DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear top perspective view of a handle for a reaching
and grasping tool according to my design;

FIG. 2 is a front bottom perspective view of the handle for a
reaching and grasping tool of FIG. 1;

tool of FIG. 1 in an open position;

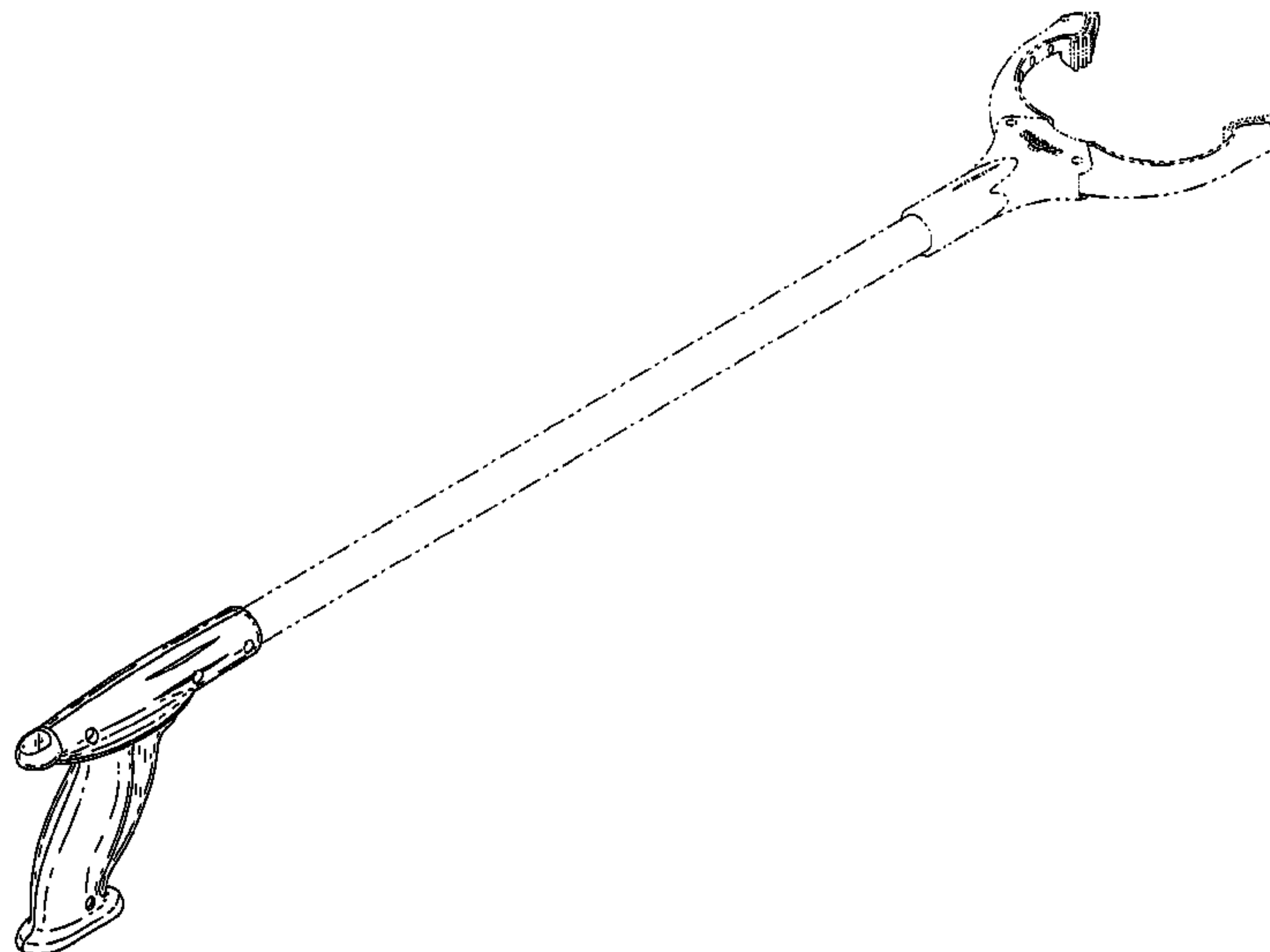
FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the handle for a reaching and

