FIG. 3 is a top view thereof;

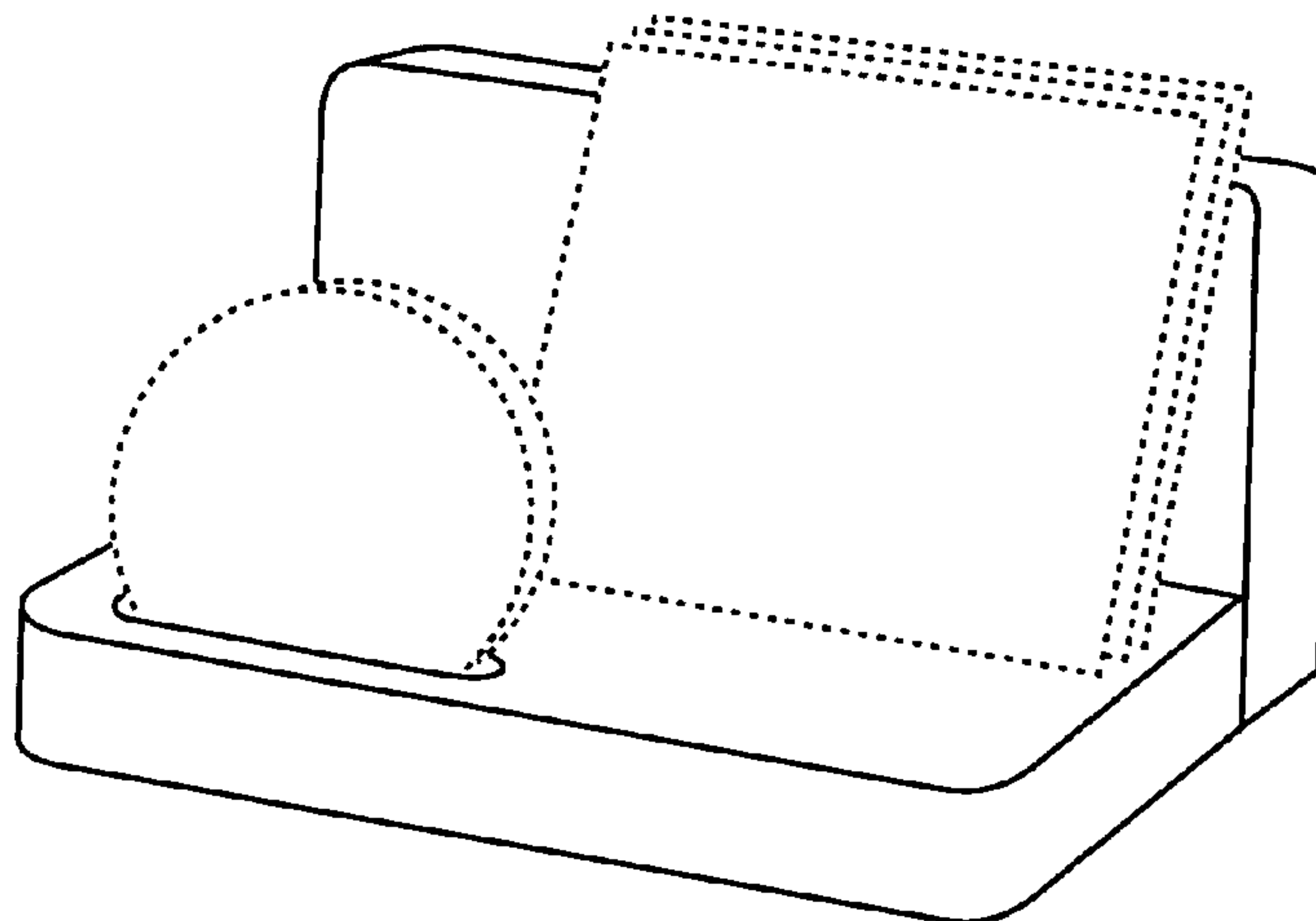
