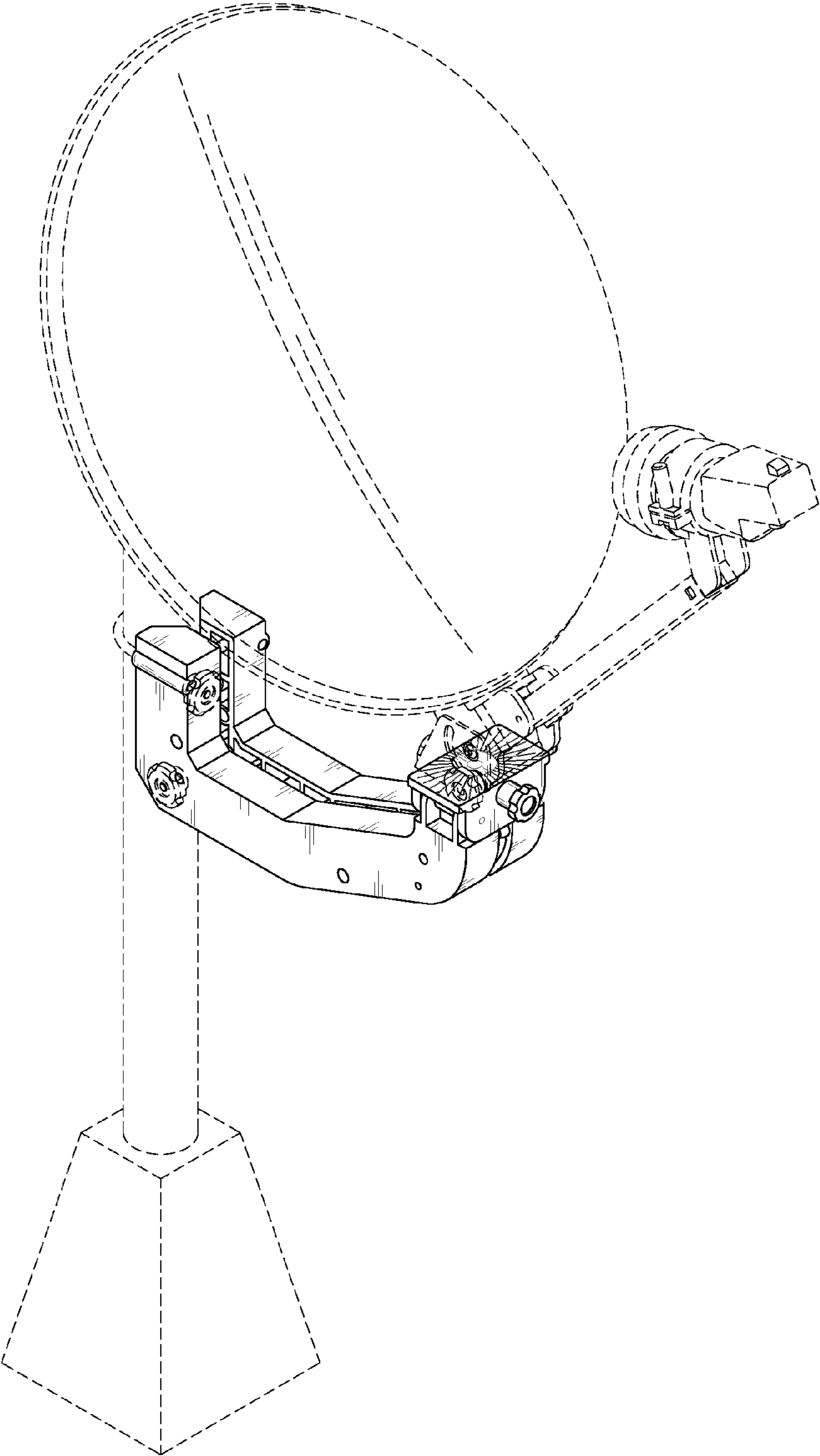