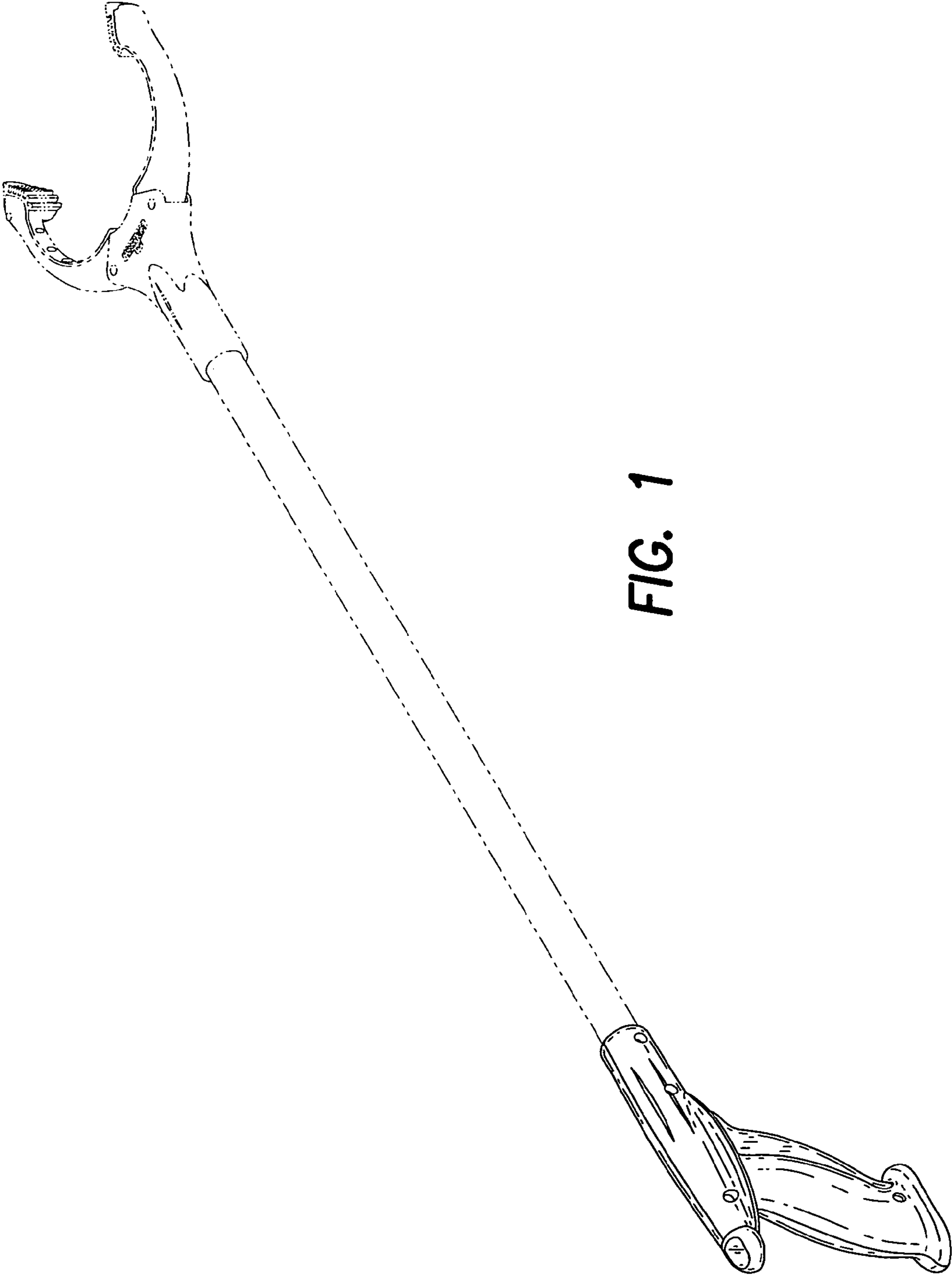

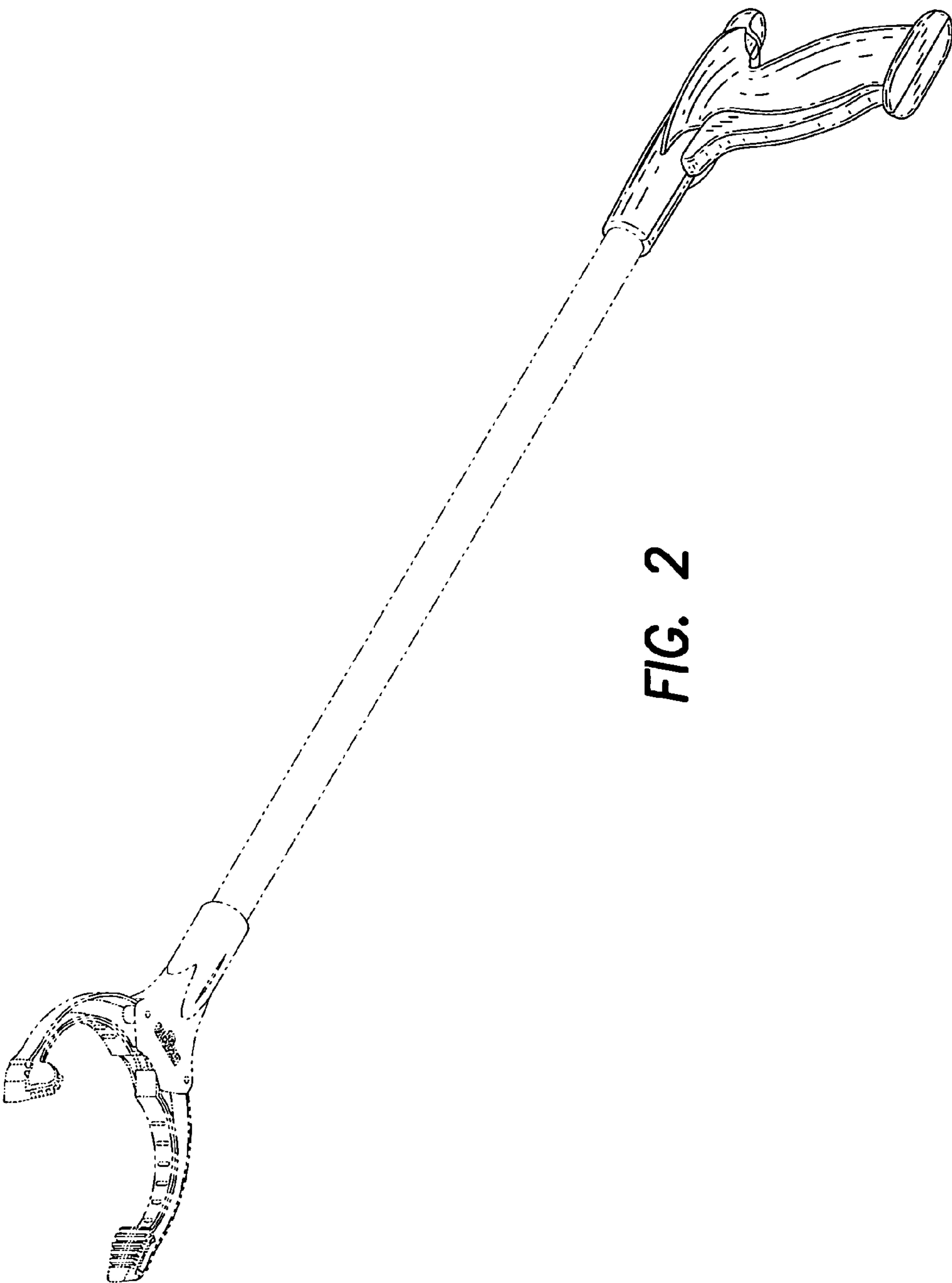