FIG. 4 is a left side view, the right being a mirror image thereof; and,

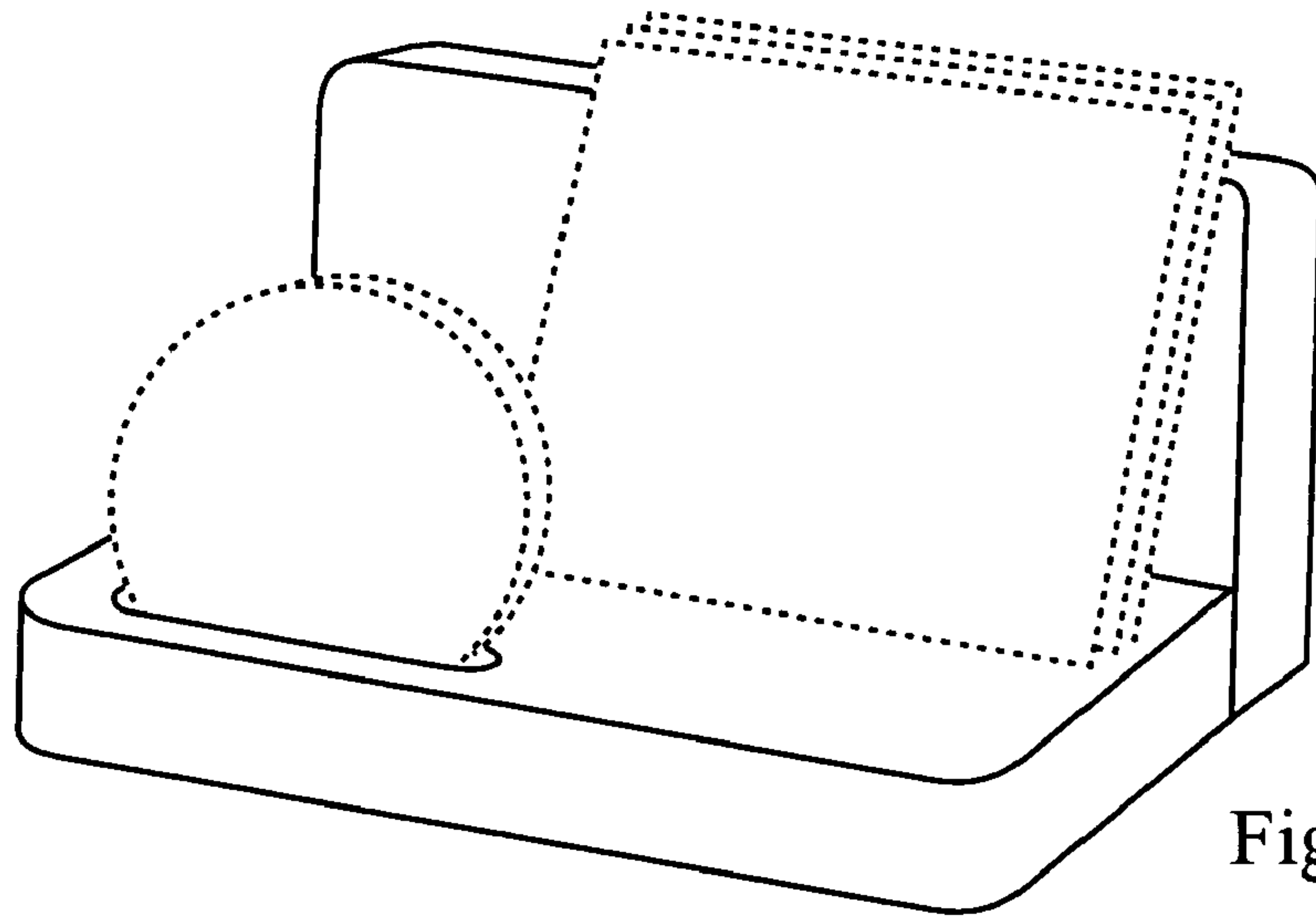