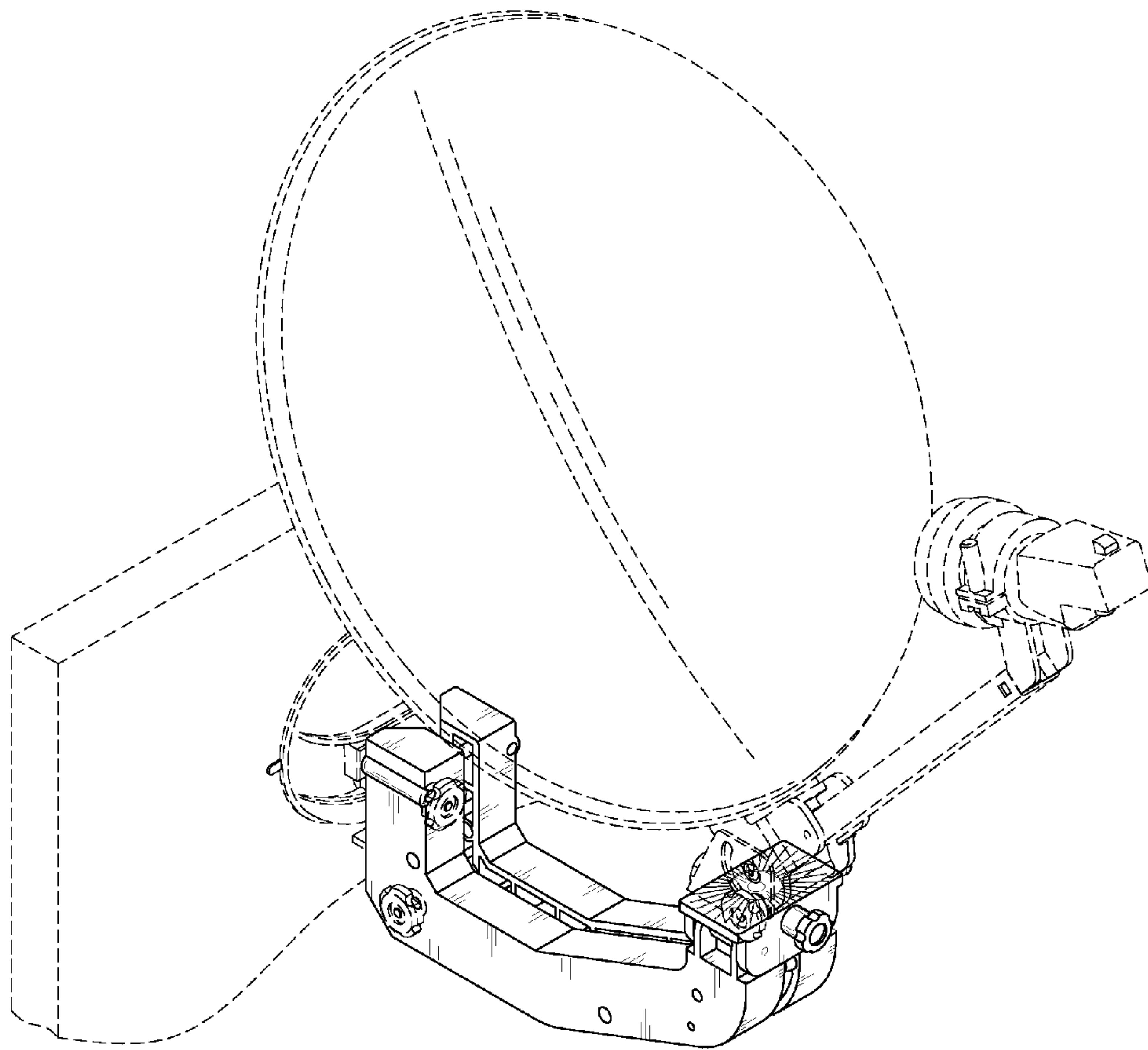