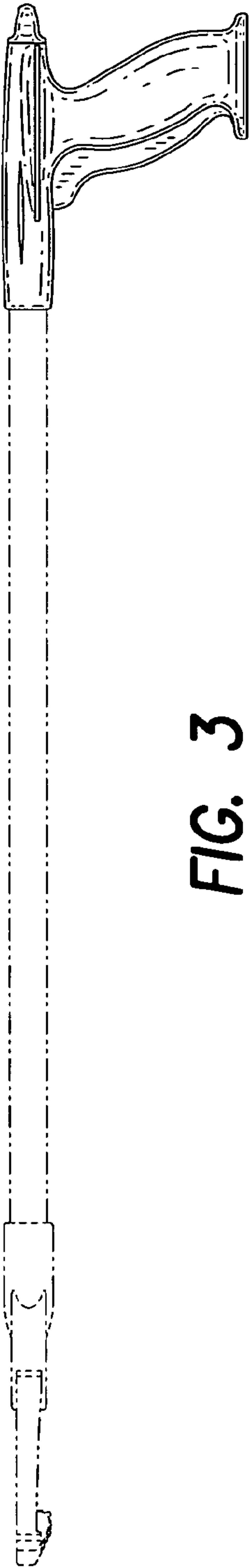

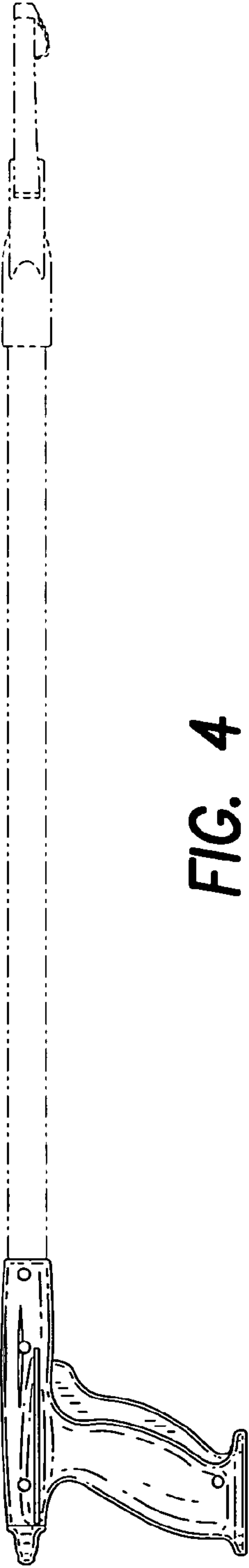

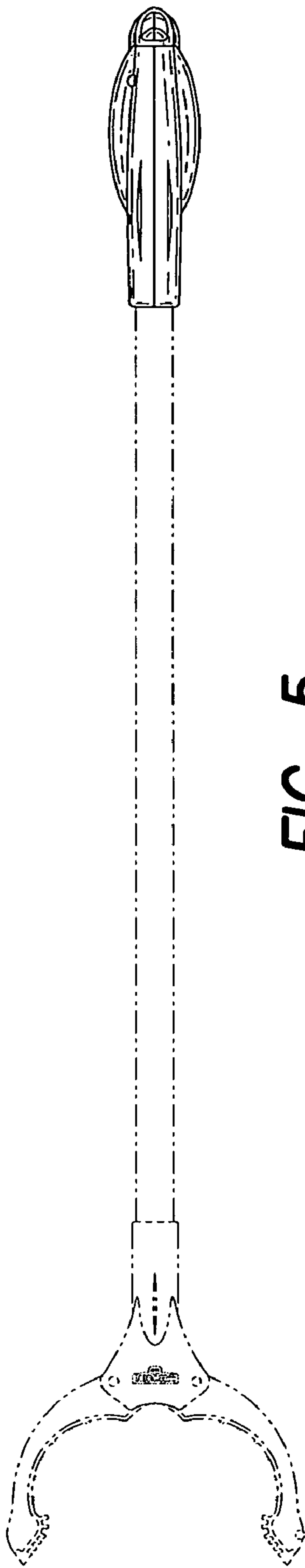