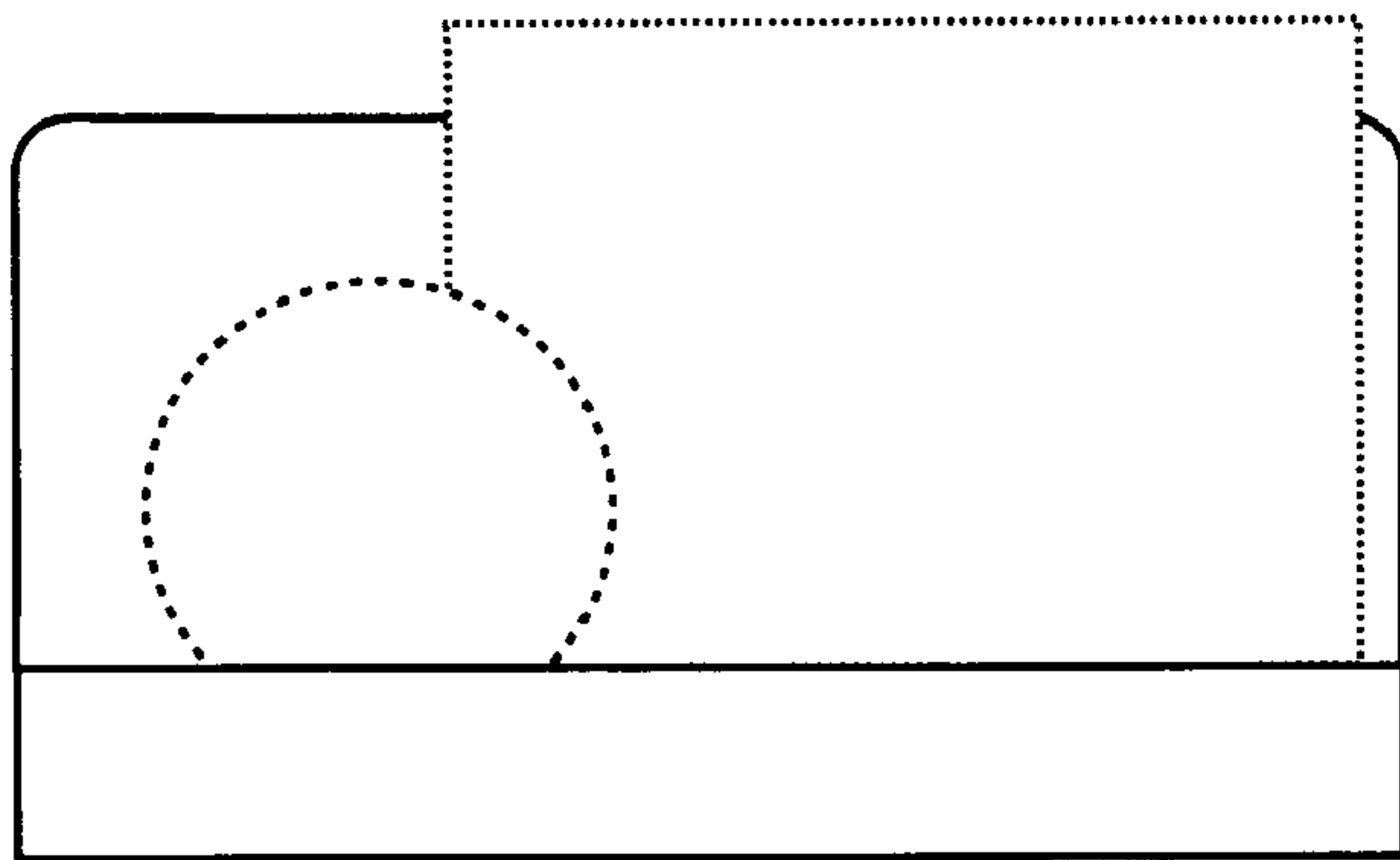