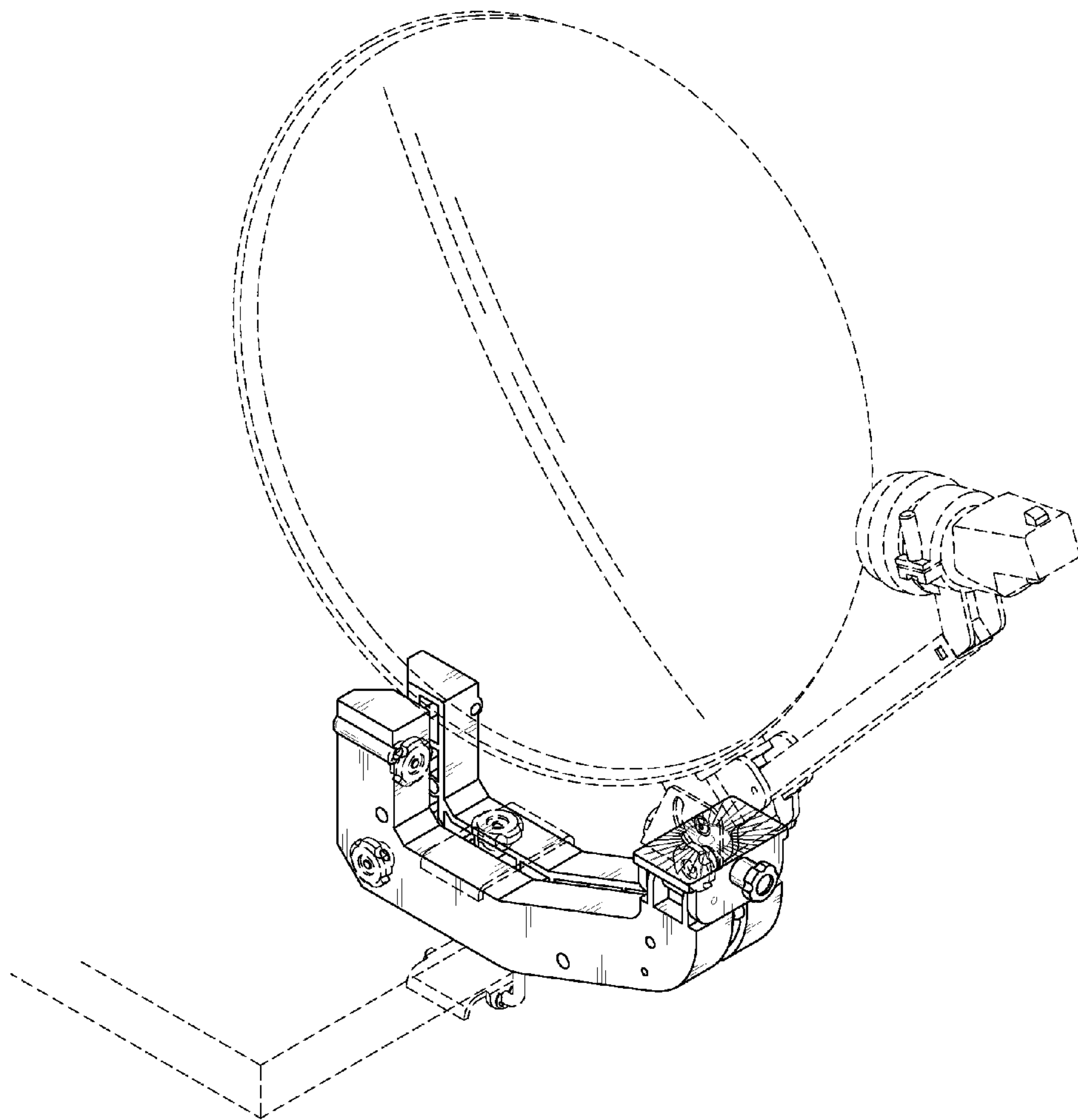