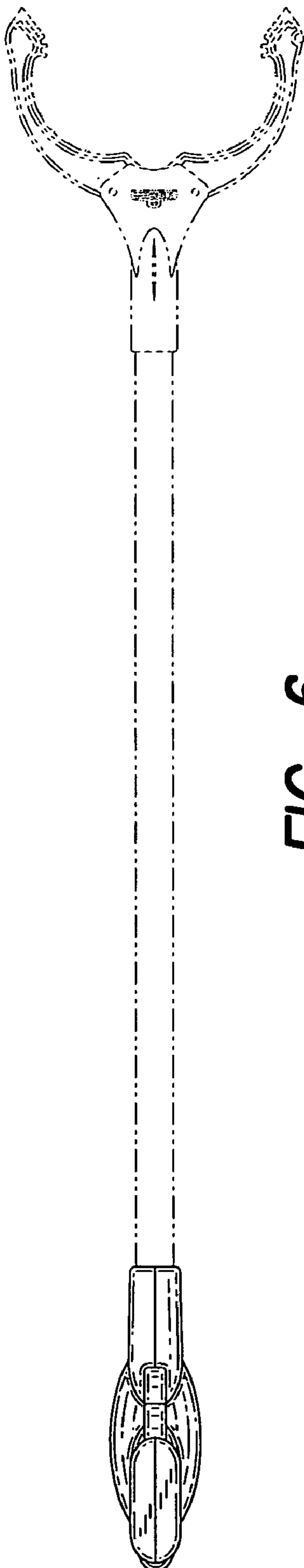