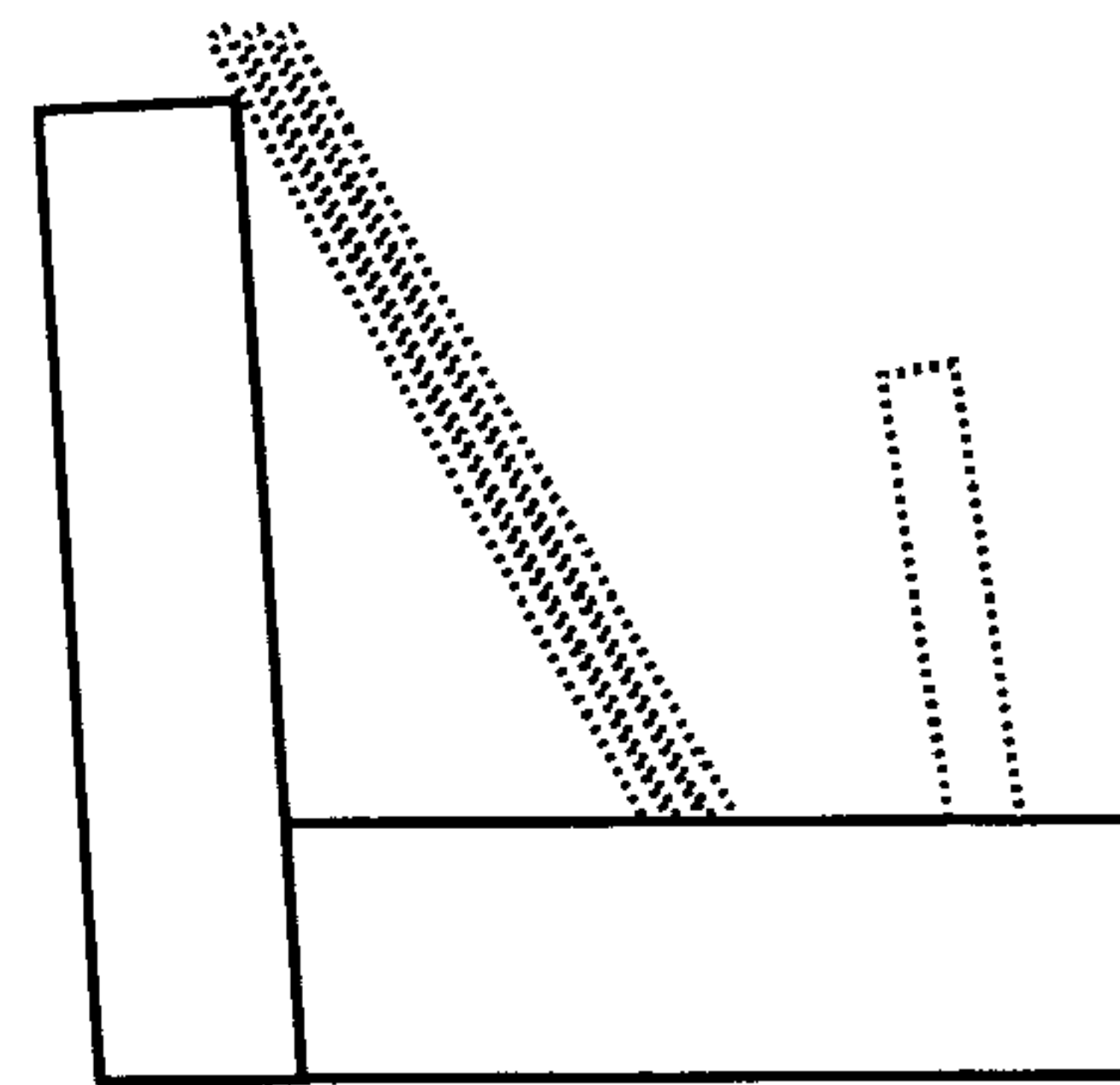

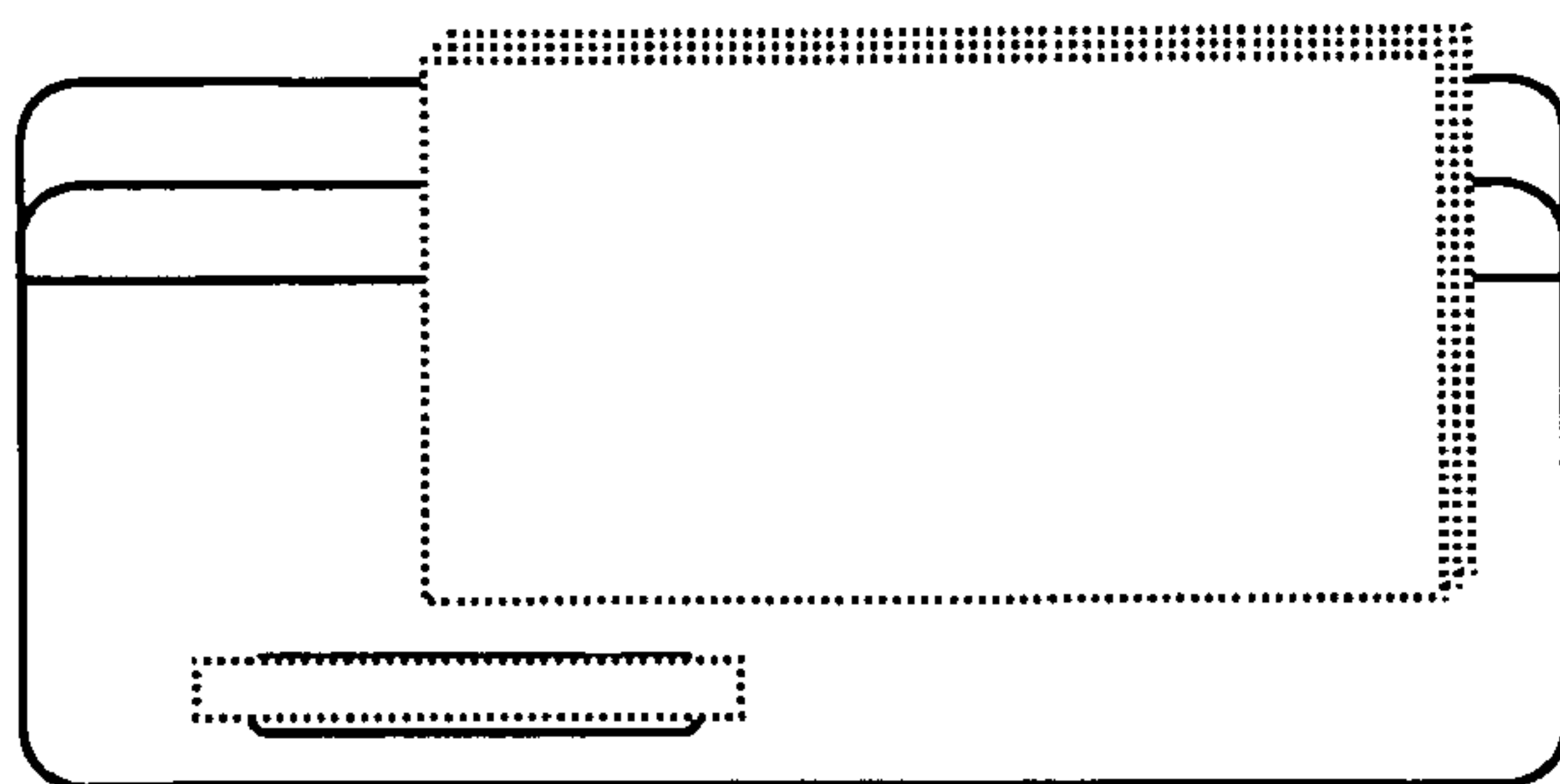

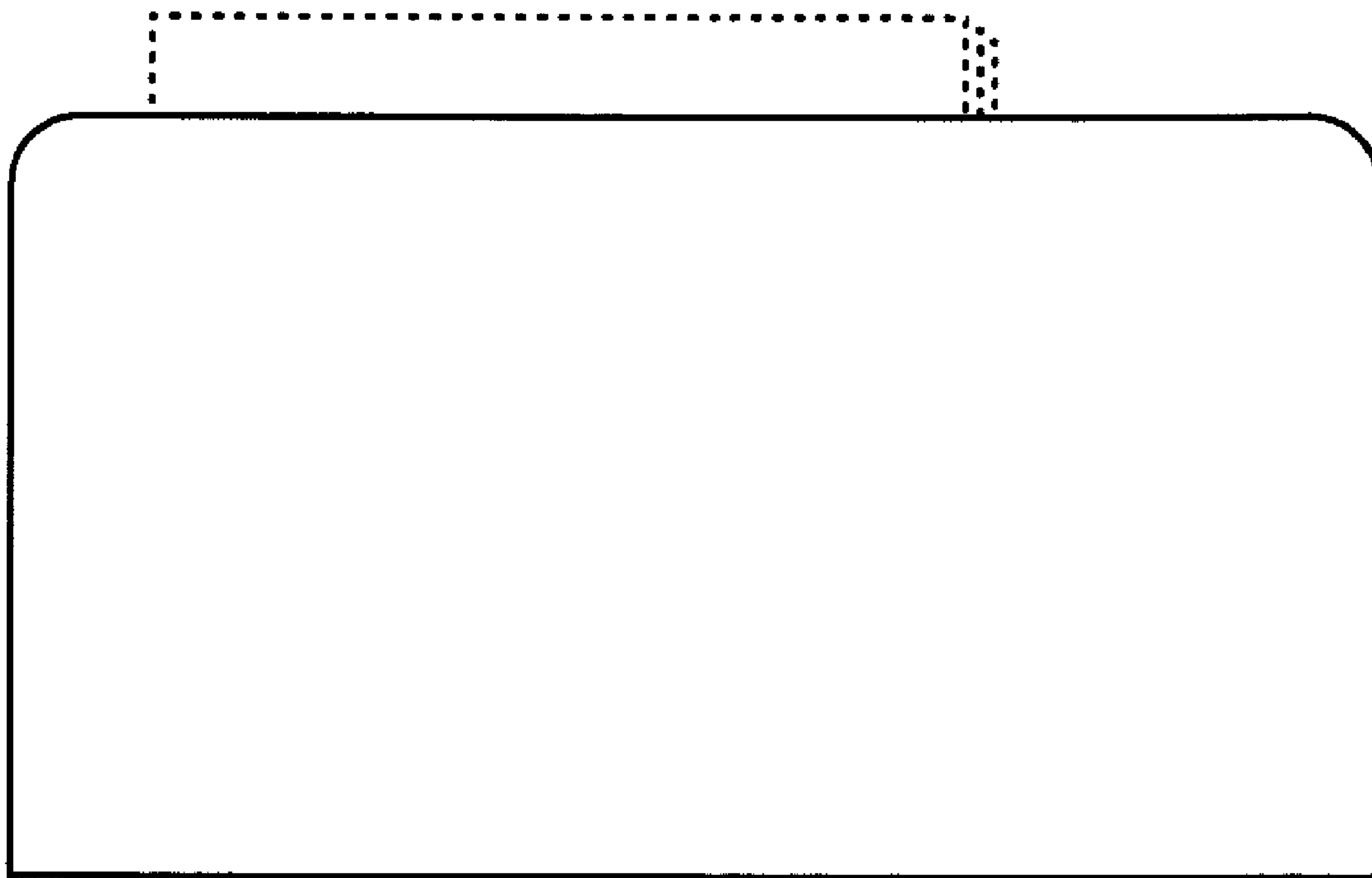