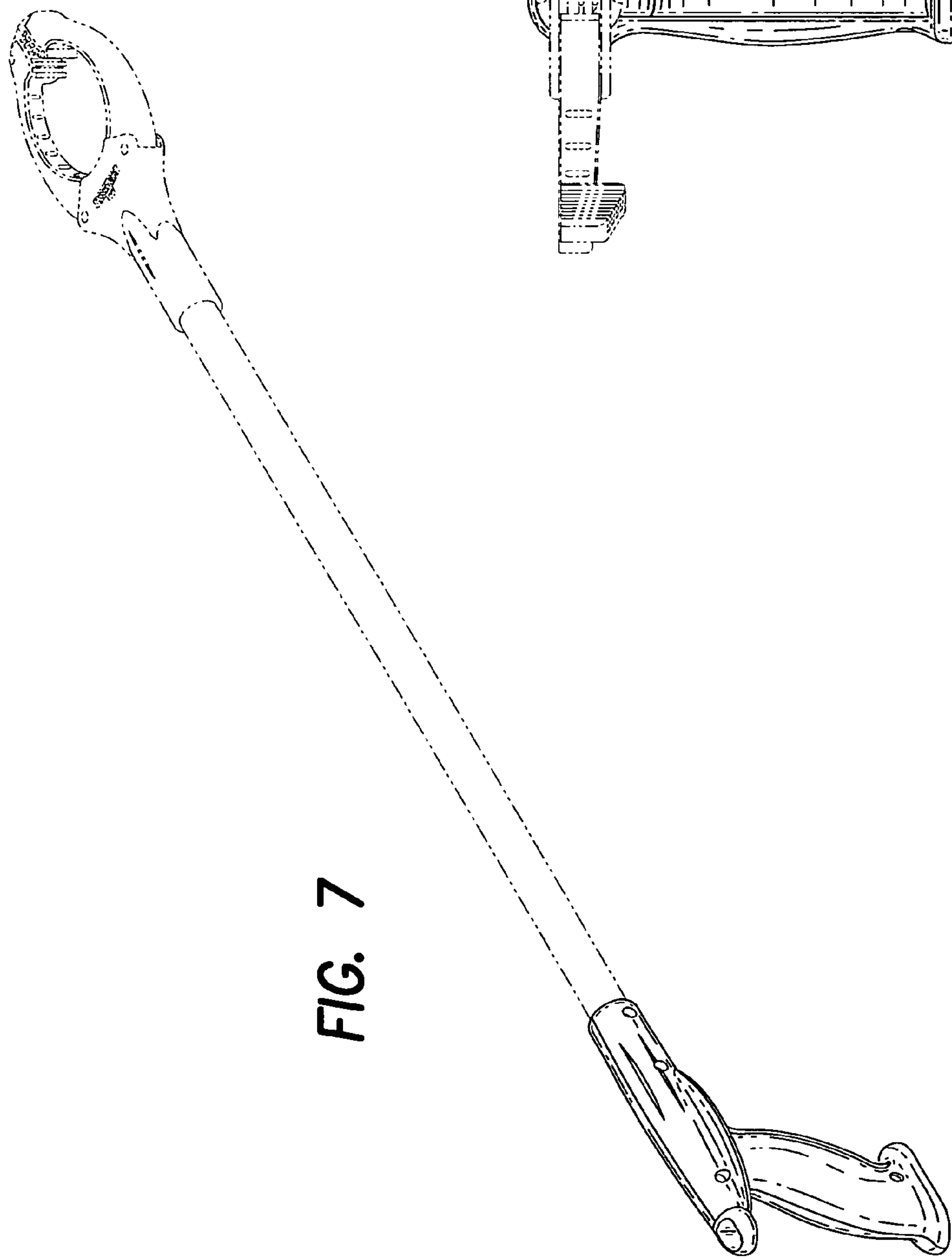

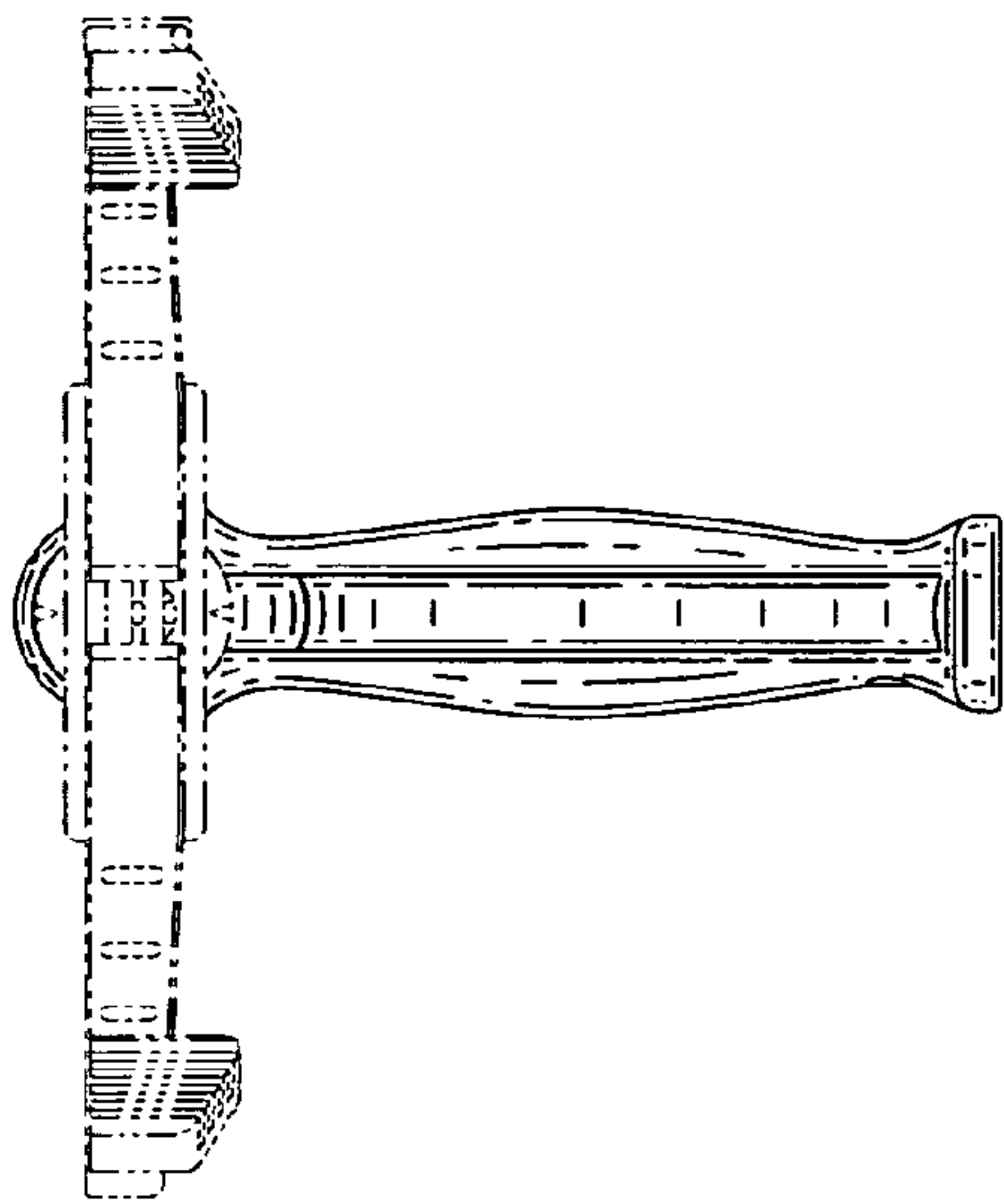
